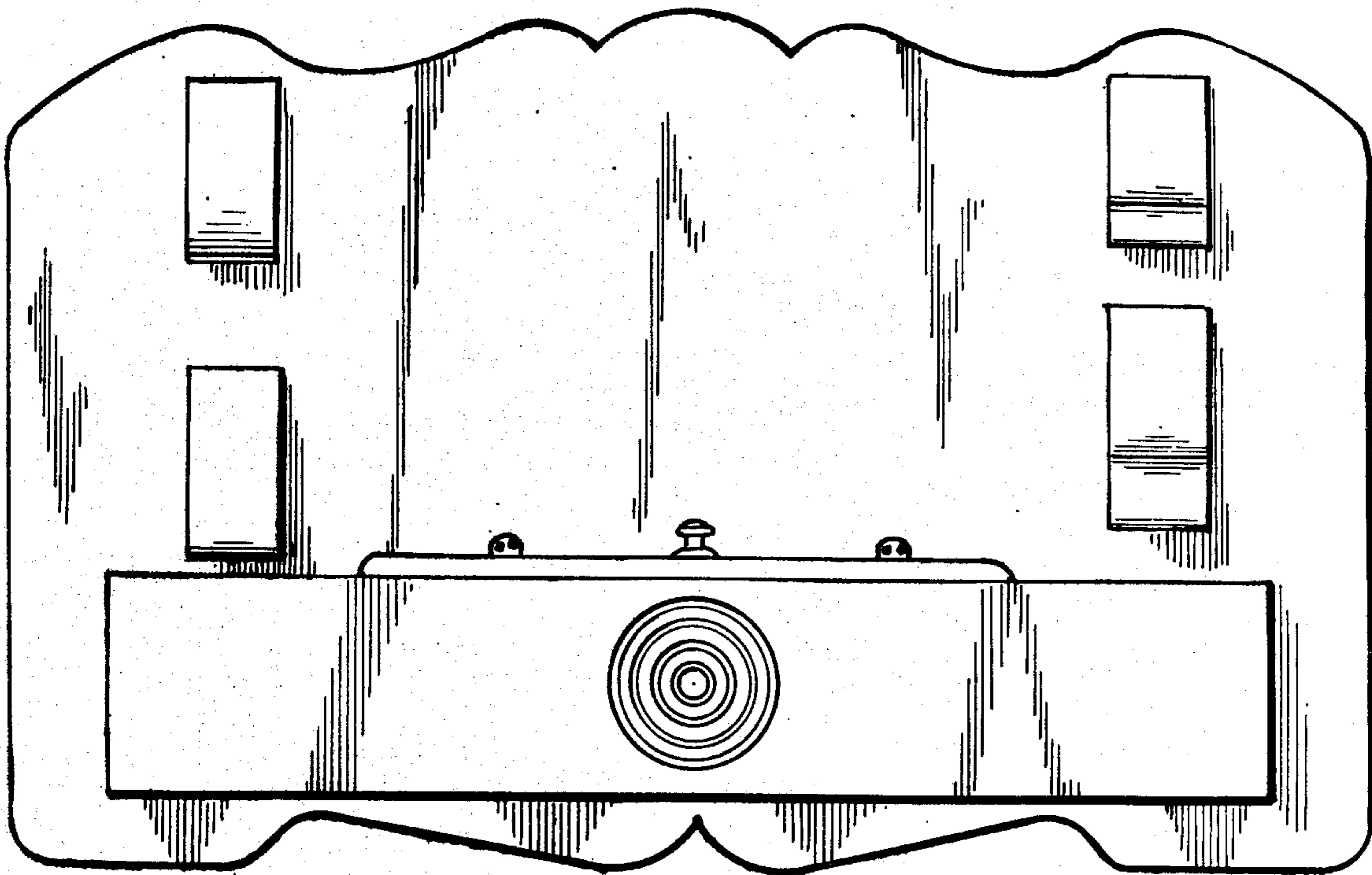

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a gun rack showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1.
The claimed design can embody multiple paired hooks in excess of those explicitly disclosed in the drawings.



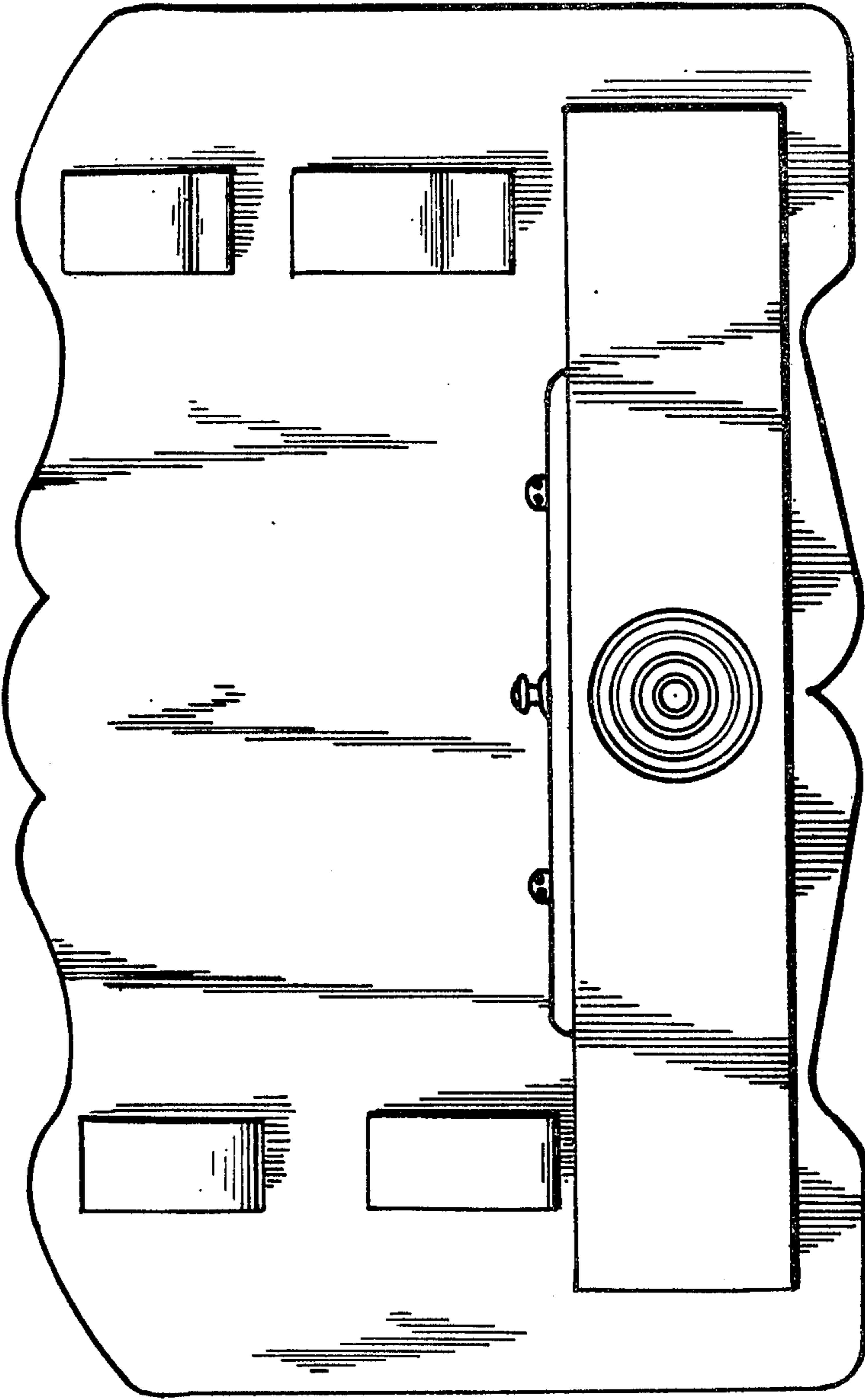

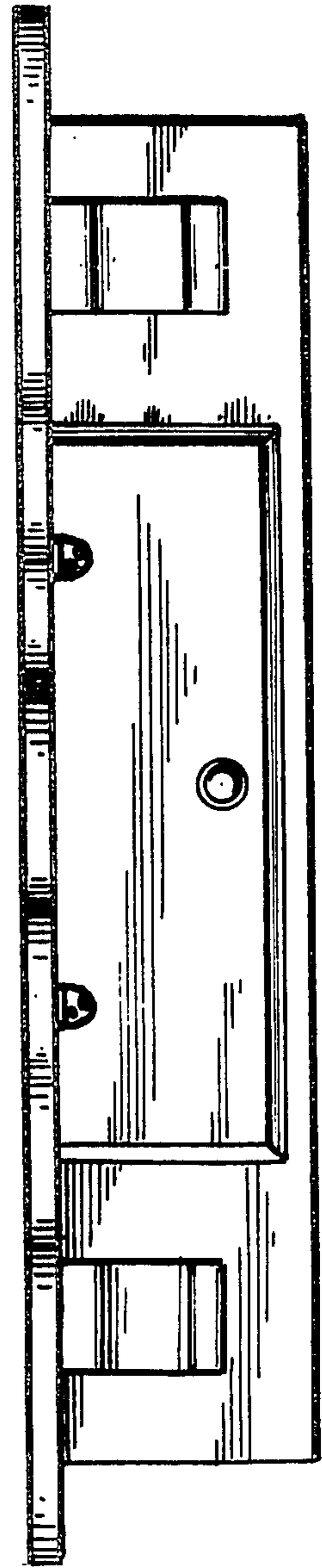

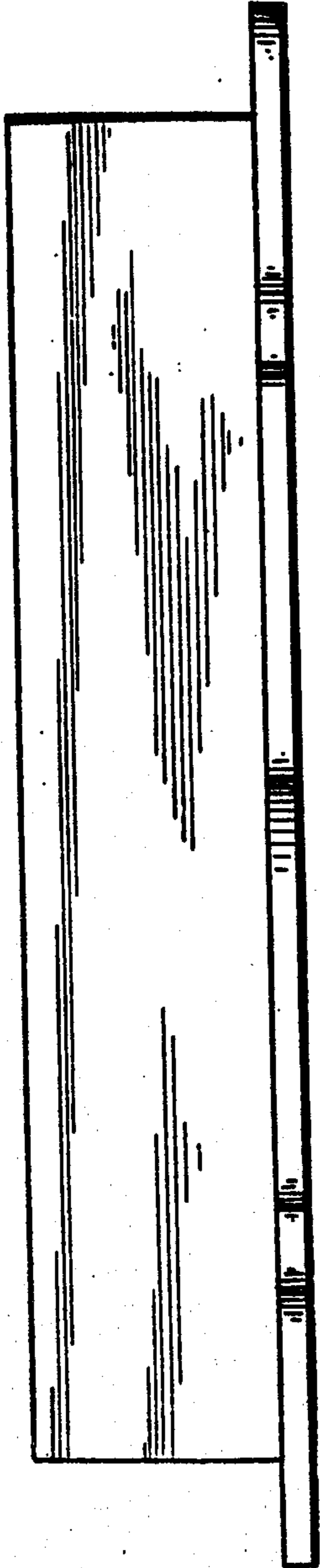

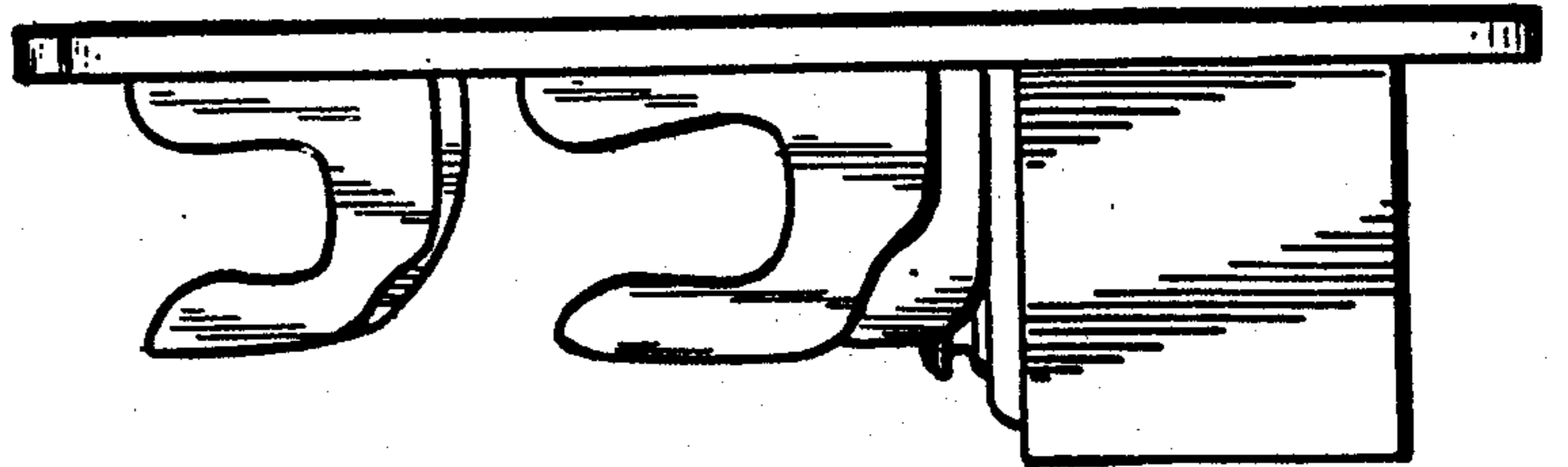

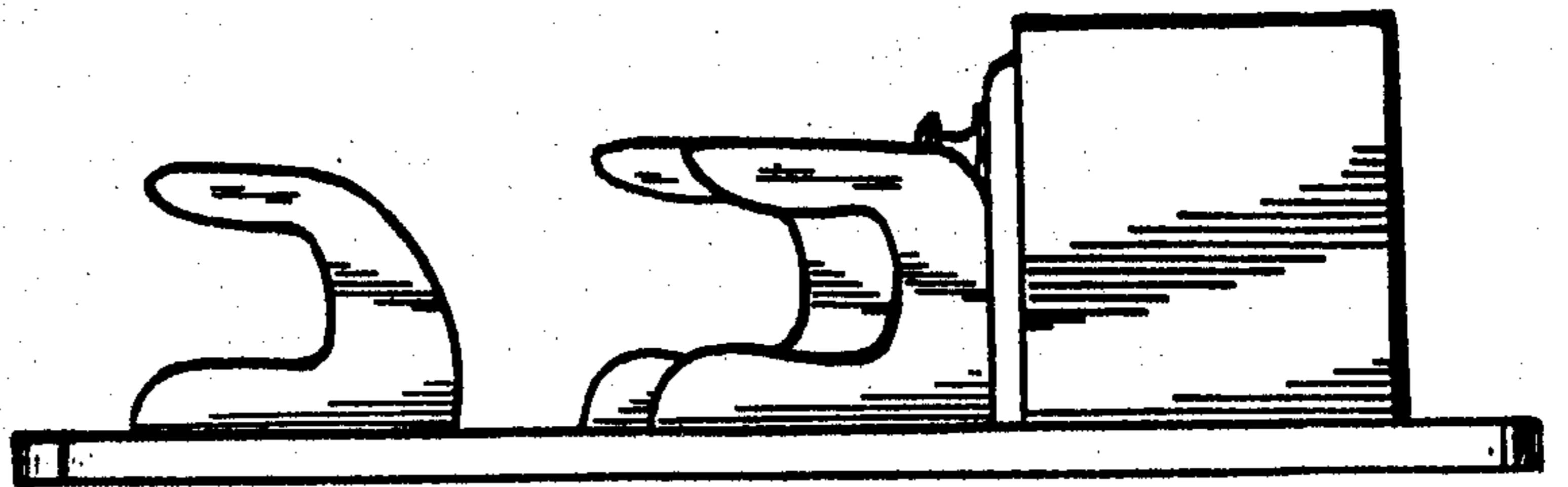
