FIG. 1 is a front view showing my new design for a translucent fishing lure as illuminated internally to externally by a light in use.

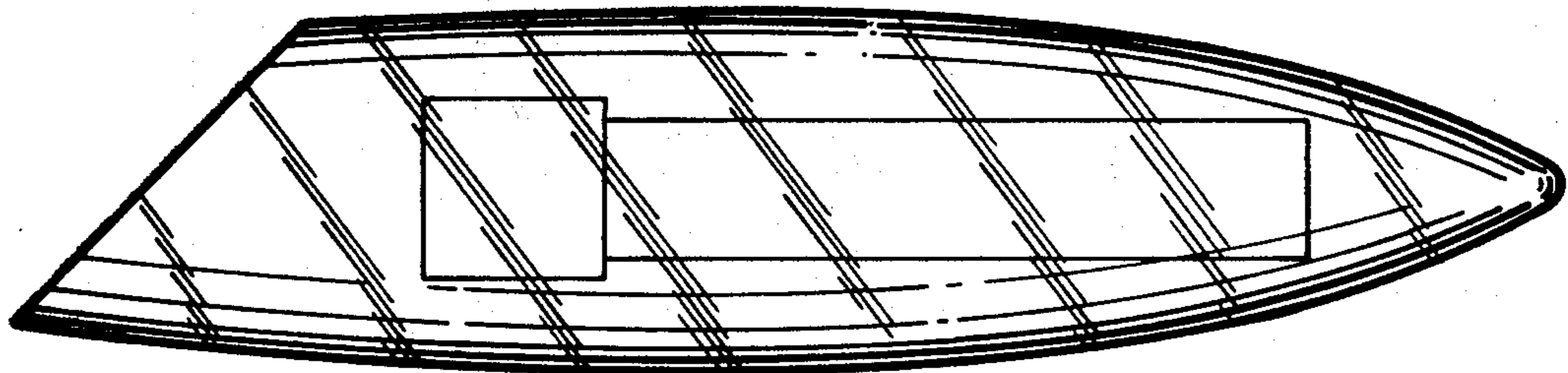
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

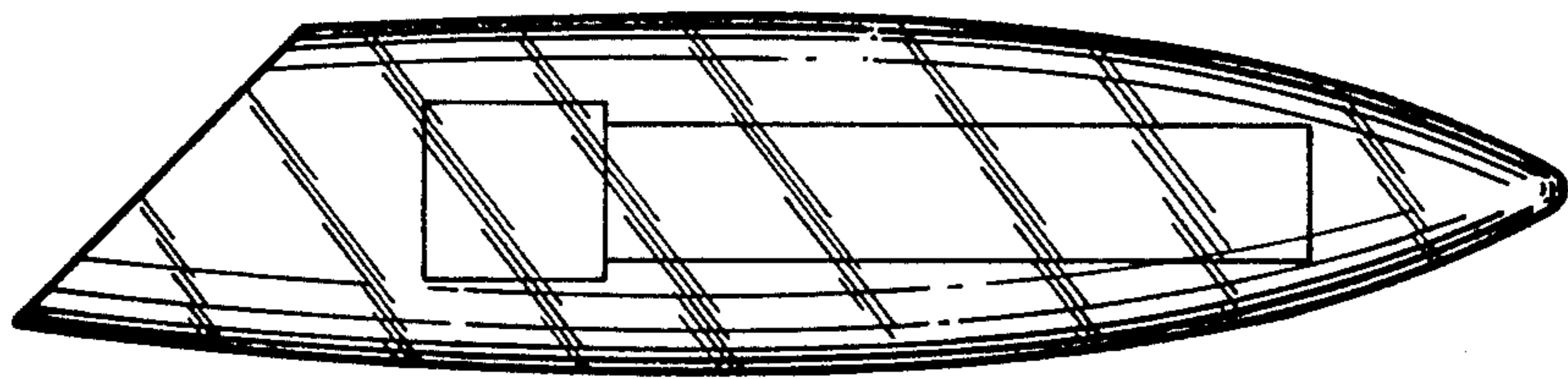
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a front left end view thereof.

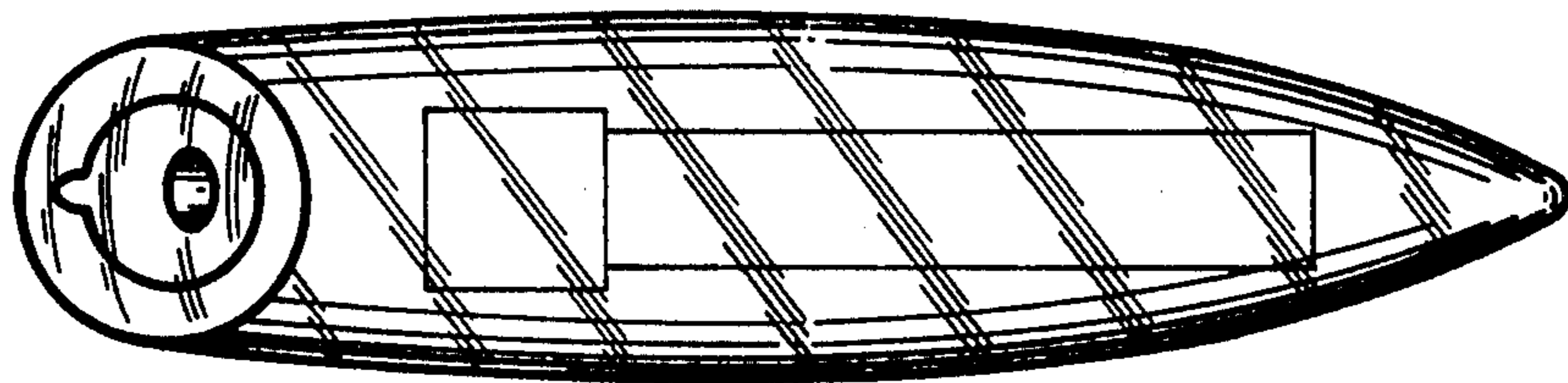
FIG. 5 is a front right end view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view of the fishing lure as shown in FIG. 1.

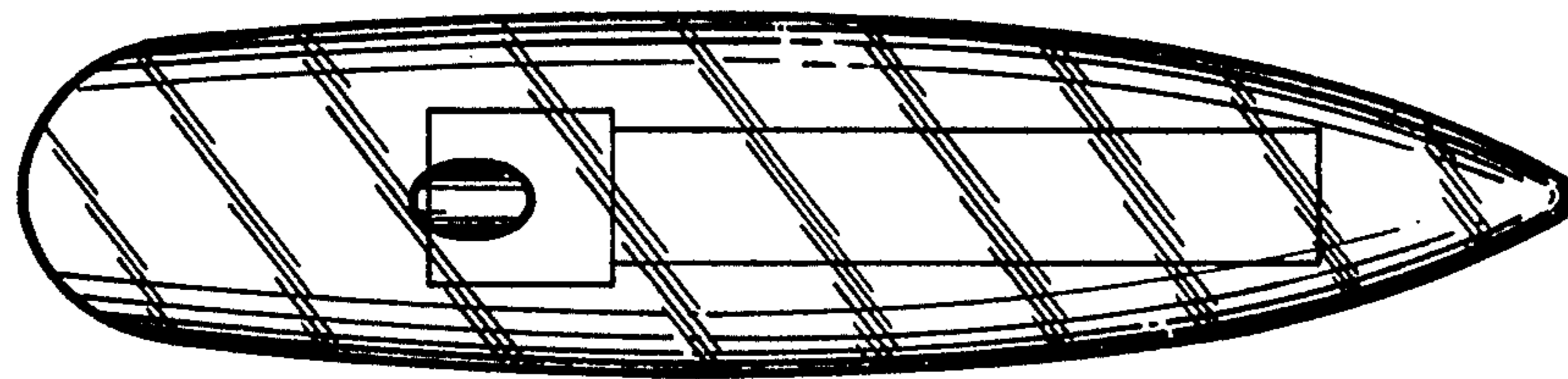




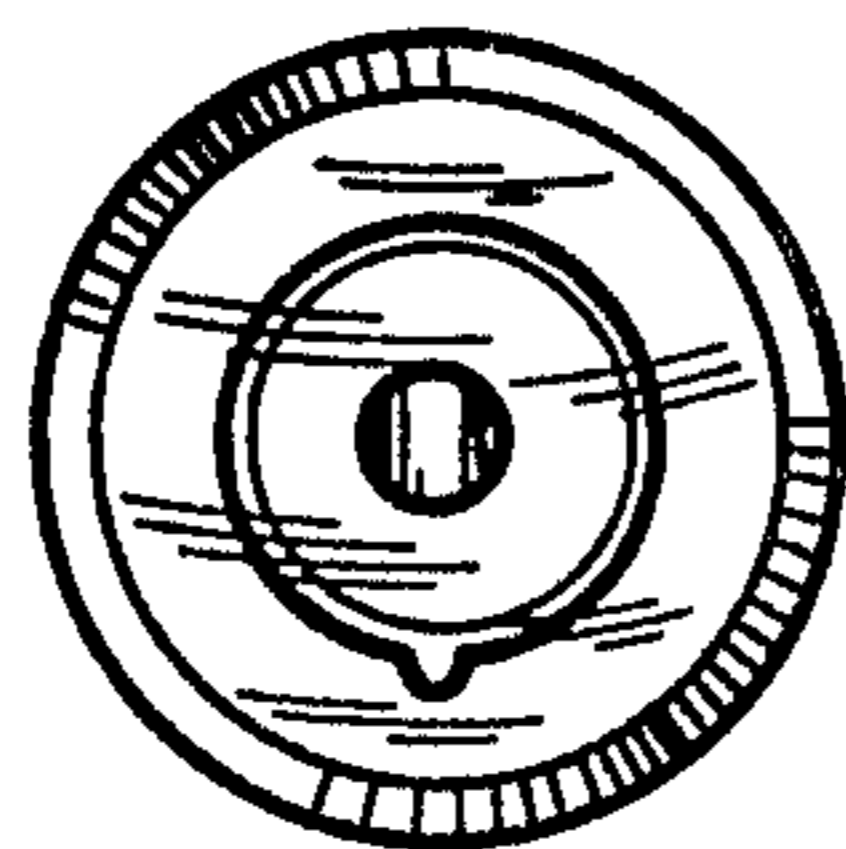

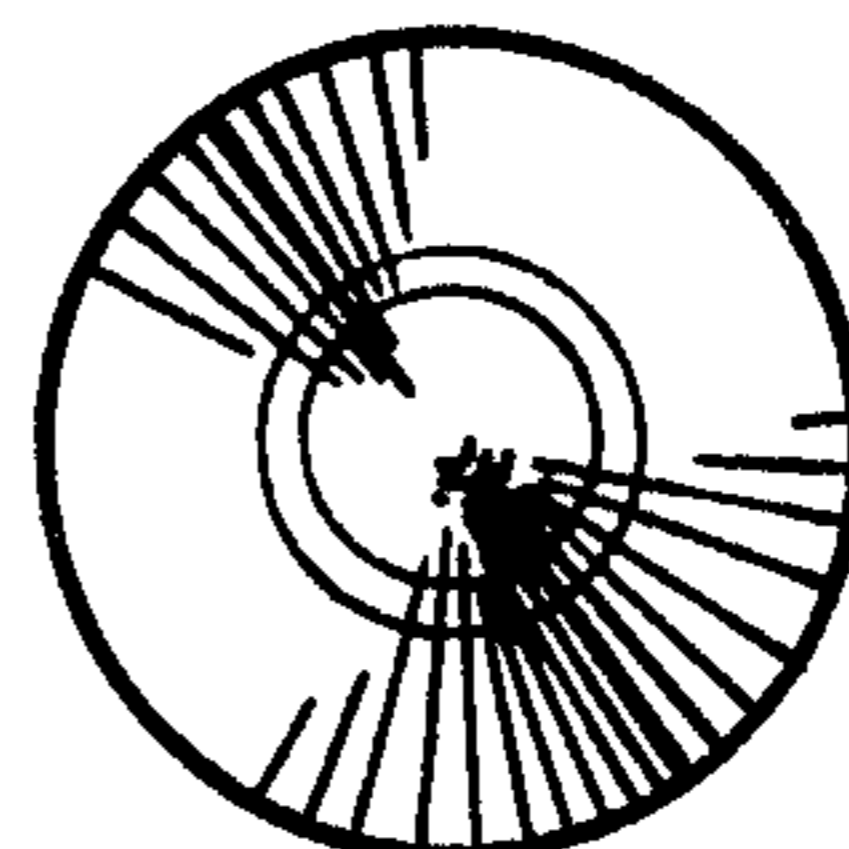

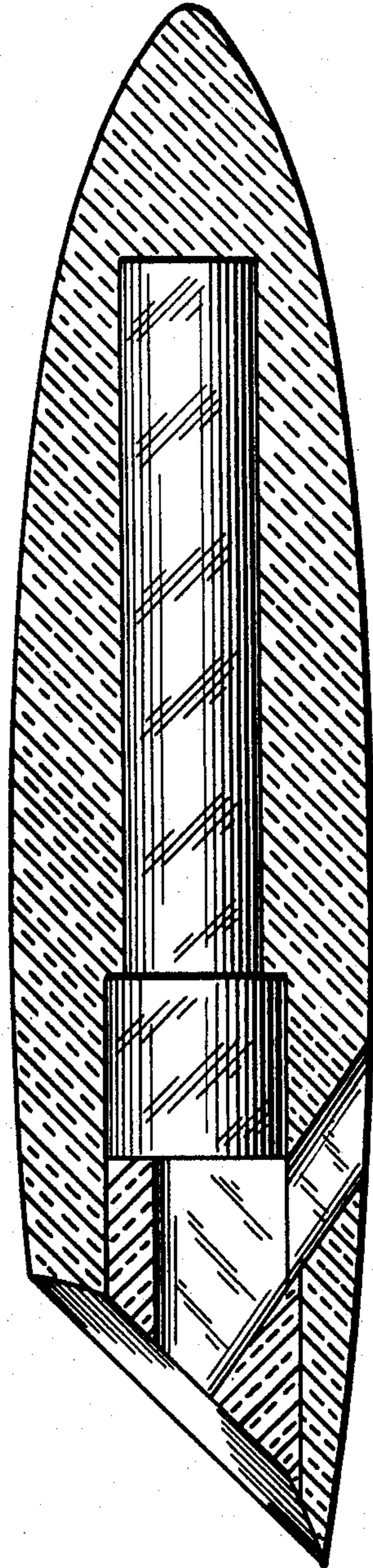
