[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bottle embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof looking from the right of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view.
The rear elevational view of the bottle, not shown, is identical to the front elevational view shown in FIG. 1. The side elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 1, not shown, is identical to the side elevational view shown in FIG. 2.

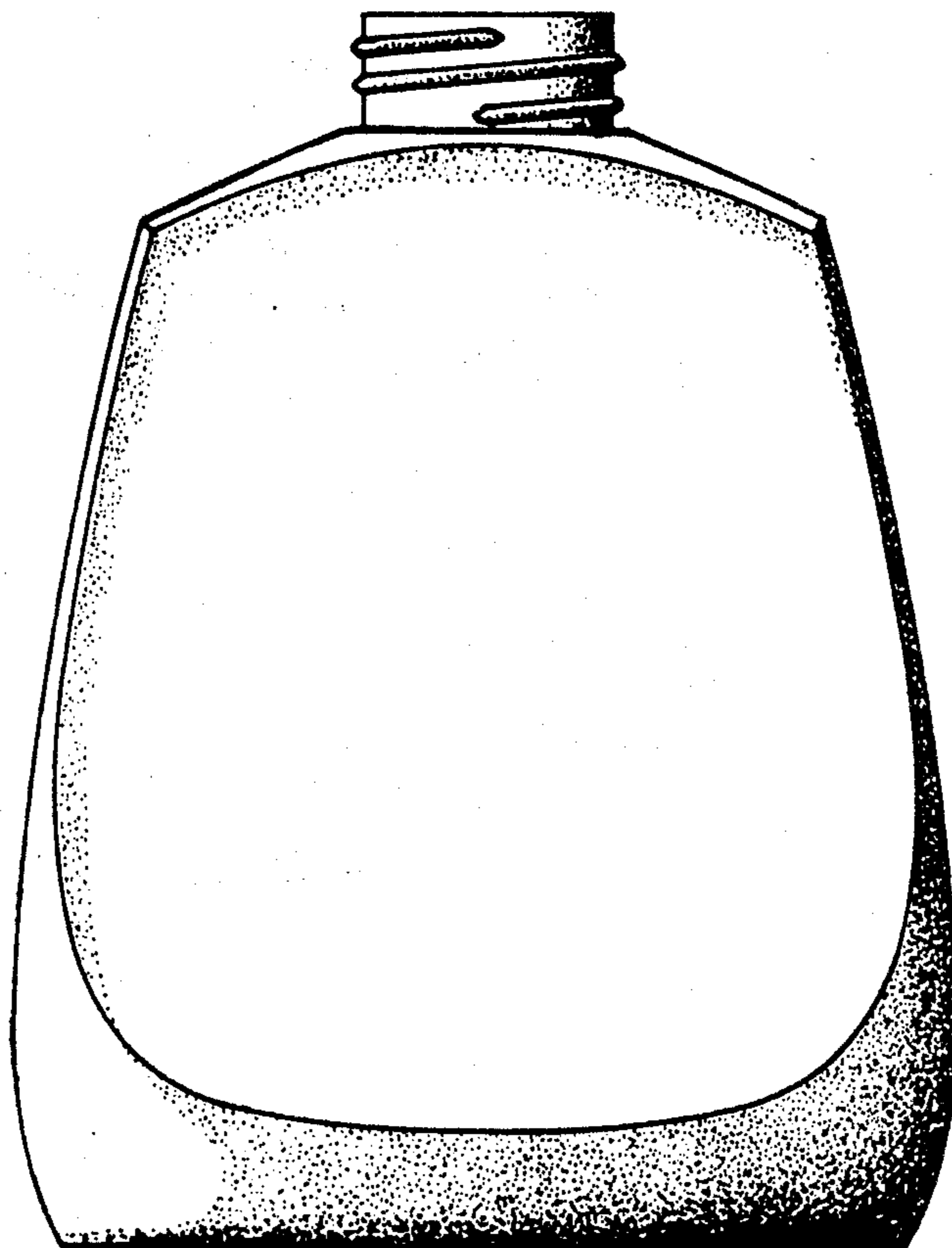

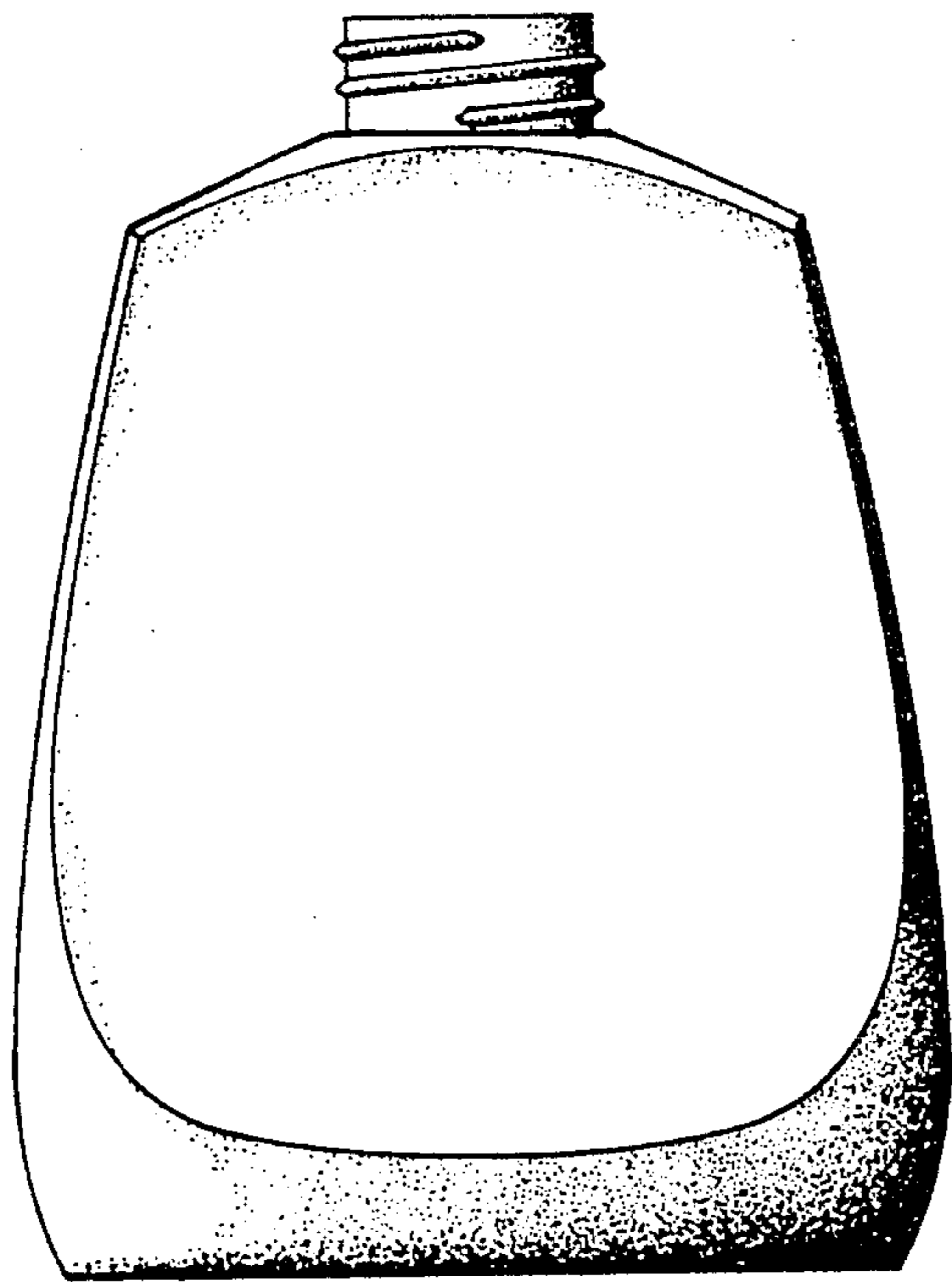

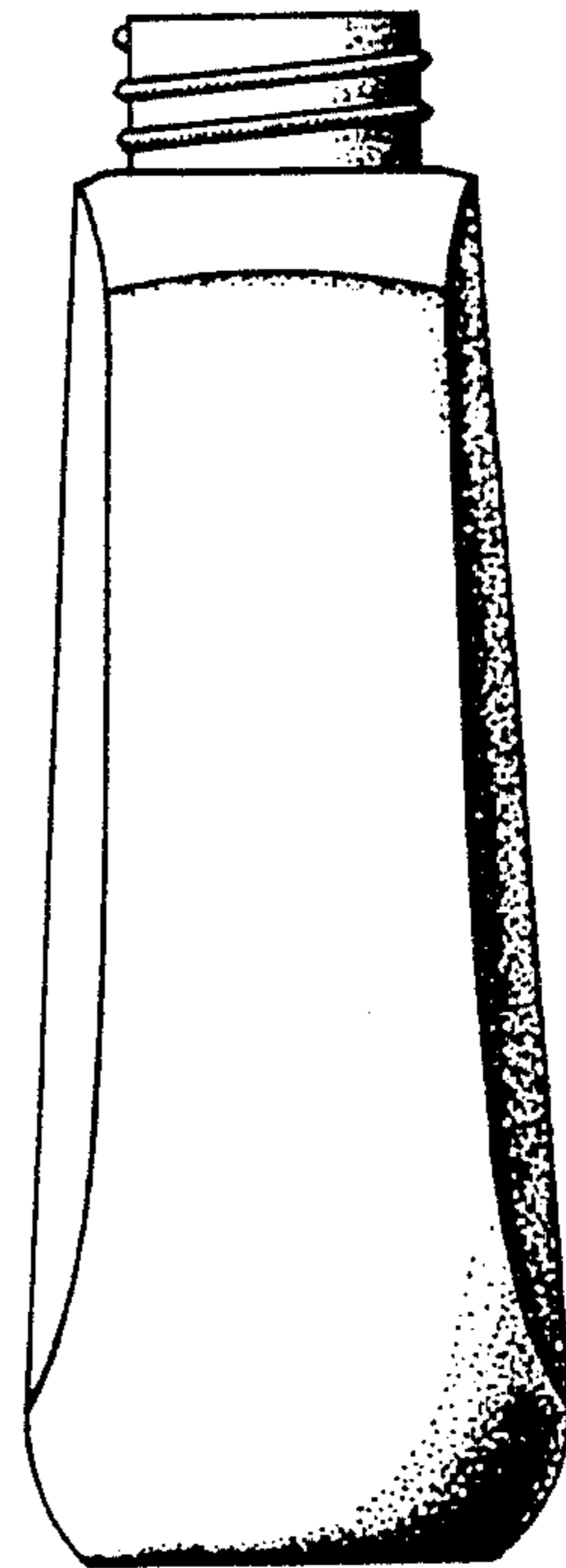

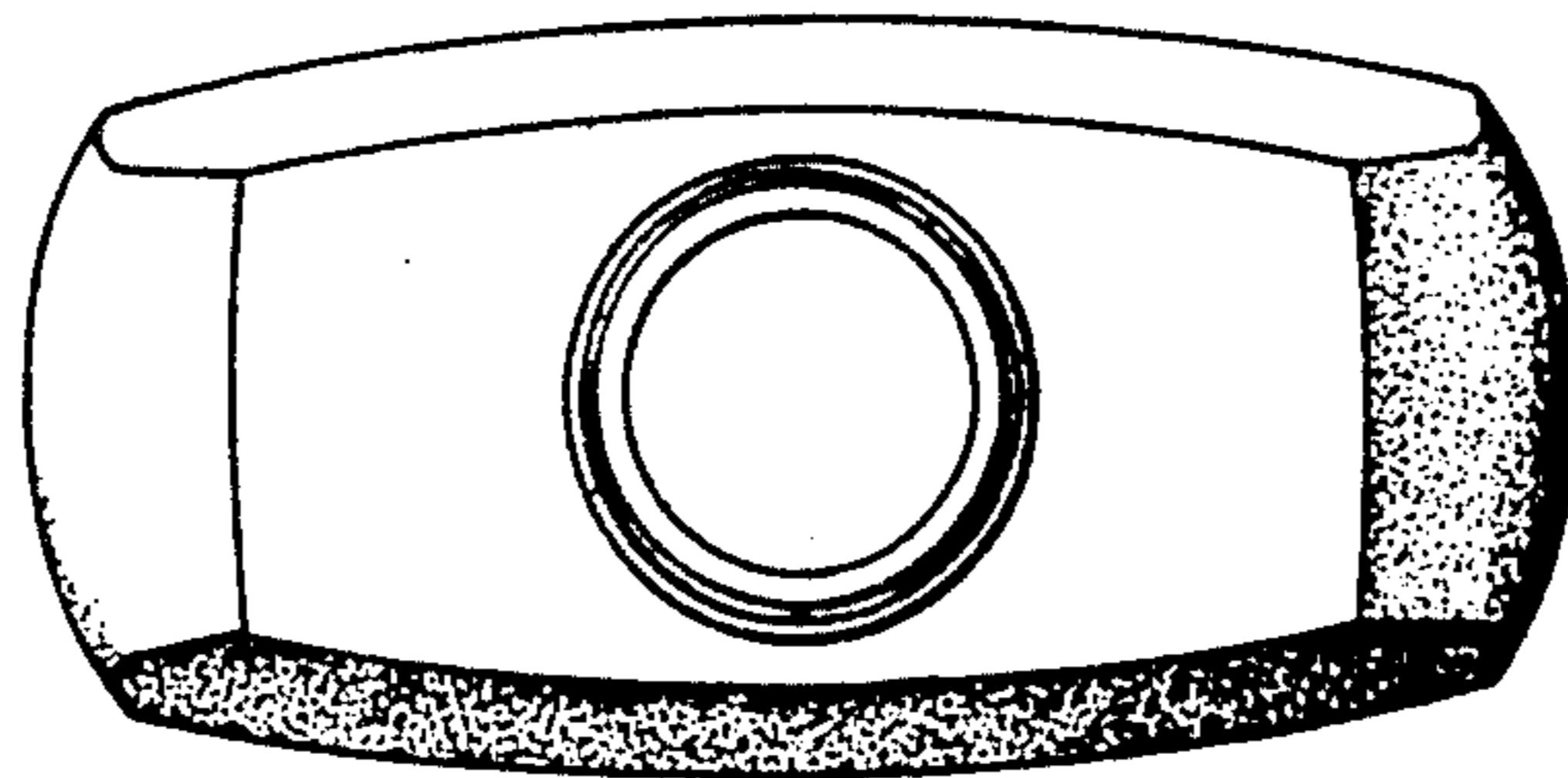
