The ornamental design for a cassette player, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a cassette player showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a view like FIG. 1 of the cassette player with the cover opened.

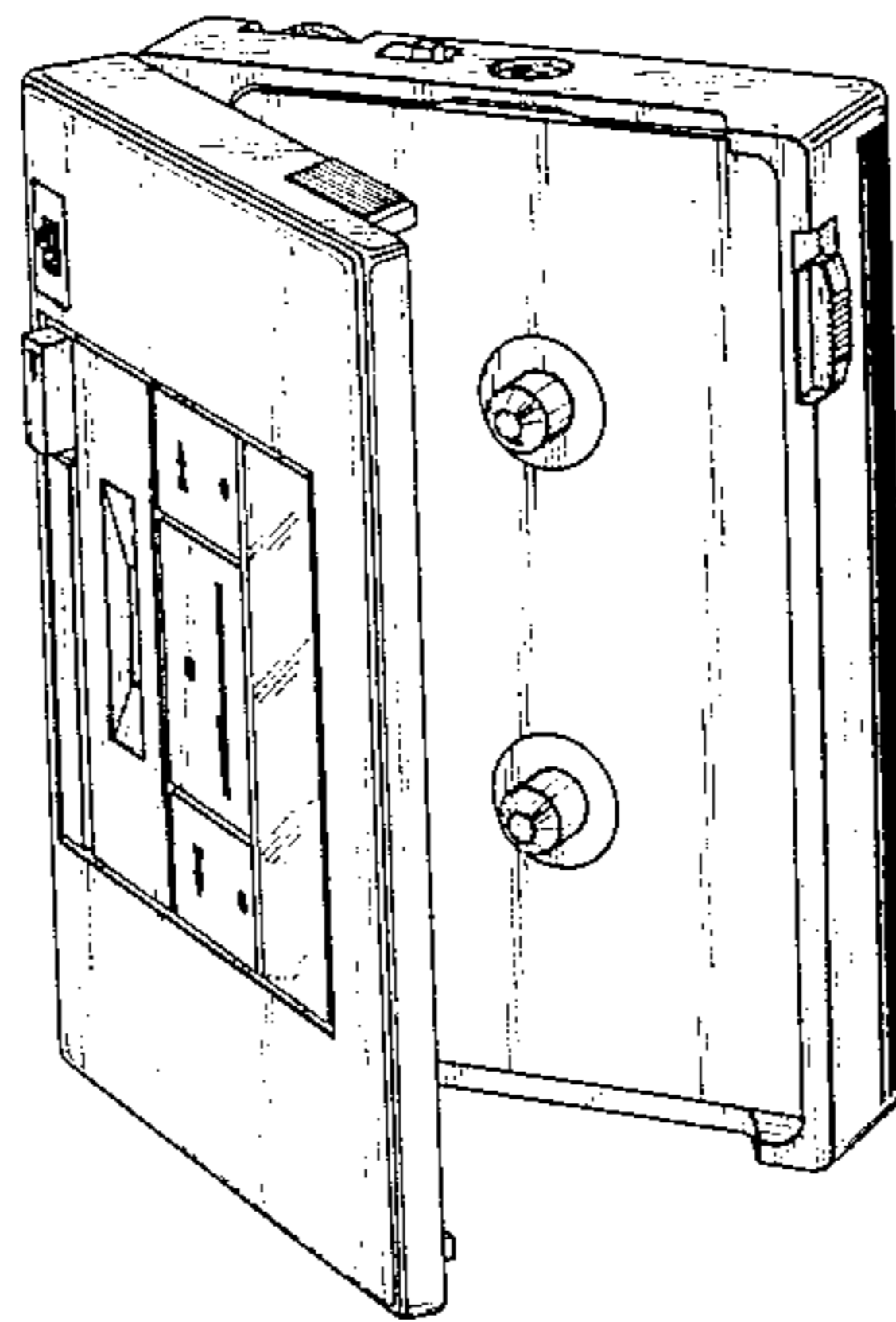

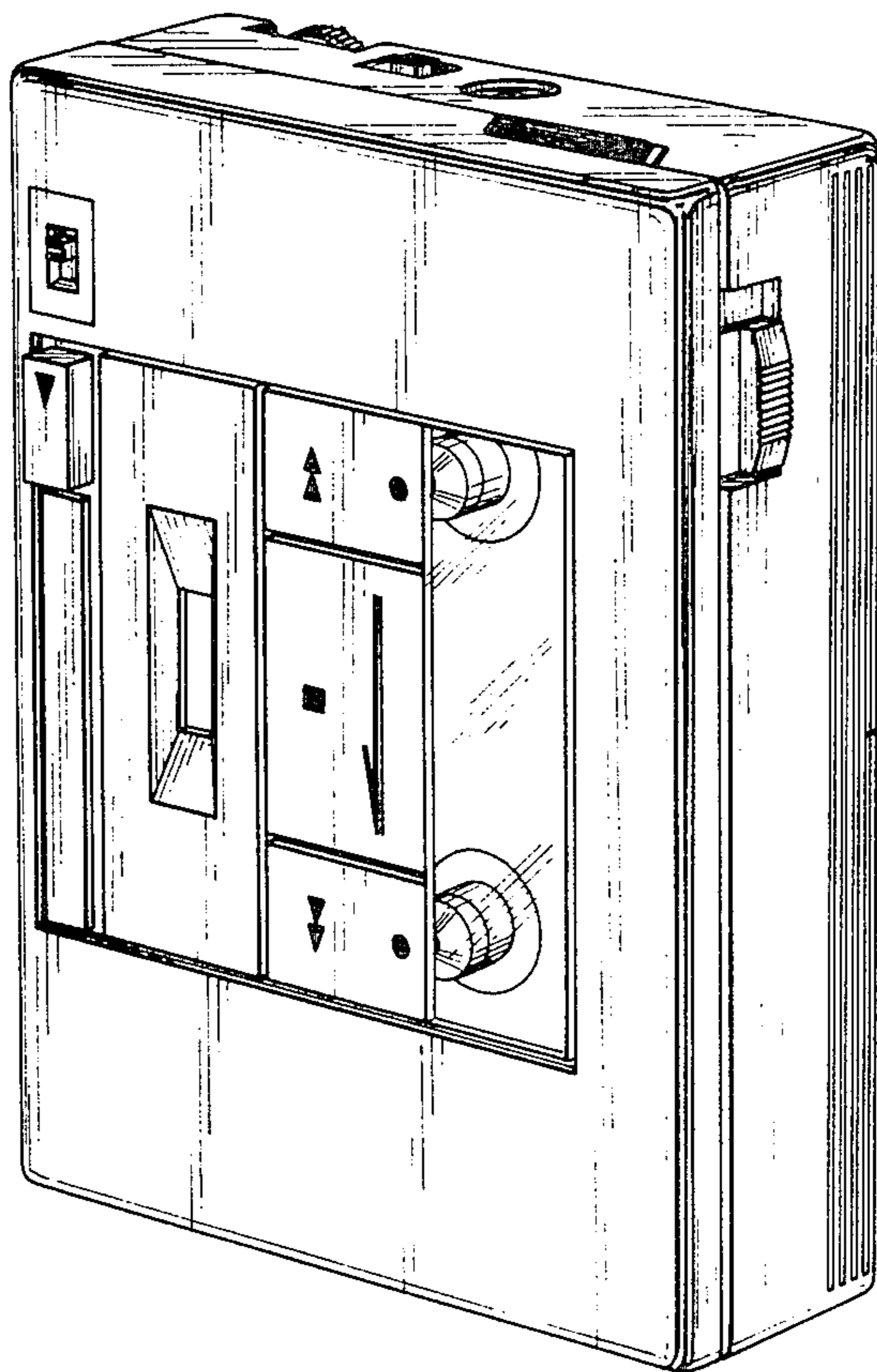

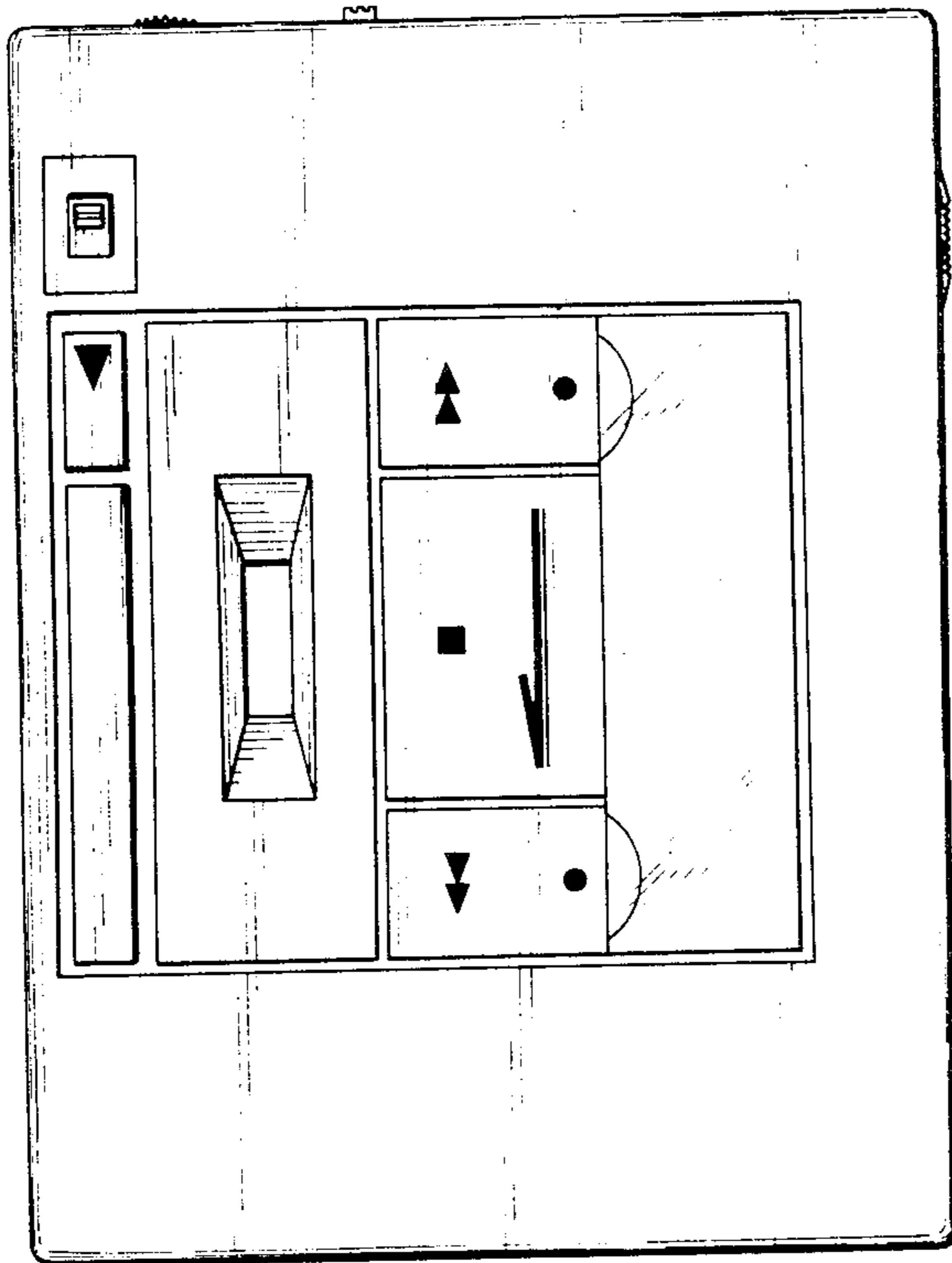

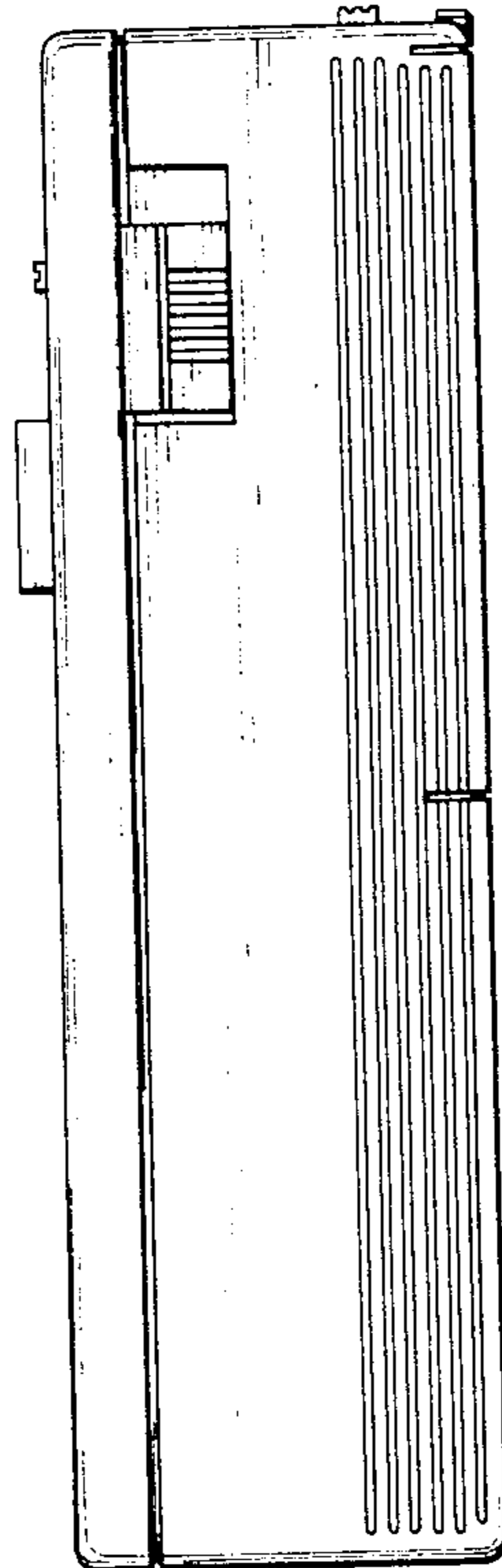

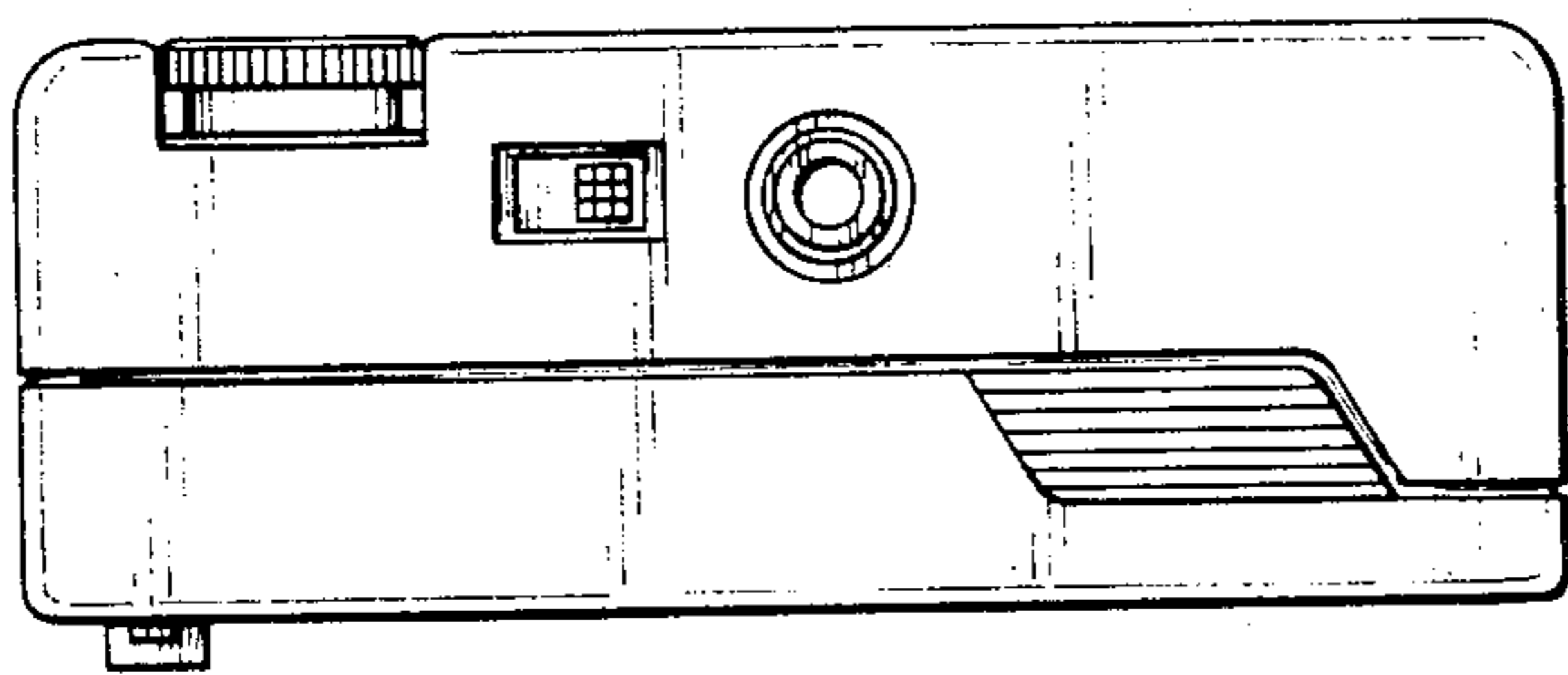

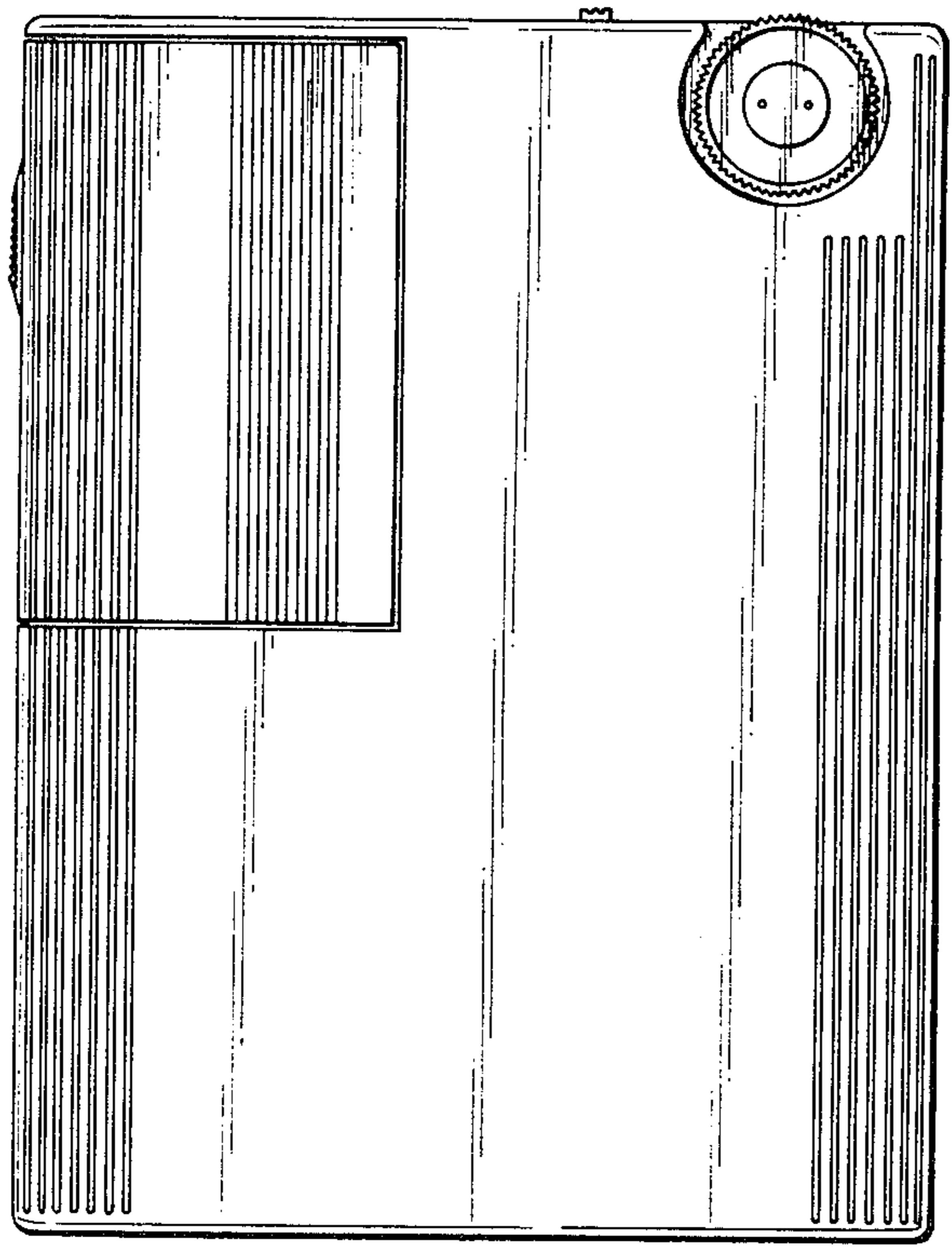

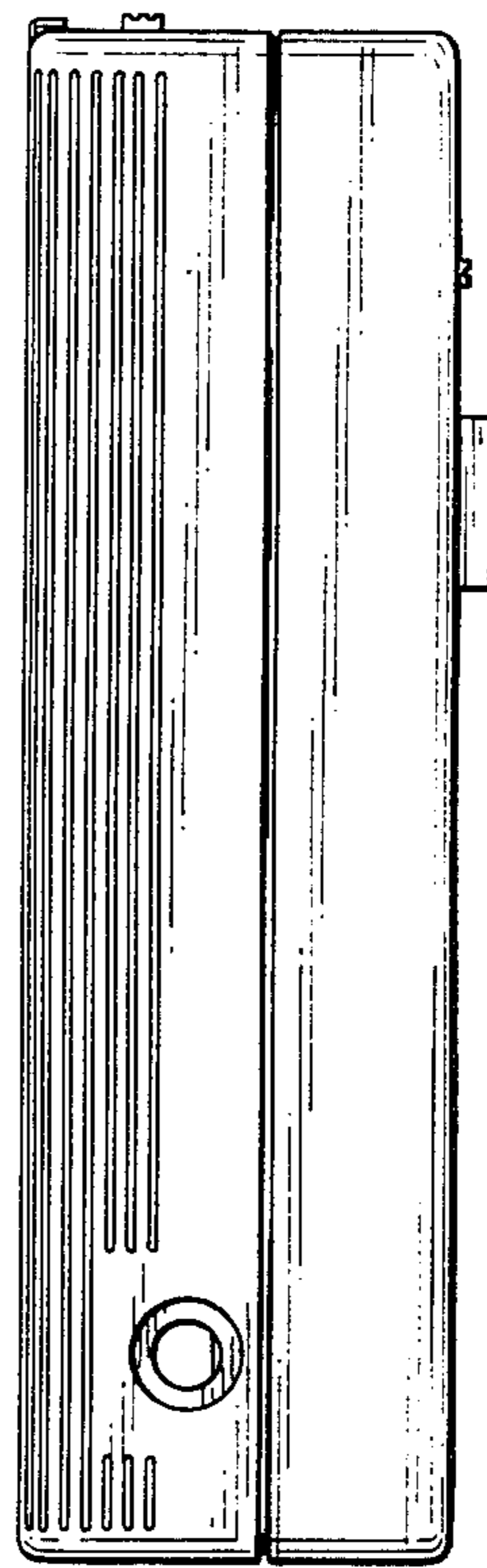

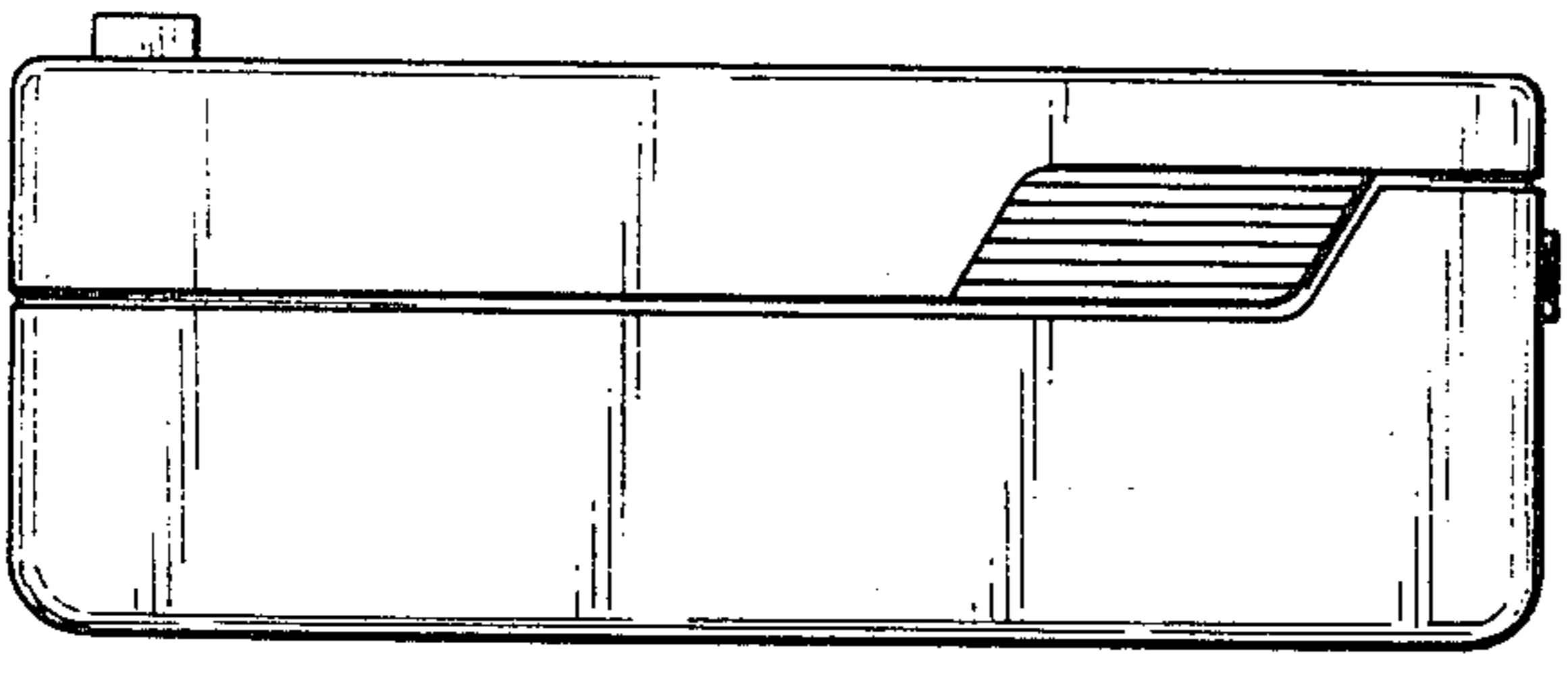
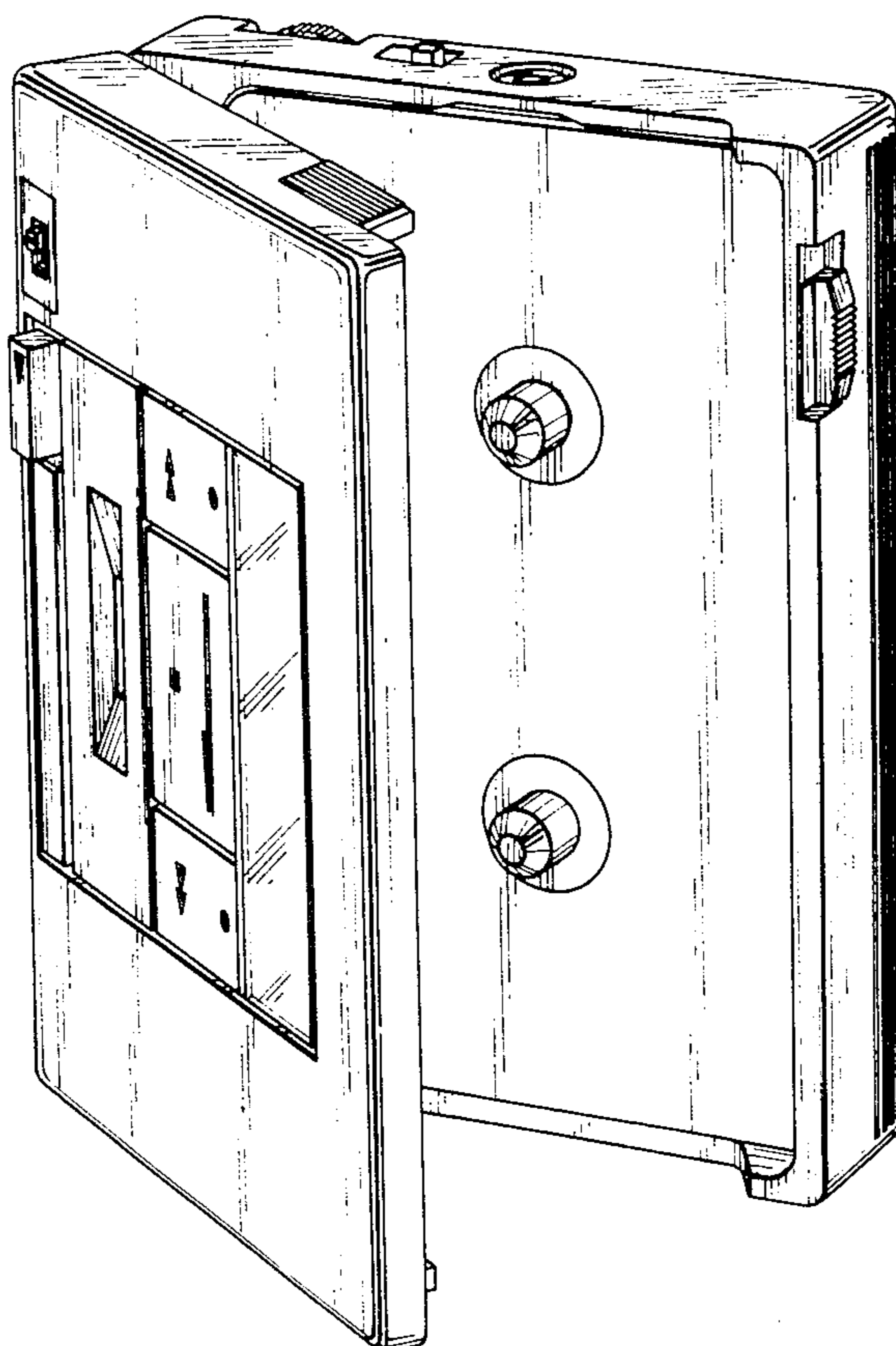
