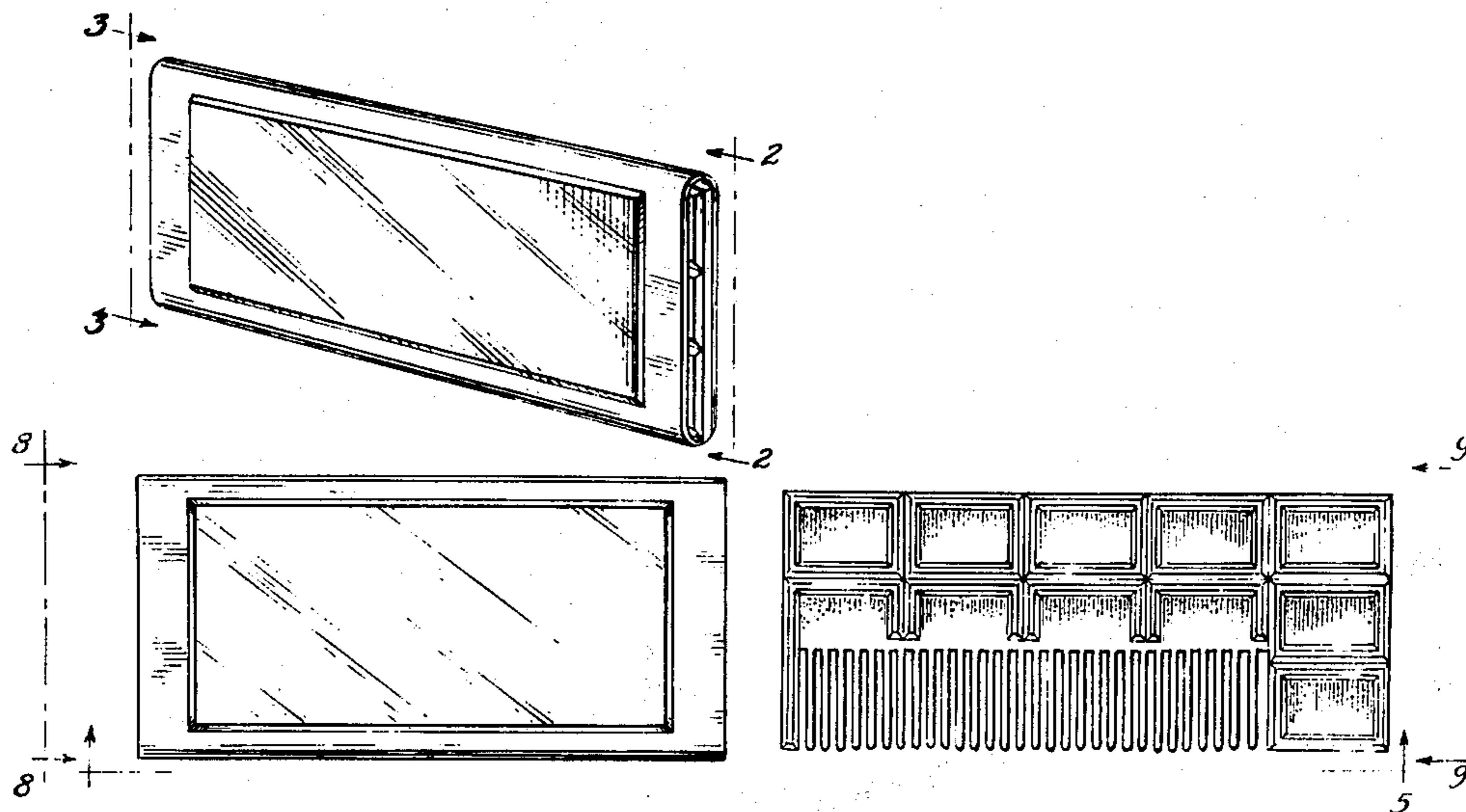

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined comb and mirrored case therefor, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined comb and mirrored case therefor showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an end view thereof as viewed from line 2—2 of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is another end view thereof as viewed from line 3—3 of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof with the comb removed from the case;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof with the comb removed from the case as viewed along line 5—5 of FIG. 4;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof with the comb removed from the case;
 FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof with the comb removed from the case as viewed along line 7—7 of FIG. 6;
 FIG. 8 is a left end view of the case thereof as viewed from line 8—8 of FIG. 4; and
 FIG. 9 is a right end view of the comb thereof as viewed from line 9—9 of FIG. 4.



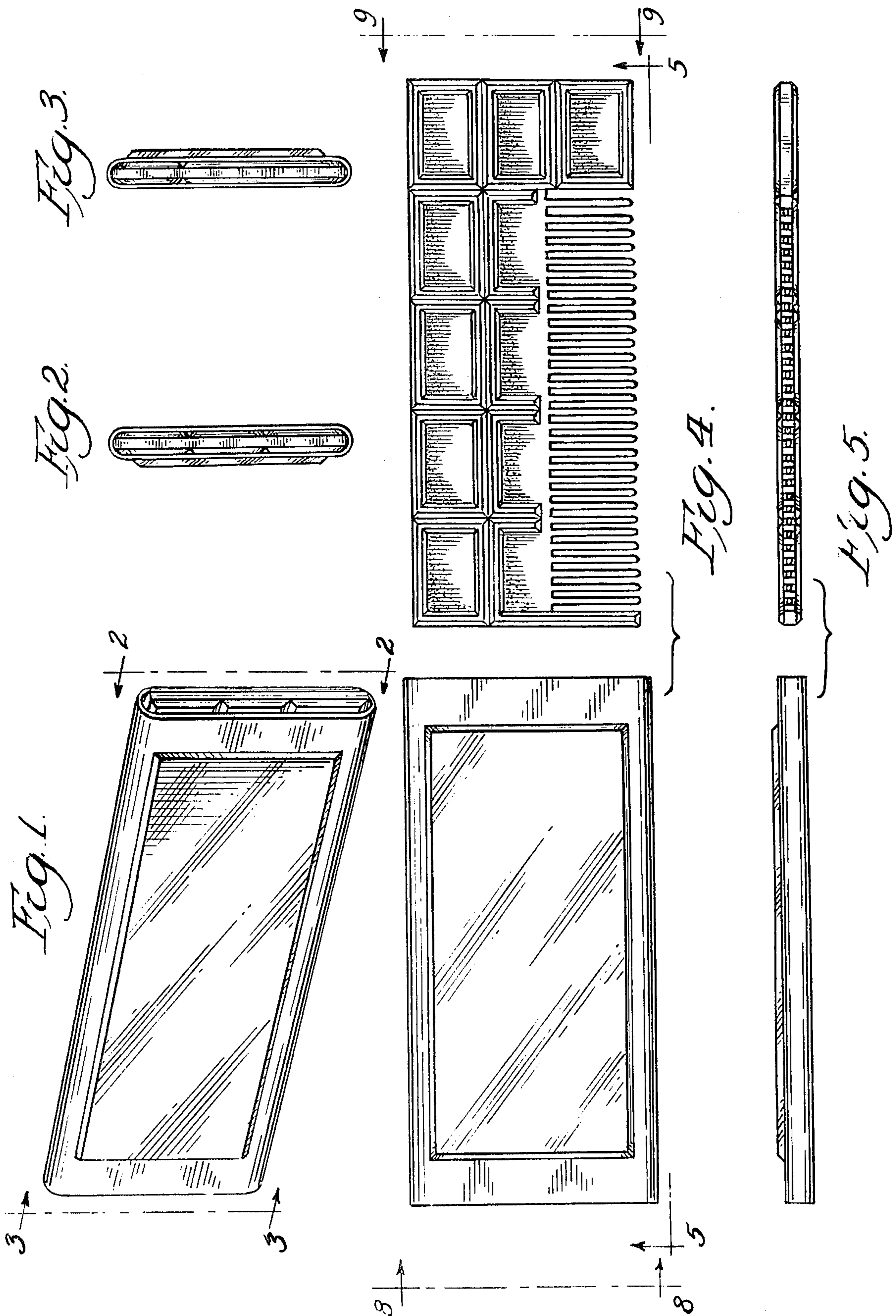

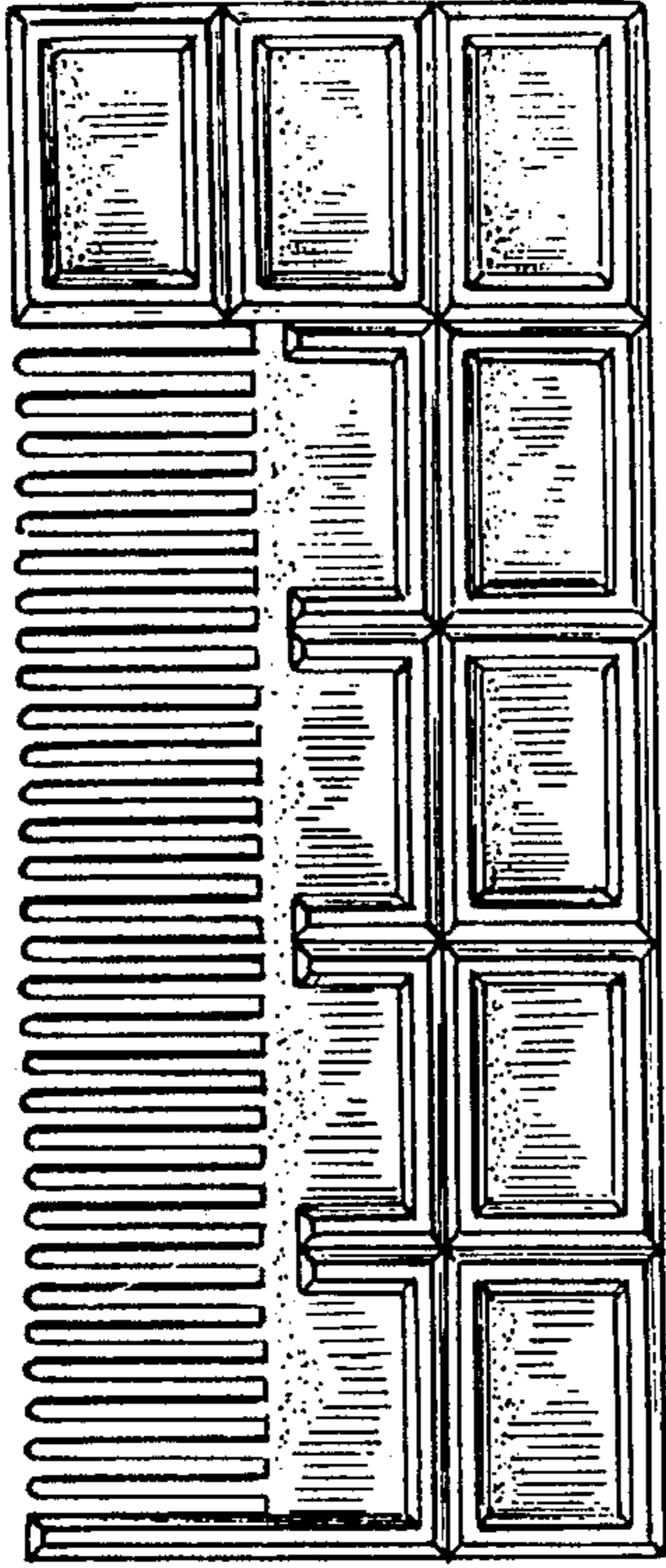
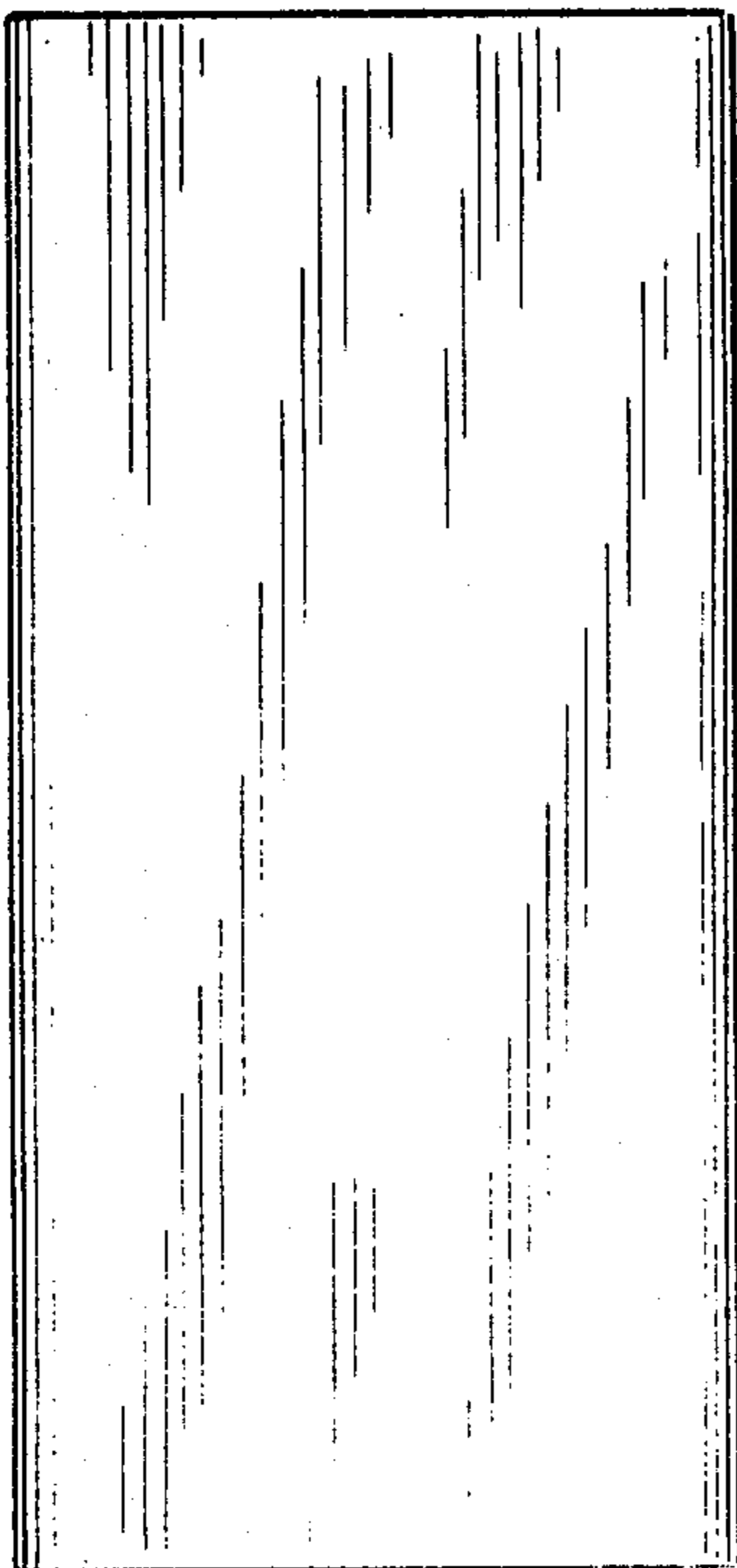

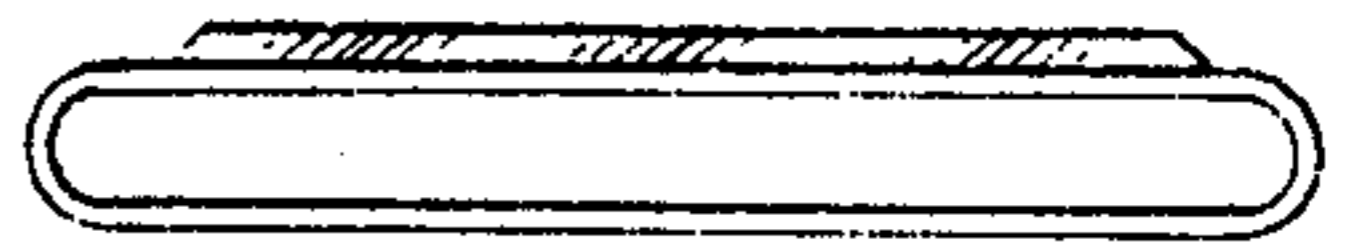
