CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined faucet handle and escutcheon, as shown, and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a combined faucet handle and escutcheon showing my new design; FIG. 2 is another side elevational view thereof, the other sides being the same as the sides shown; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a top perspective view thereof.

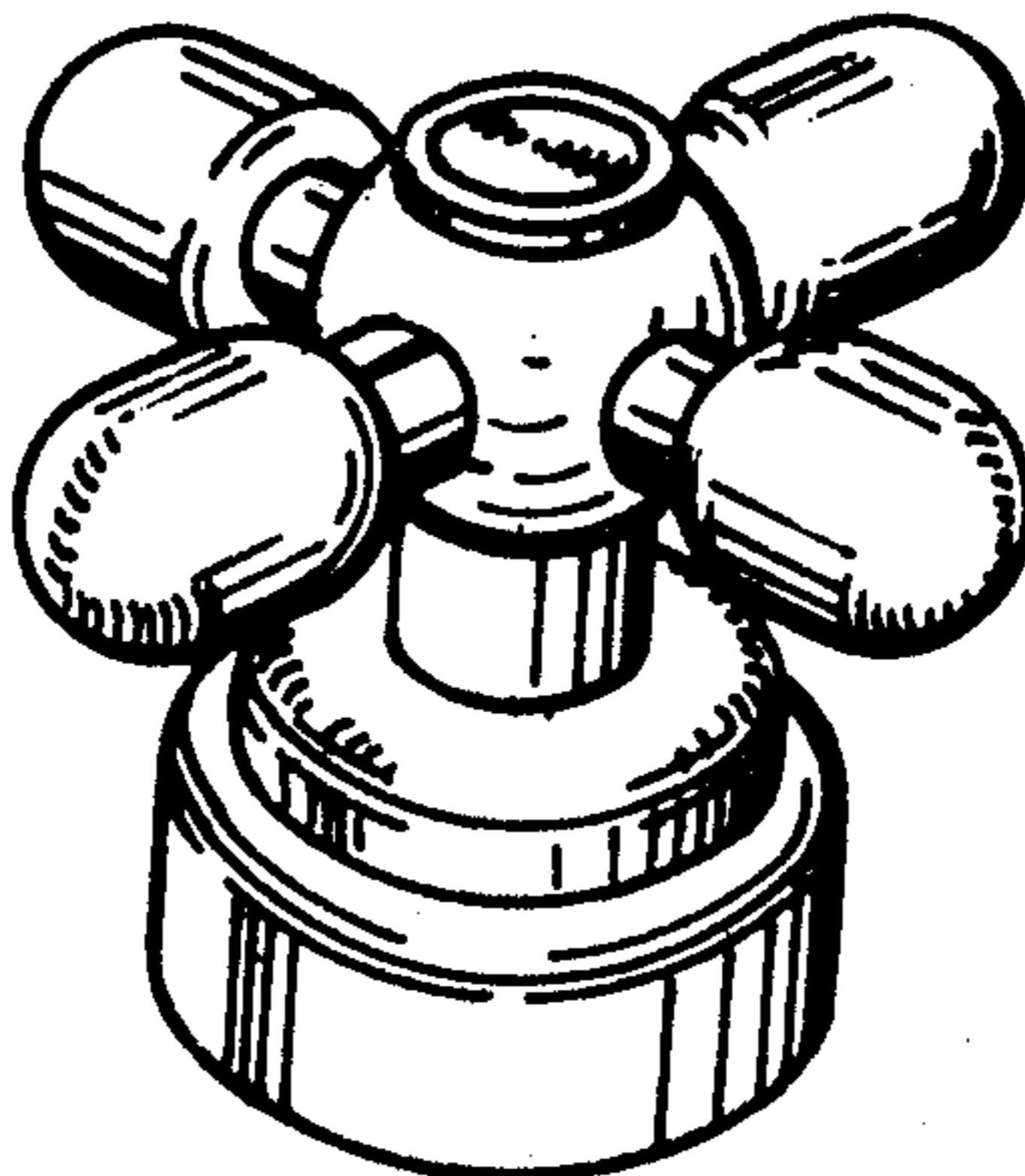

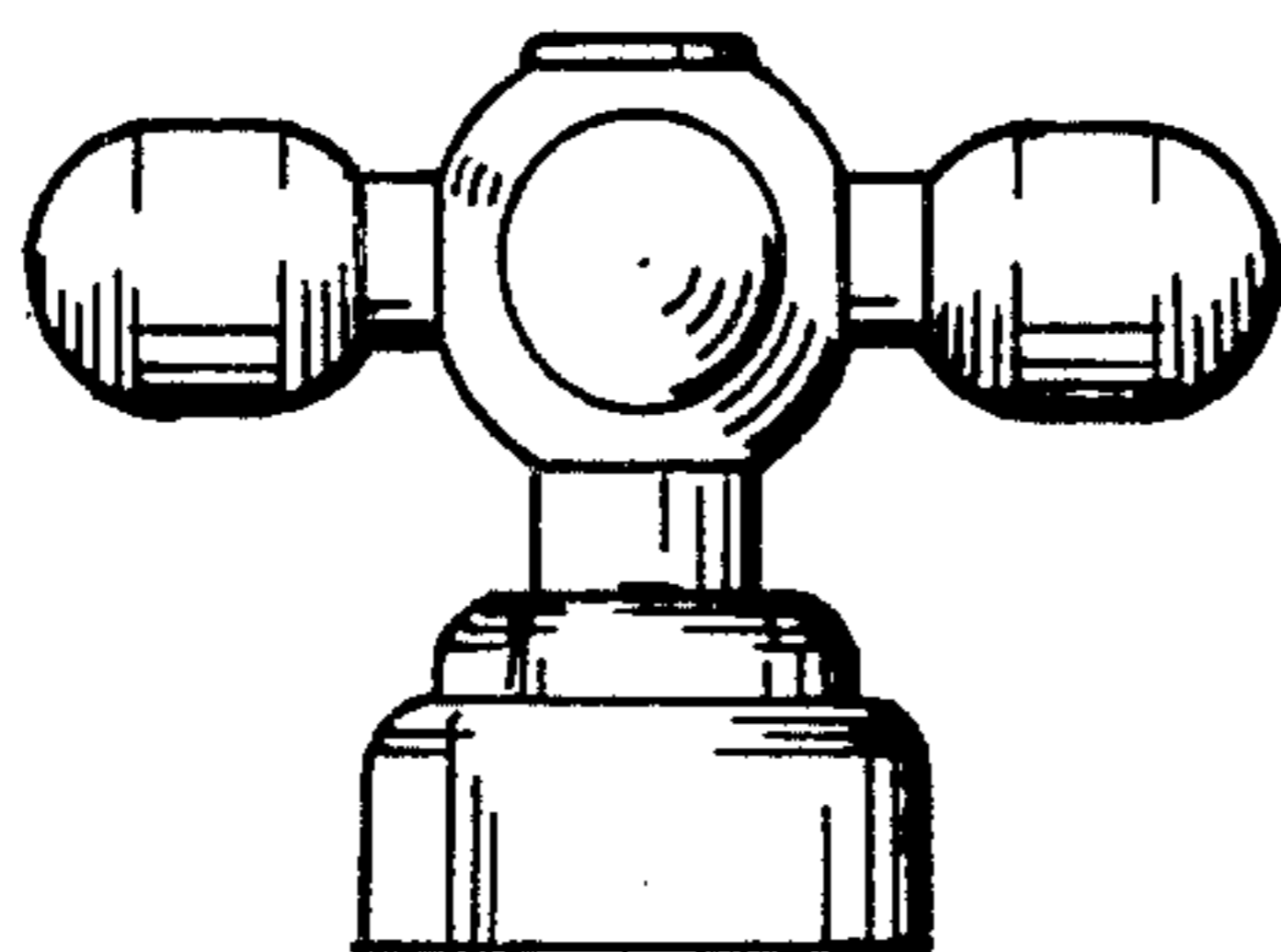

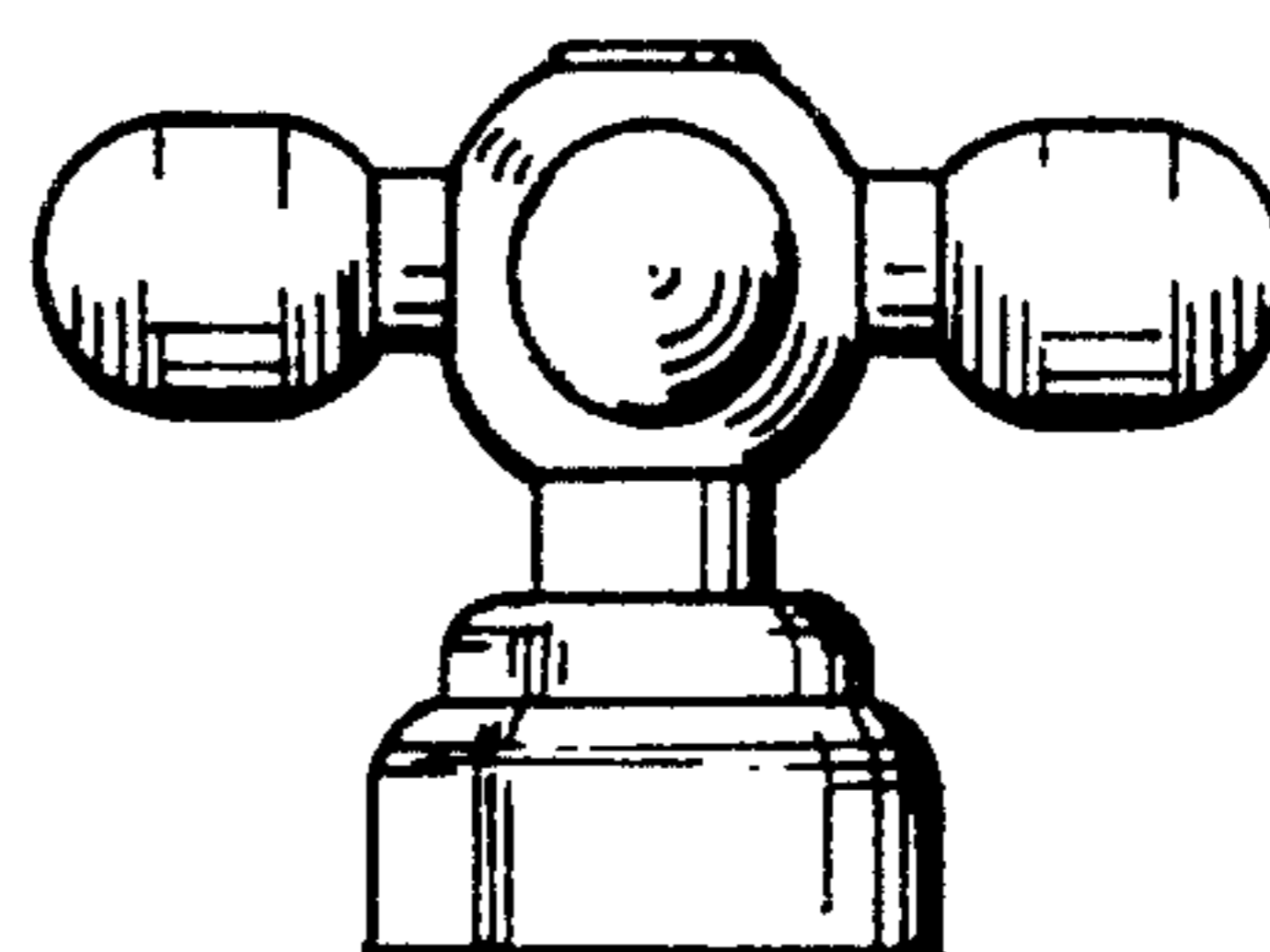

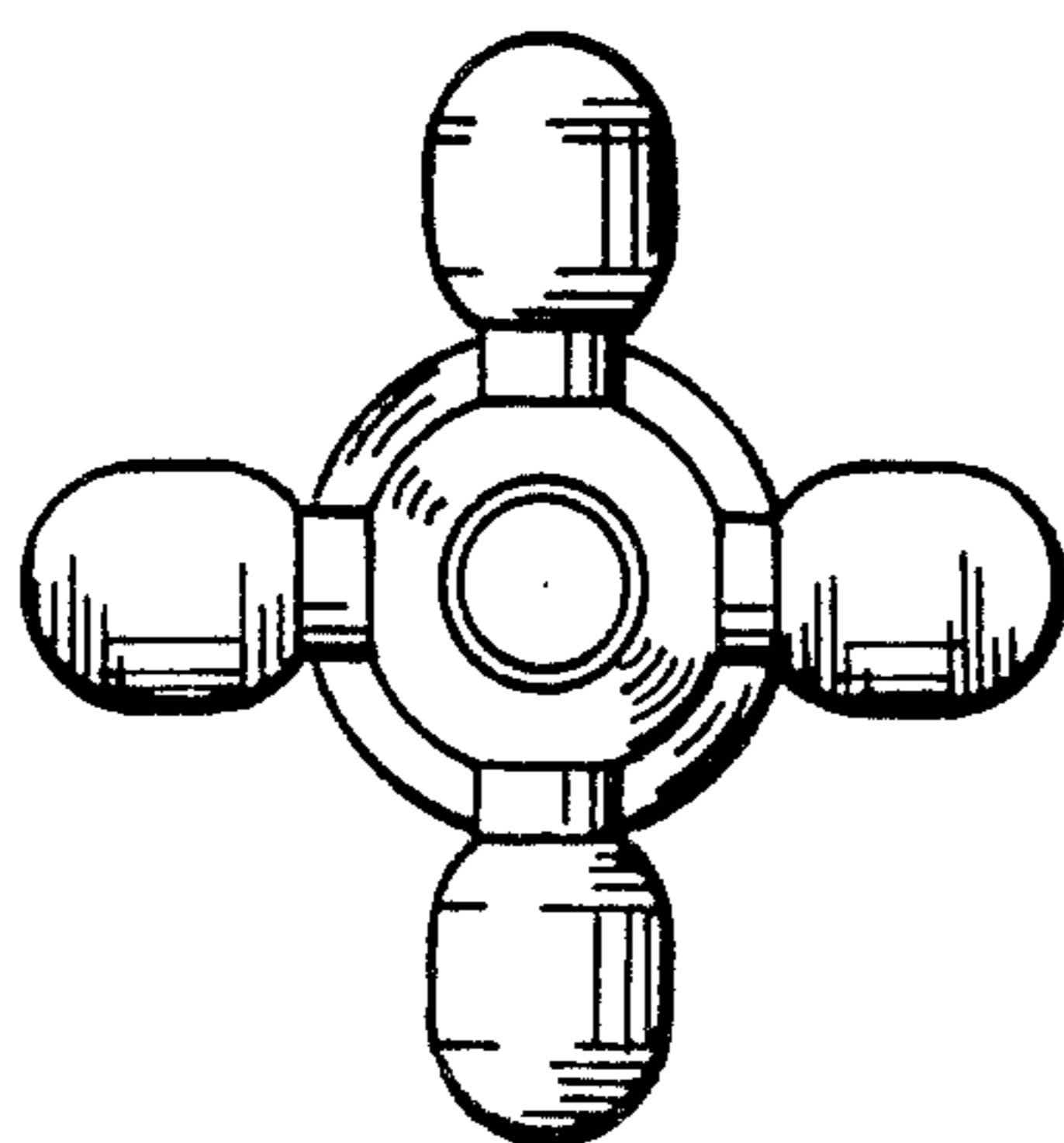
