

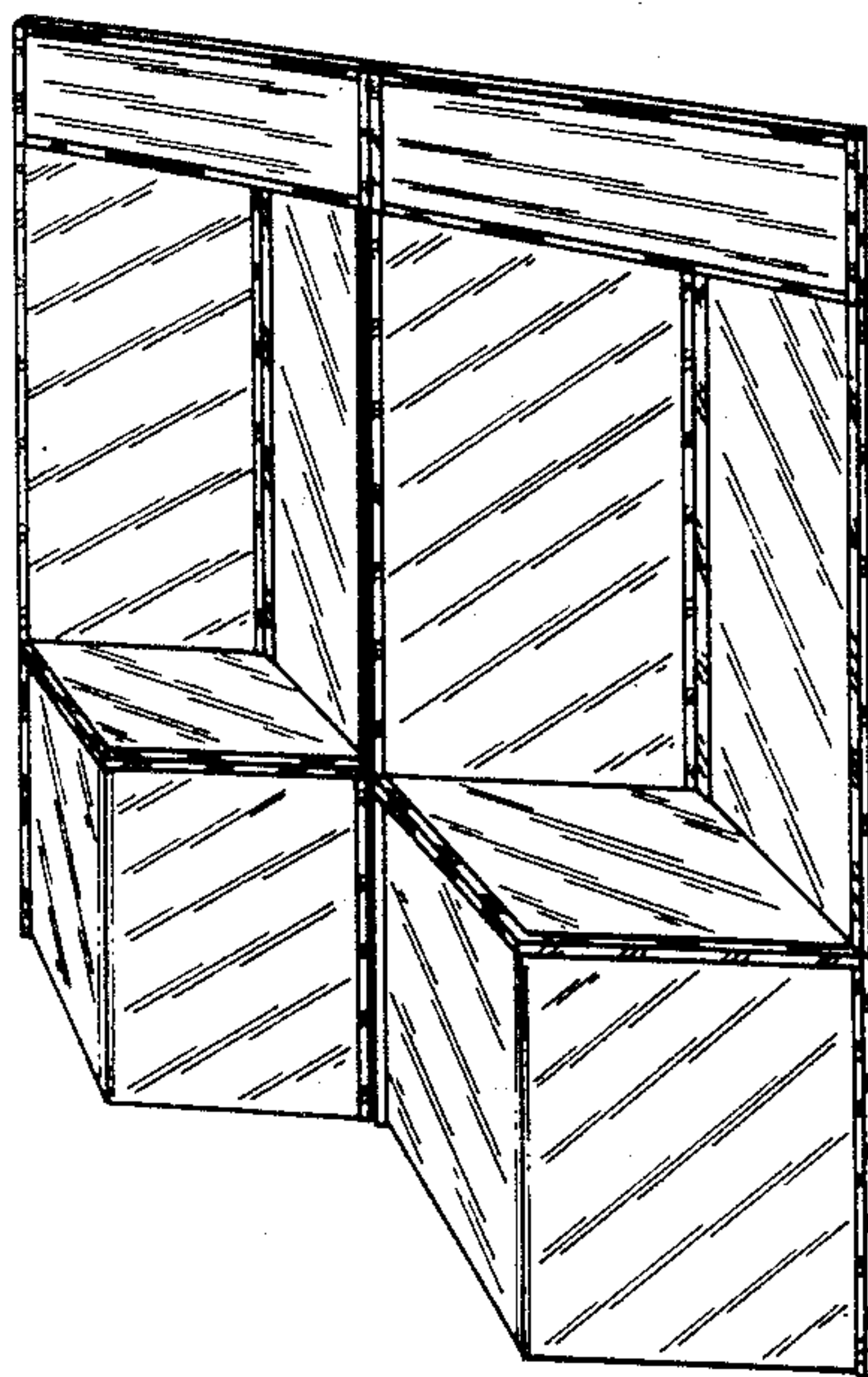

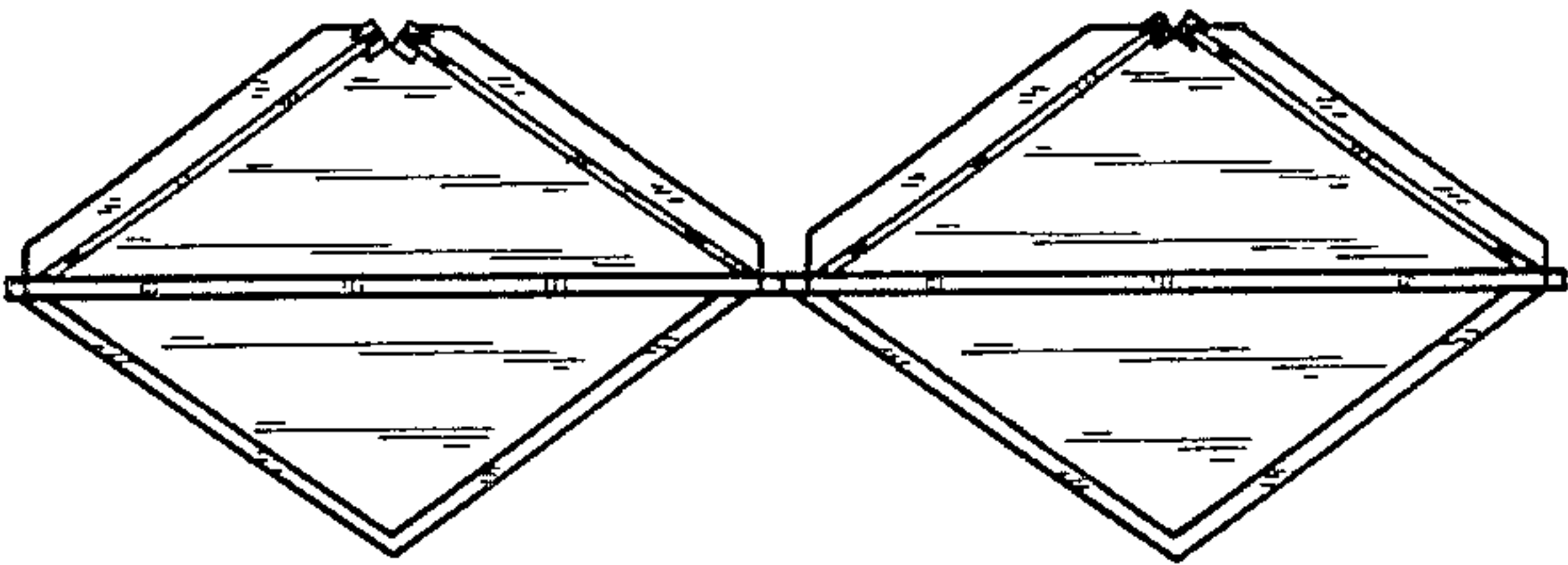

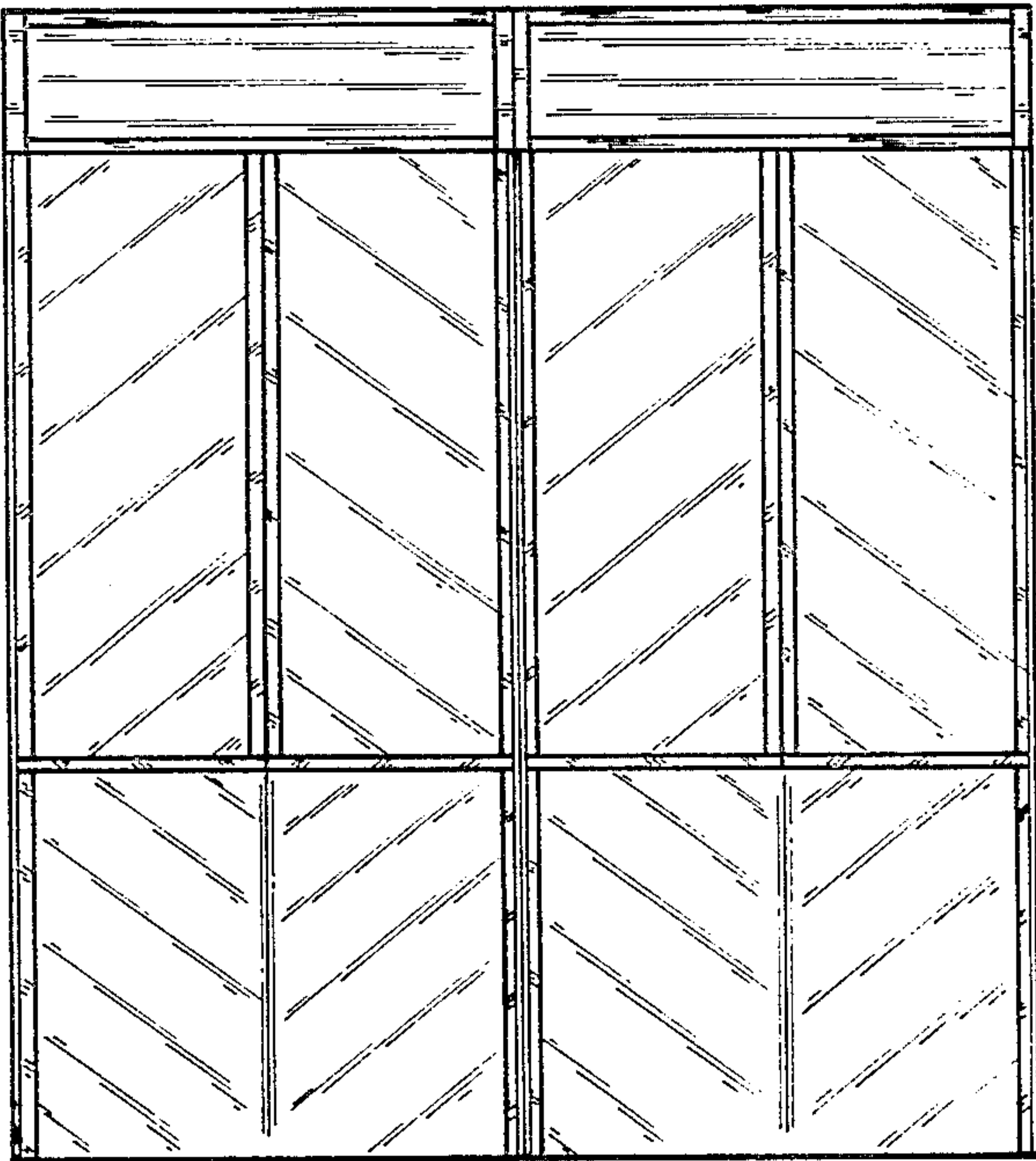
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 5 is a right side perspective view thereof.

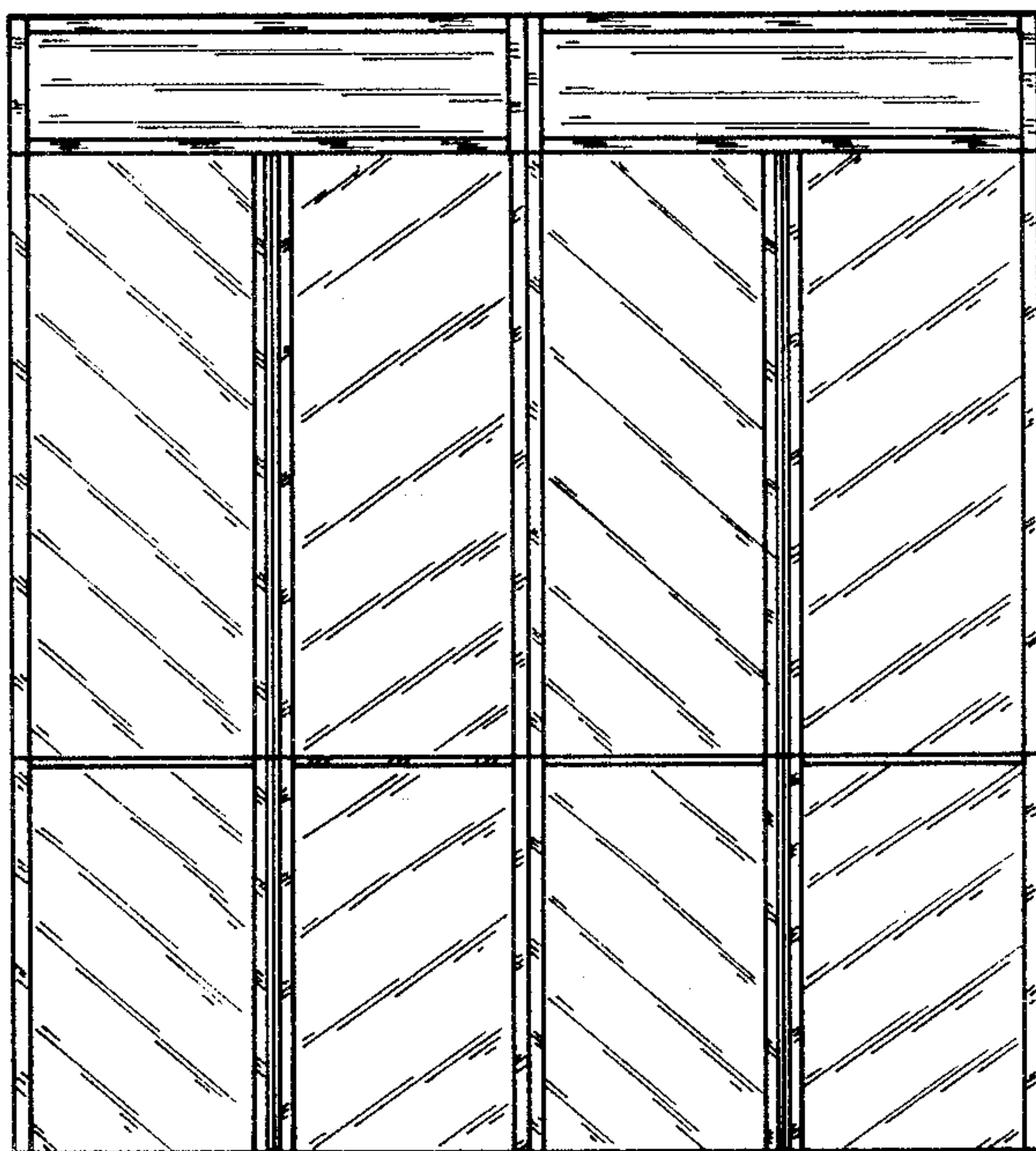




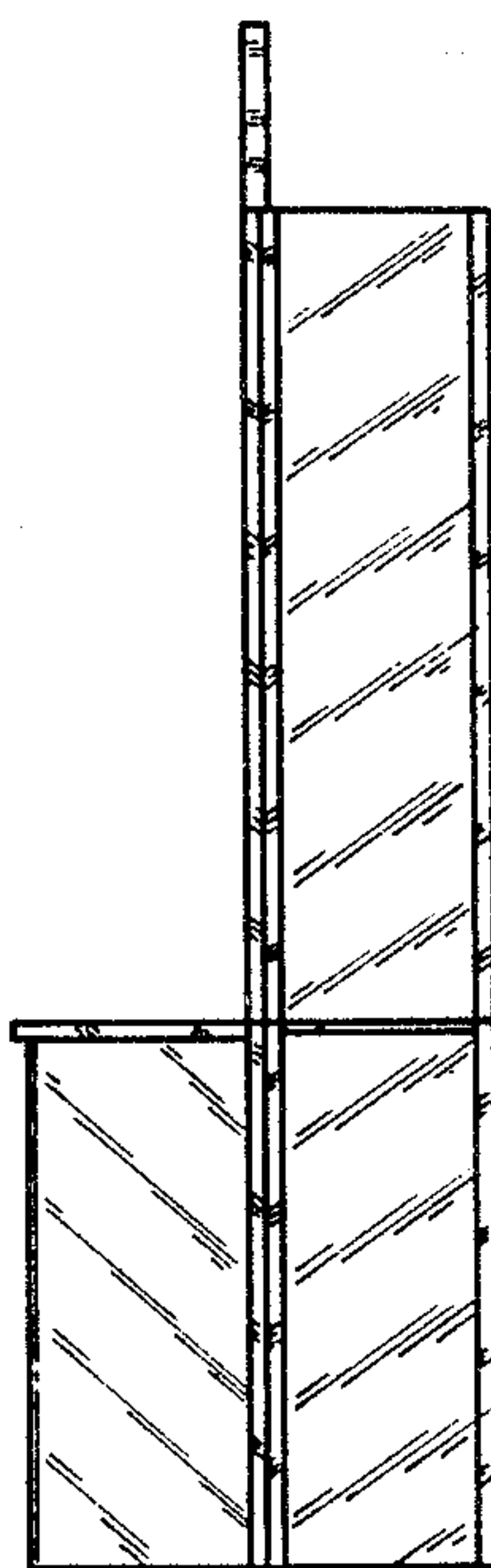

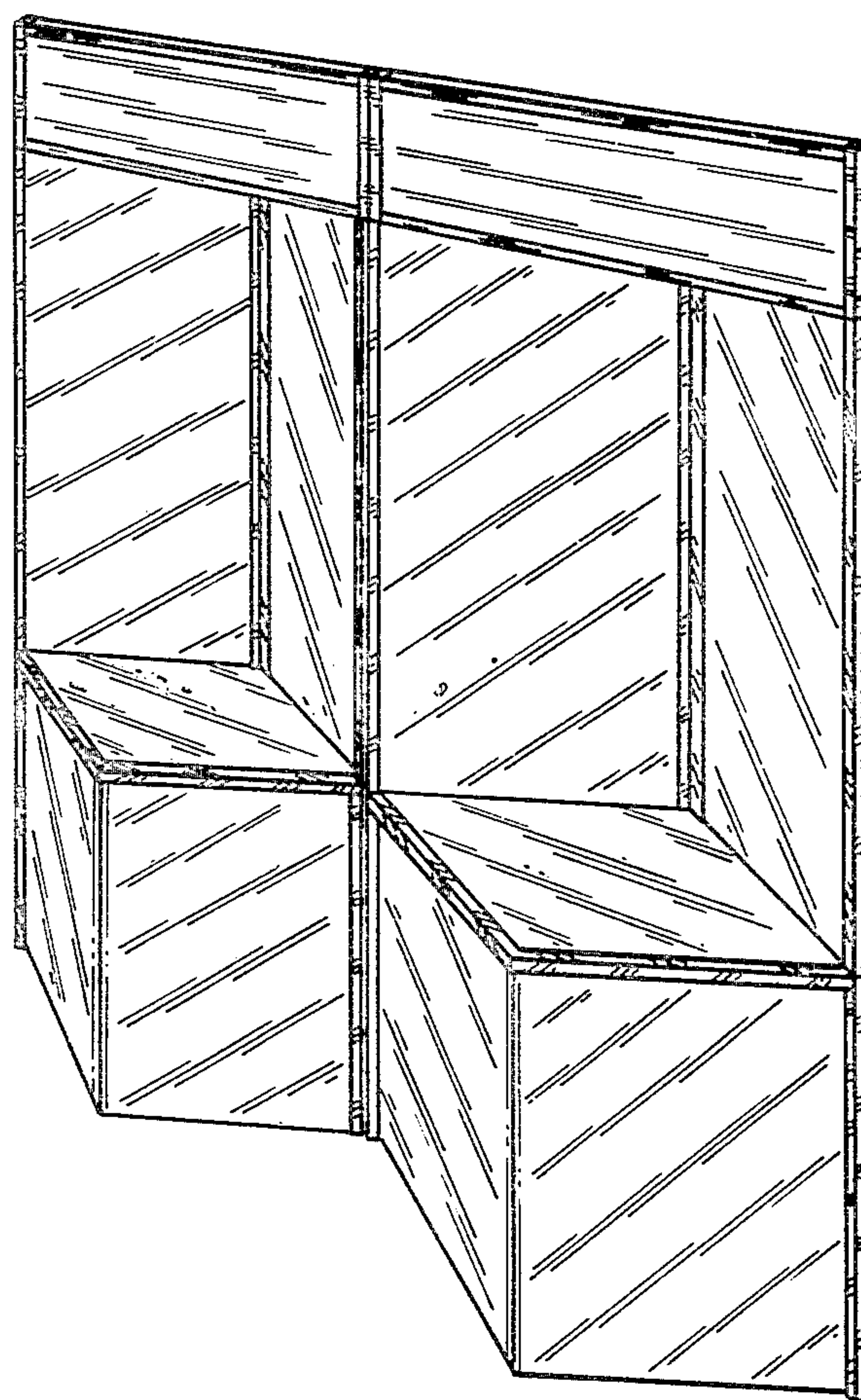
