FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a record player showing our new design; and FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

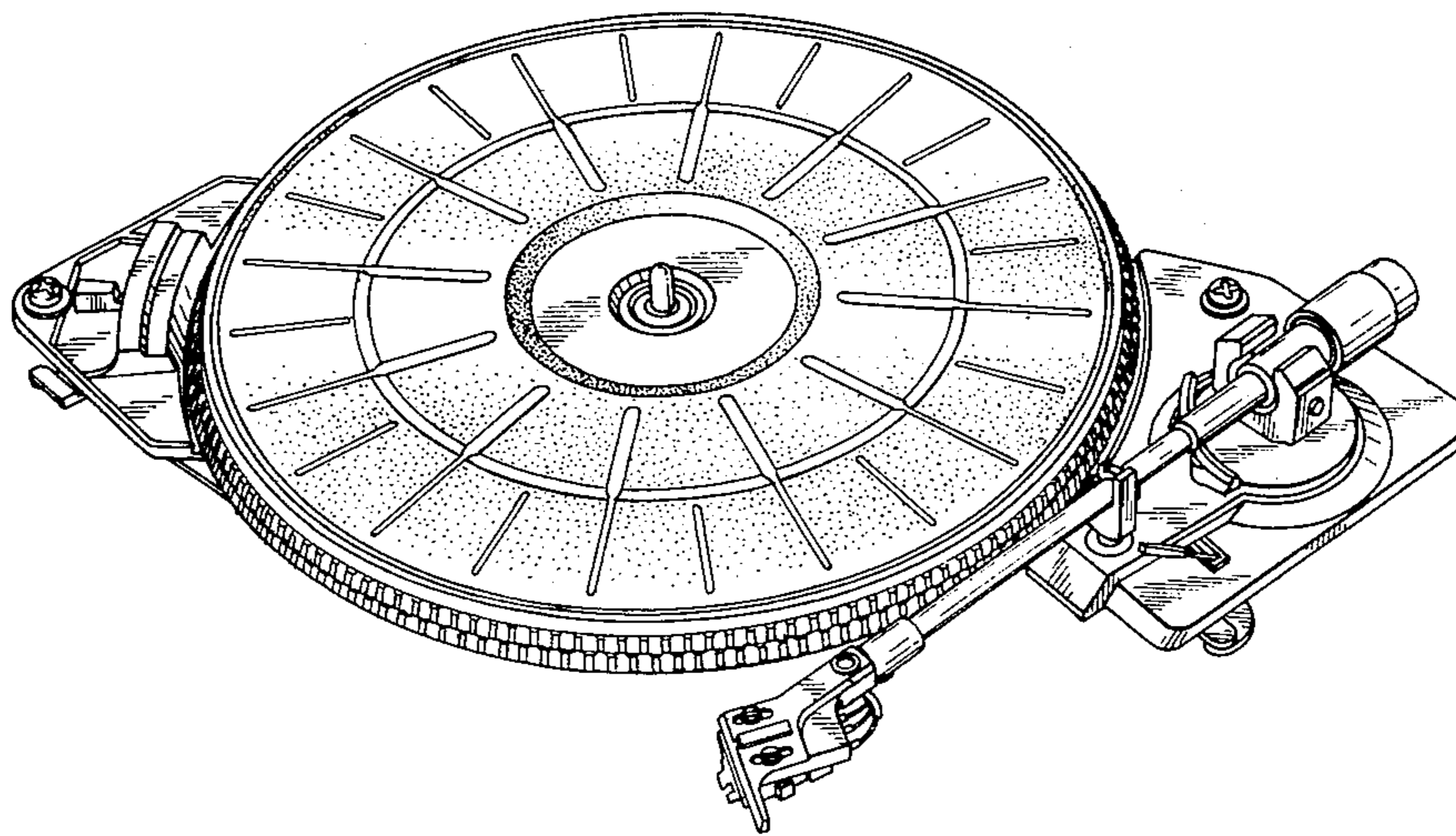

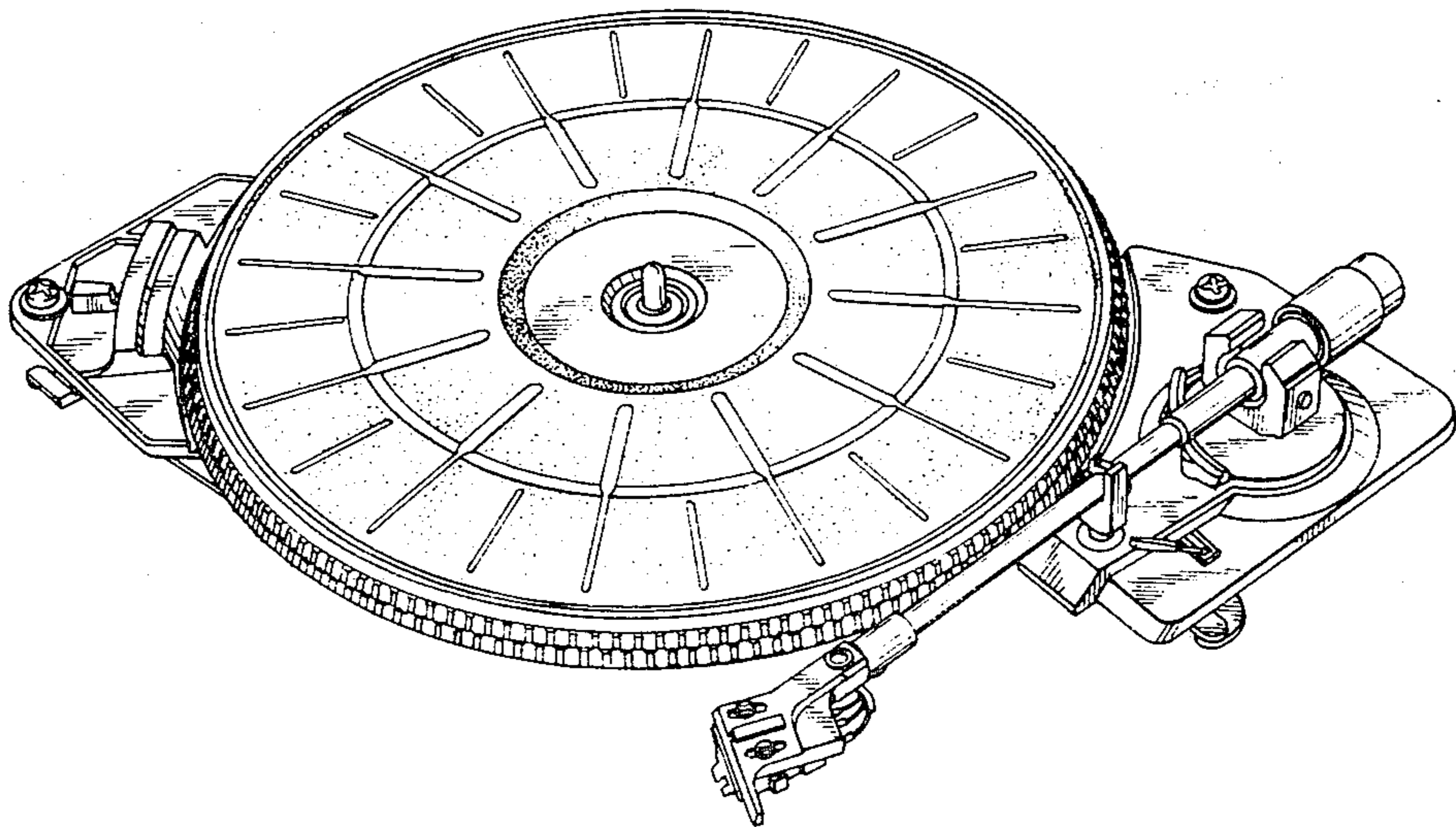
