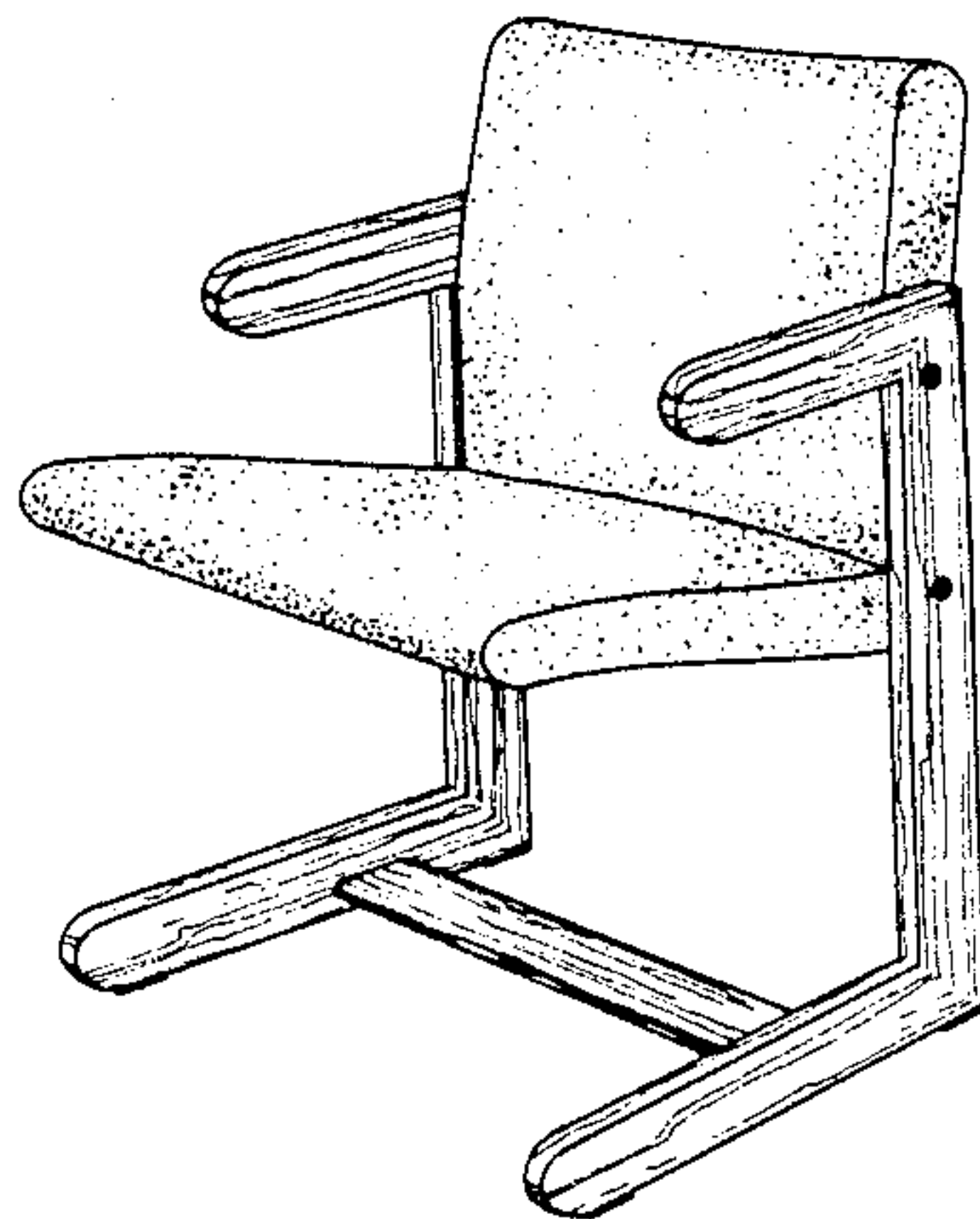

being substantially identical.



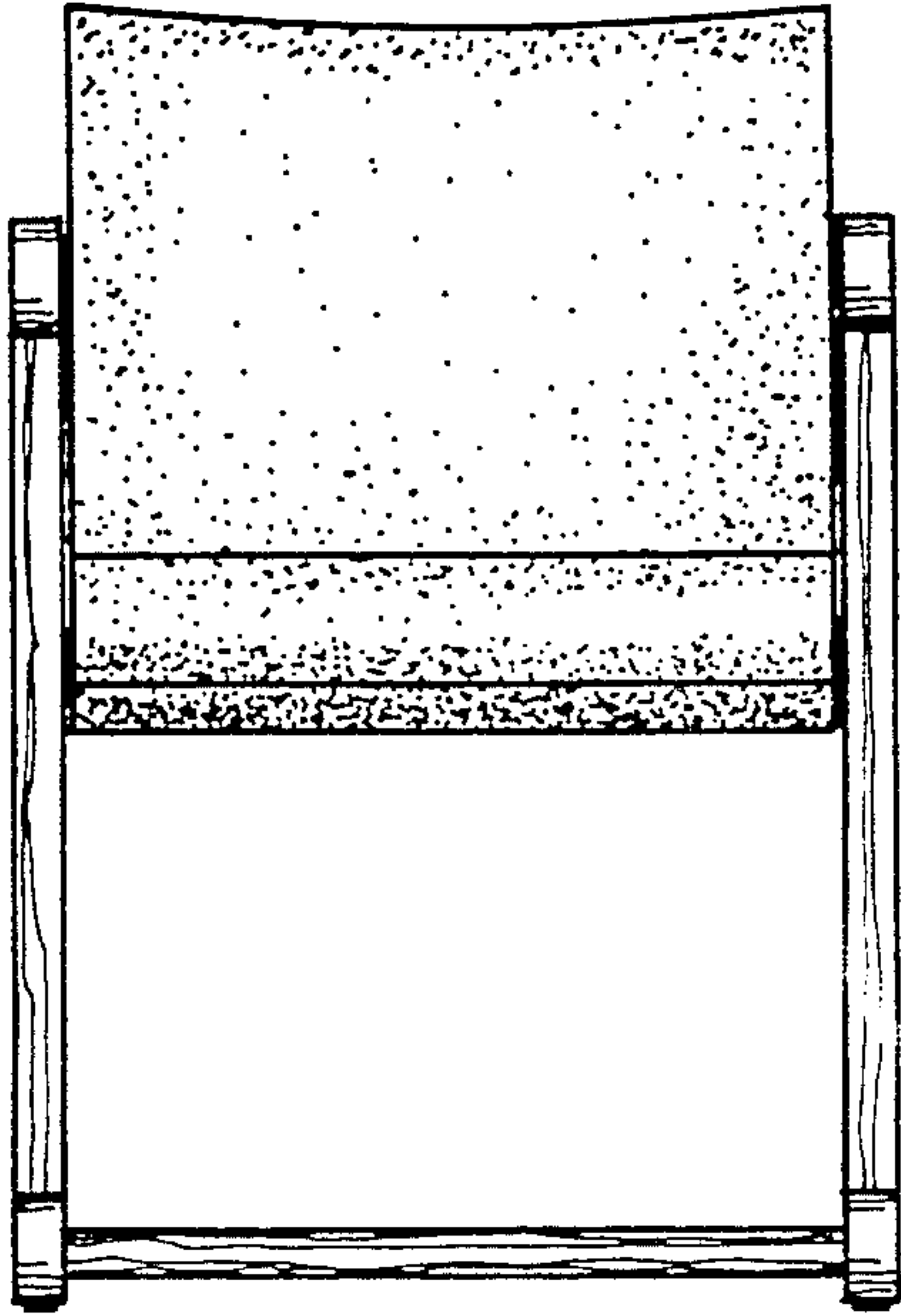

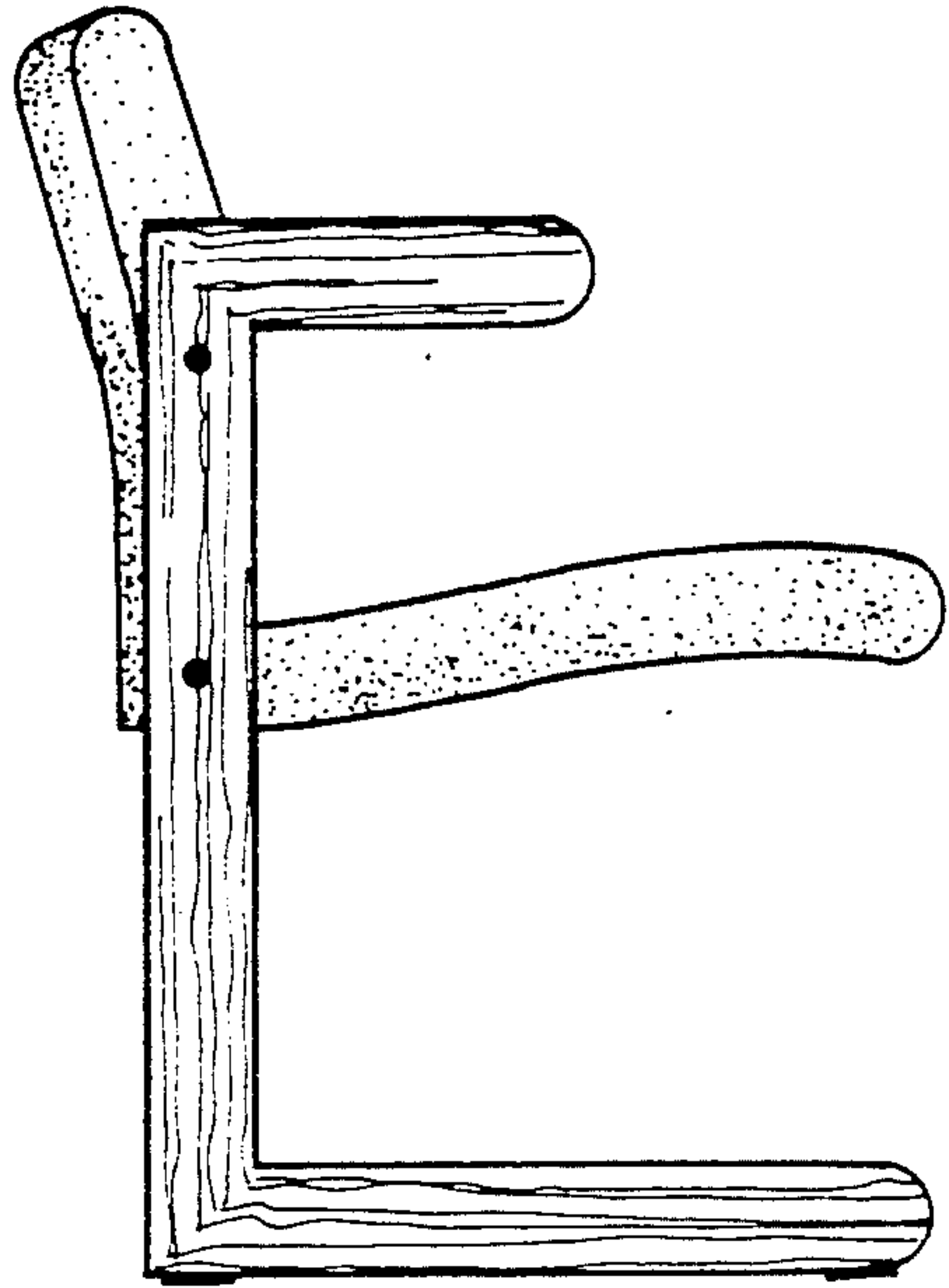

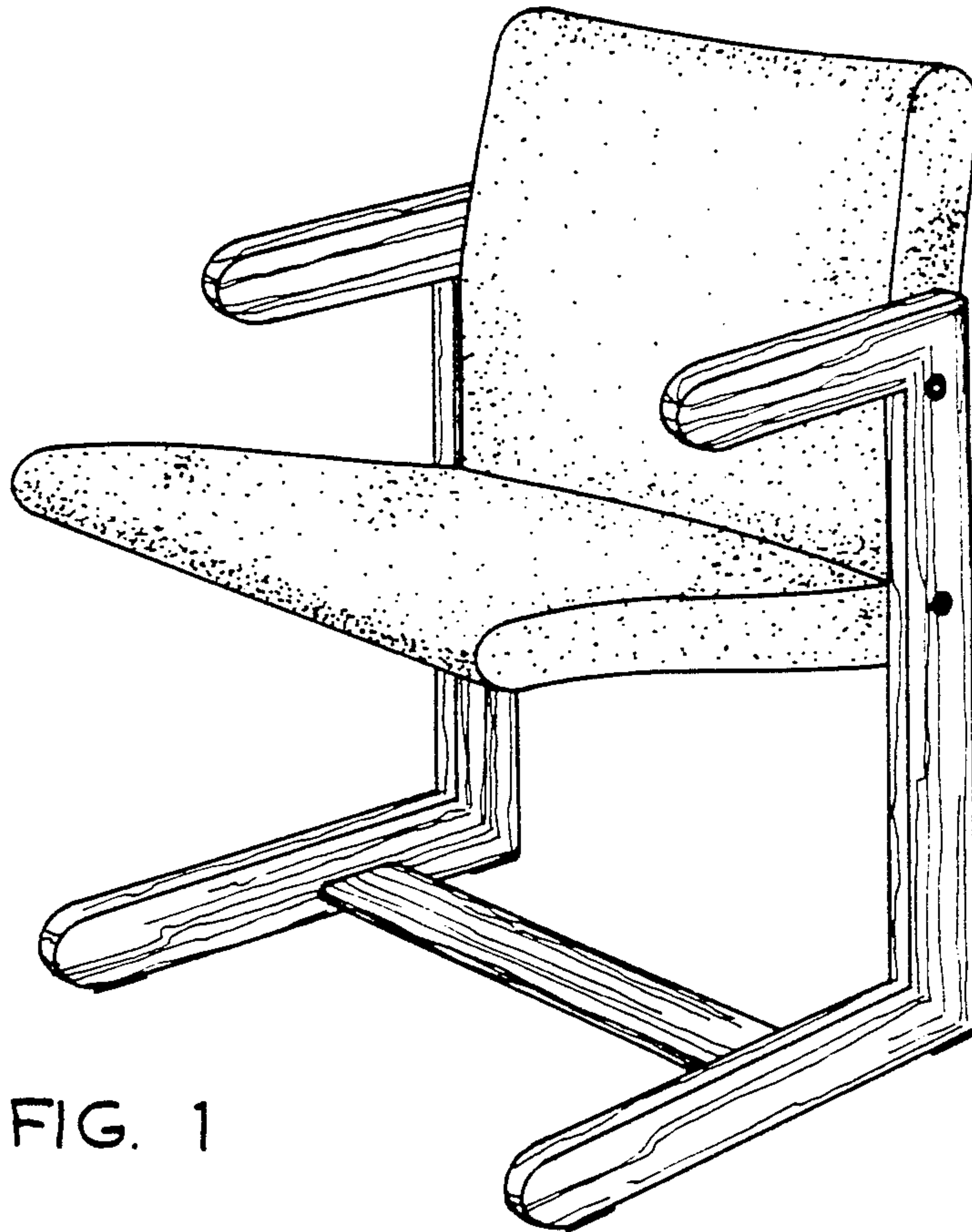
