[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a gripper tie, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a reduced perspective view of a gripper tie showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an end view taken from the left of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a fragmentary top view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a fragmentary side view taken from the left of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 5—5 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a fragmentary side view taken from the left of FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 7—7 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a fragmentary top view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 9—9 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 10 is a fragmentary side view taken from the left of FIG. 9.
