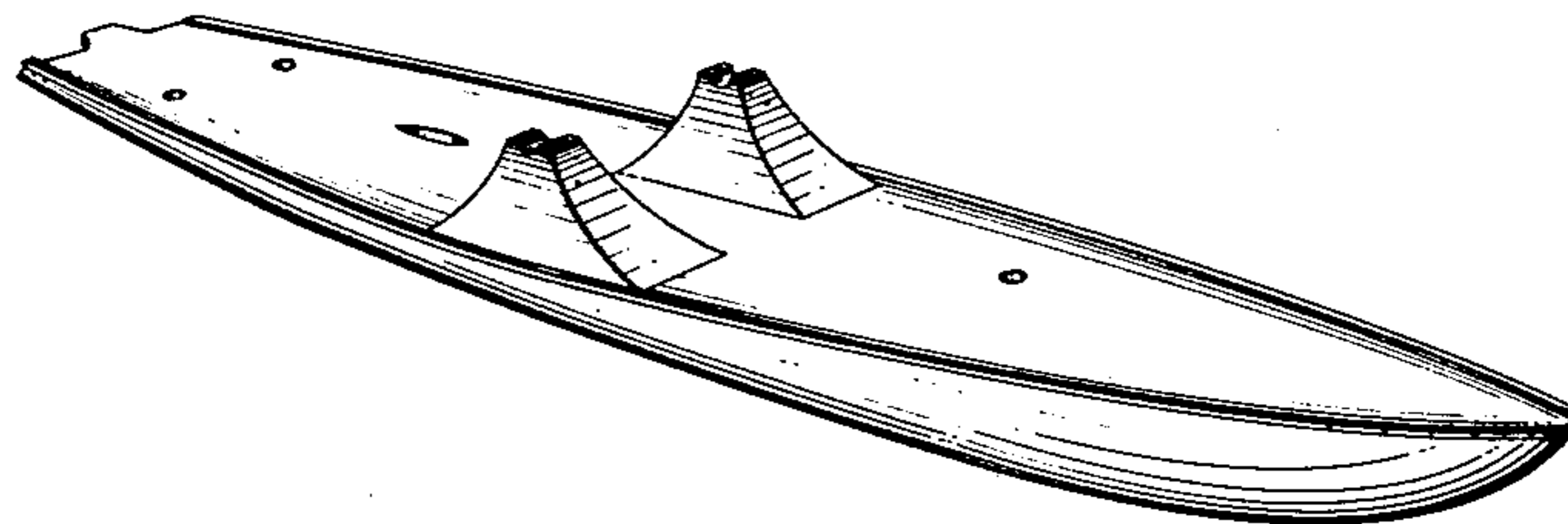

FIG. 6 is a top, front and side perspective view.



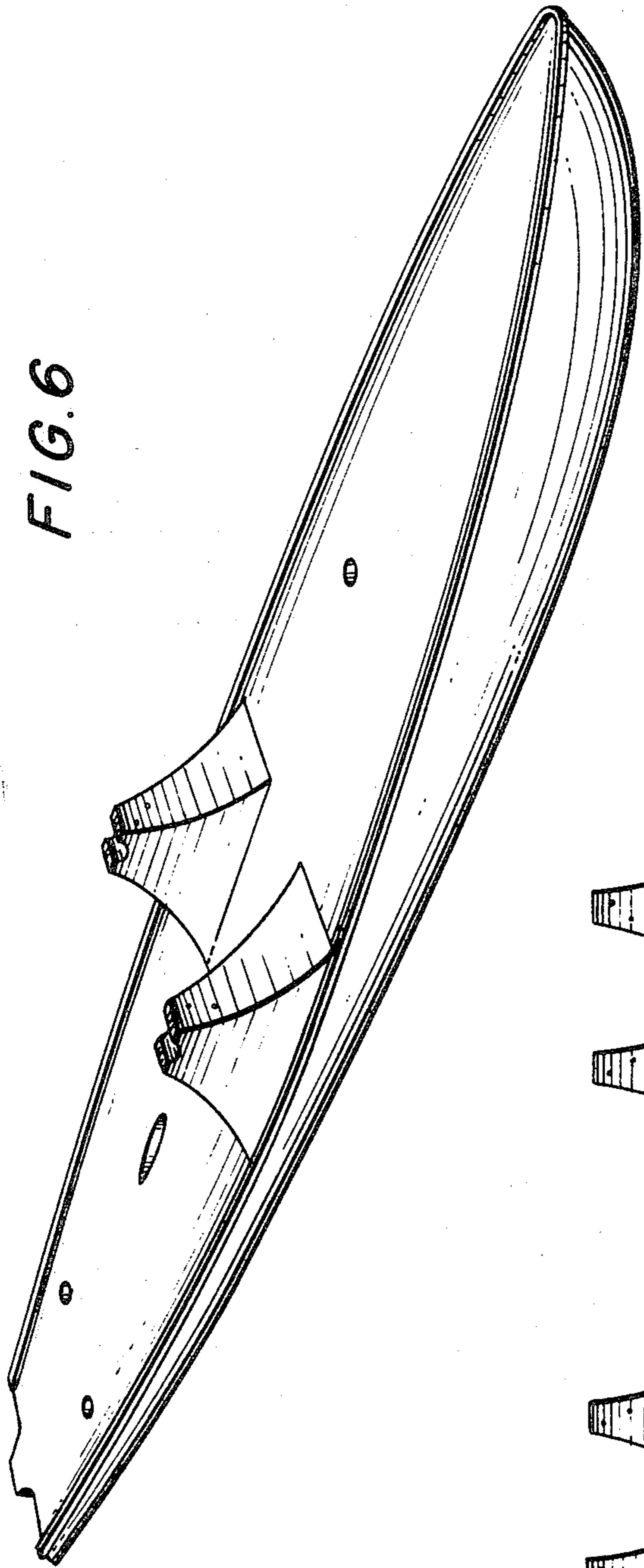

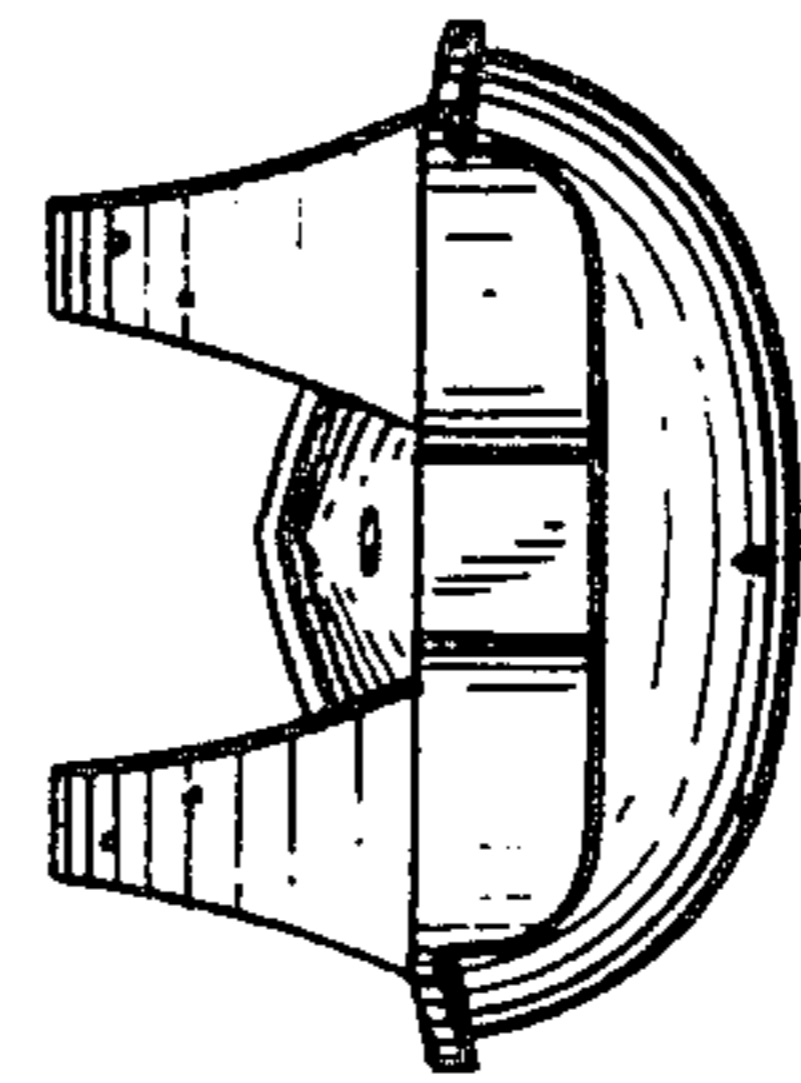

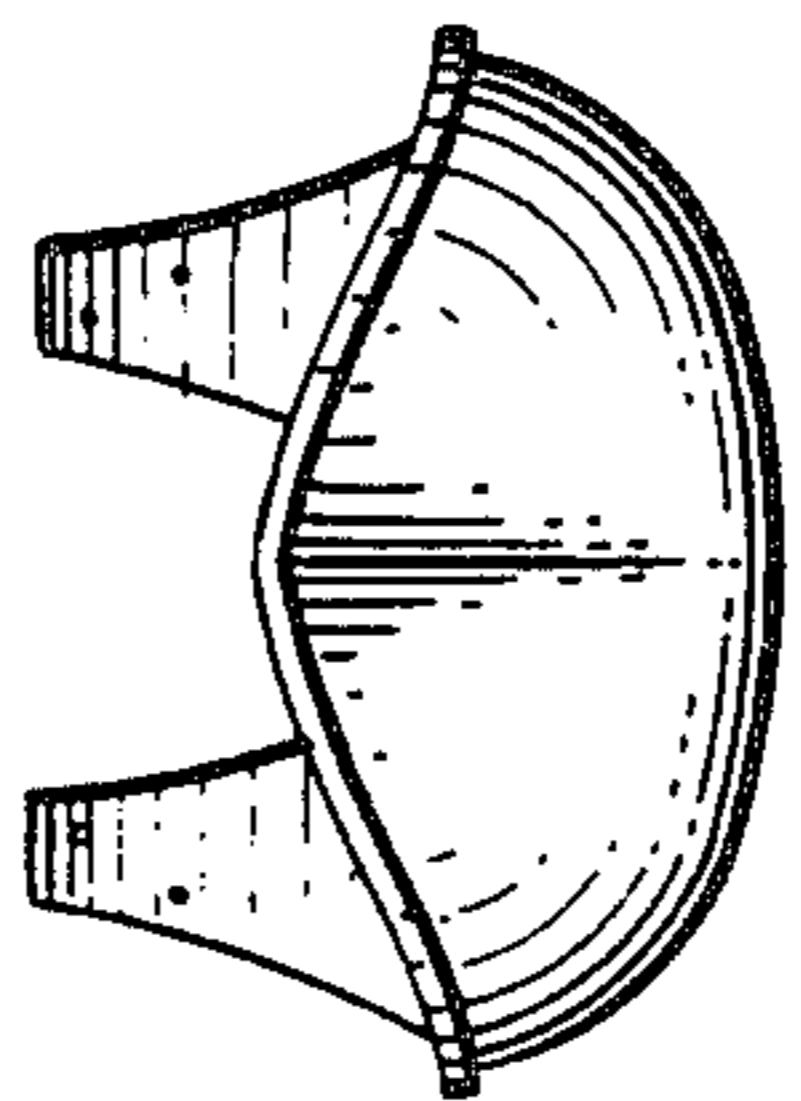

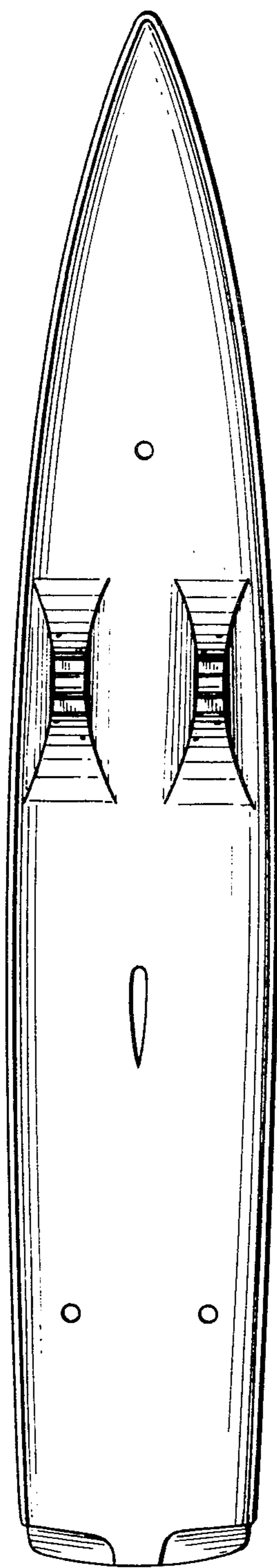

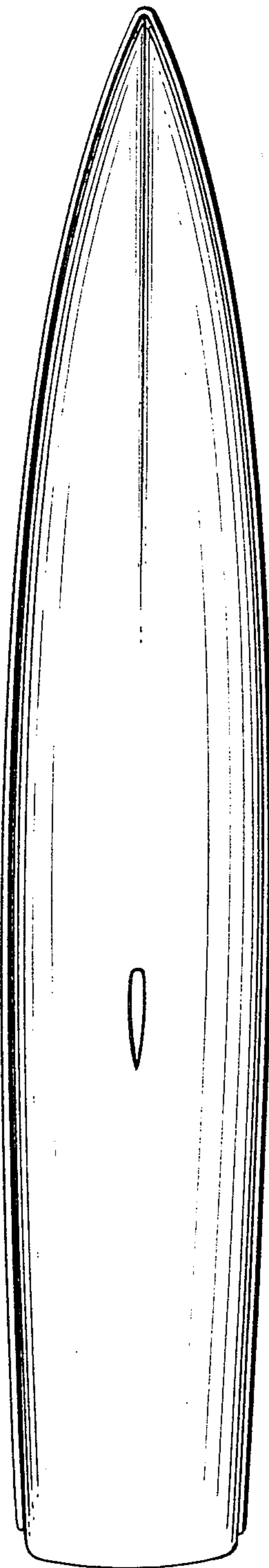

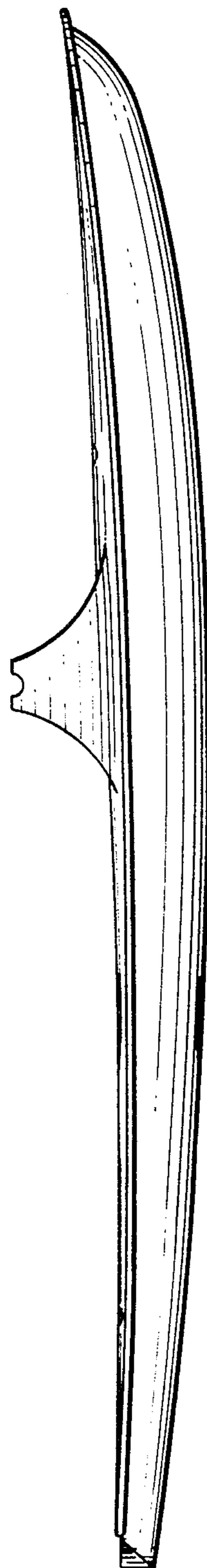
