FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view thereof;

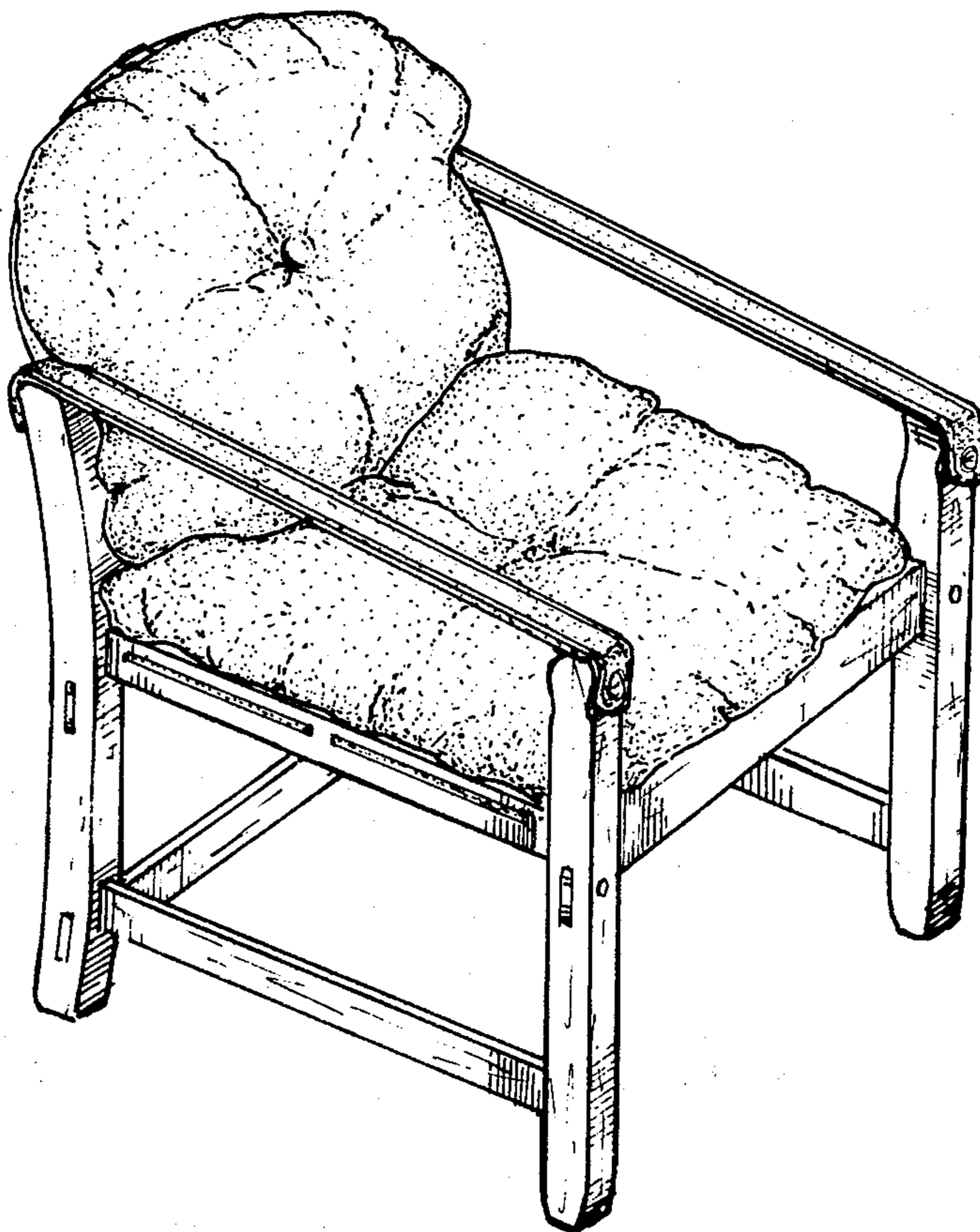
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



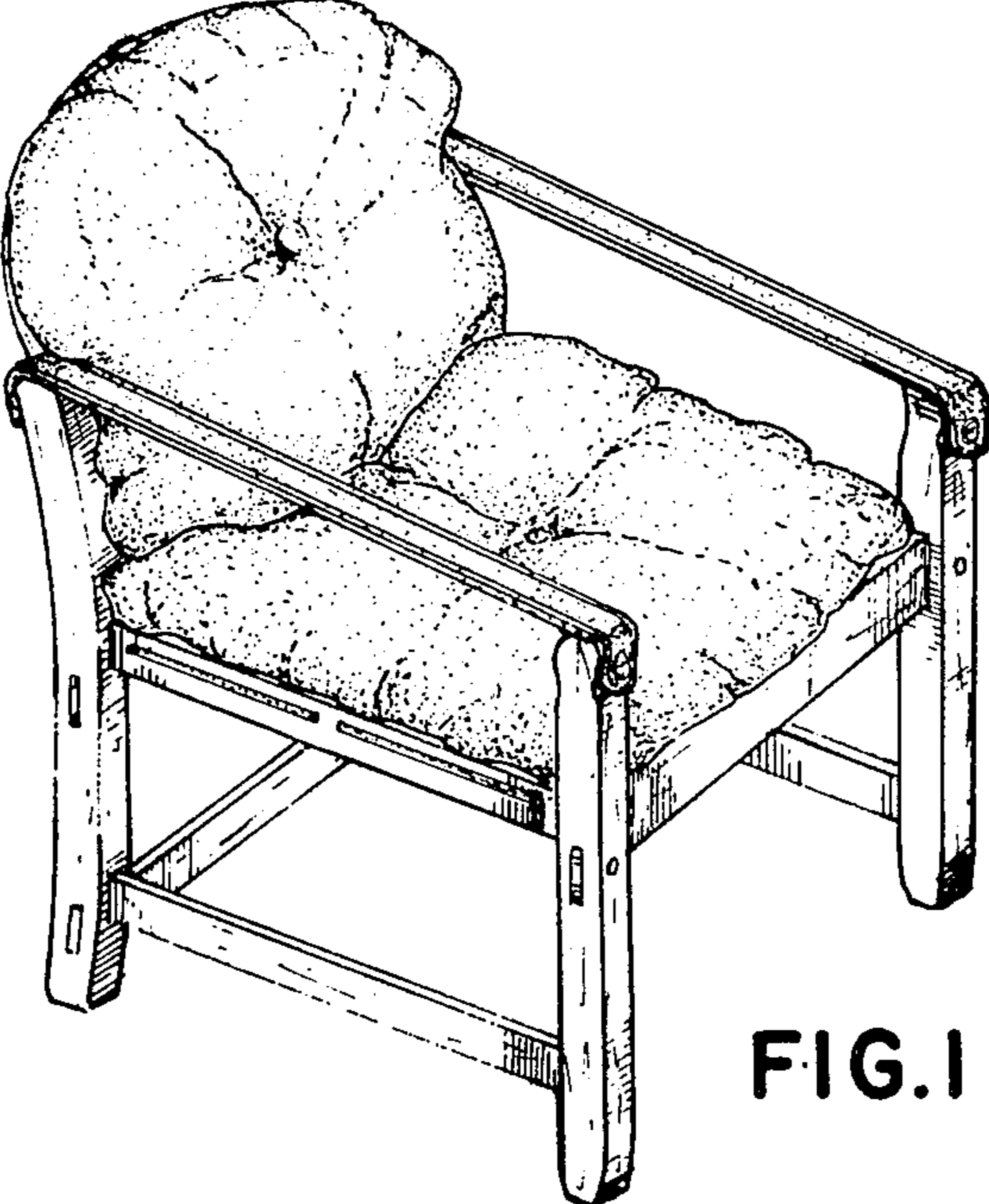

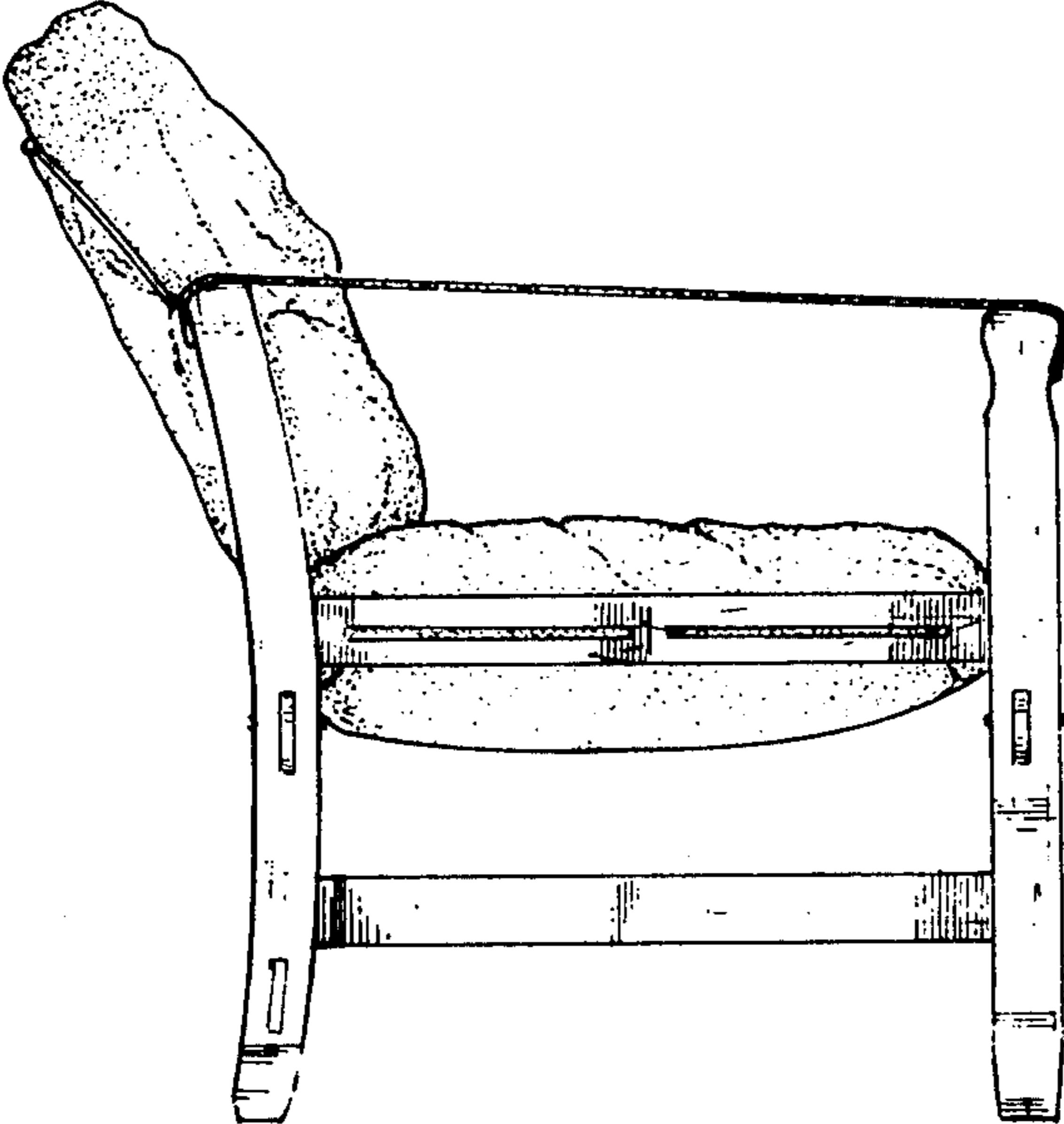

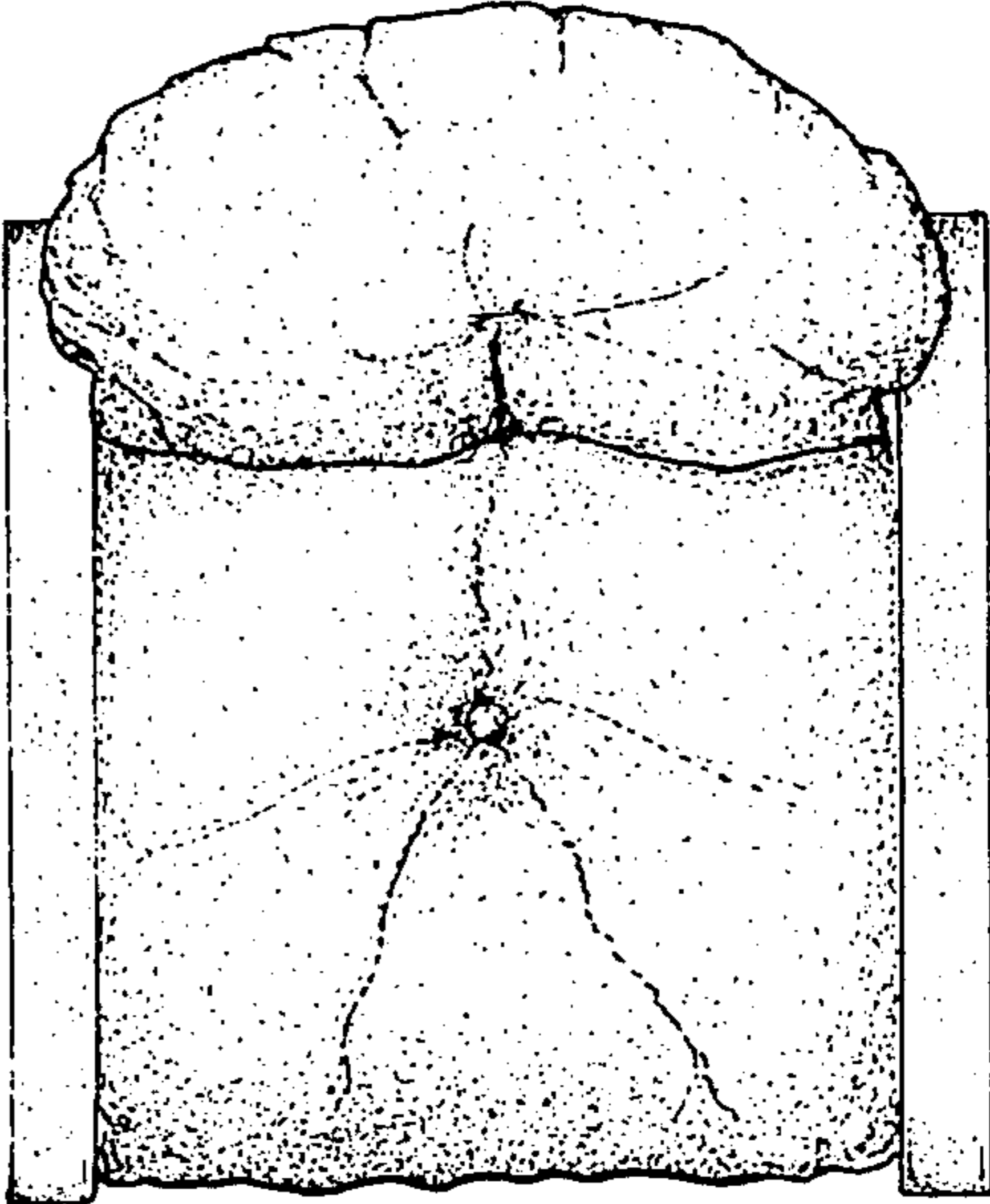

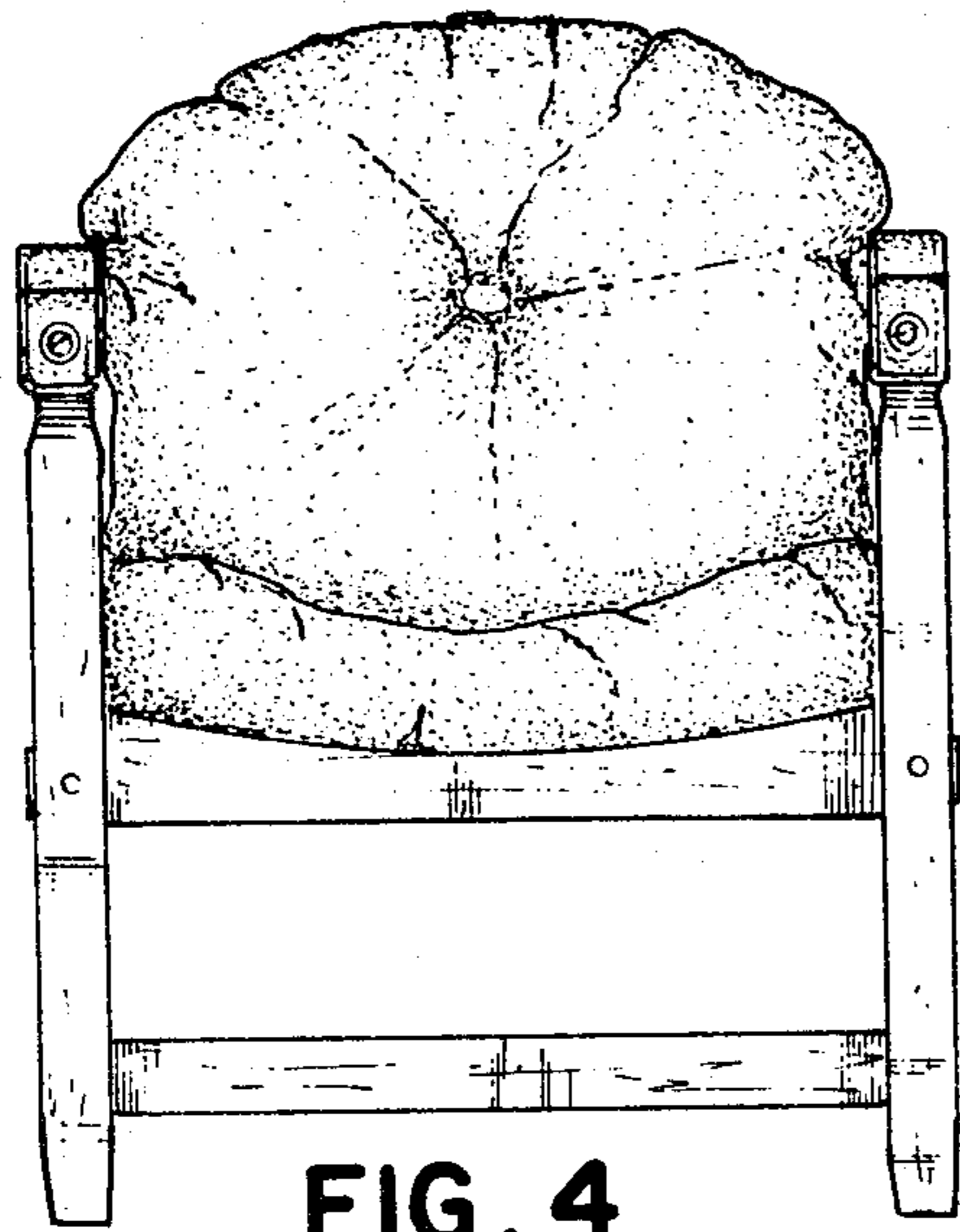

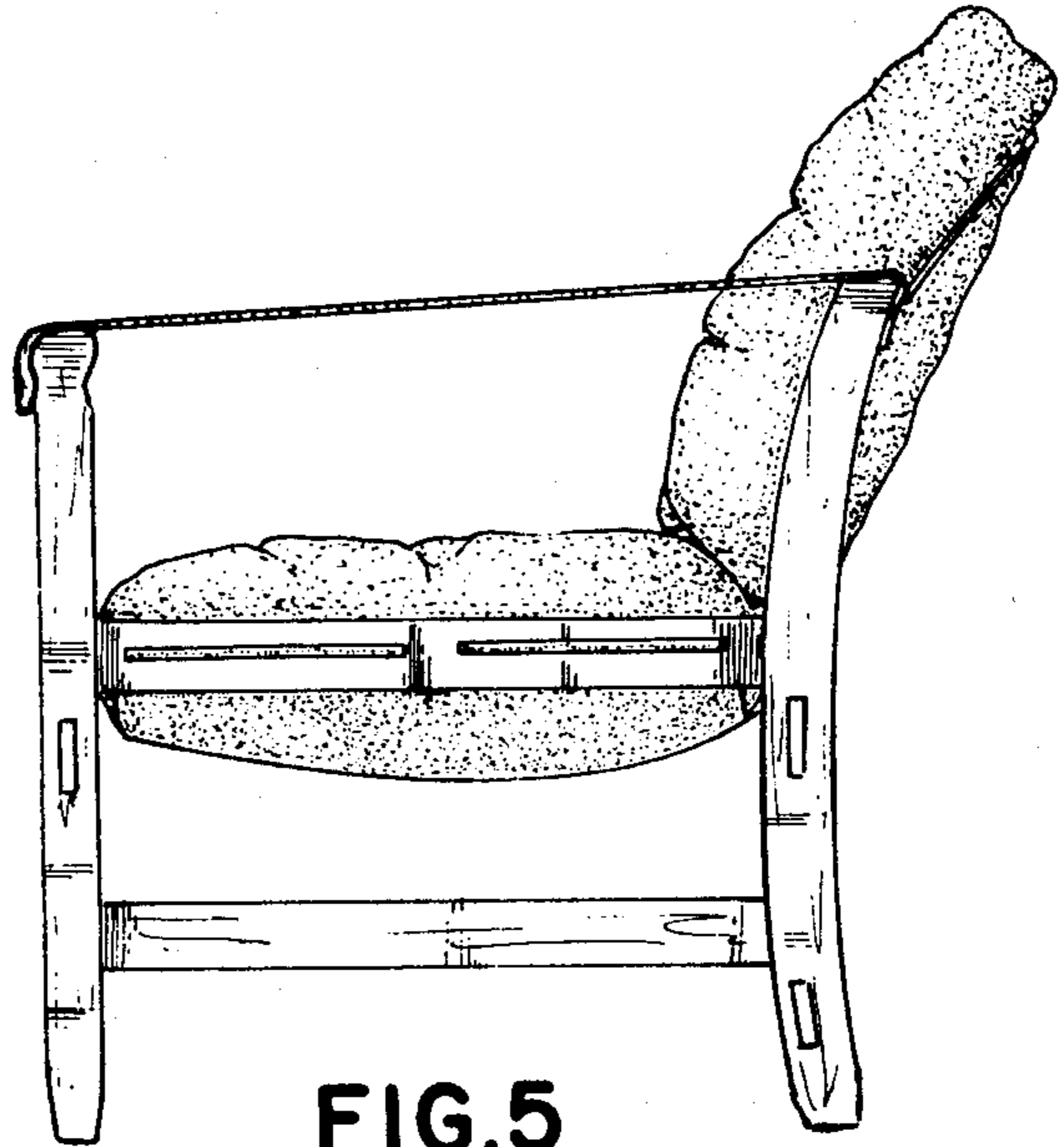

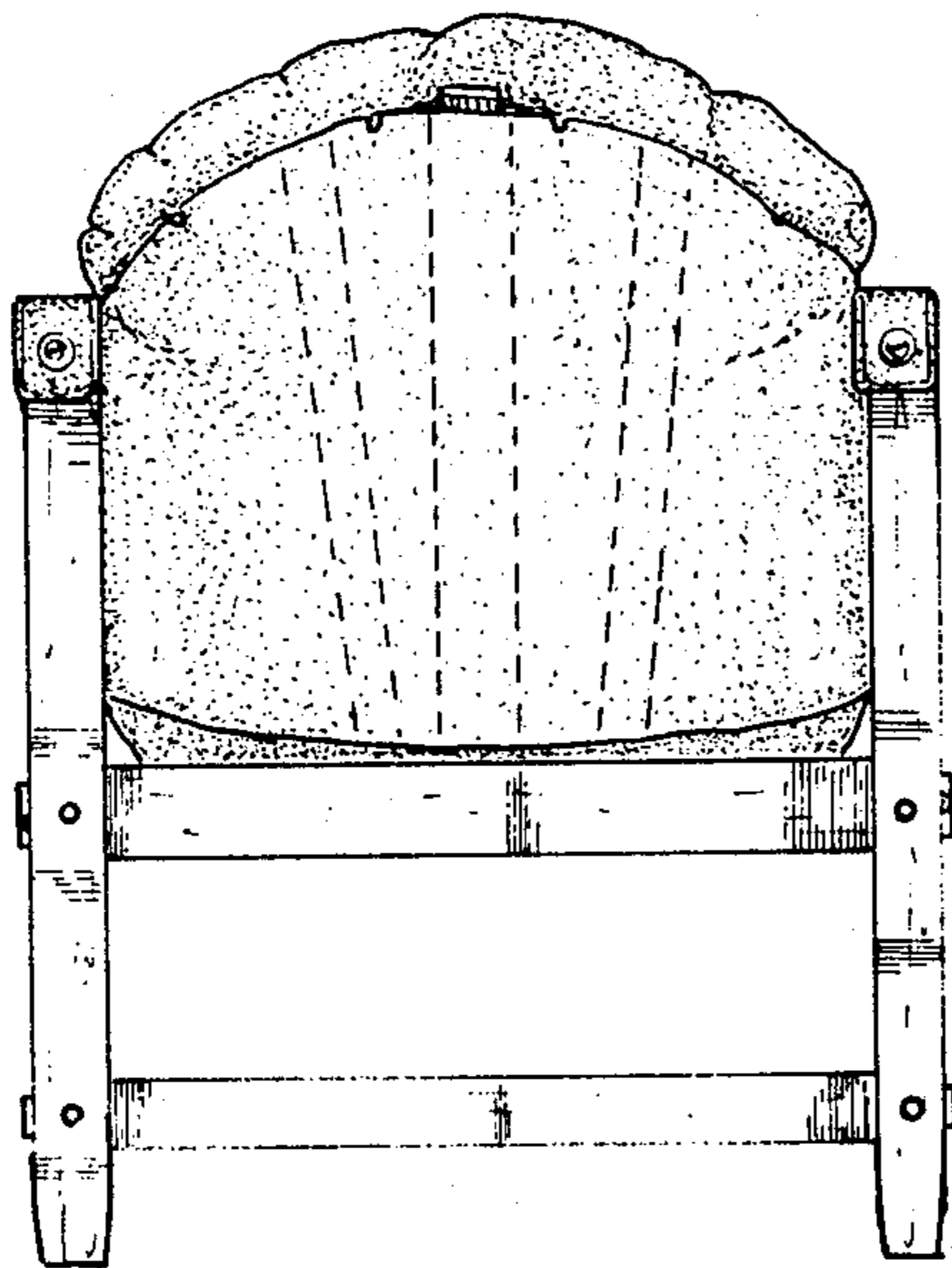

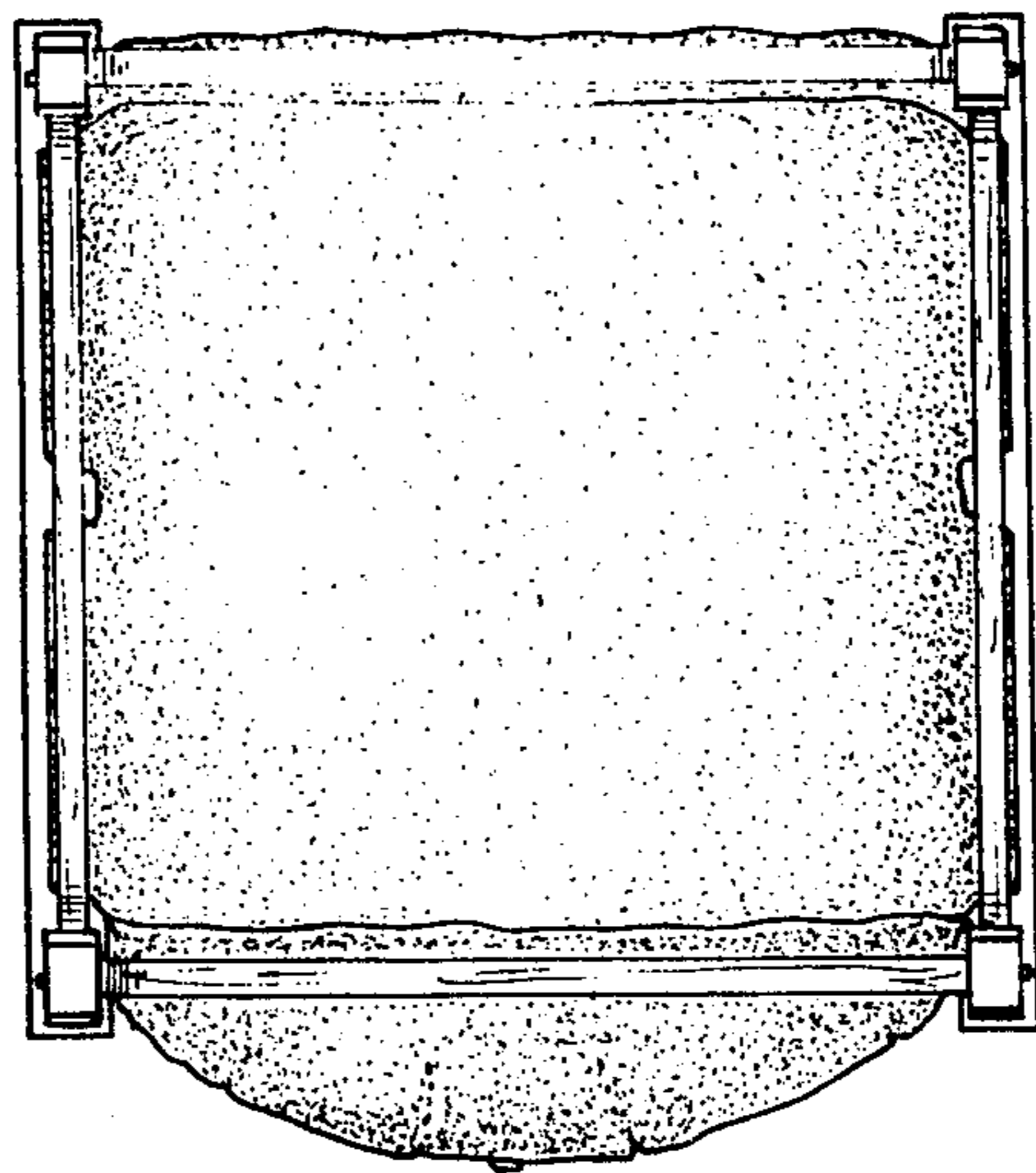
