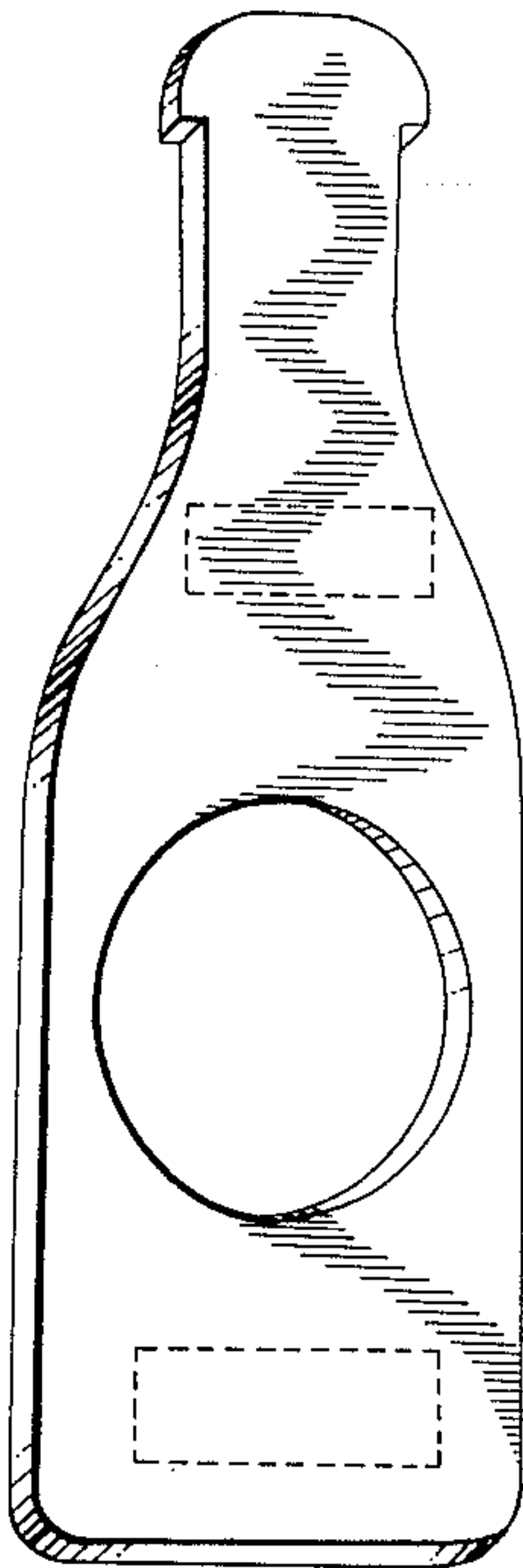

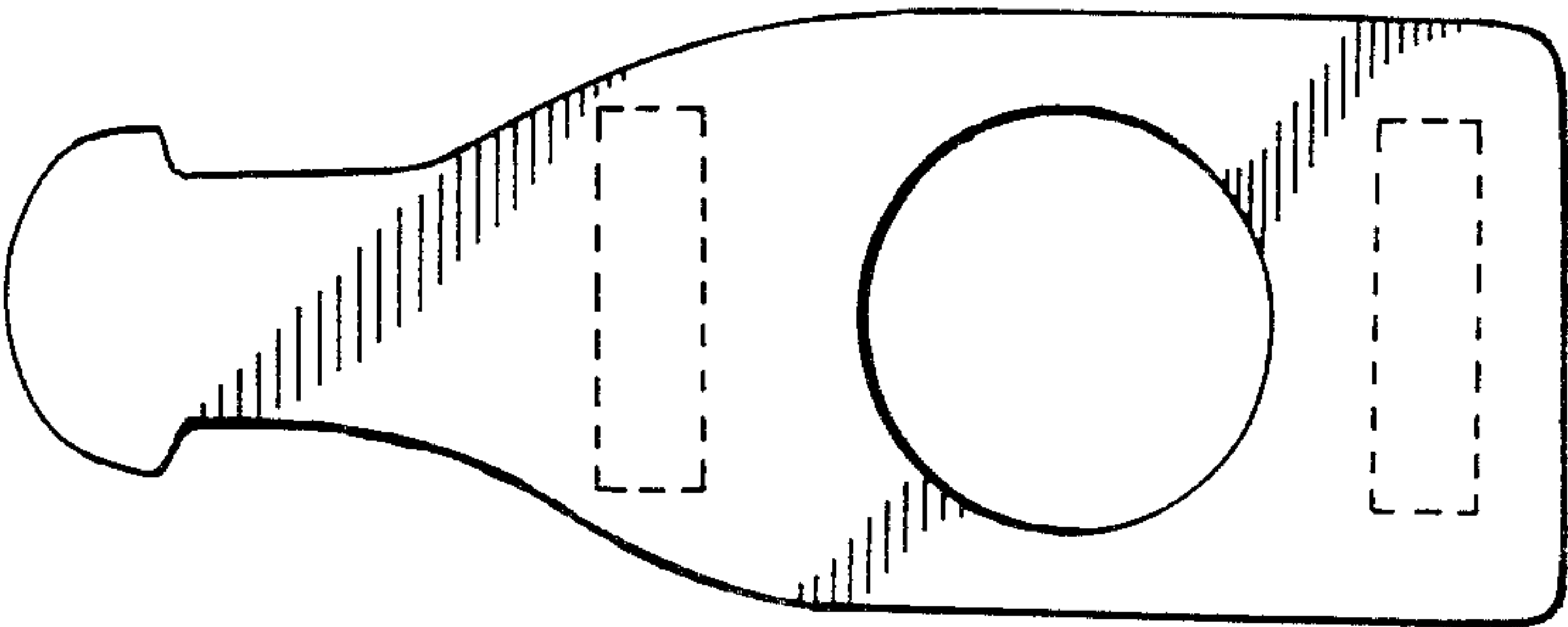
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined champagne and wine bottle stopper remover, substantially as shown and described.

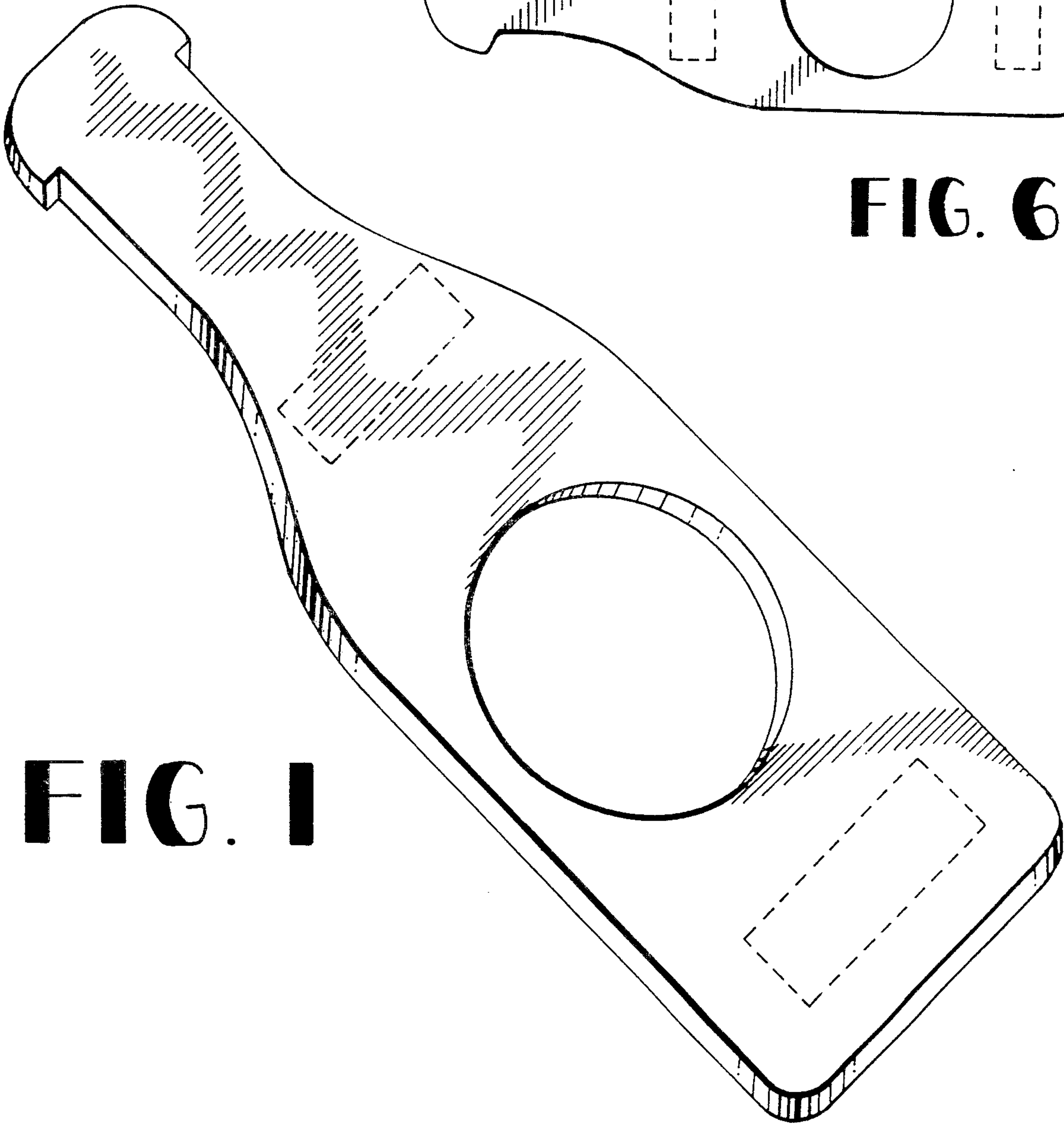
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an enlarged top perspective view of a combined champagne and wine bottle stopper remover showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a front elevation thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of the design illustrated in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a third modified embodiment of the design illustrated in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 8 is a top plan view of a fourth modified embodiment of the design illustrated in FIG. 1; and  
FIG. 9 is an enlarged bottom perspective view of the embodiment shown in FIGS. 1-5.  
The broken lines are shown for illustrative purposes only.

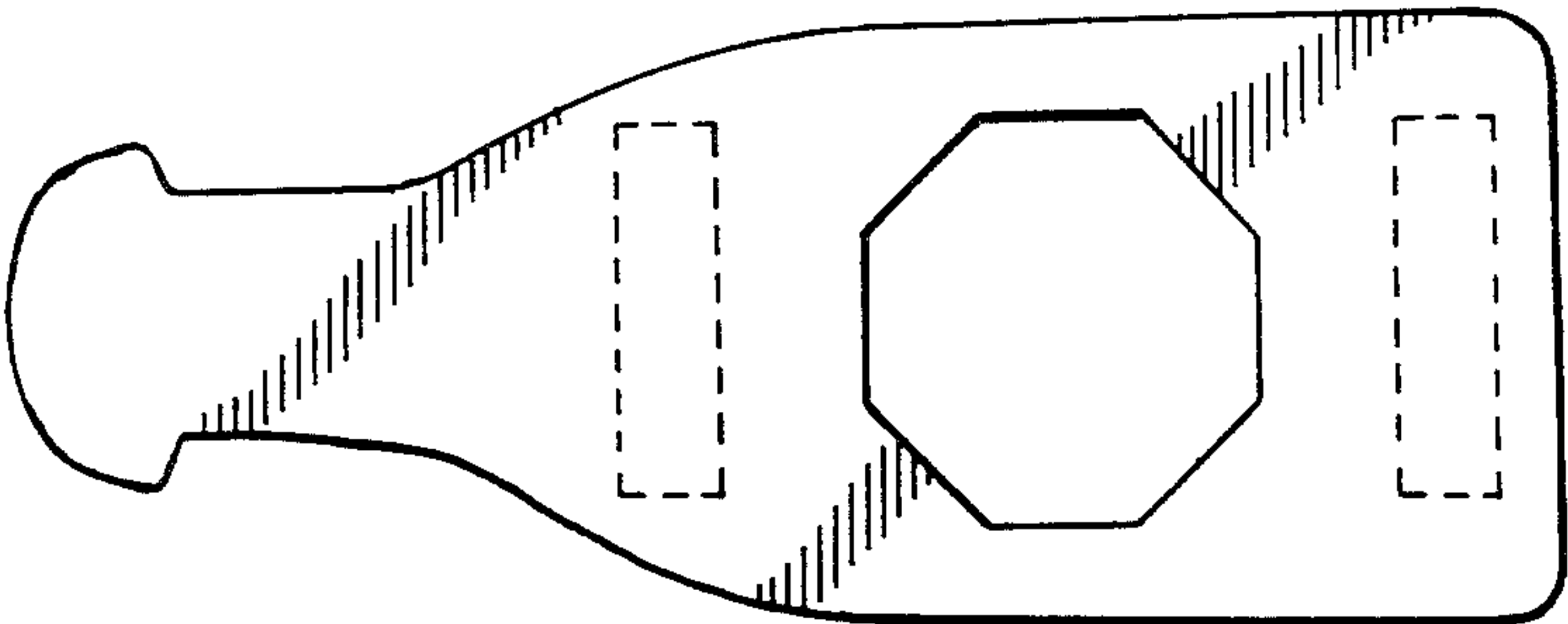

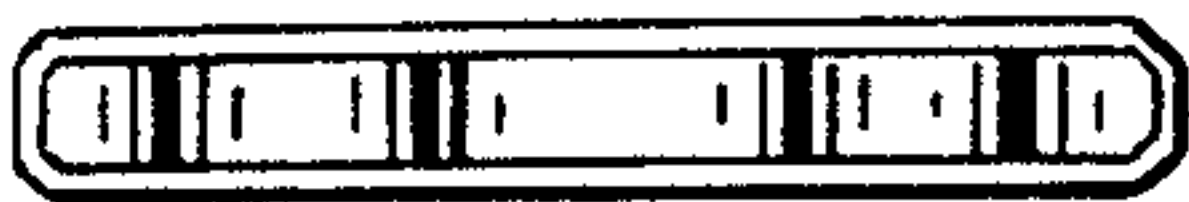

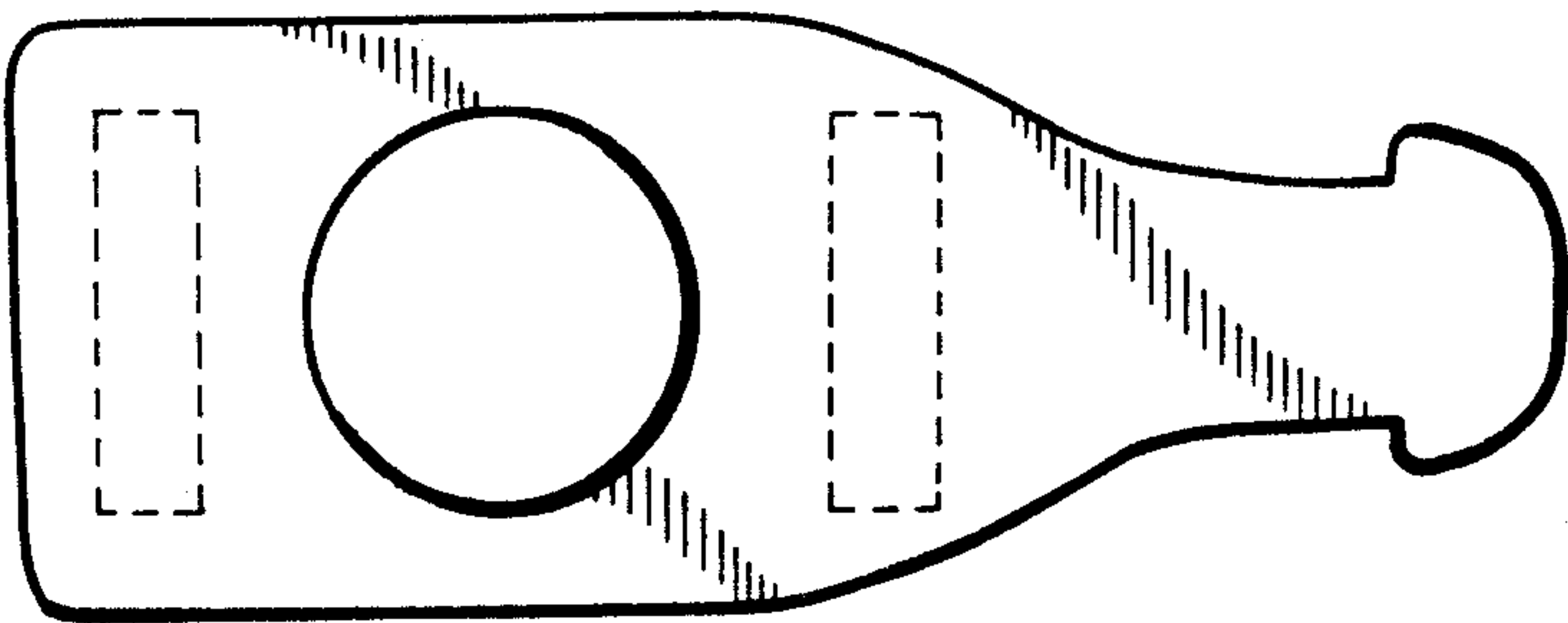

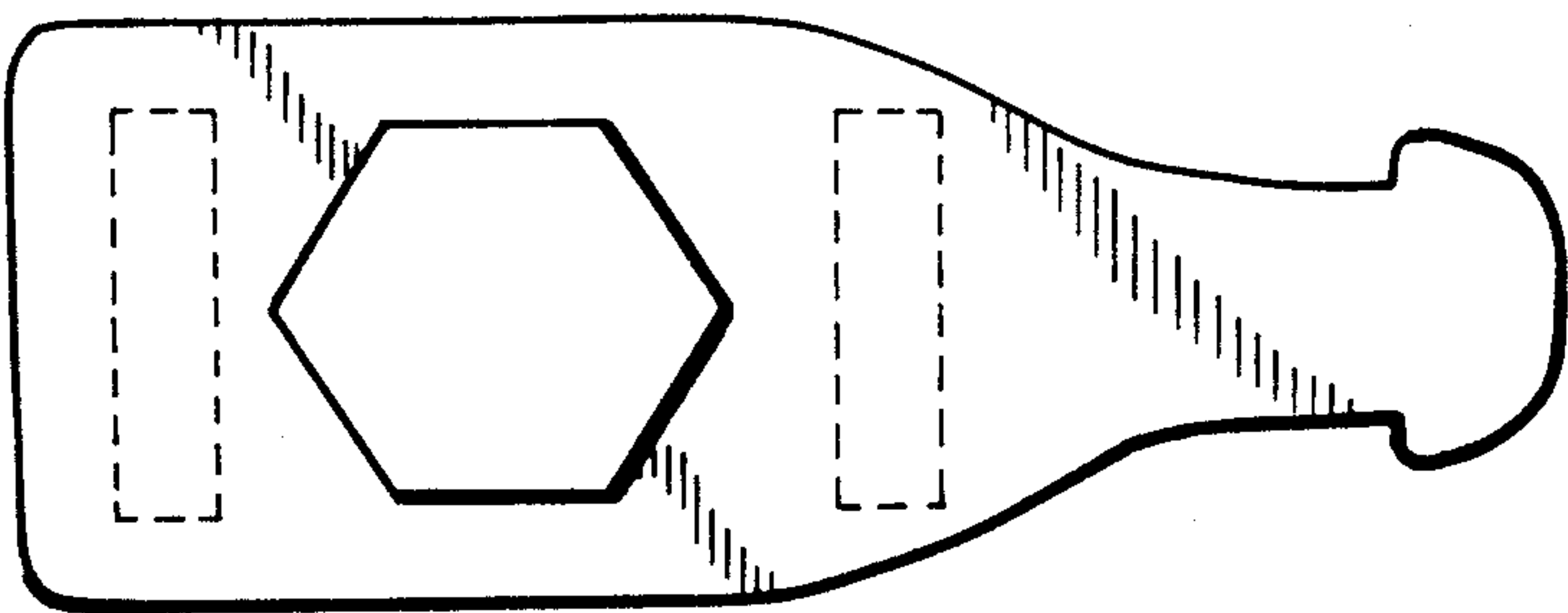

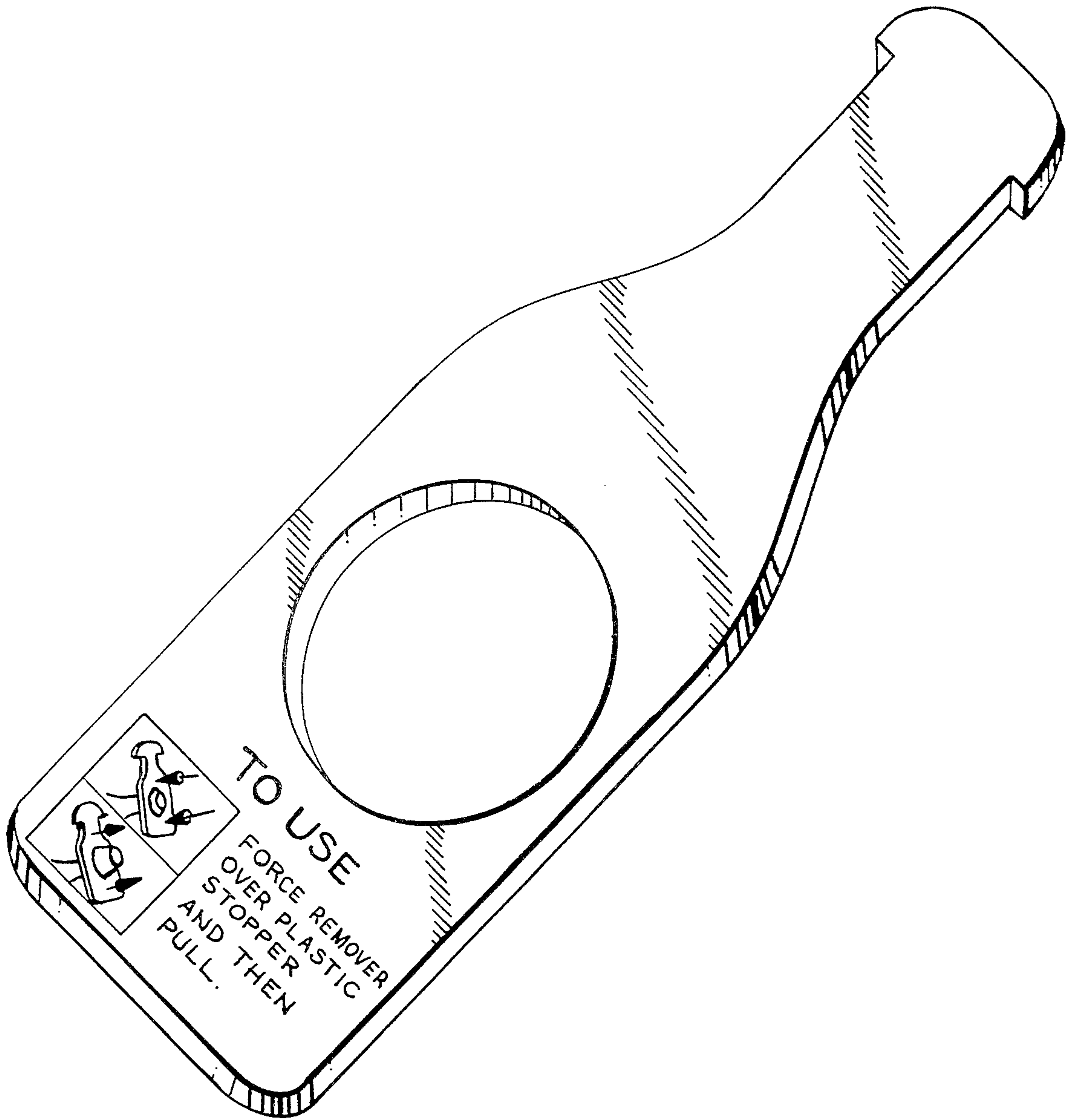
