FIG. 4 is a right side perspective view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image;

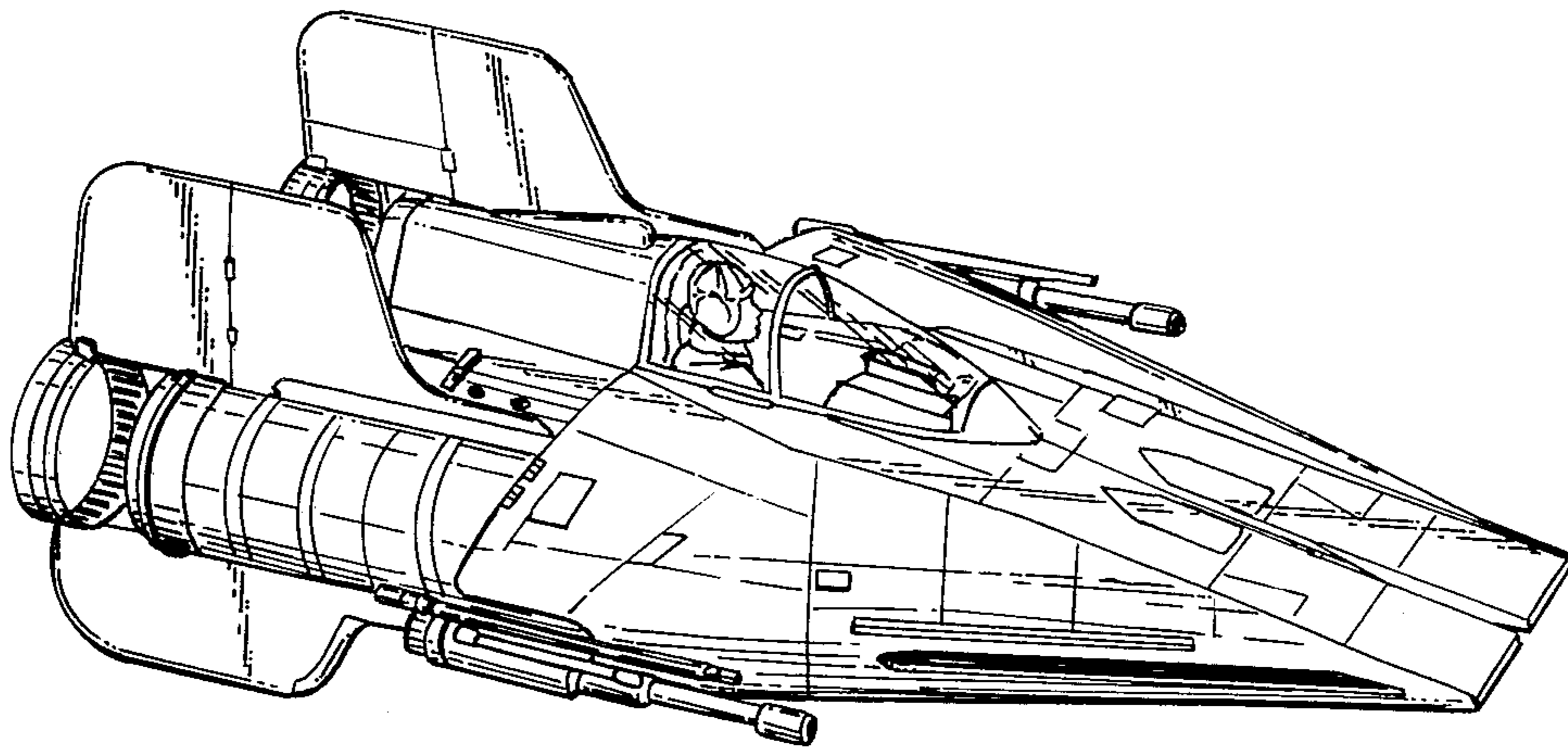
FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof; and,

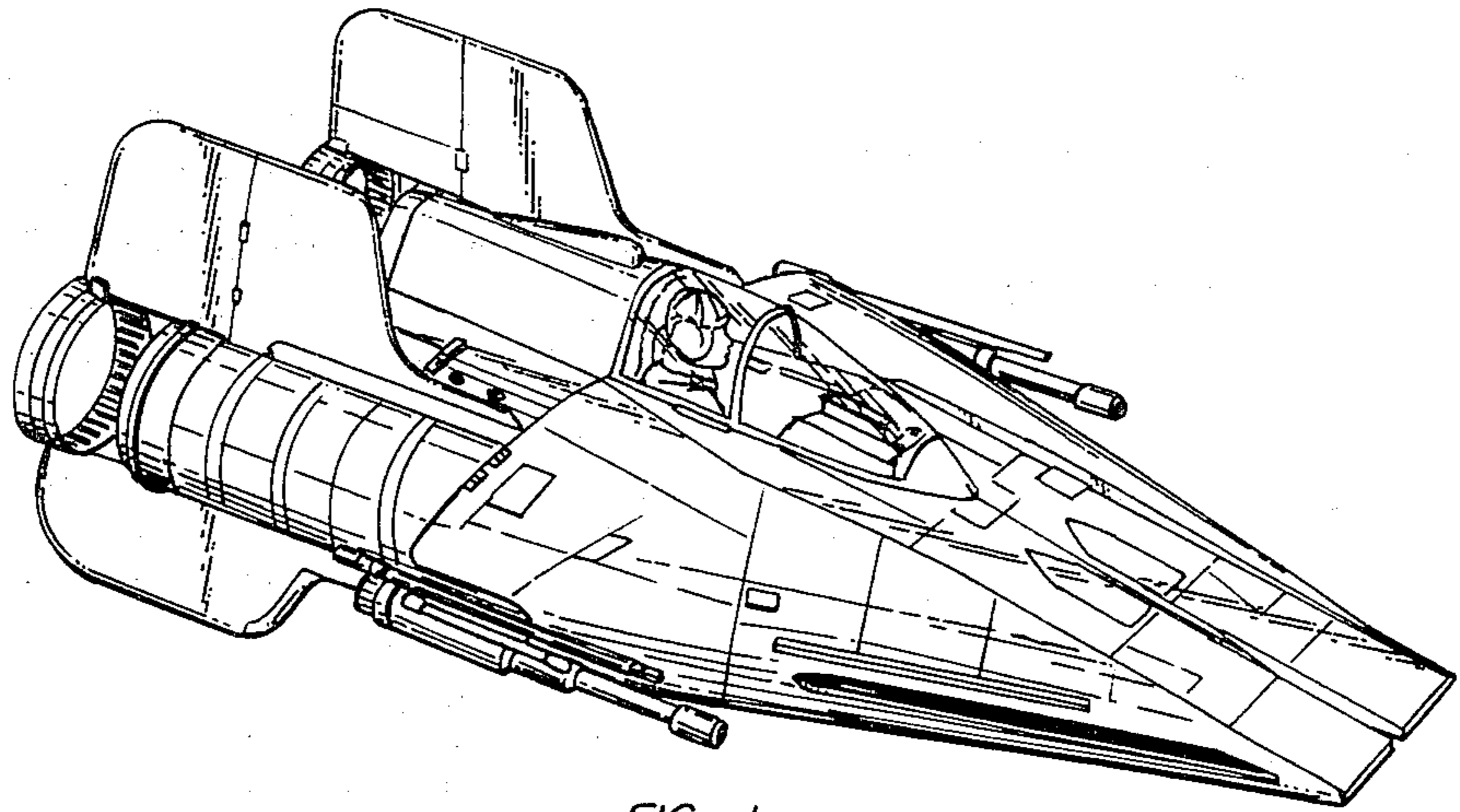

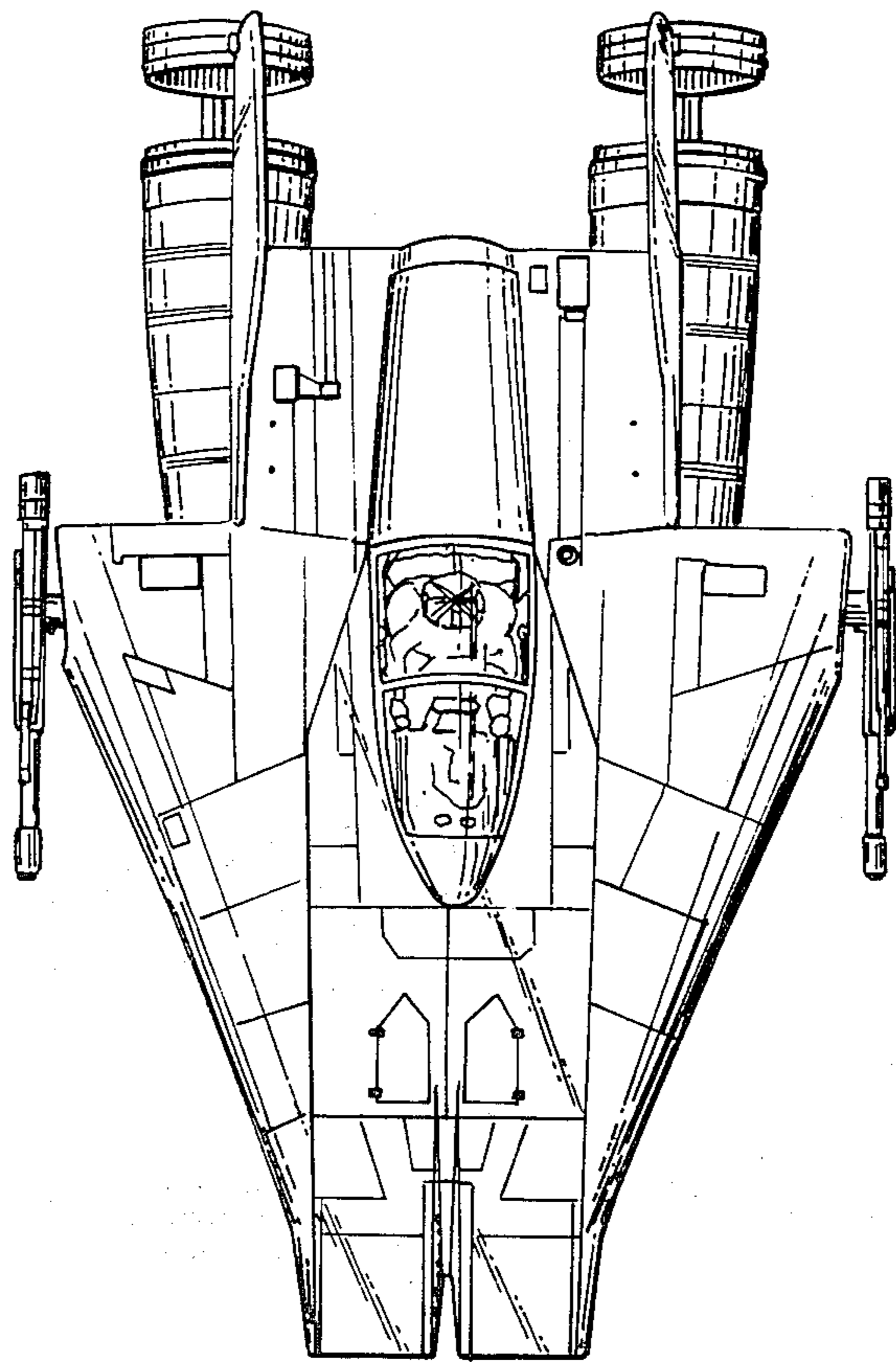

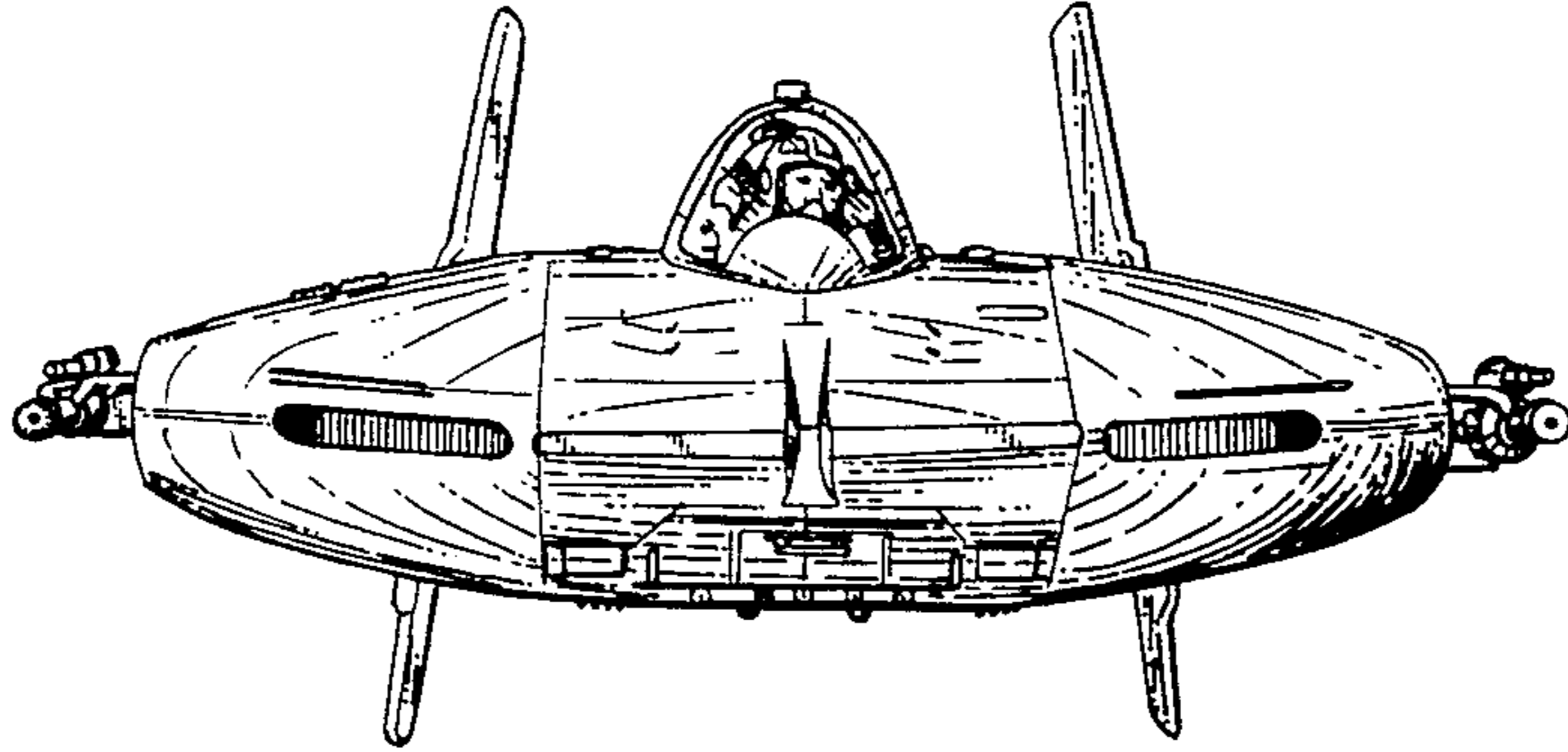

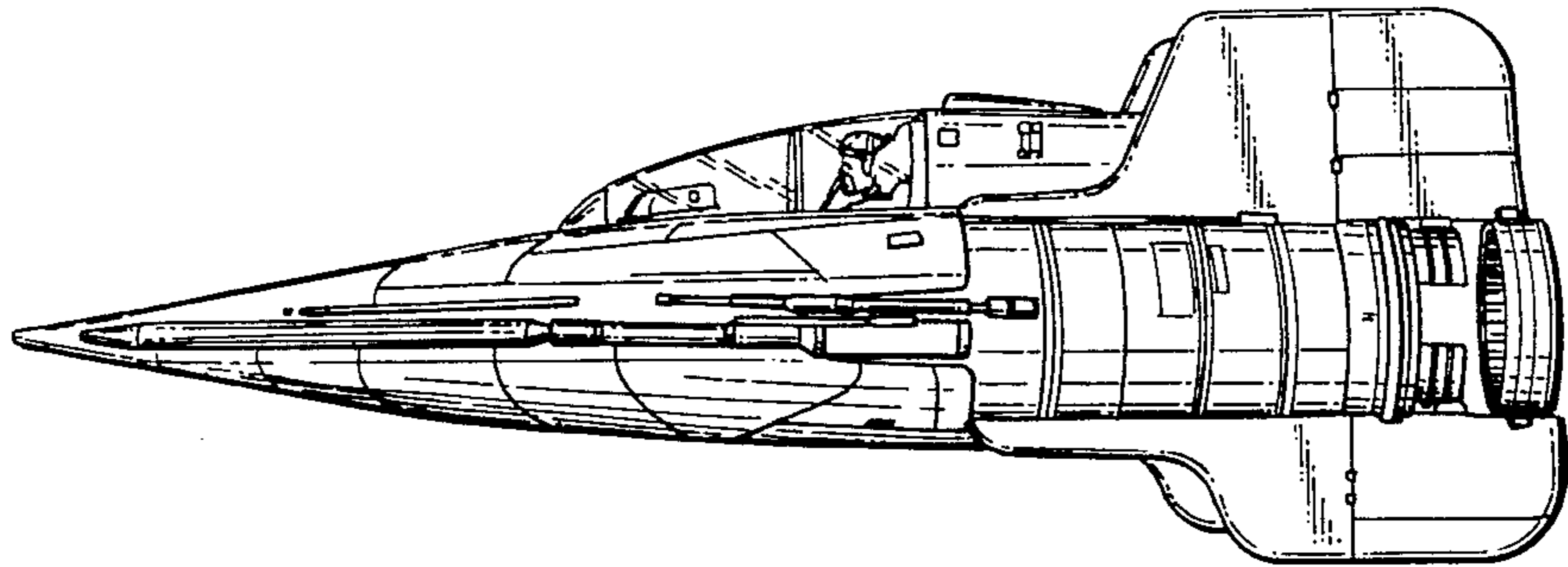

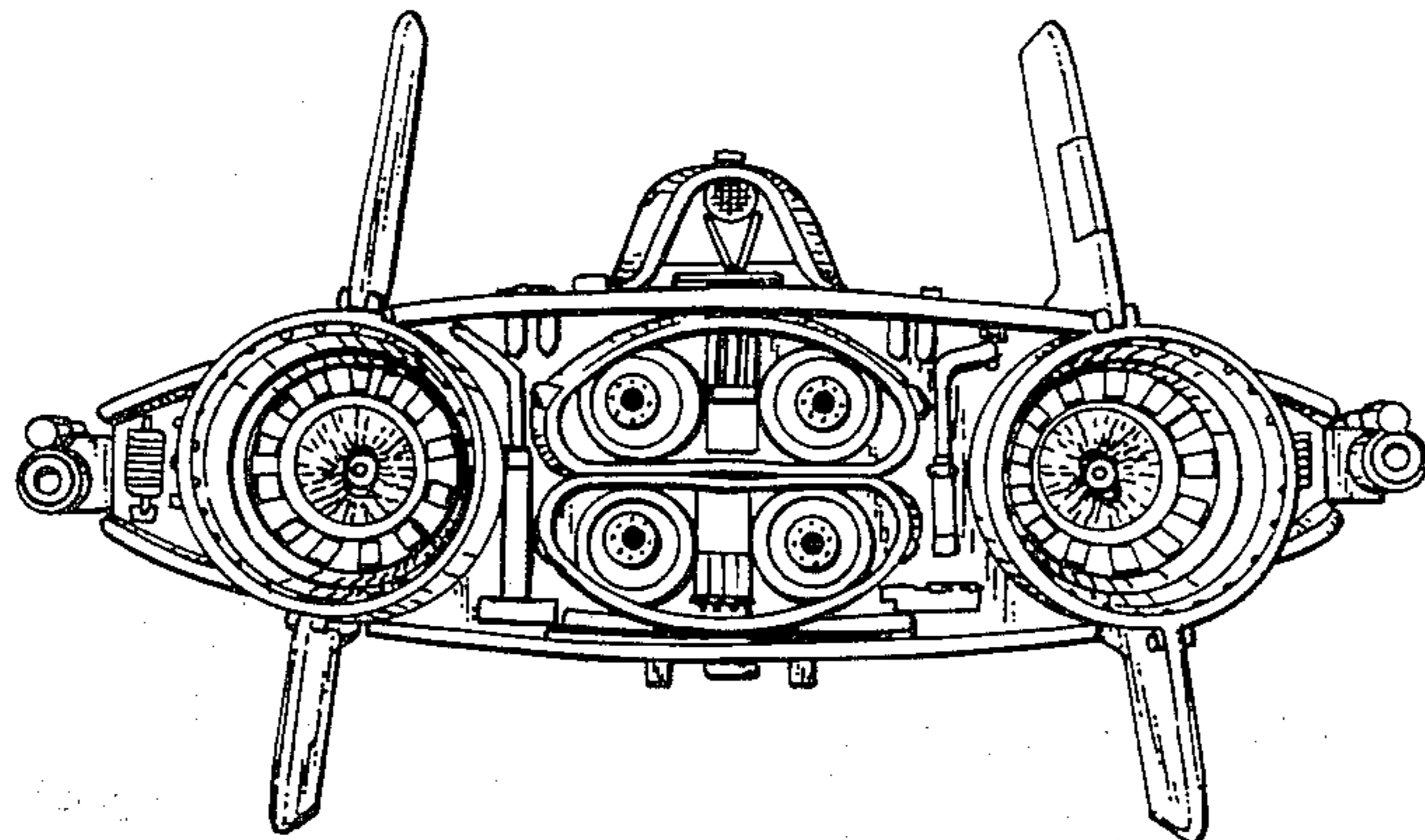

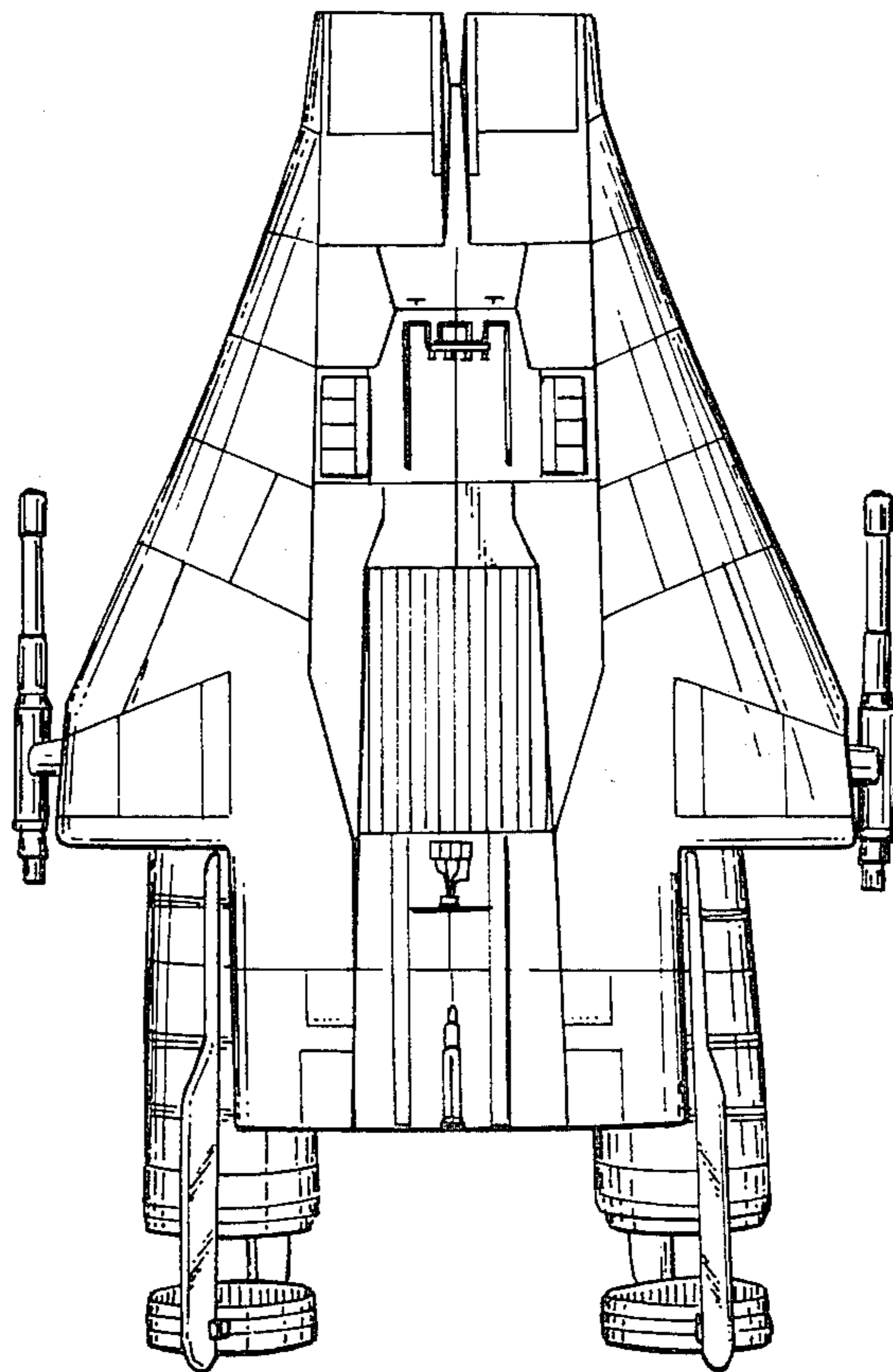
