The ornamental design for a folding music stand, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a music stand showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the stand shown in FIG. 1;

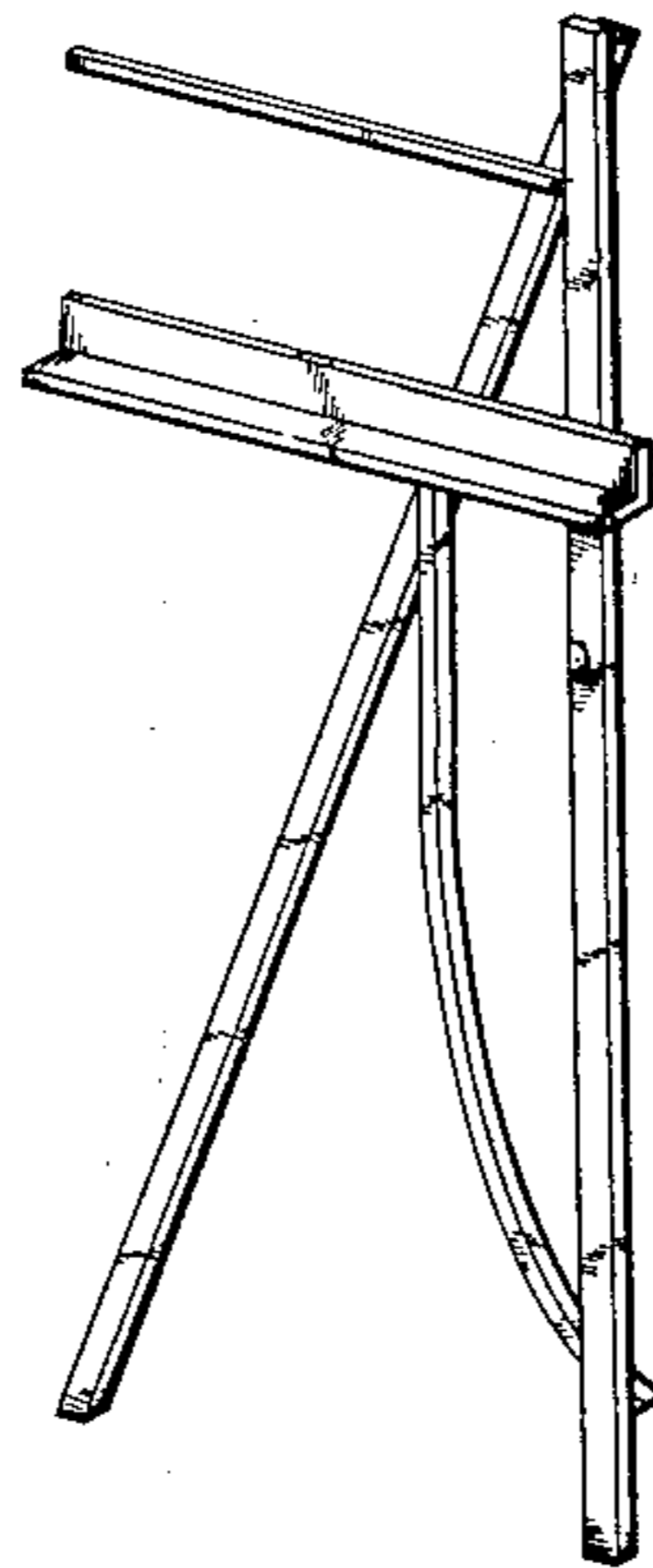
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view, opposite the side shown in FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is a front view of the stand shown in FIG. 2, but folded for non-use;

FIG. 7 is a side view of the stand as in FIG. 3, but folded for non-use.



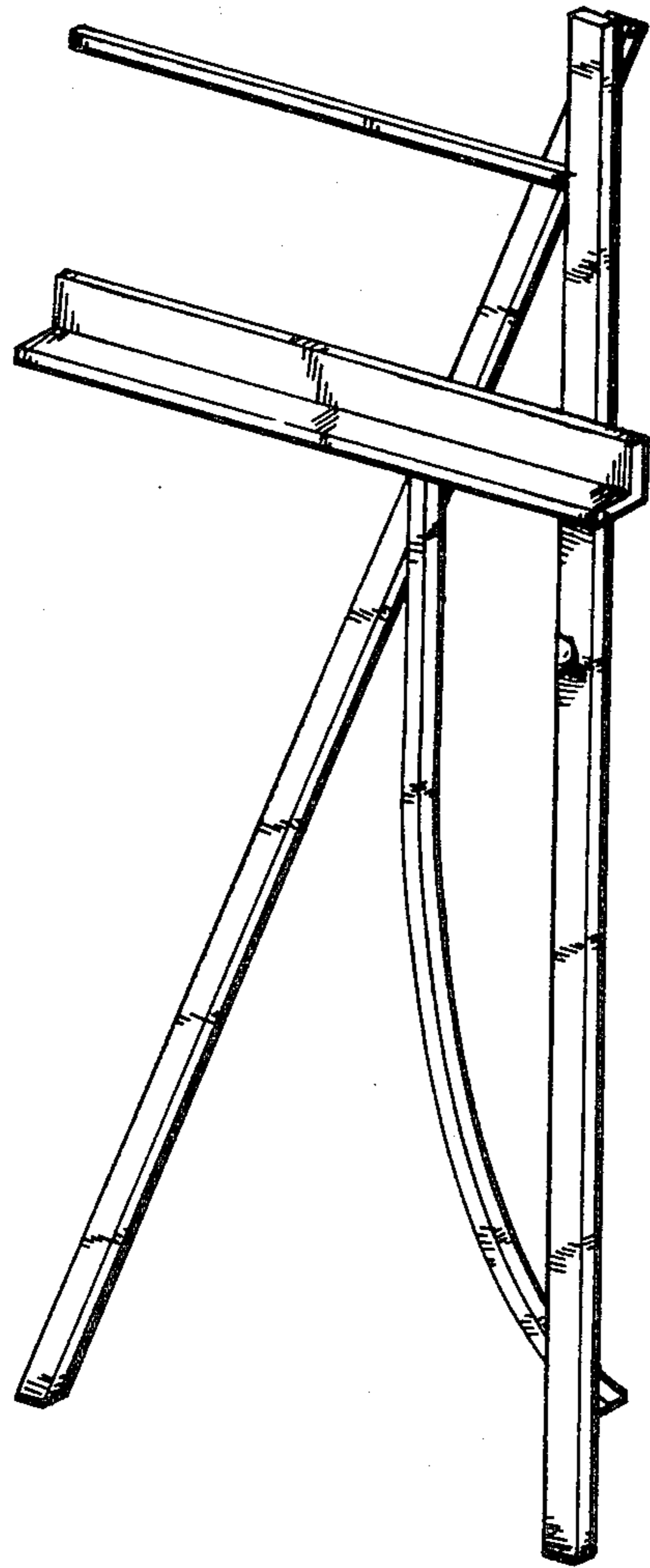

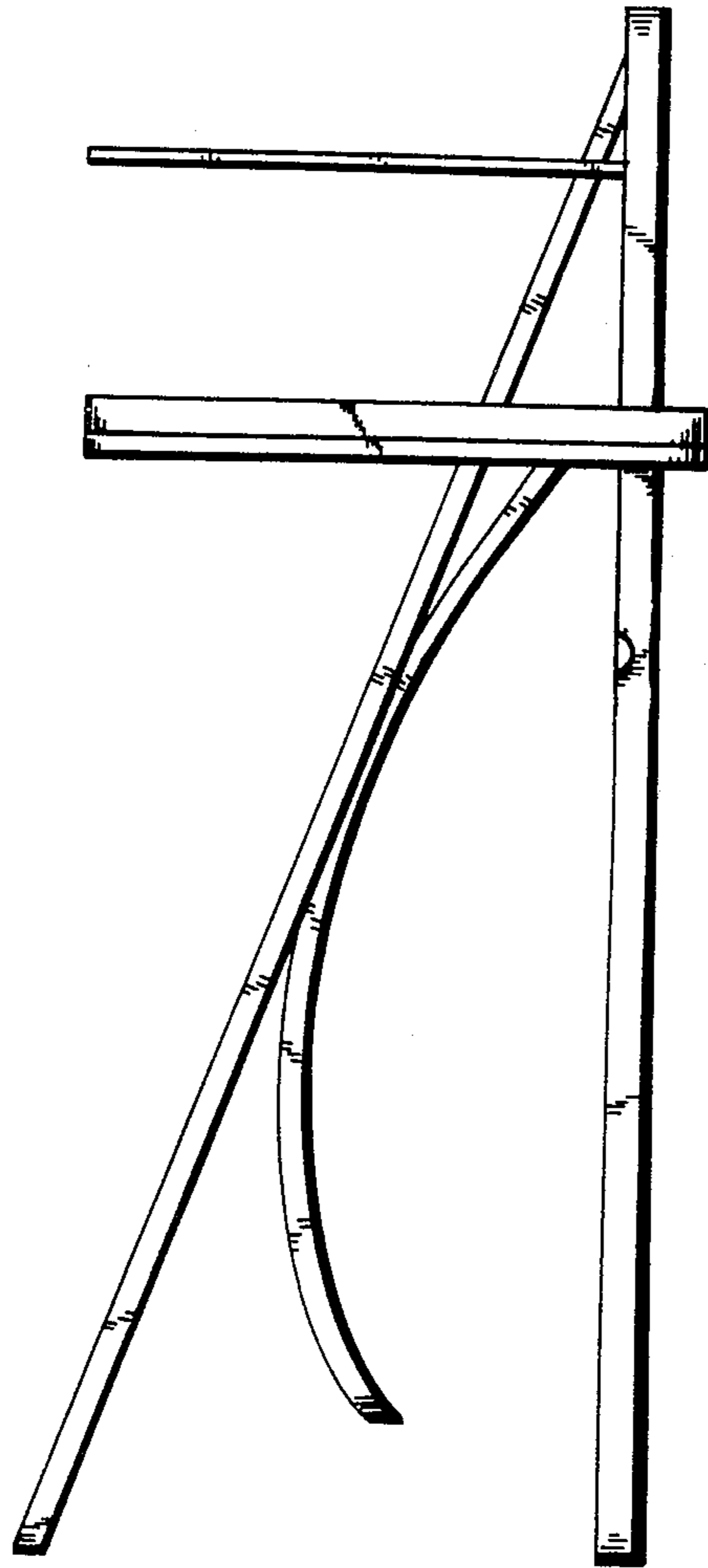

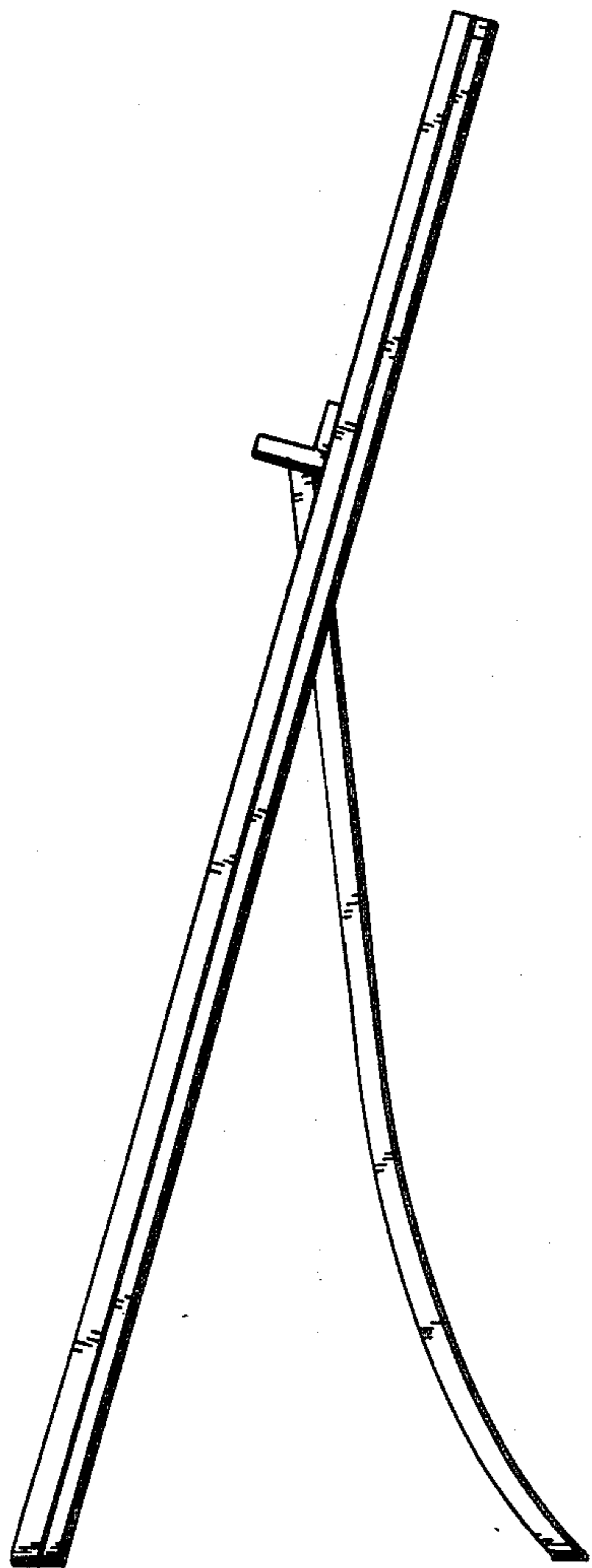

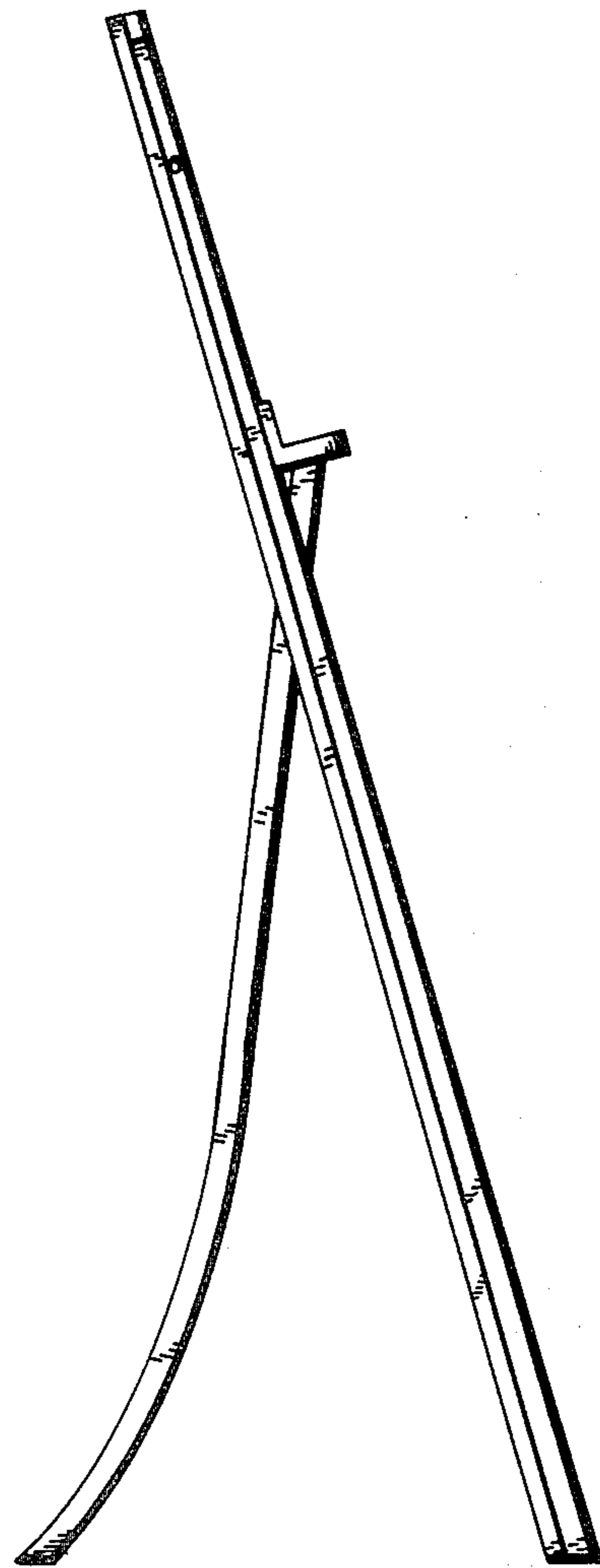

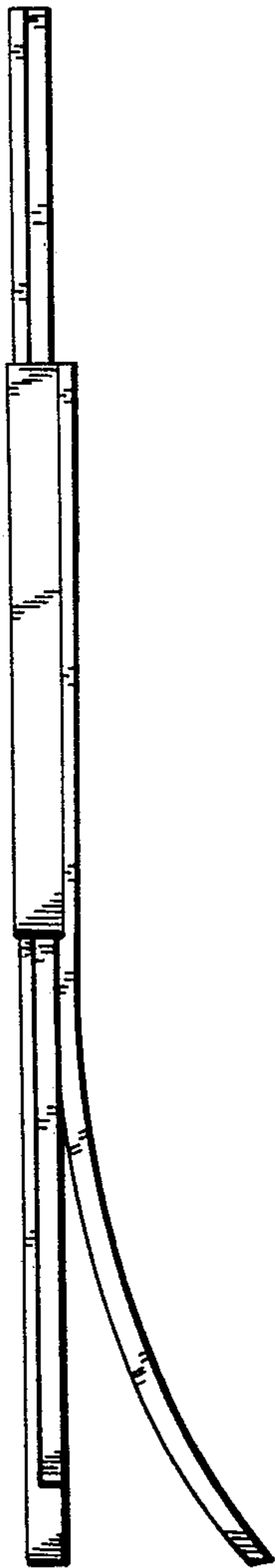

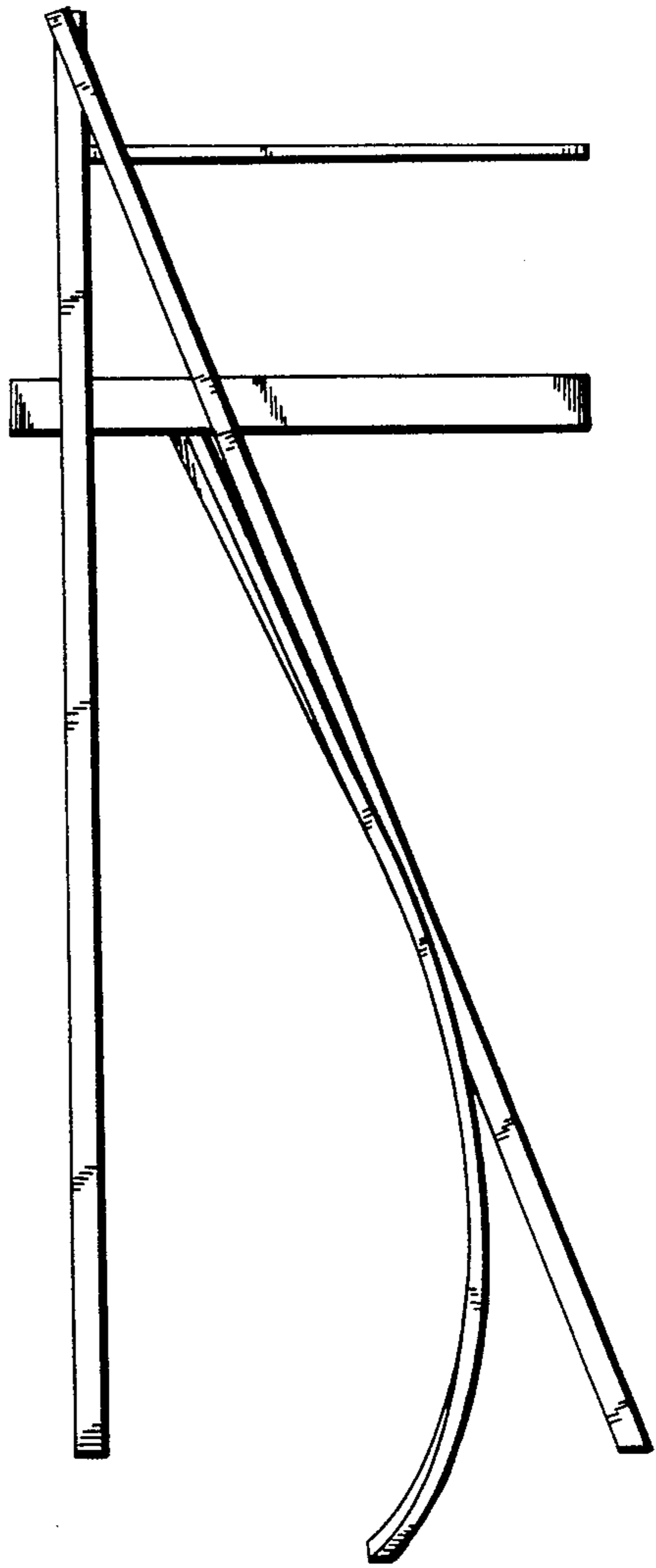
