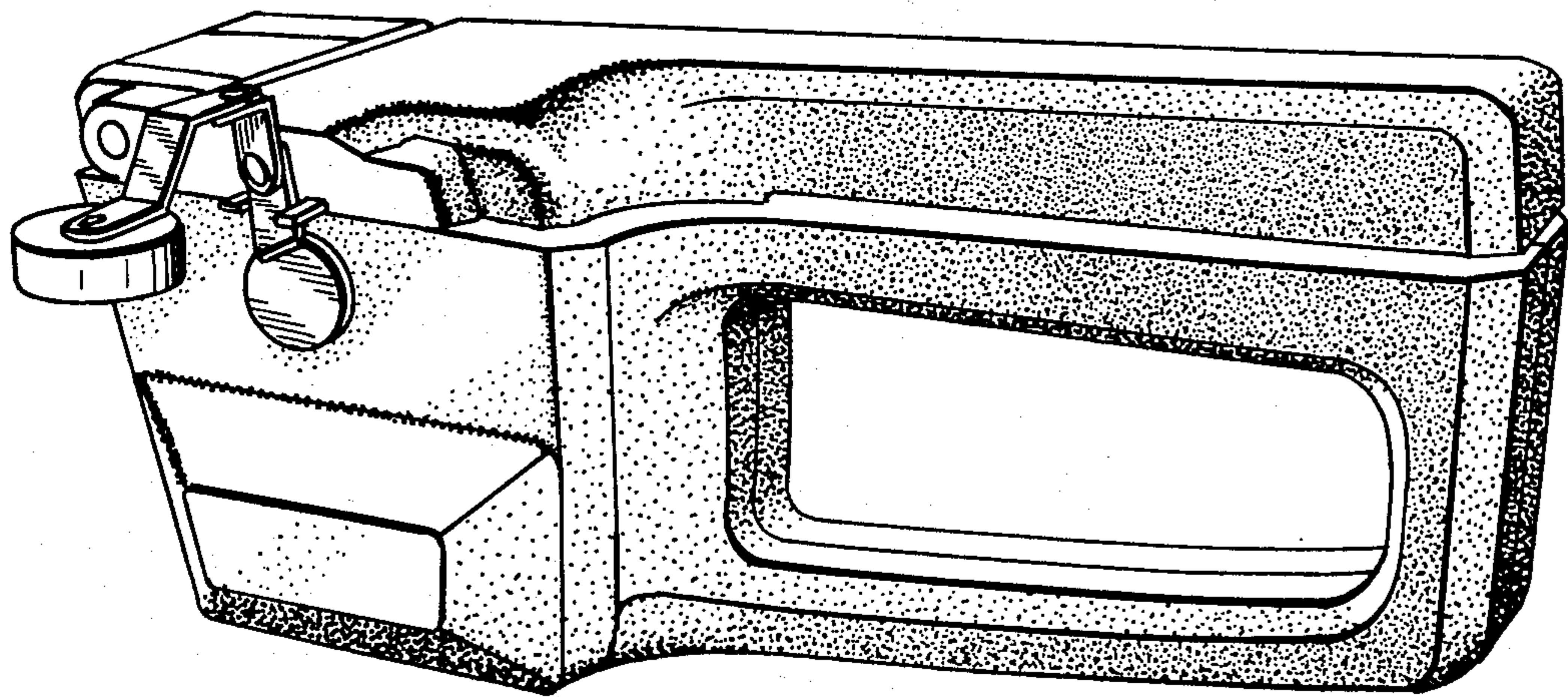

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hand held can opener, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a hand held can opener showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right end elevation thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right end elevation of FIG. 2;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of the can opener with the addition of magnetic can holding element;
FIG. 9 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 10 is a right end elevation thereof;
FIG. 11 is a rear elevation thereof;
FIG. 12 is a left end elevation of FIG. 9;
FIG. 13 is a top plan view of the can opener illustrated in FIG. 8; and
FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The magnetic can holder element has been omitted in FIGS. 1 to 7 for ease of illustration.



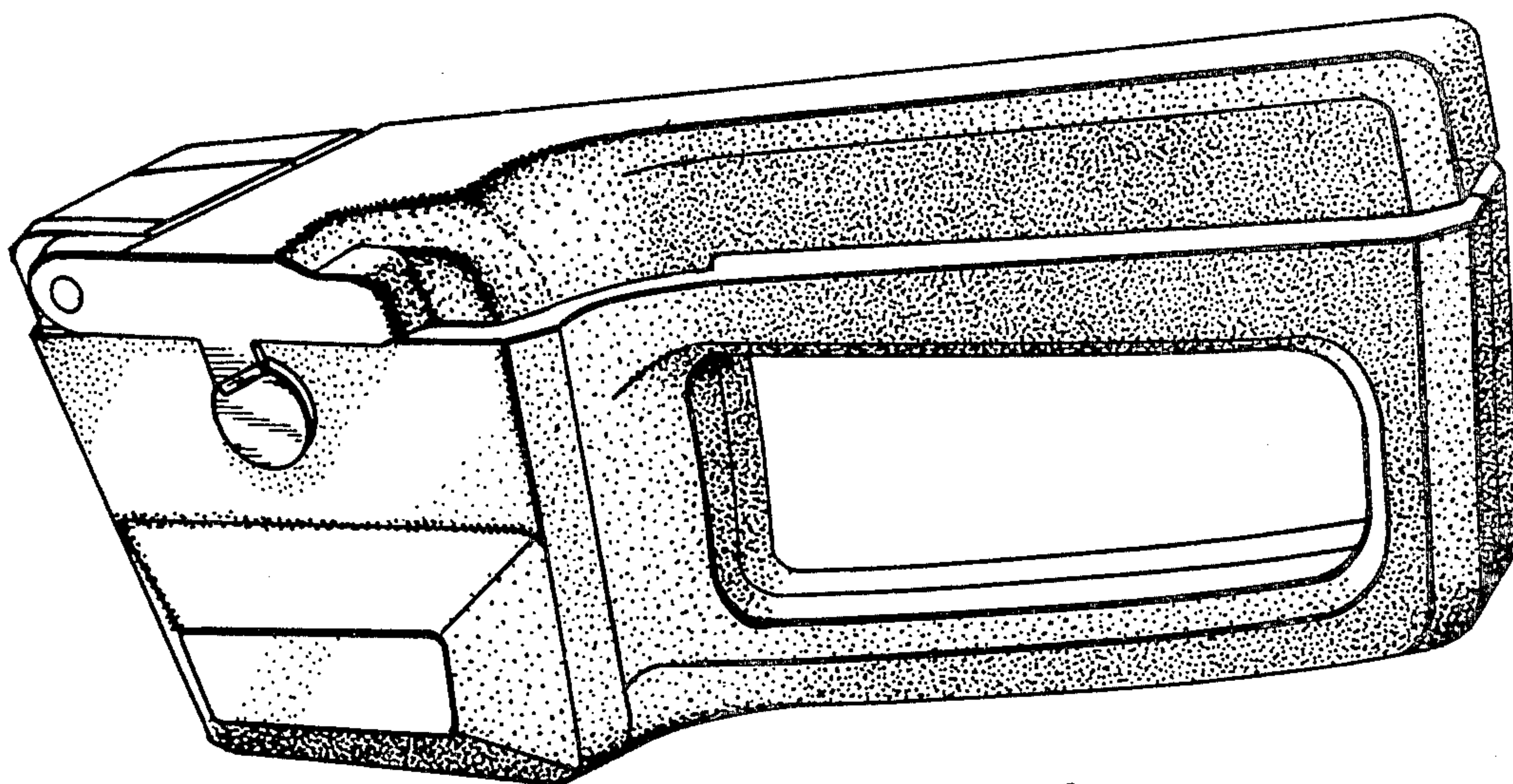

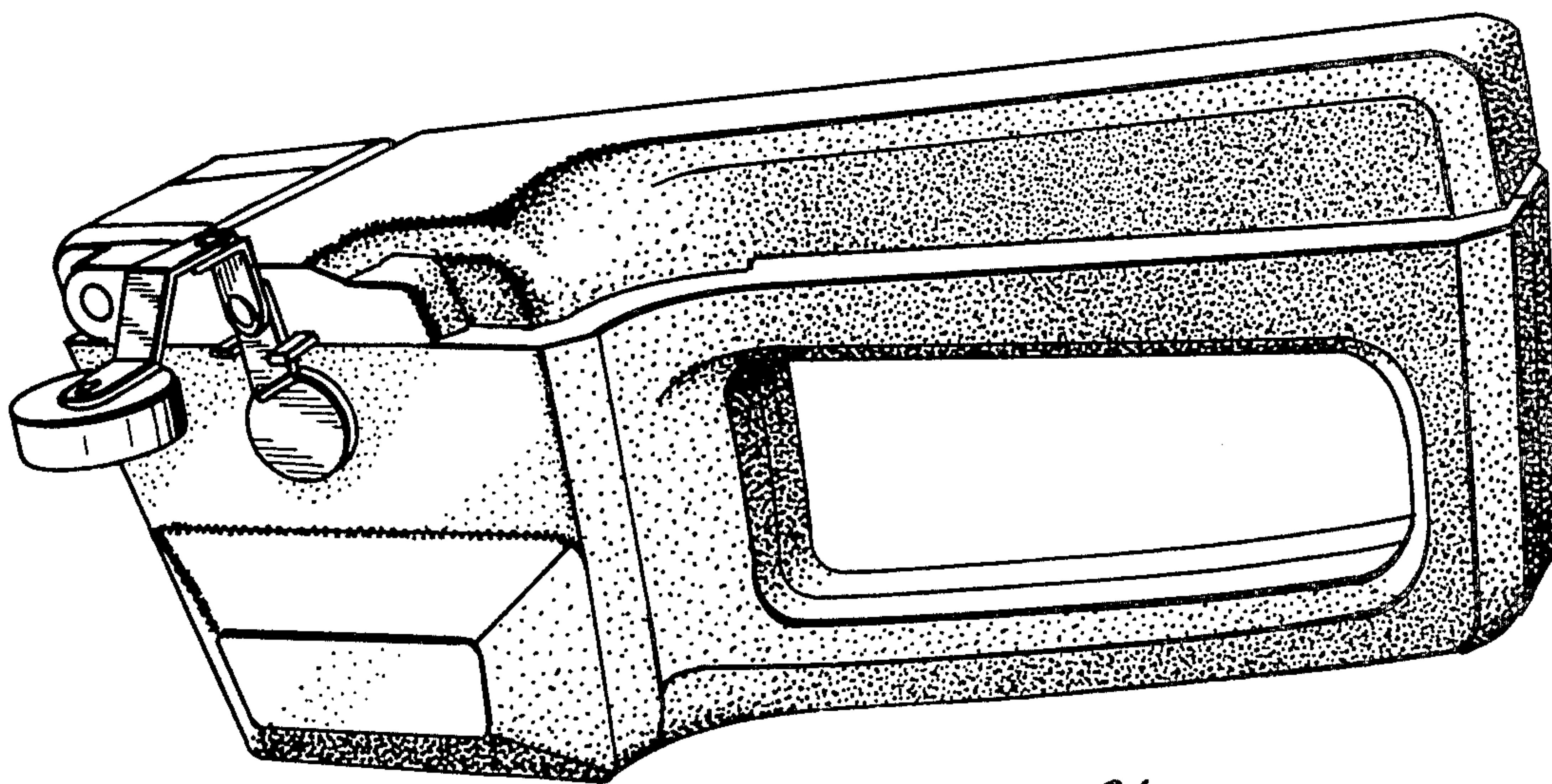

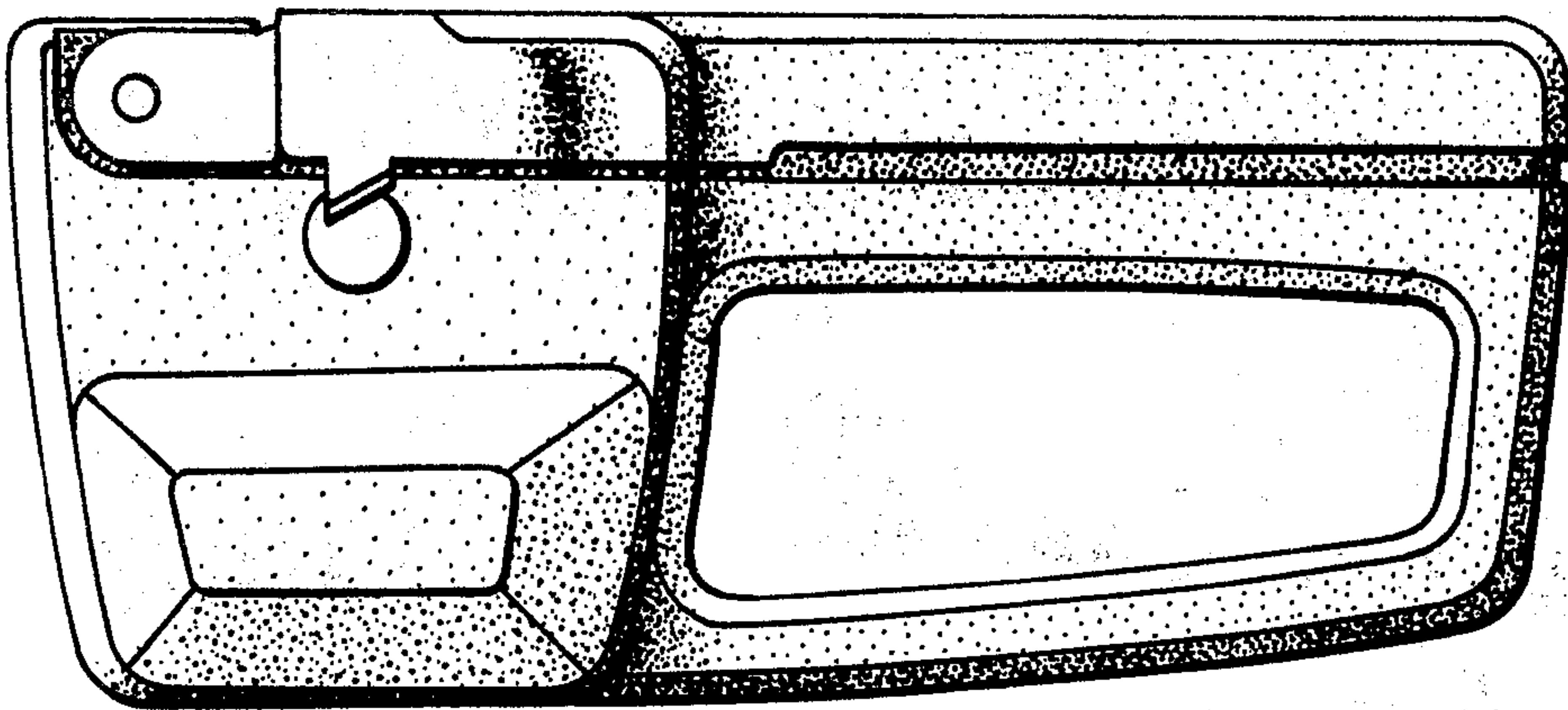

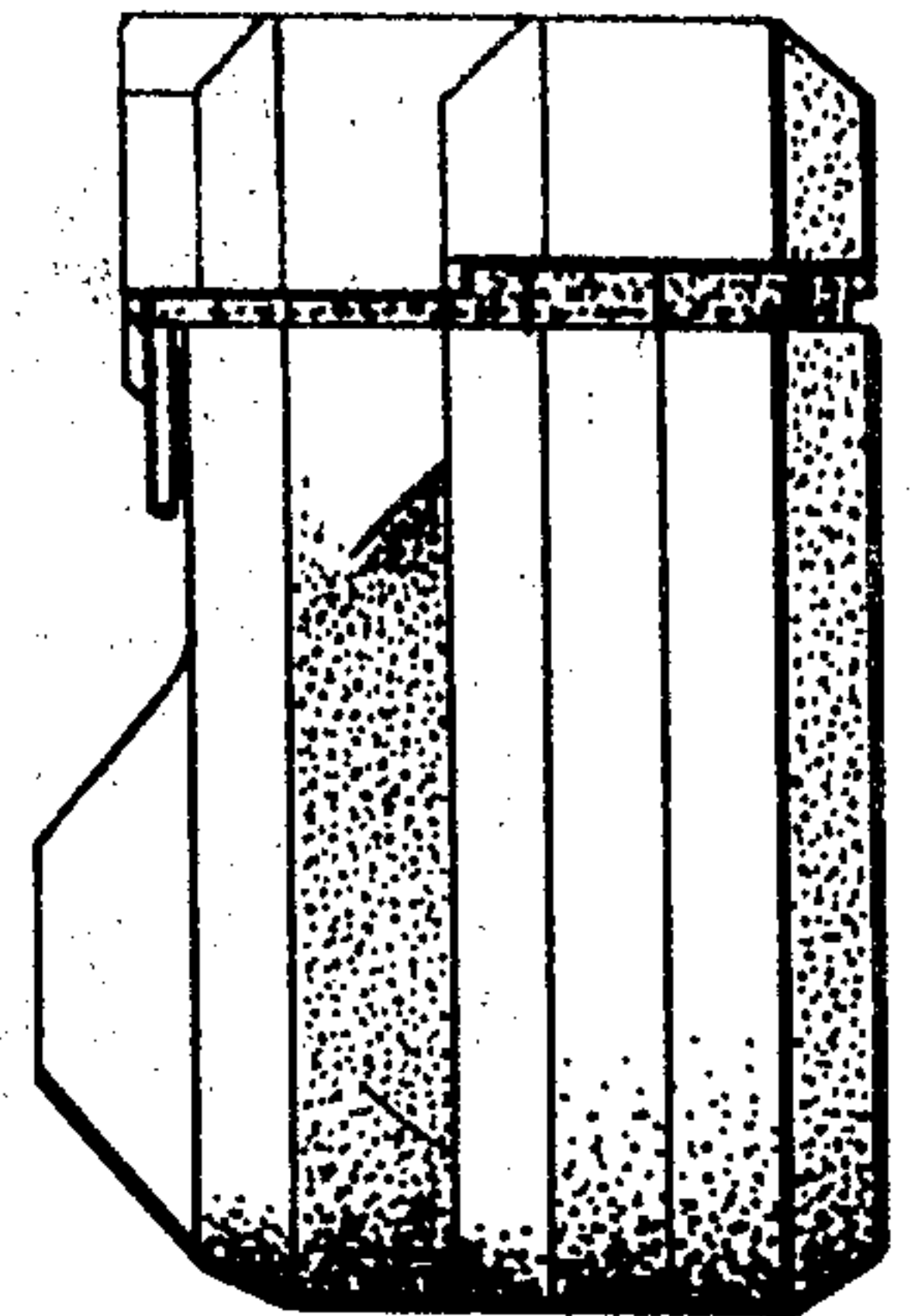

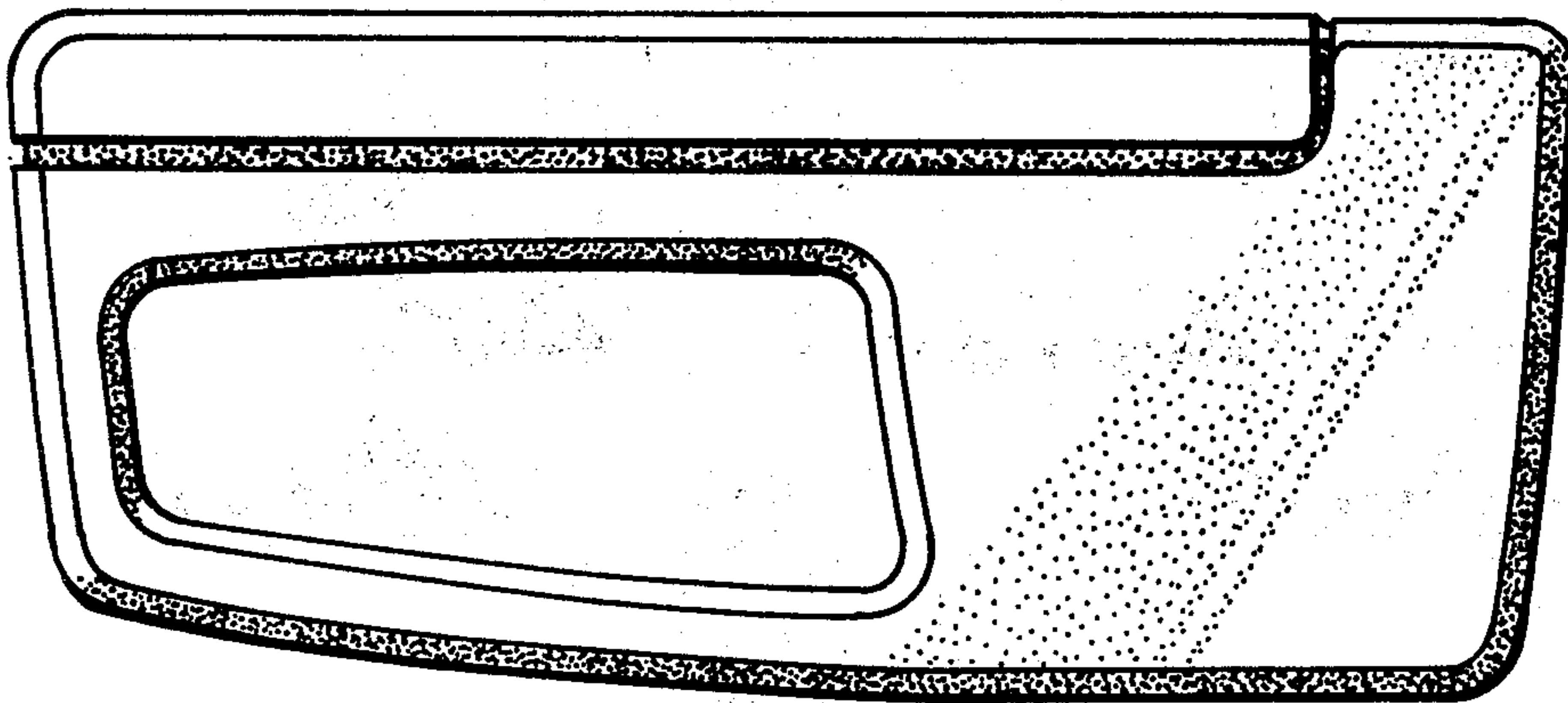

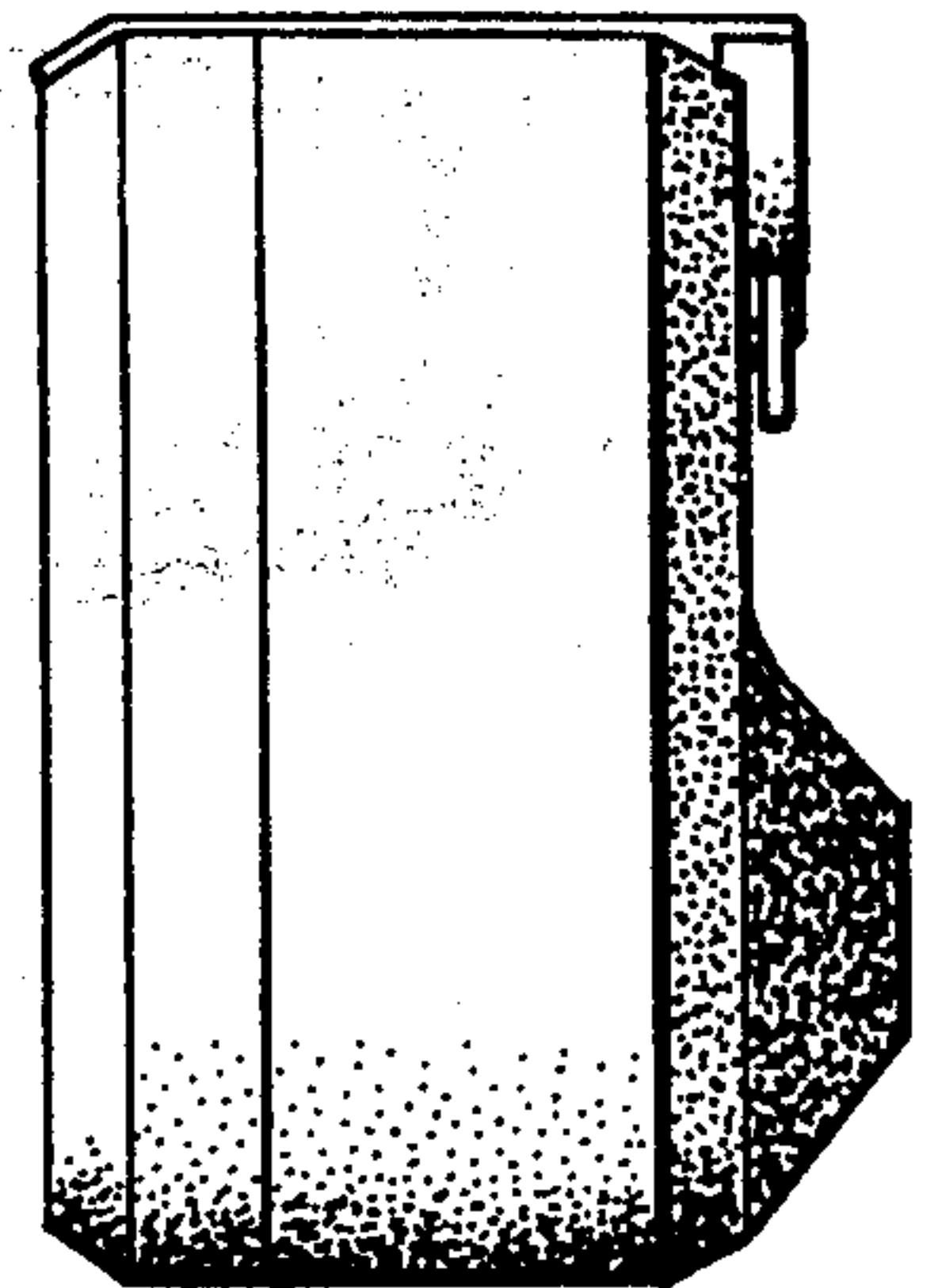

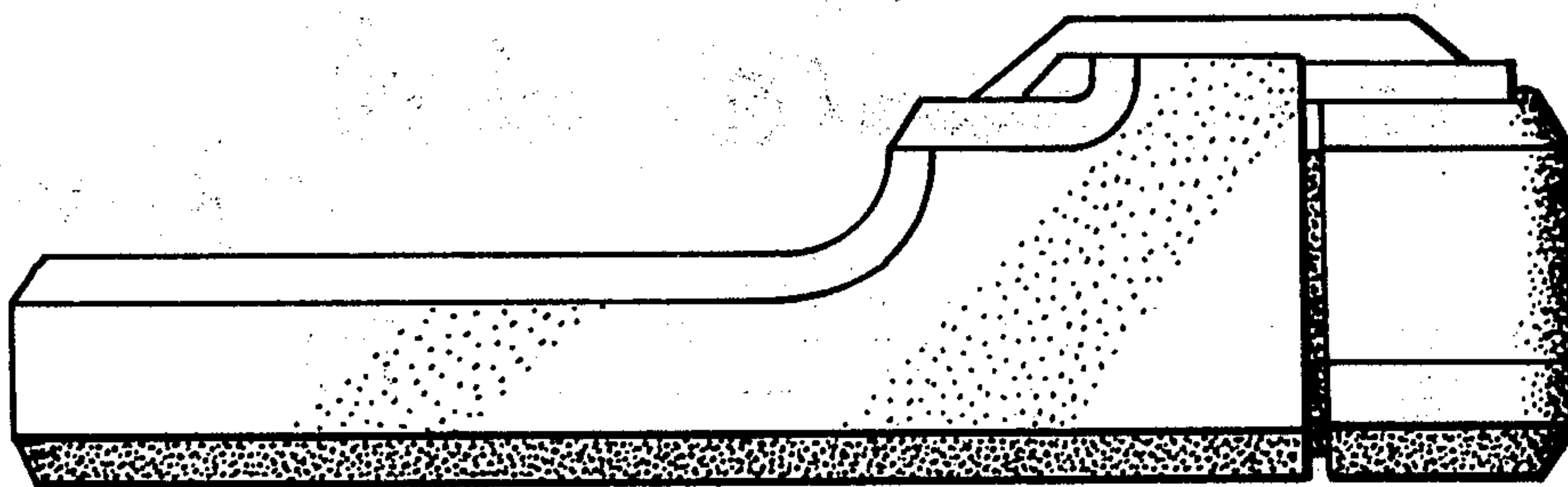

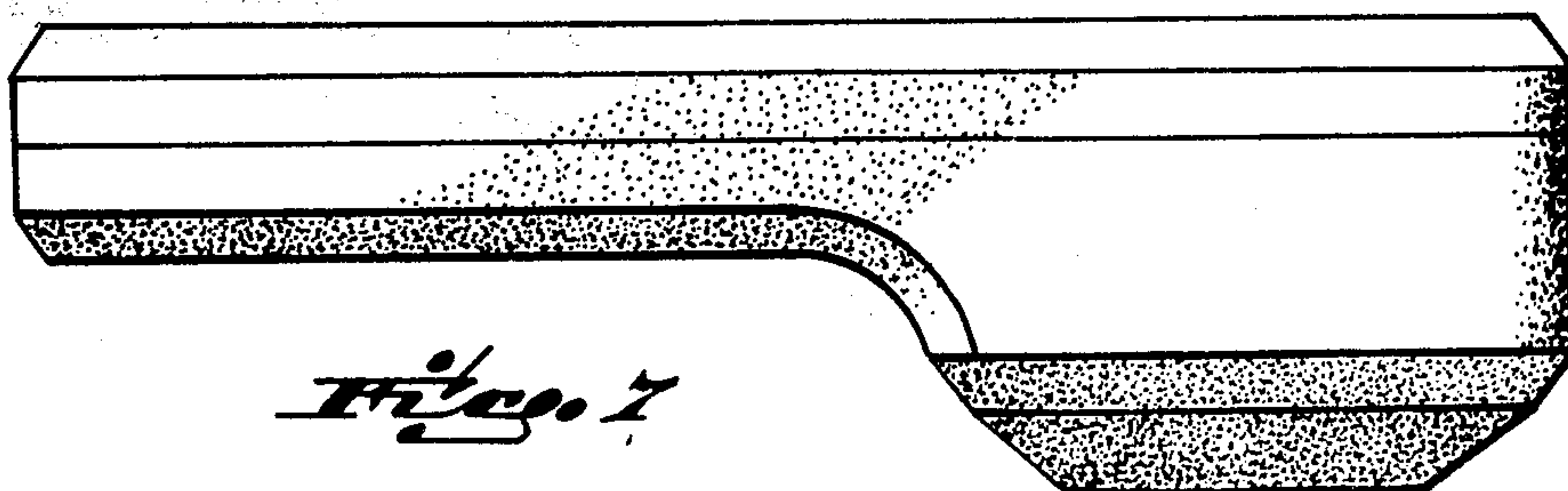

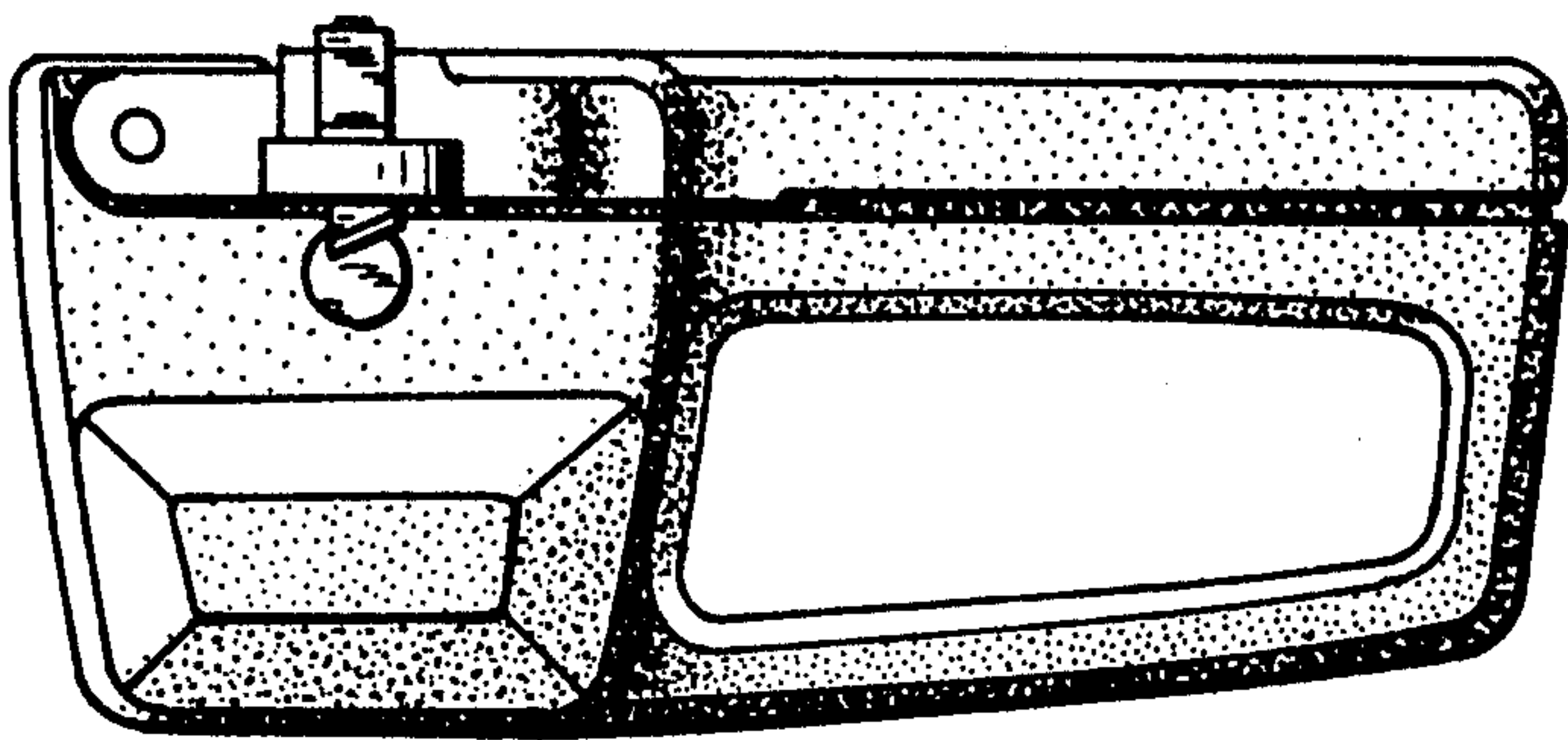

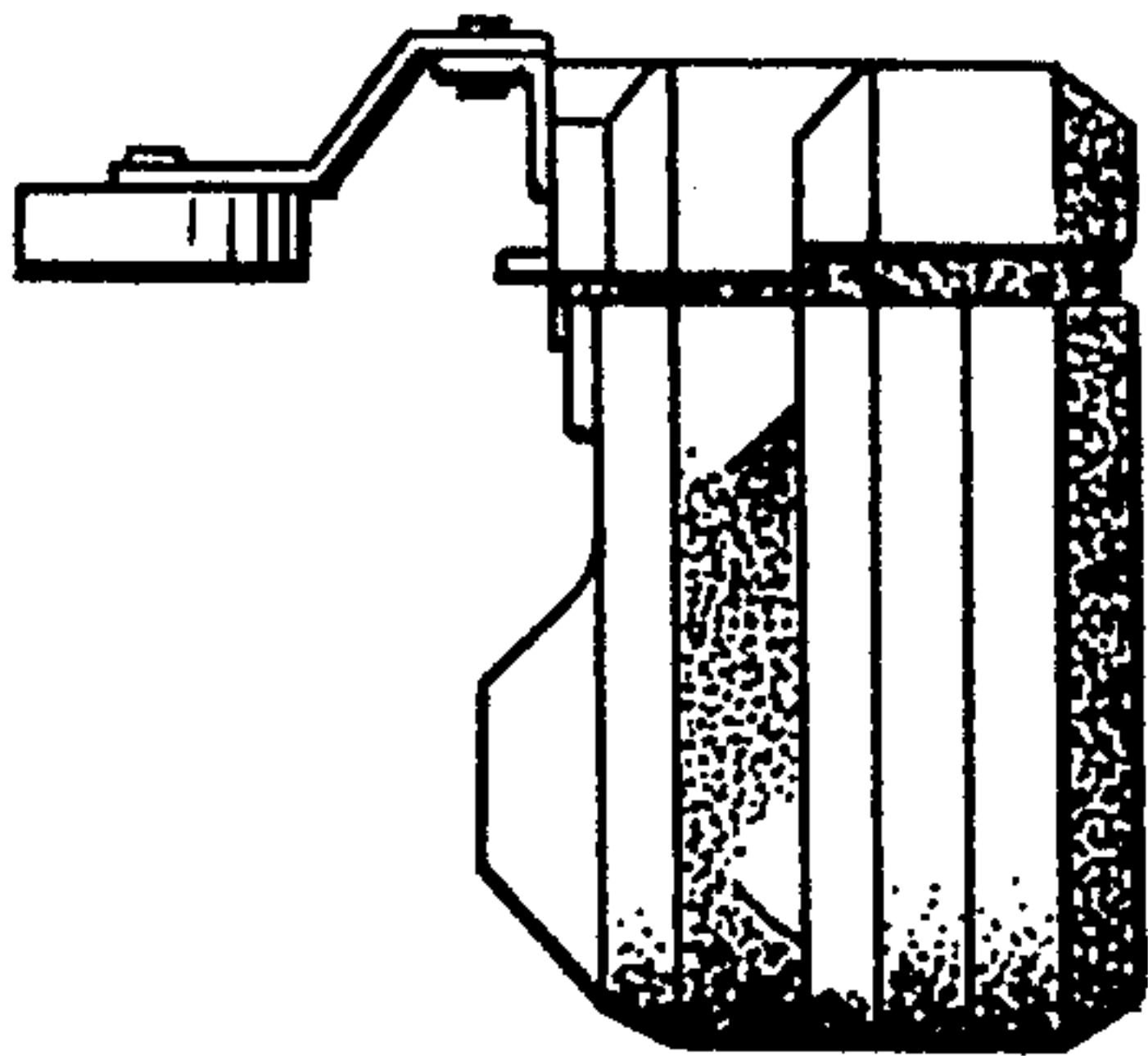

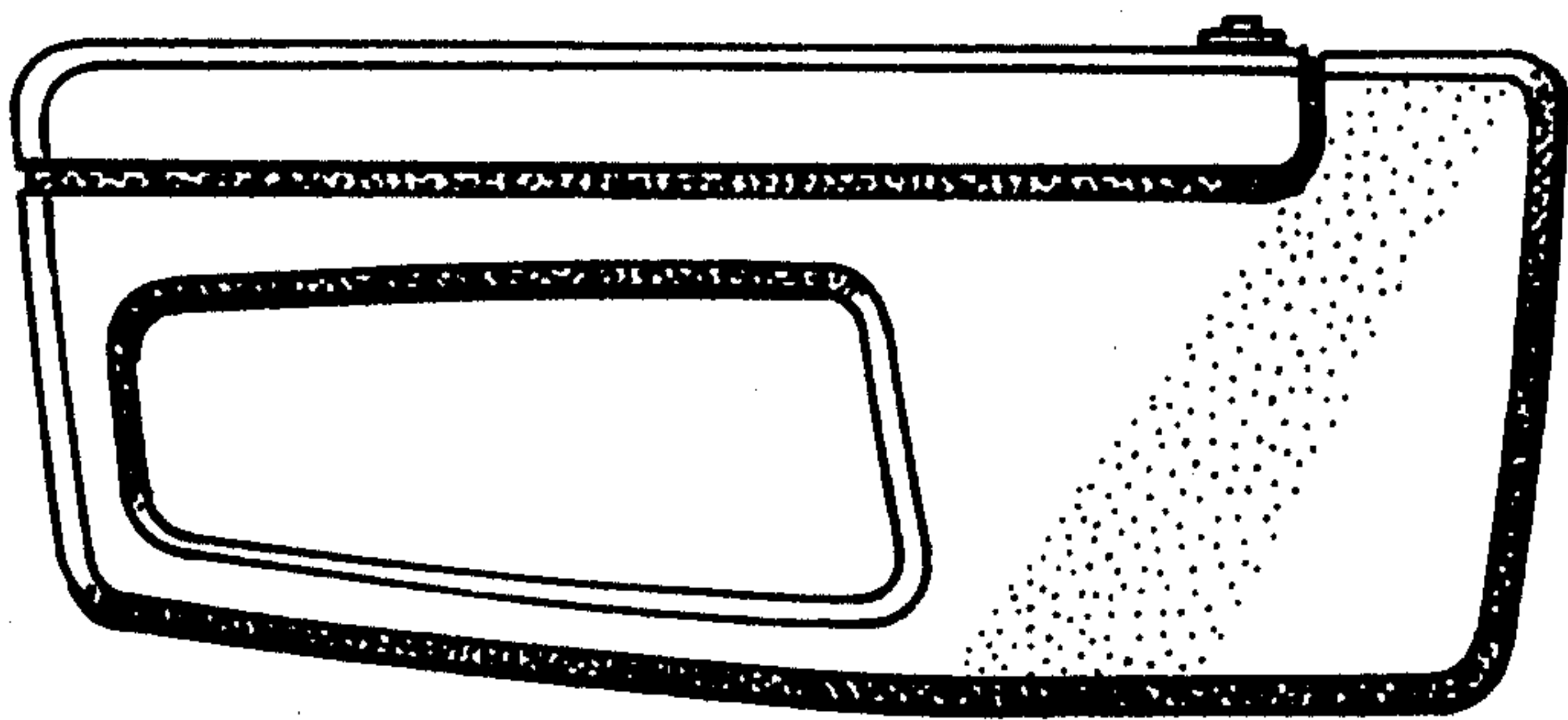

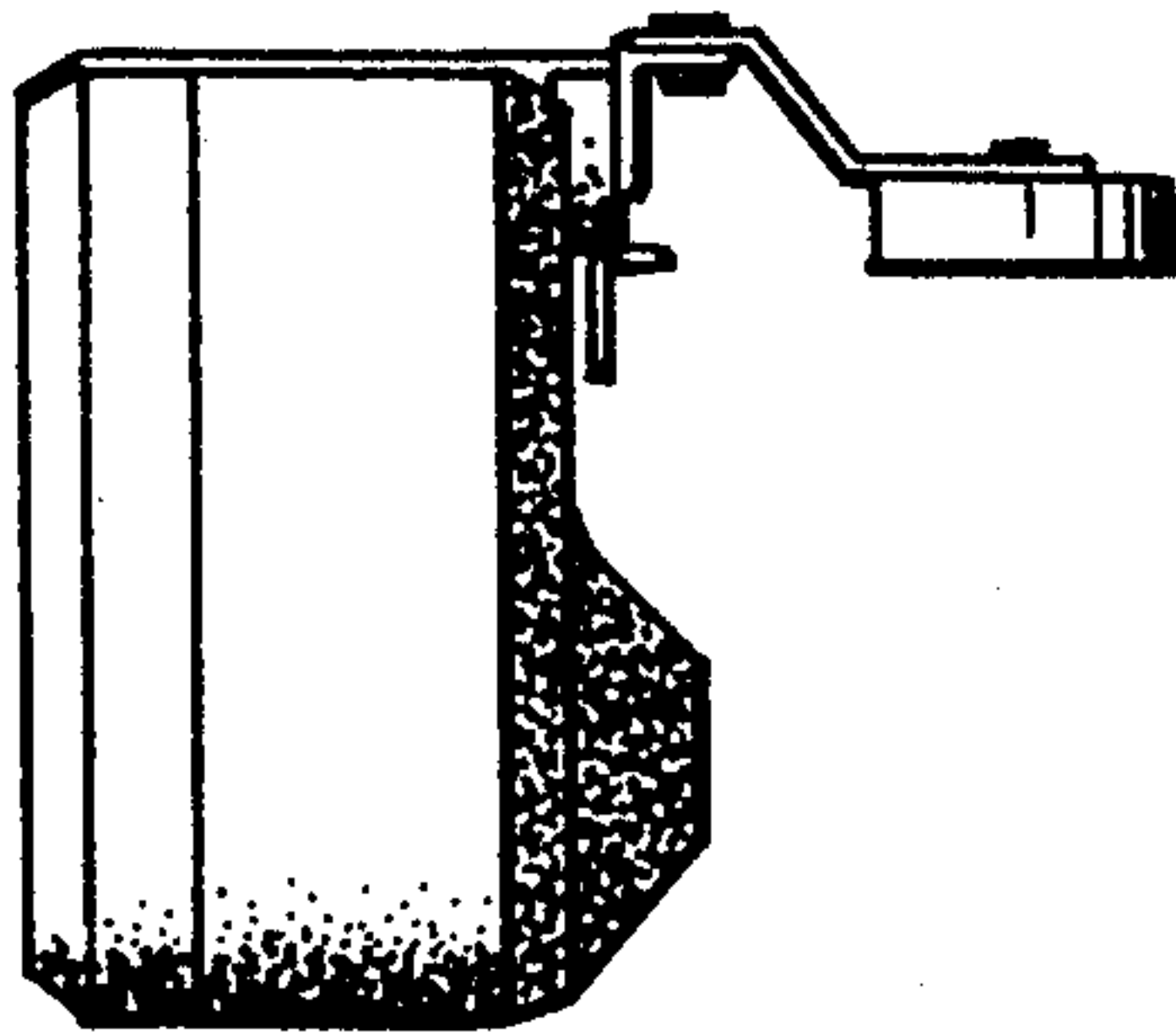

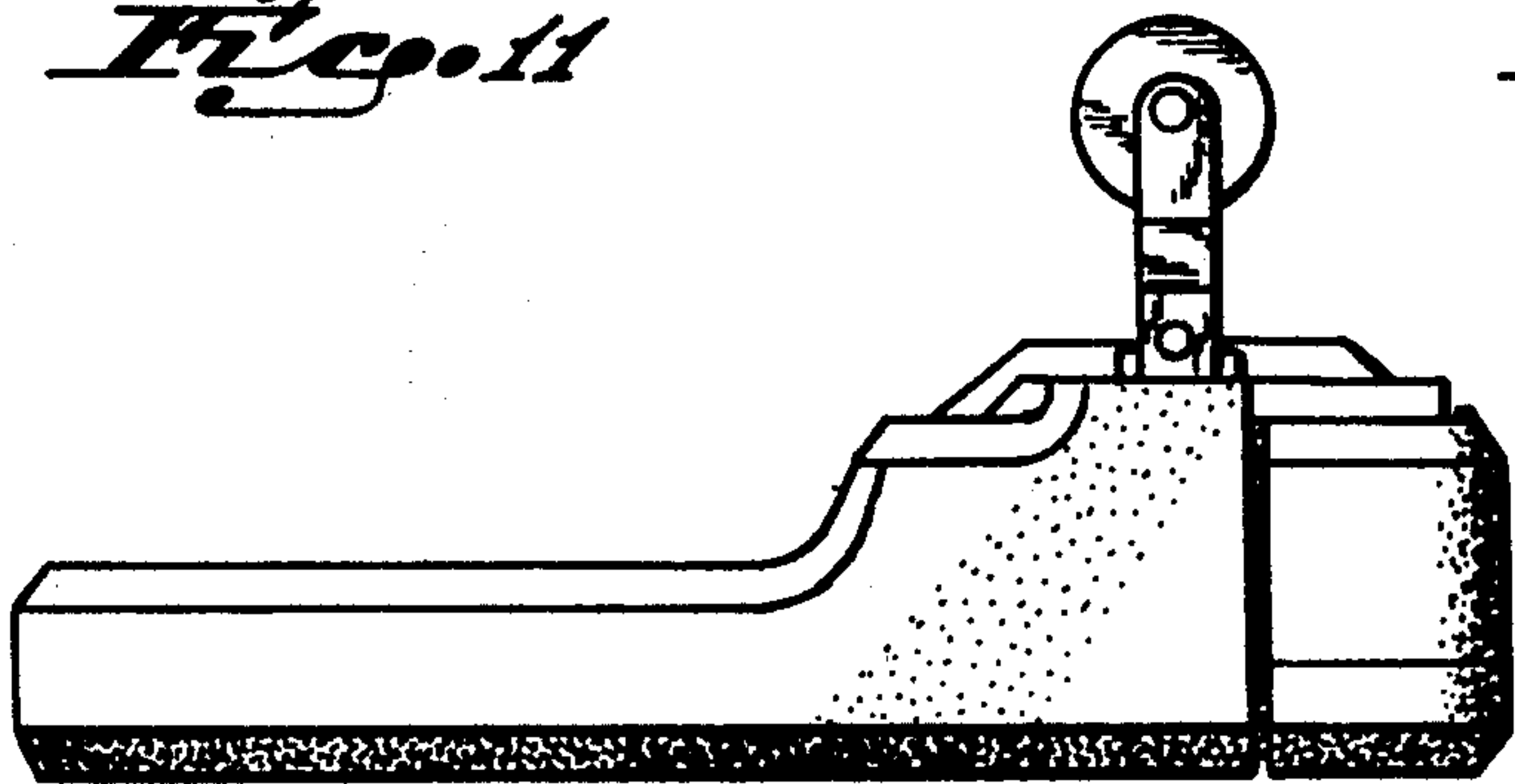

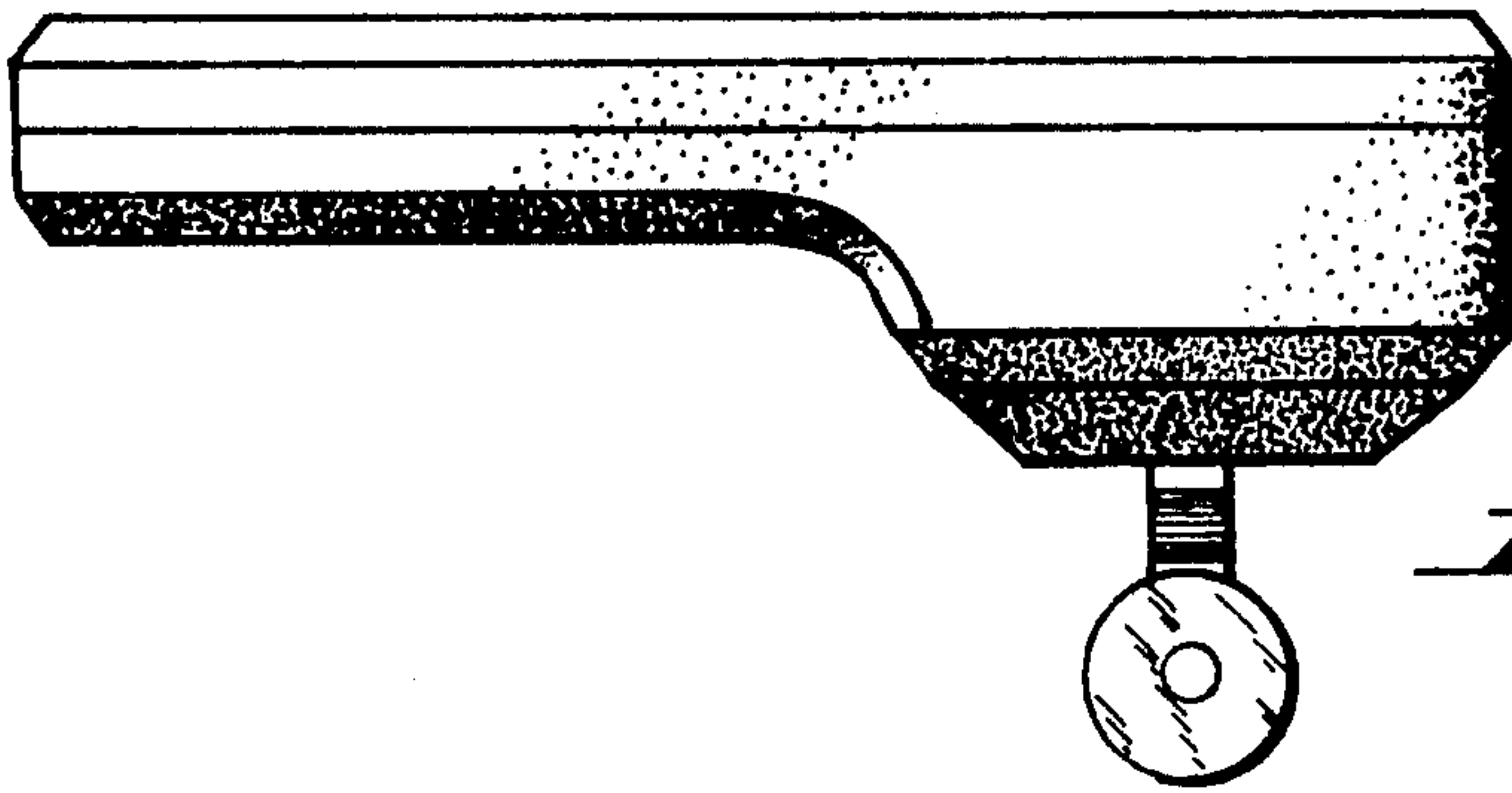
