FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a plastic container for liquids showing my new design, the opposite side being the same in appearance;

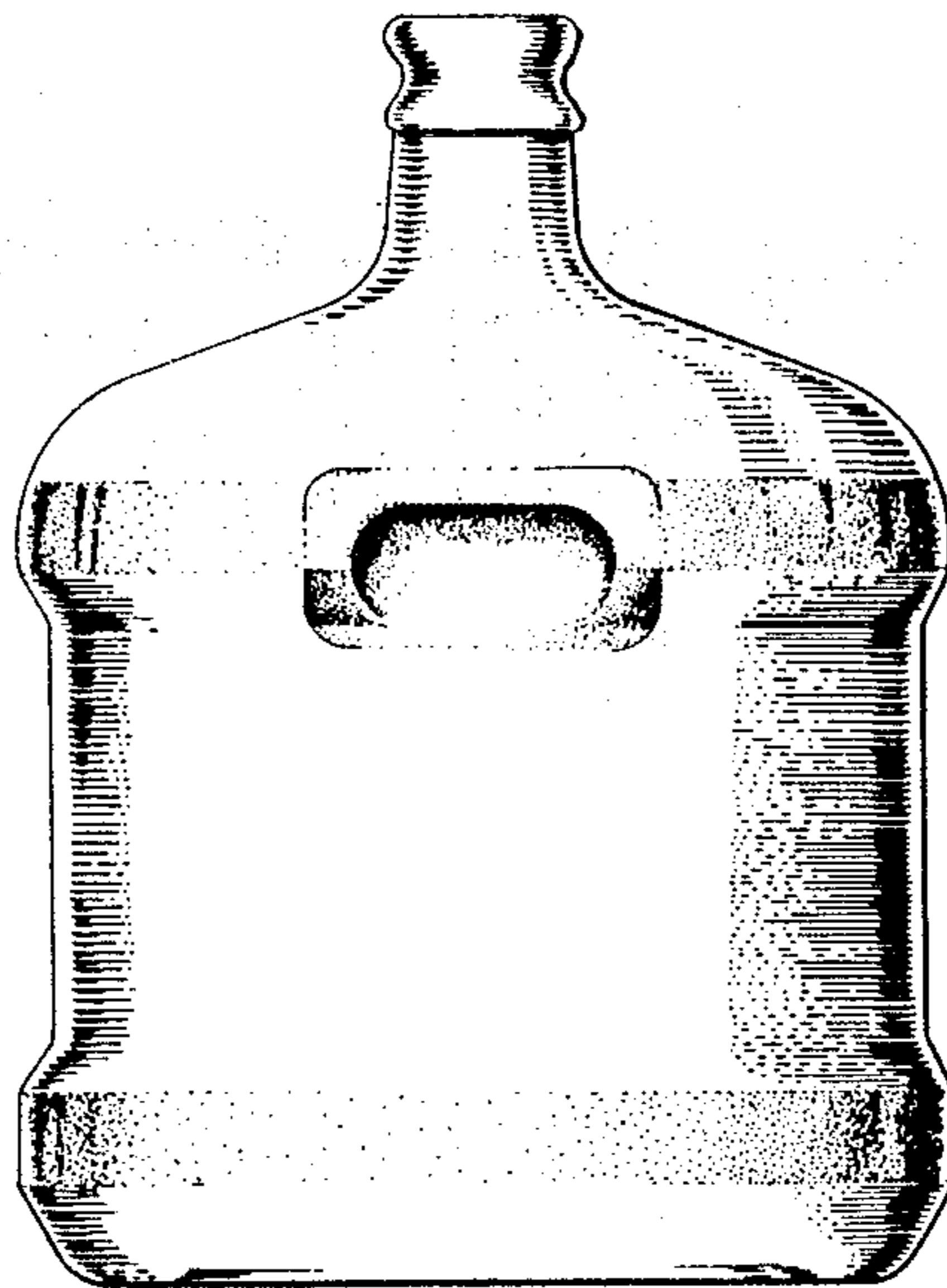

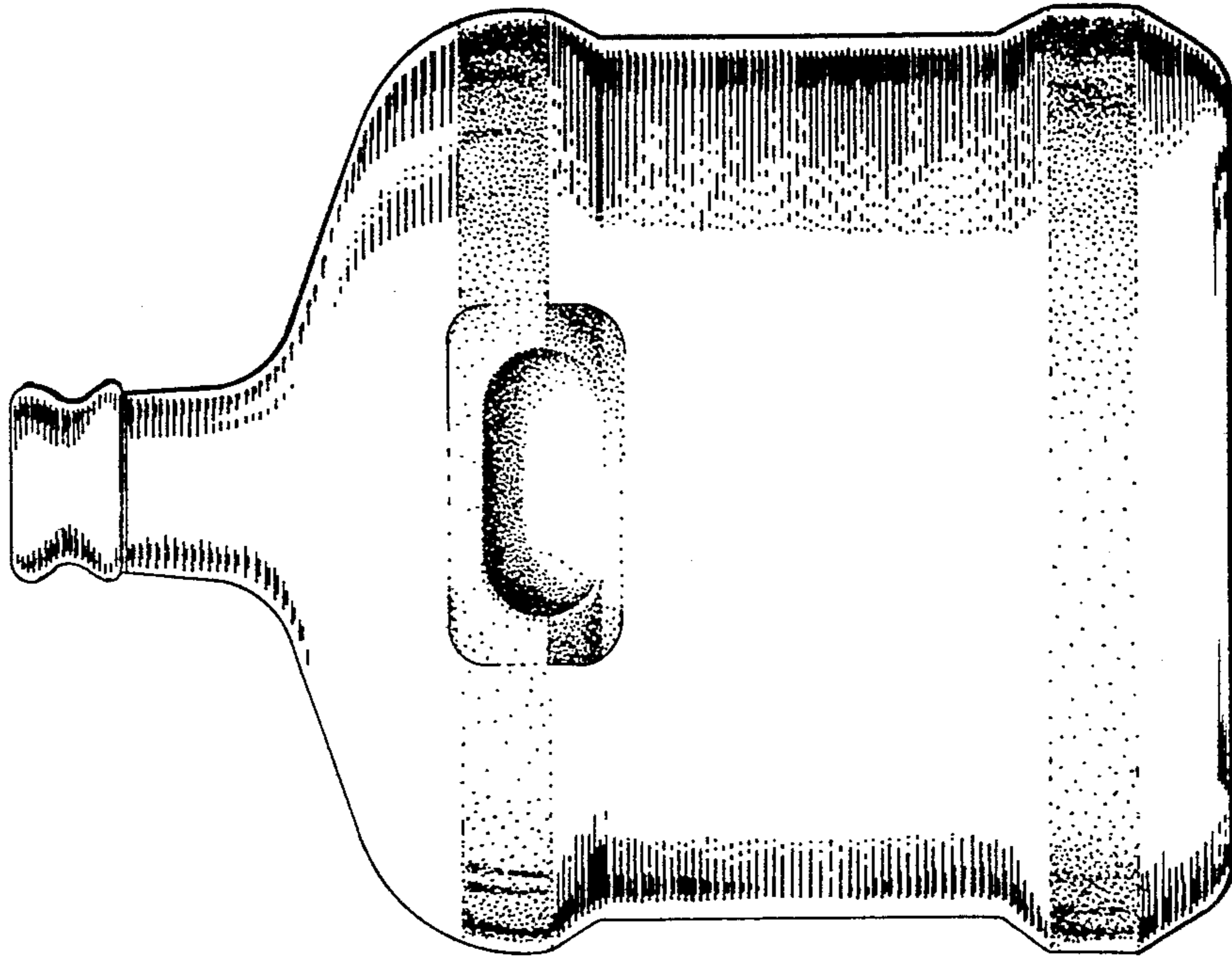

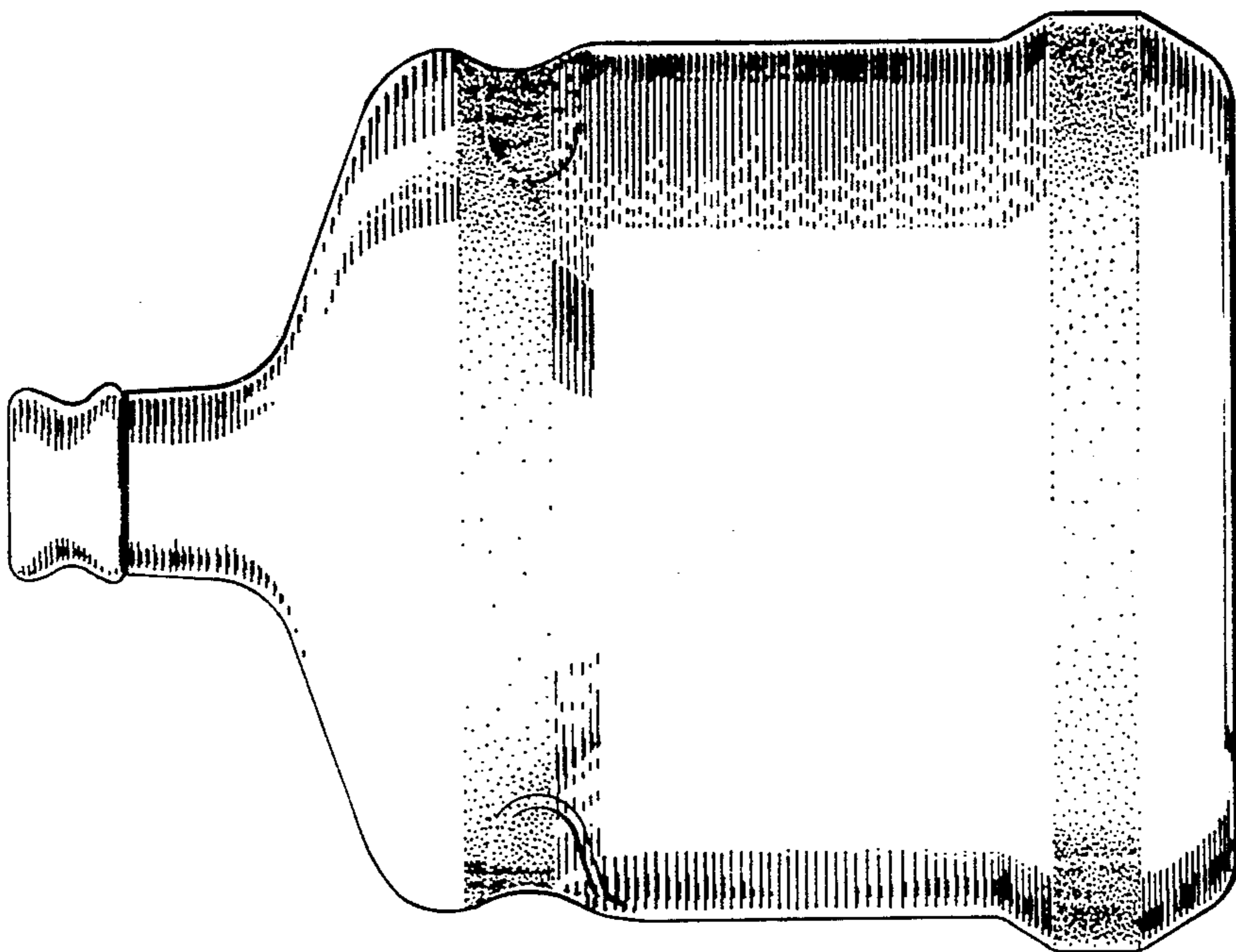

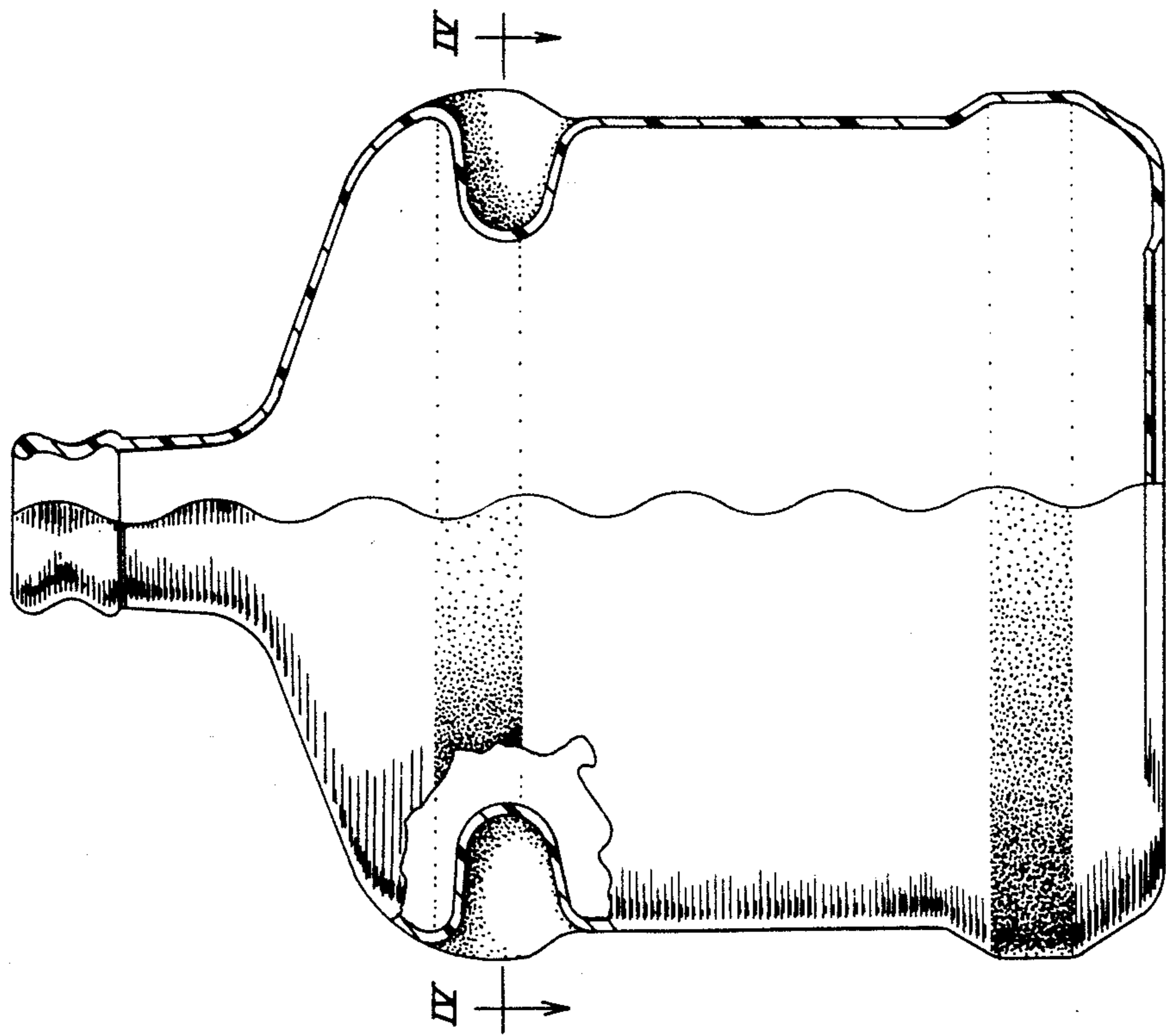

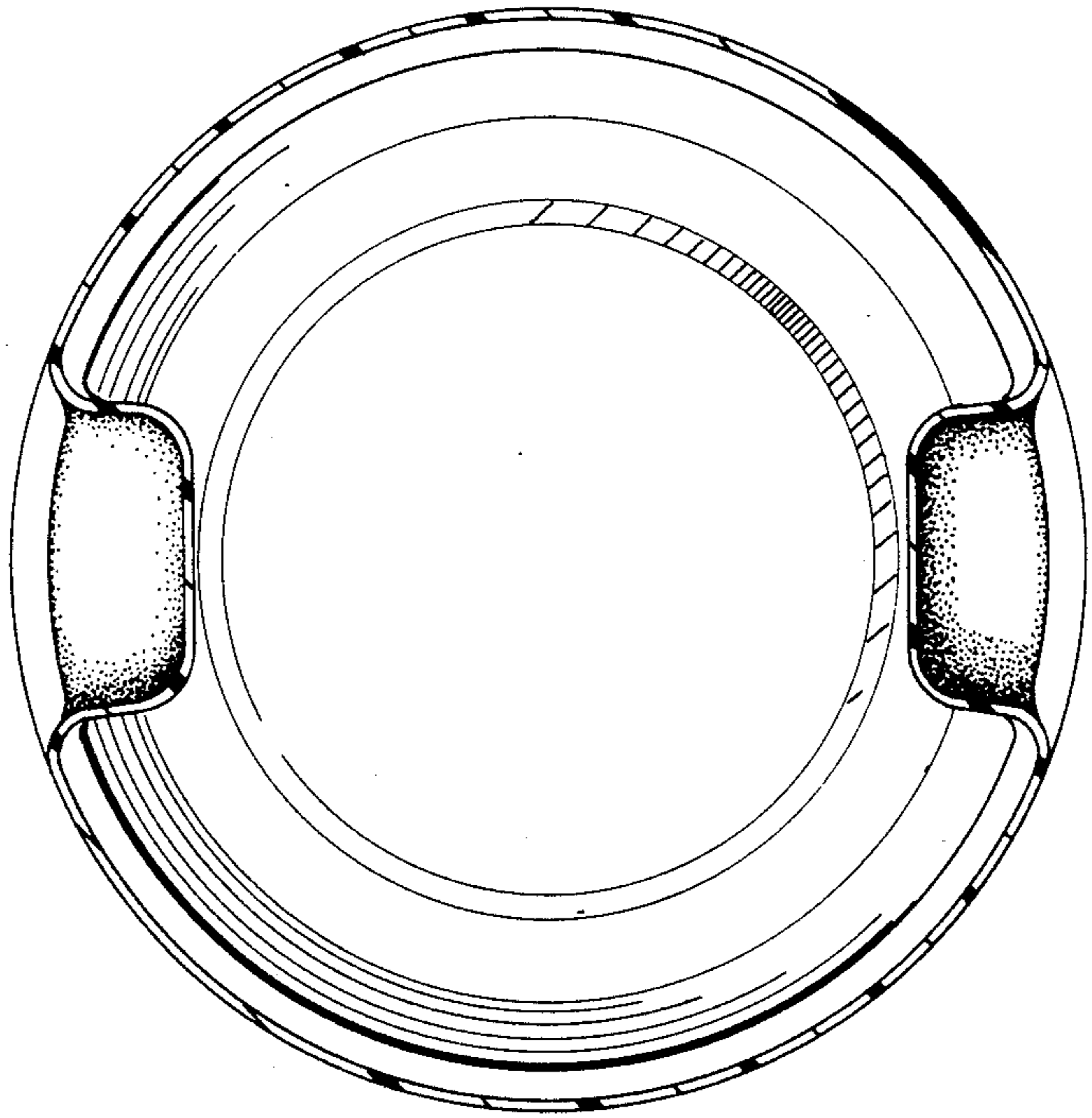
