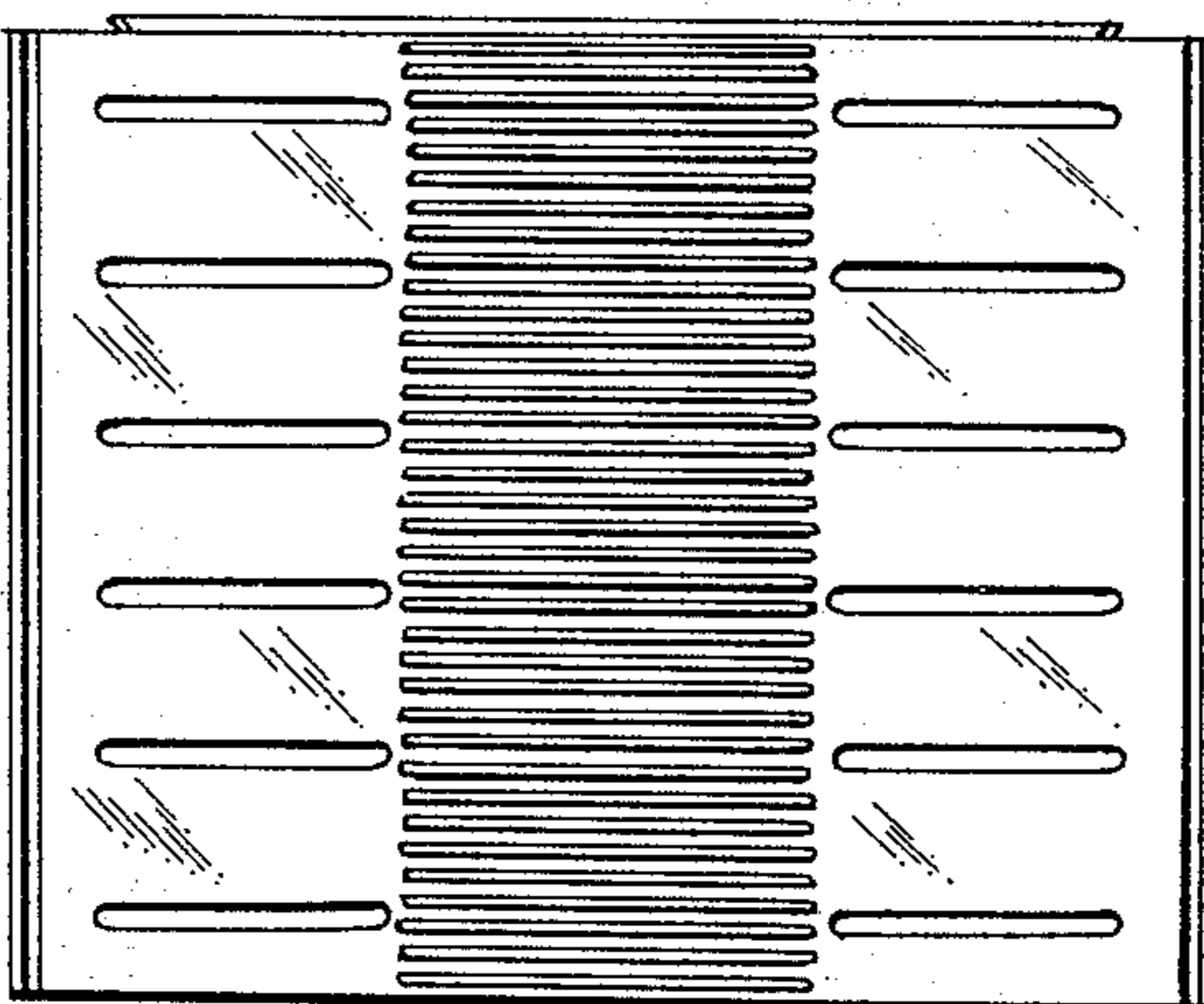
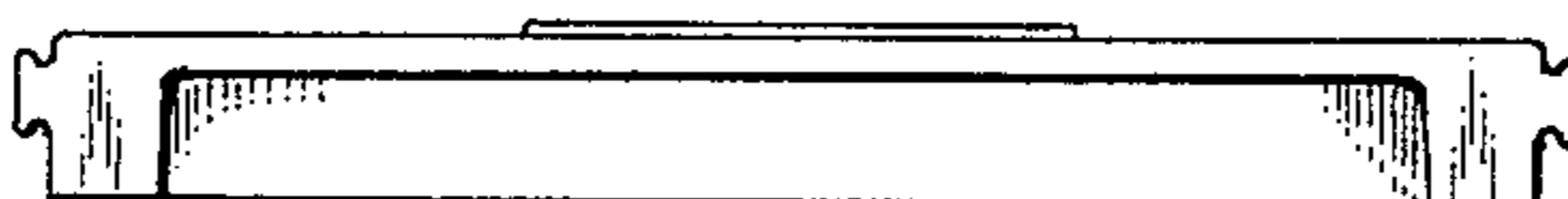

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a base plate for use in a filing system, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a base plate for use in a filing system showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



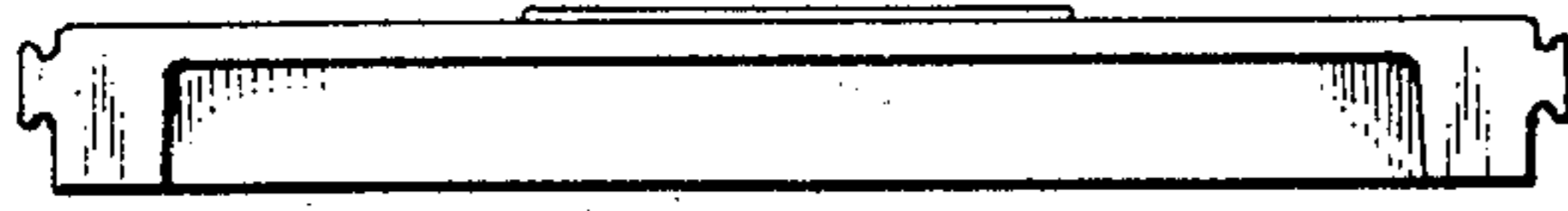

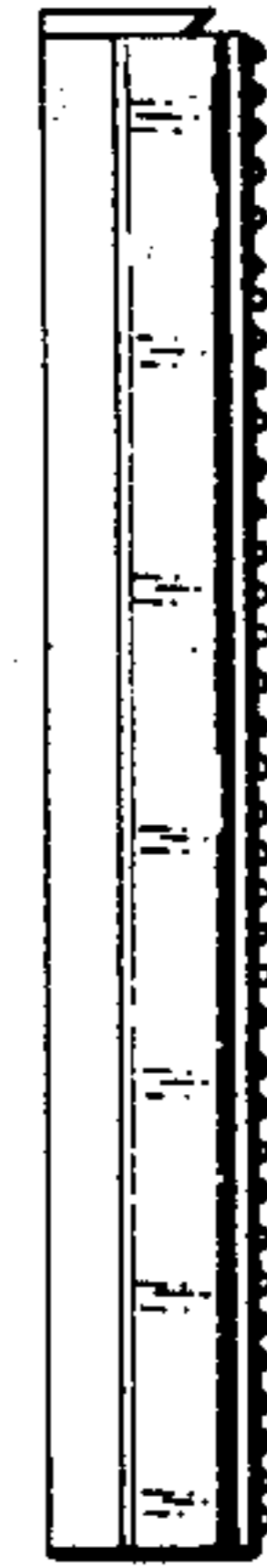

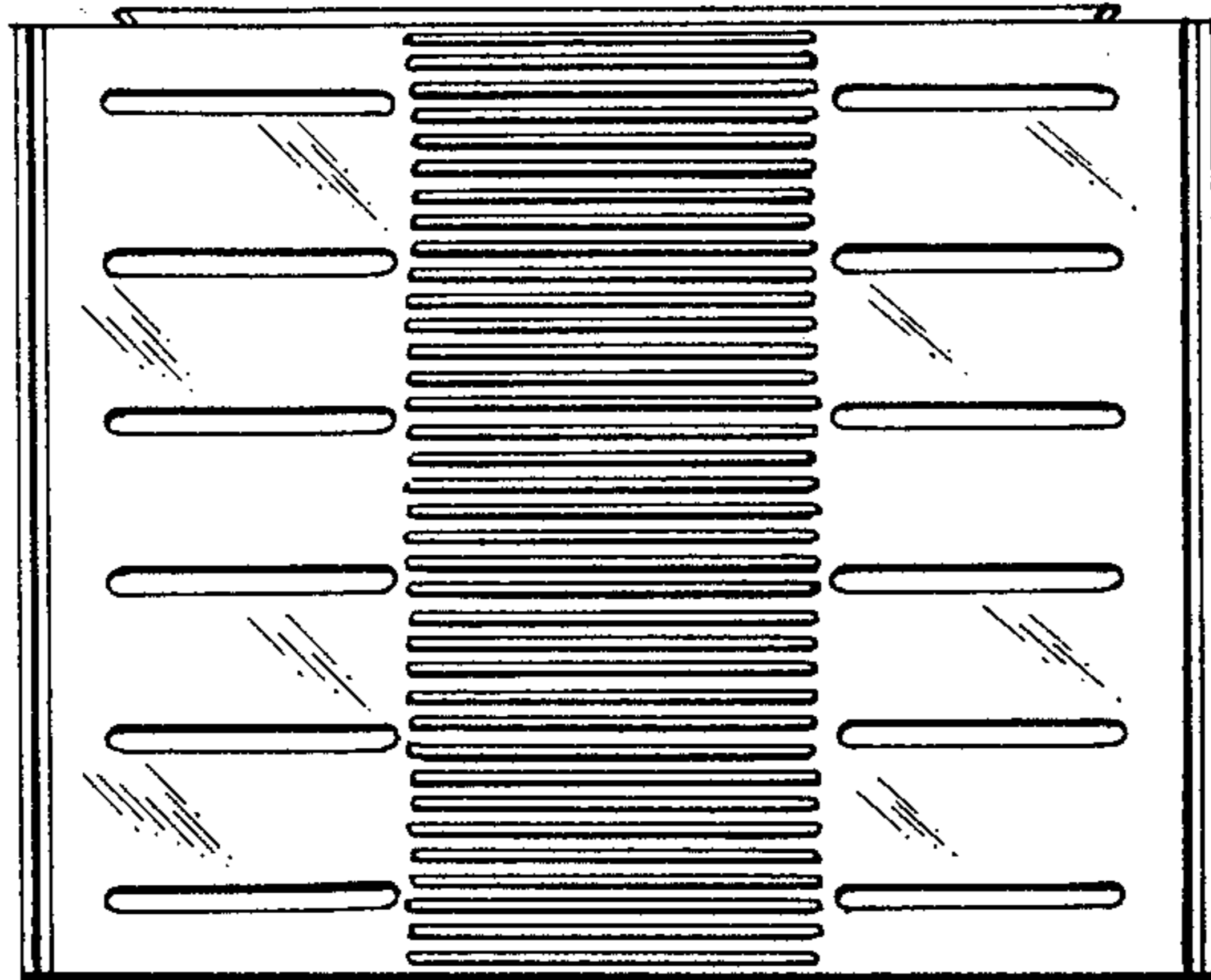

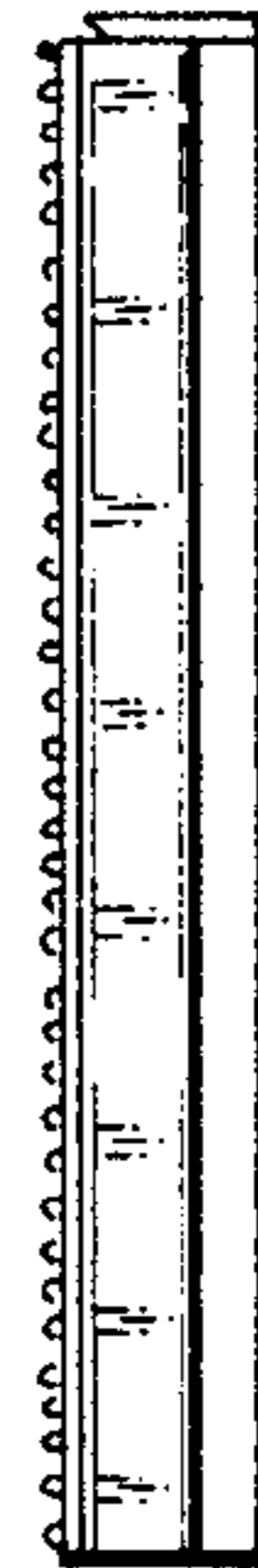

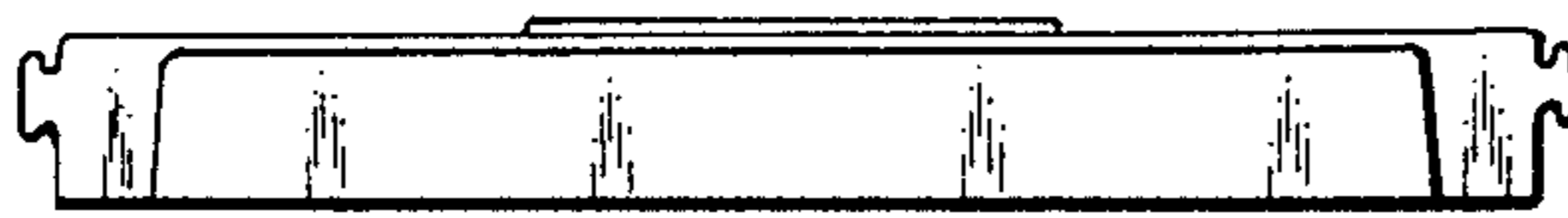

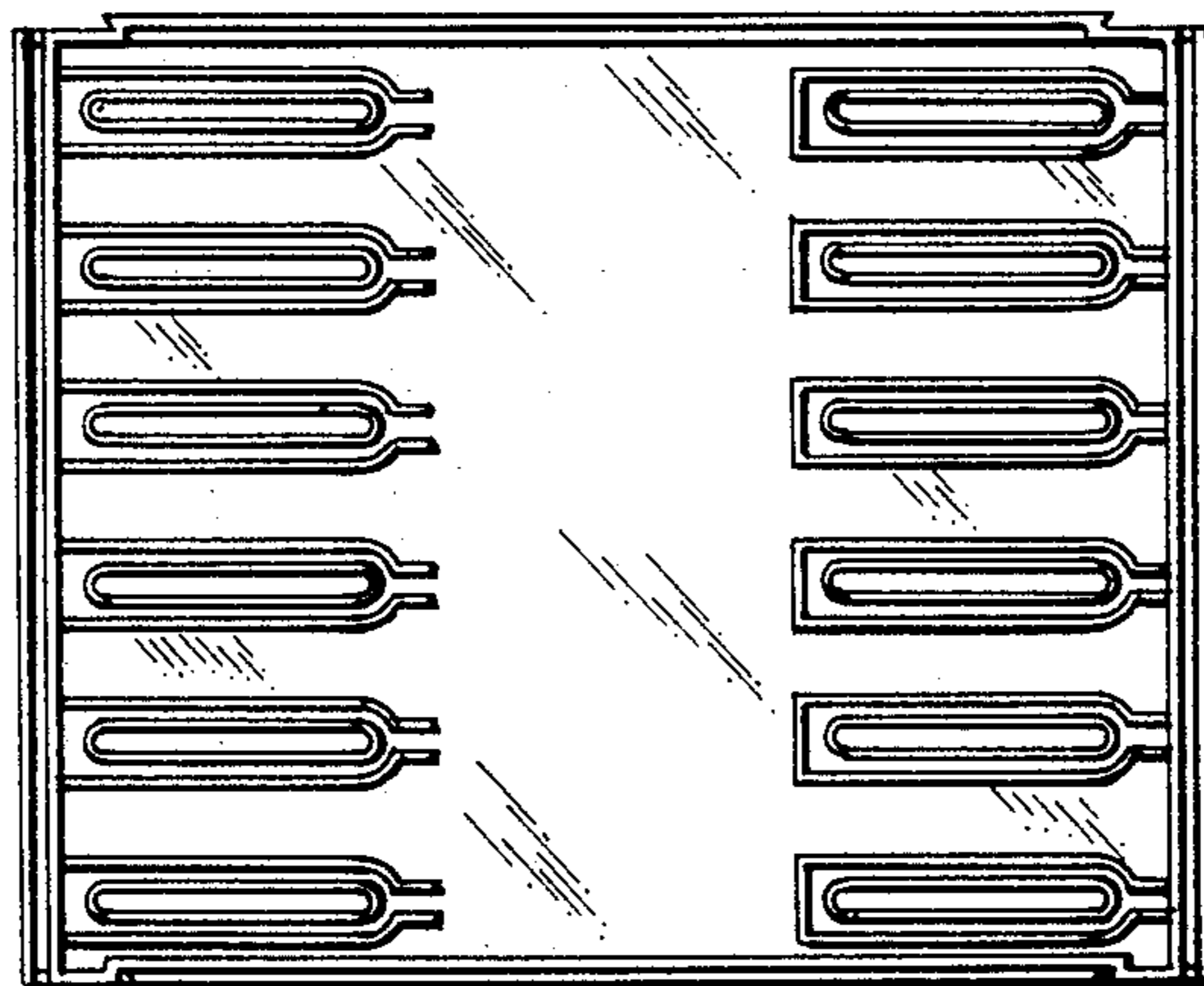
