DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a simulative toy car showing my new design.
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially in a mirror image.
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof.
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view of the body member taken along the reference line in FIG. 6.
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

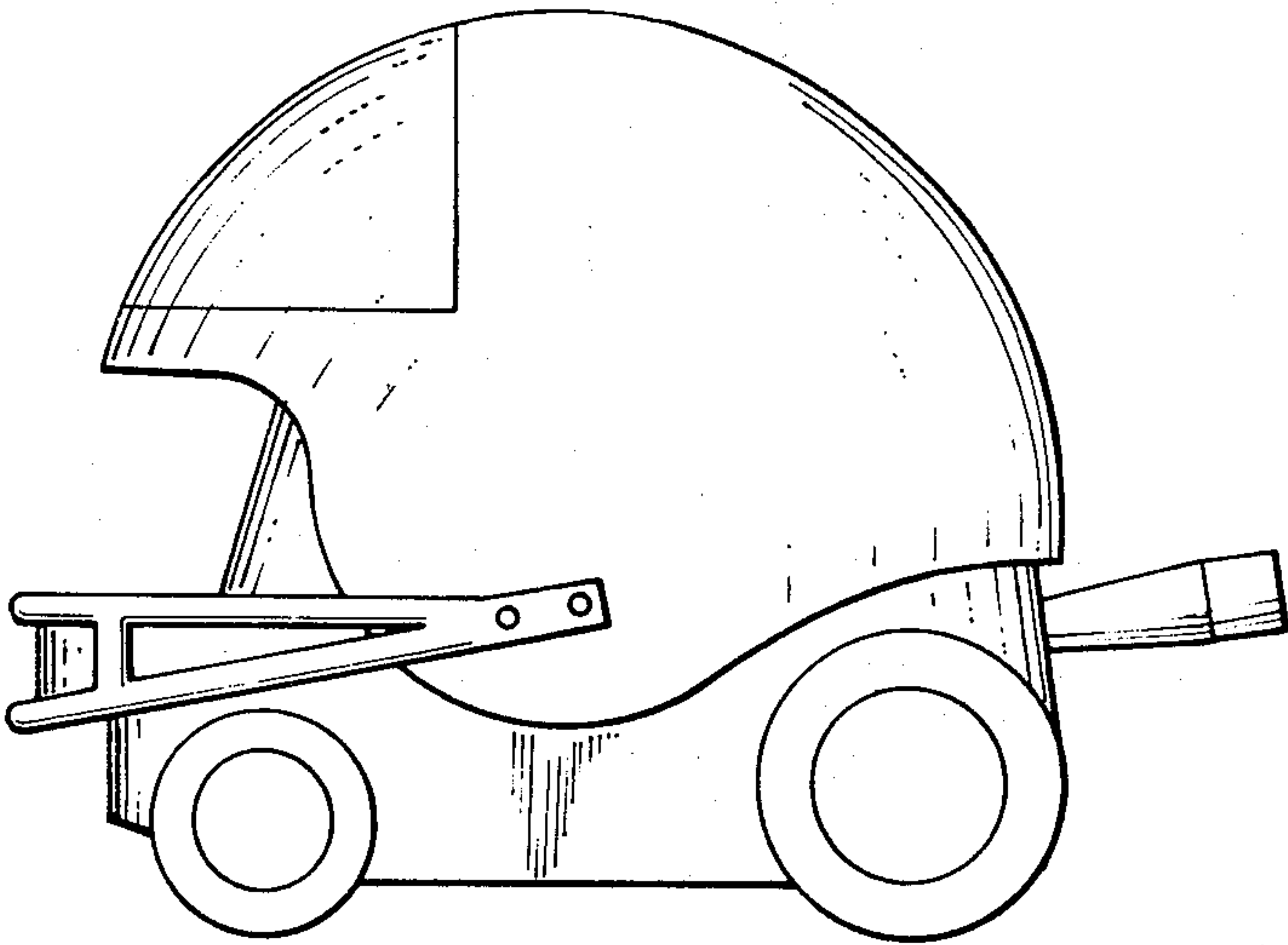

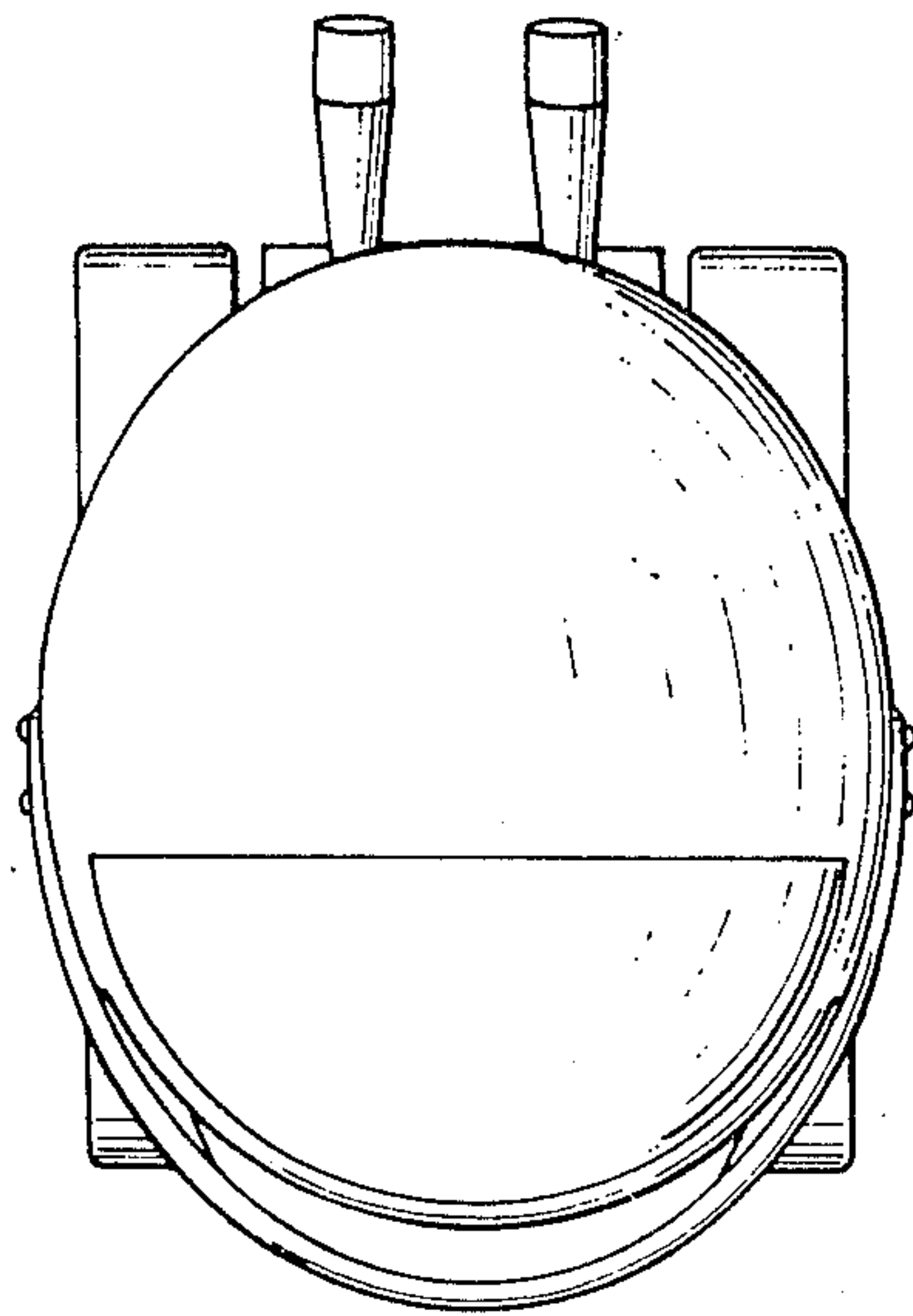

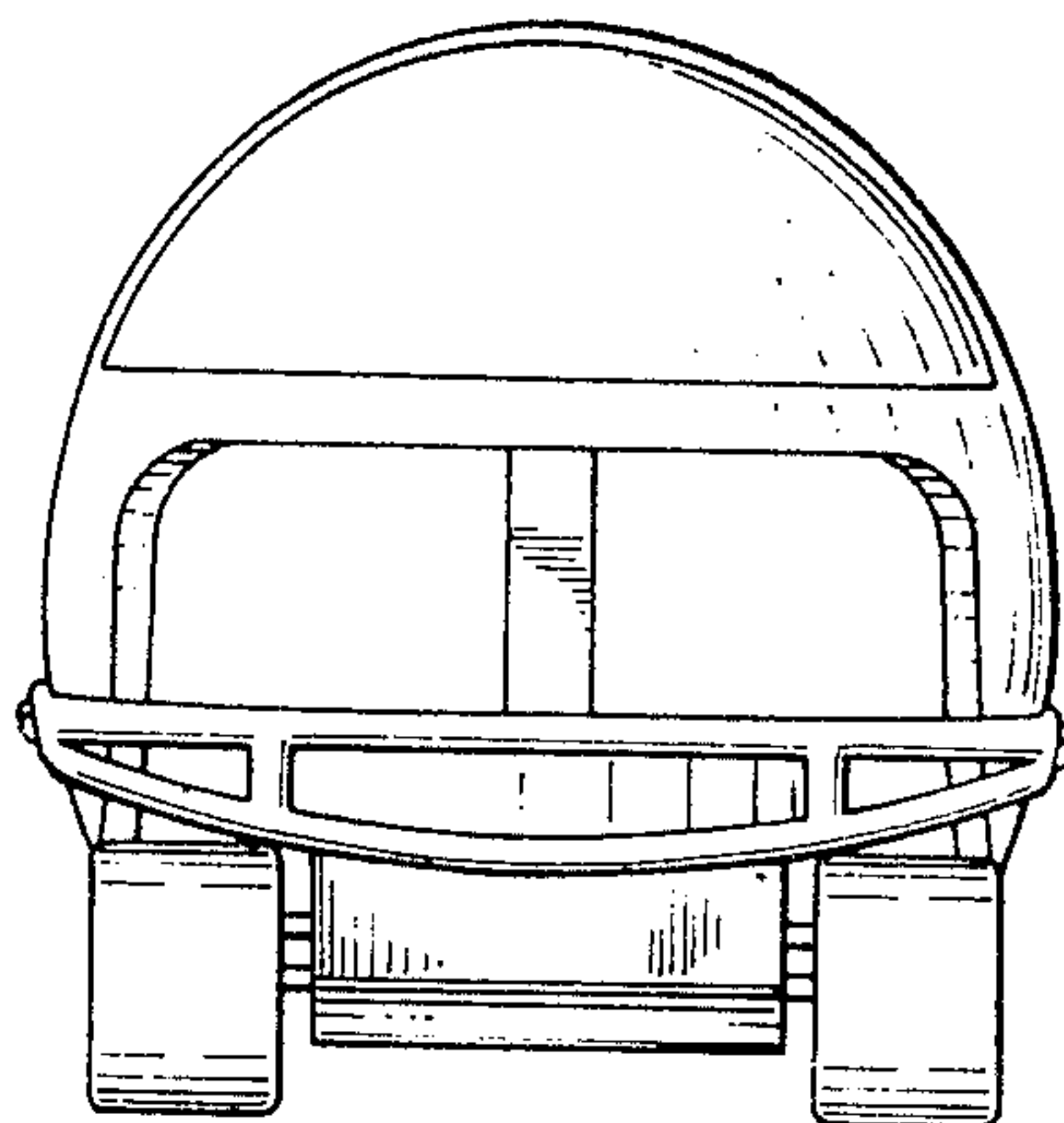

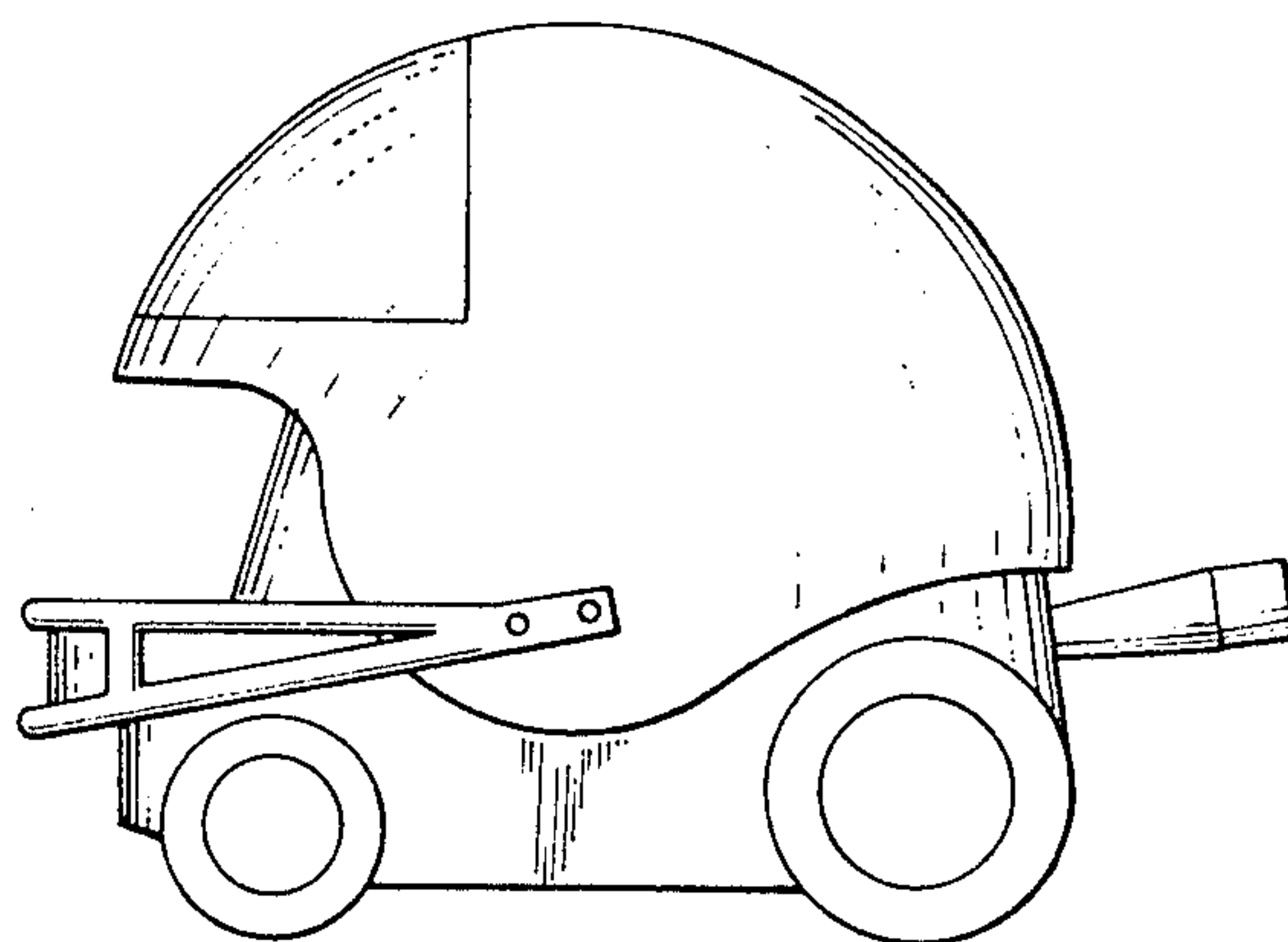

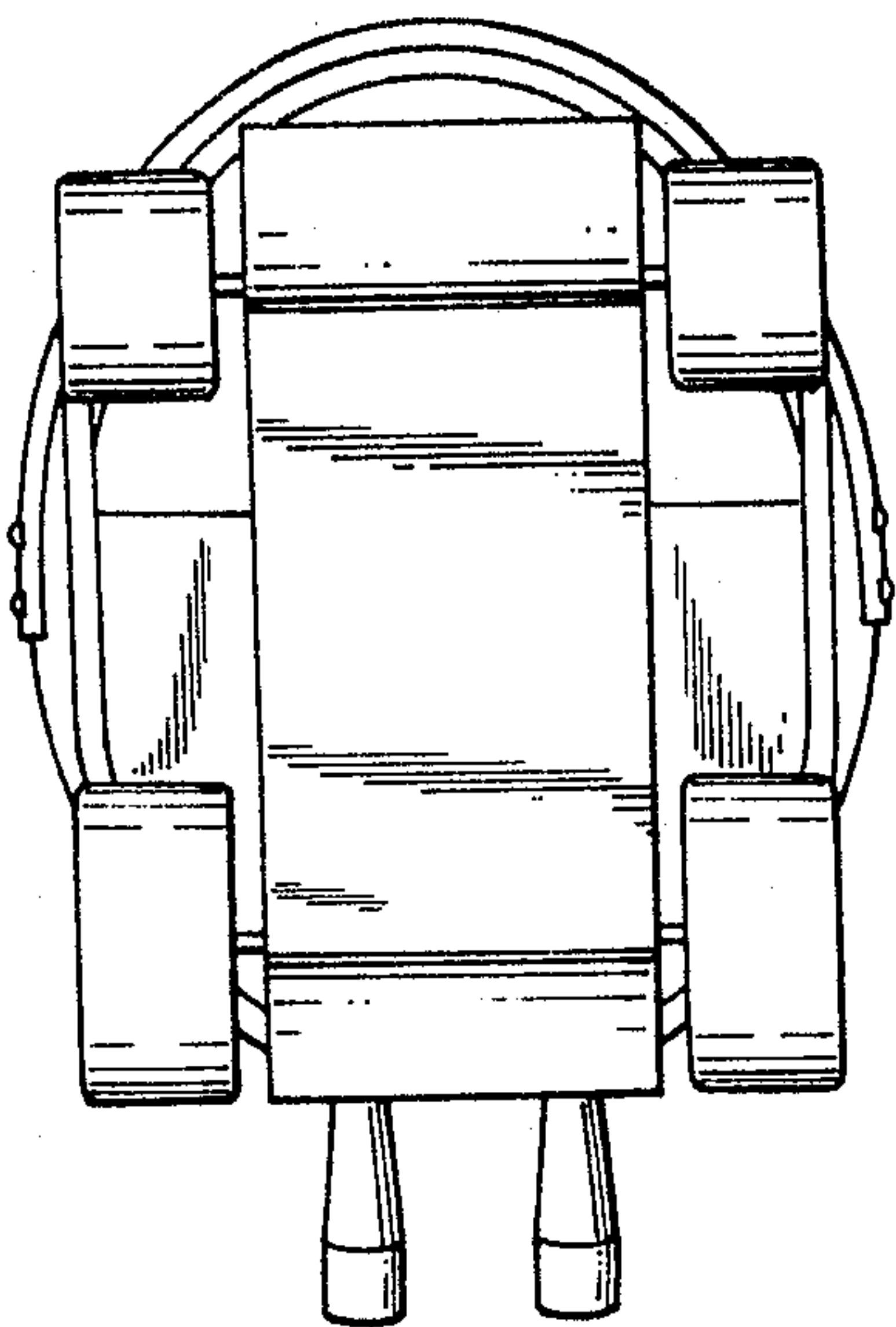

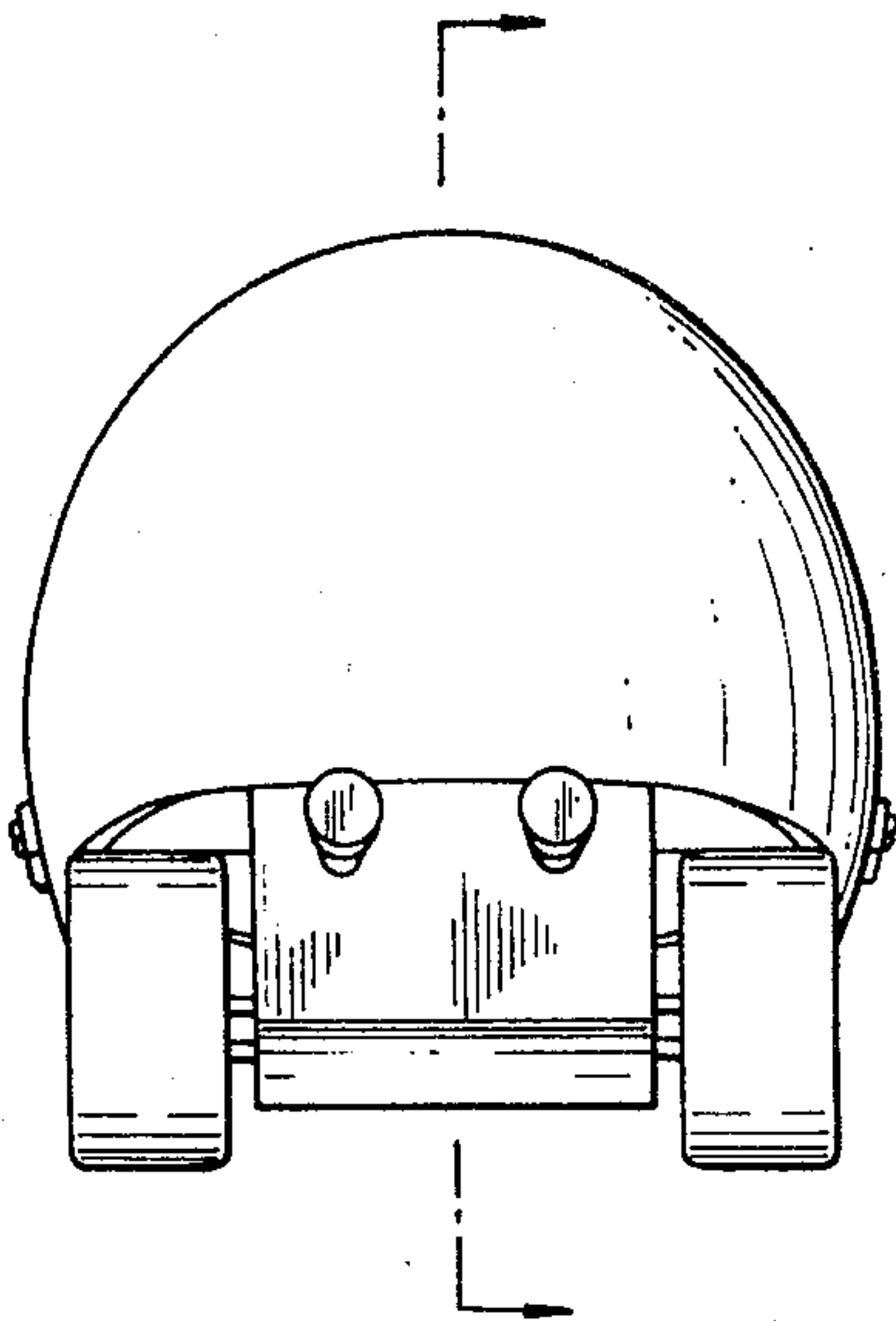
