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[57] CLAIM

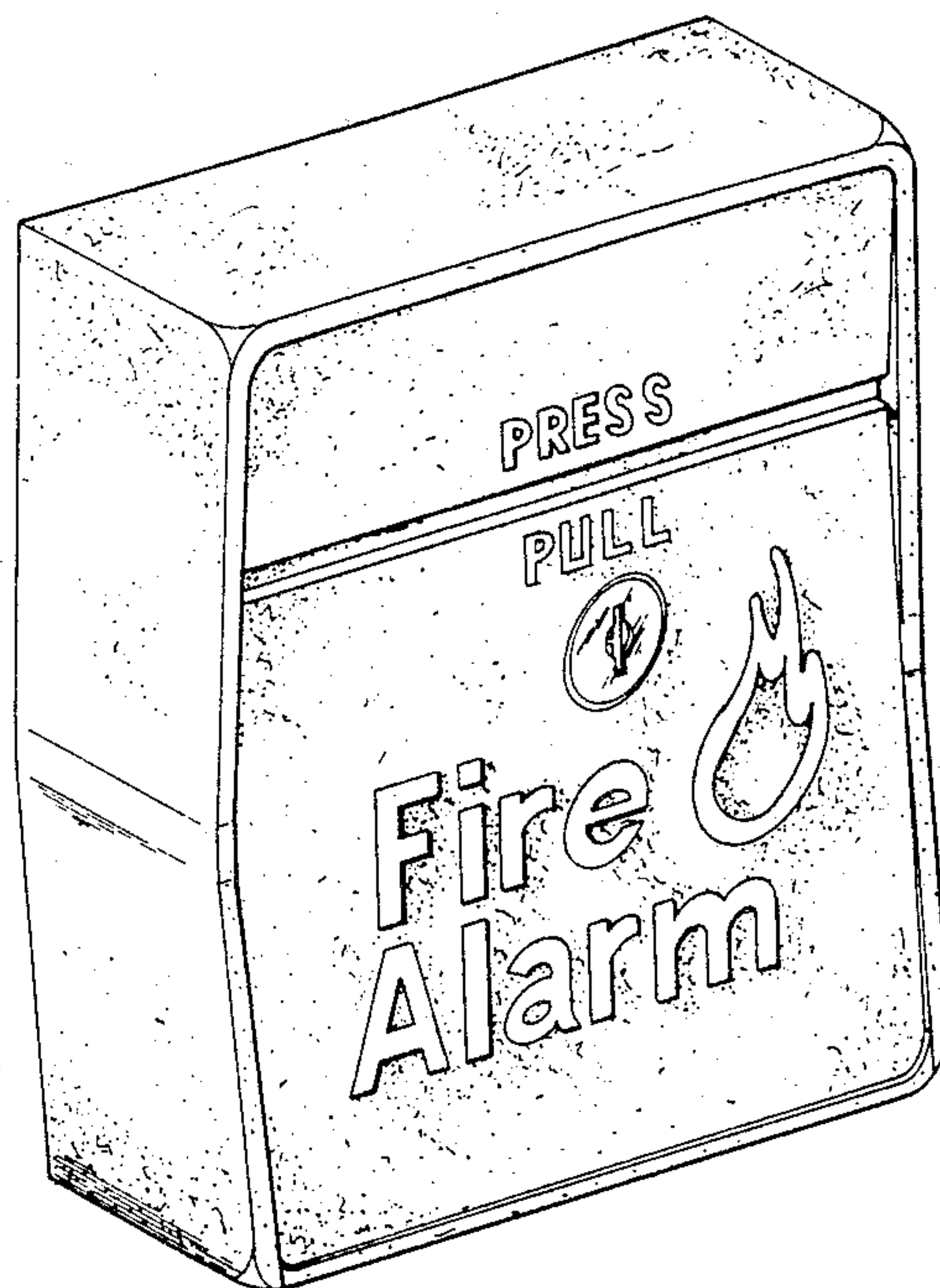
The ornamental design for a fire alarm housing, substantially as shown.

FIG. 3 is a perspective view thereof as seen from the top, front and opposite side of FIG. 2.



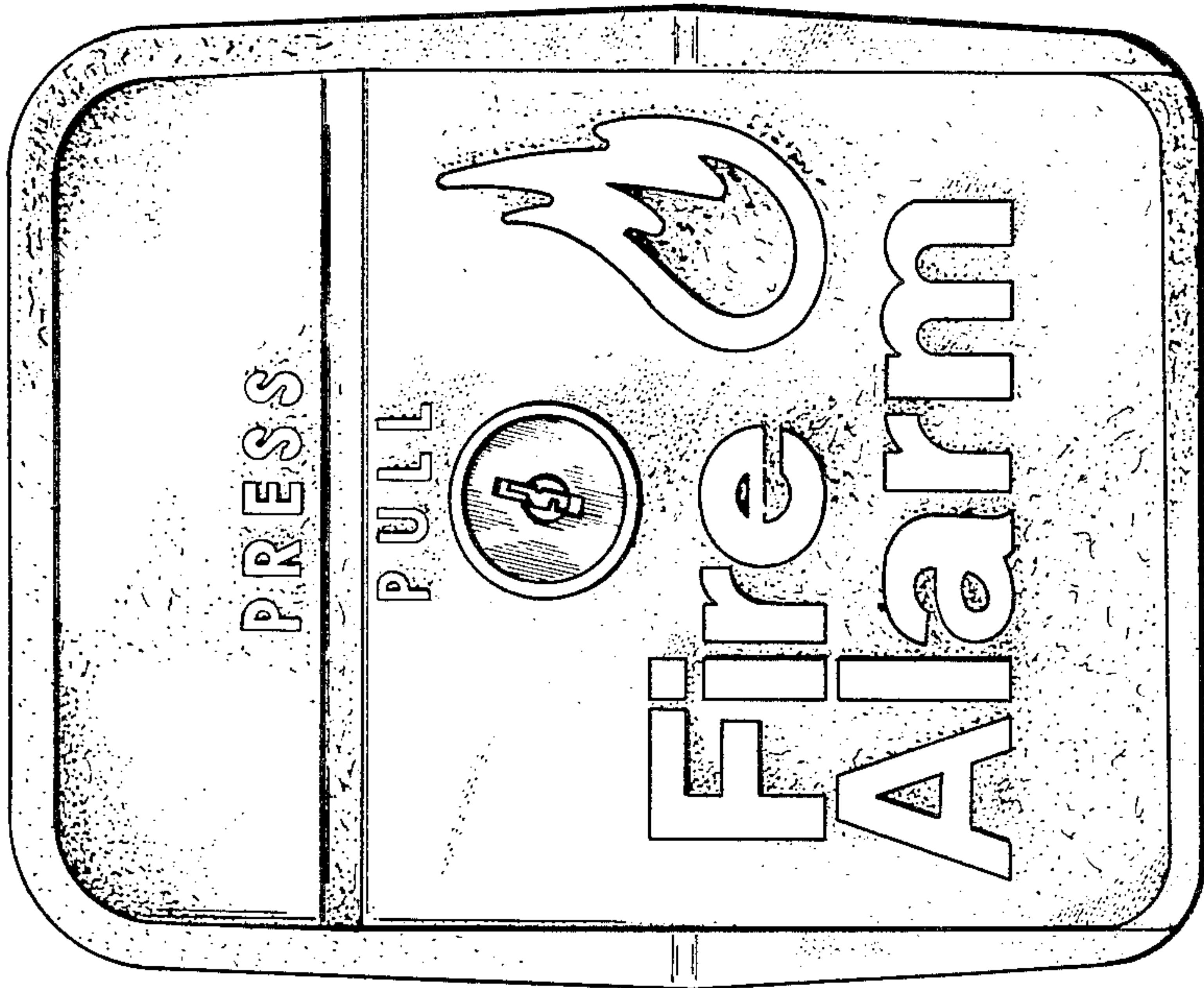

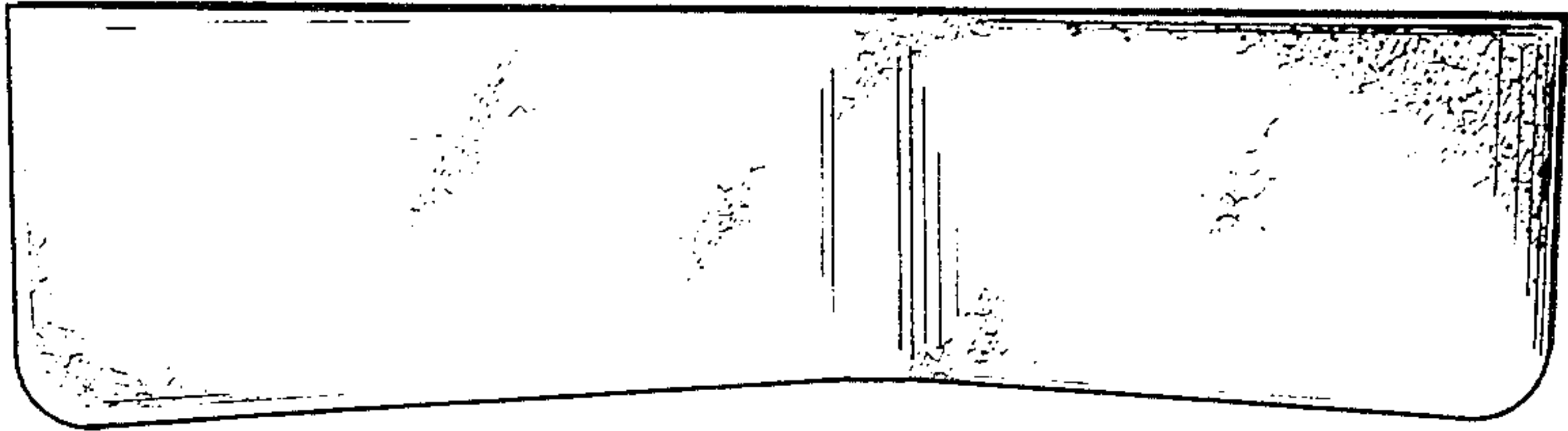
