FIG. 6 is a bottom plane view thereof.

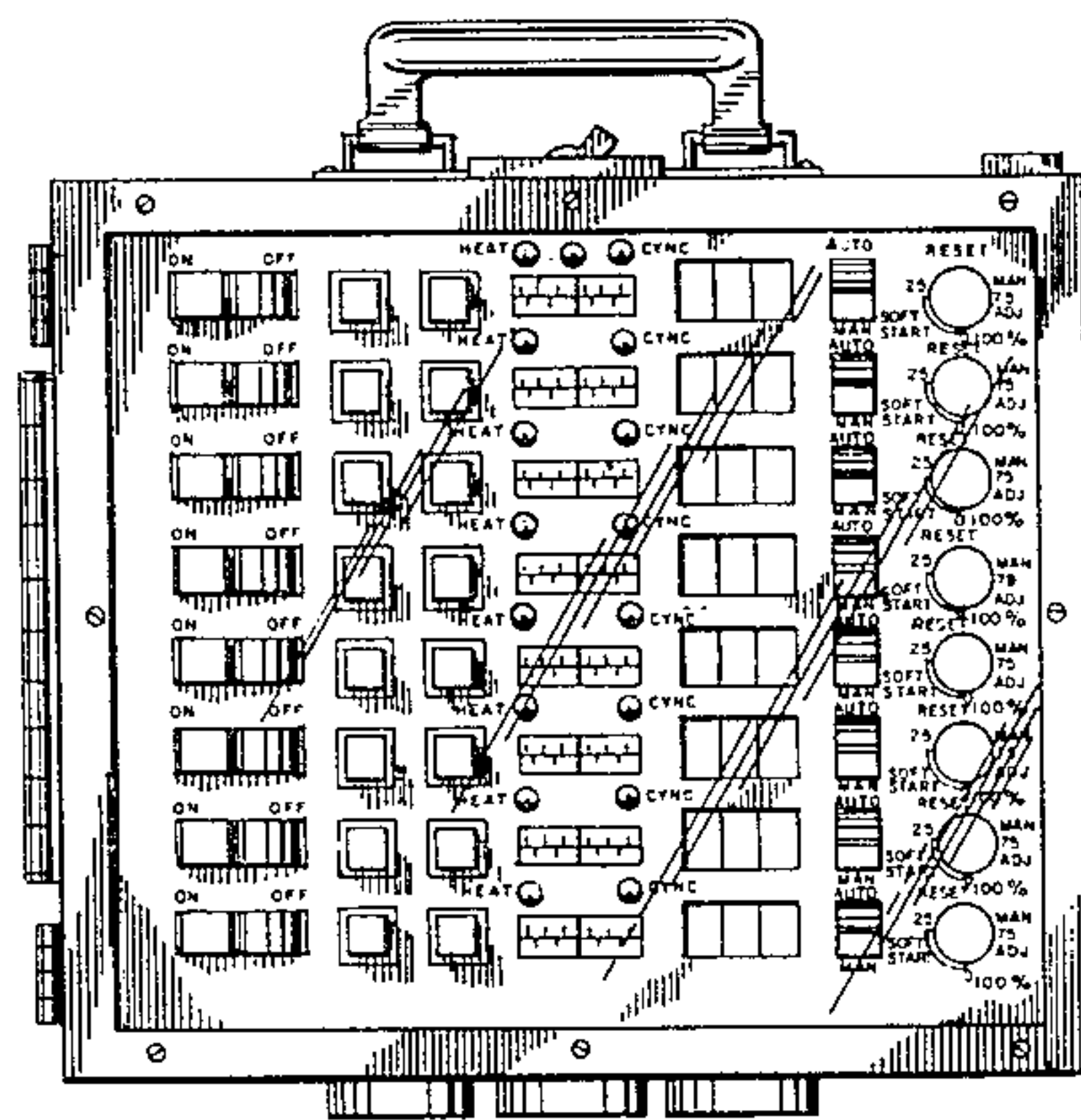

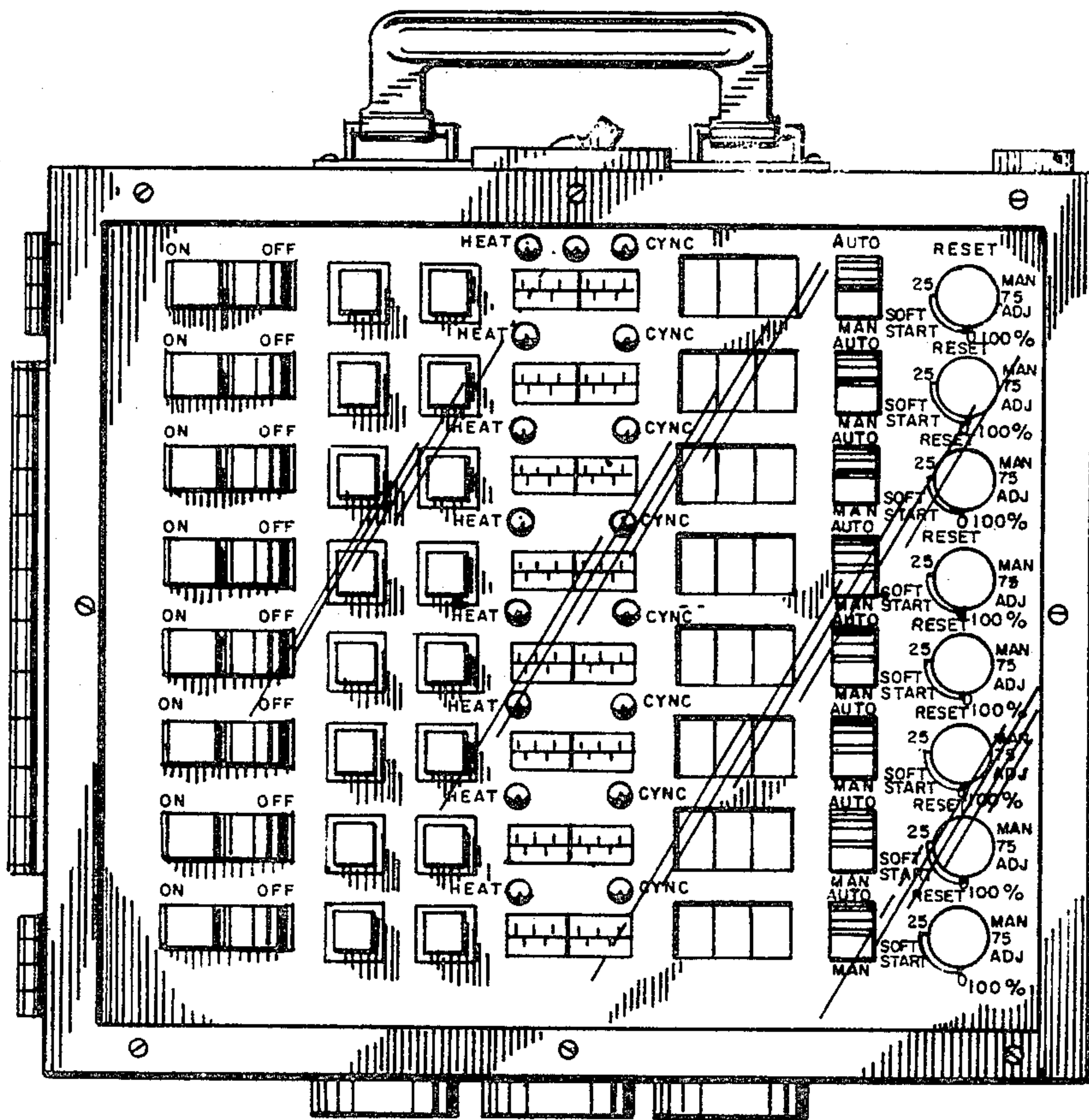

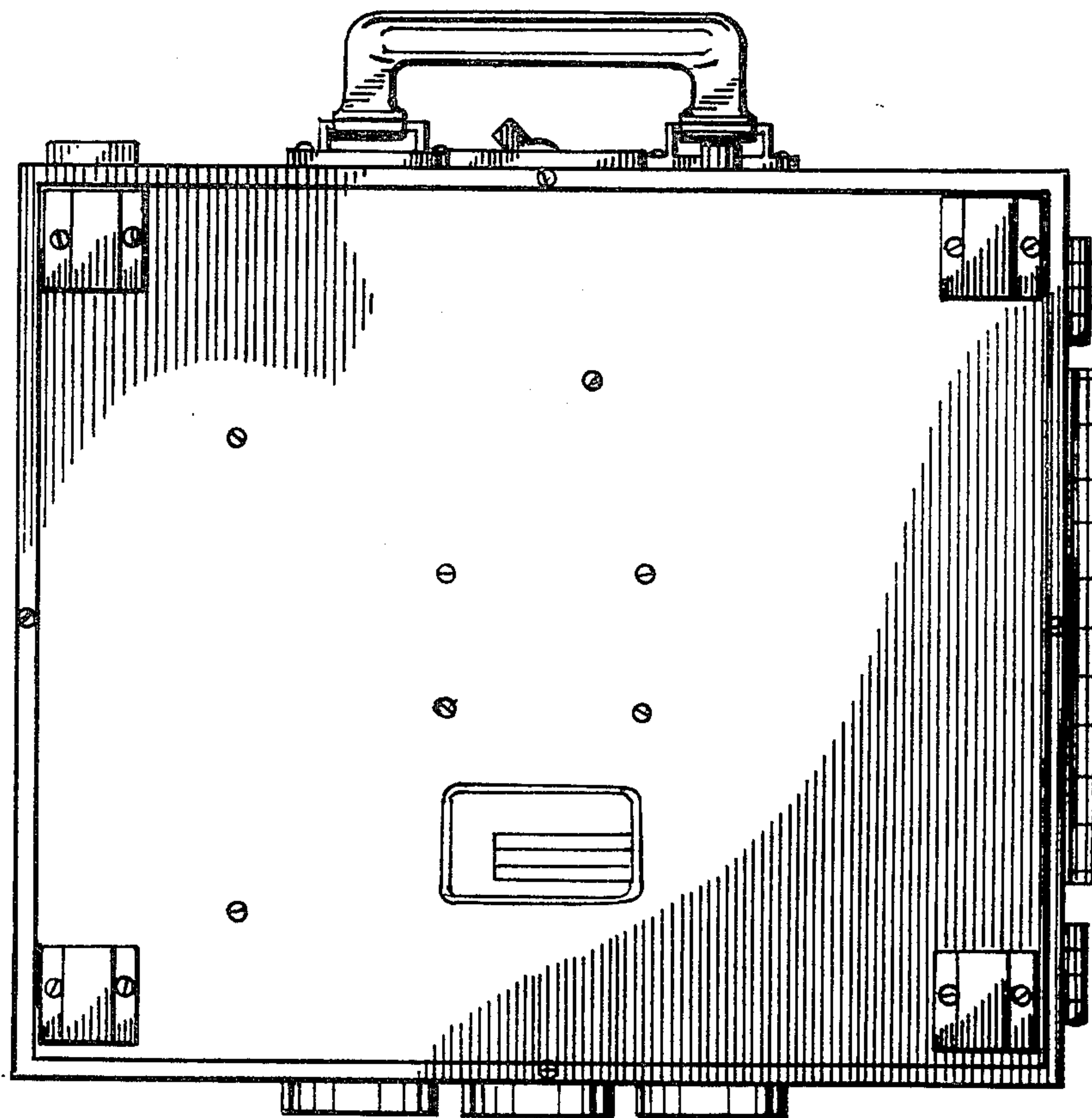

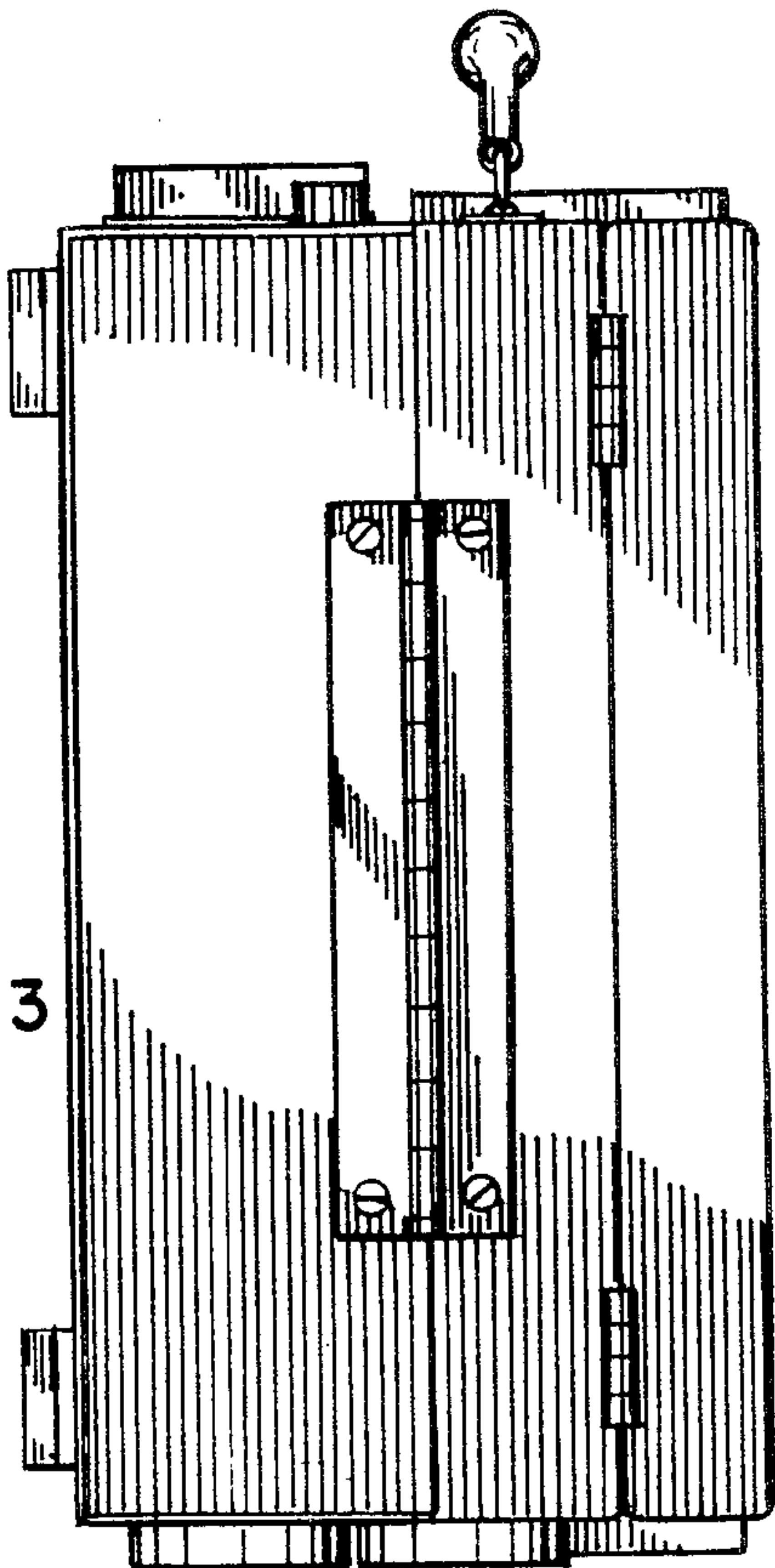

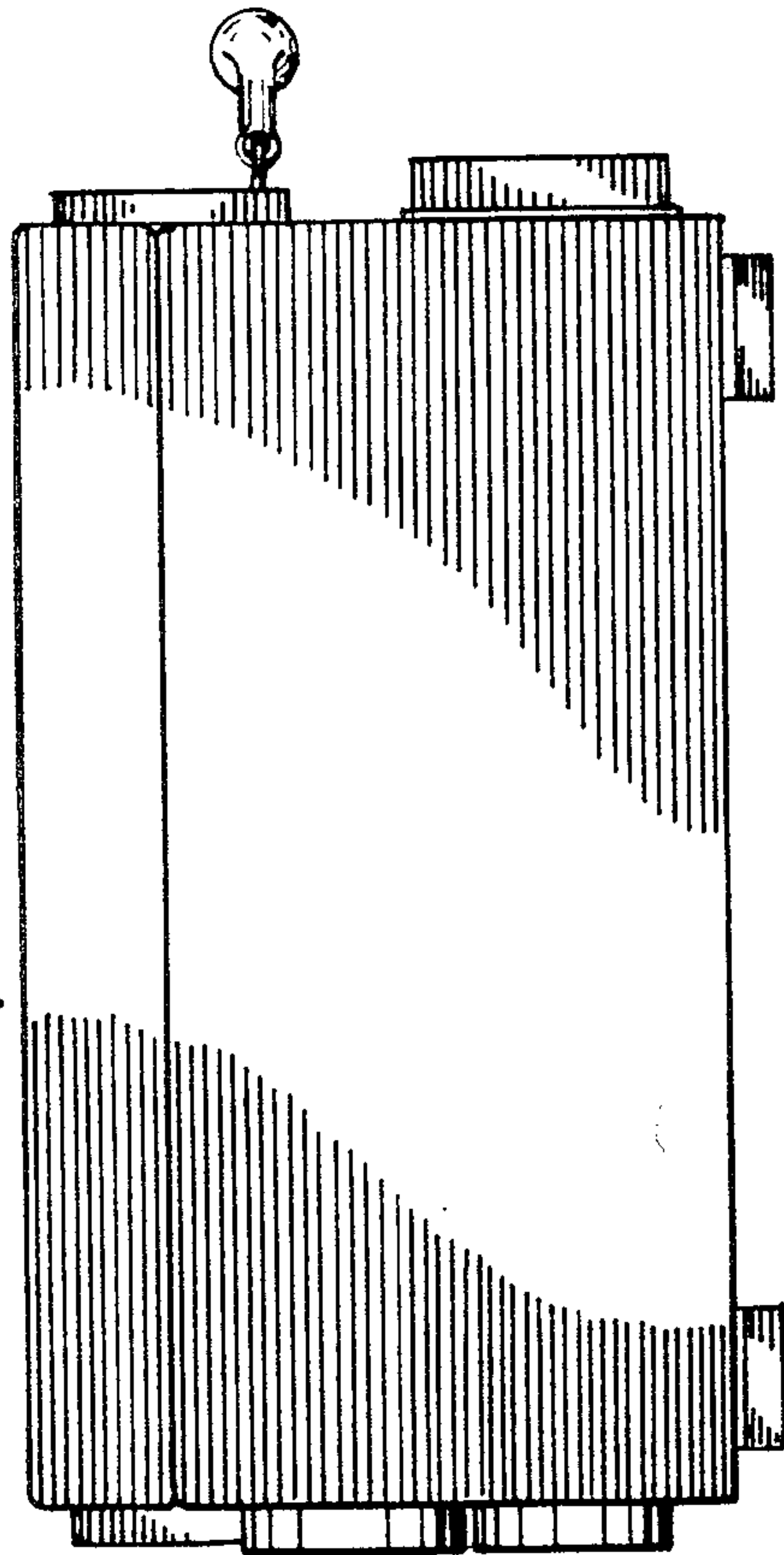

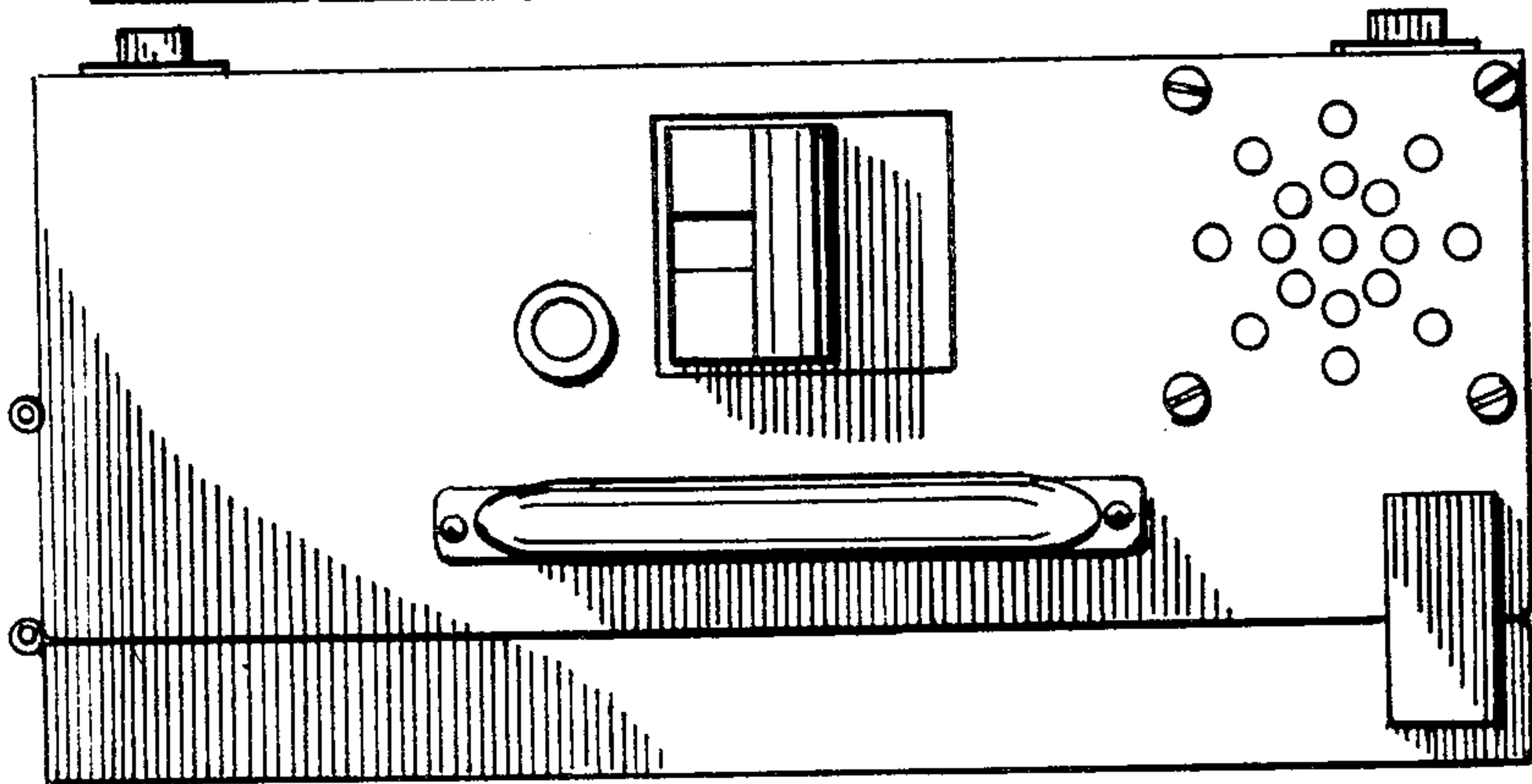
