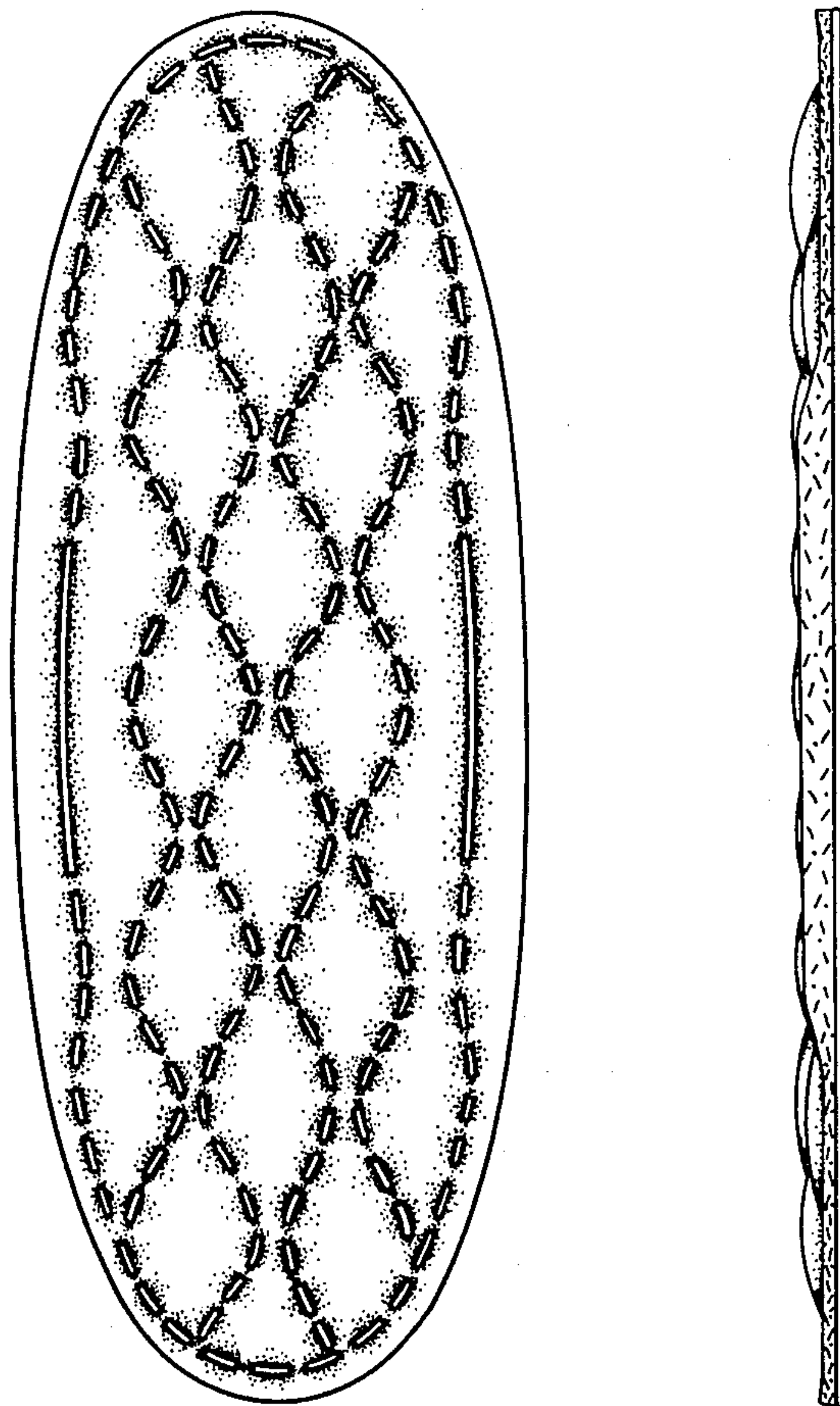

FIG. 4 is a front end elevational view thereof.



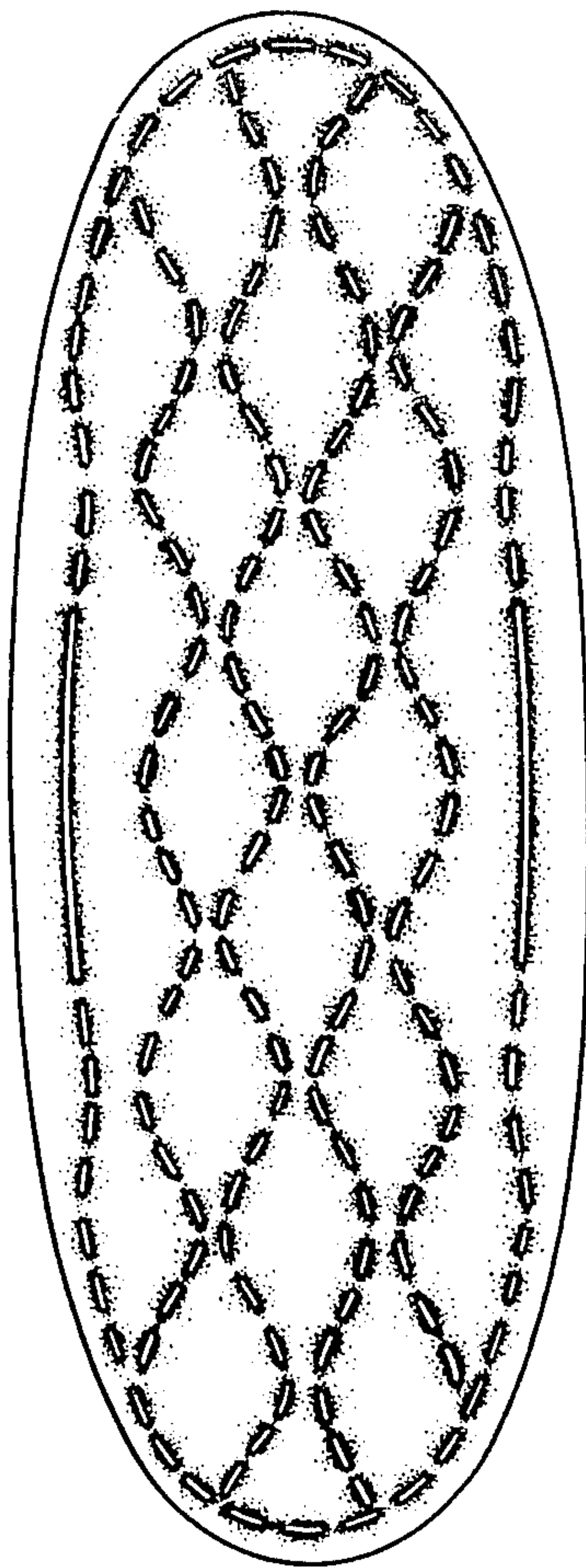

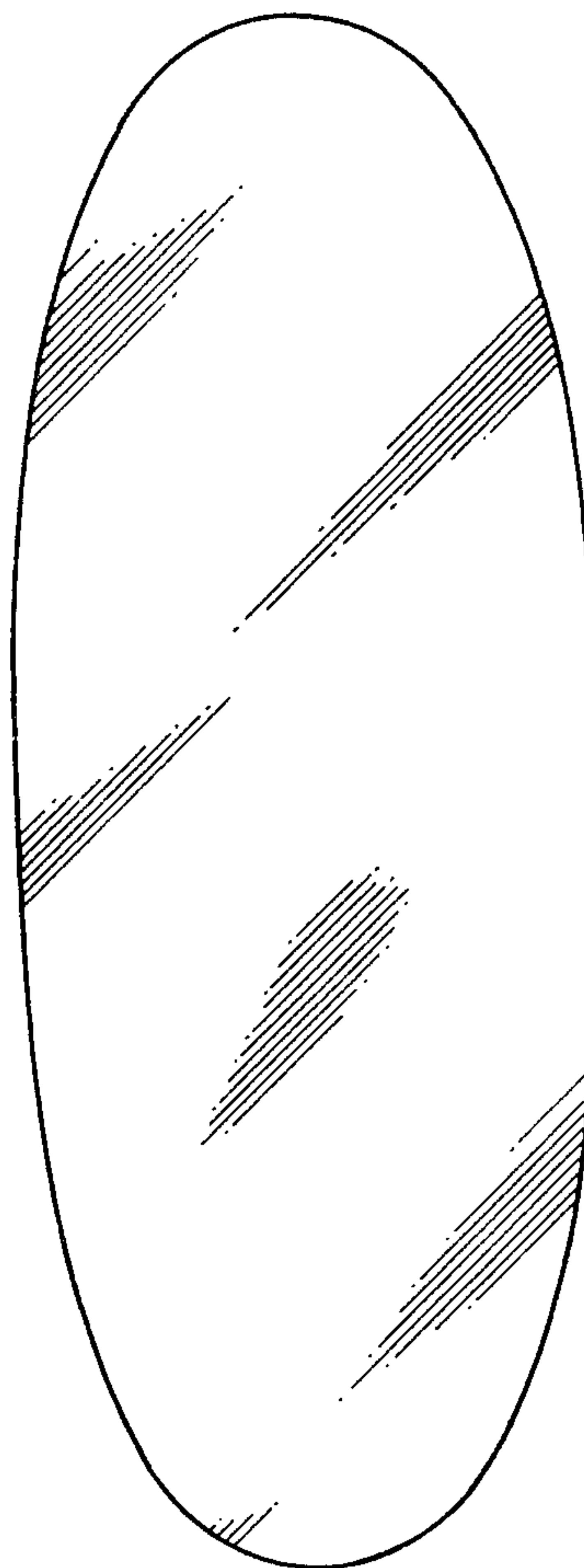

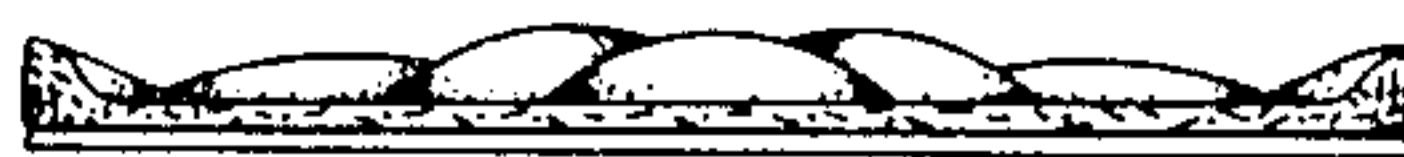
