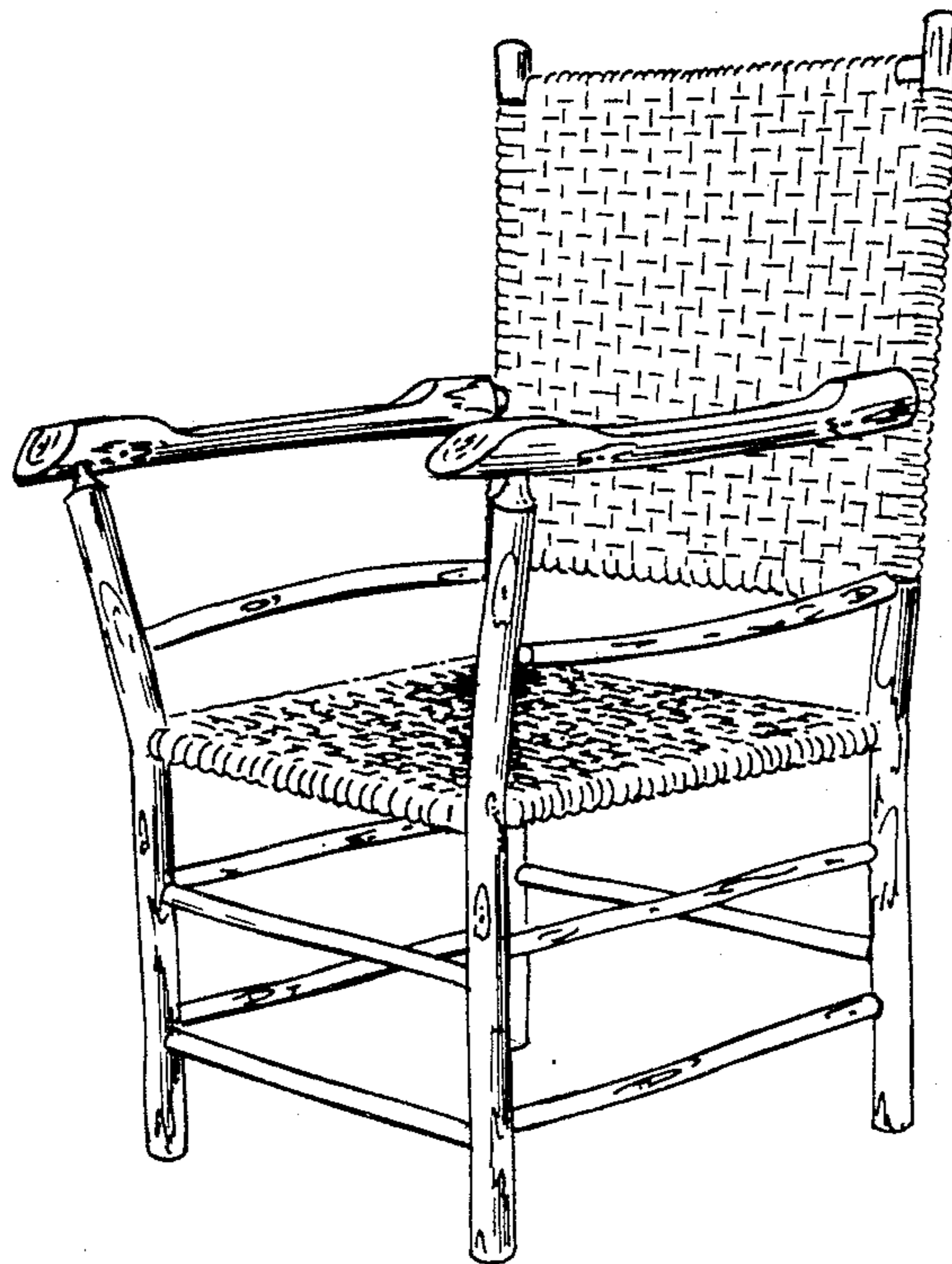

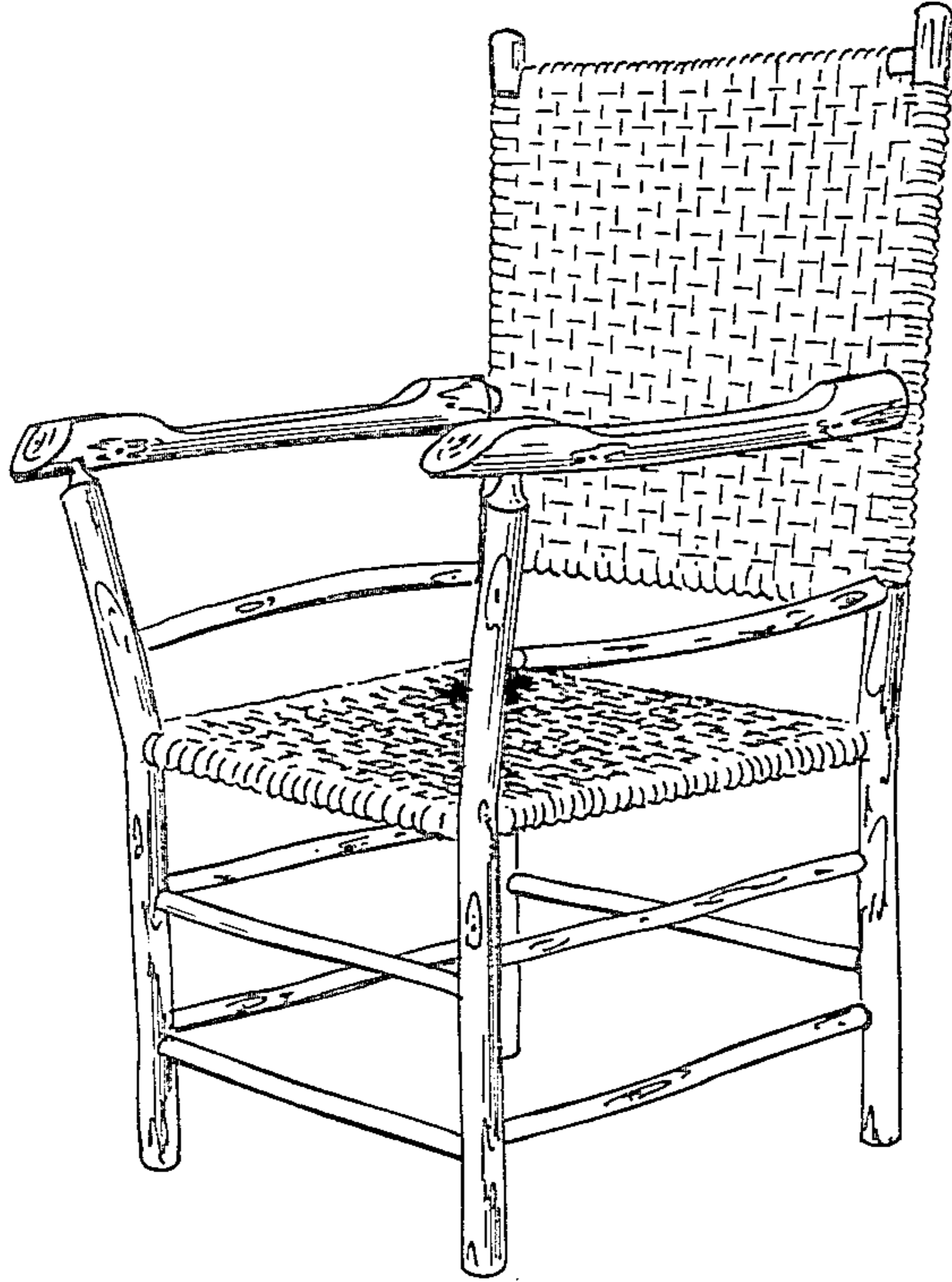

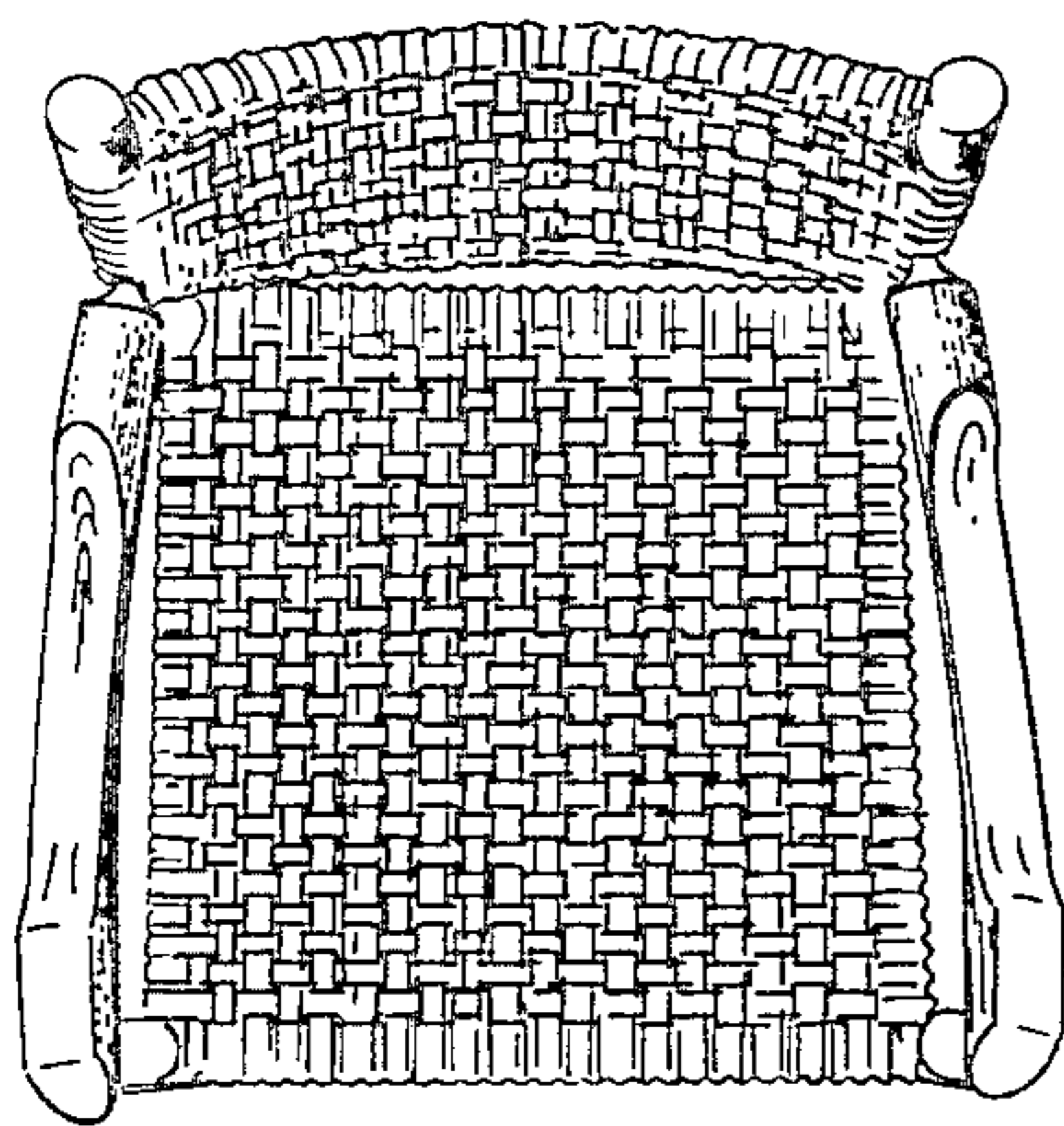
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the chair illustrated in FIG. 1.

The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the side shown while the undisclosed rear is conventional in appearance.

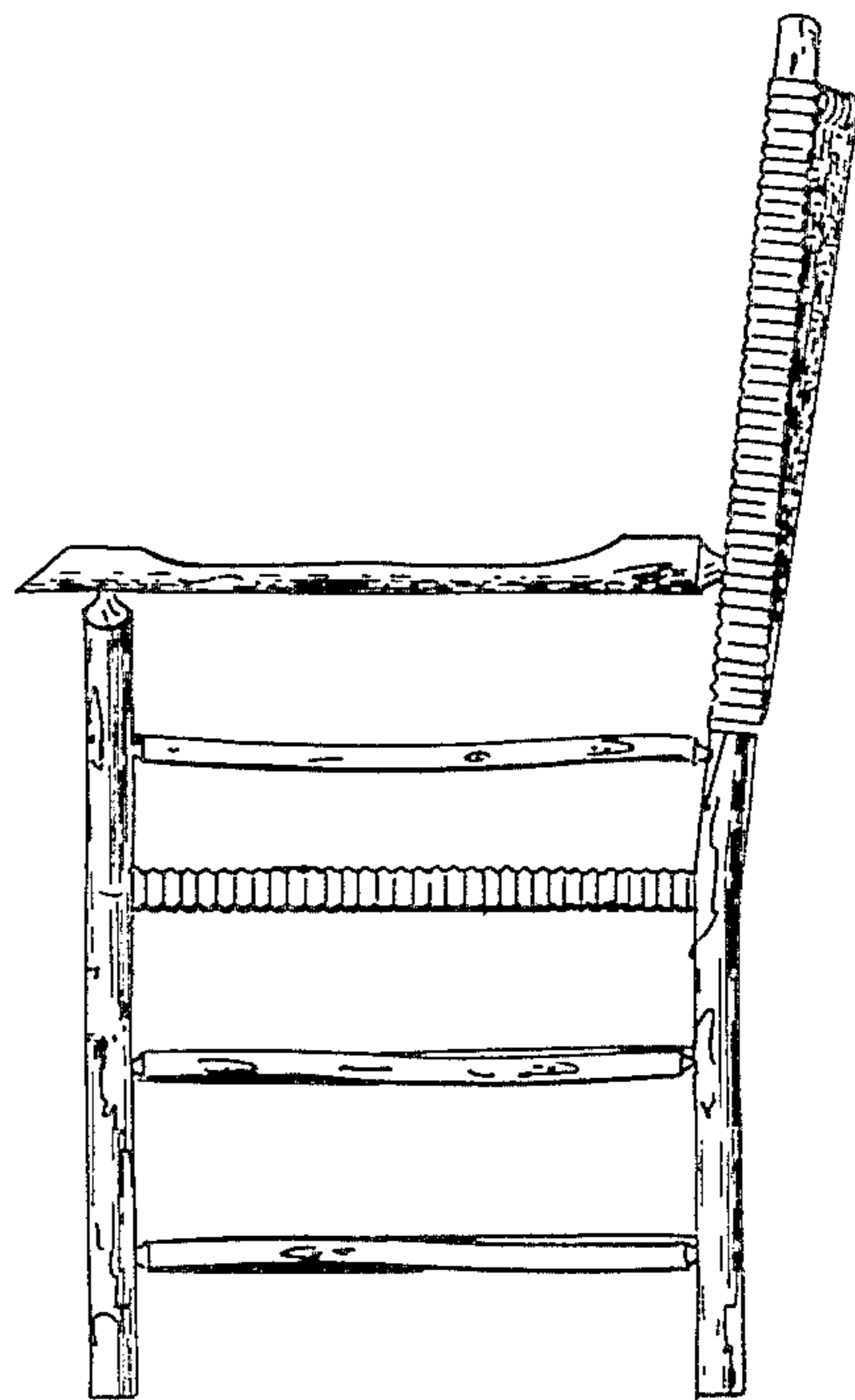
