DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a telephone showing my new design;

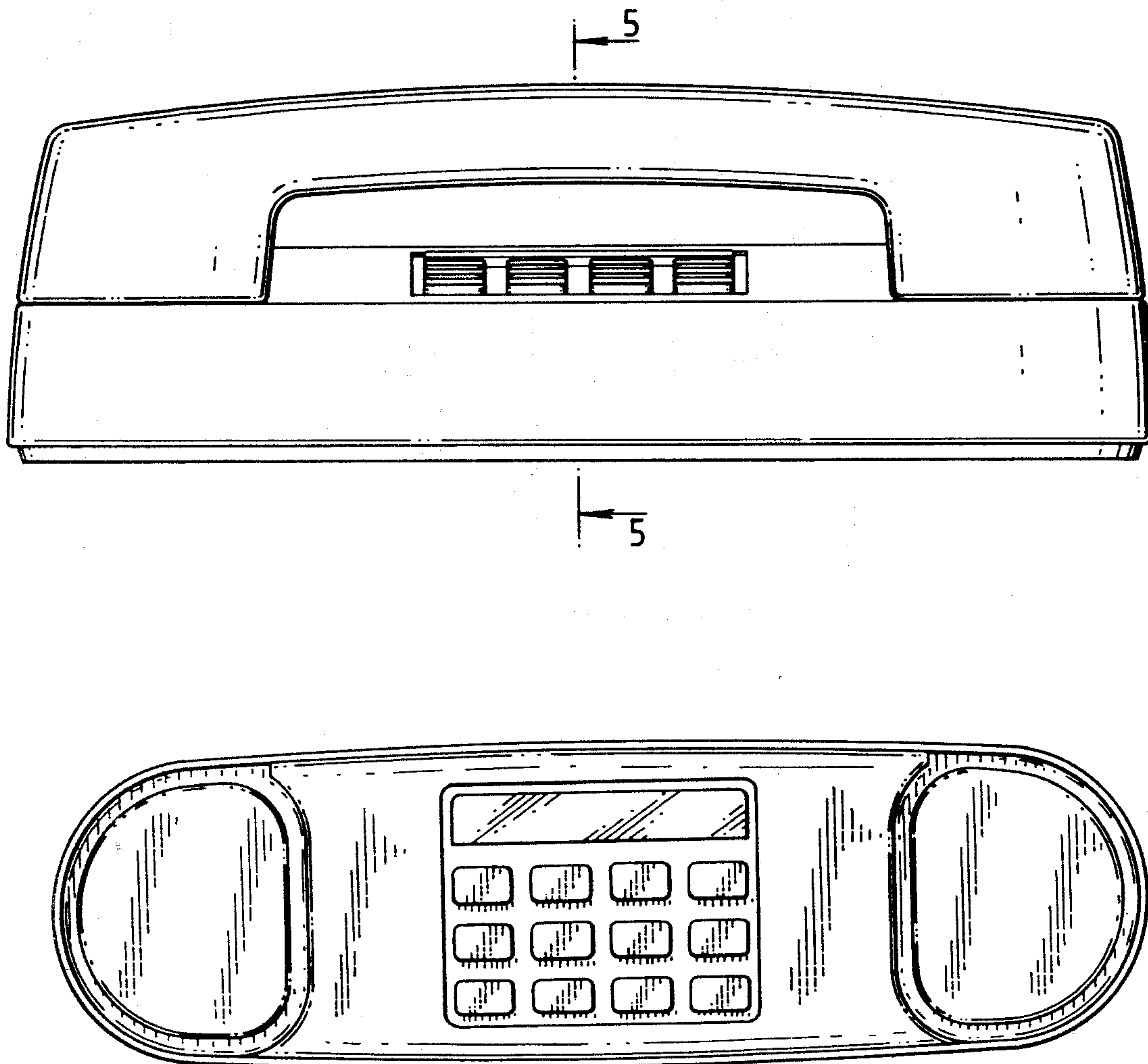
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the handset, the side view opposite thereto being a mirror image.



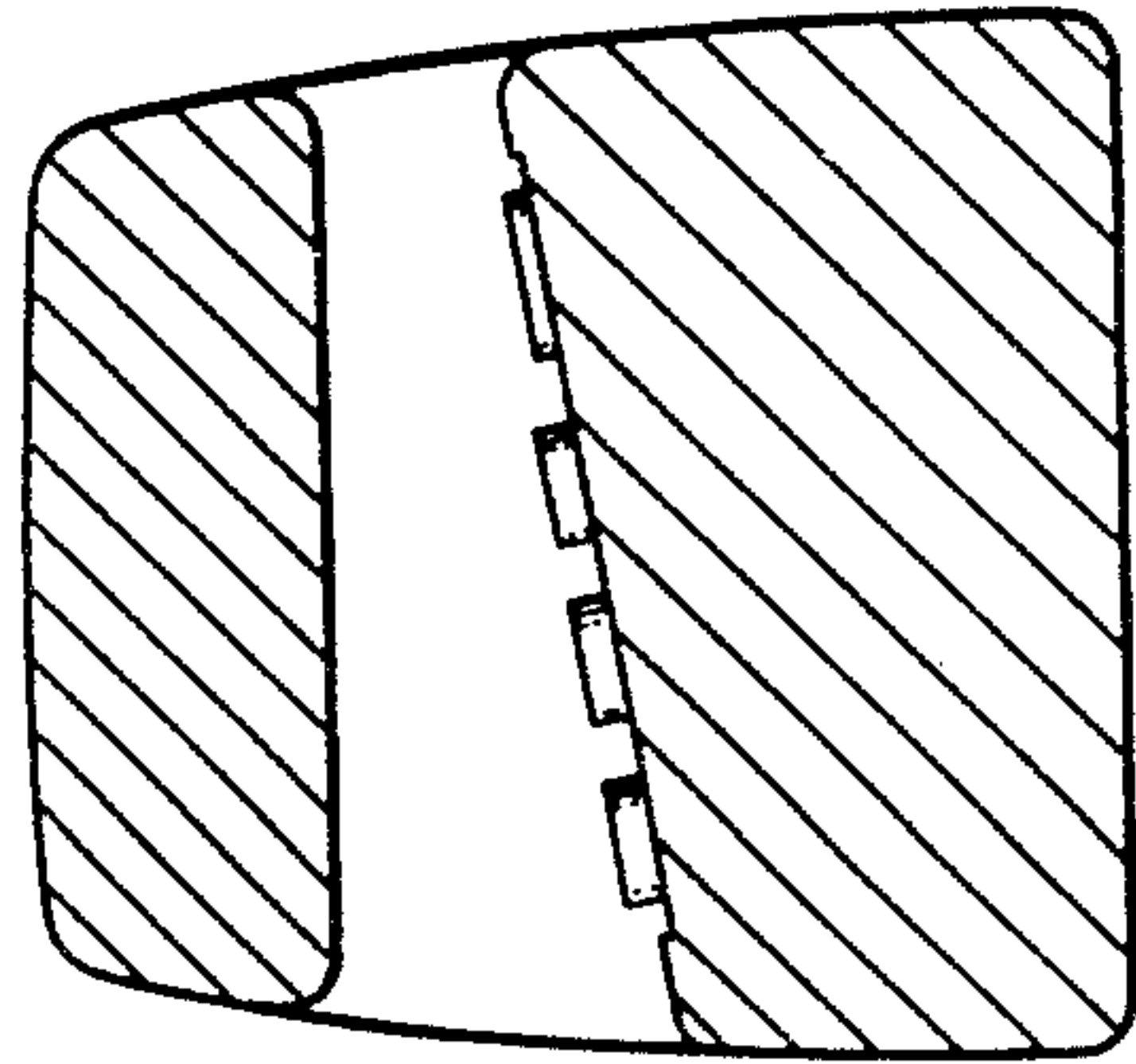
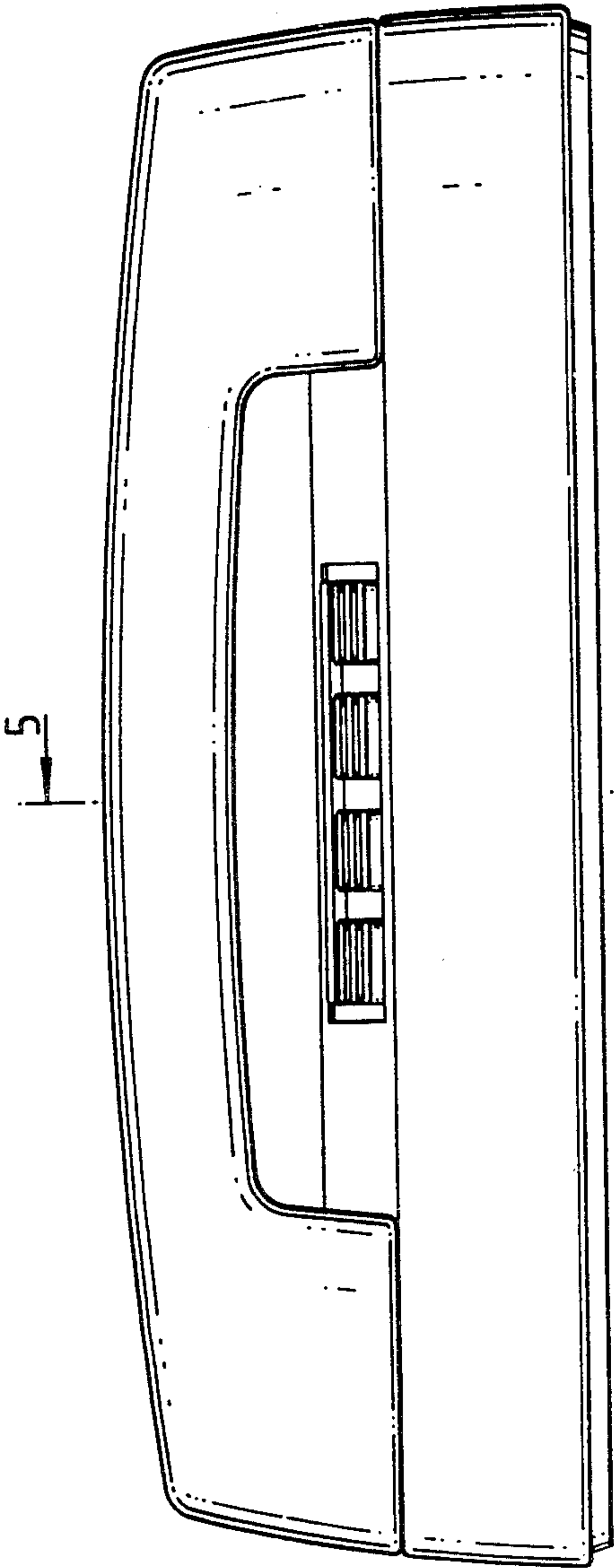

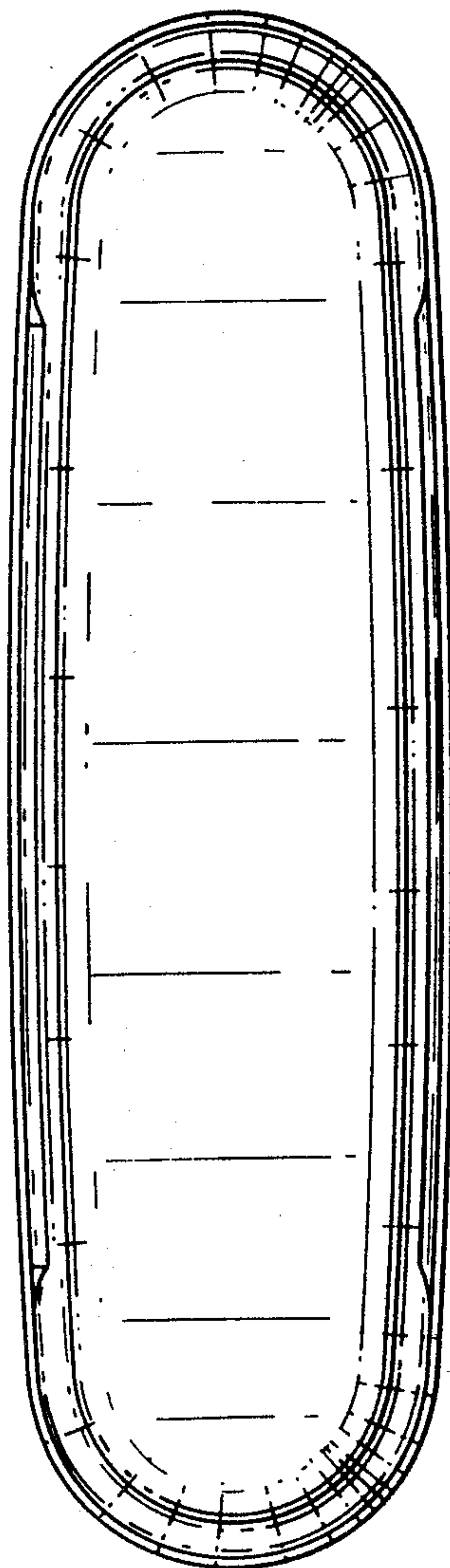

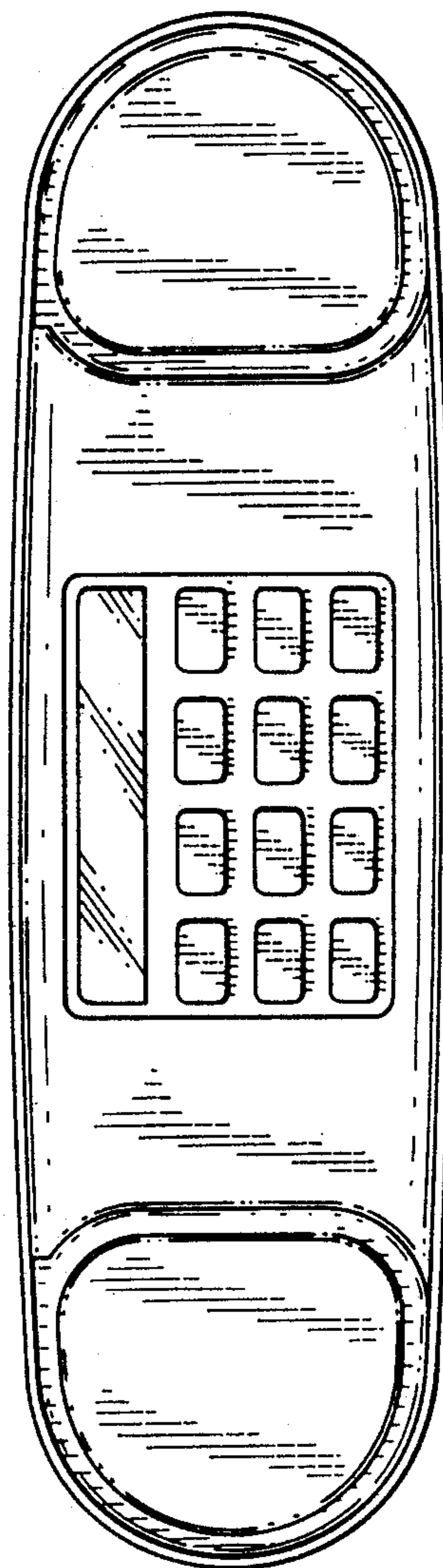

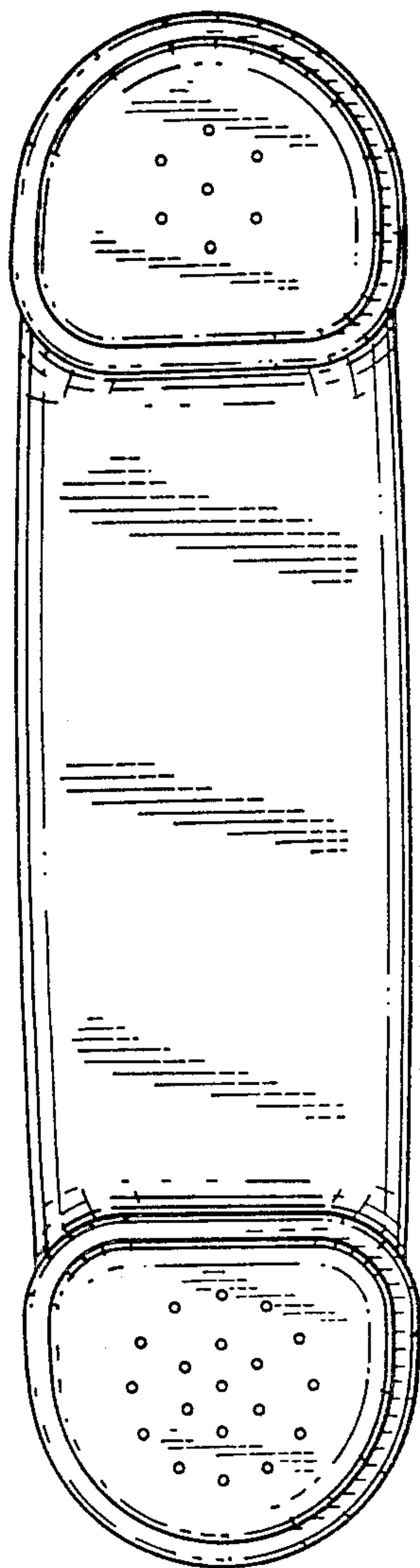
