The ornamental design for a load body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the load body with all of the gull wing doors in their open position showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof the opposite side being substantially a mirror image of that shown;
FIG. 4 is a rear end elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a front end elevational view thereof.

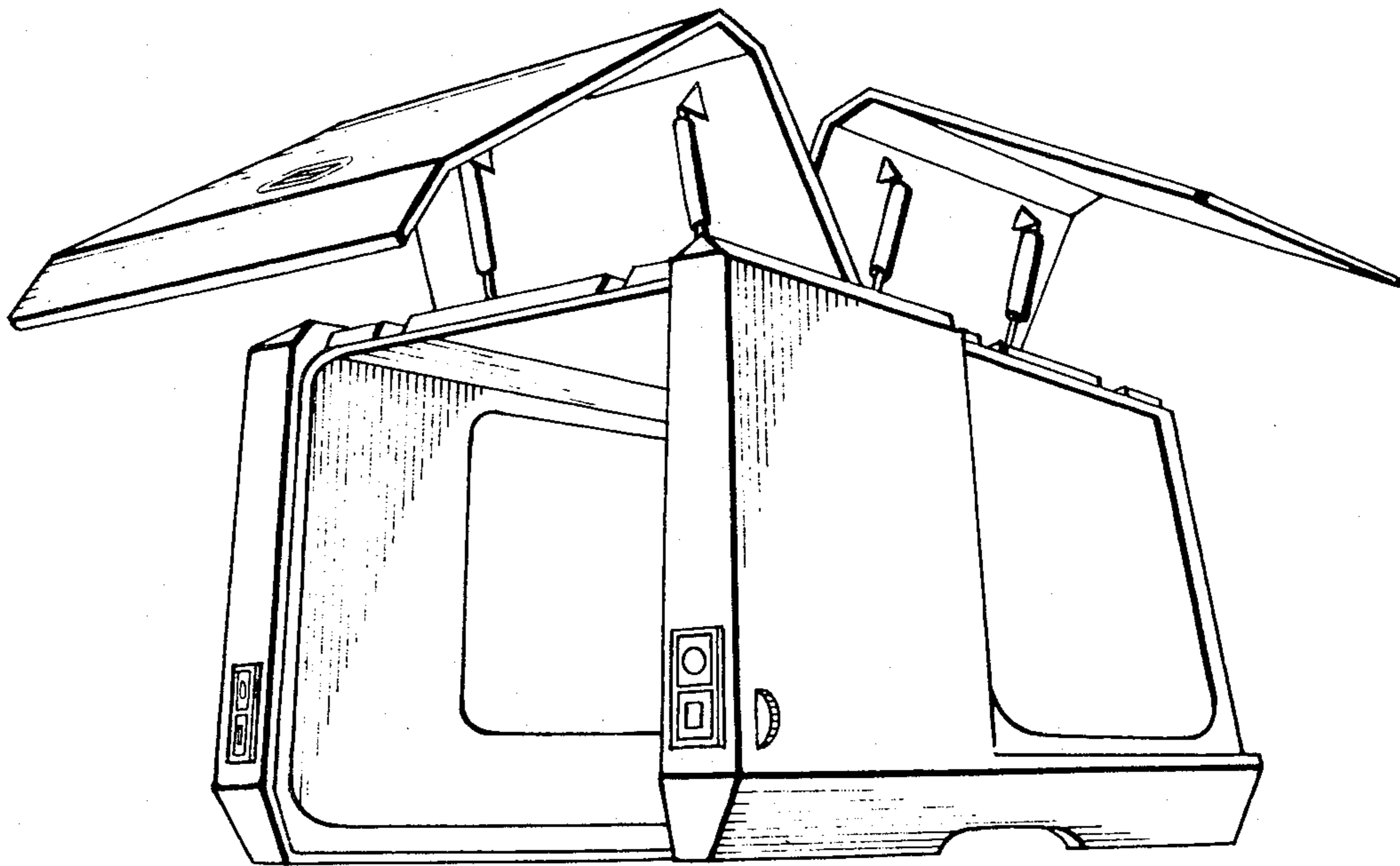

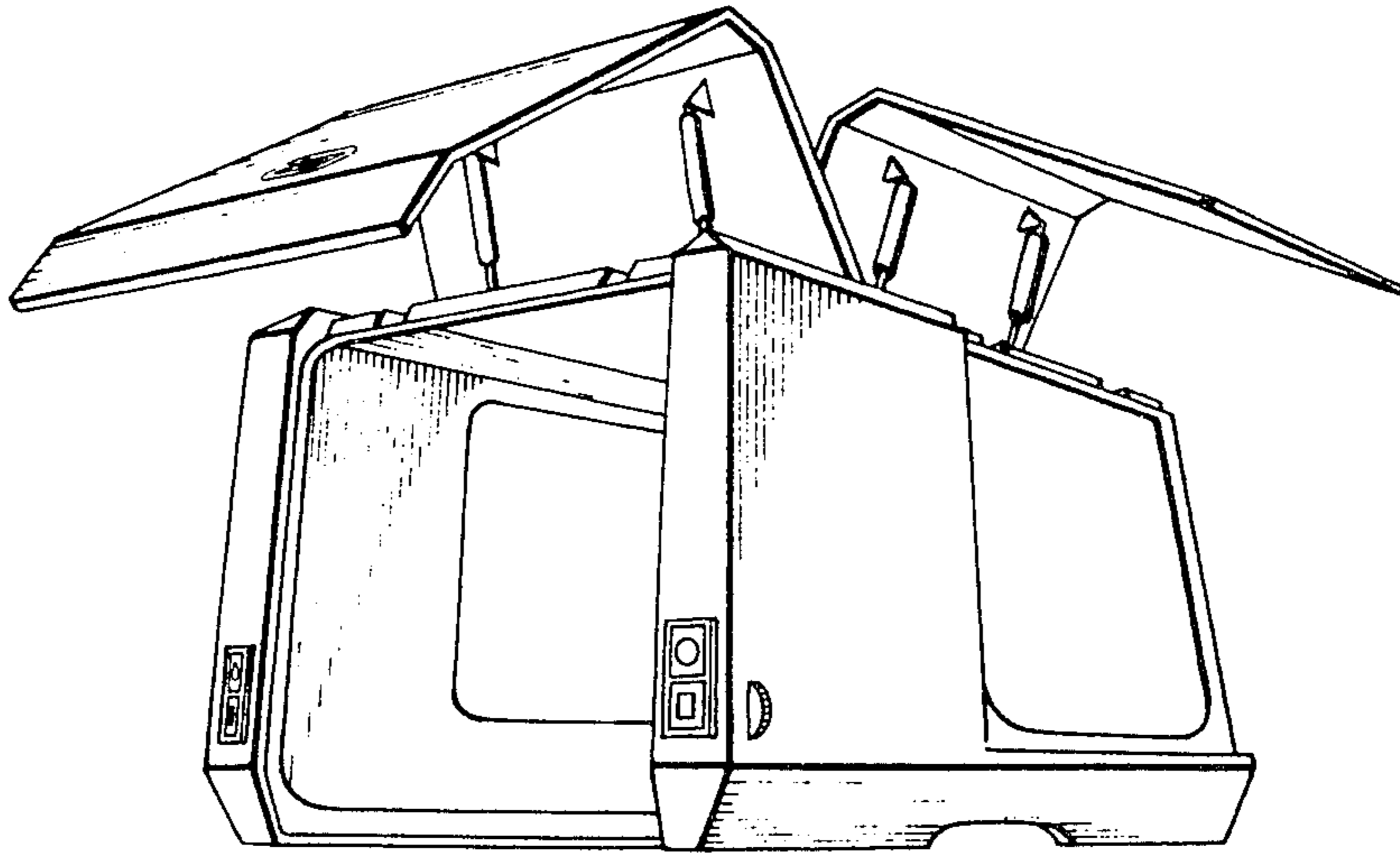

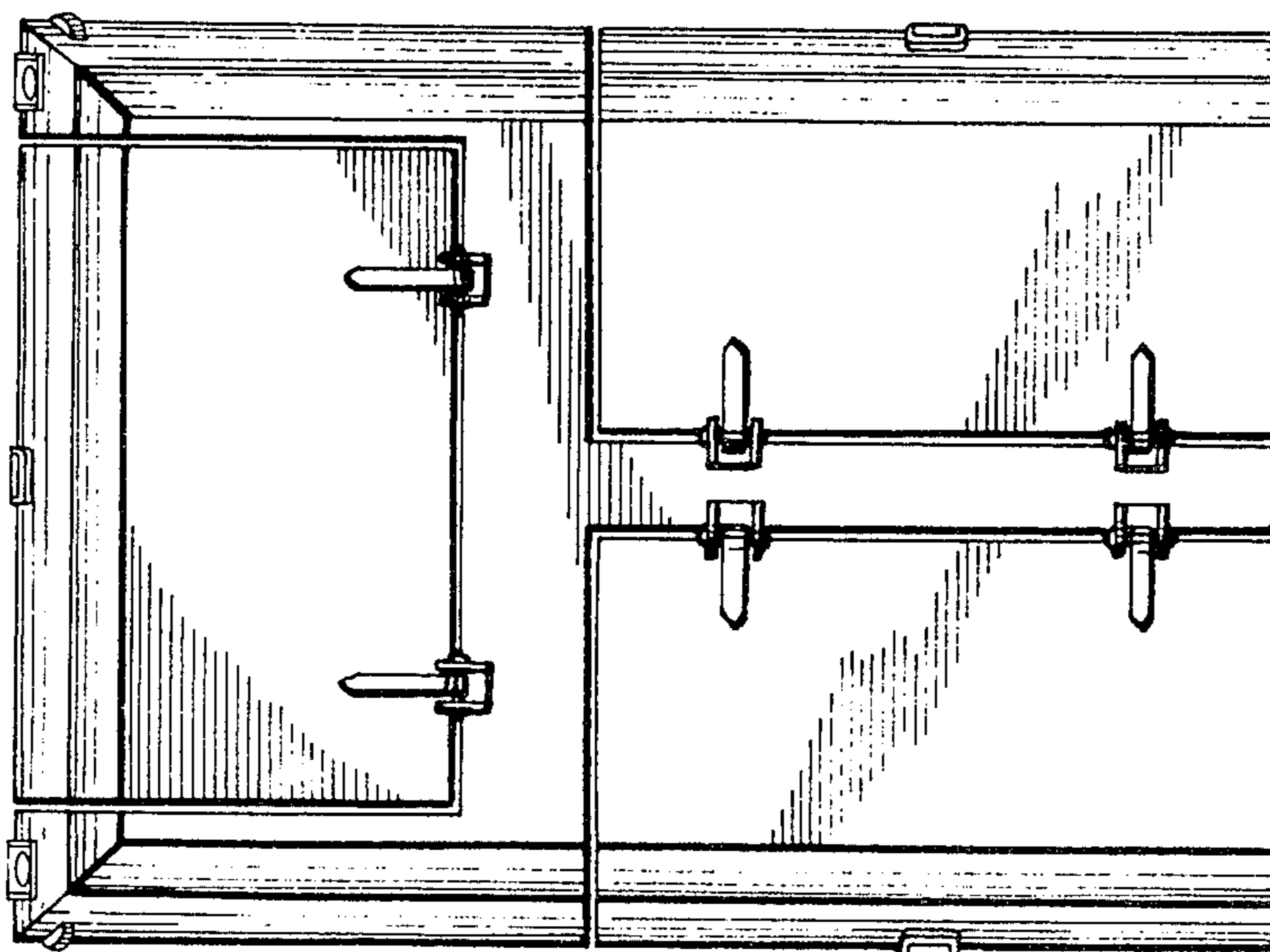

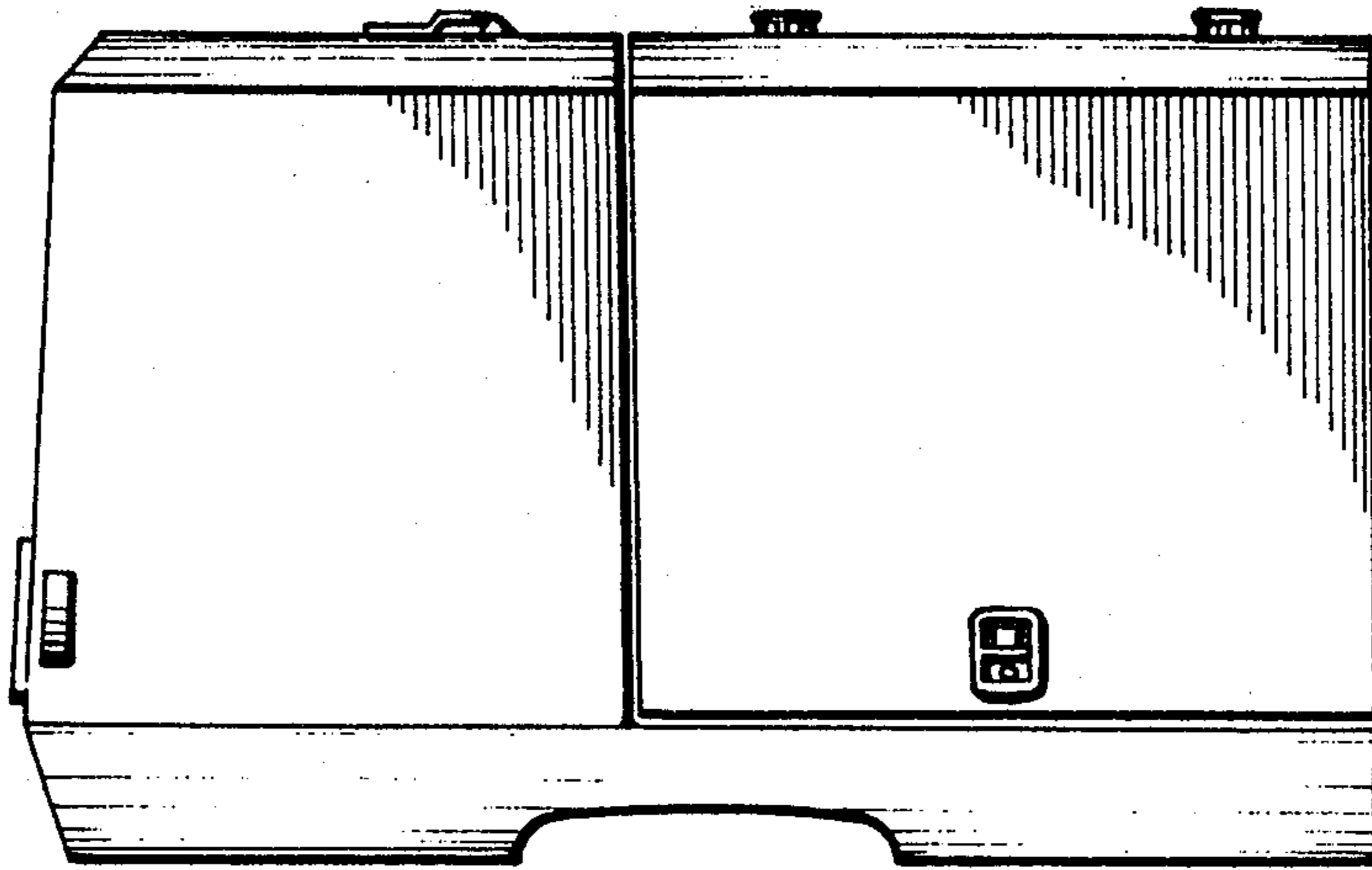

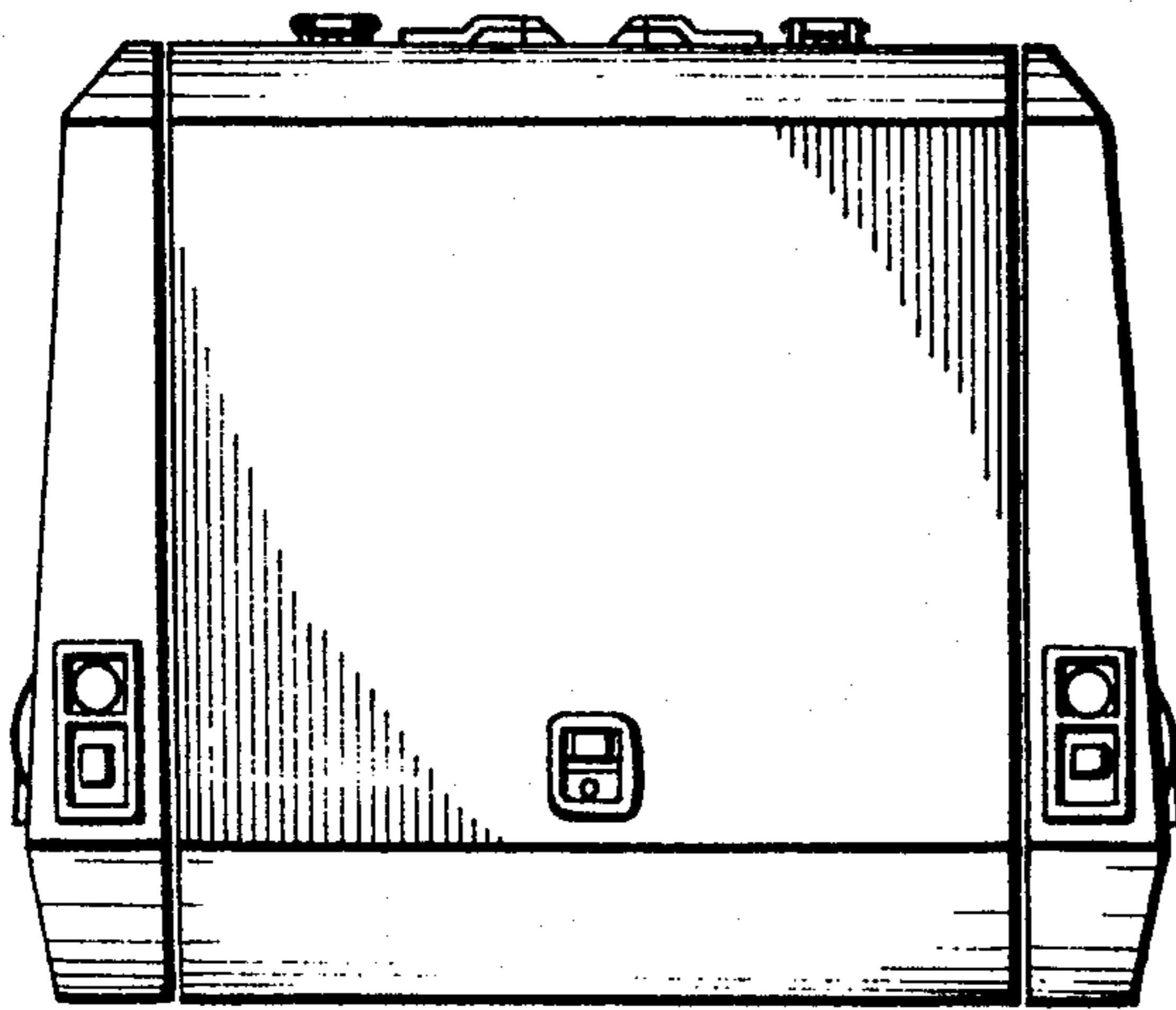
