[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bezel for a coin or token freed mechanism, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a bezel for a coin or token freed mechanism showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a cross-section taken along the lines 4—4 of FIG. 3.

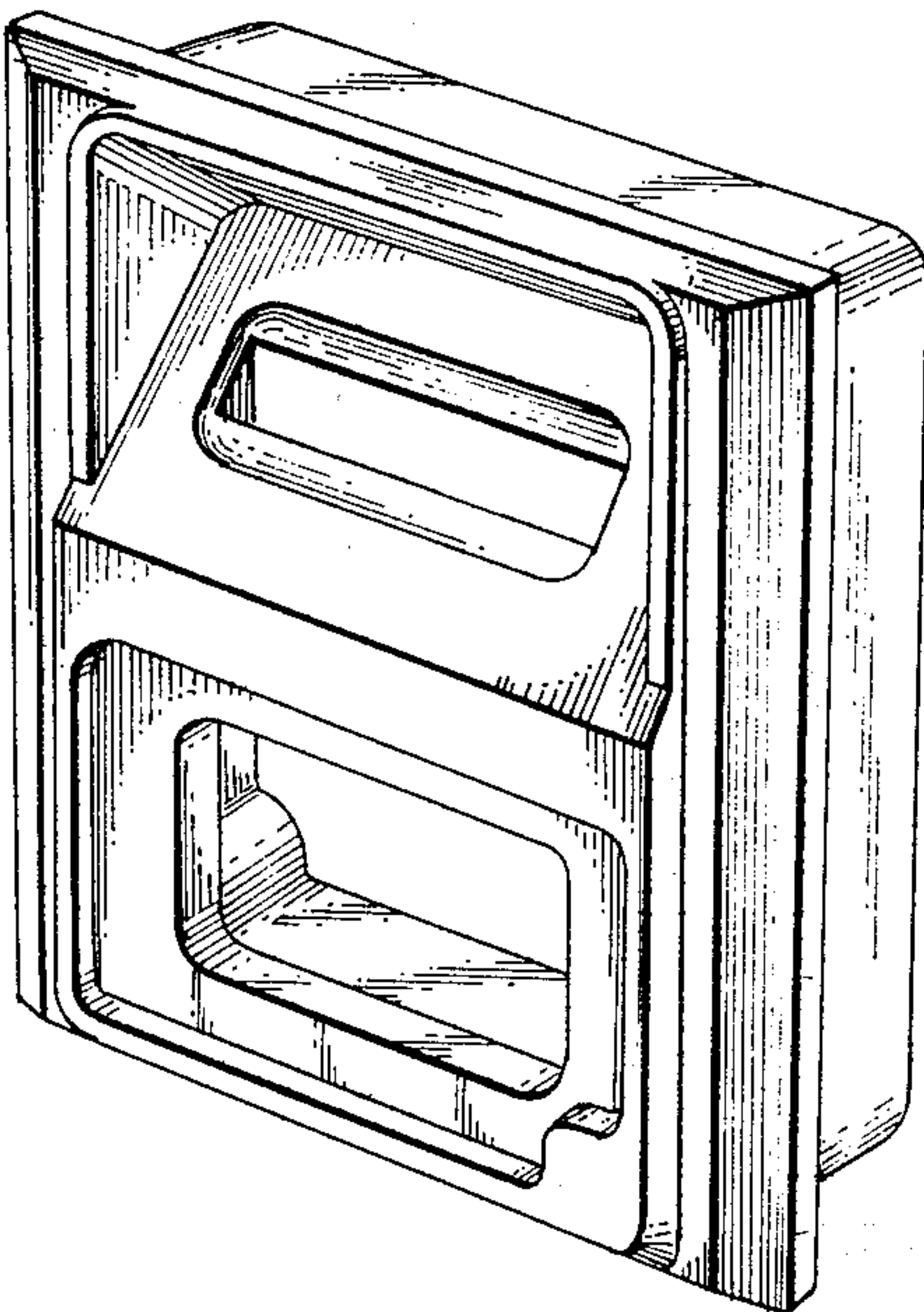

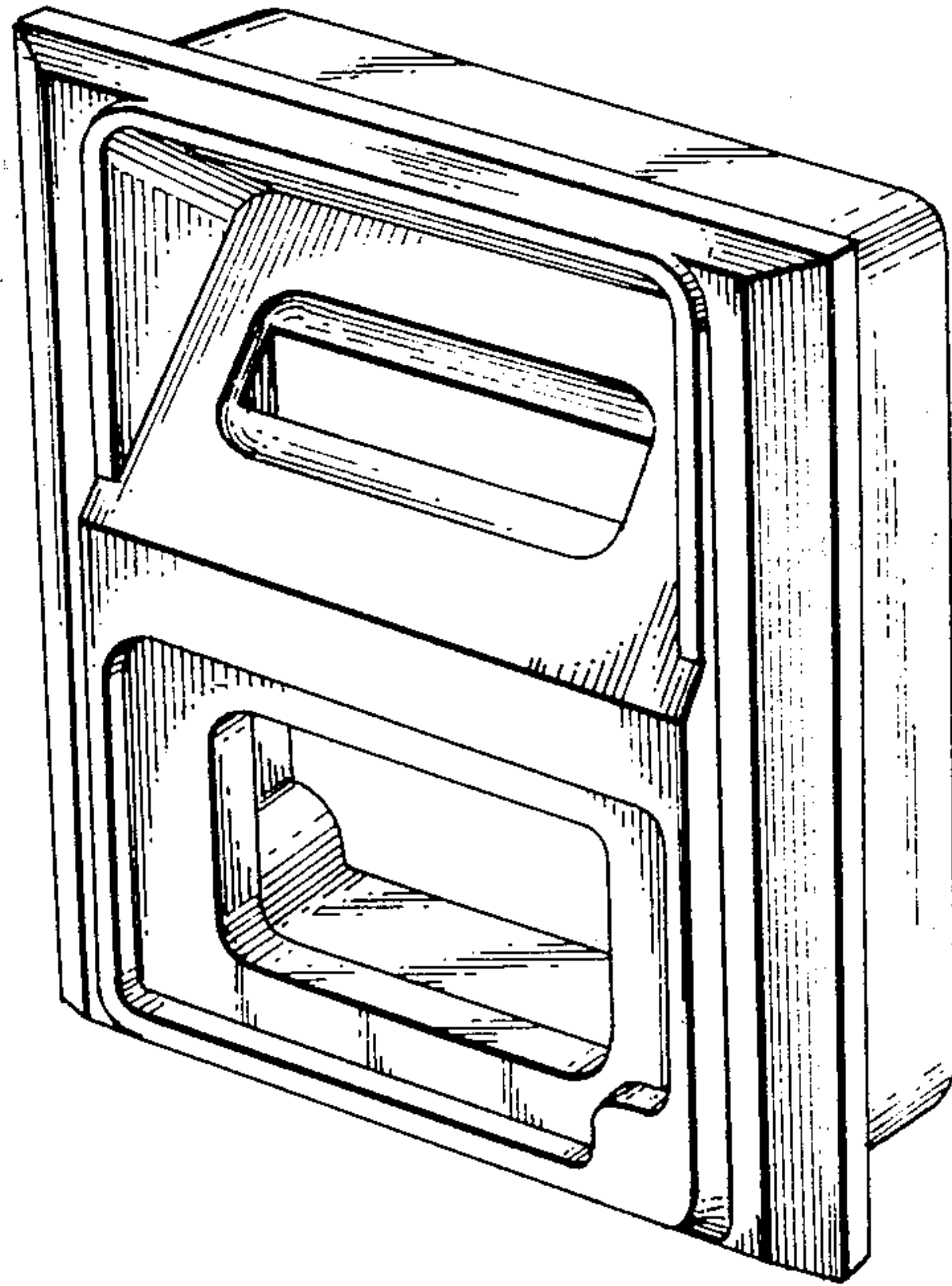
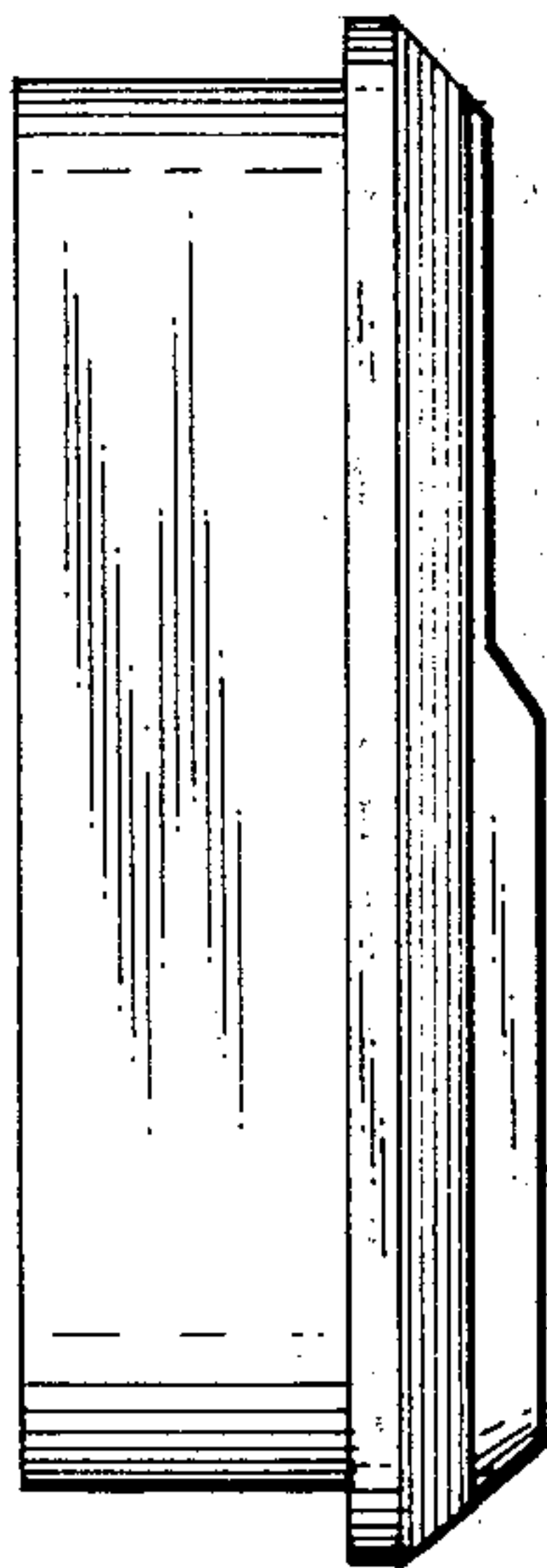

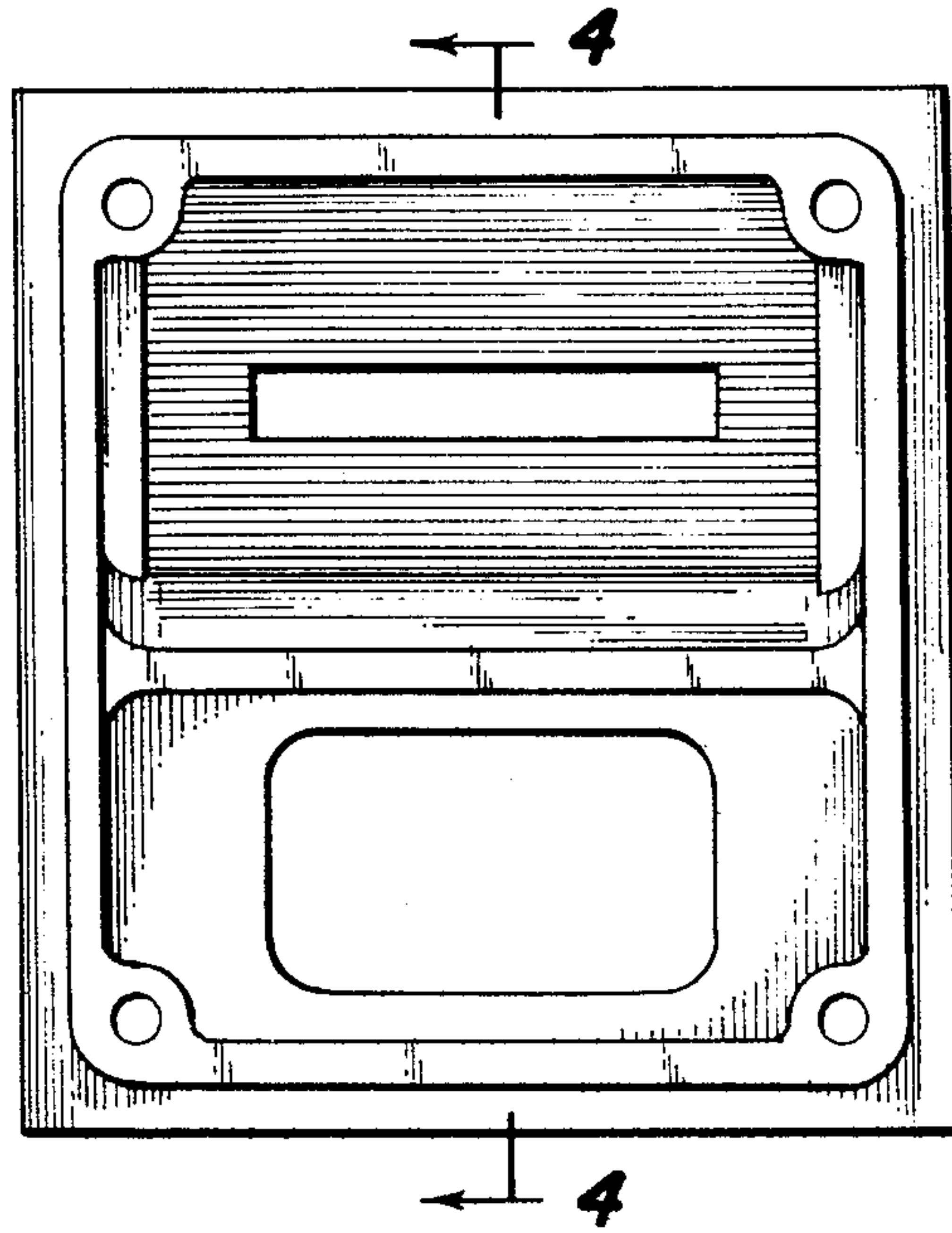
