DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a cover for a baking dish or the like showing my new design.

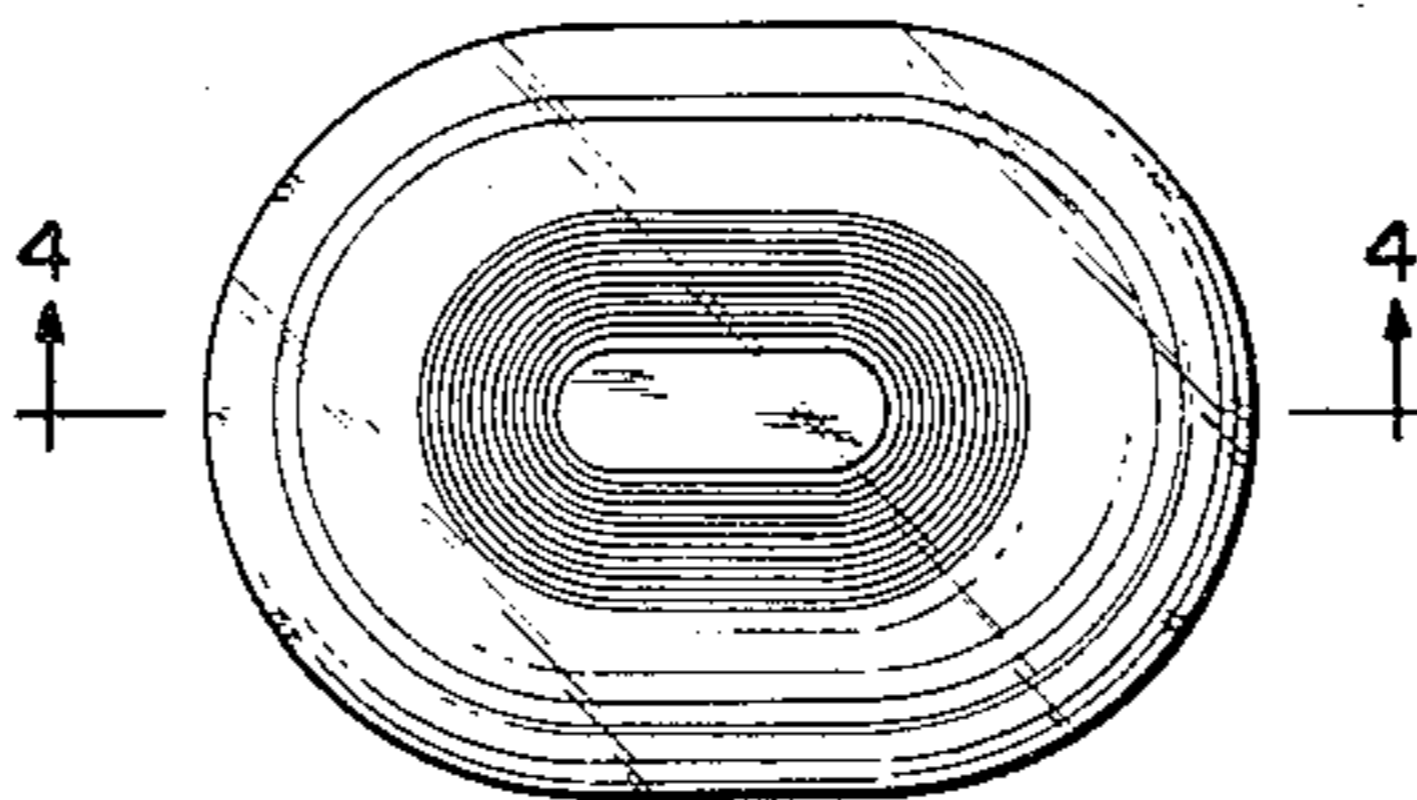
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, with the rear elevational view being identical.

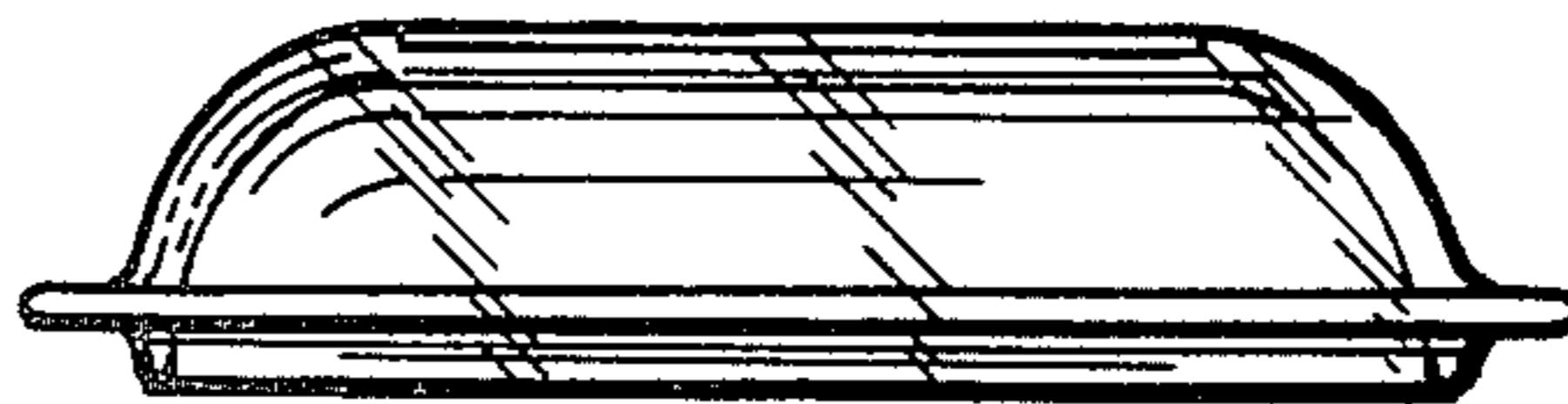
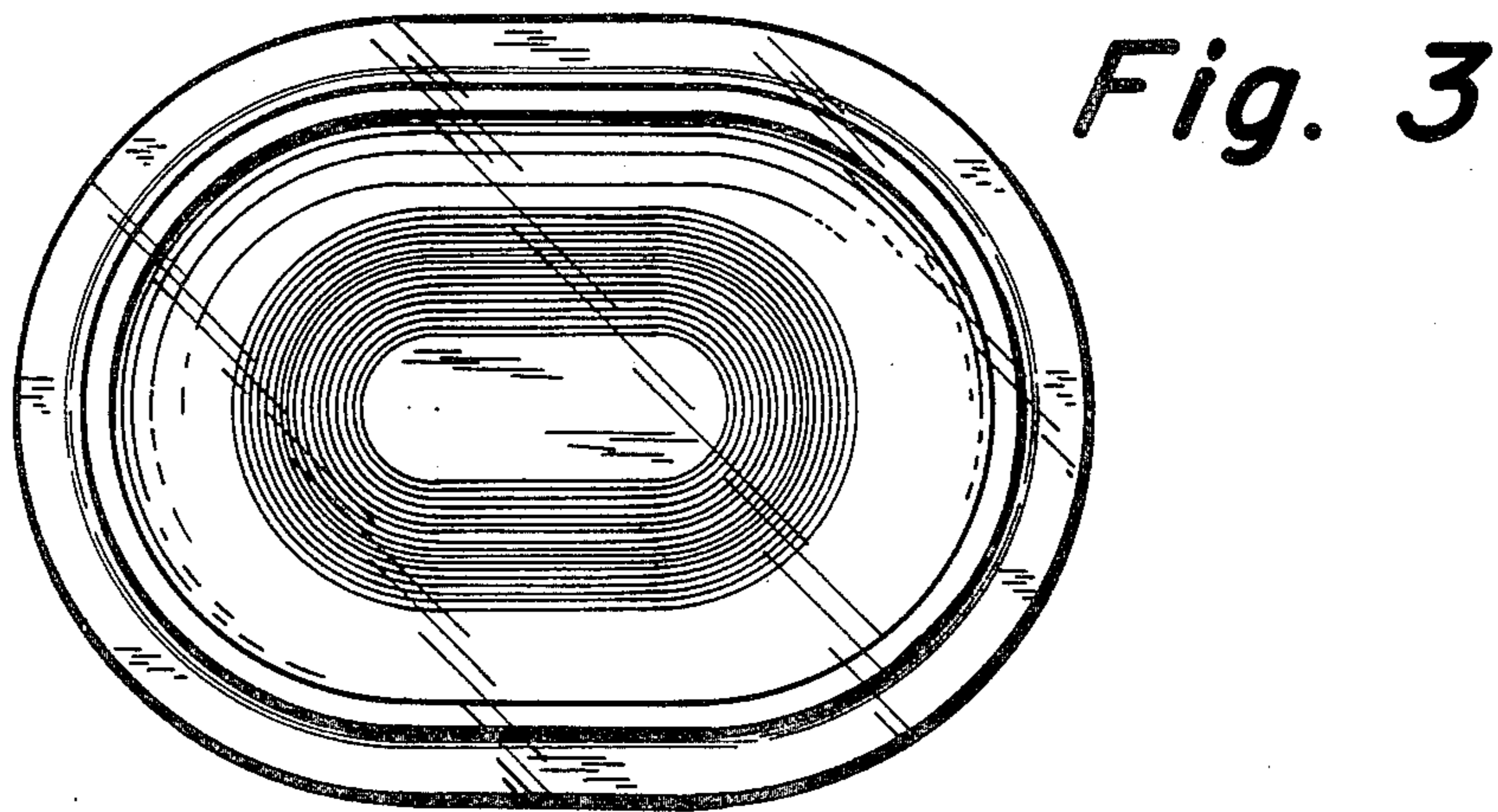
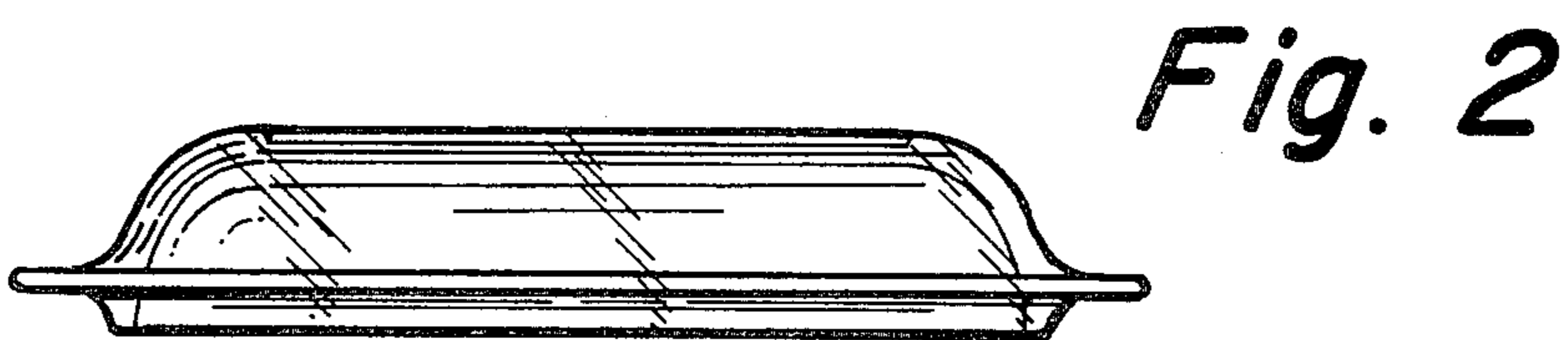
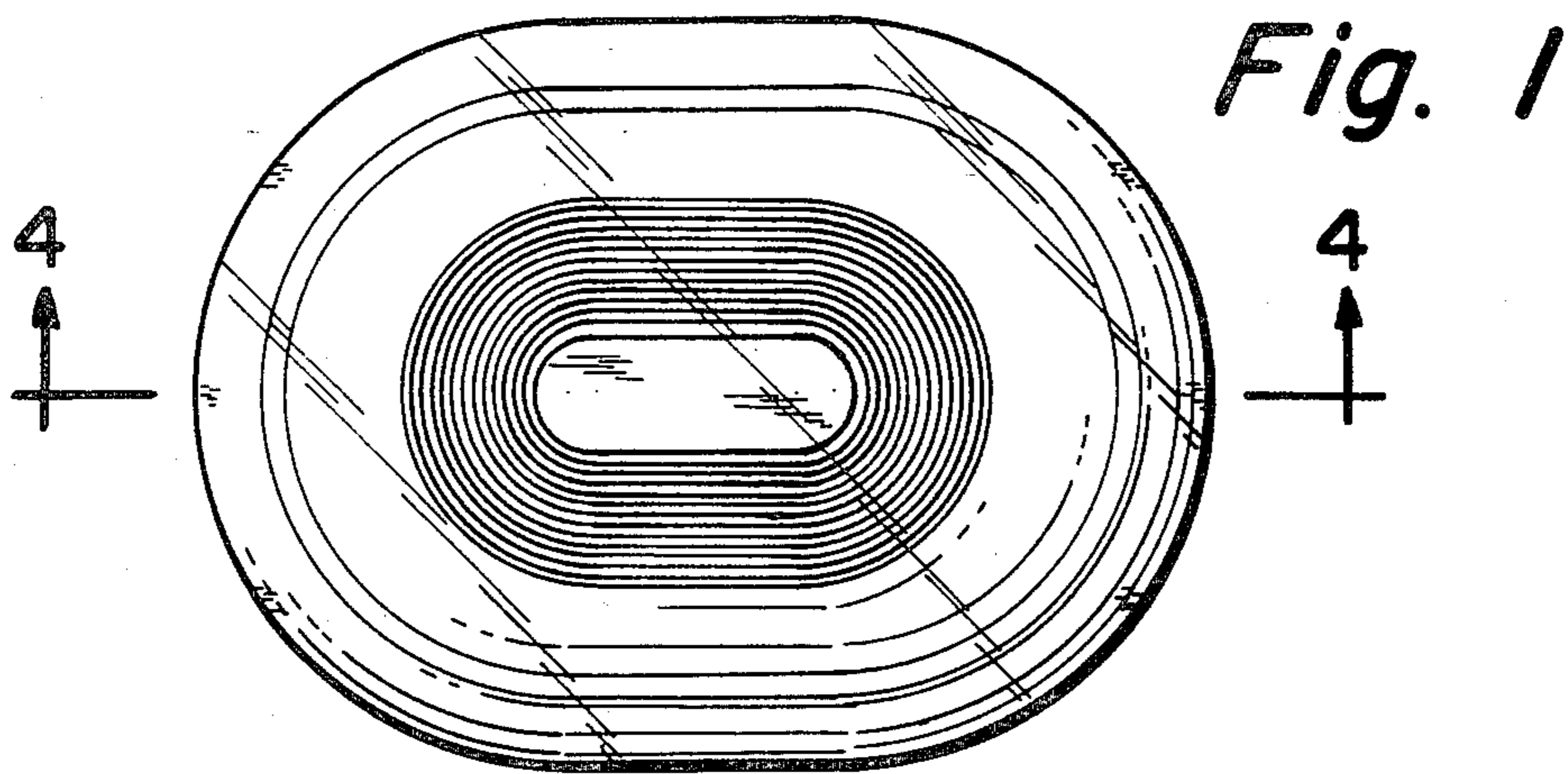
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view.
