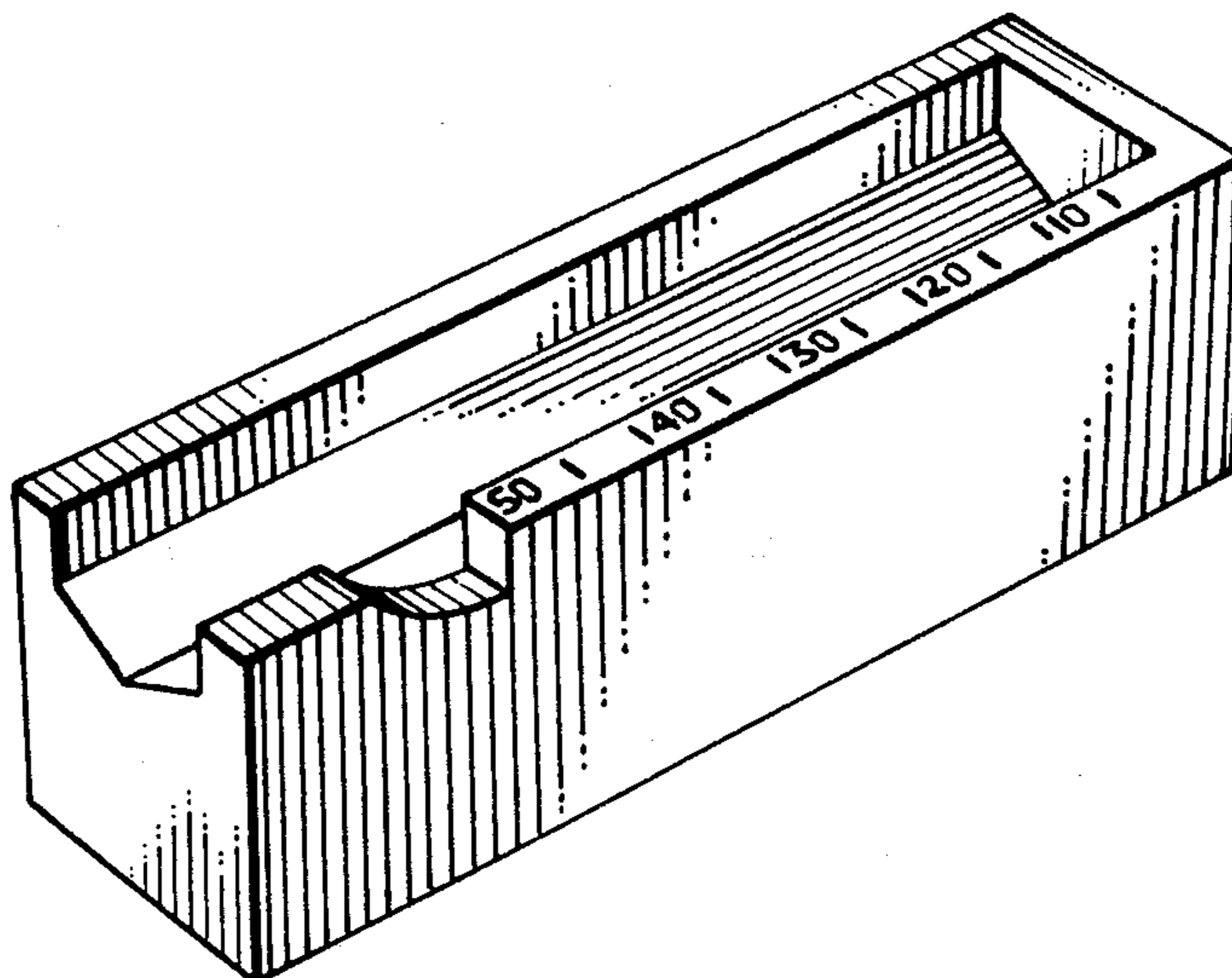

 FIG. 5 is a left end elevational view thereof.



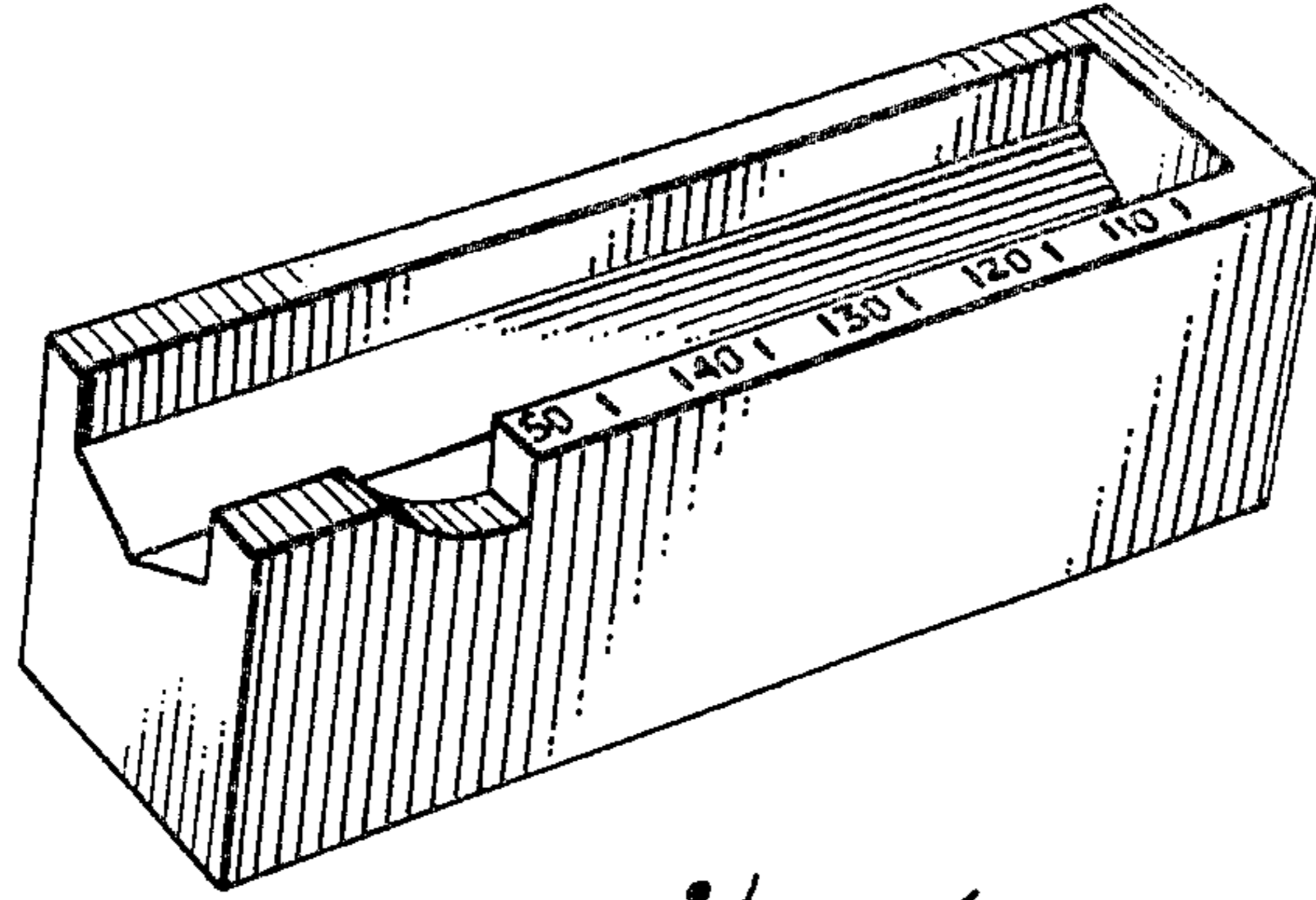

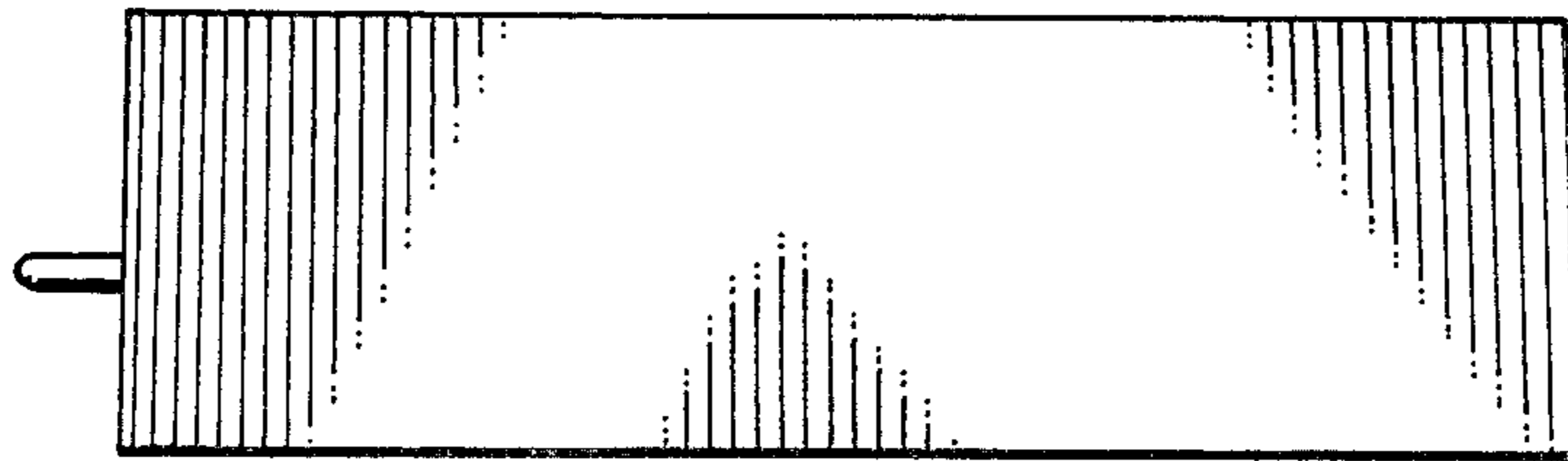

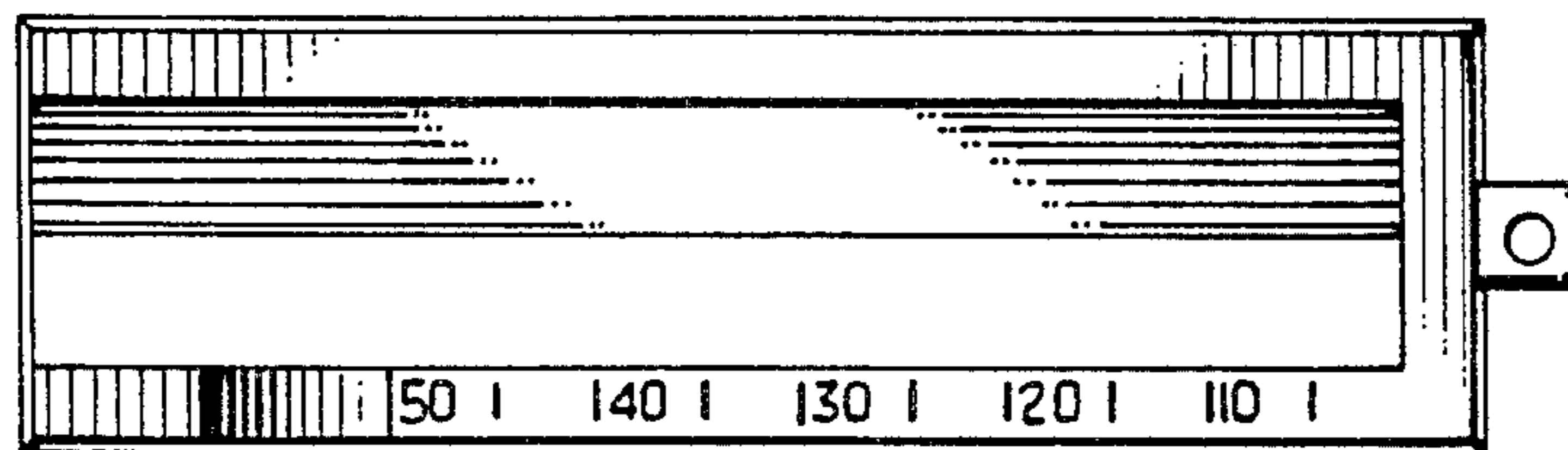

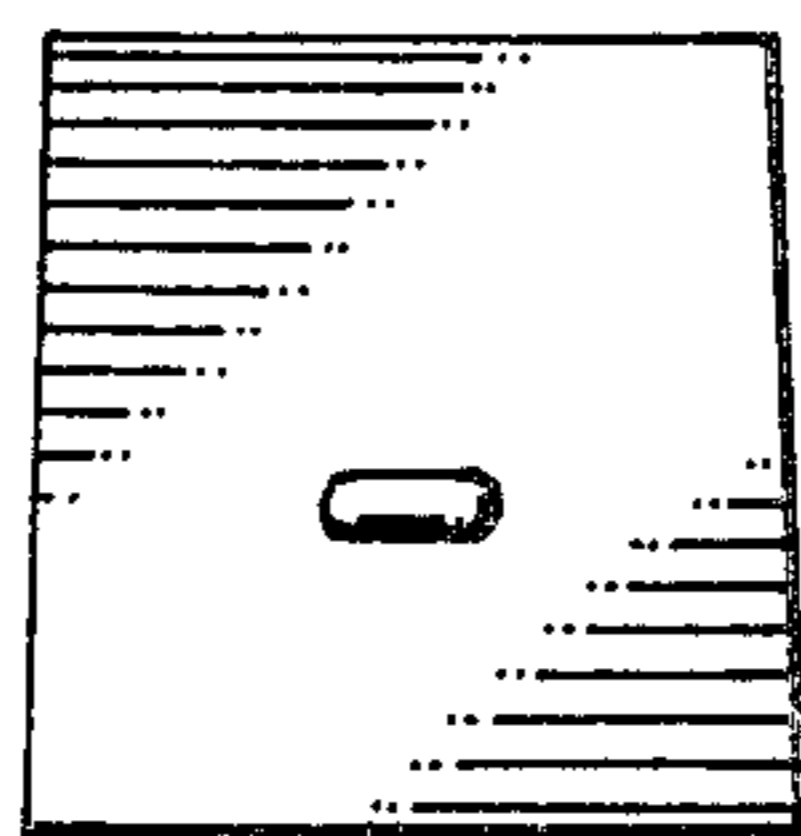

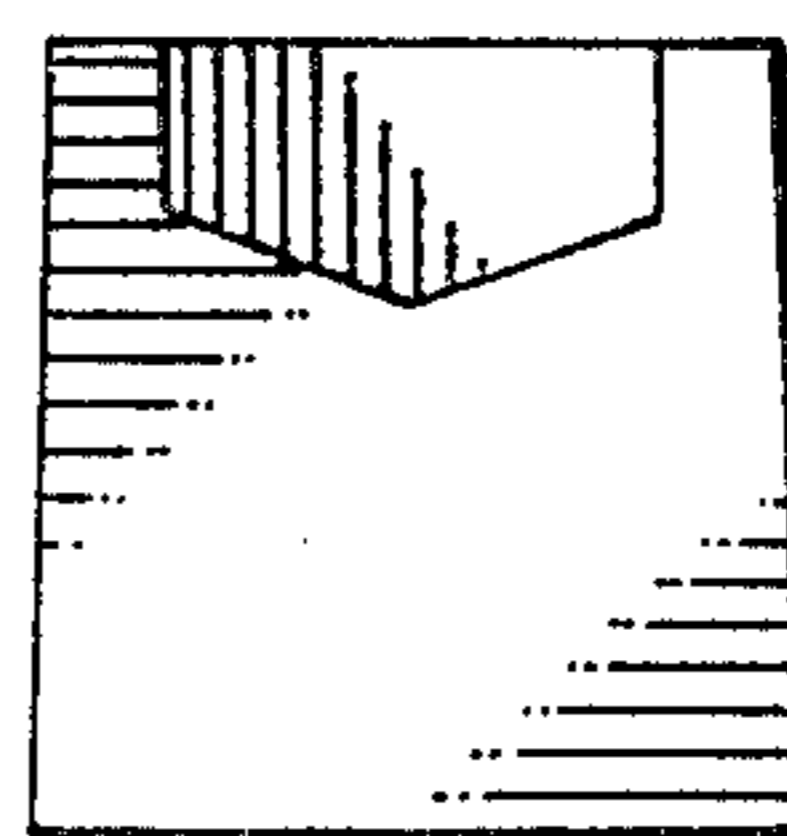
