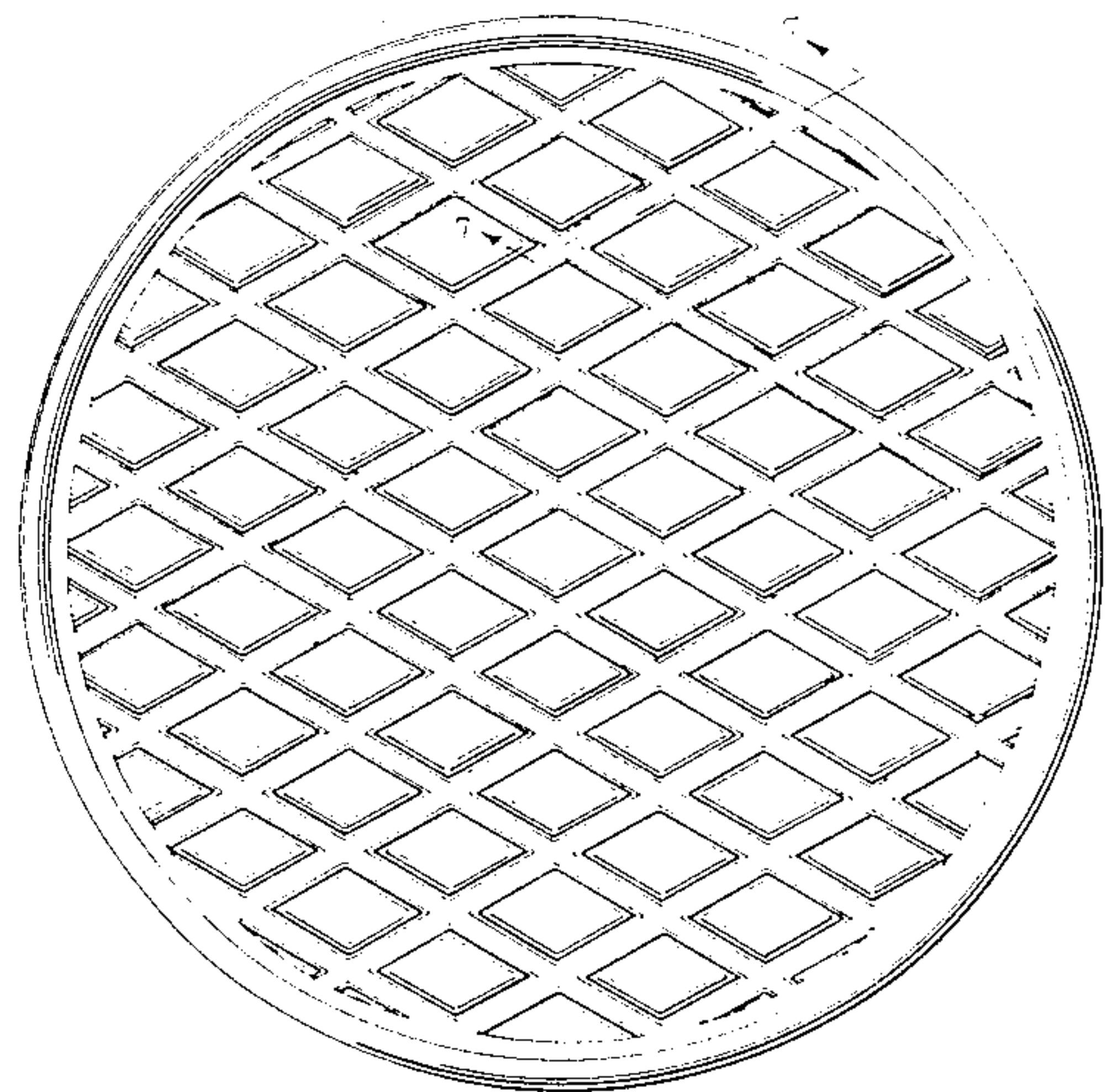
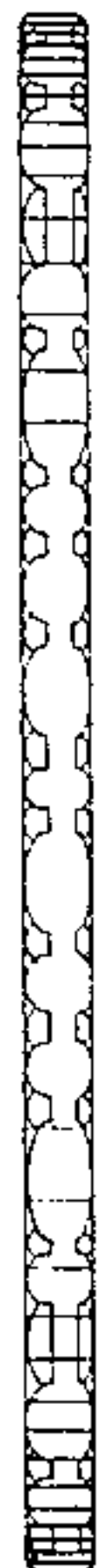
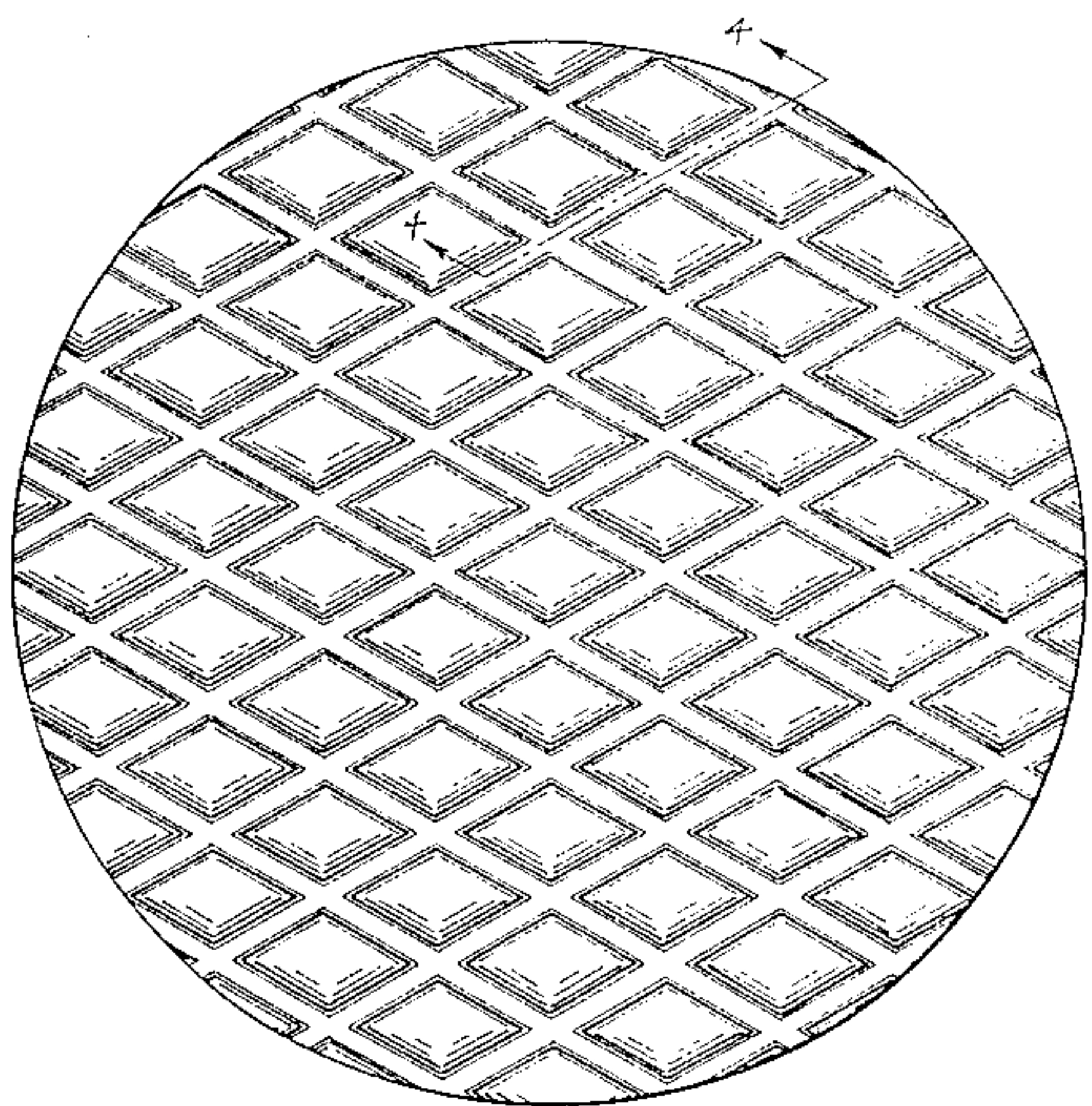

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pizza shell, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a pizza shell showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of the pizza shell shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 5.



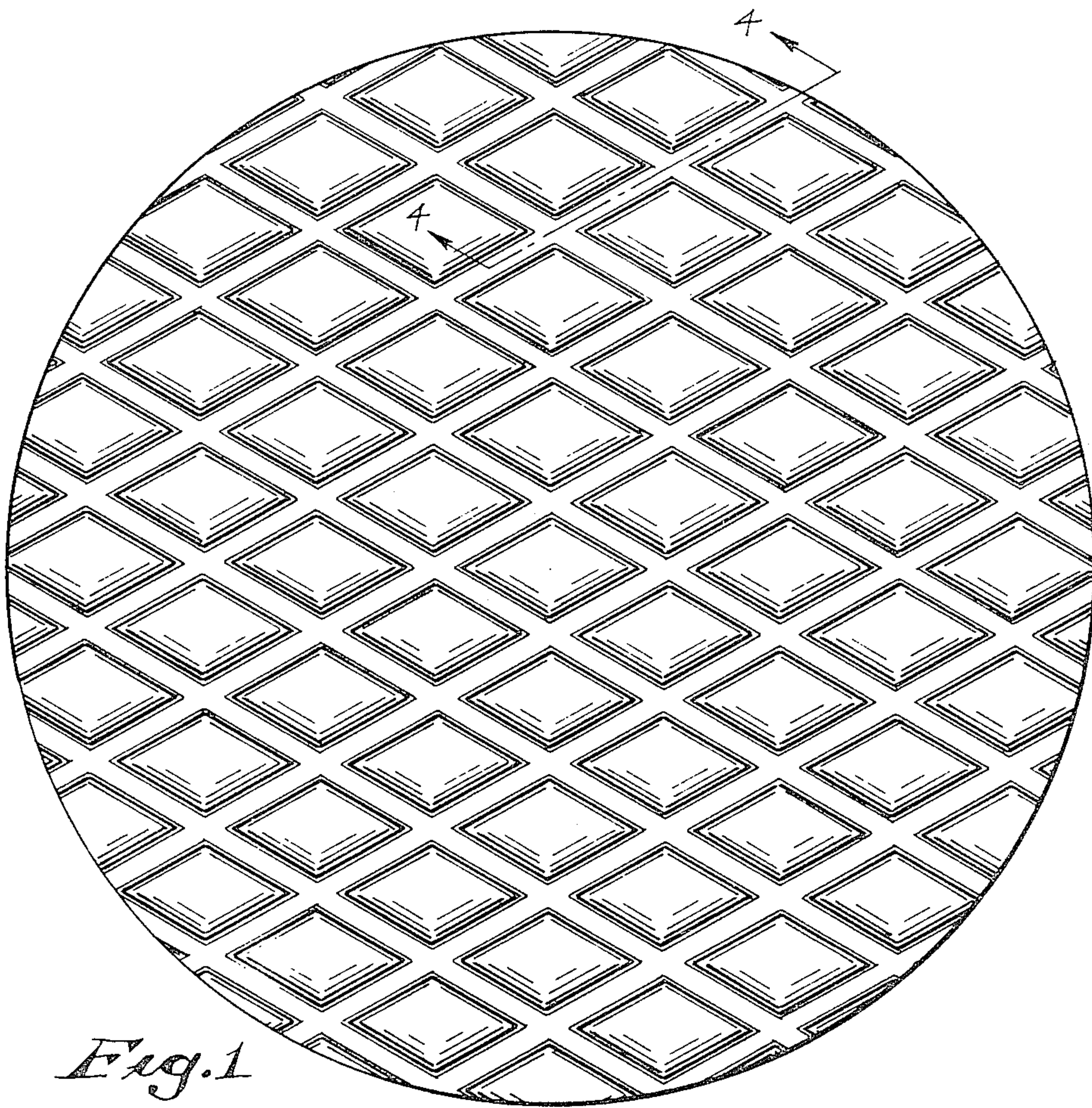

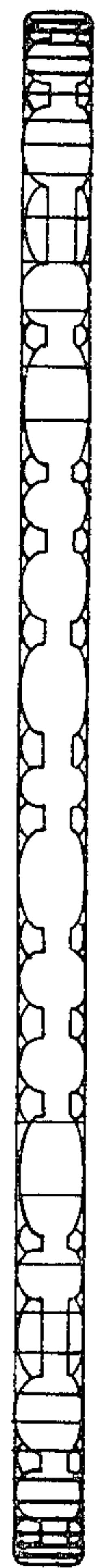

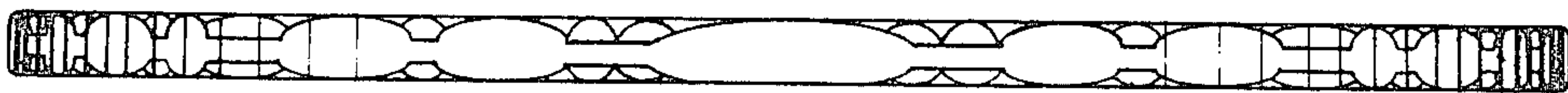

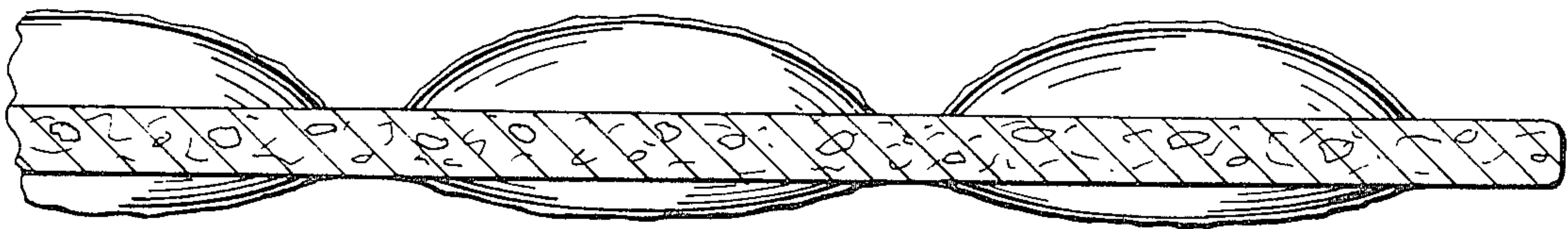

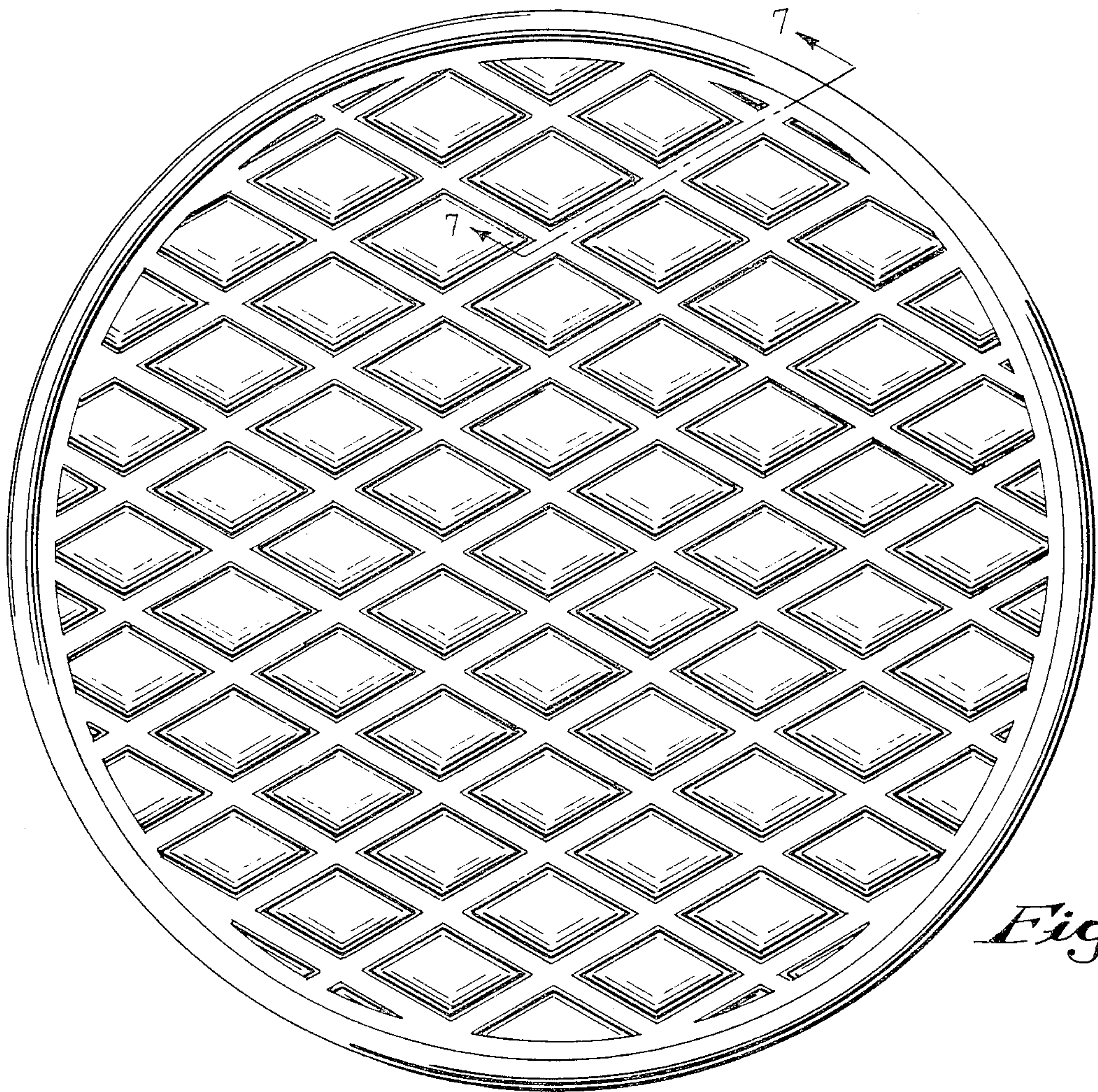

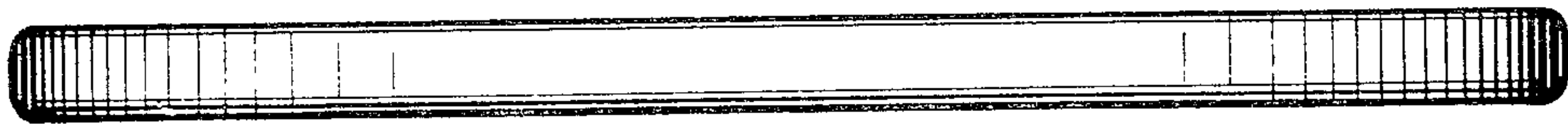

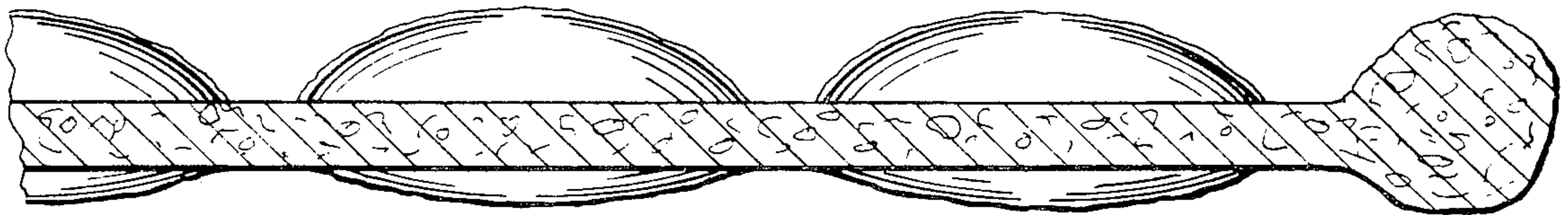
