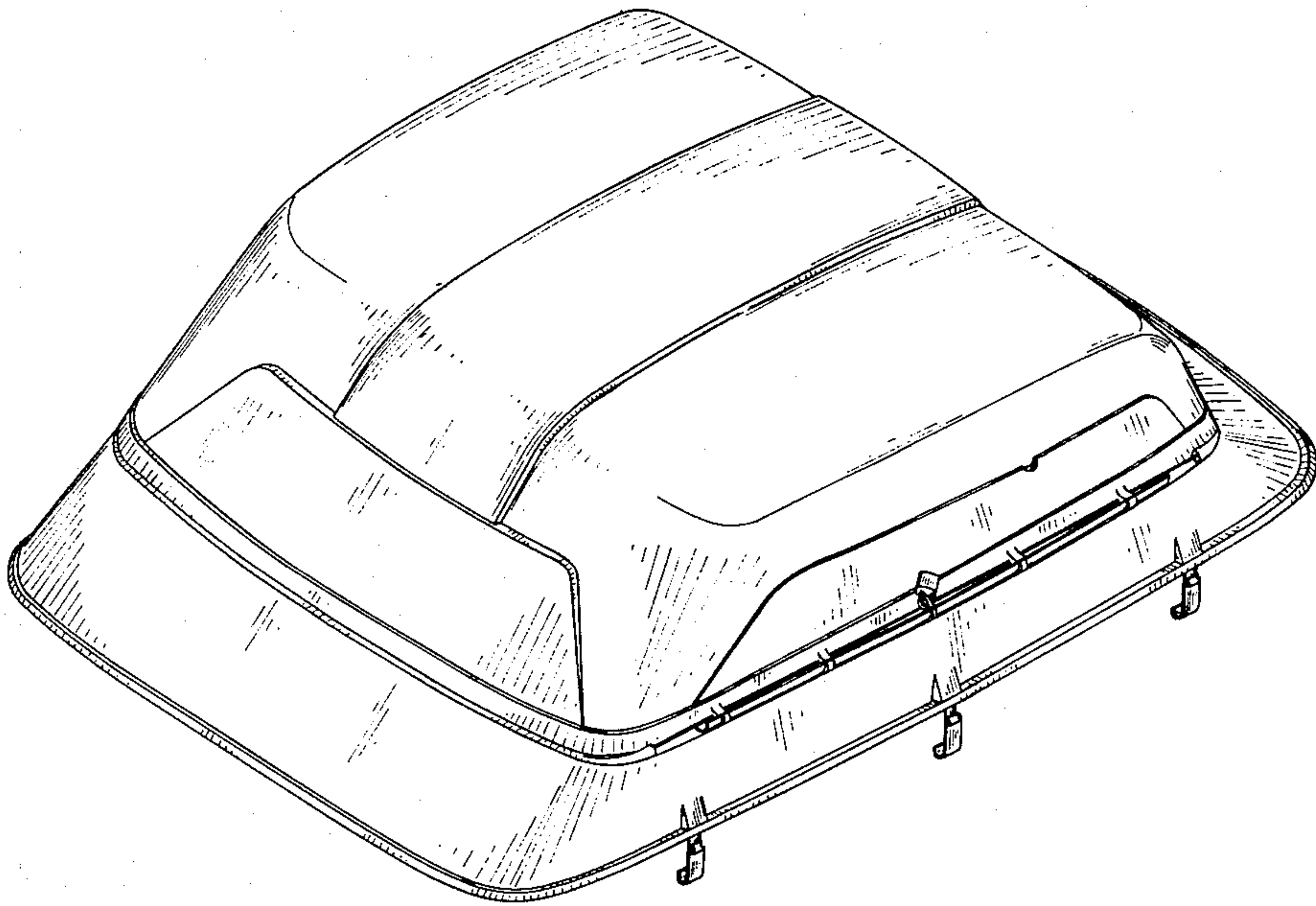

The ornamental design for a luggage carrier for vehicles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a luggage carrier for vehicles showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of that shown;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



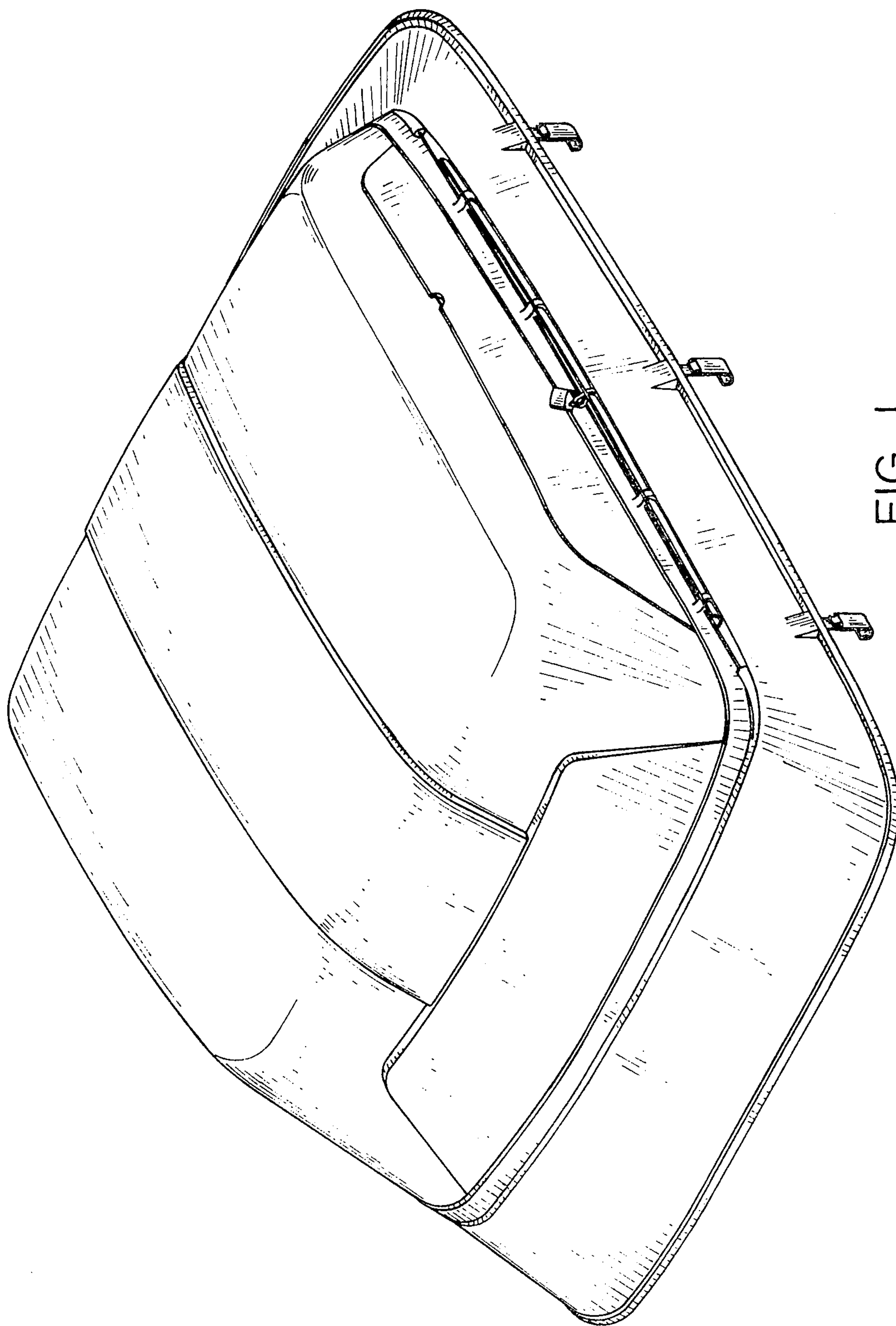

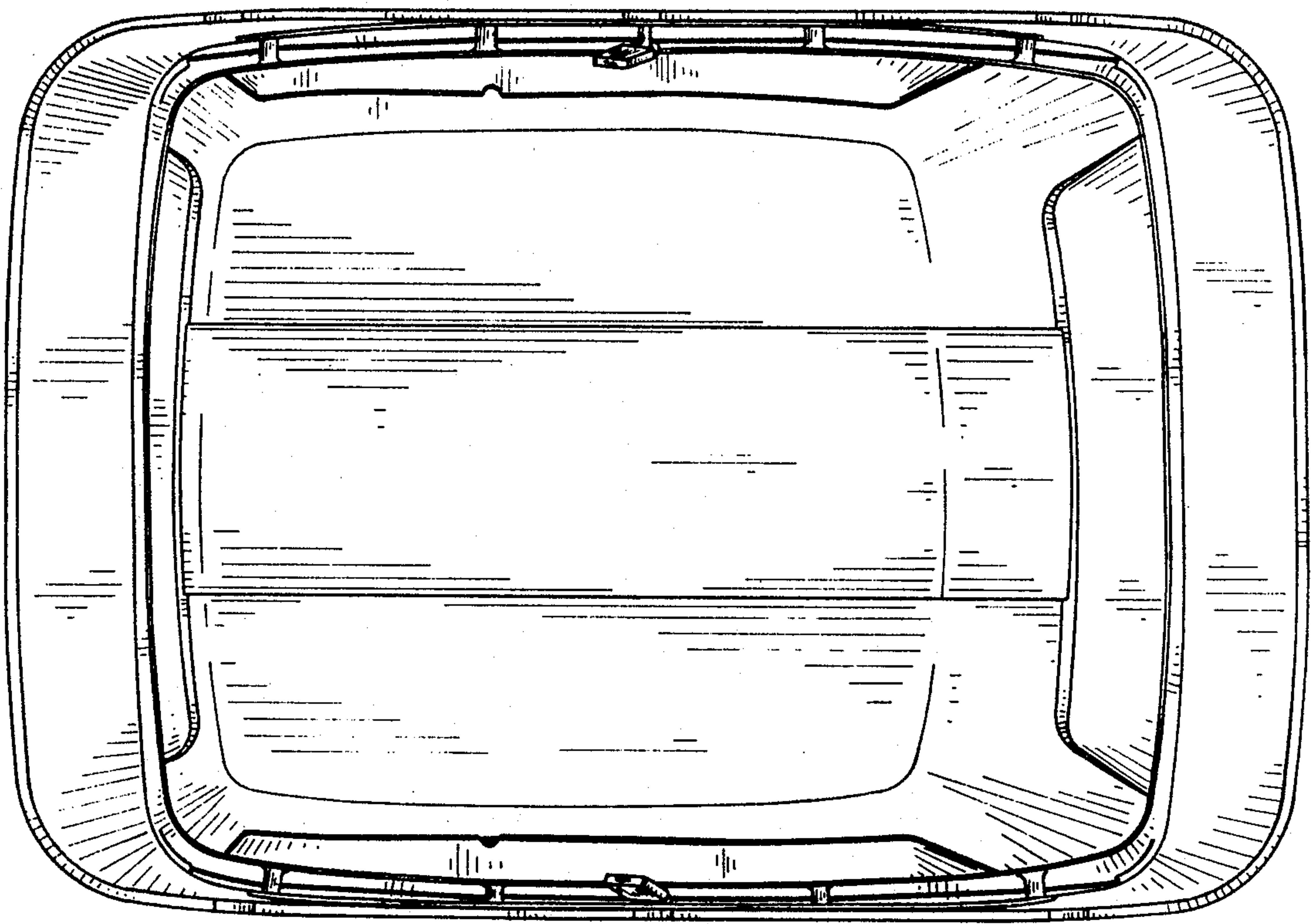

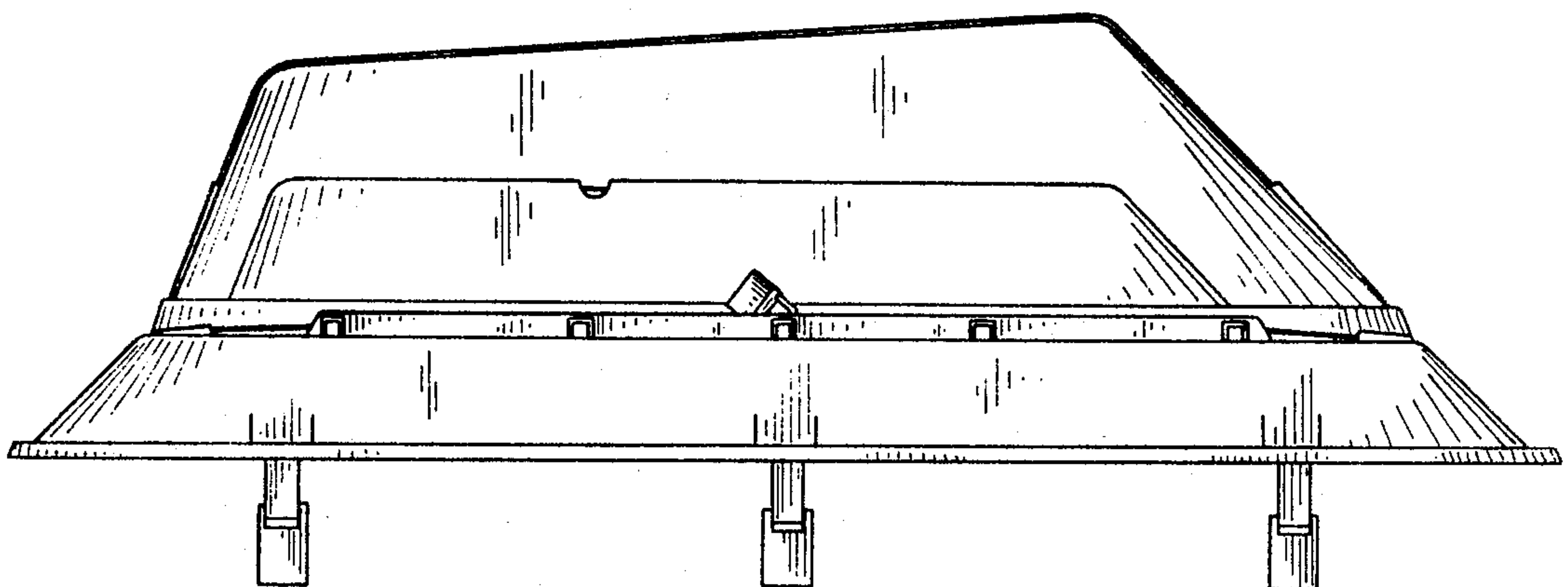

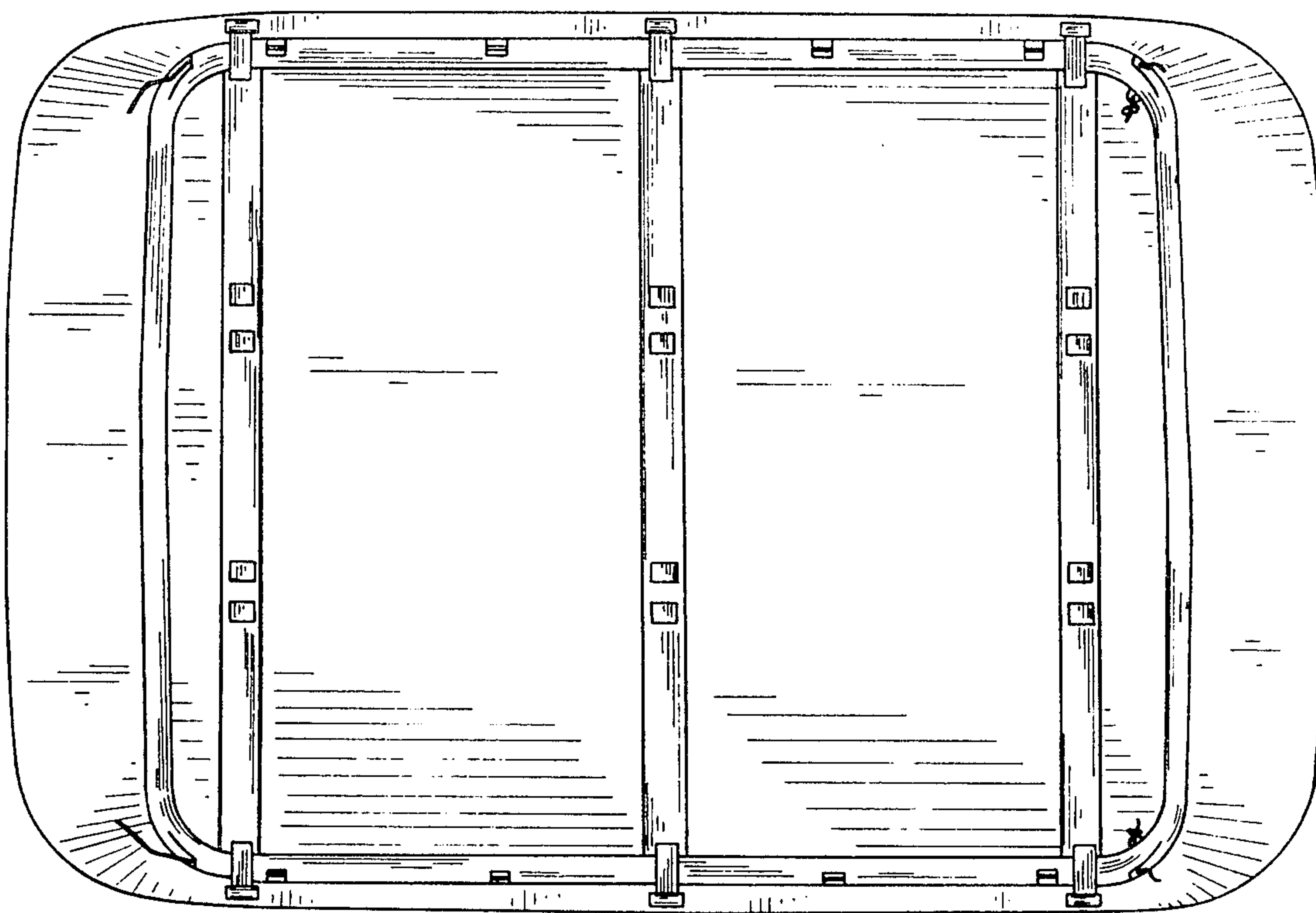

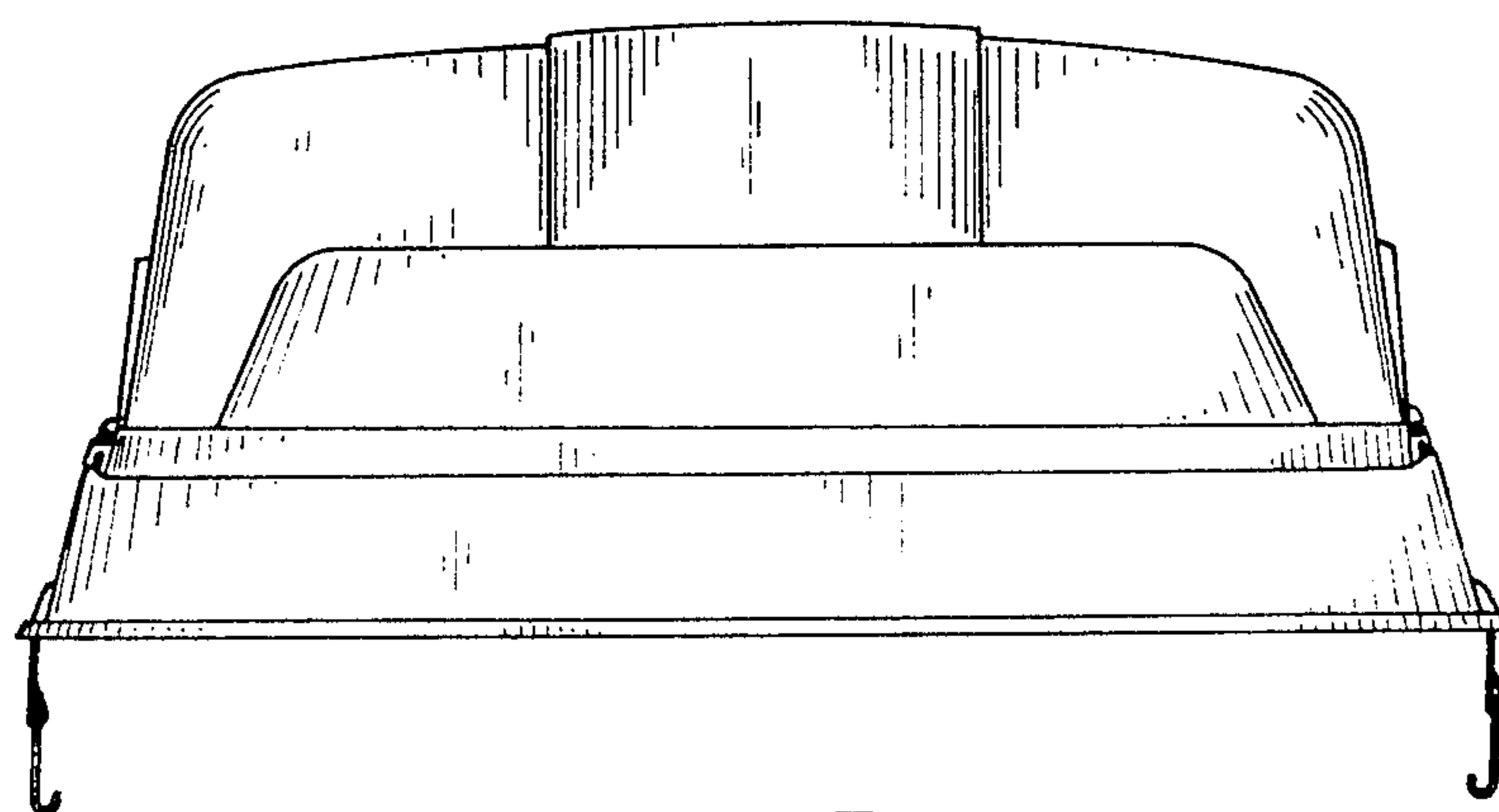

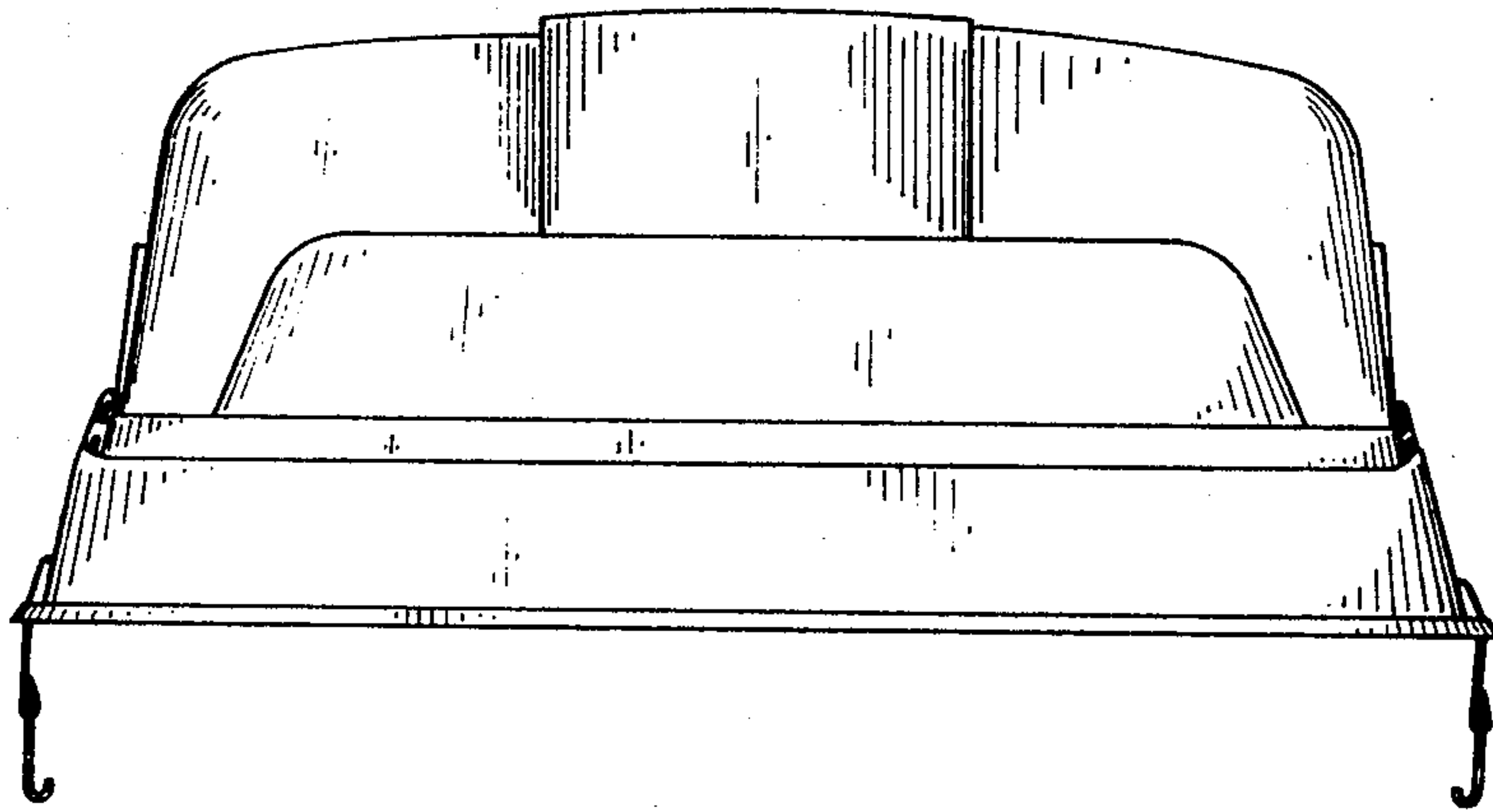
