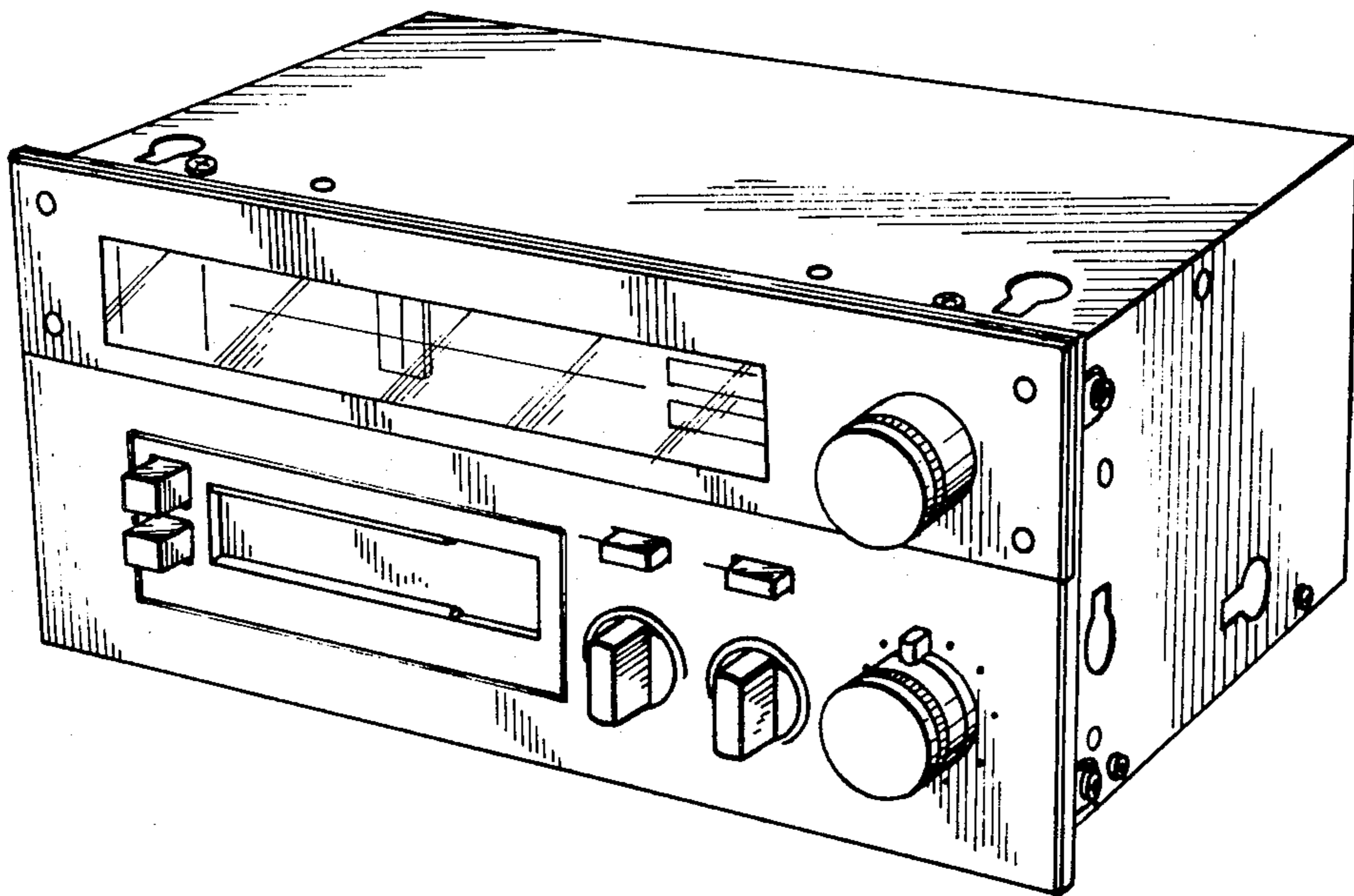

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined motor vehicular cassette player and radio, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a combined motor vehicular cassette player and radio showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view.



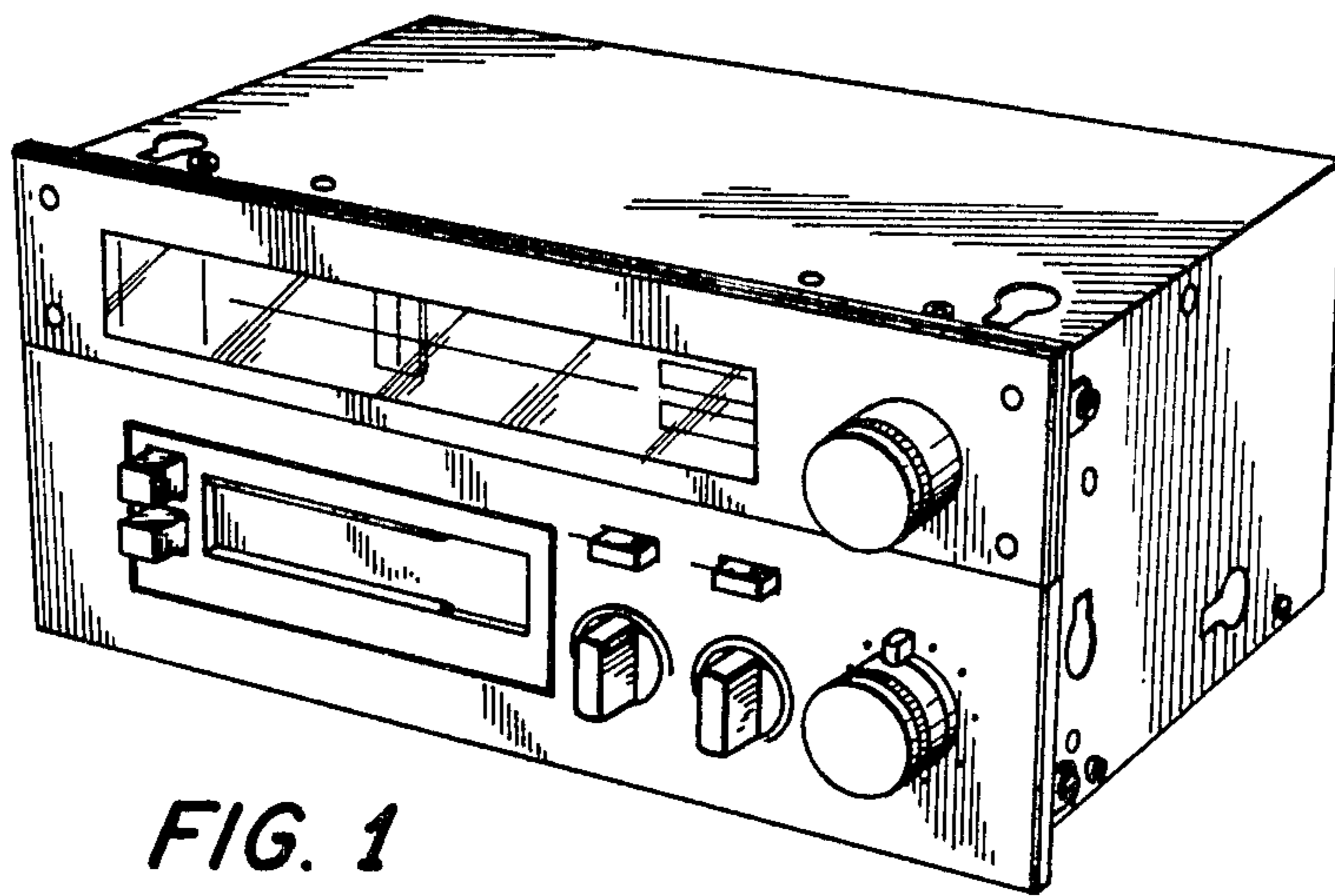

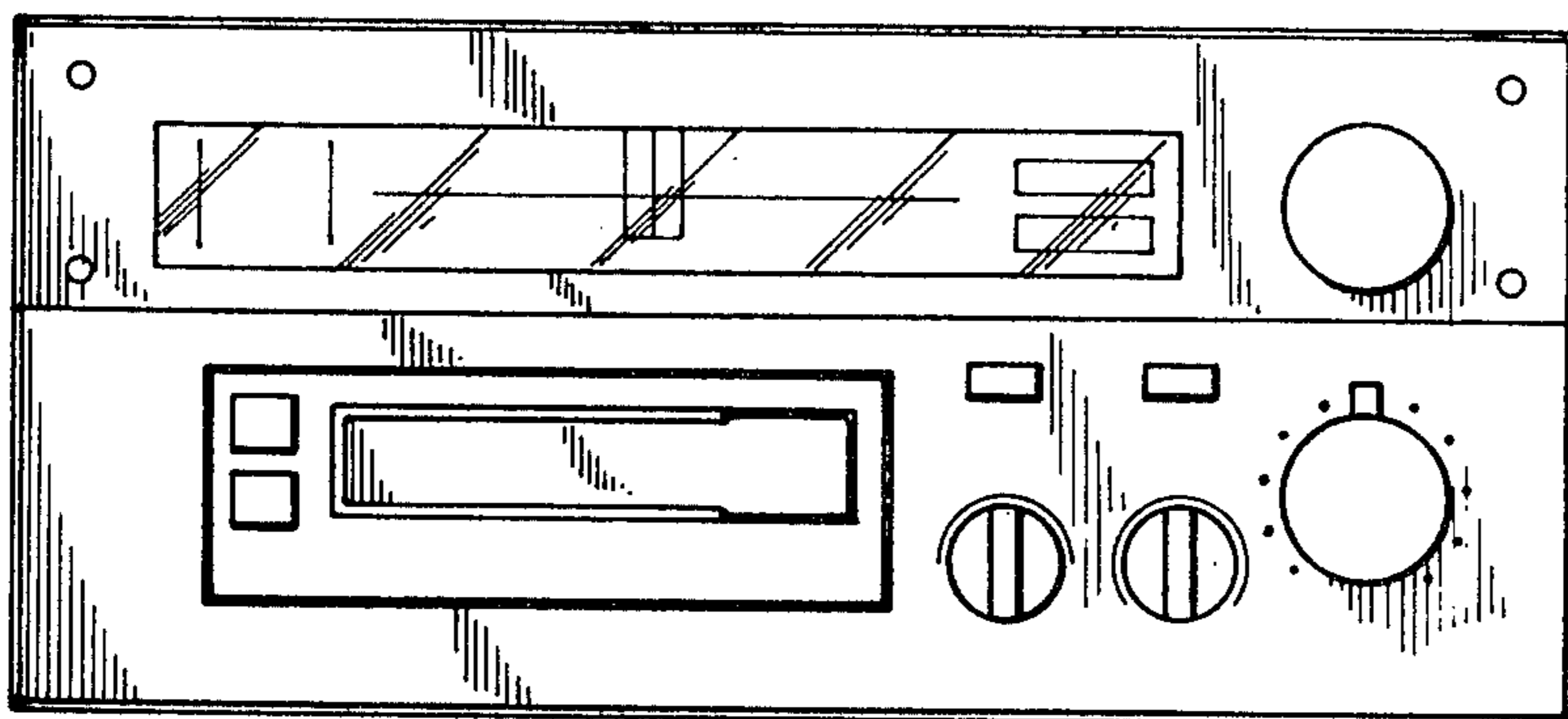

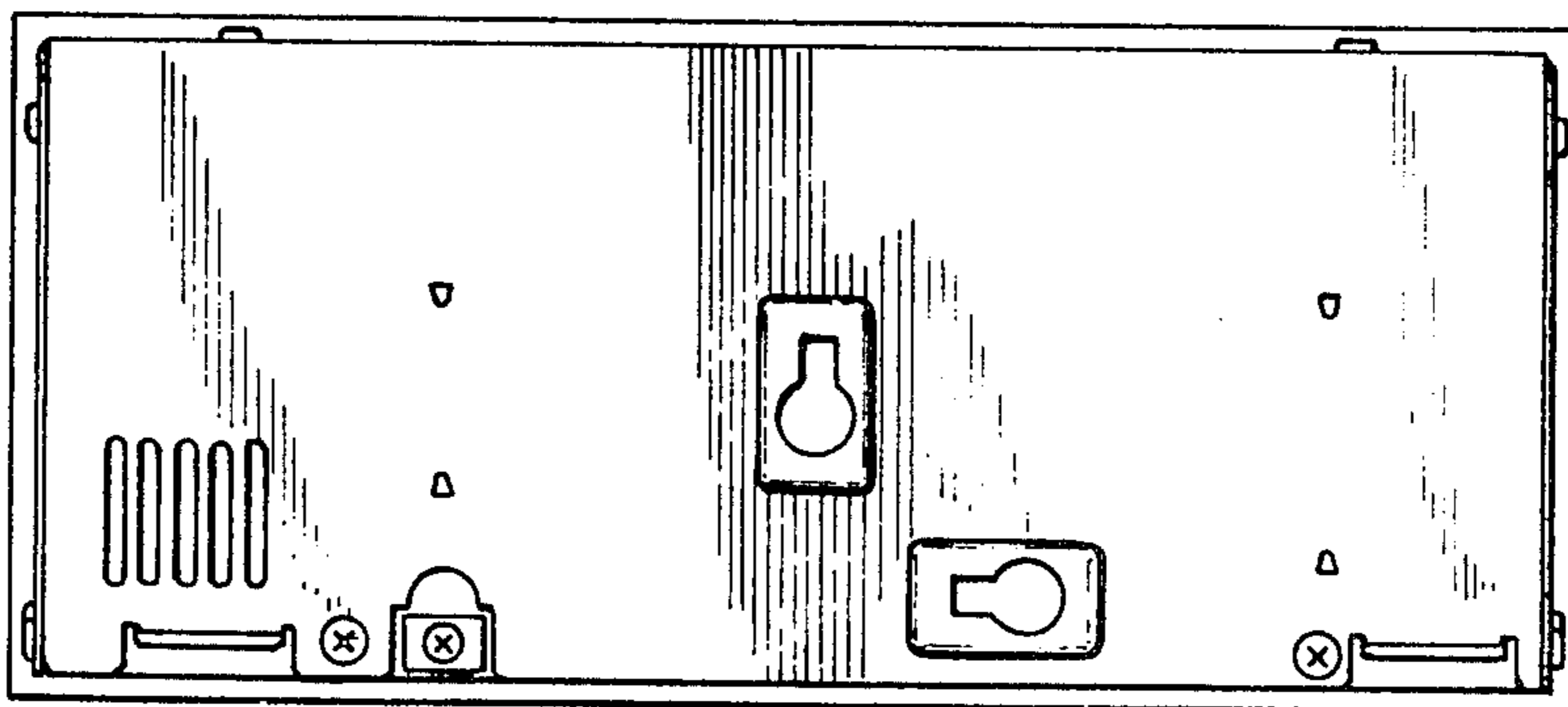

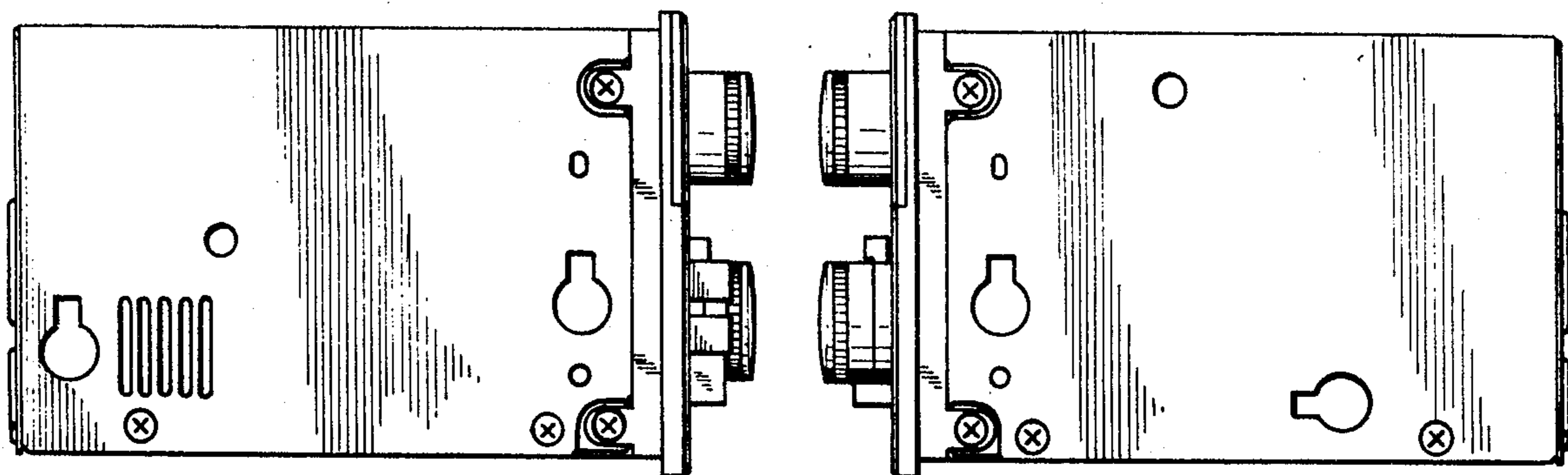

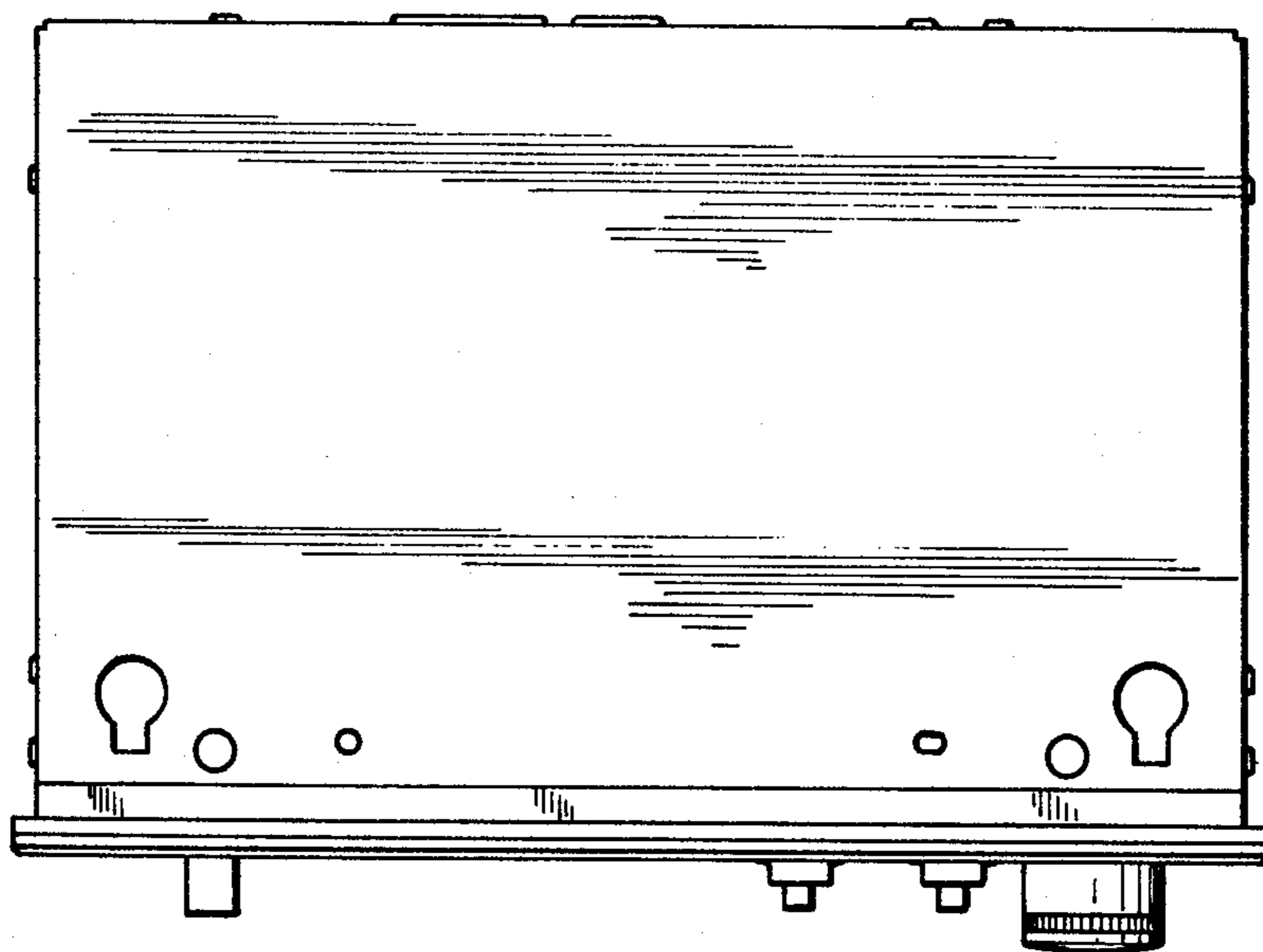
