FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the teaching machine.

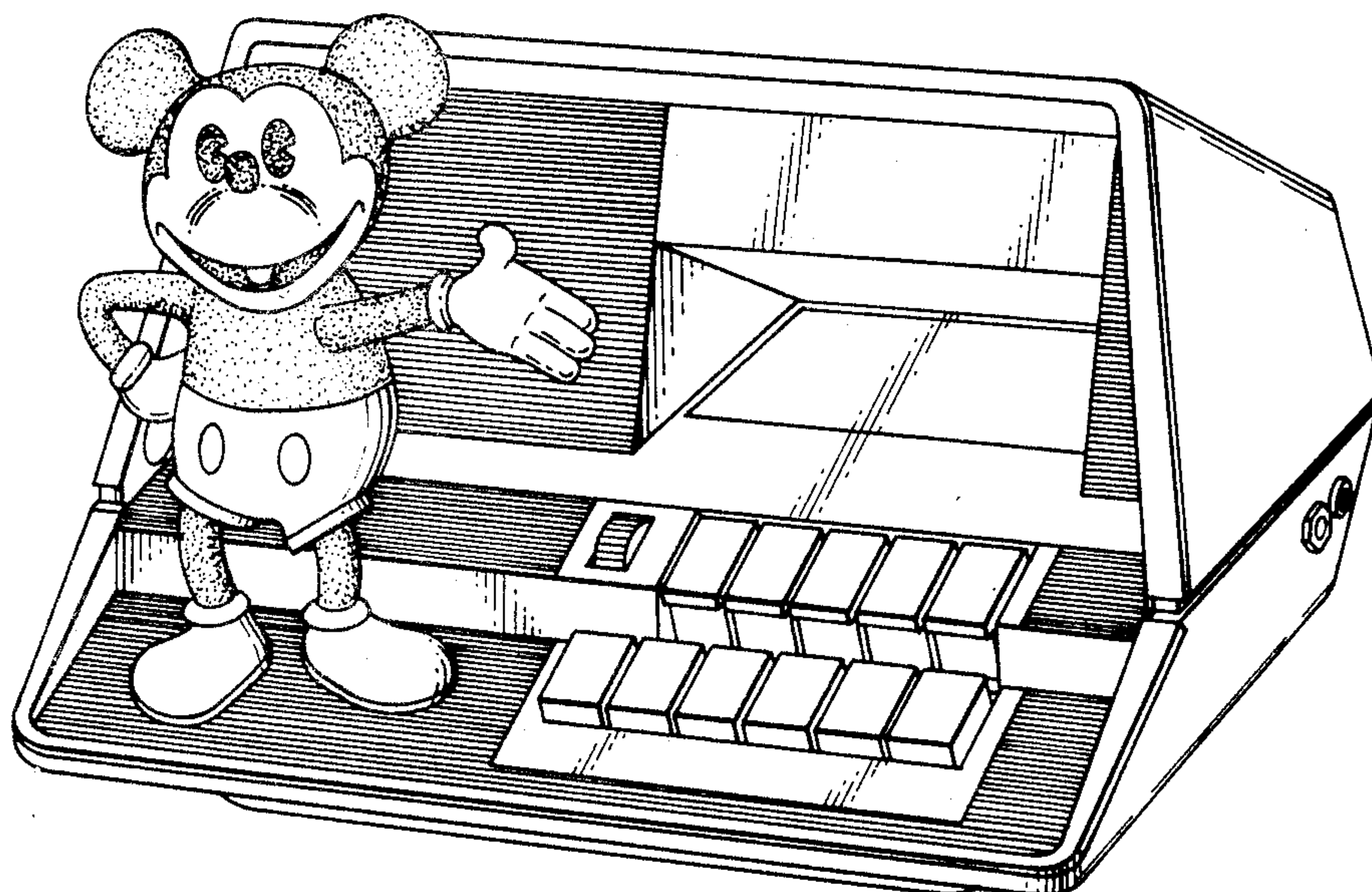

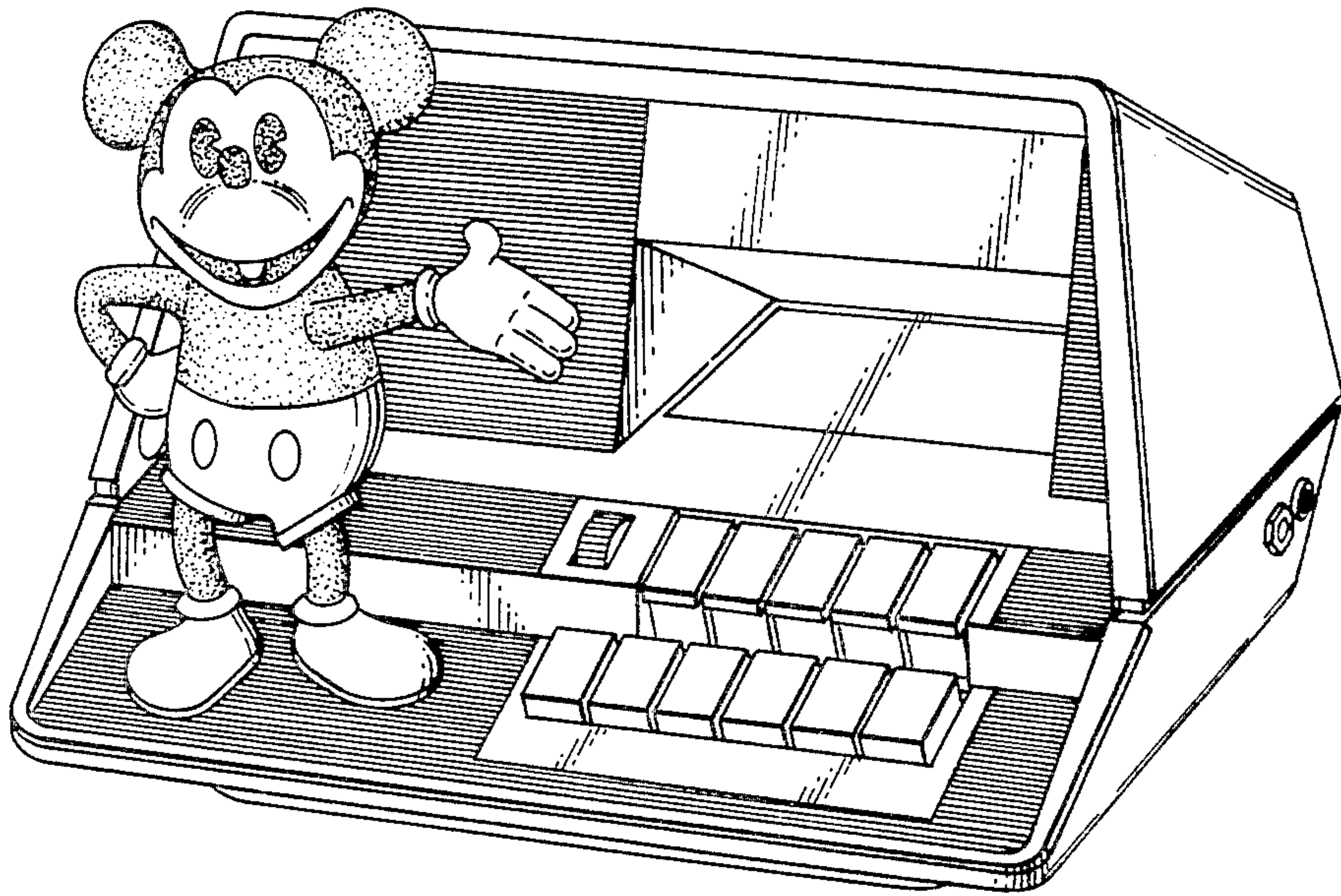

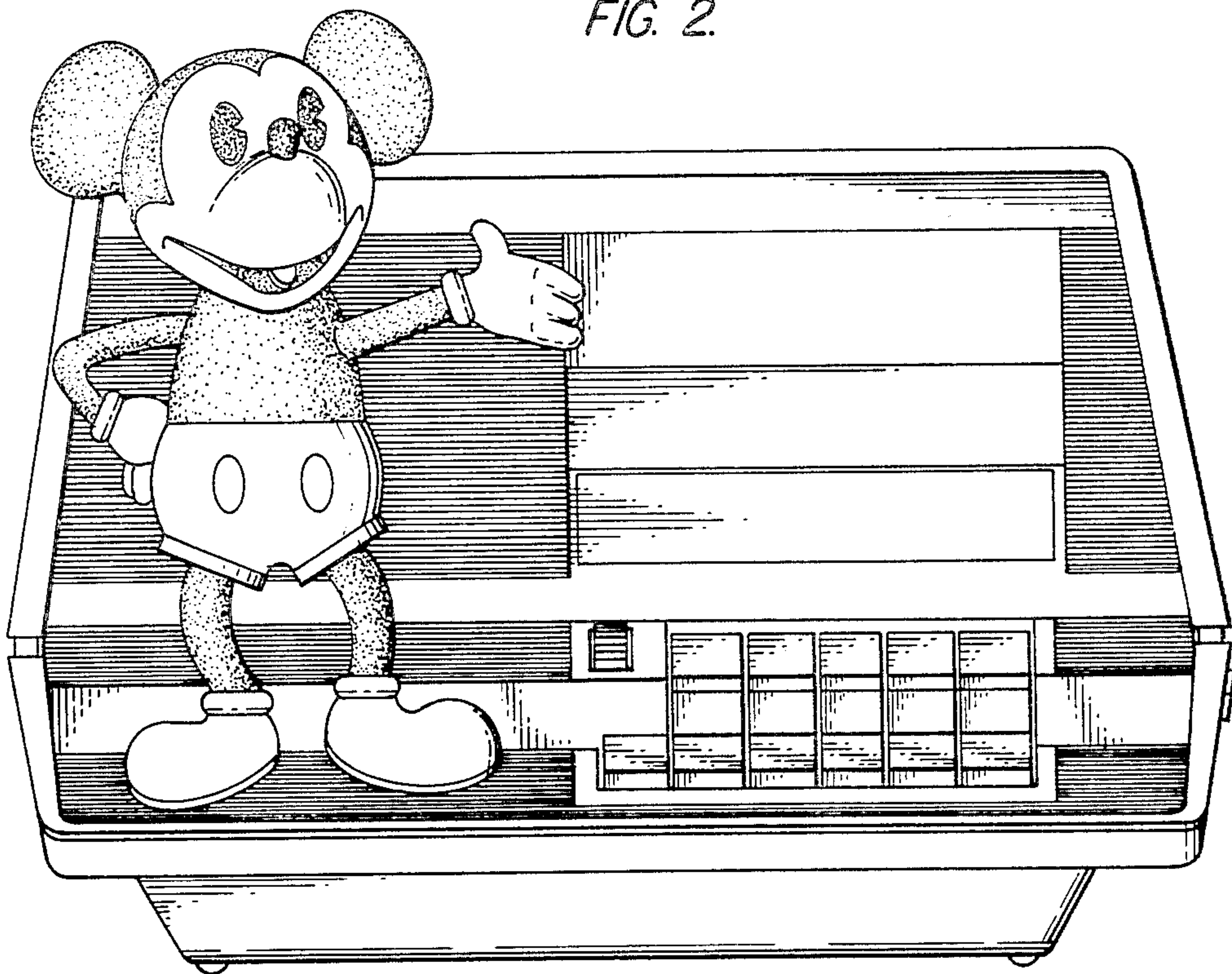

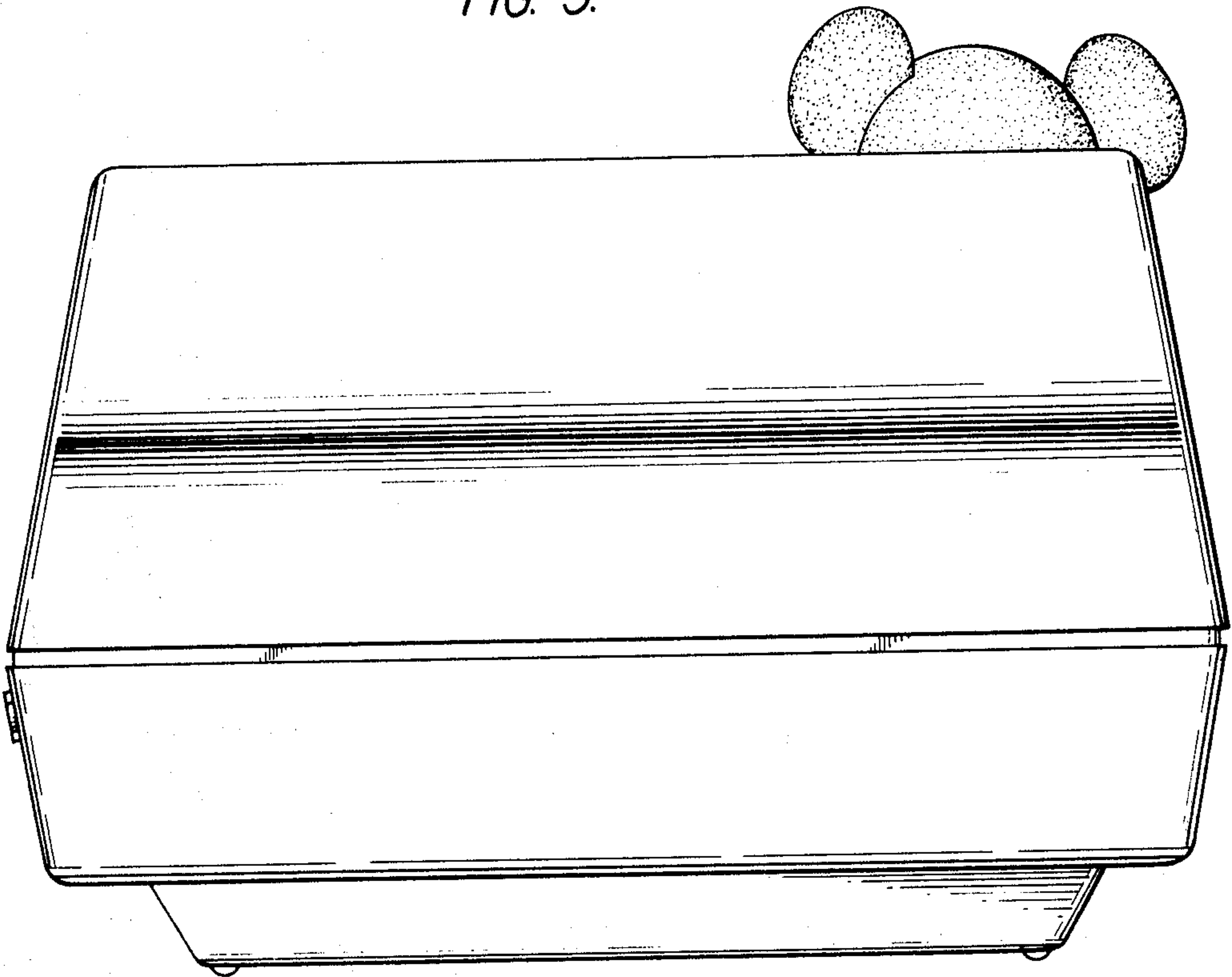

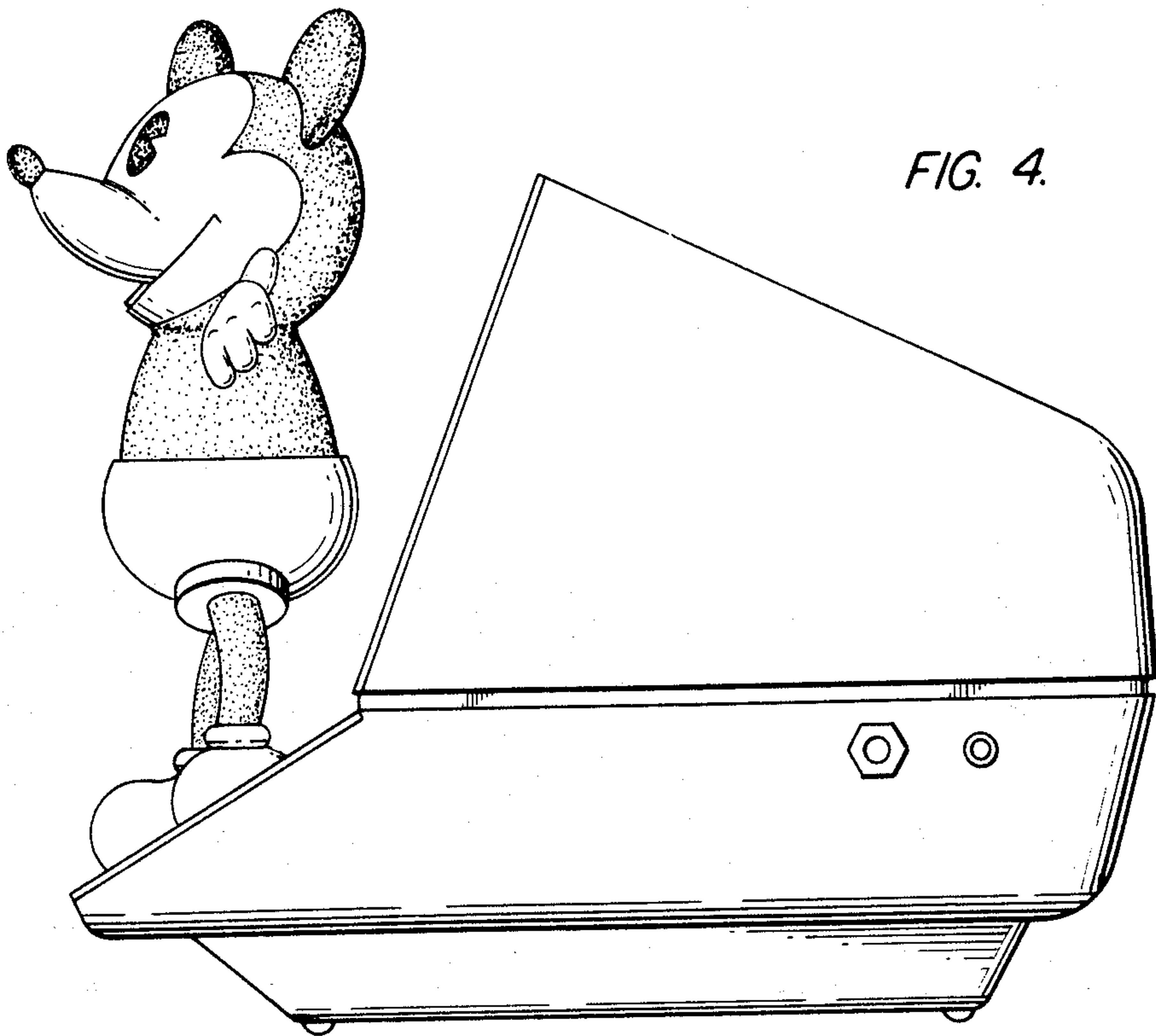

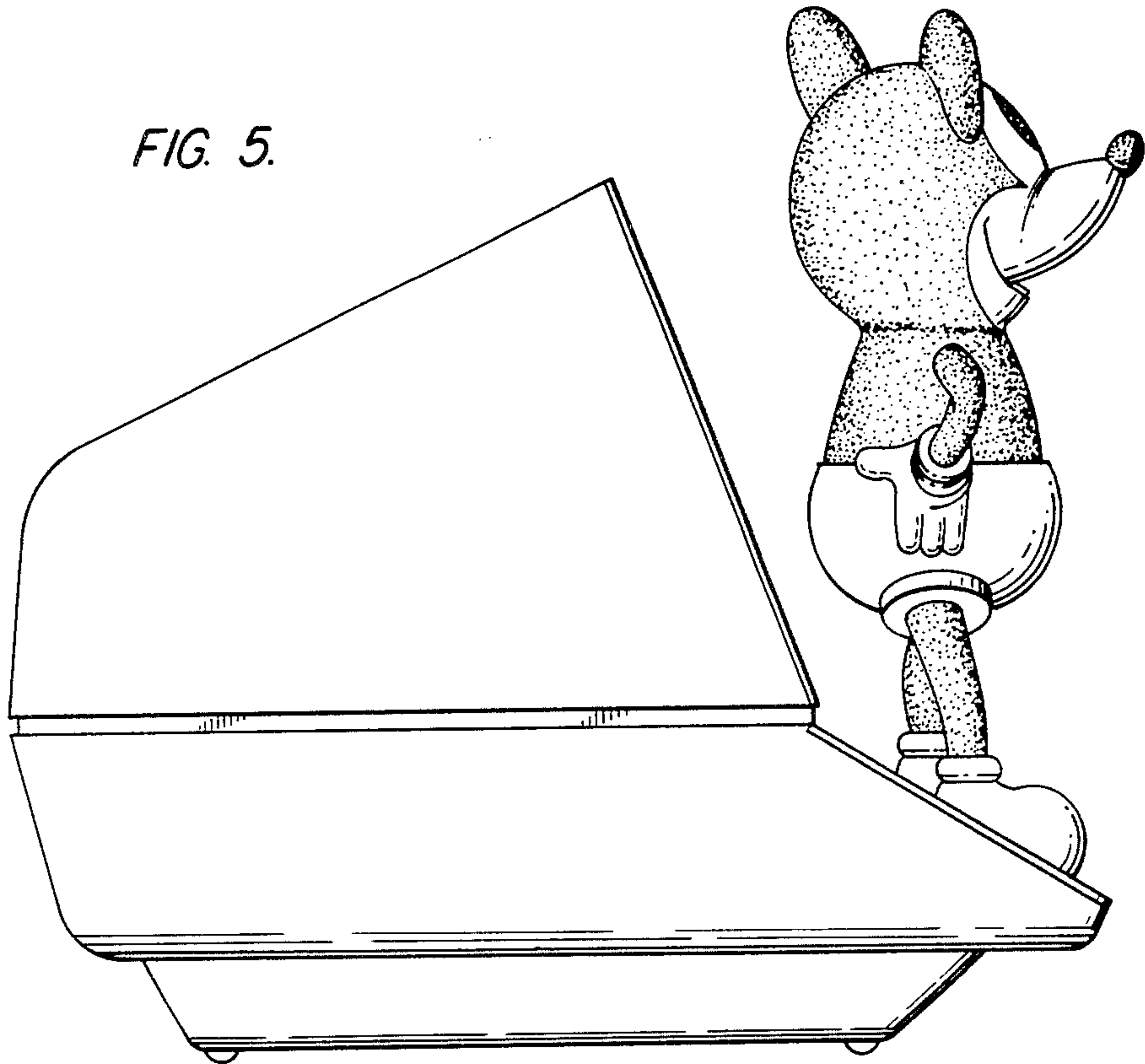
