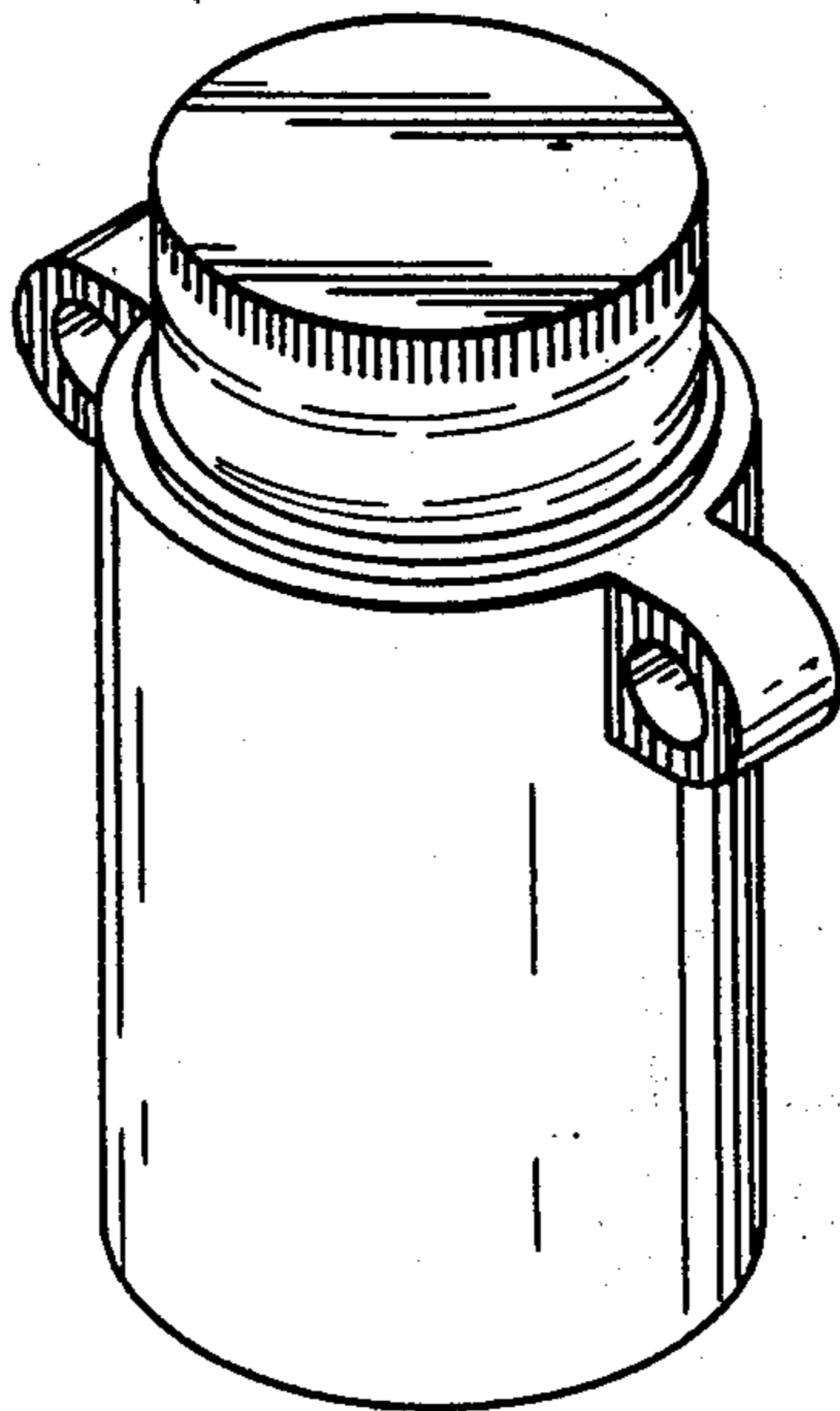

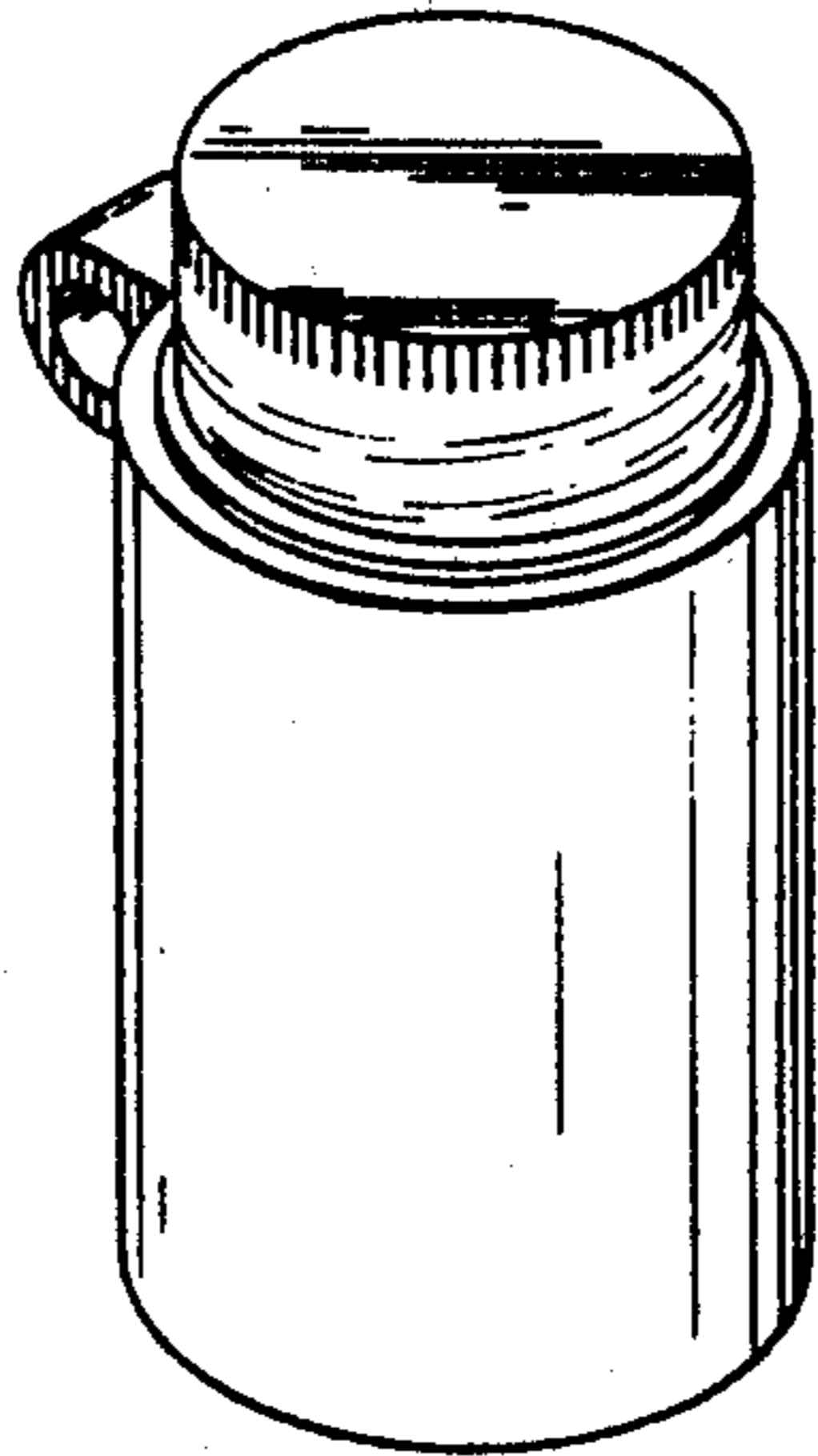
The ornamental design for a container for medicinals, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

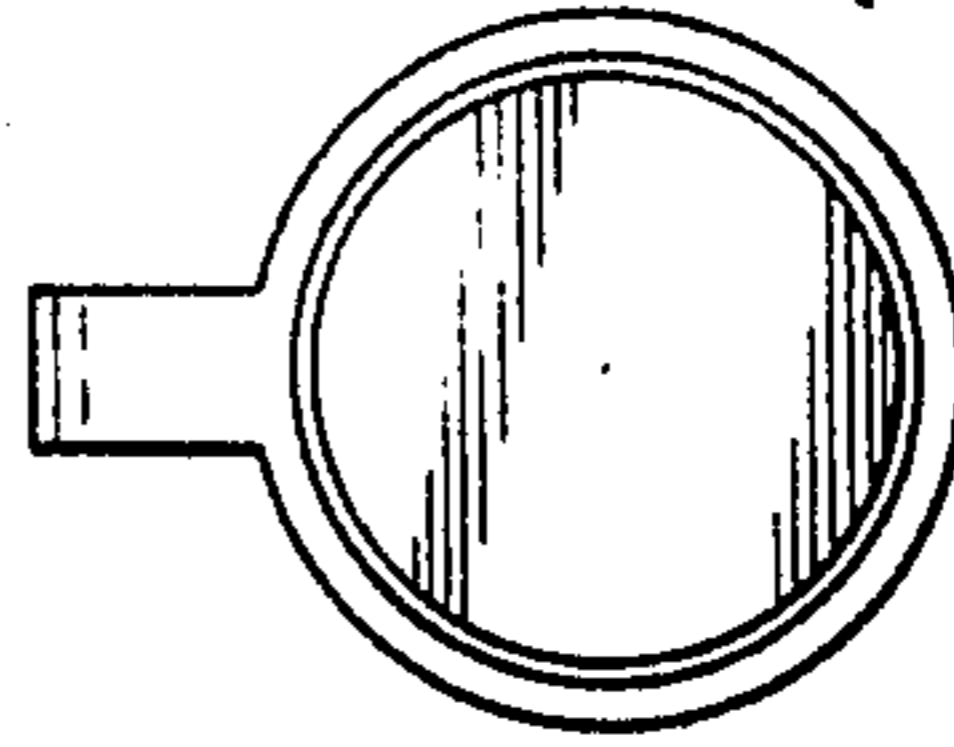

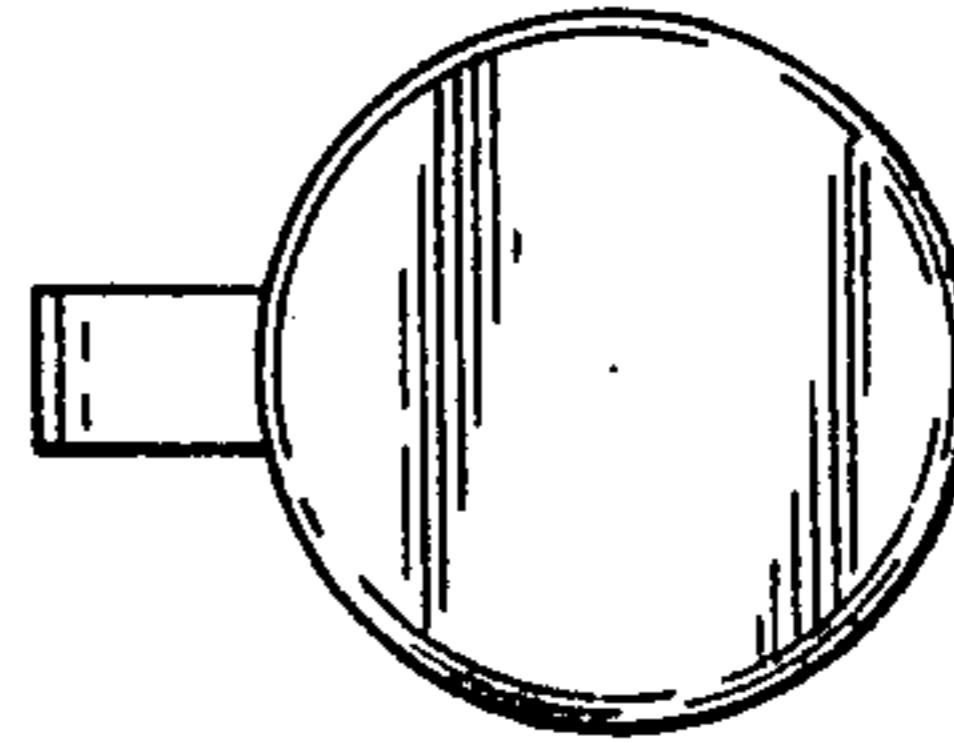

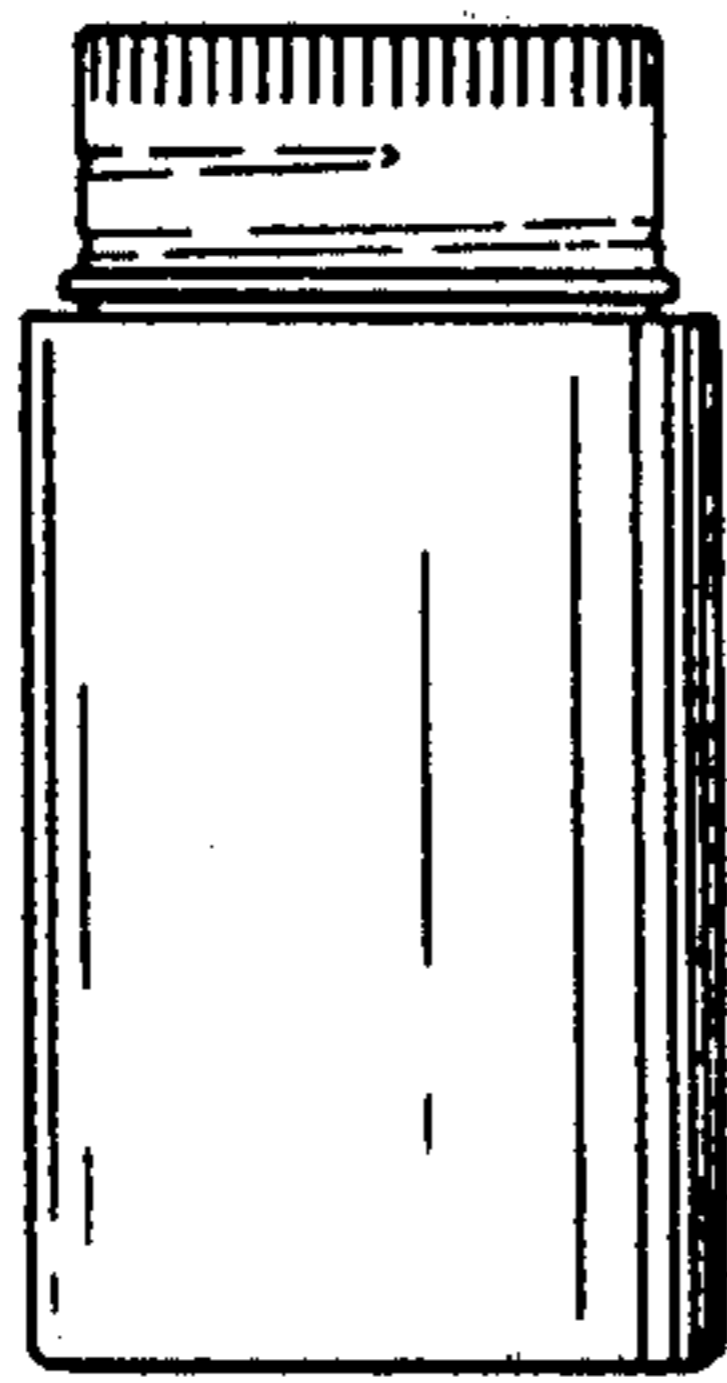

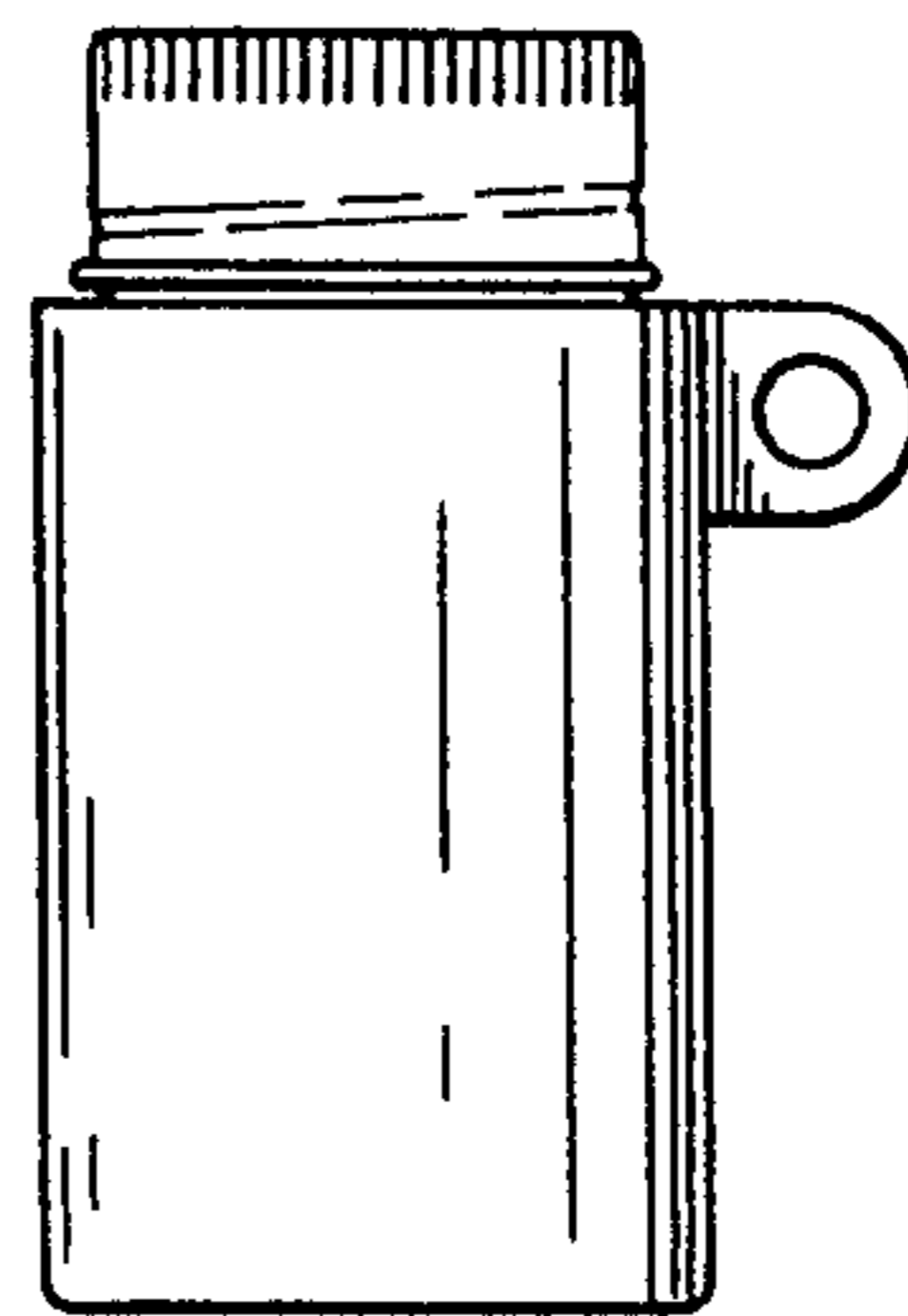

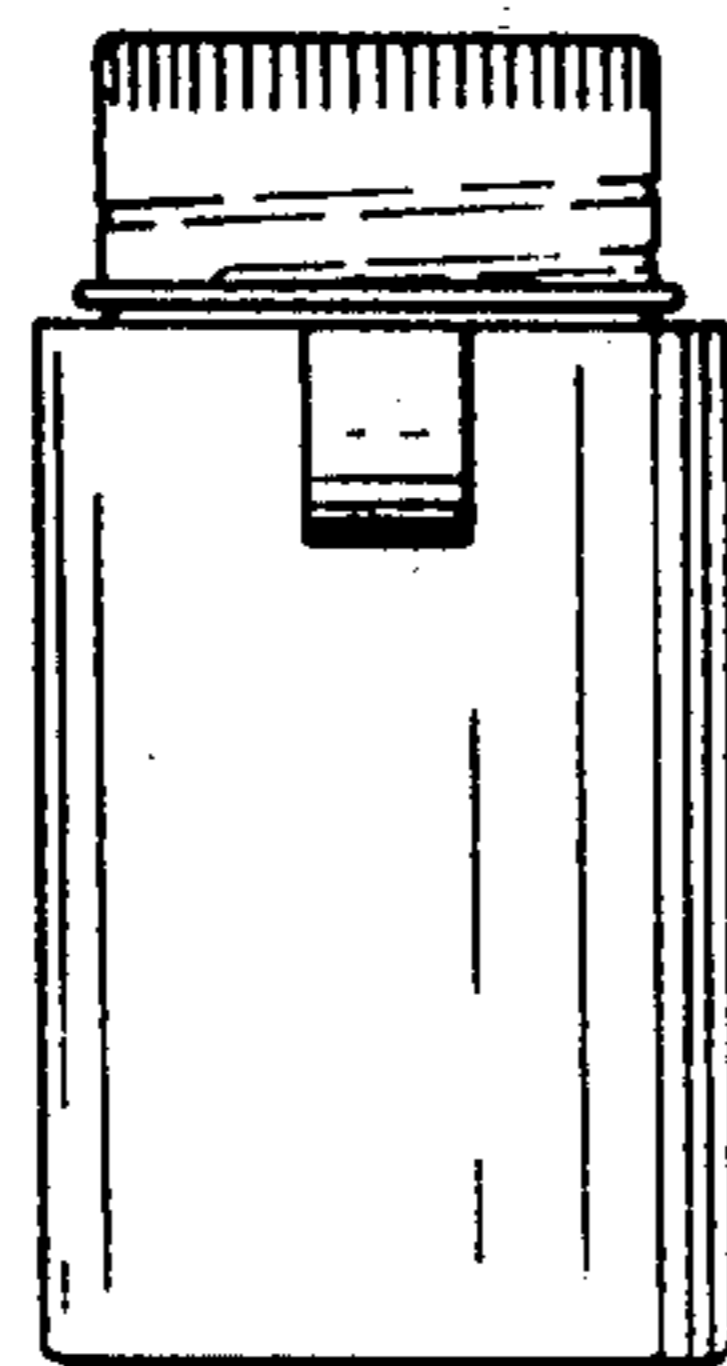
