FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof.

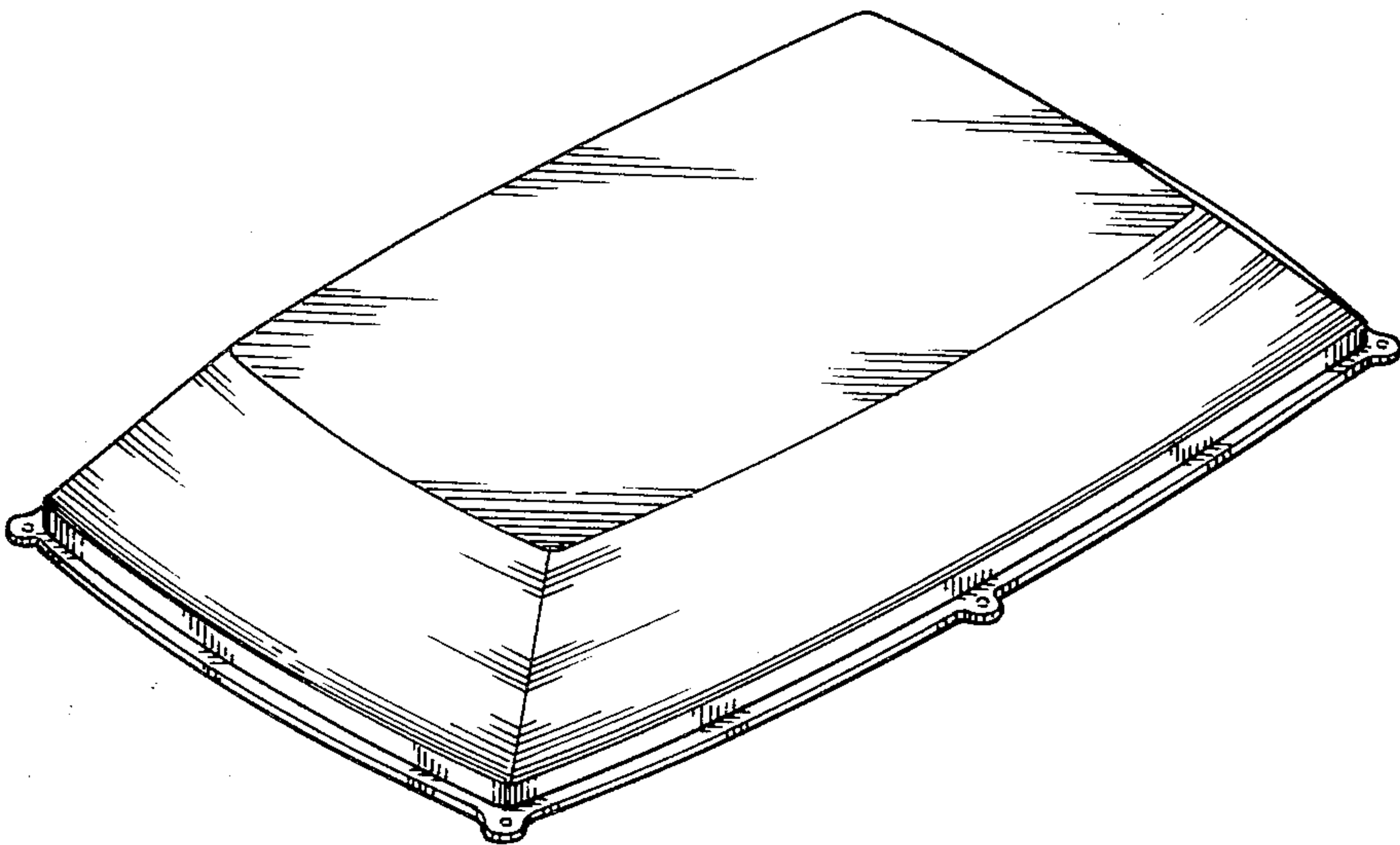

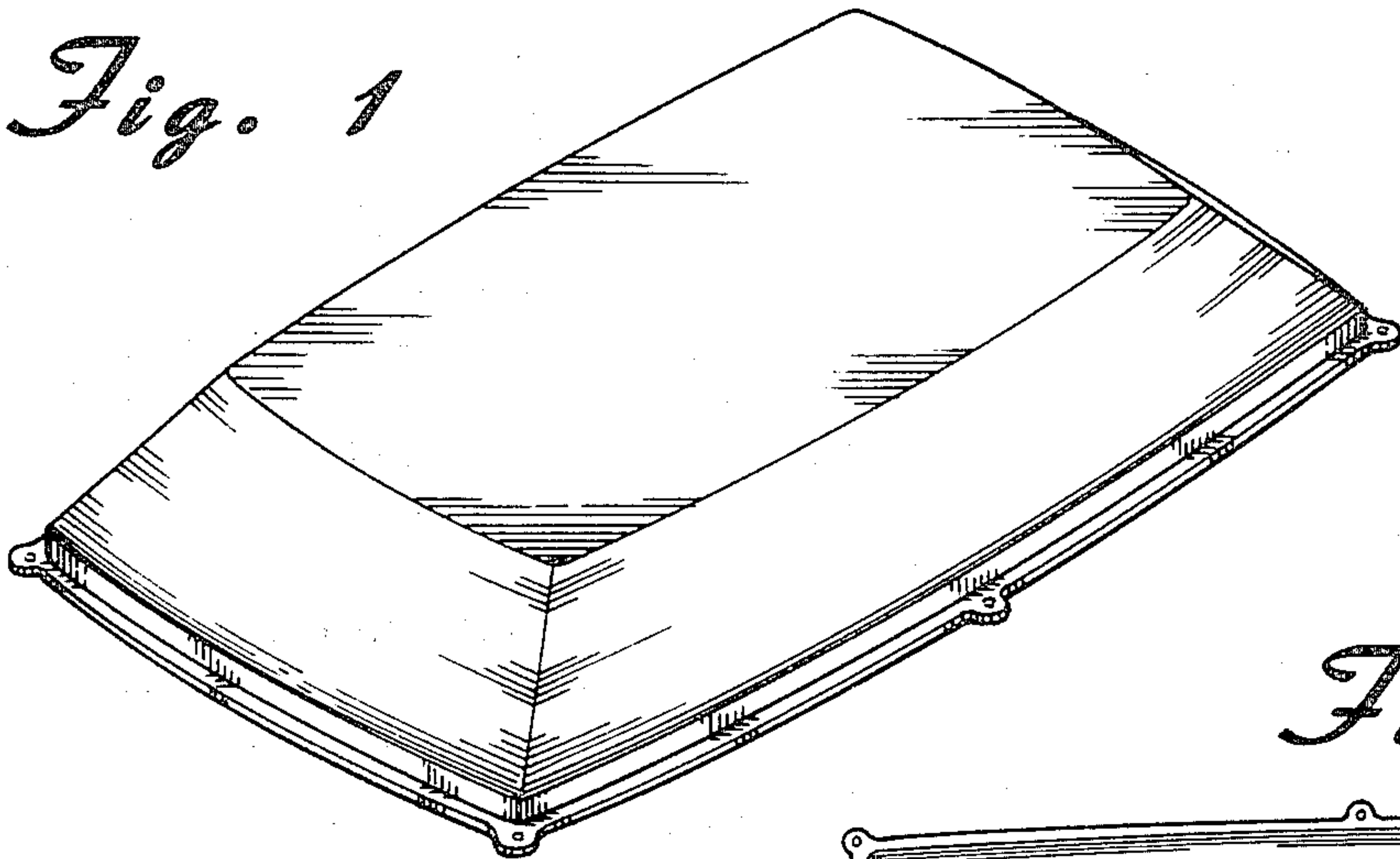

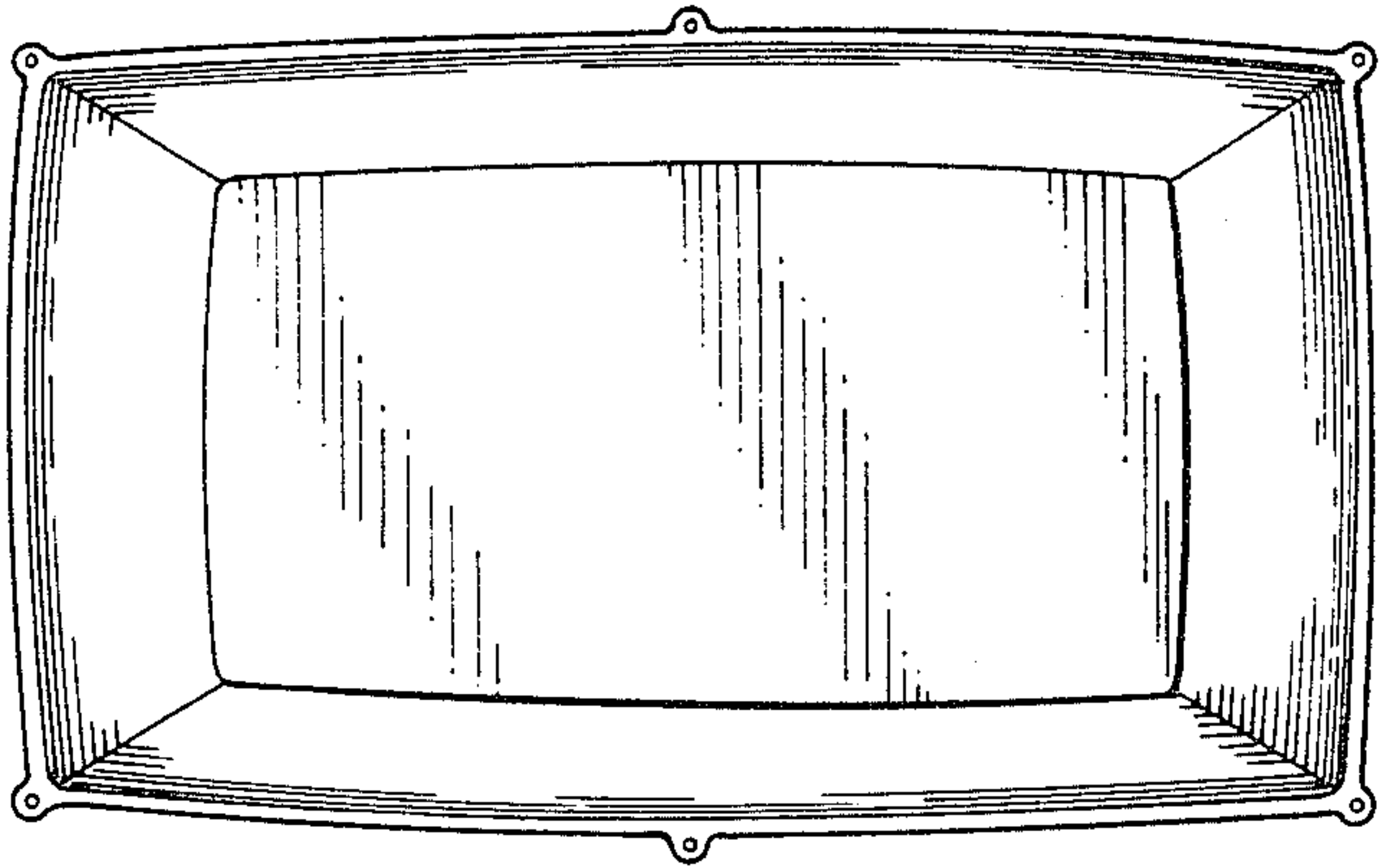

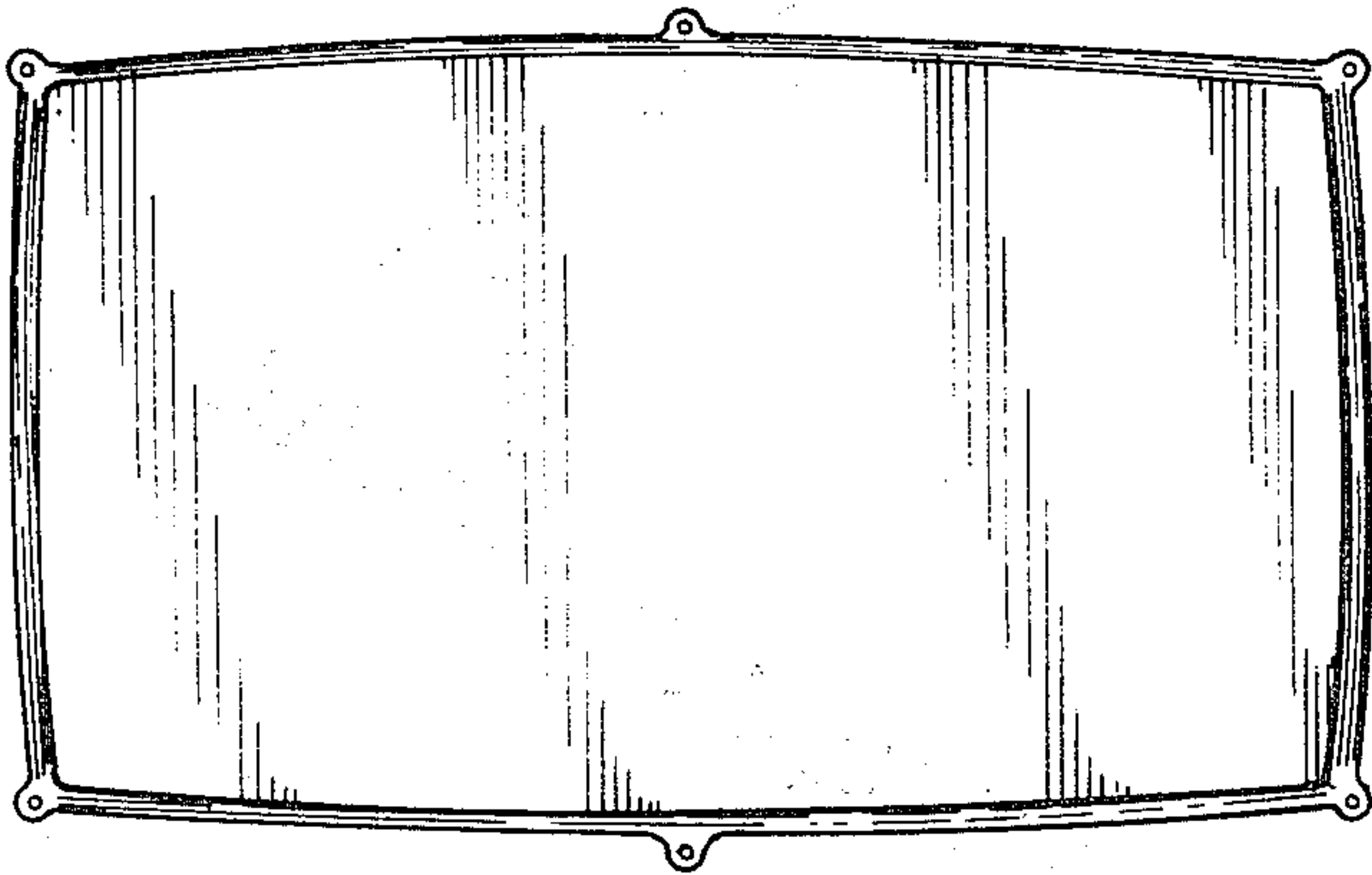

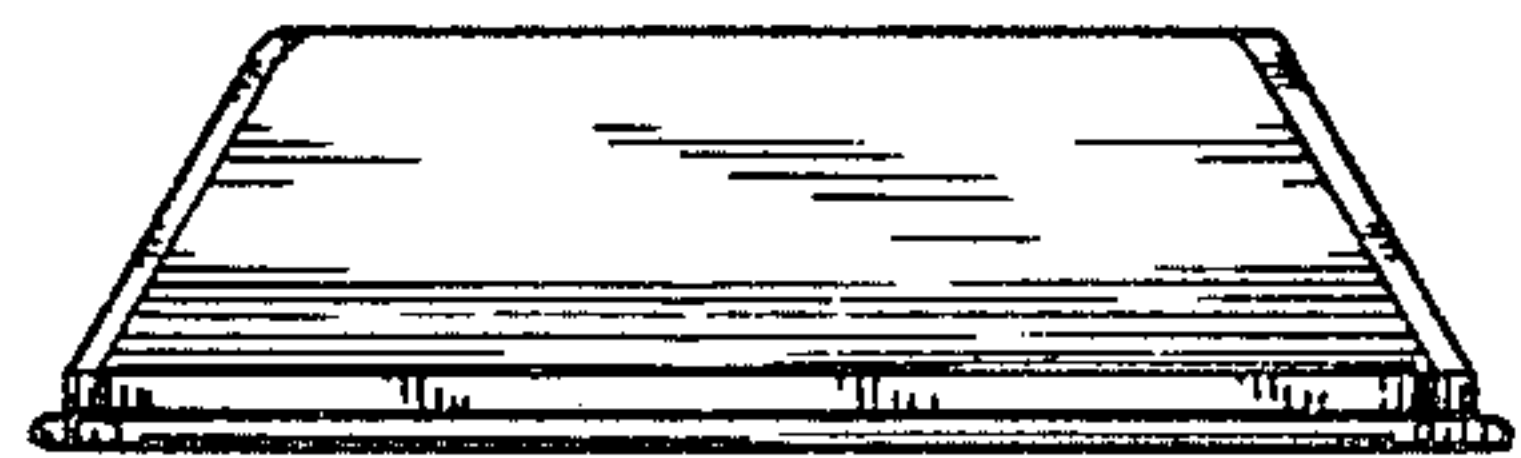
