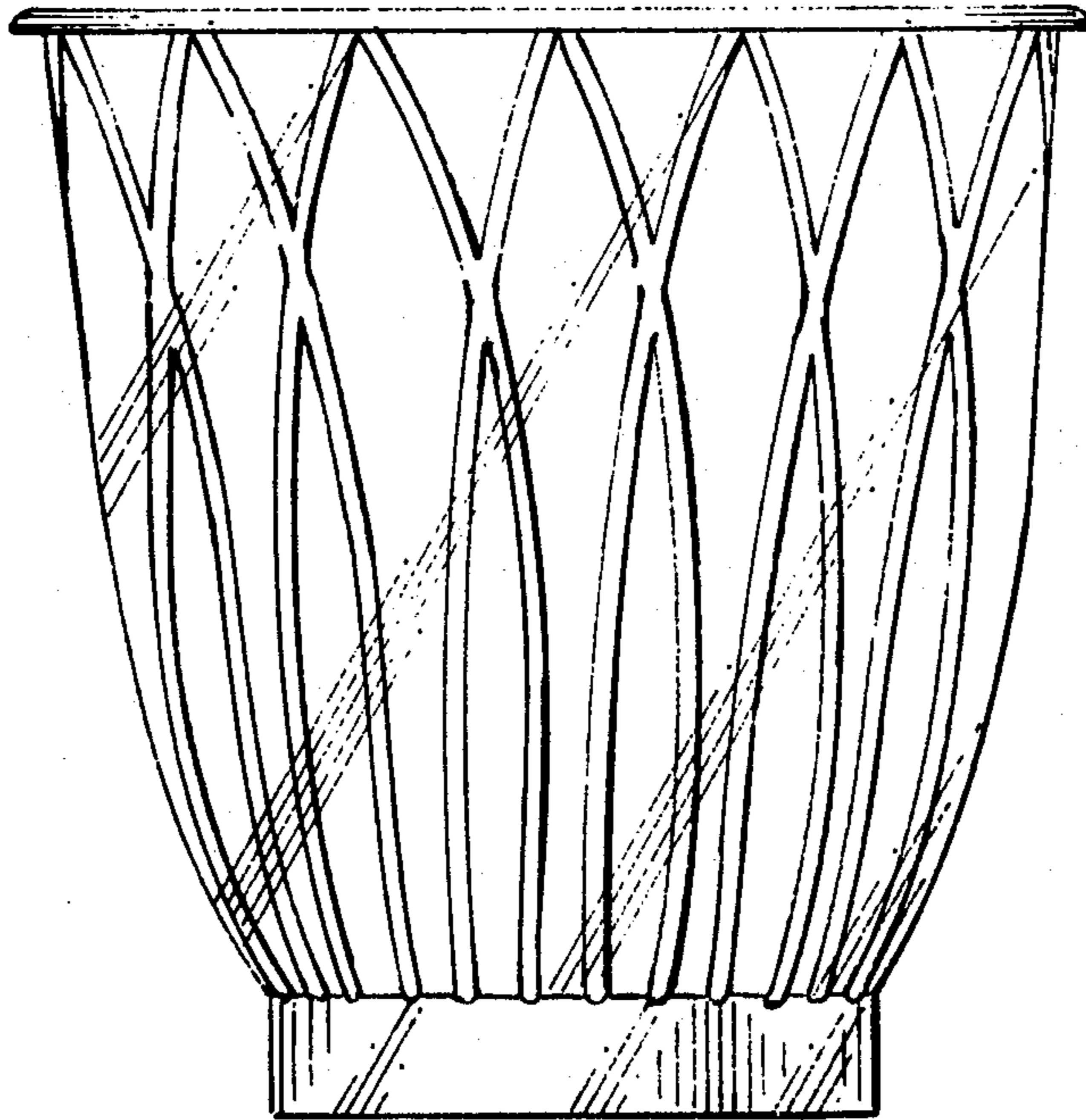

### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tumbler, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tumbler showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational, the opposite side being the same in appearance;  
FIG. 3 is a fragmentary developed plan view of the side wall;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view of the ornamentation on the exterior of the tumbler.



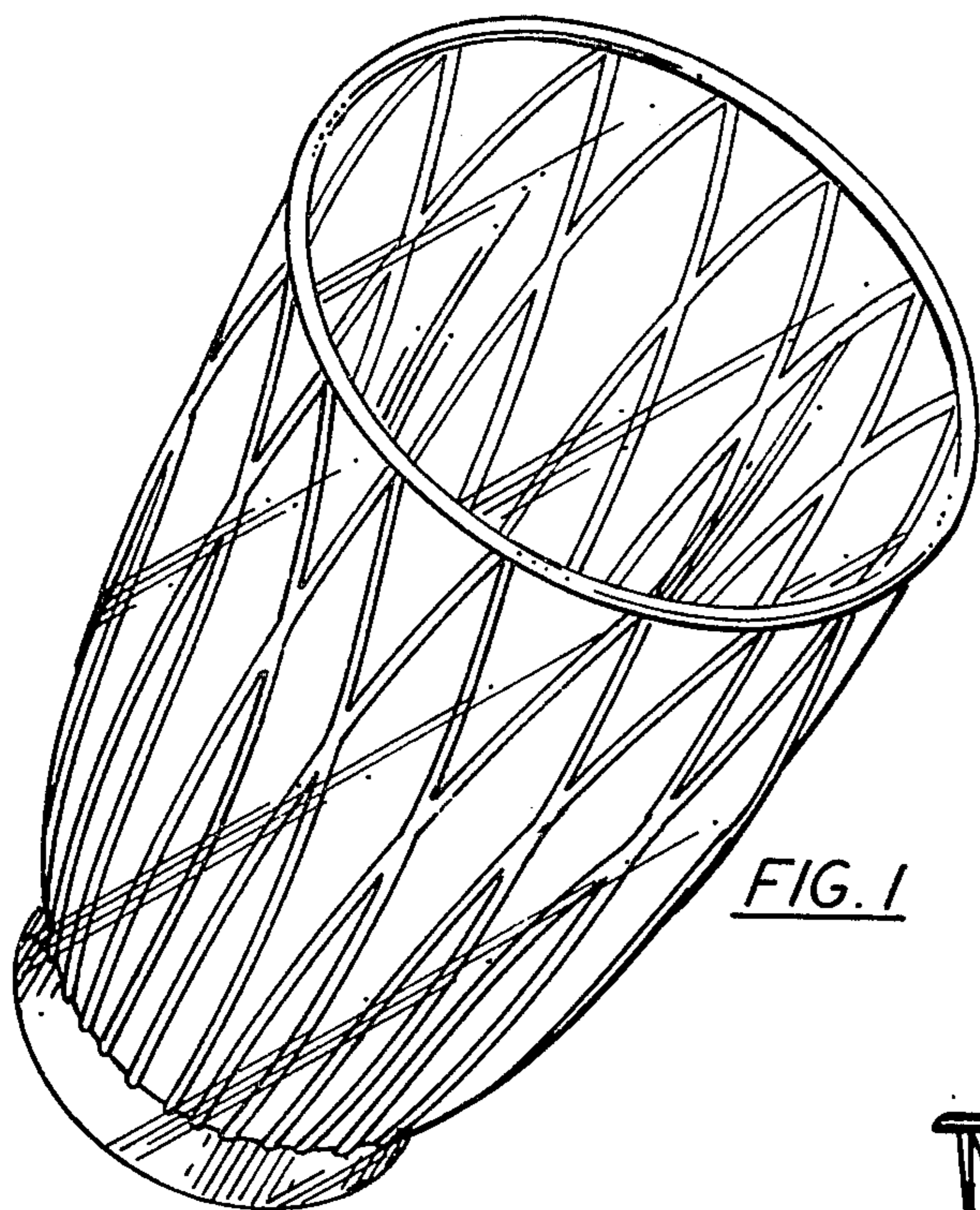

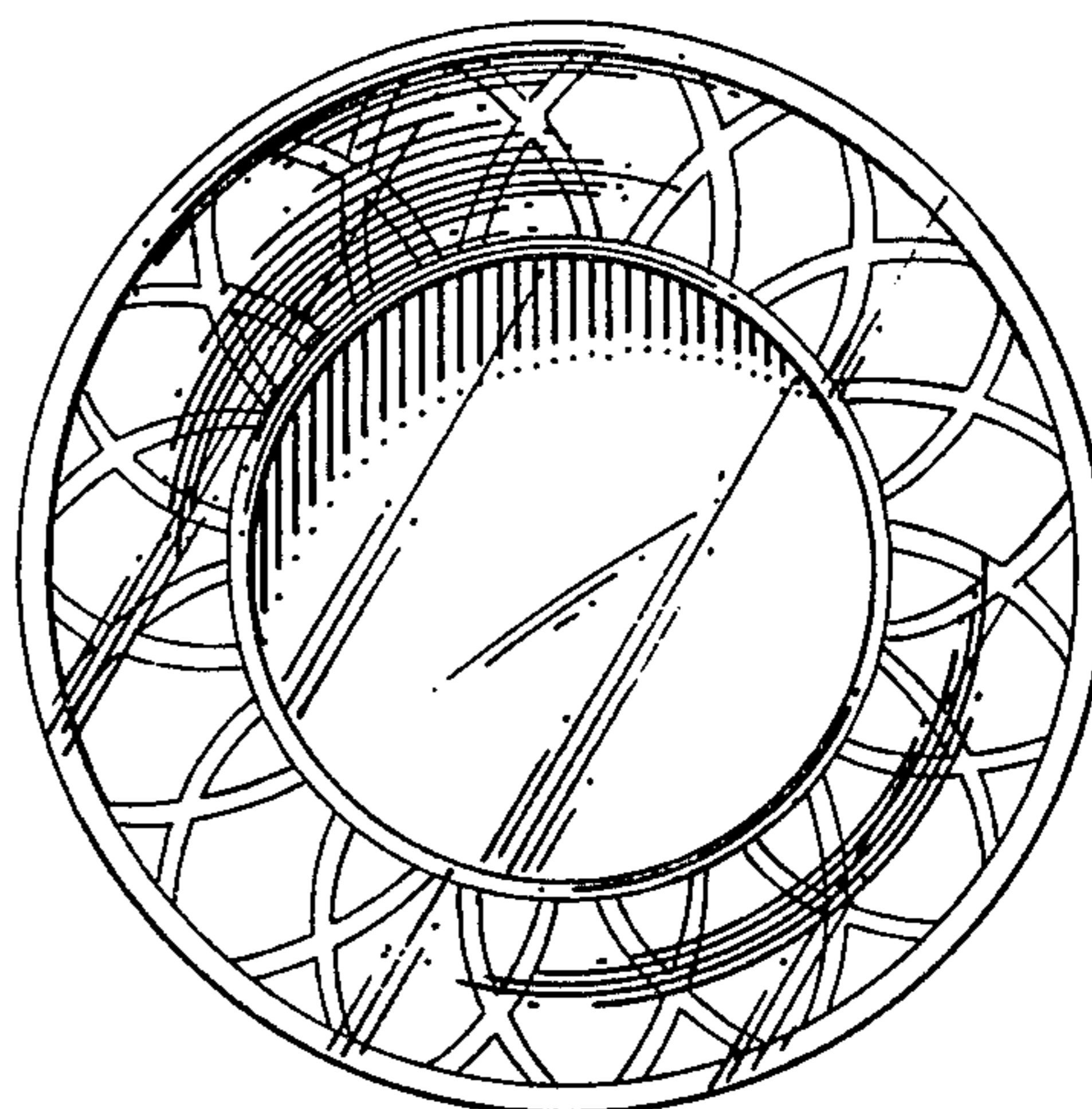

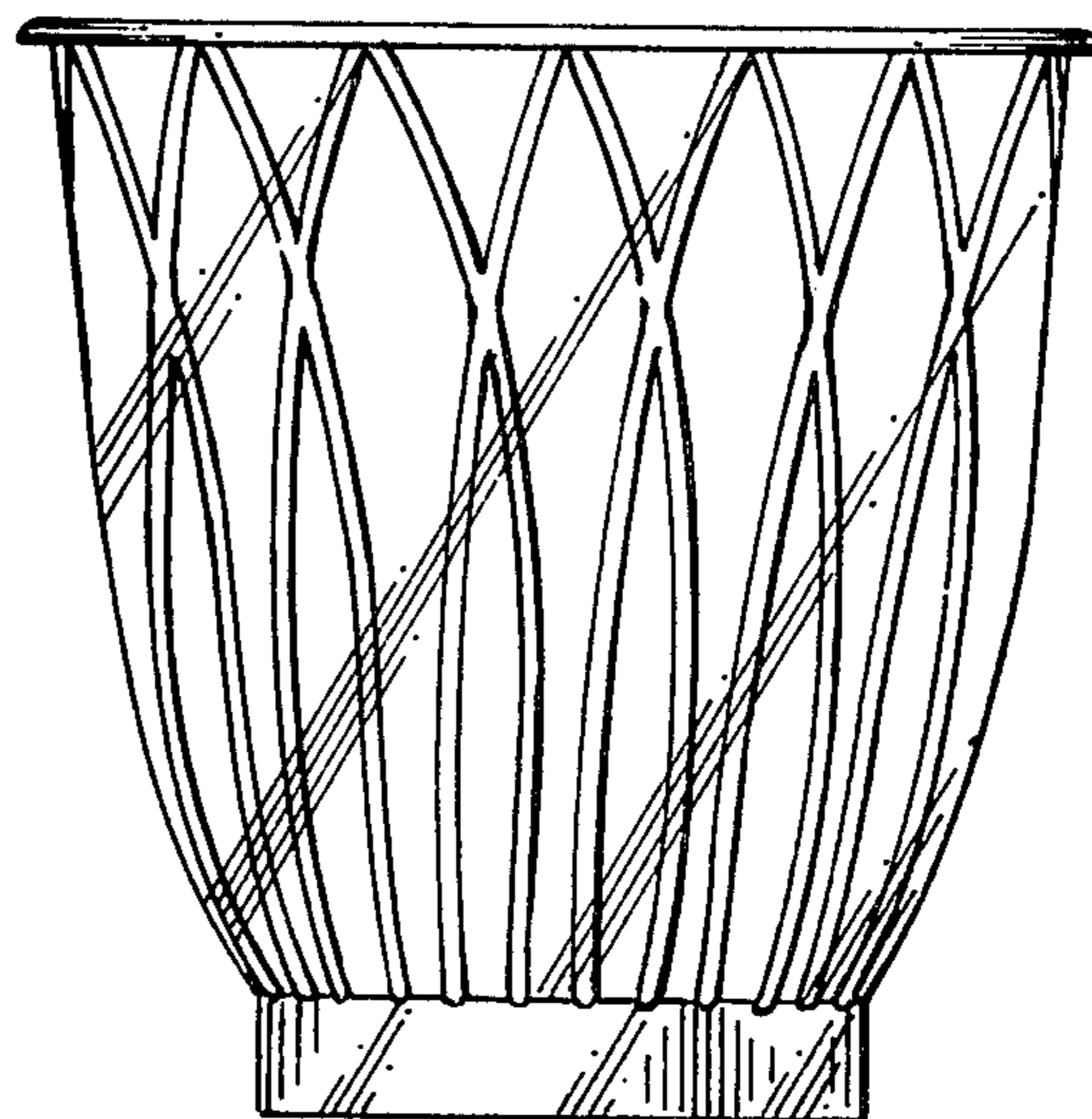

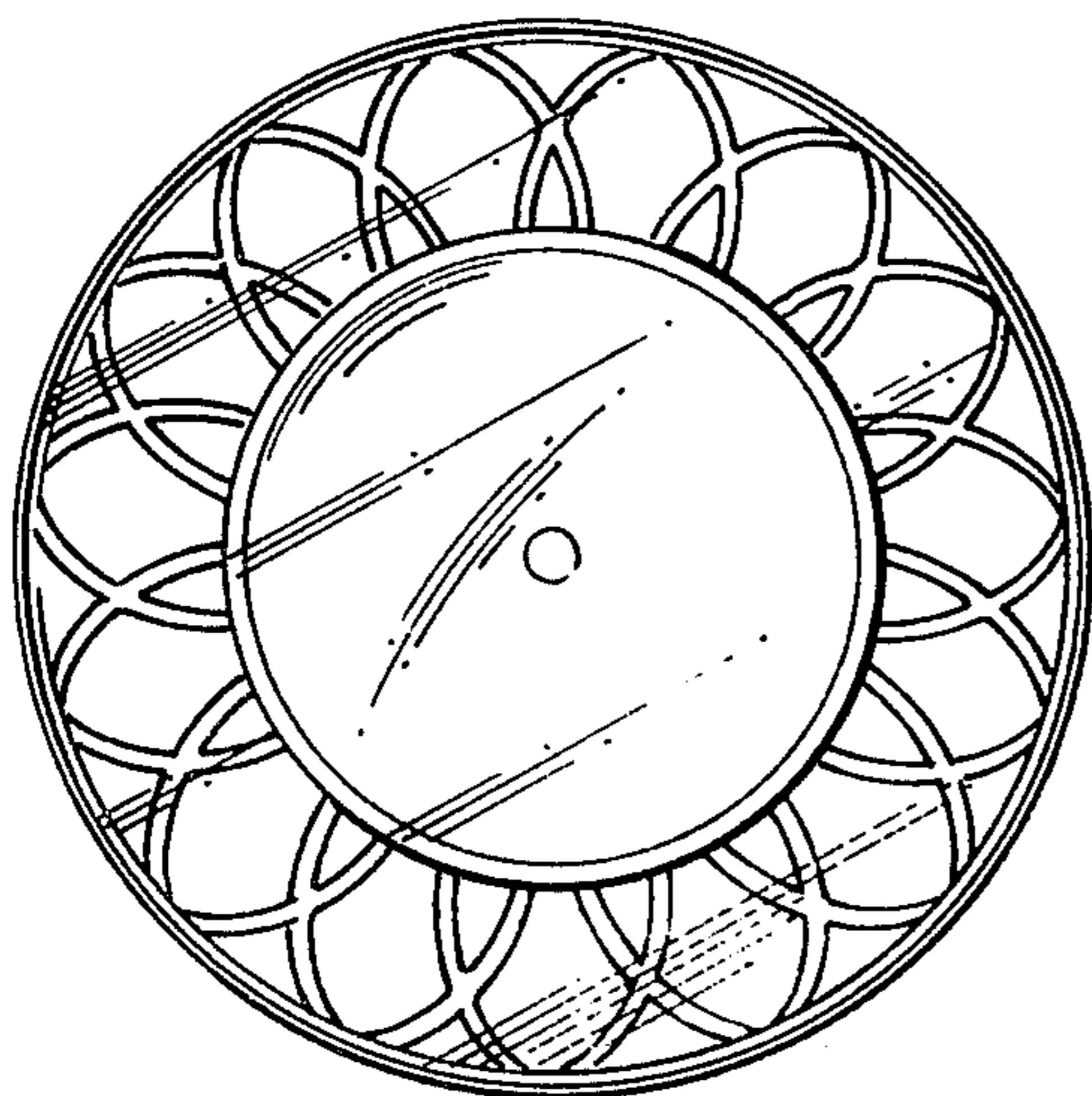

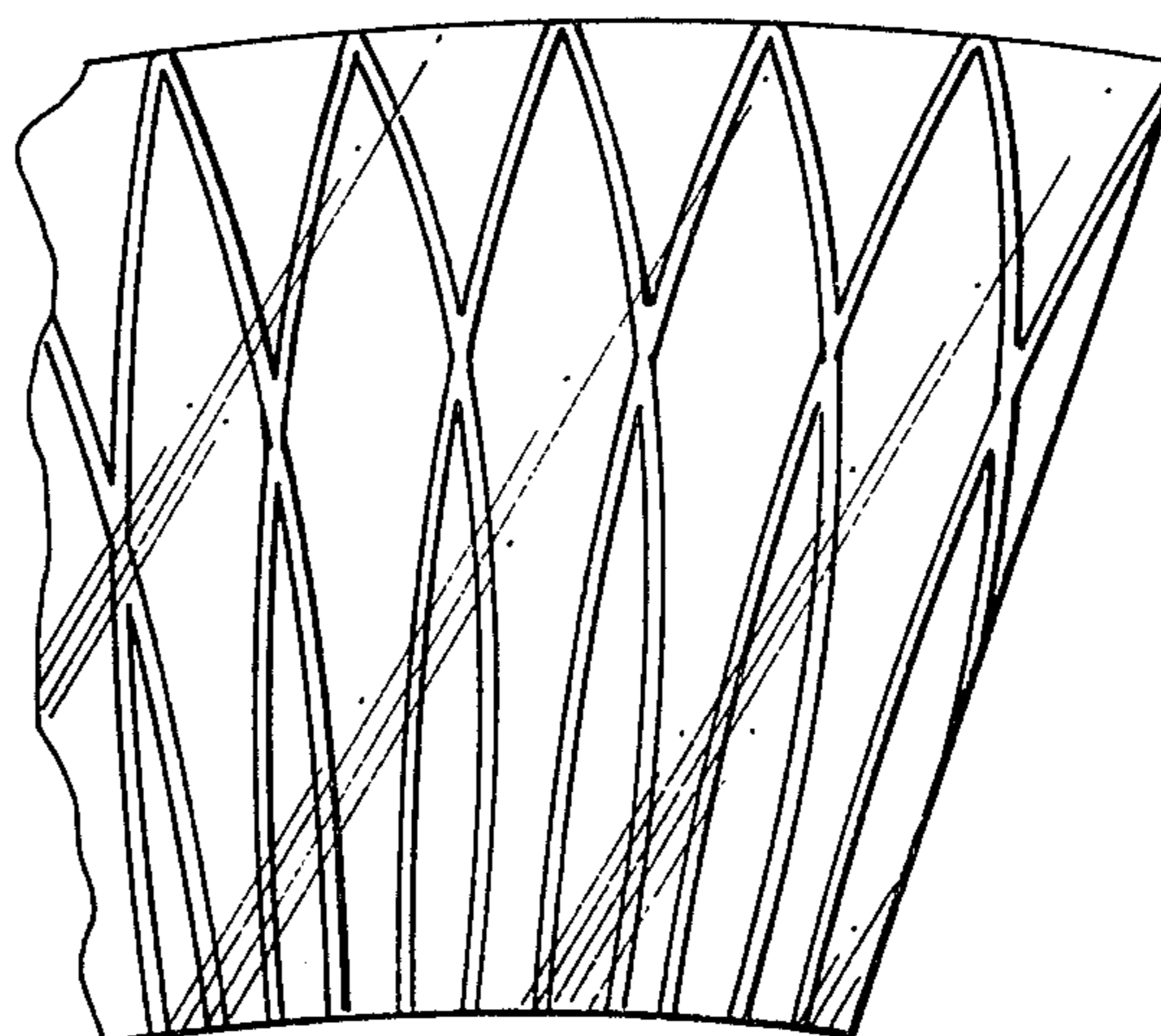
