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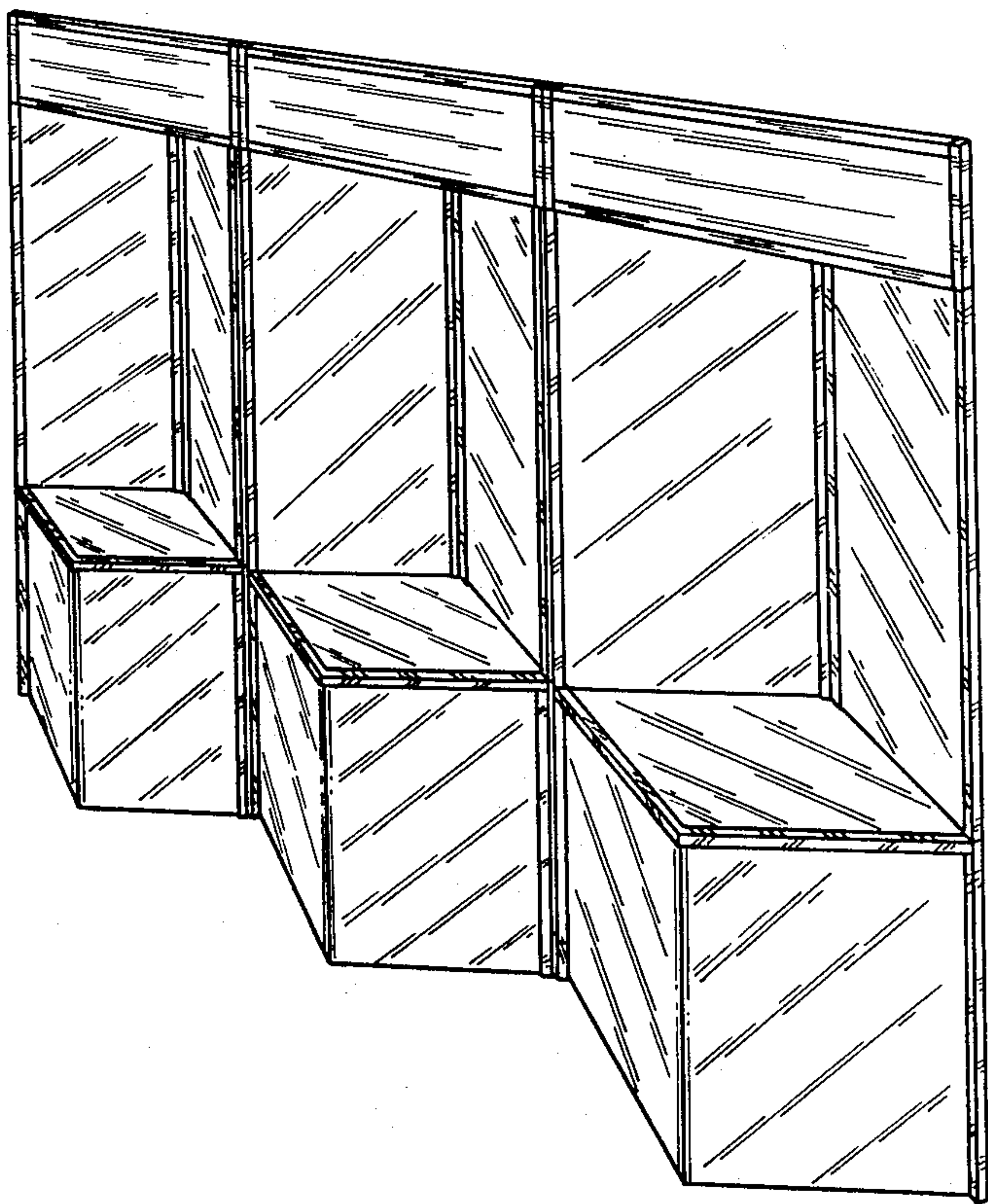
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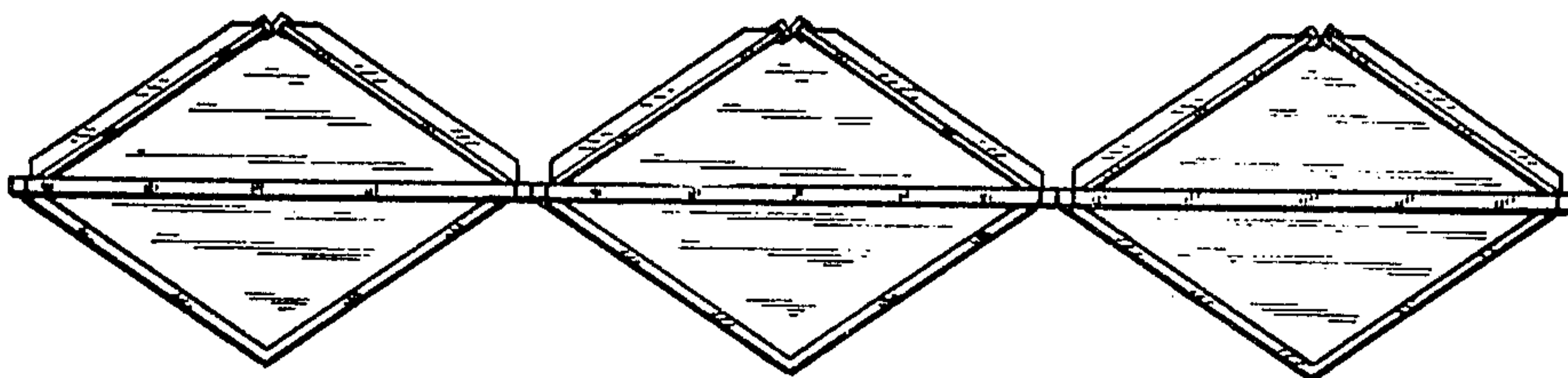

The ornamental design for a display stand, as shown and described.

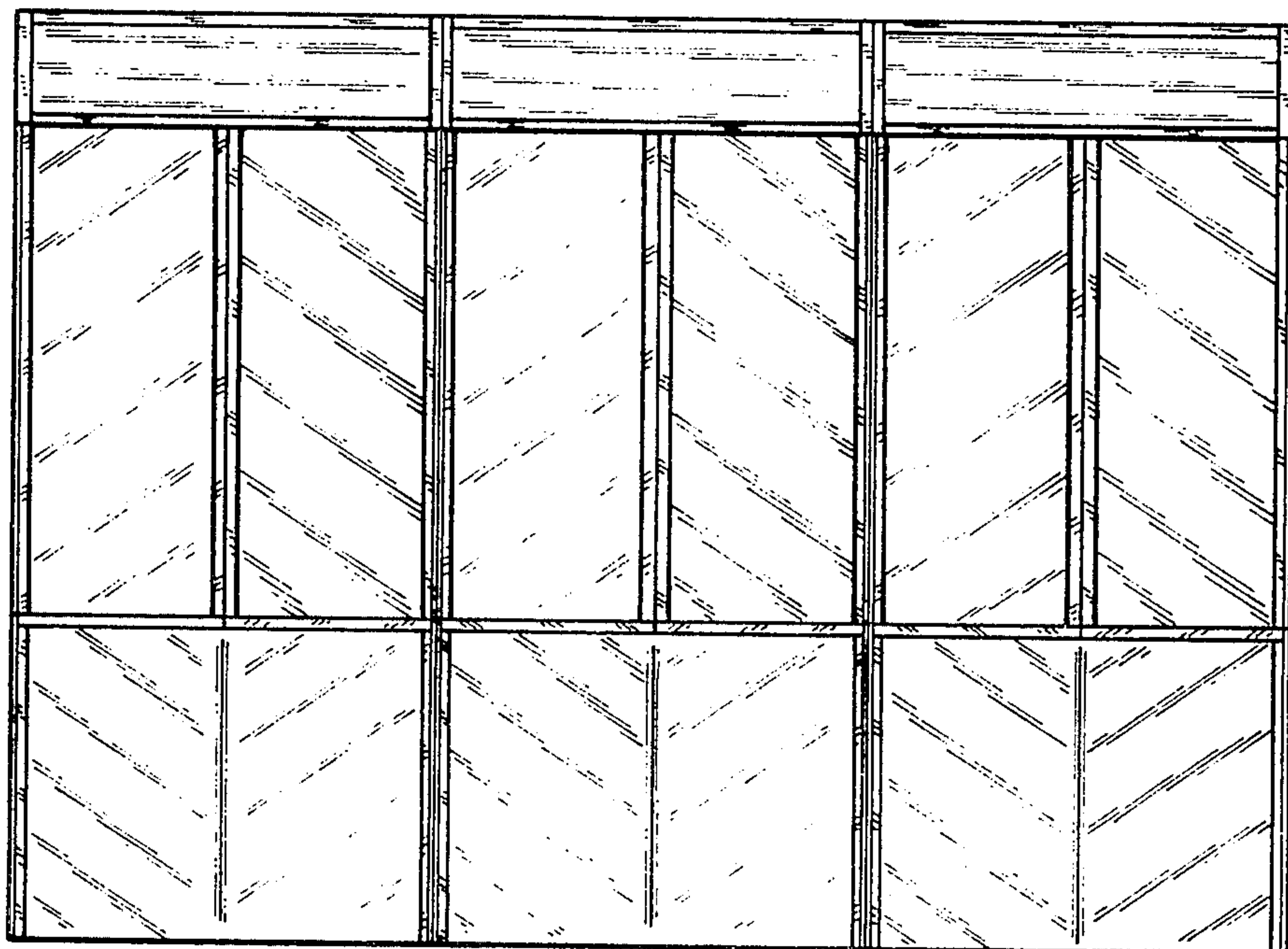
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a right side perspective view thereof.

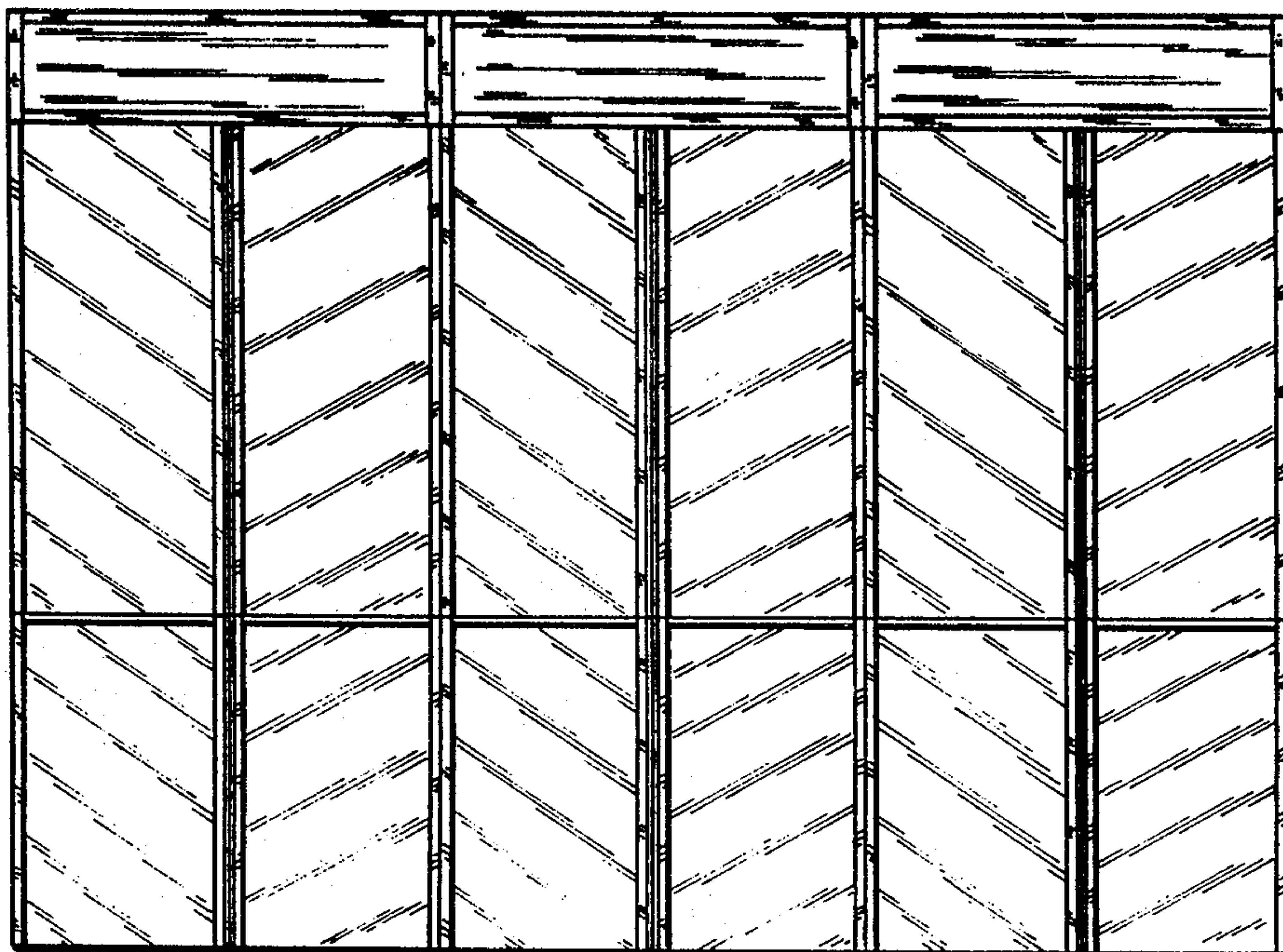




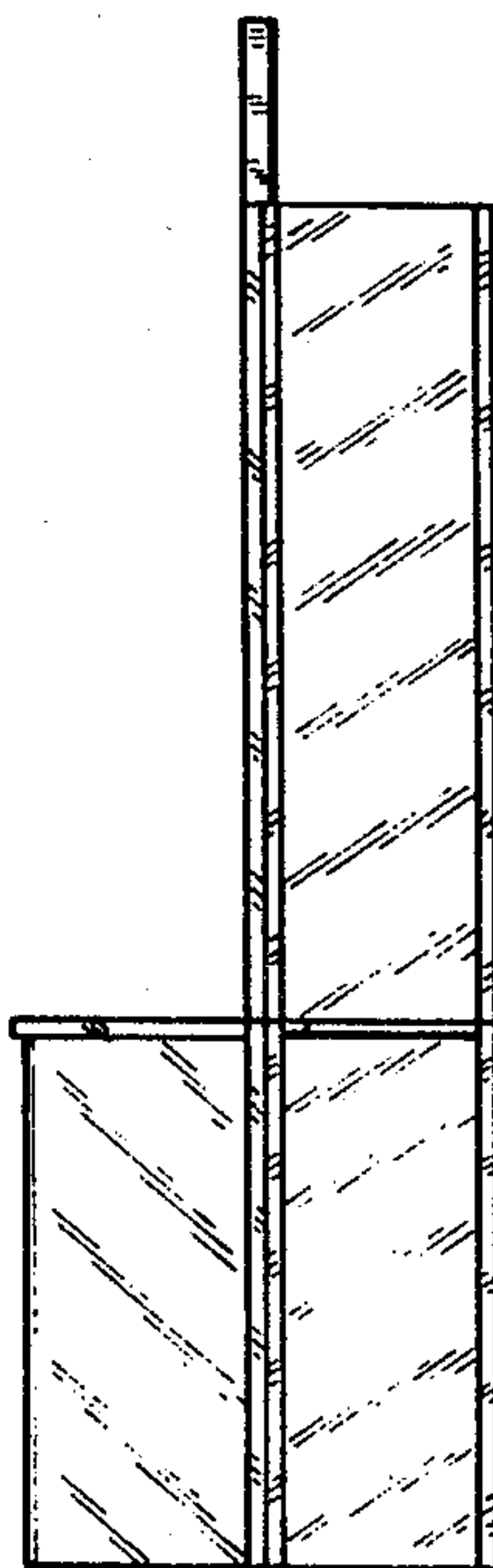

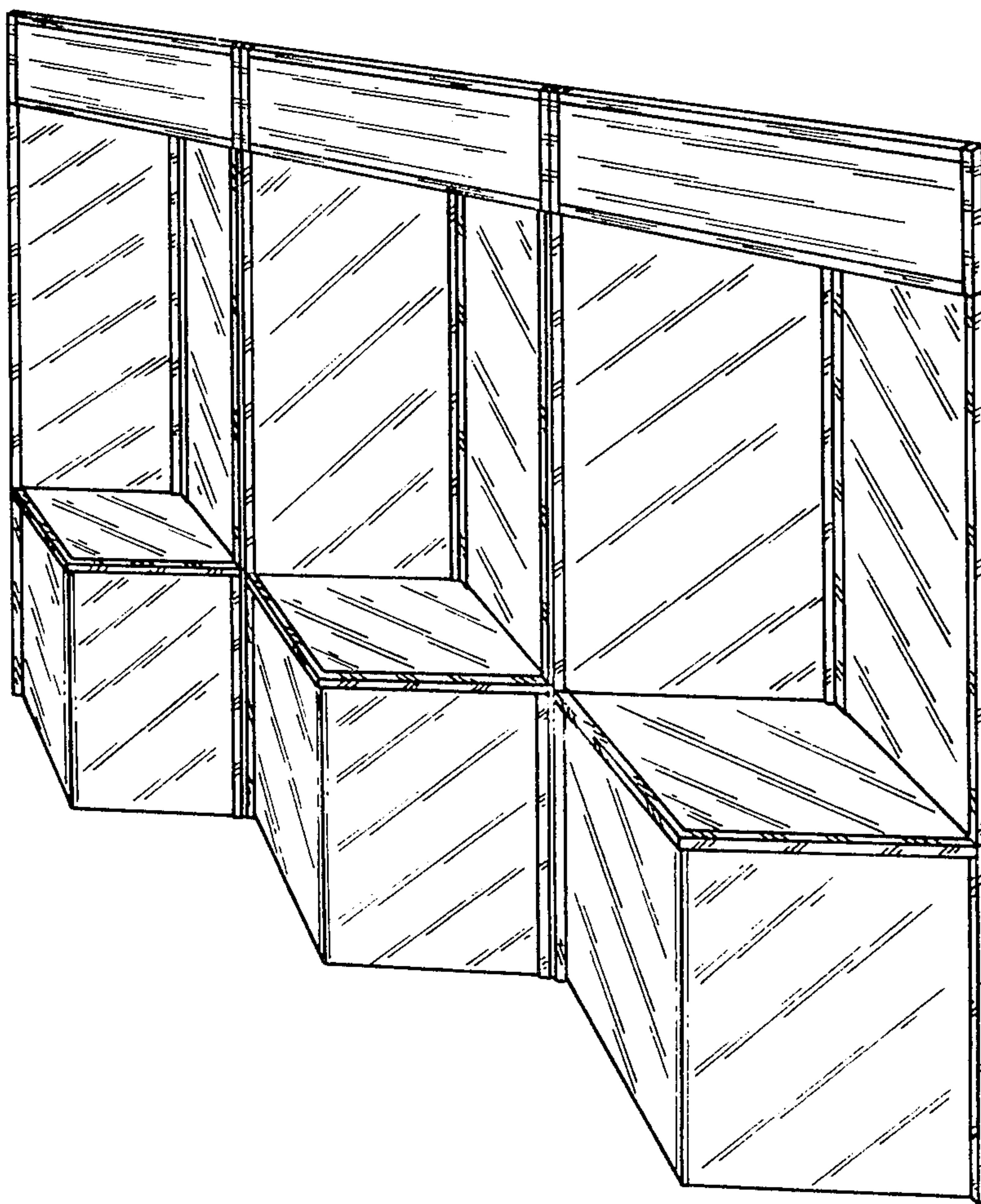
