DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a coin tray or similar article  
showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the coin tray, as  
viewed from the bottom of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the coin tray, as  
viewed from the left of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the coin tray, as  
viewed from the top of FIG. 1;

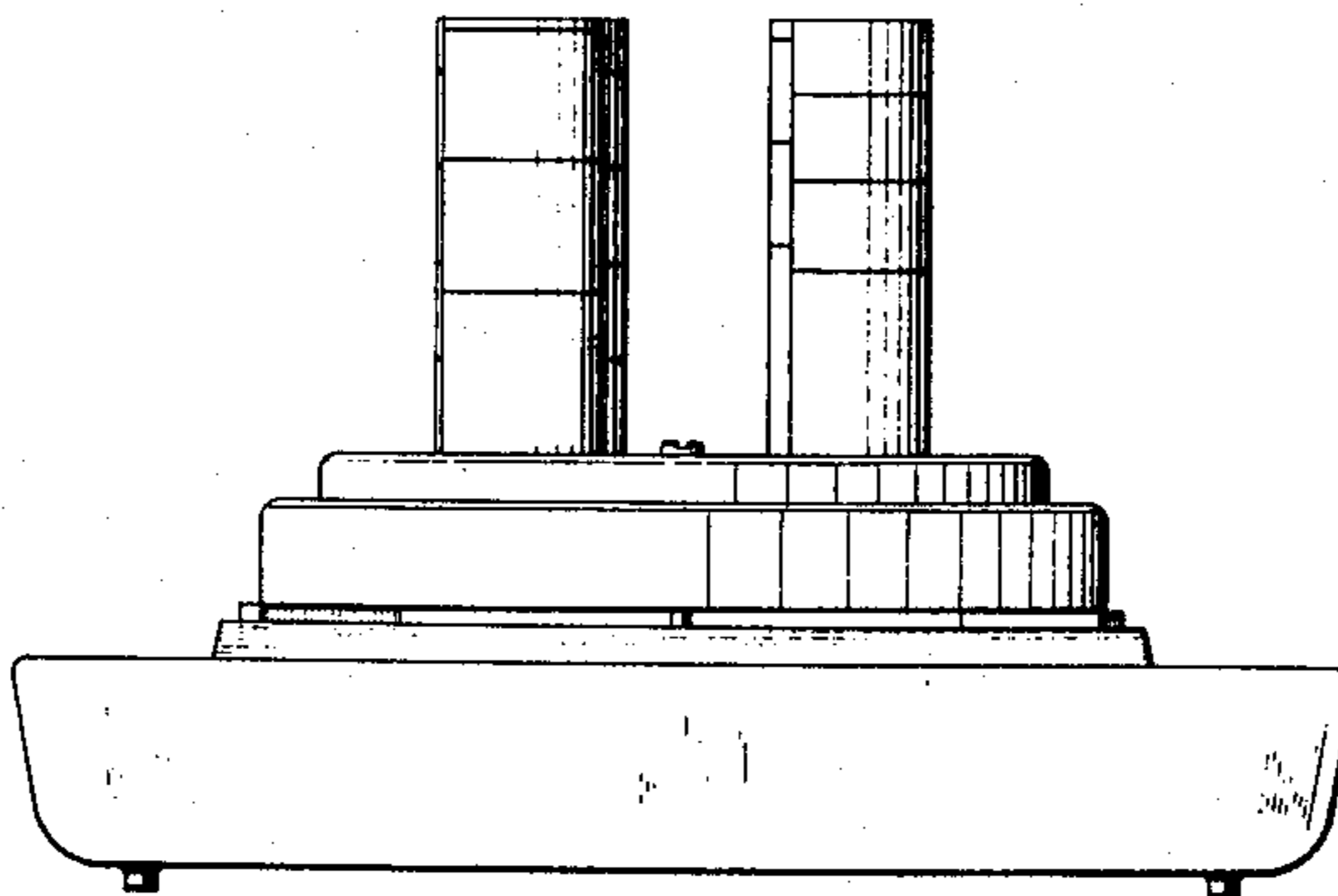
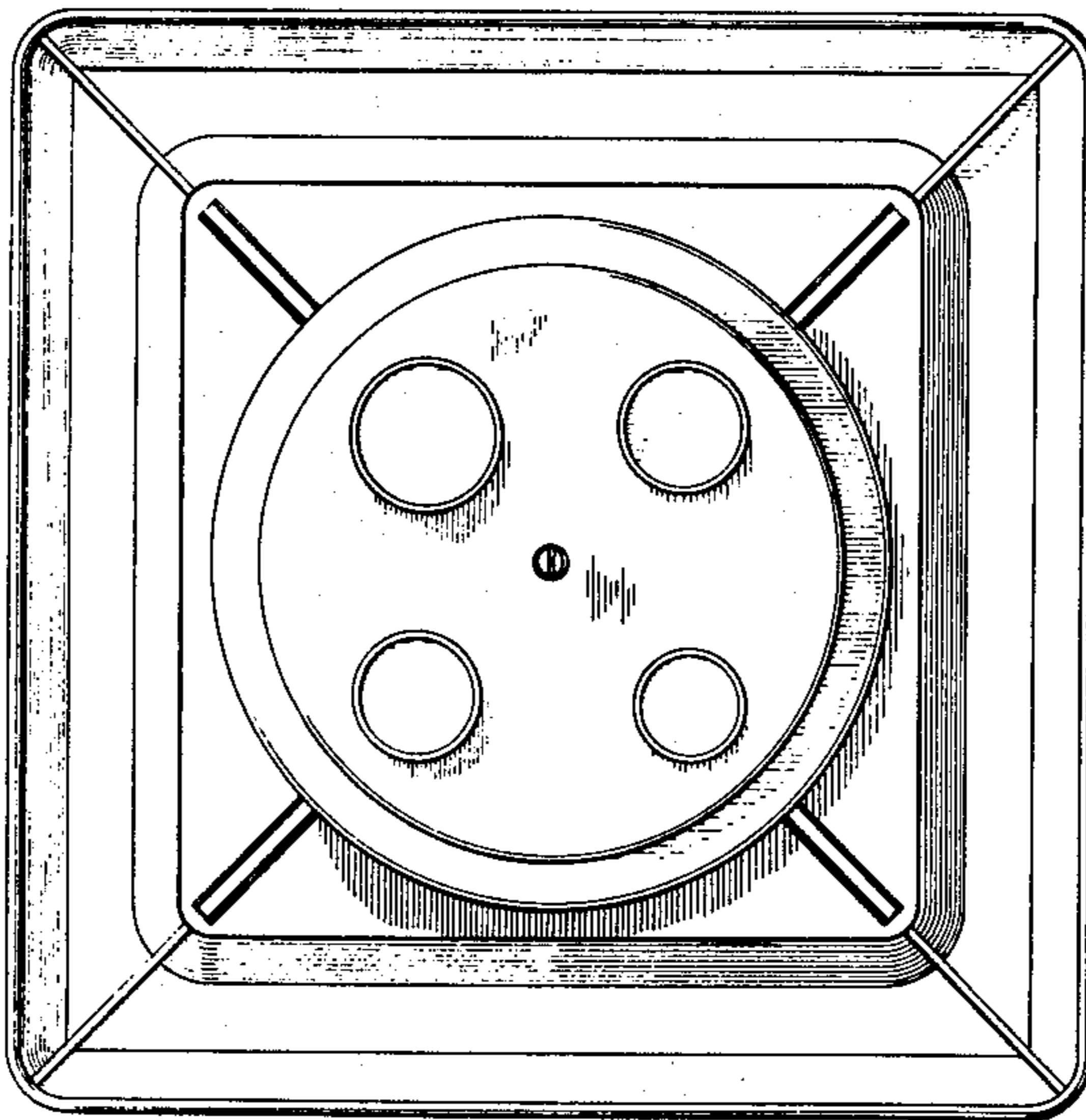
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the coin tray, as

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the coin tray.

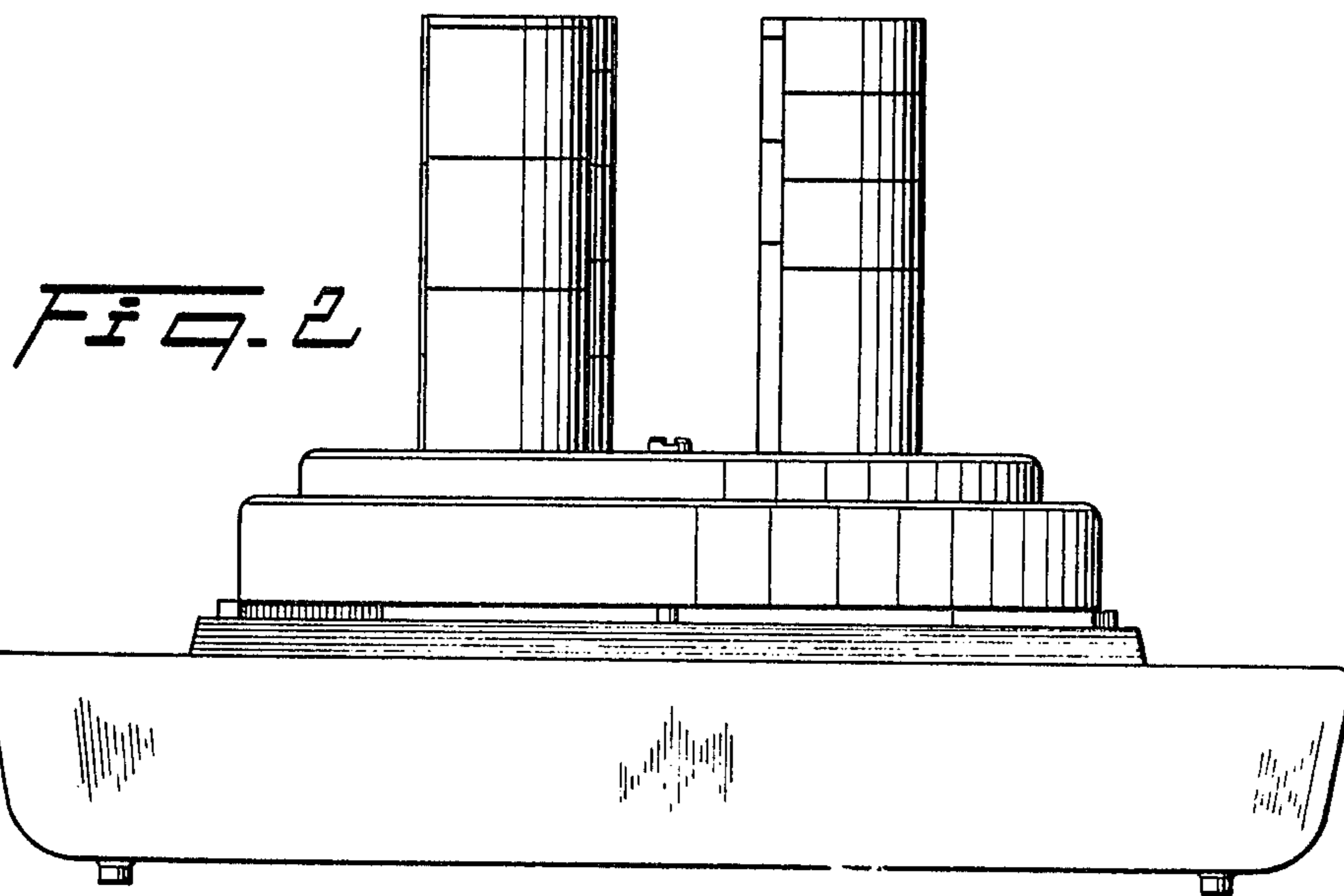
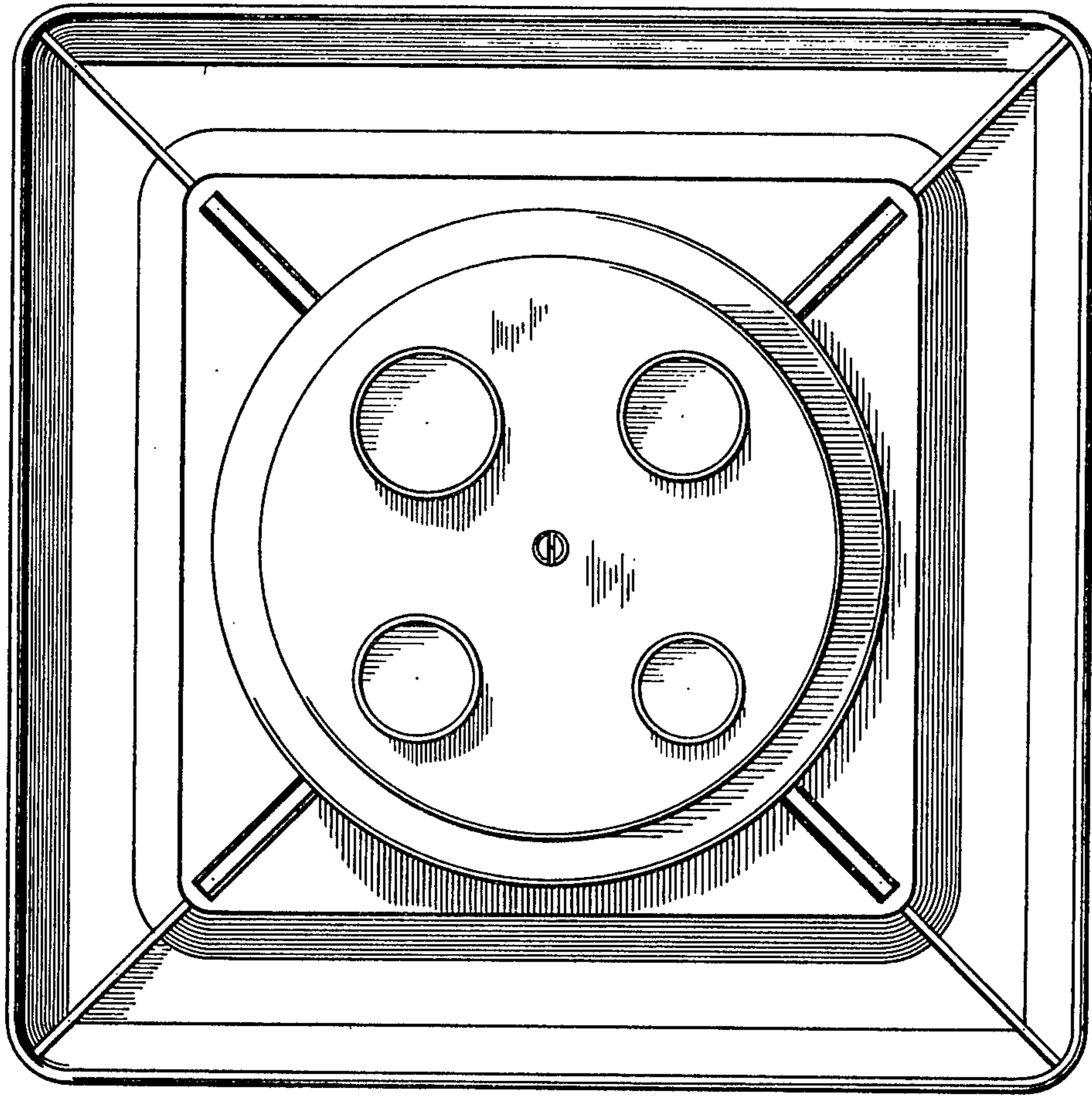

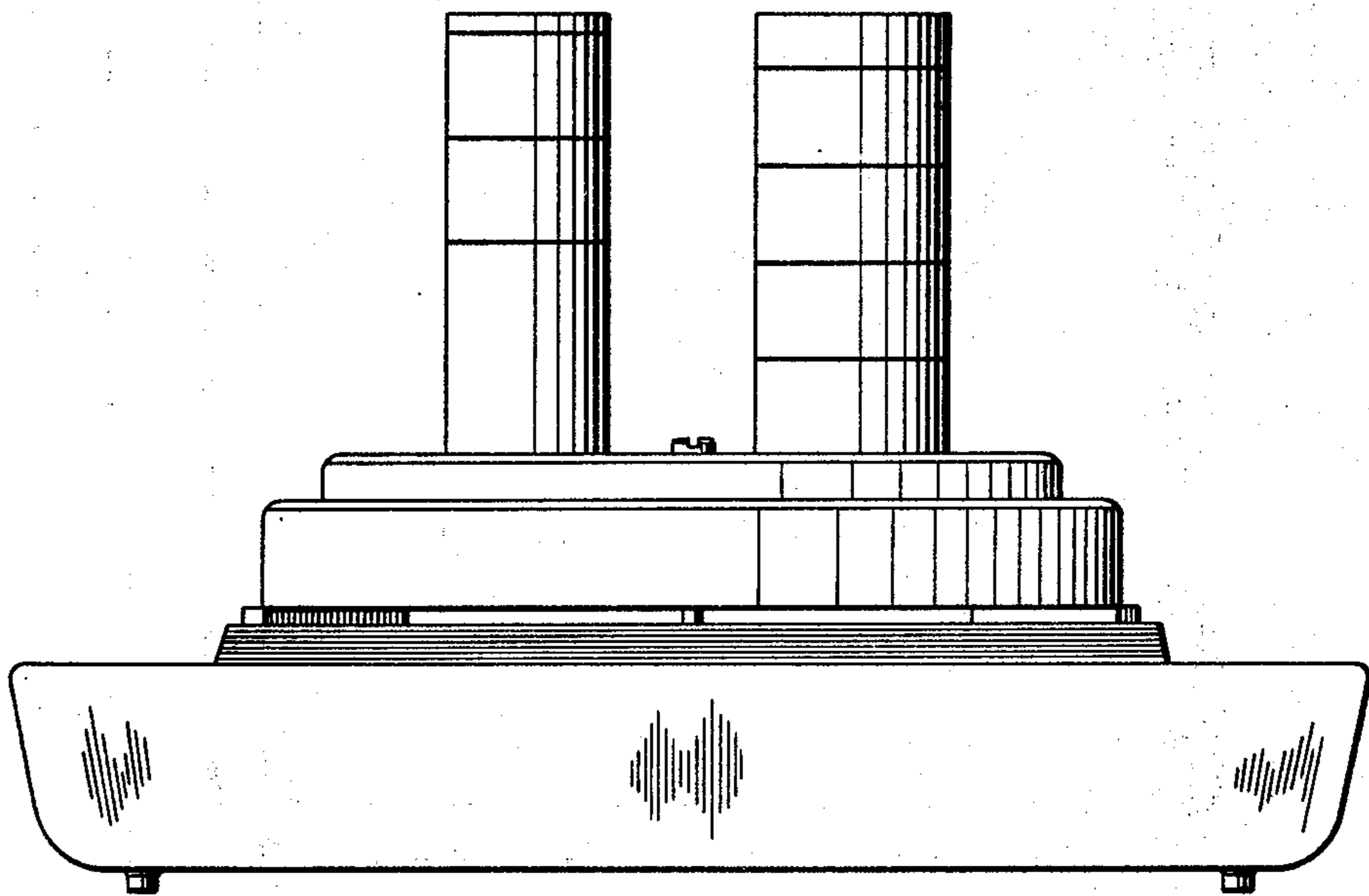
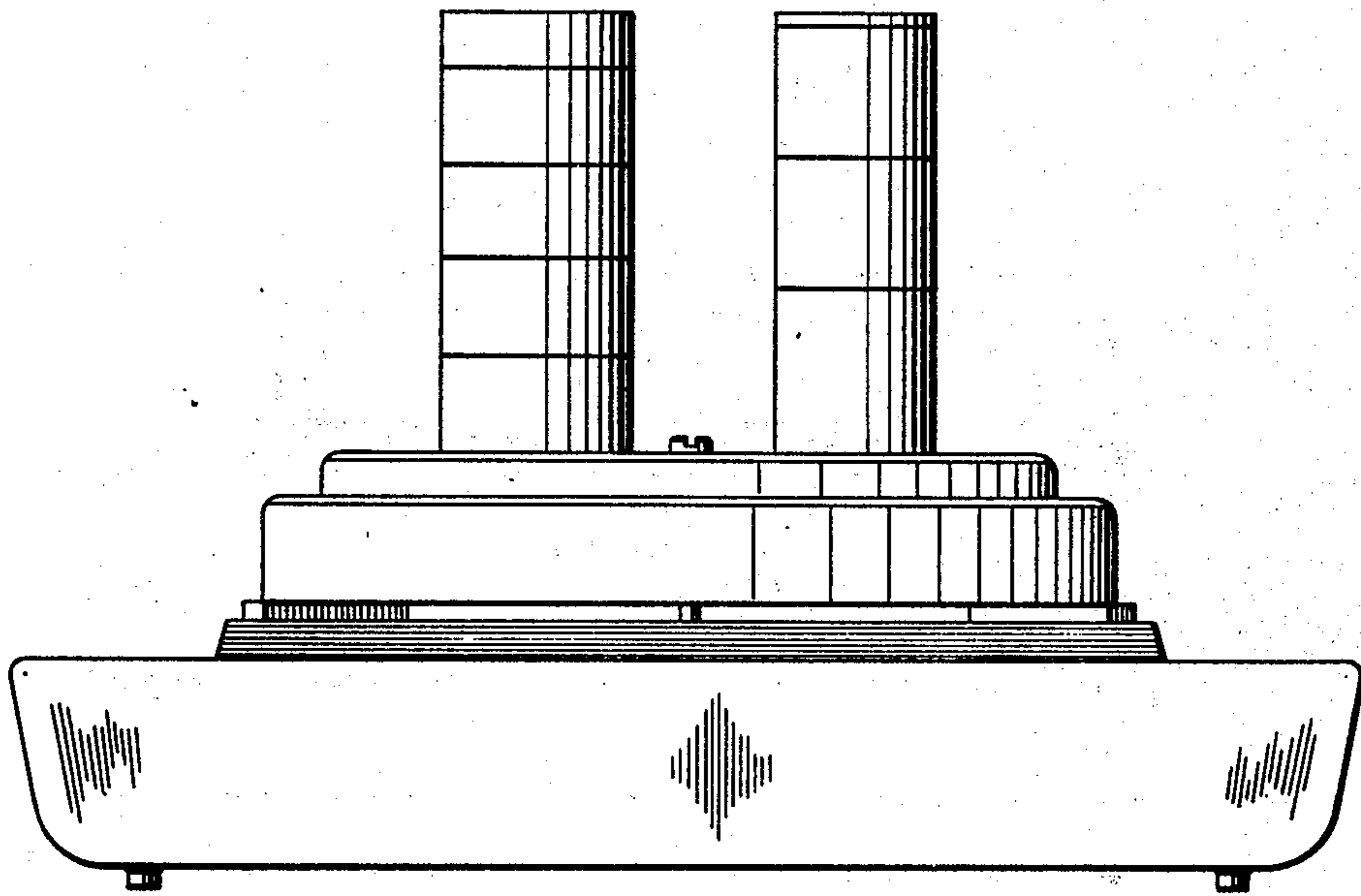

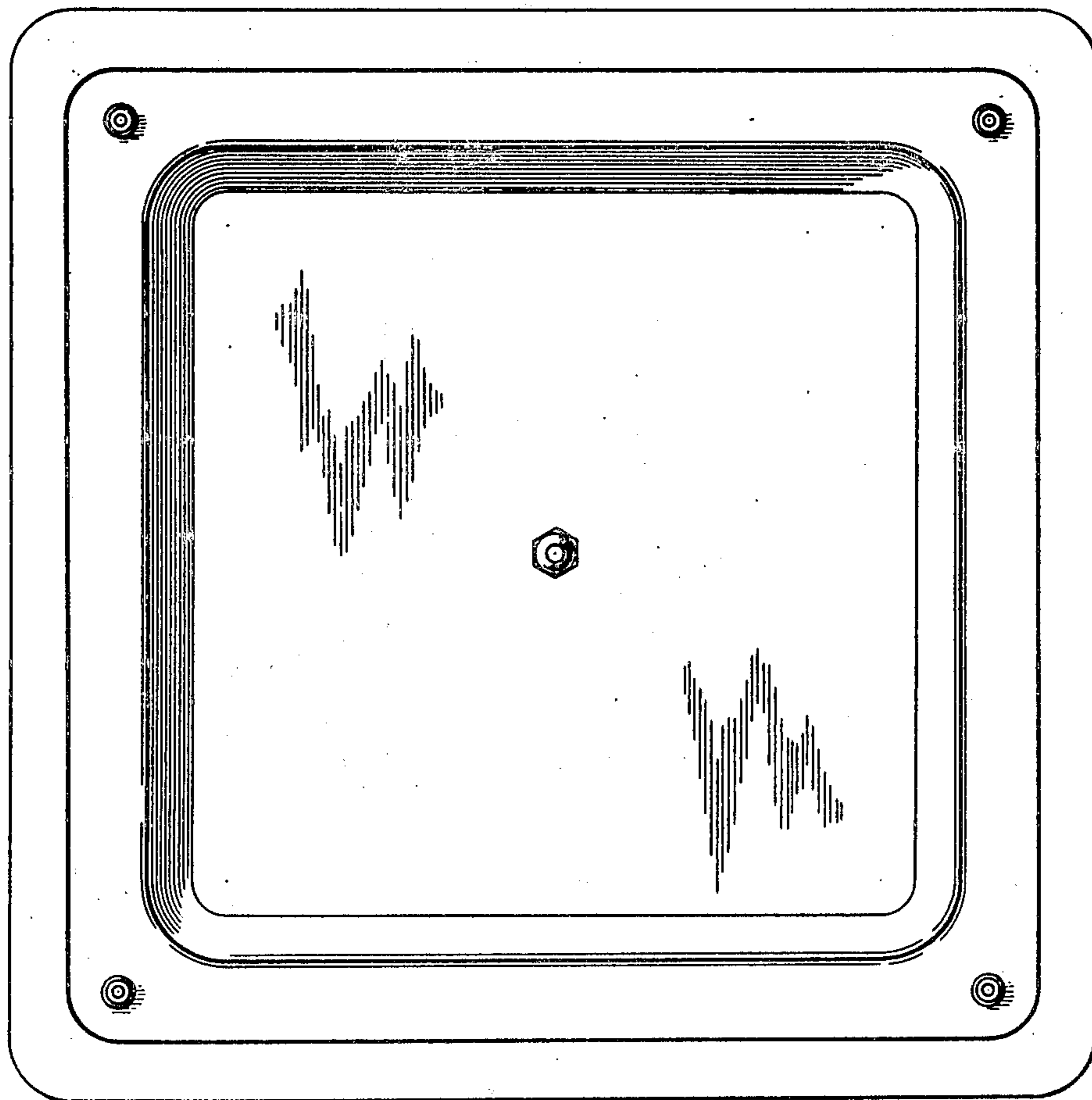
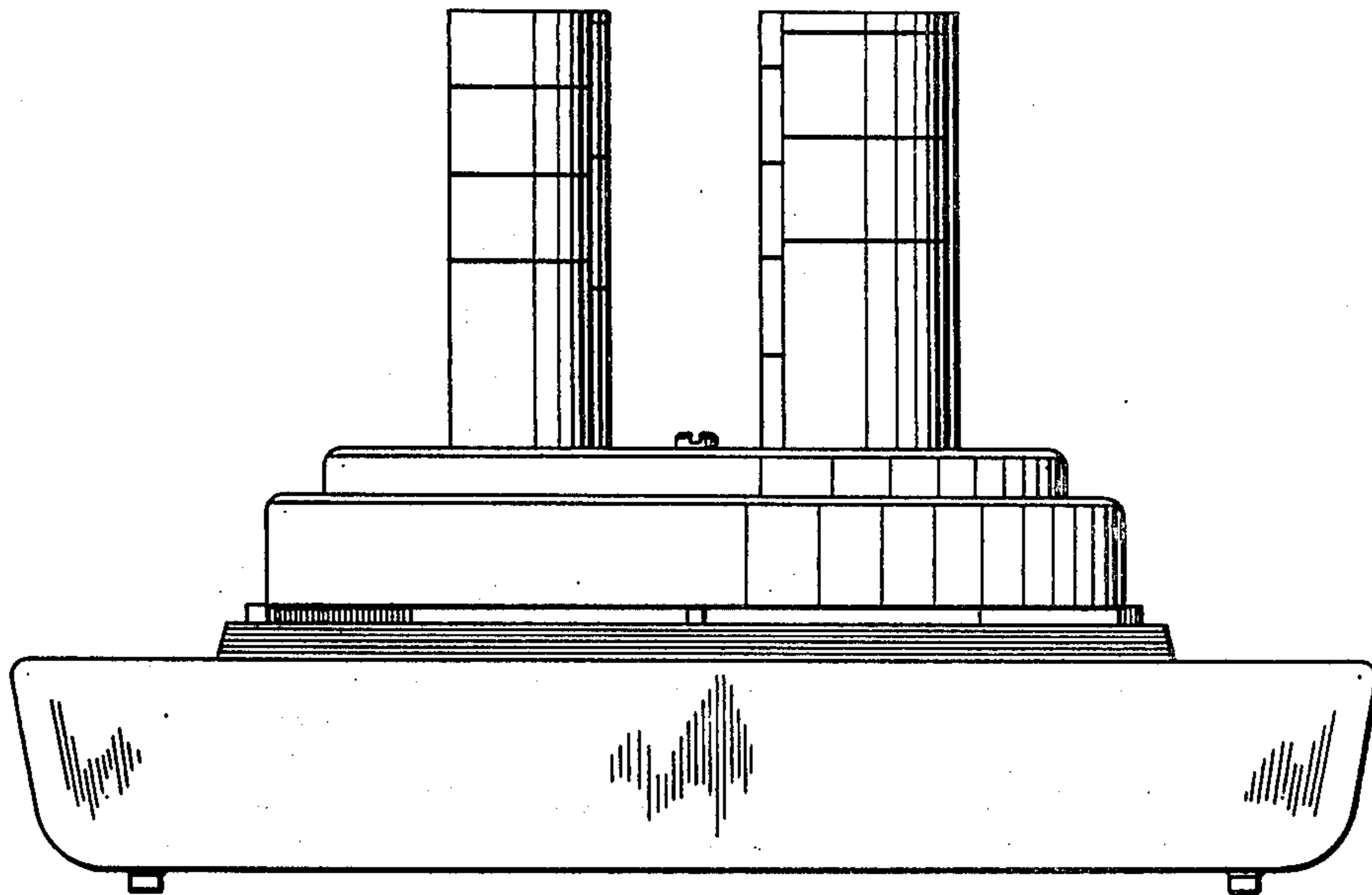
