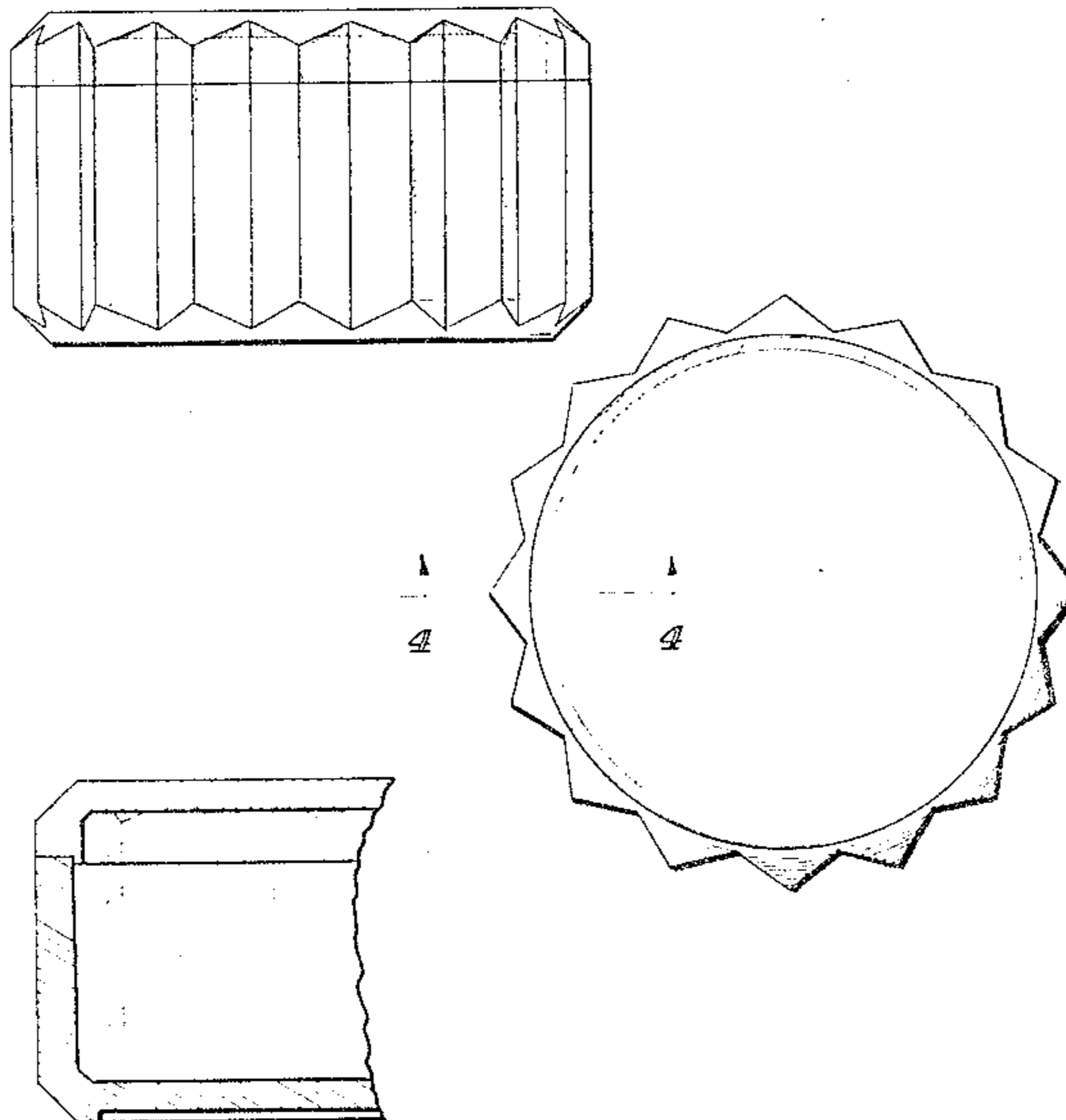

The ornamental design for a combined bowl and lid, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined bowl and lid, showing my new design, with all other elevational views being the same;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 4 is a partial sectional view taken along lines 4—4 of FIG. 2.



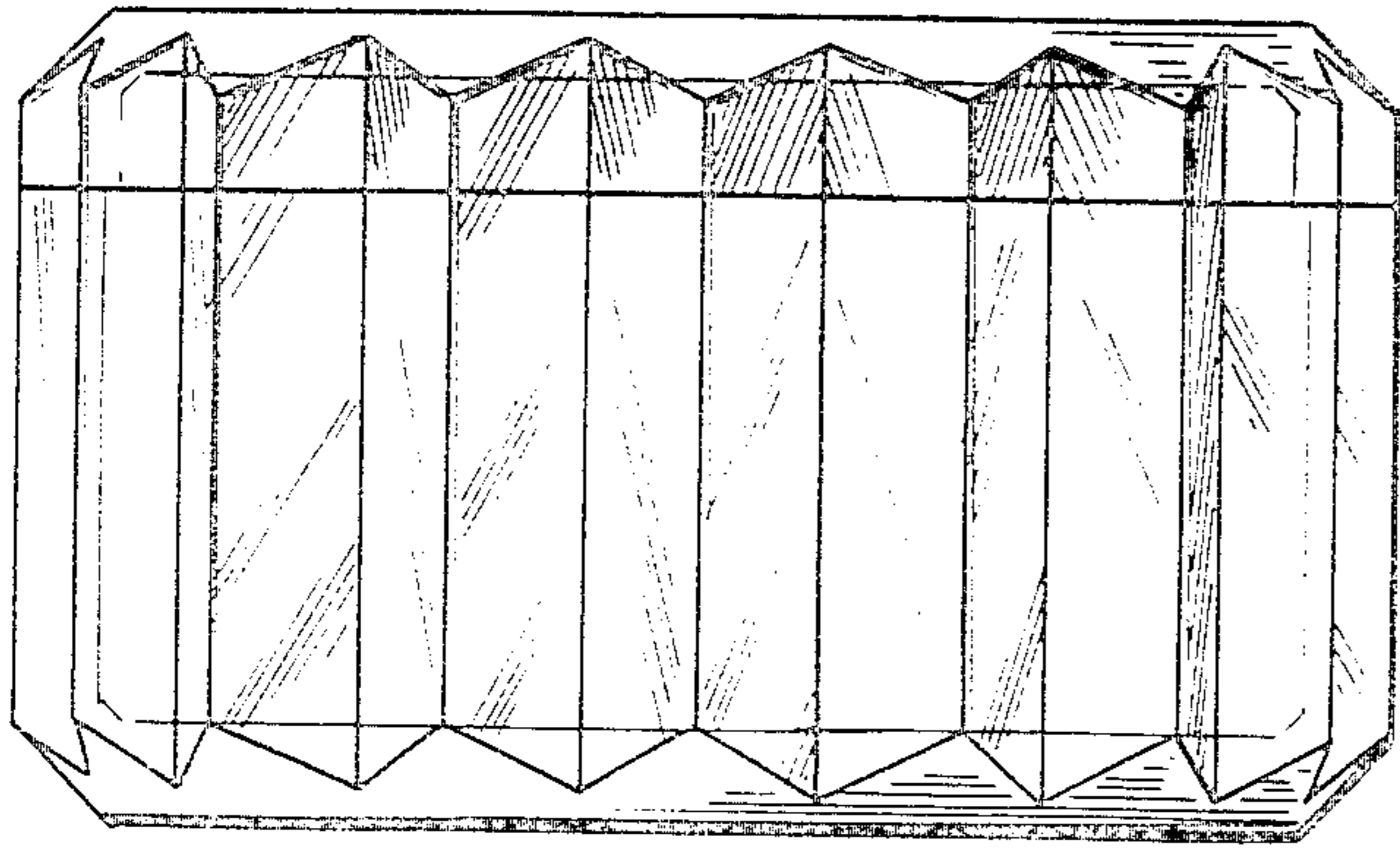

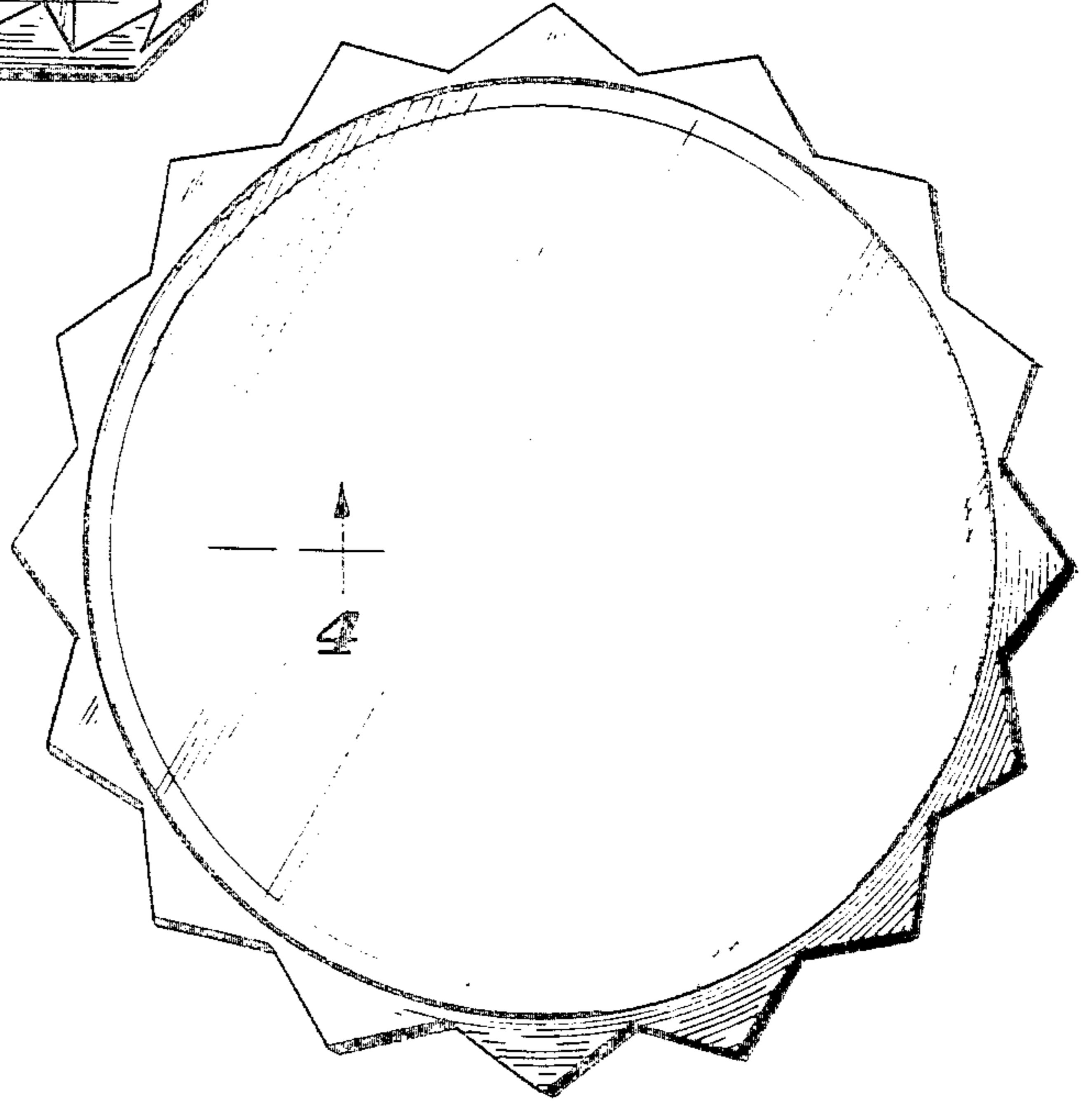

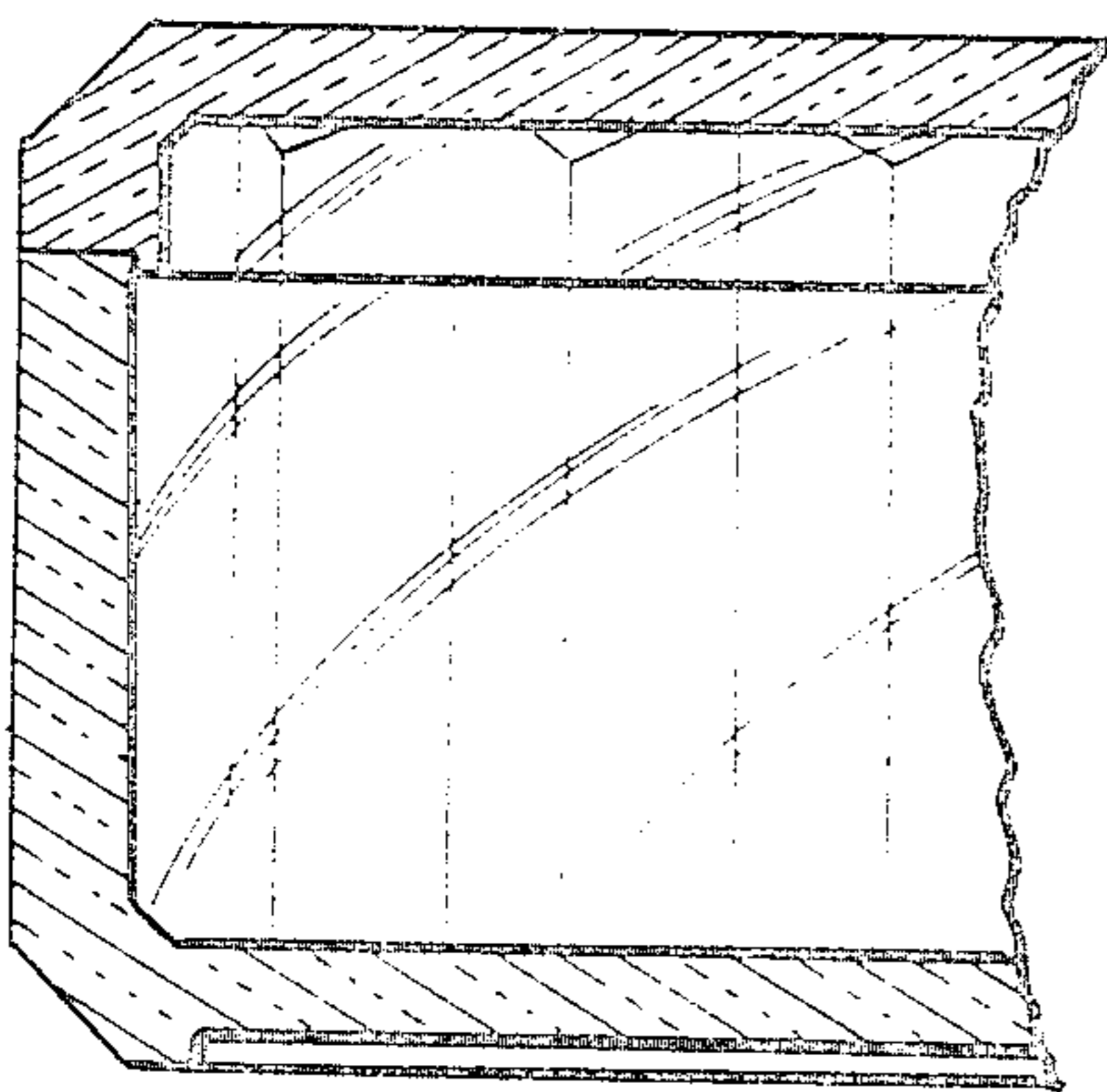

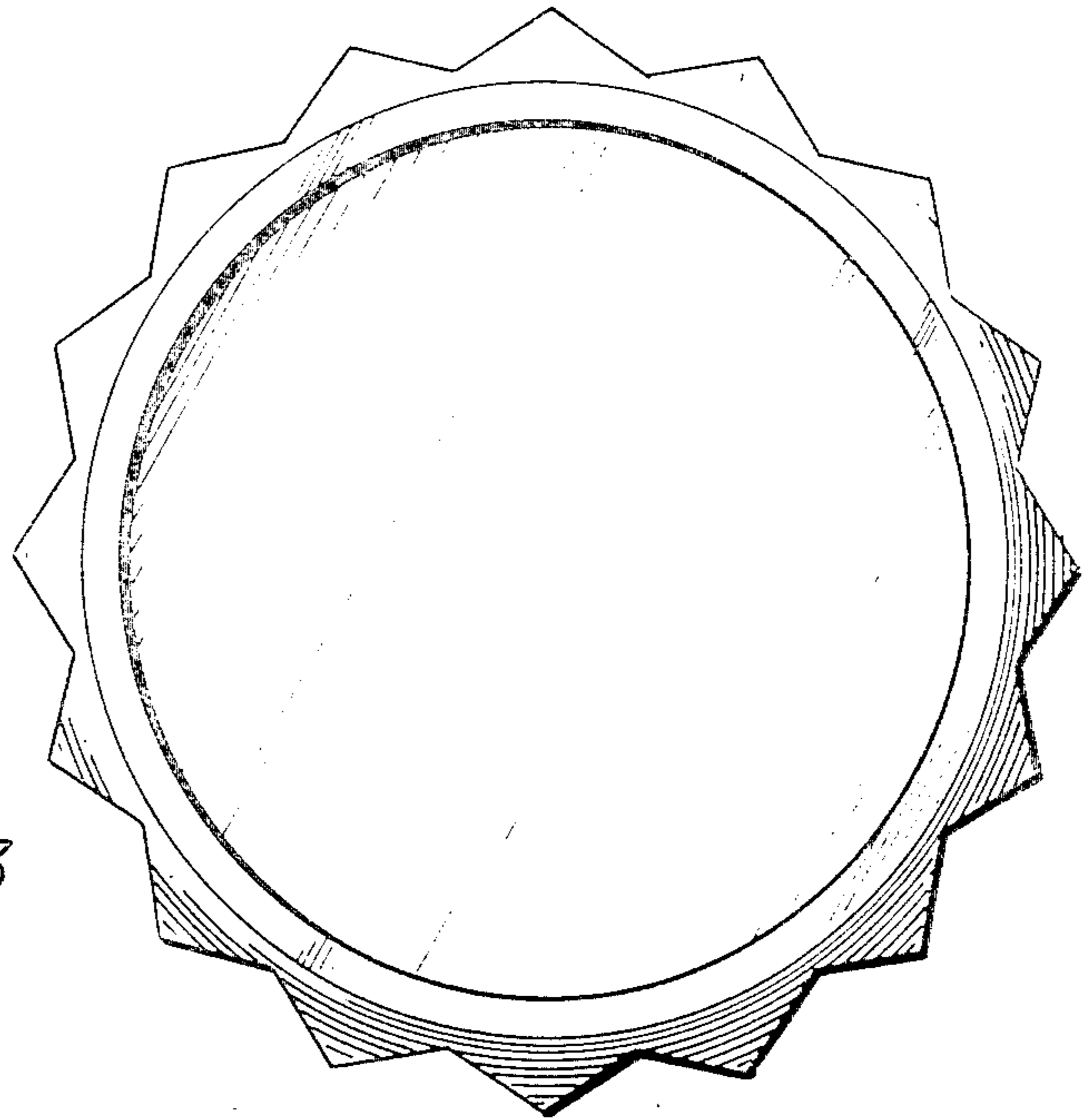
