FIG. 2 is a side perspective view thereof;

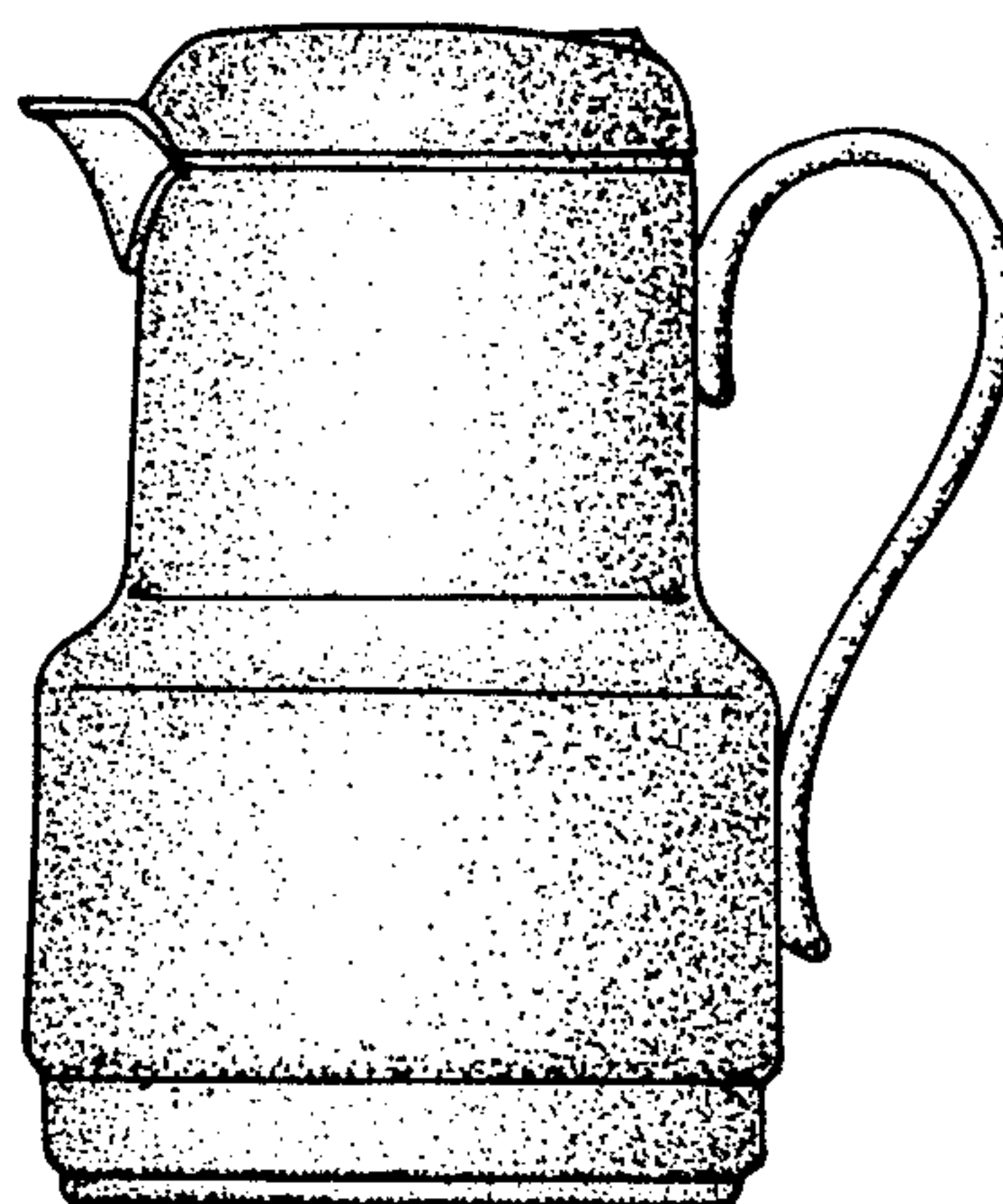
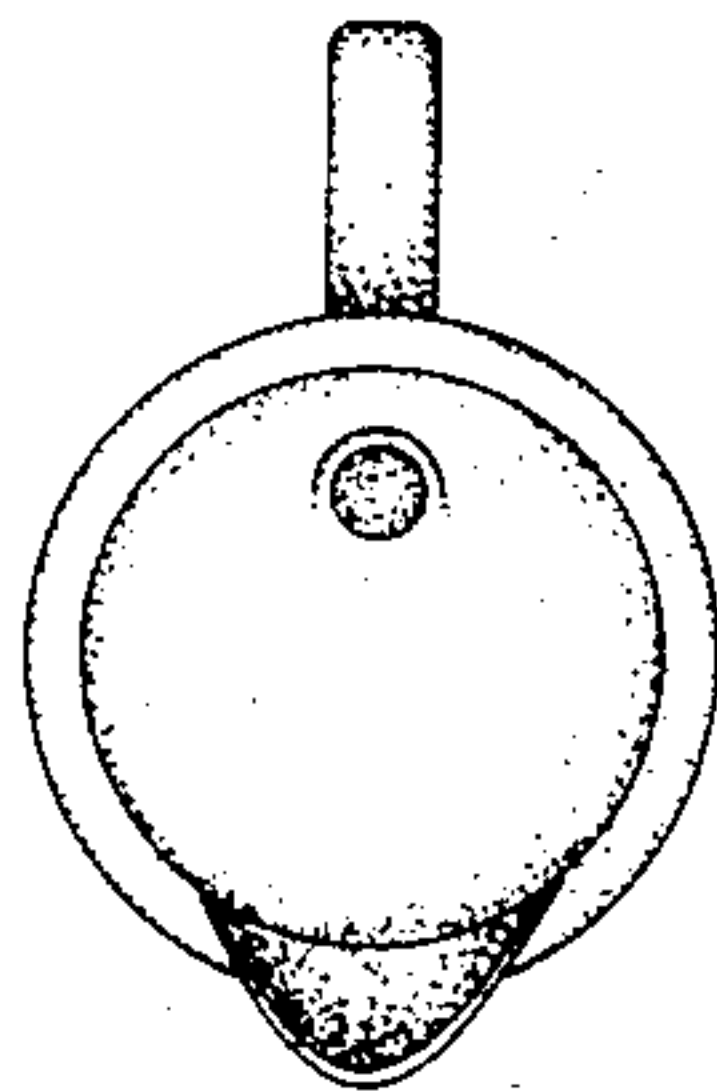
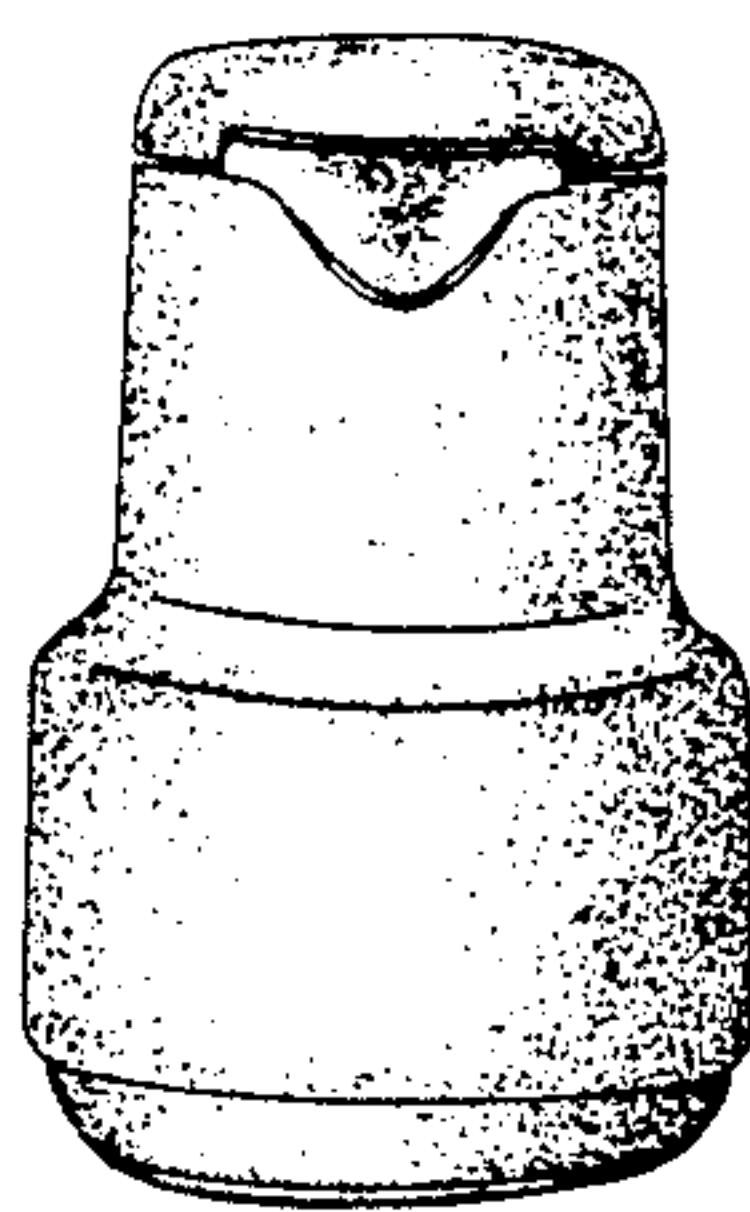
FIG. 3 is a front perspective view thereof;

The bottom of the insulated jug is flat and unornamented.



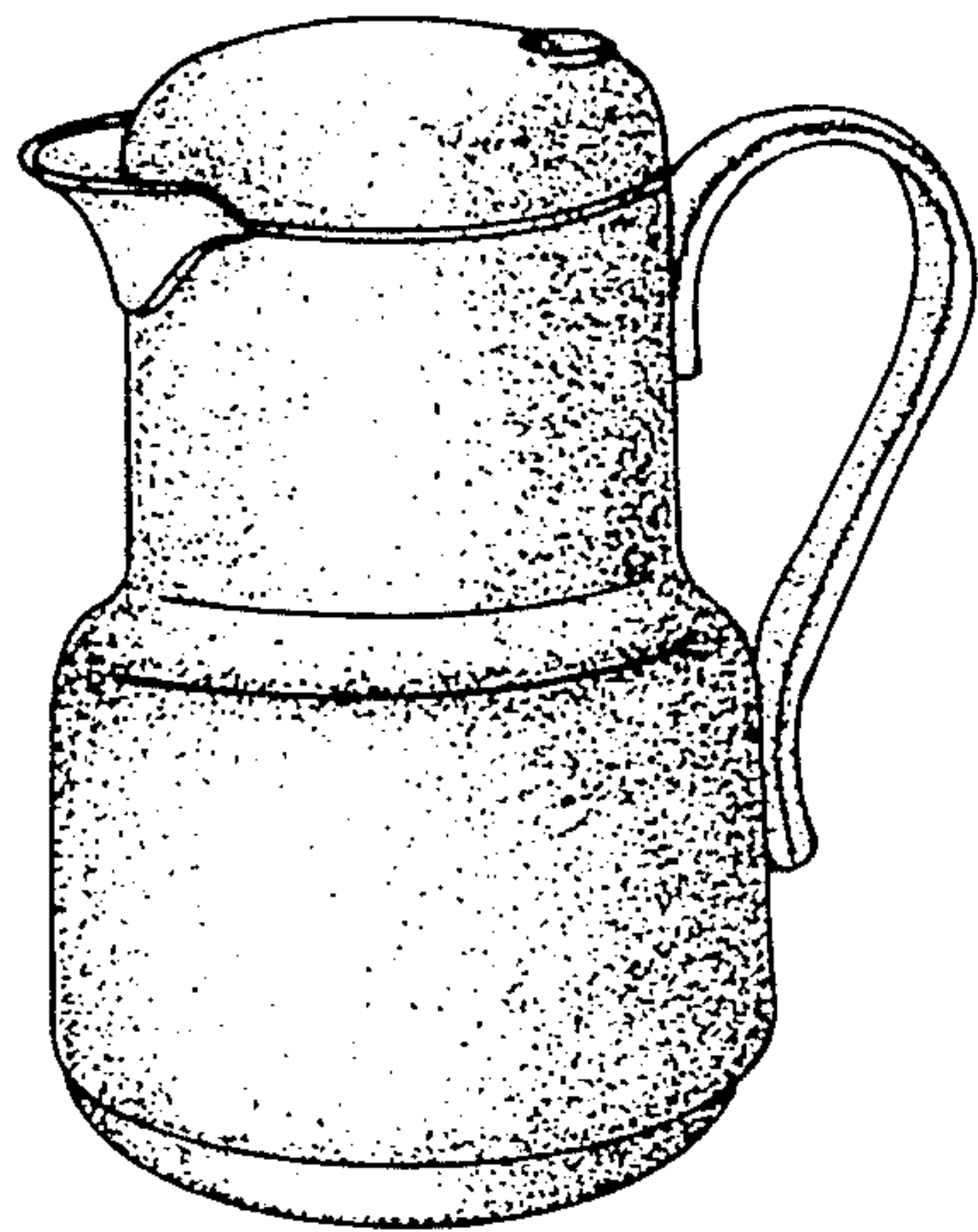

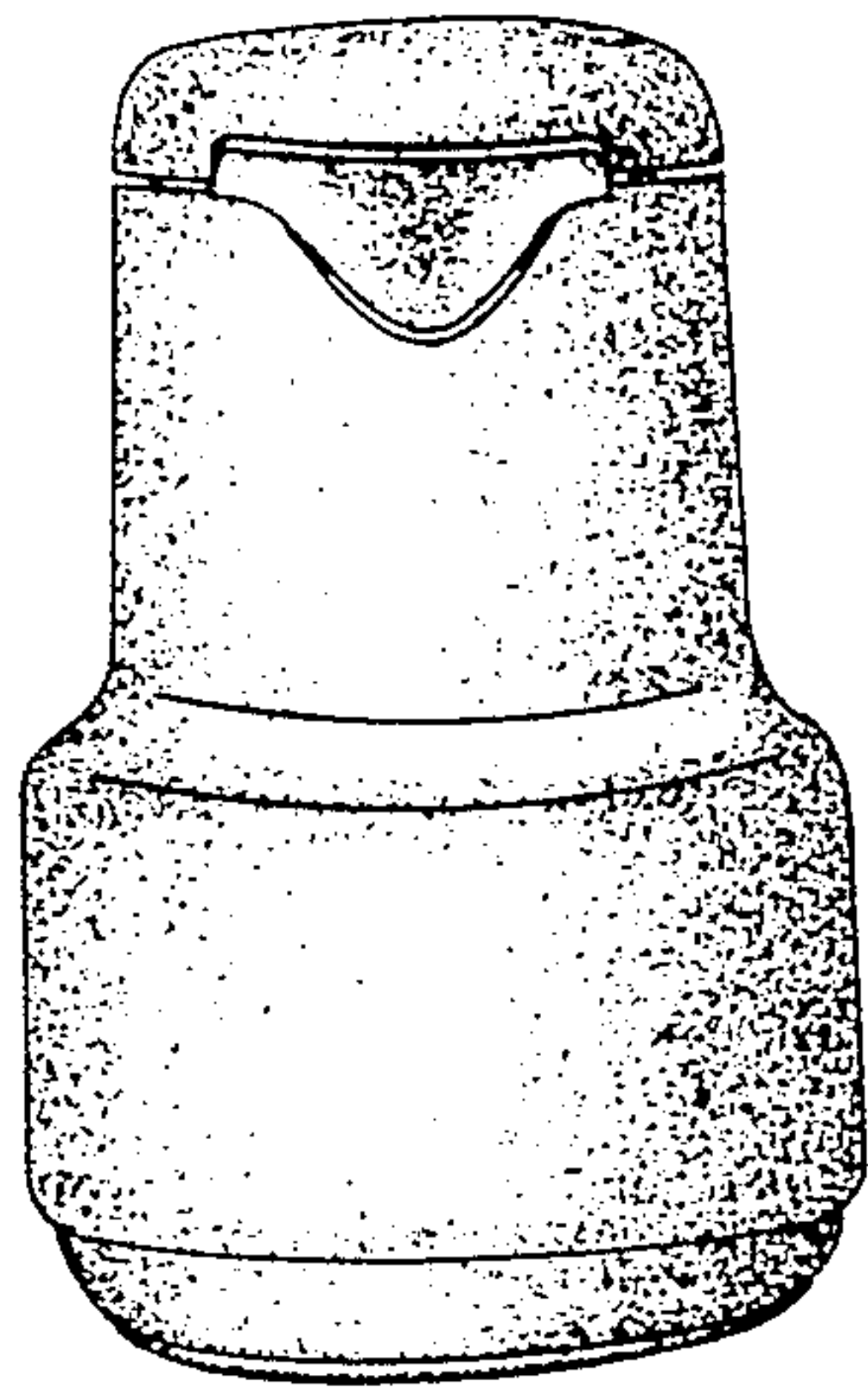

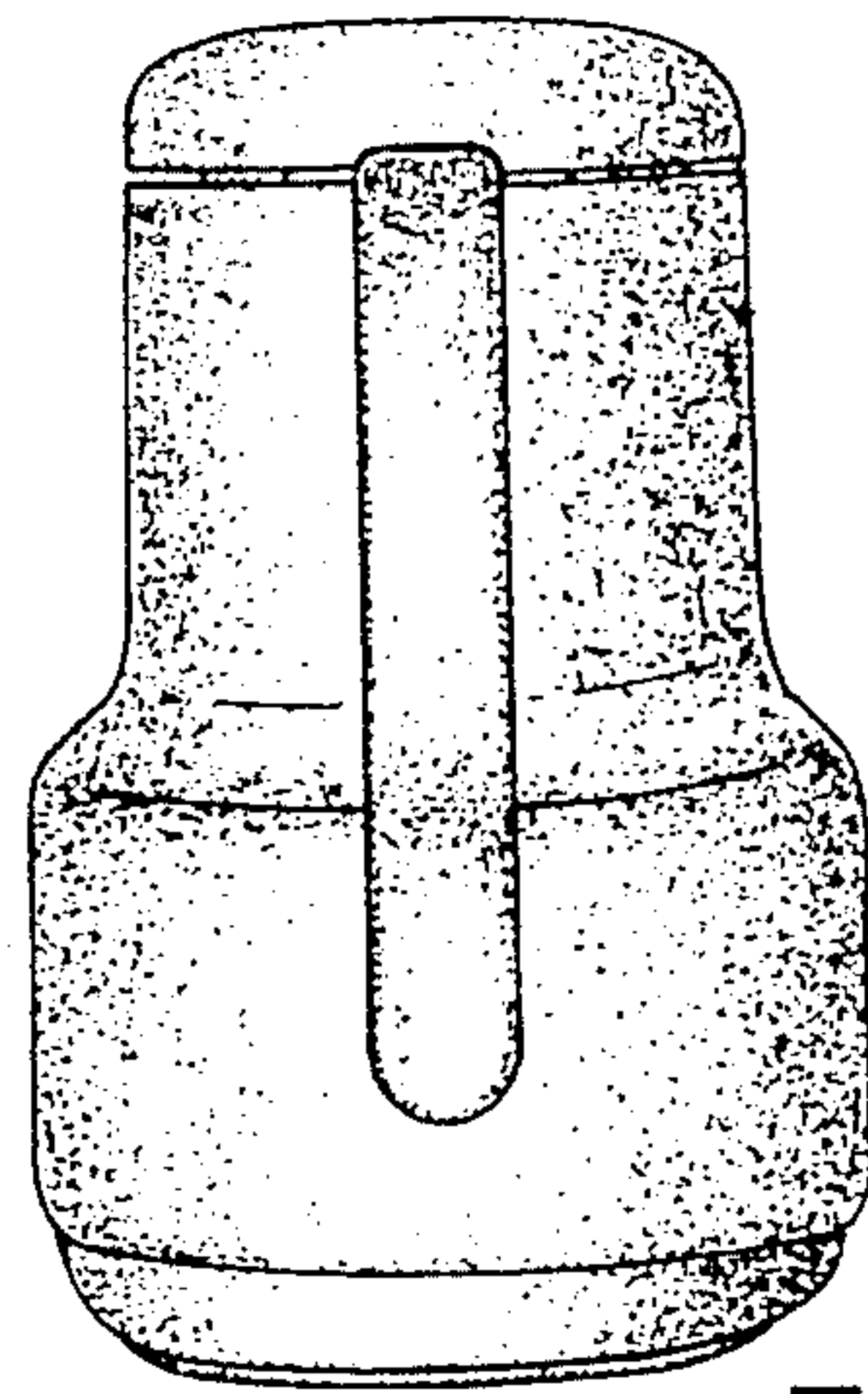

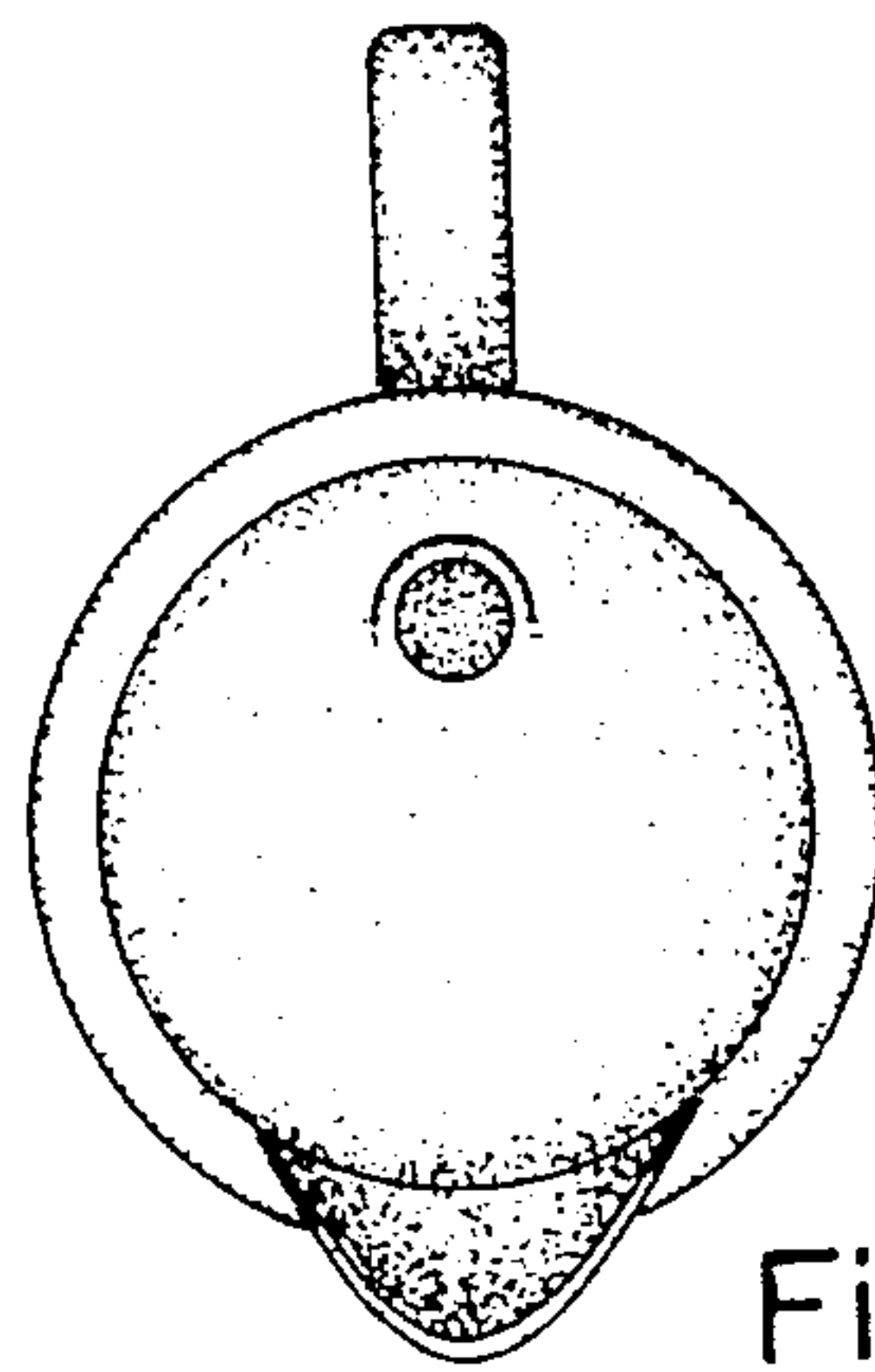

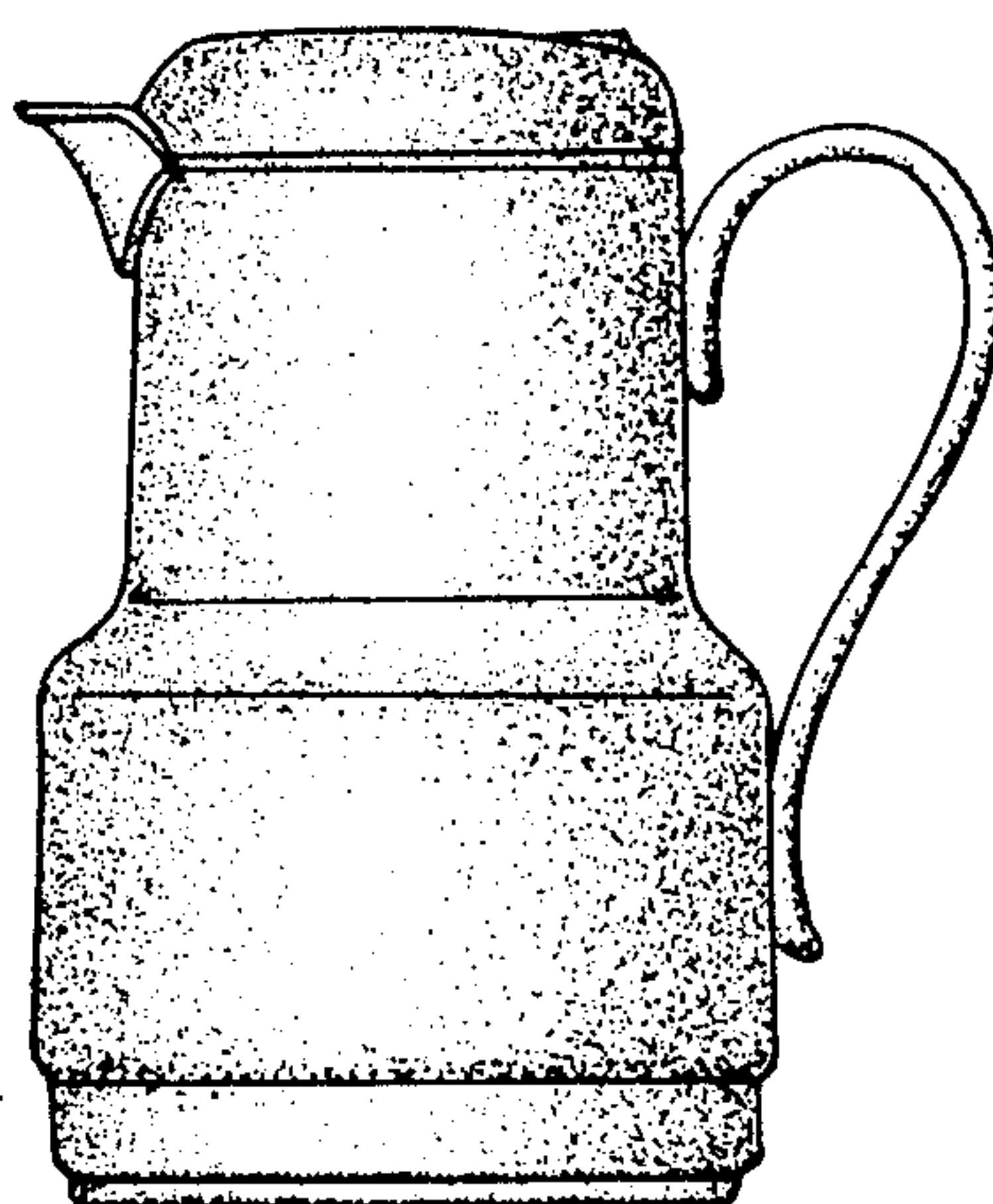
