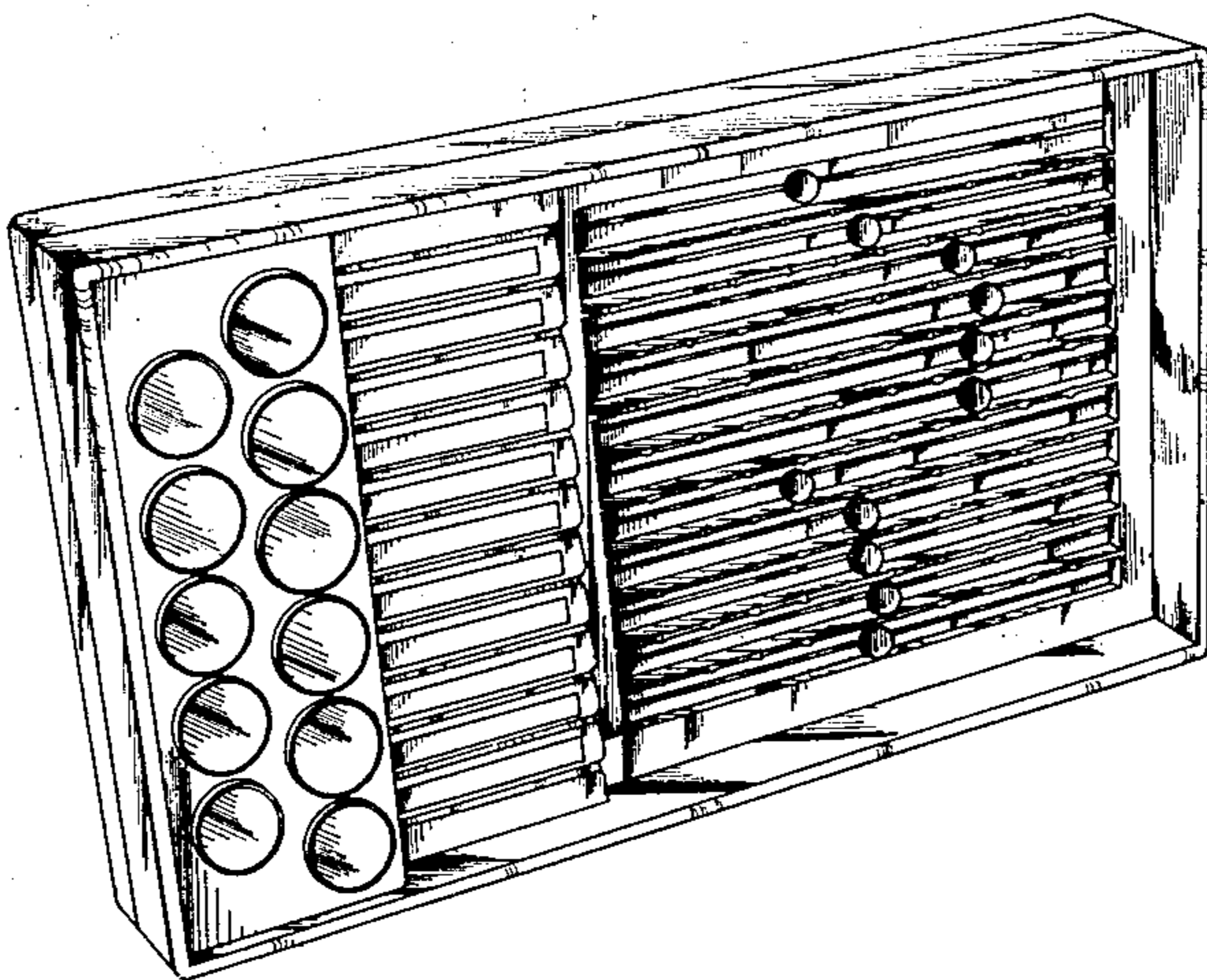

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a two sided in-out panel and message holder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front isometric view of a two sided in-out panel and message holder, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top rear isometric view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view, the bottom view being identical thereto;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being identical thereto.



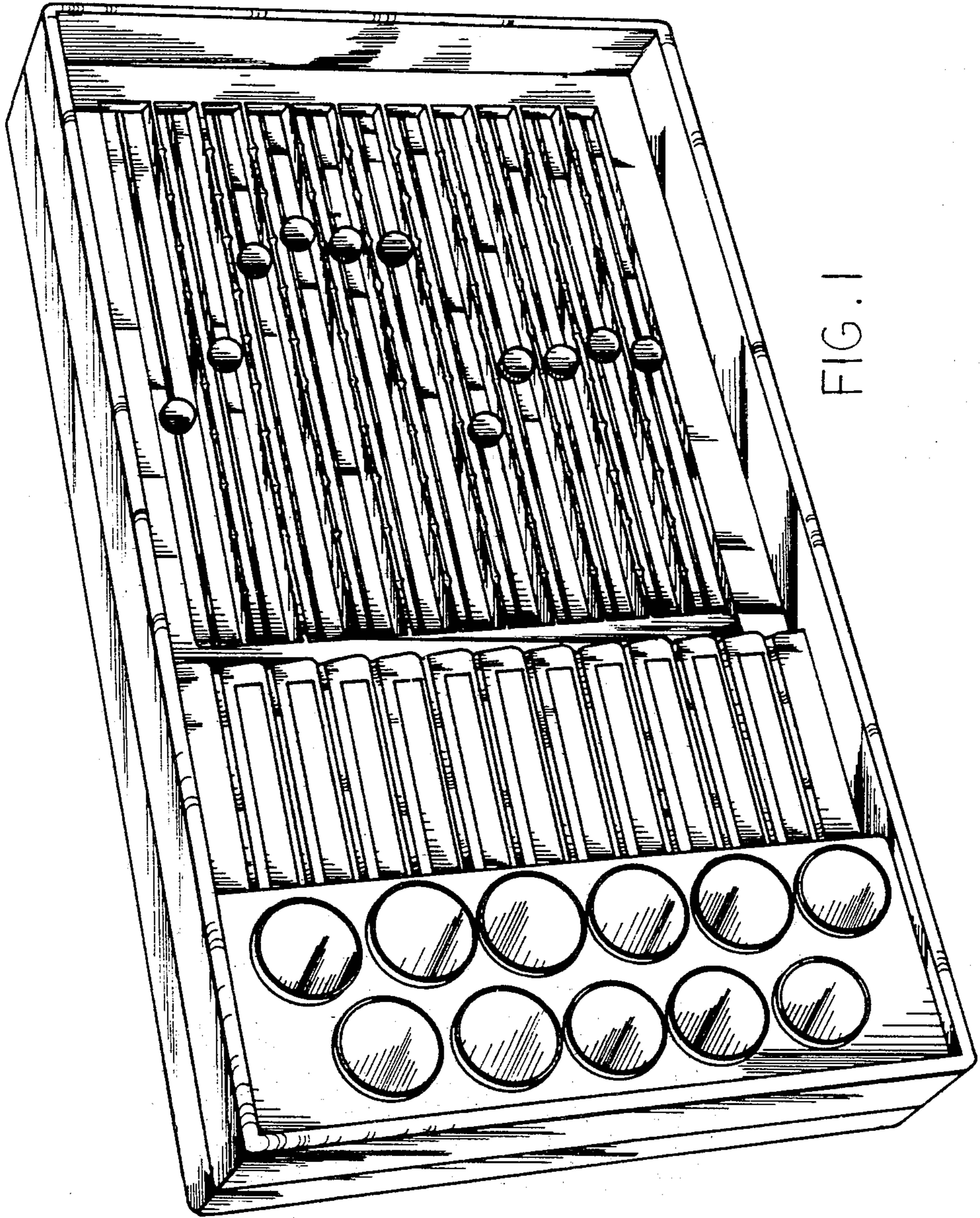

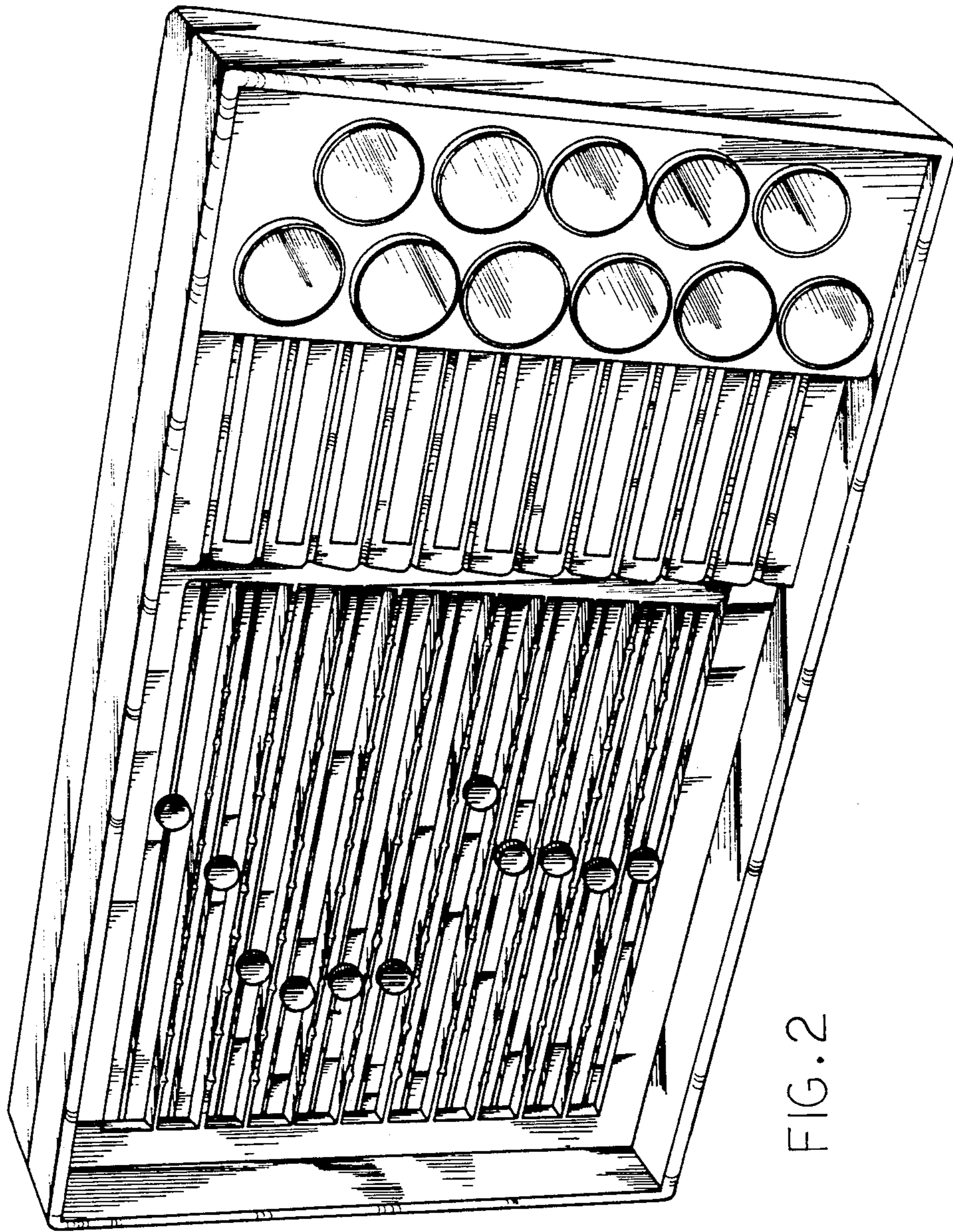

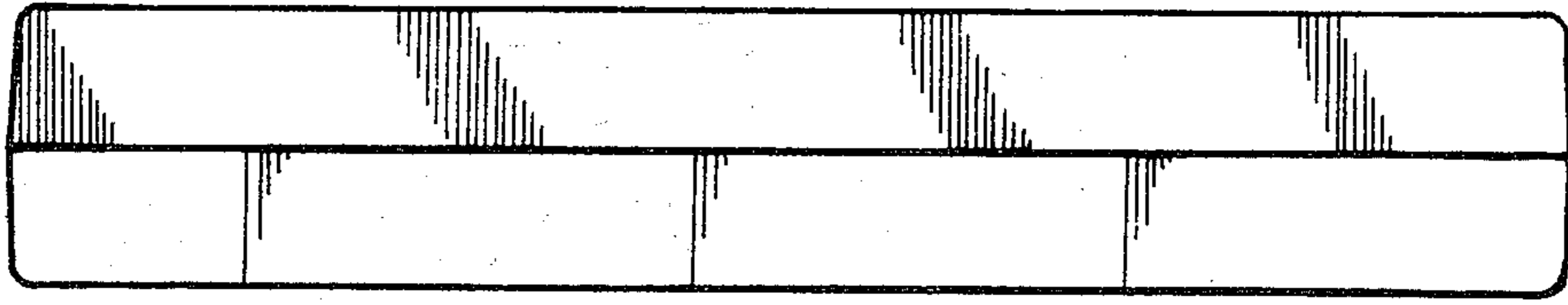

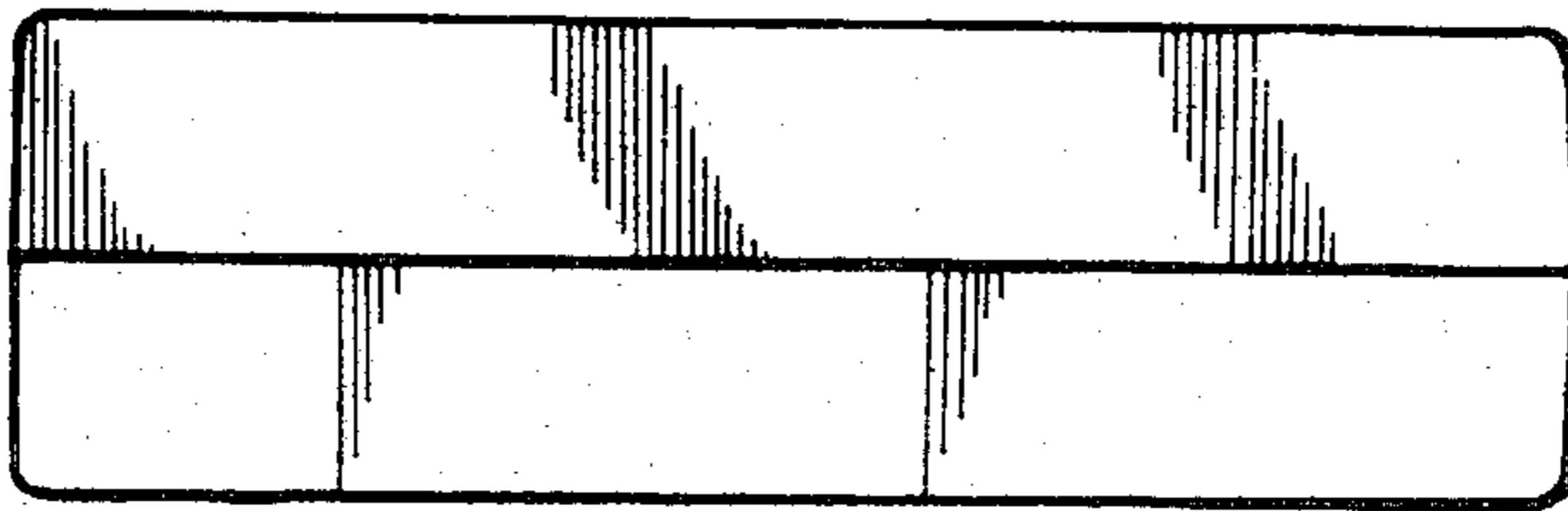
