[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a container for medicinals, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a container for medicinals showing our new design; FIG. 2 is an elevational view; FIG. 3 is an elevational view showing the side opposite that seen in FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a top plan view; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 6 is an elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 3; and FIG. 7 is a perspective view showing a modified form of our new design.

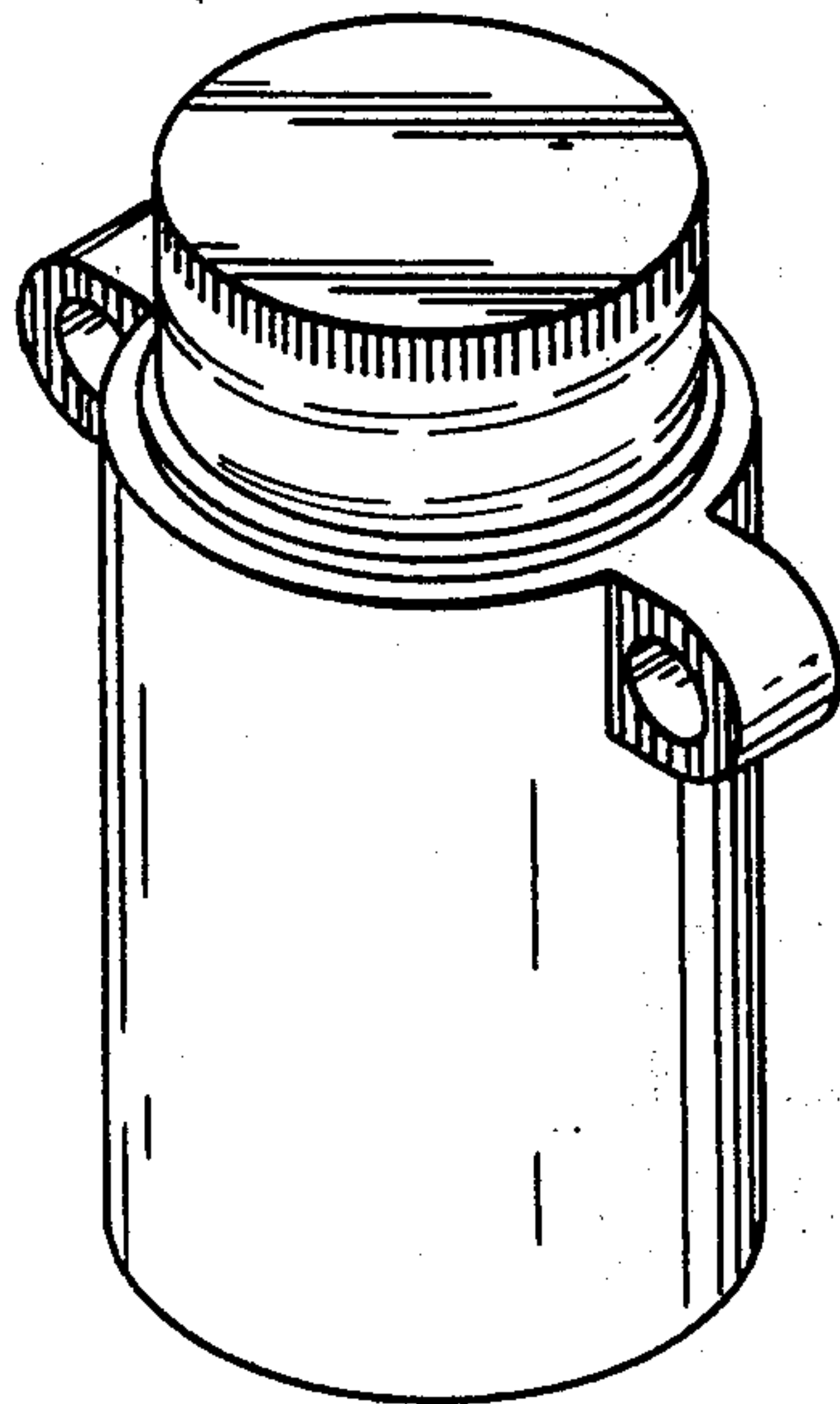

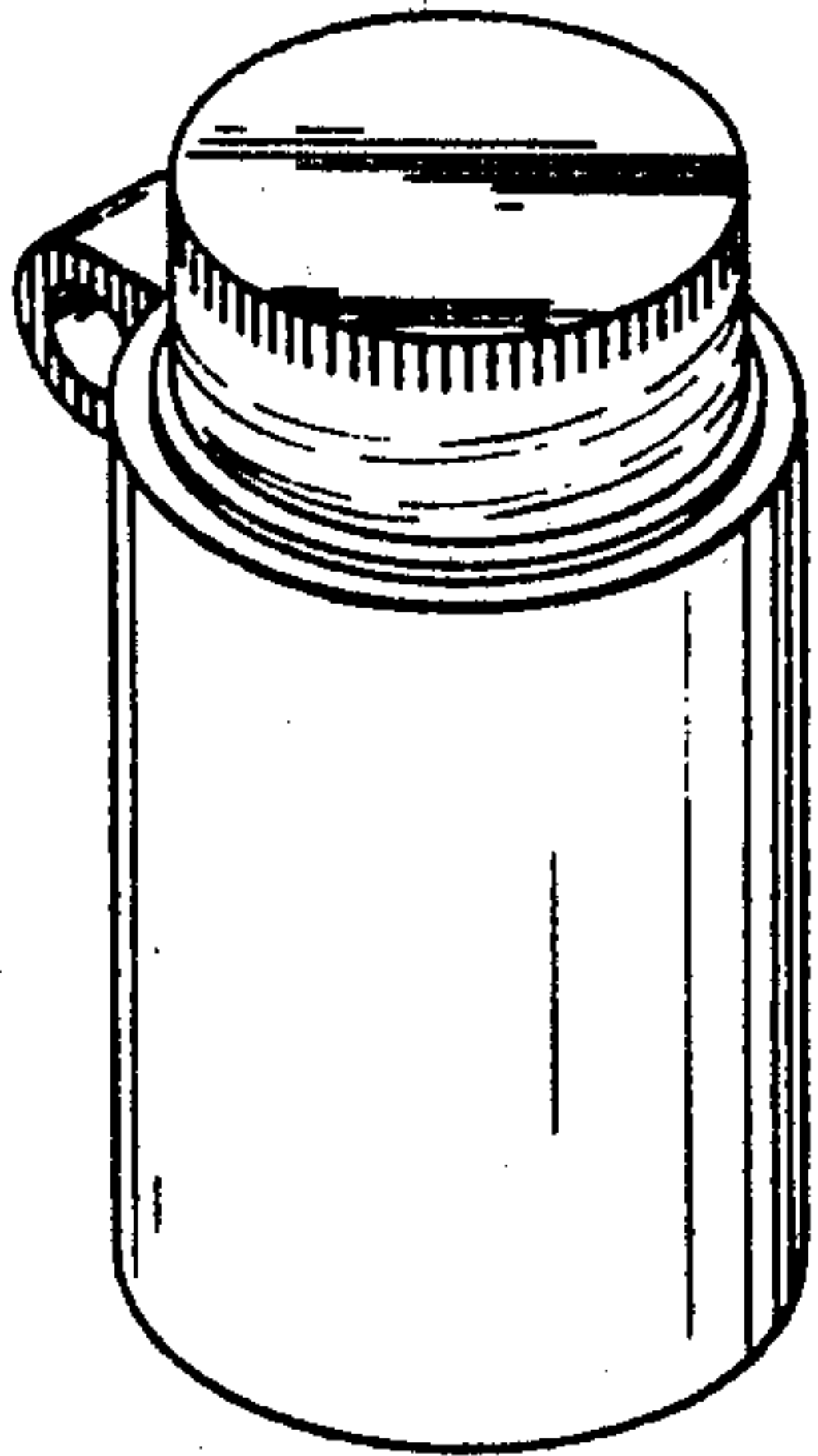

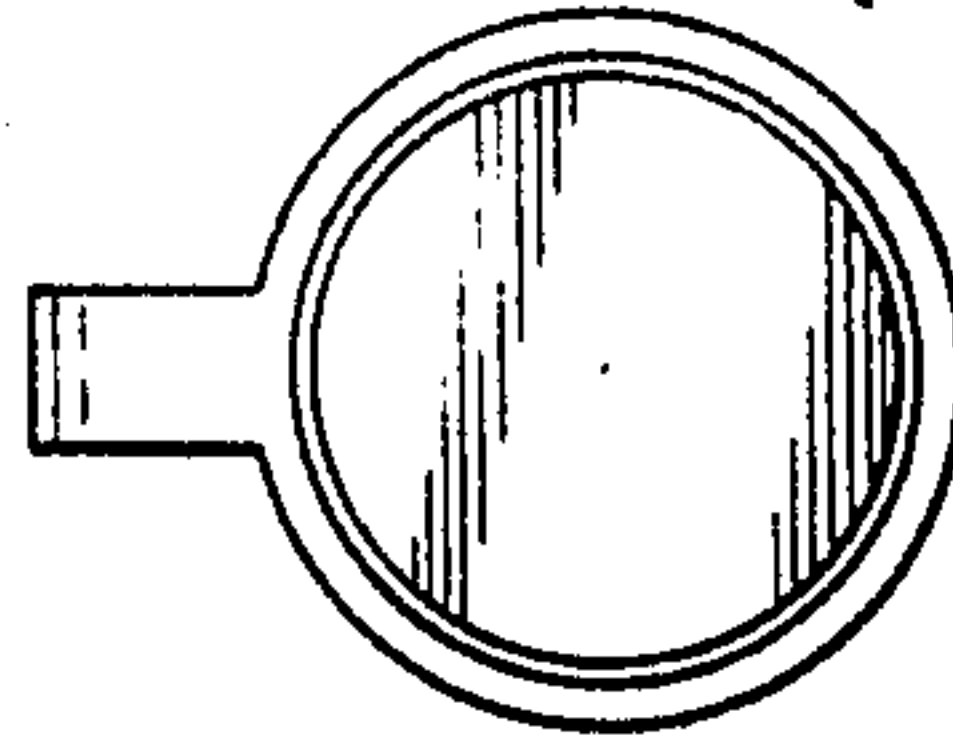

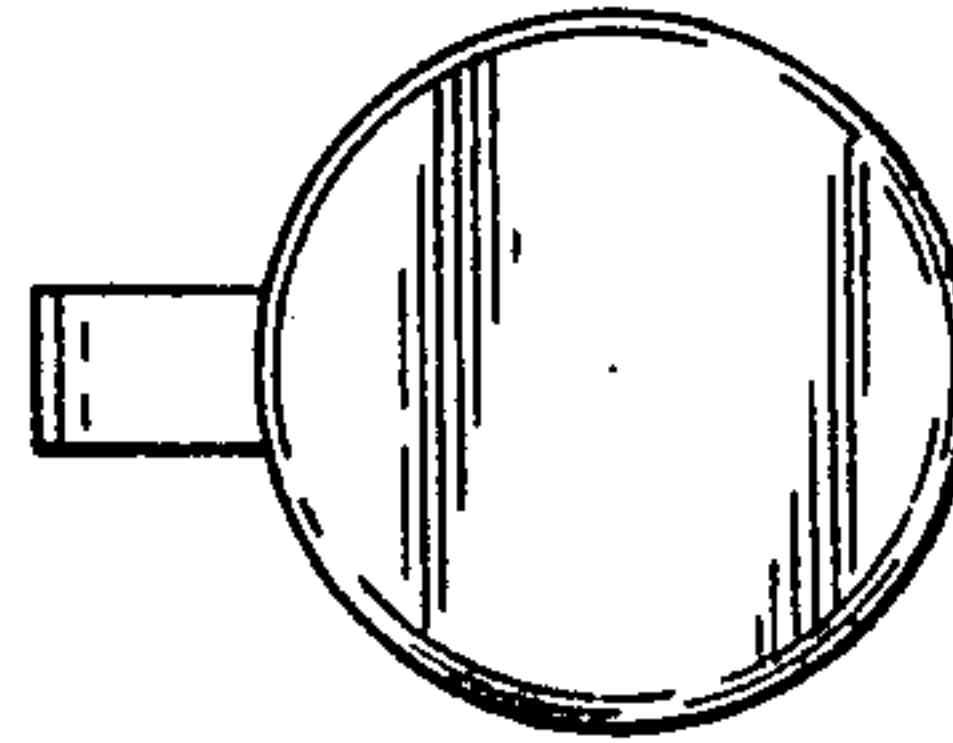

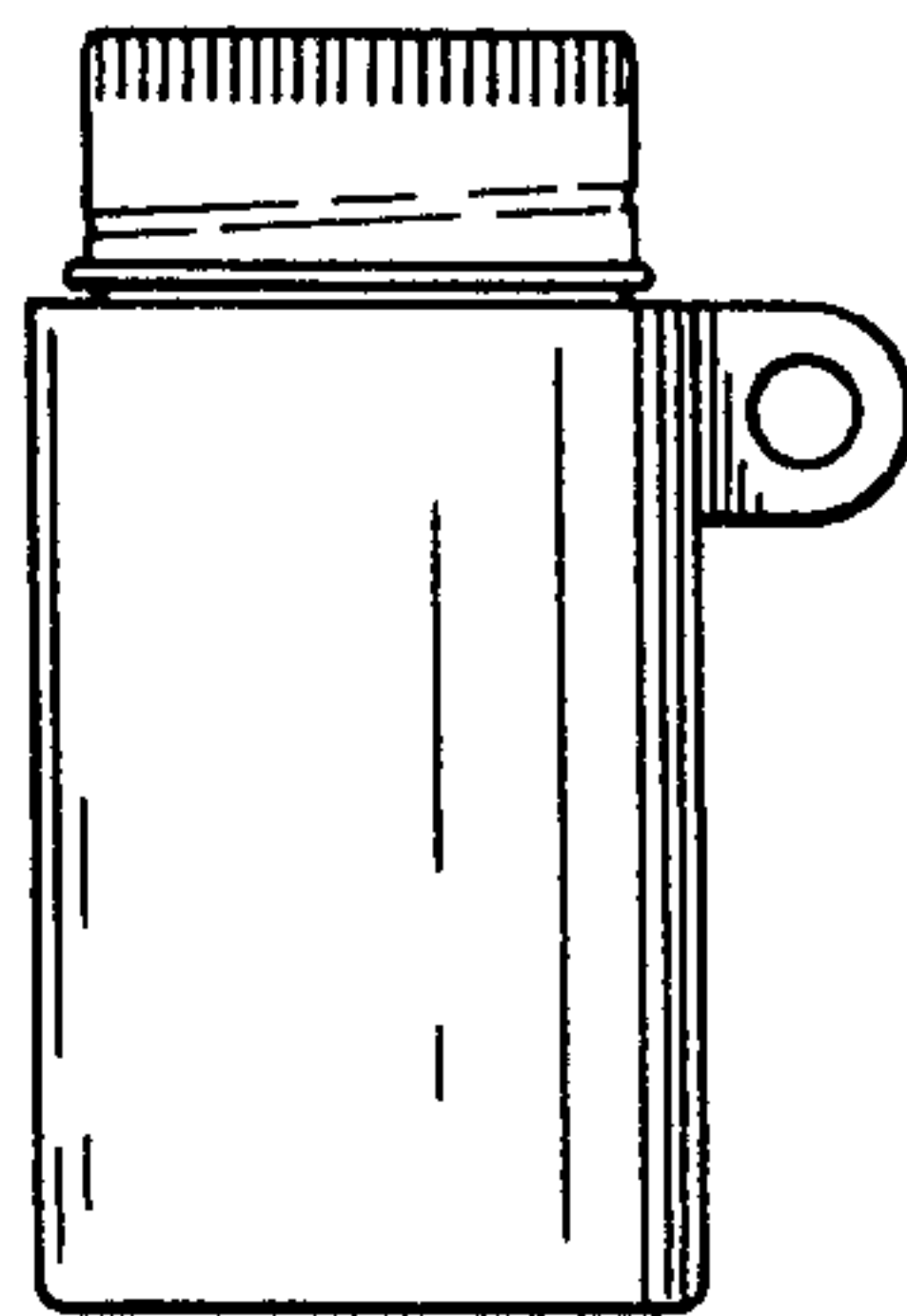

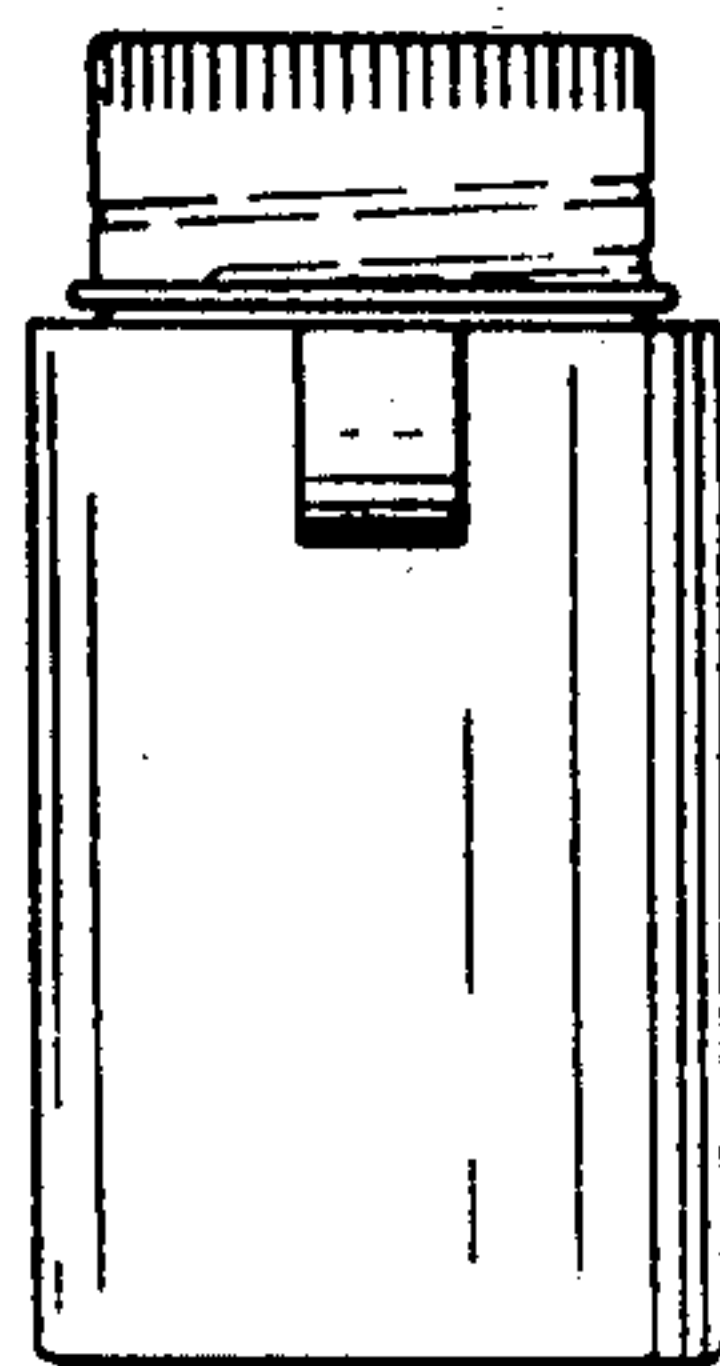
