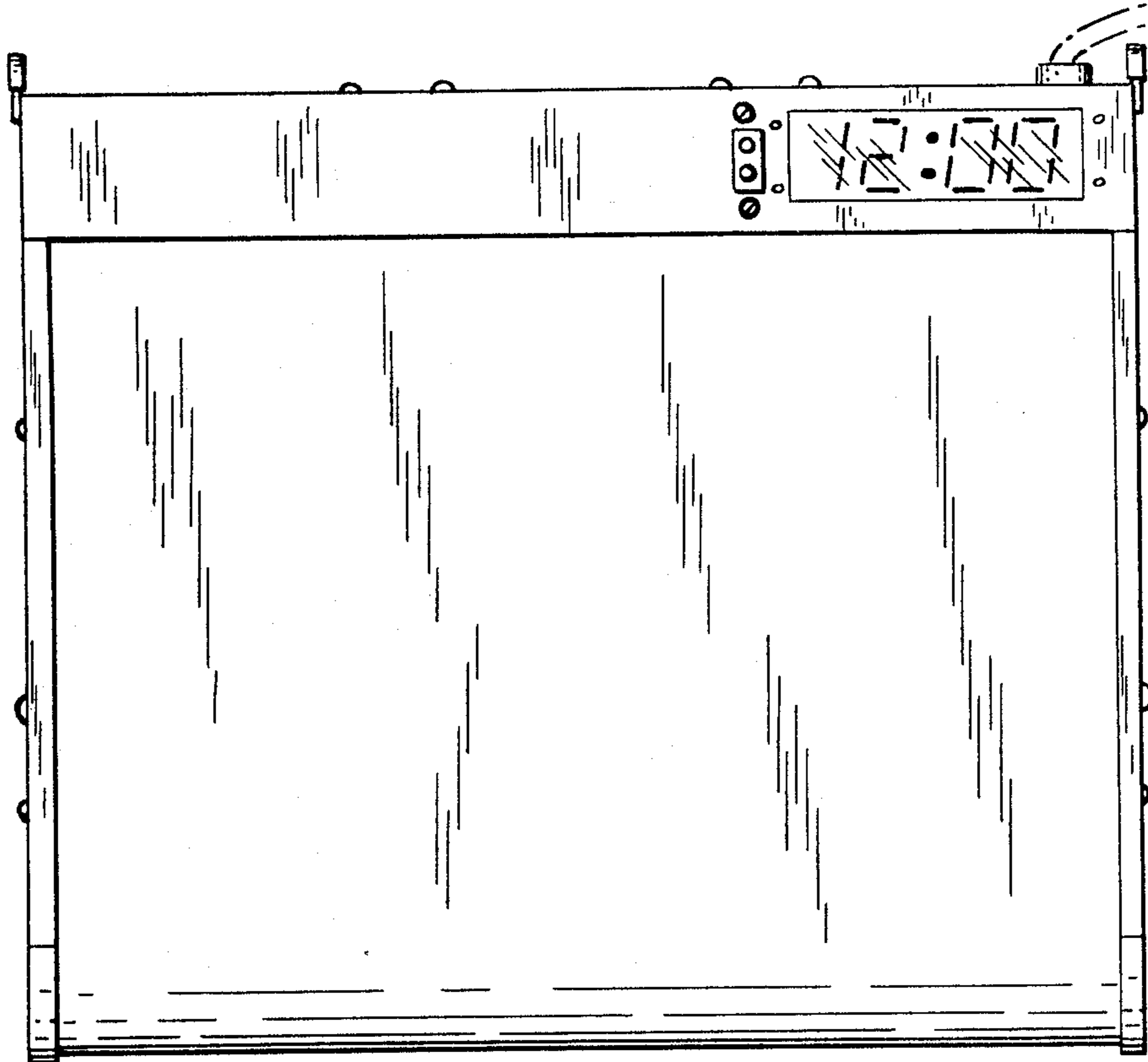

The ornamental design for an illuminated sign with clock, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an illuminated sign with clock, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line disclosure of a cord in FIGS. 1-4 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



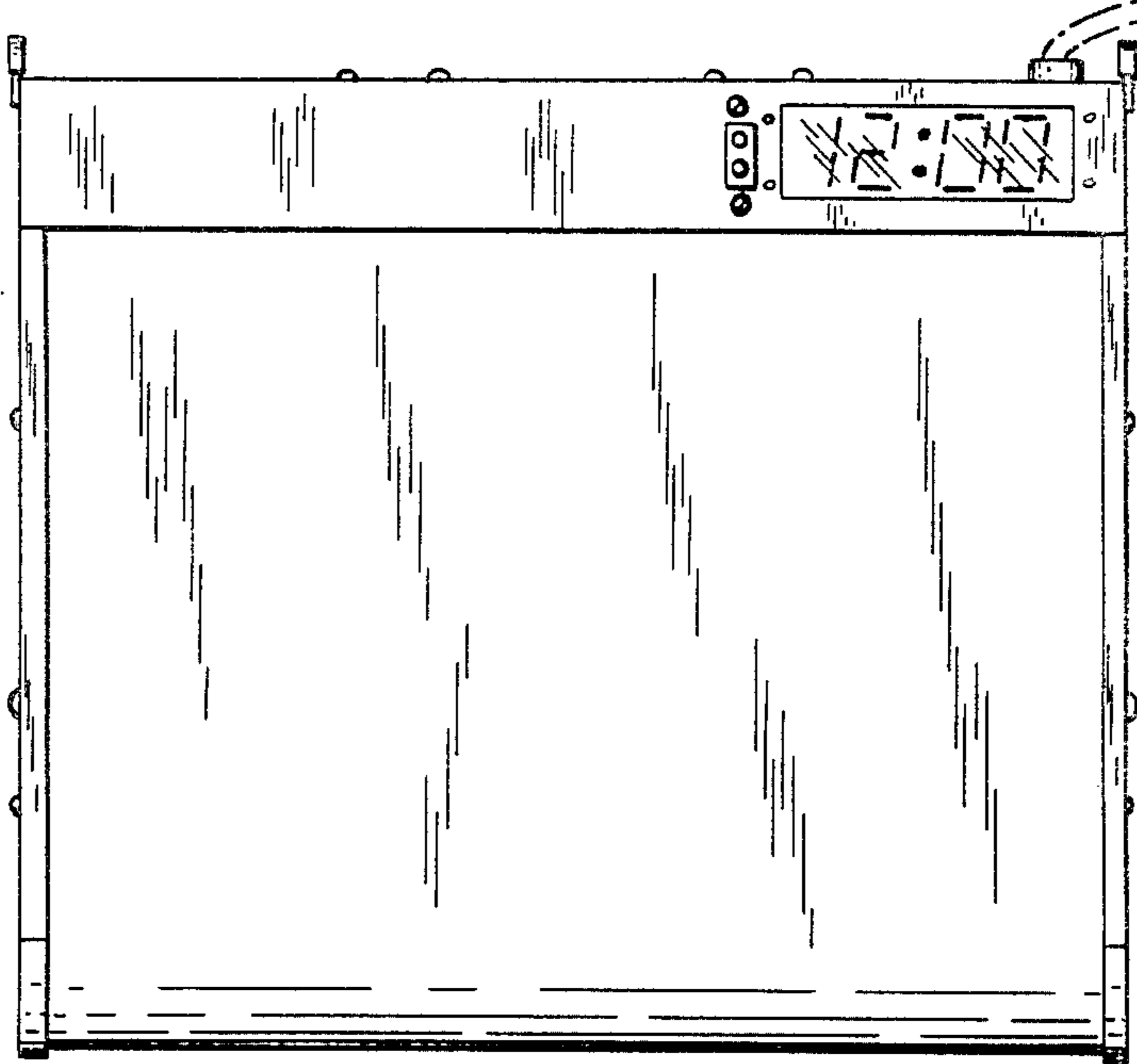
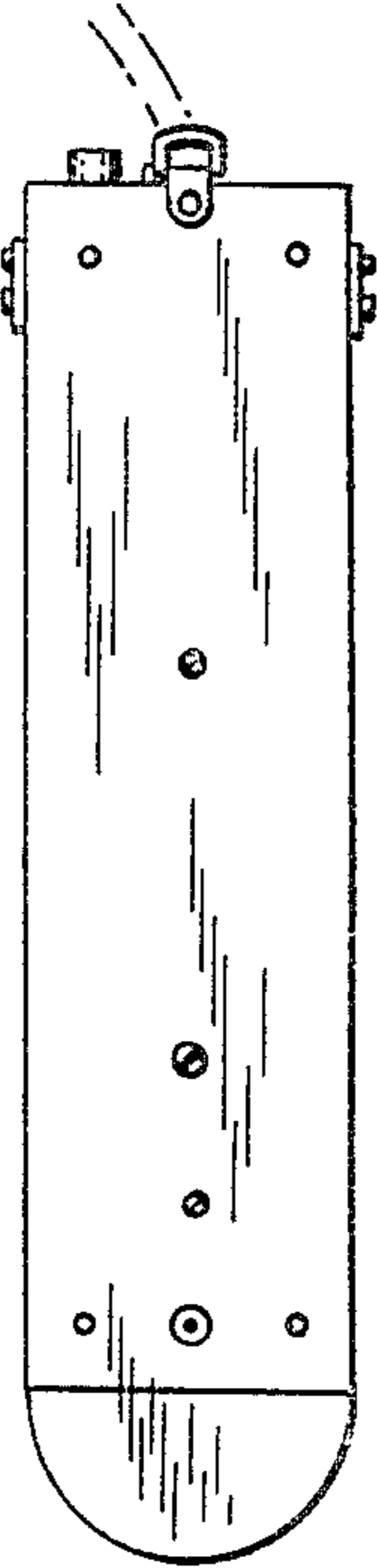
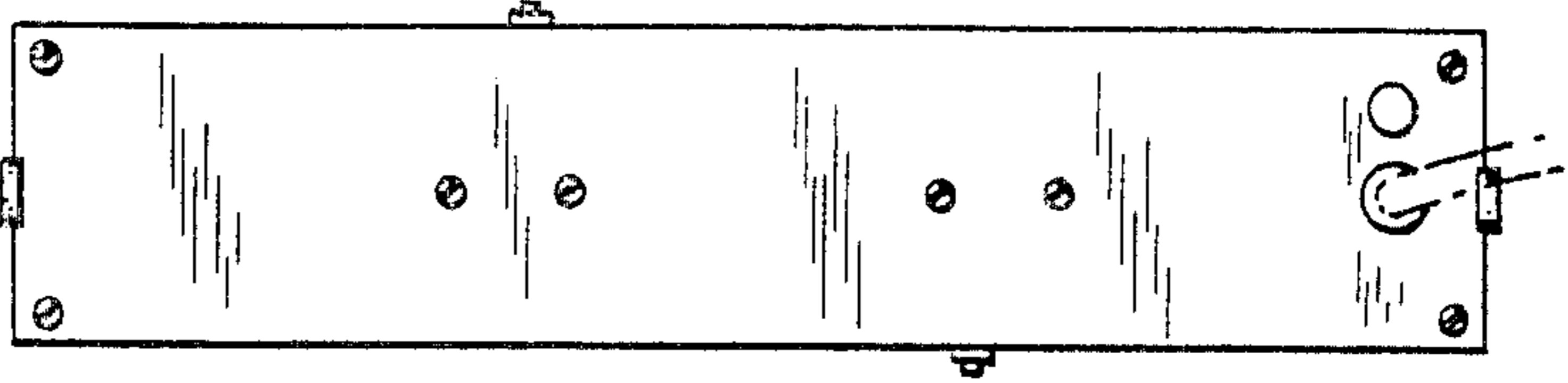
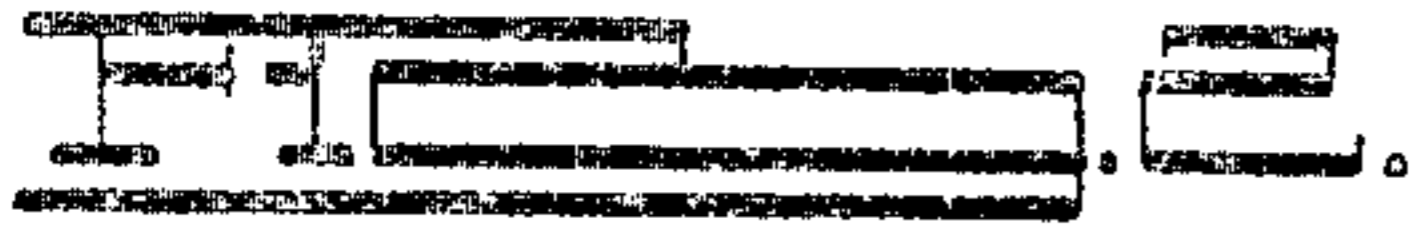

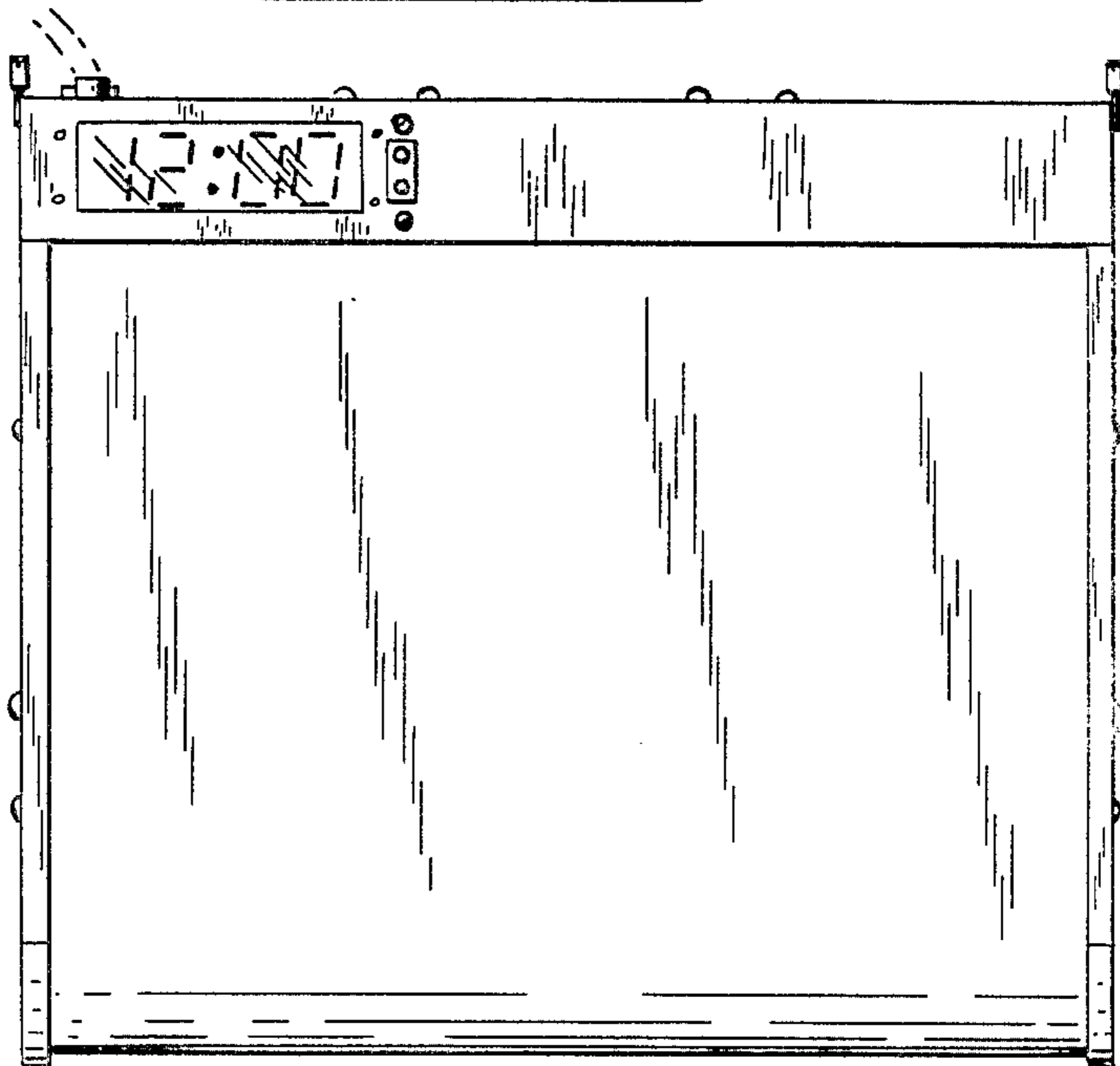
