The ornamental design for a transparent tool cover for suction cleaners or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view.

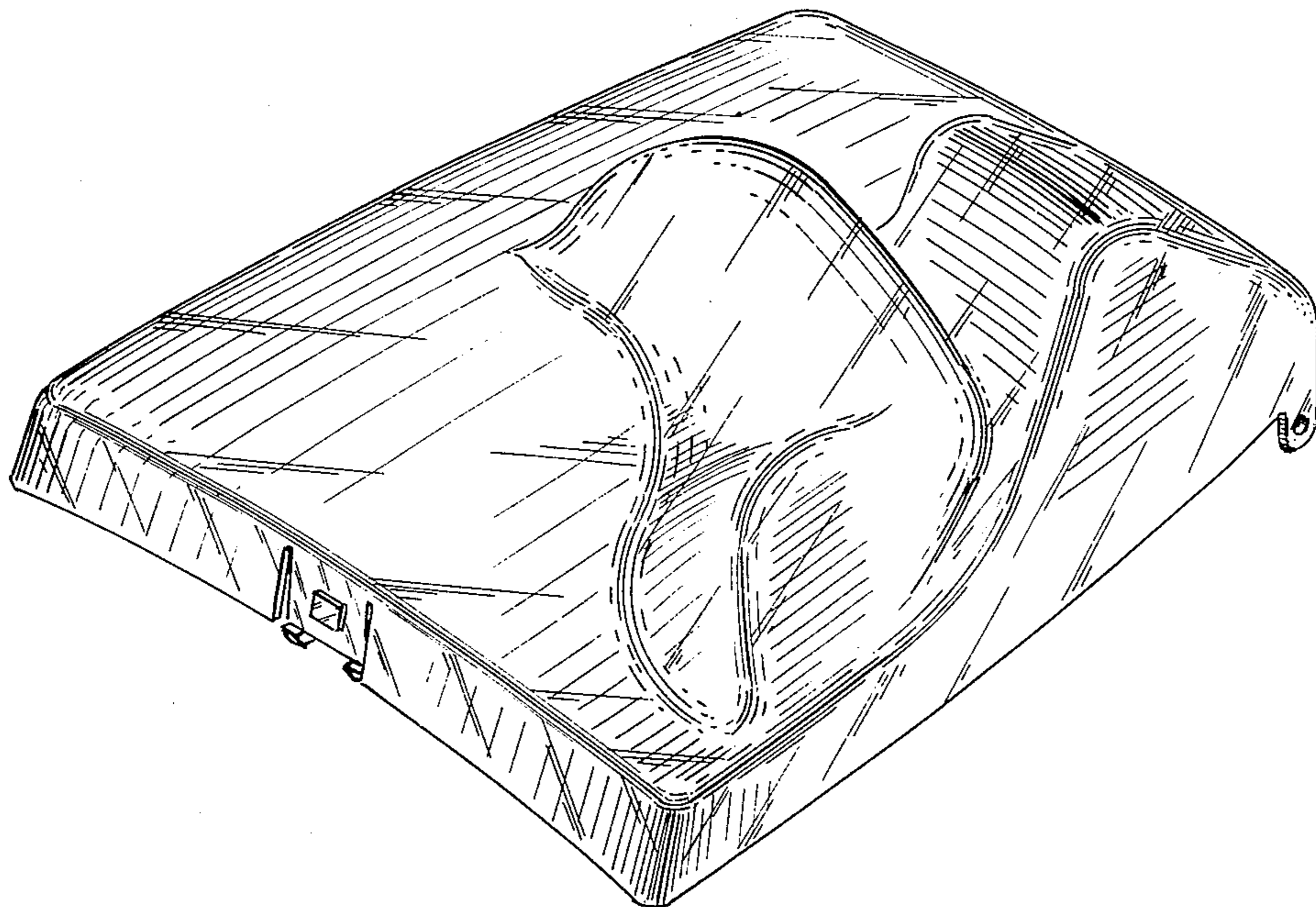

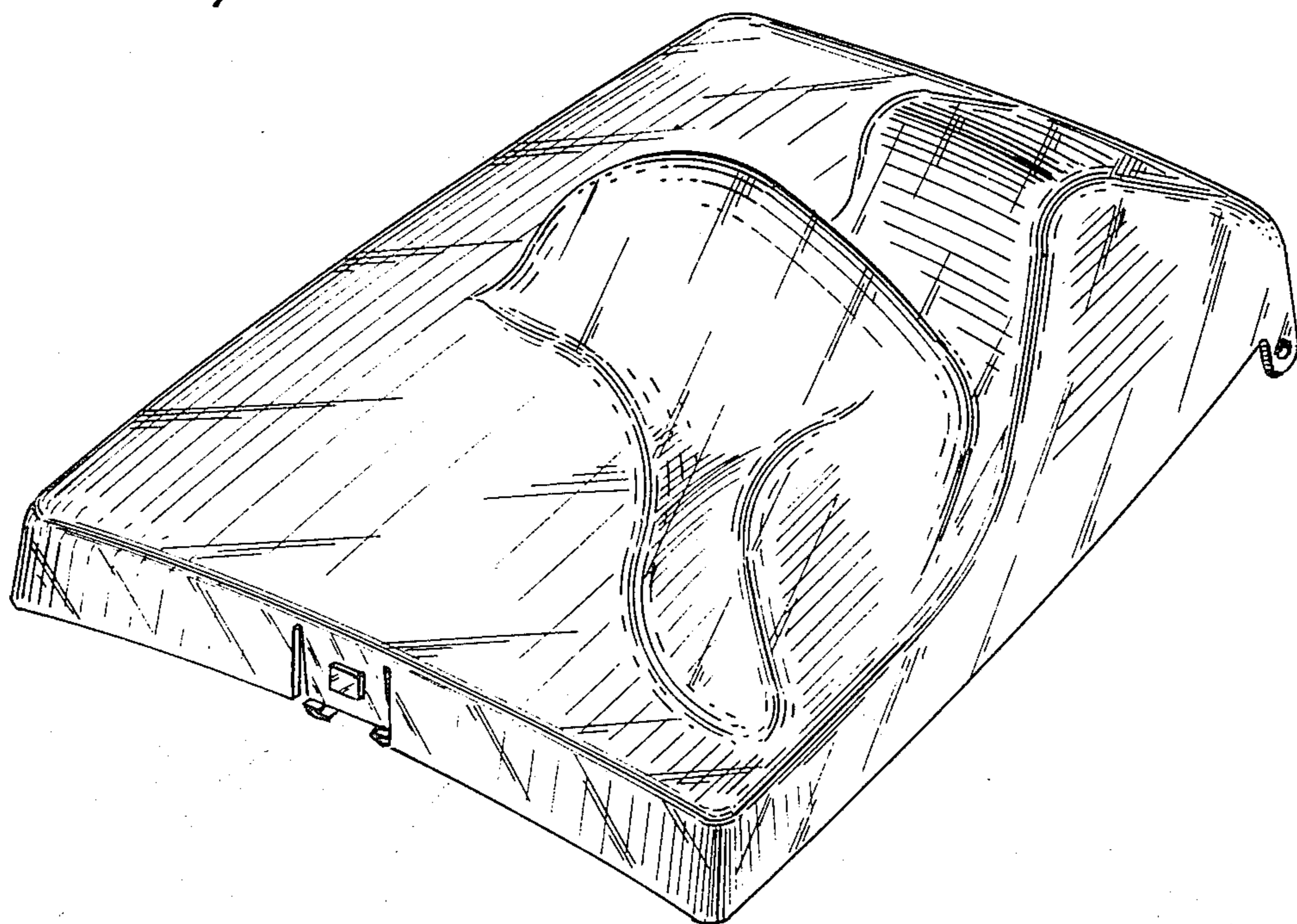

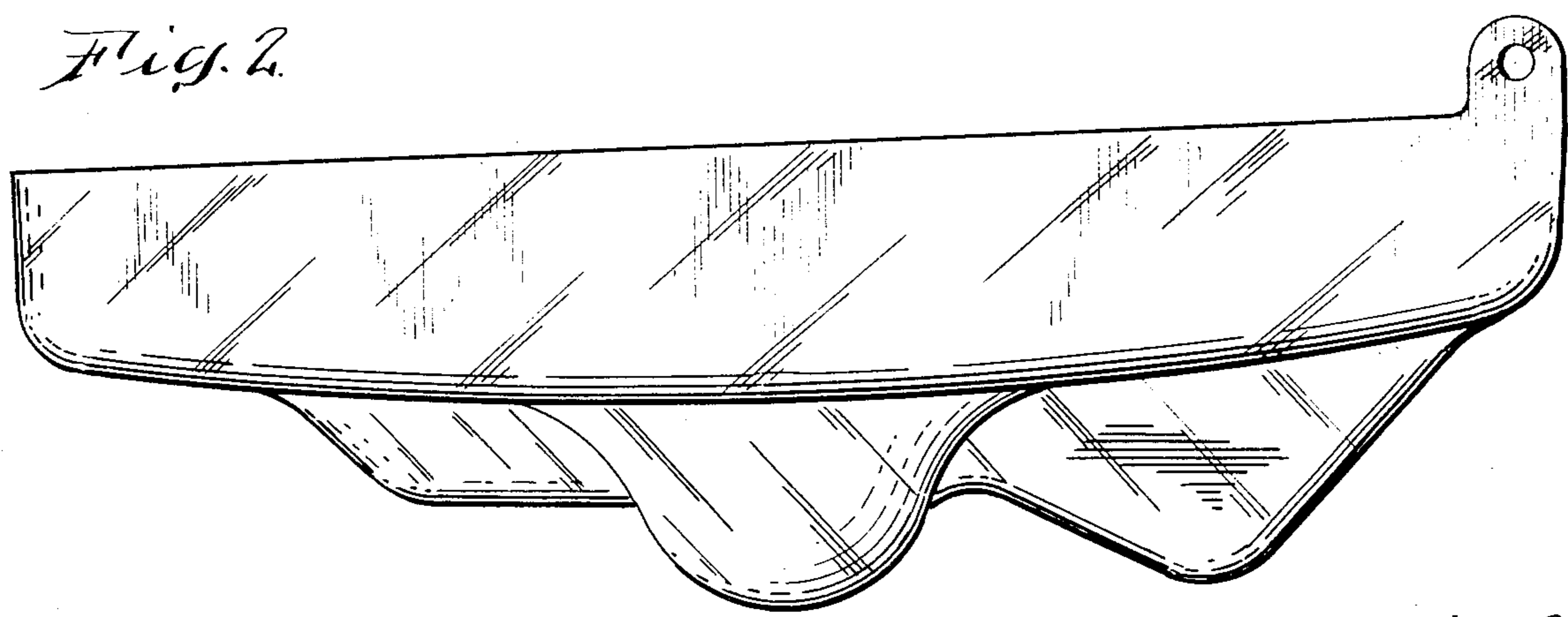

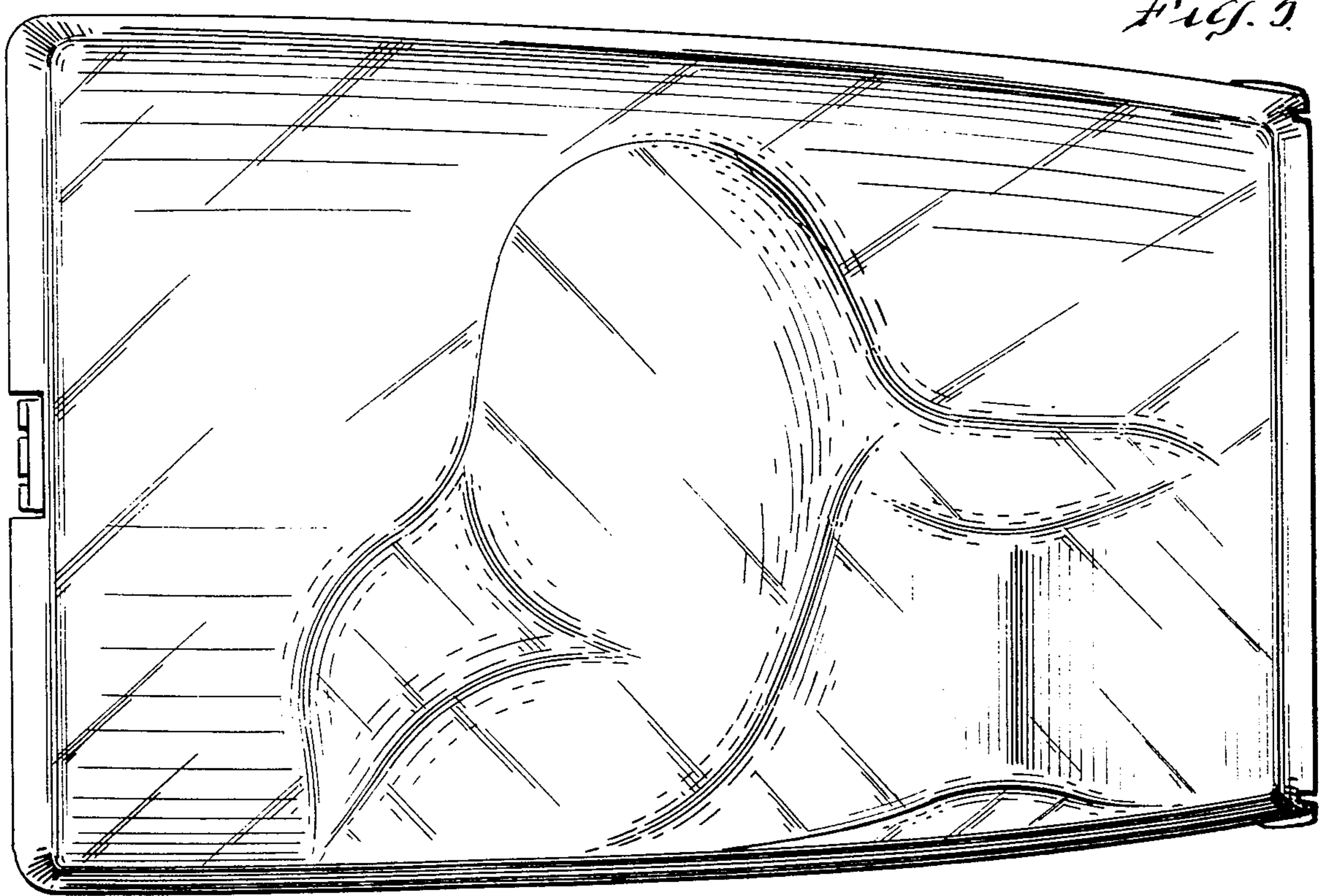
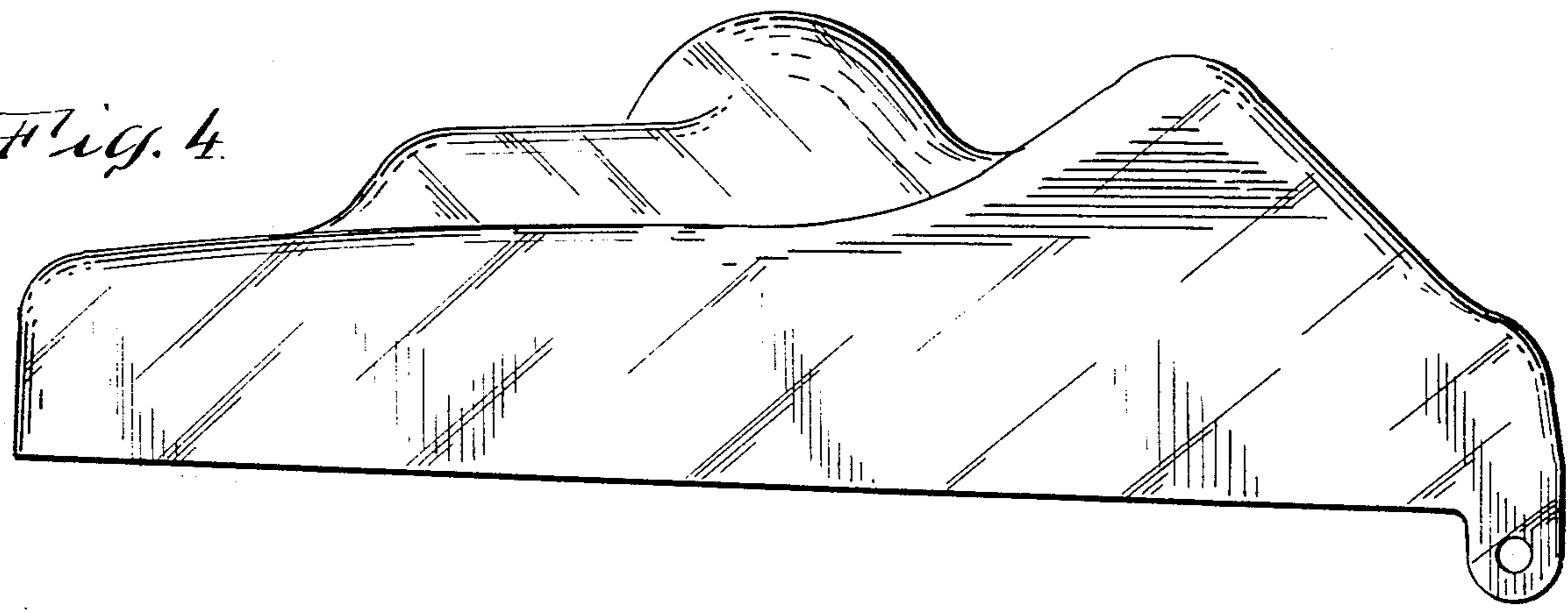

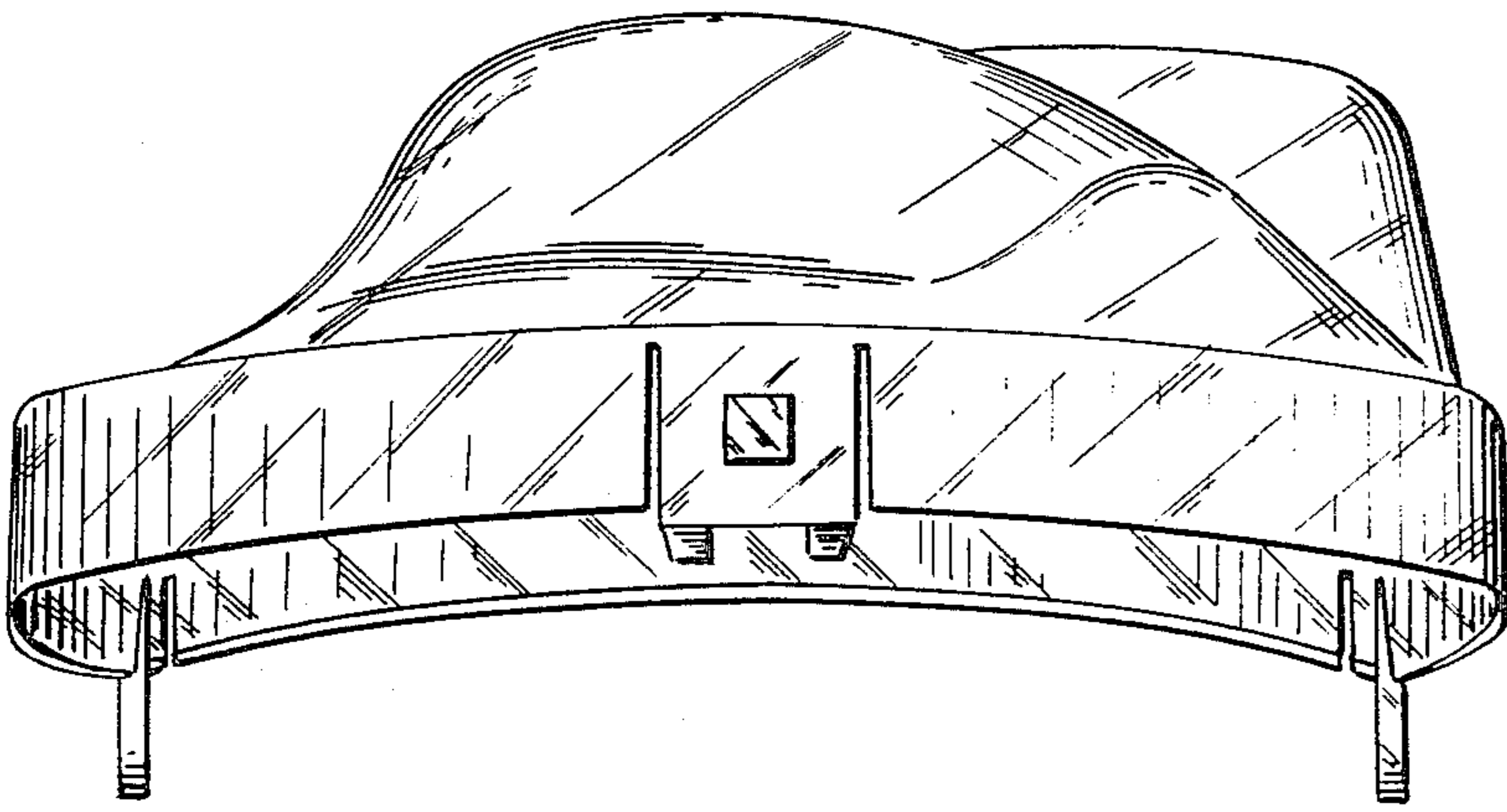

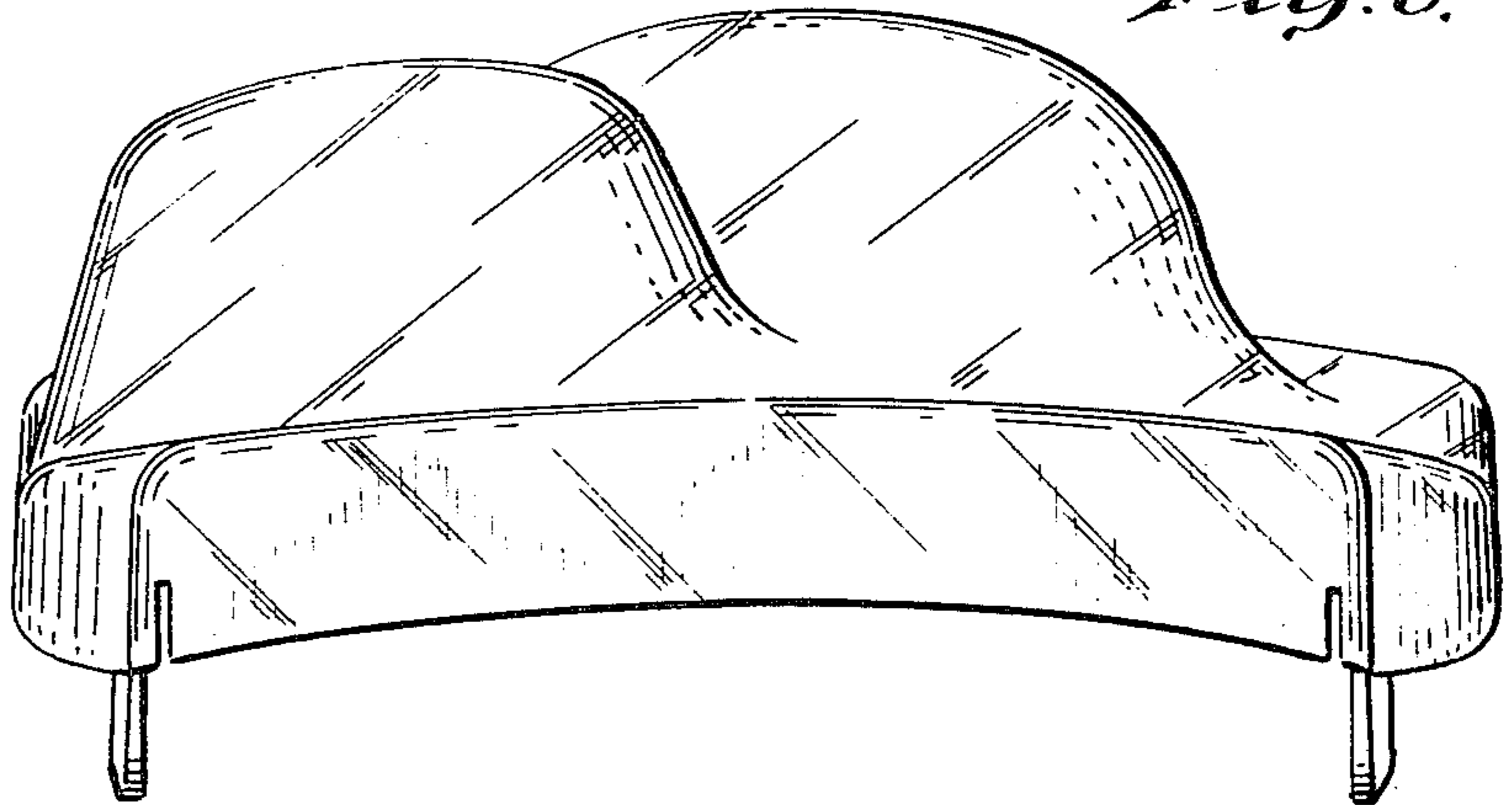
