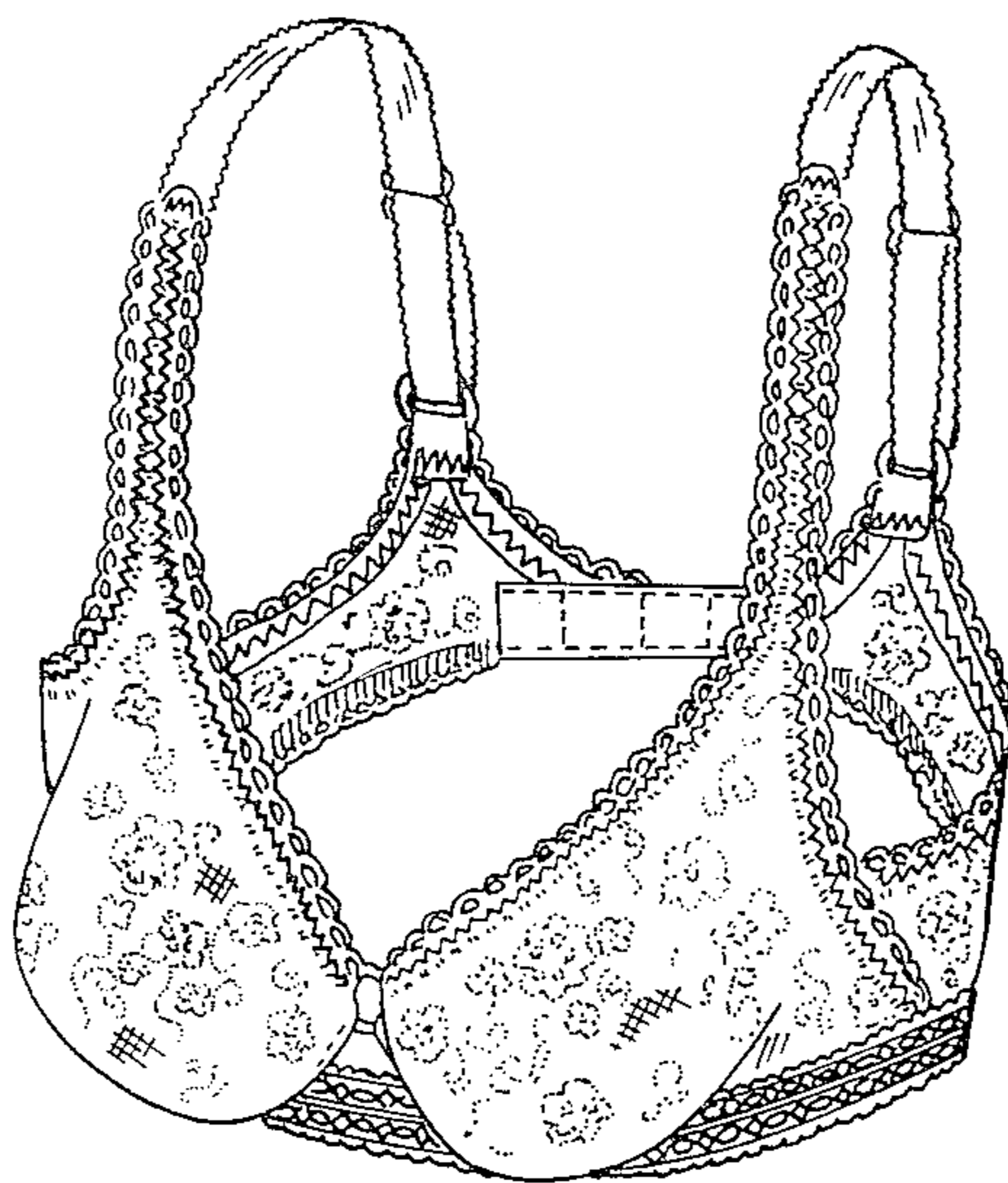

The ornamental design for a brassiere, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a brassiere showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view with the straps shown as broken off for convenience of illustration; and
FIG. 3 is a rear, bottom and left side perspective view.



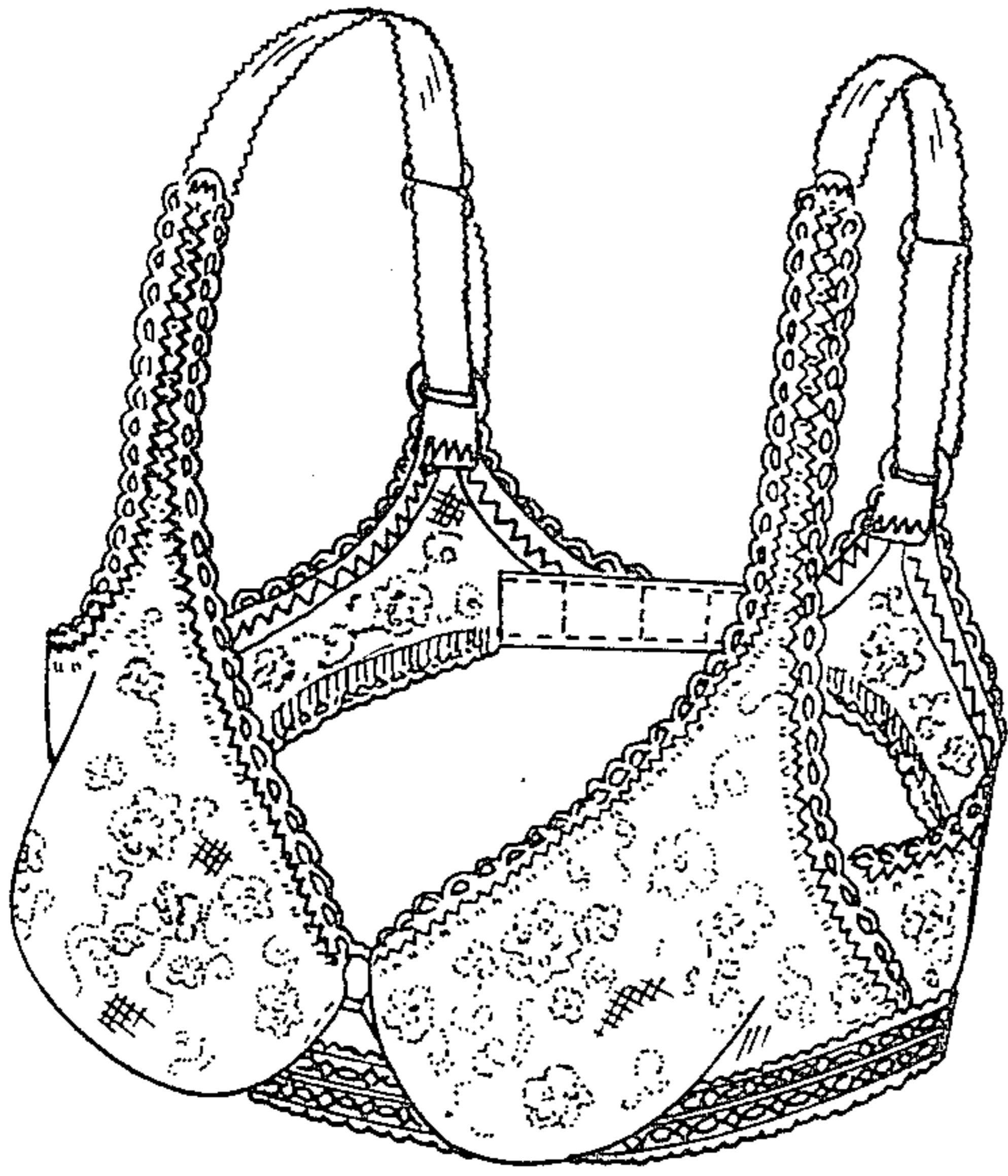

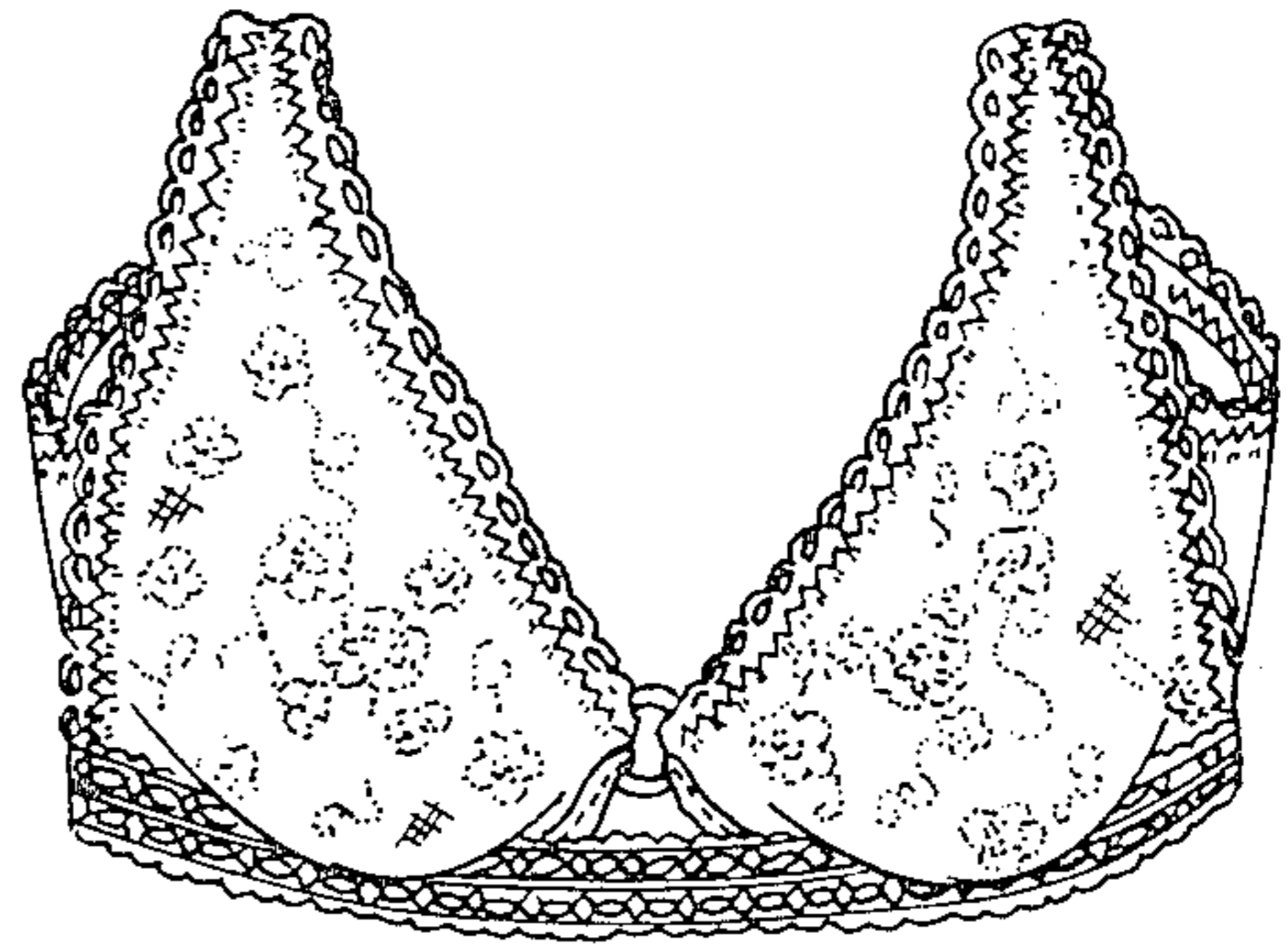

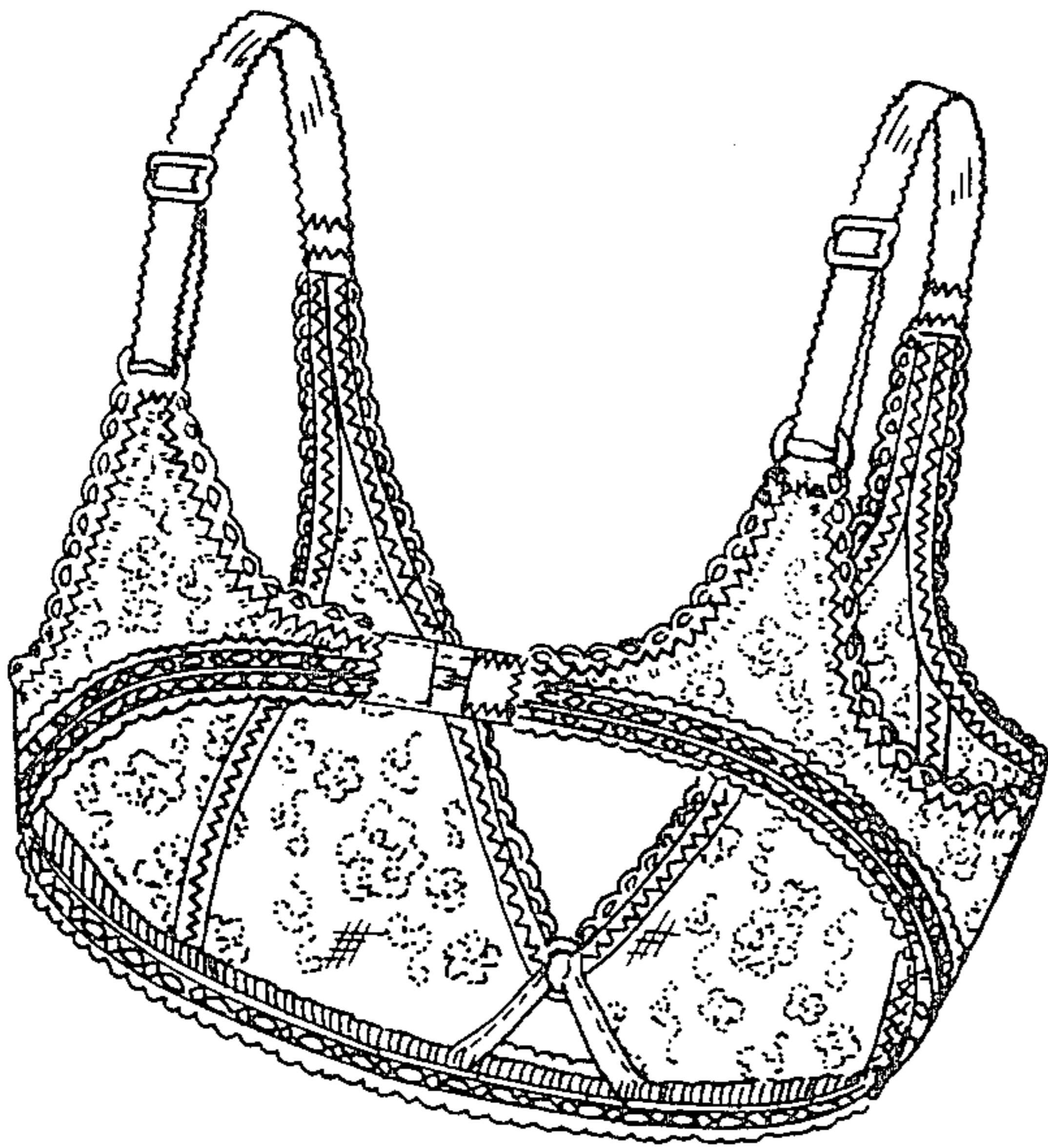
