DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a turning machine em-
bodying our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side view taken from the right of FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a side view taken from the left of FIG. 2;
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.
The bottom view, which is not shown, is unornamented
and not visible in normal use.

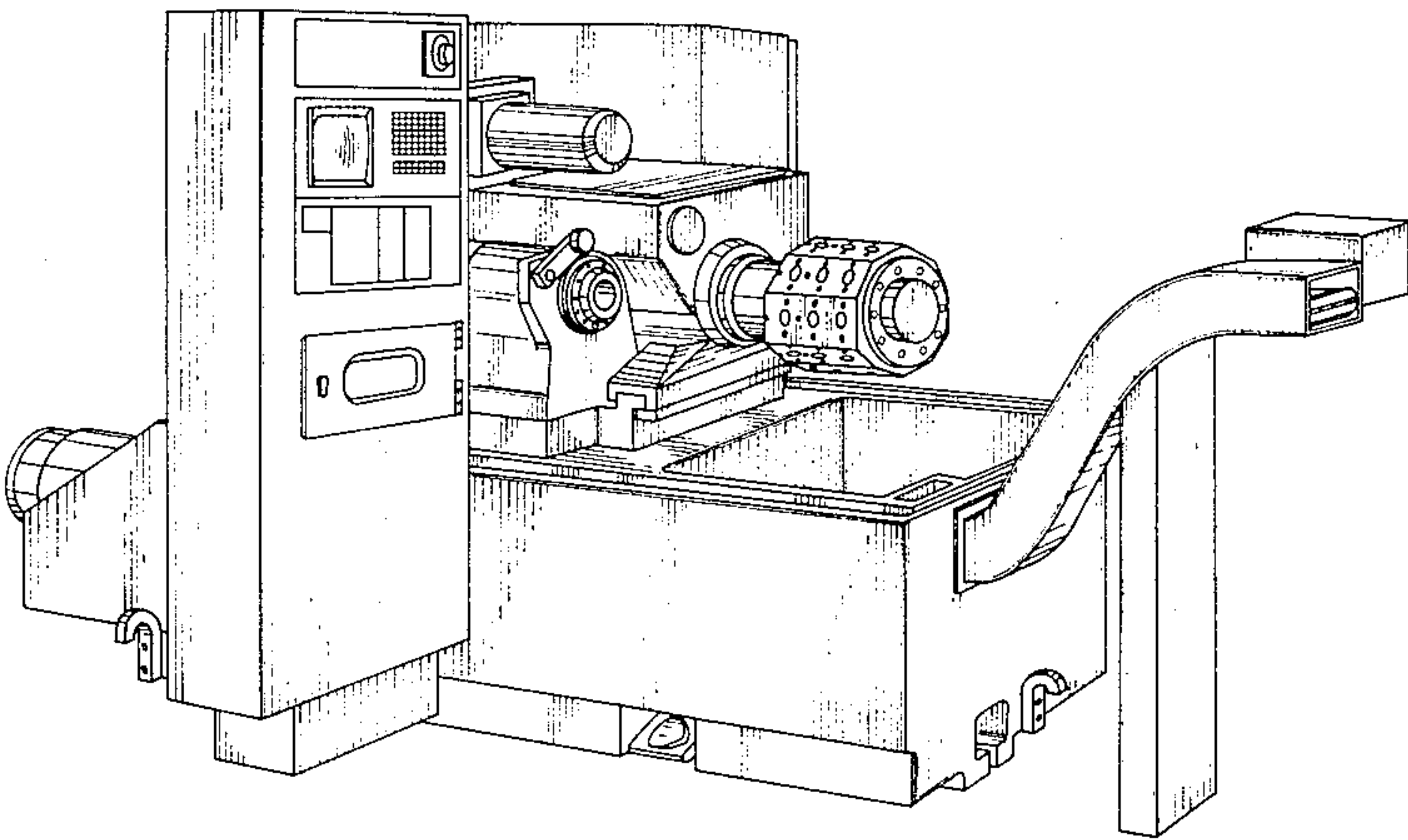

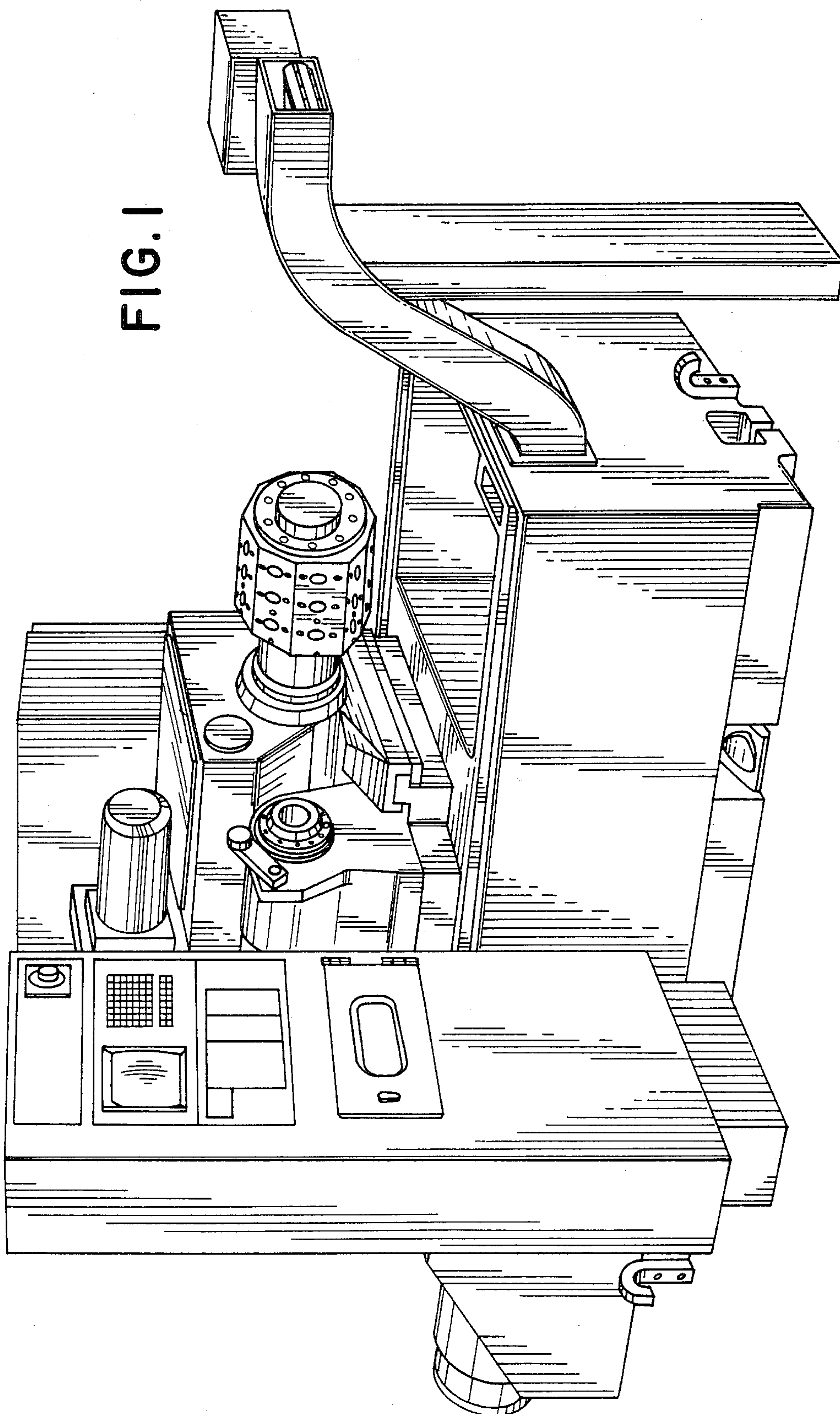
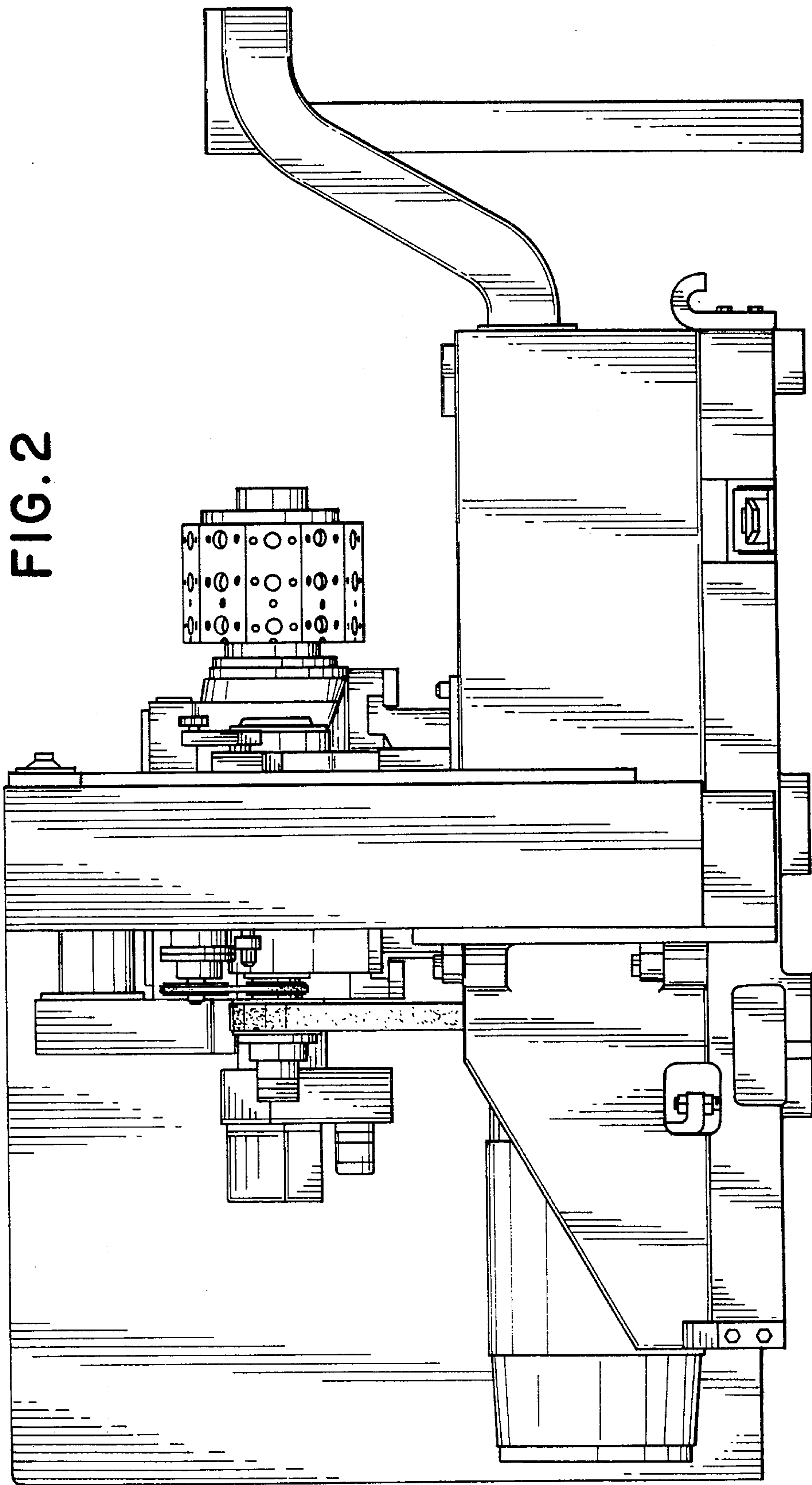
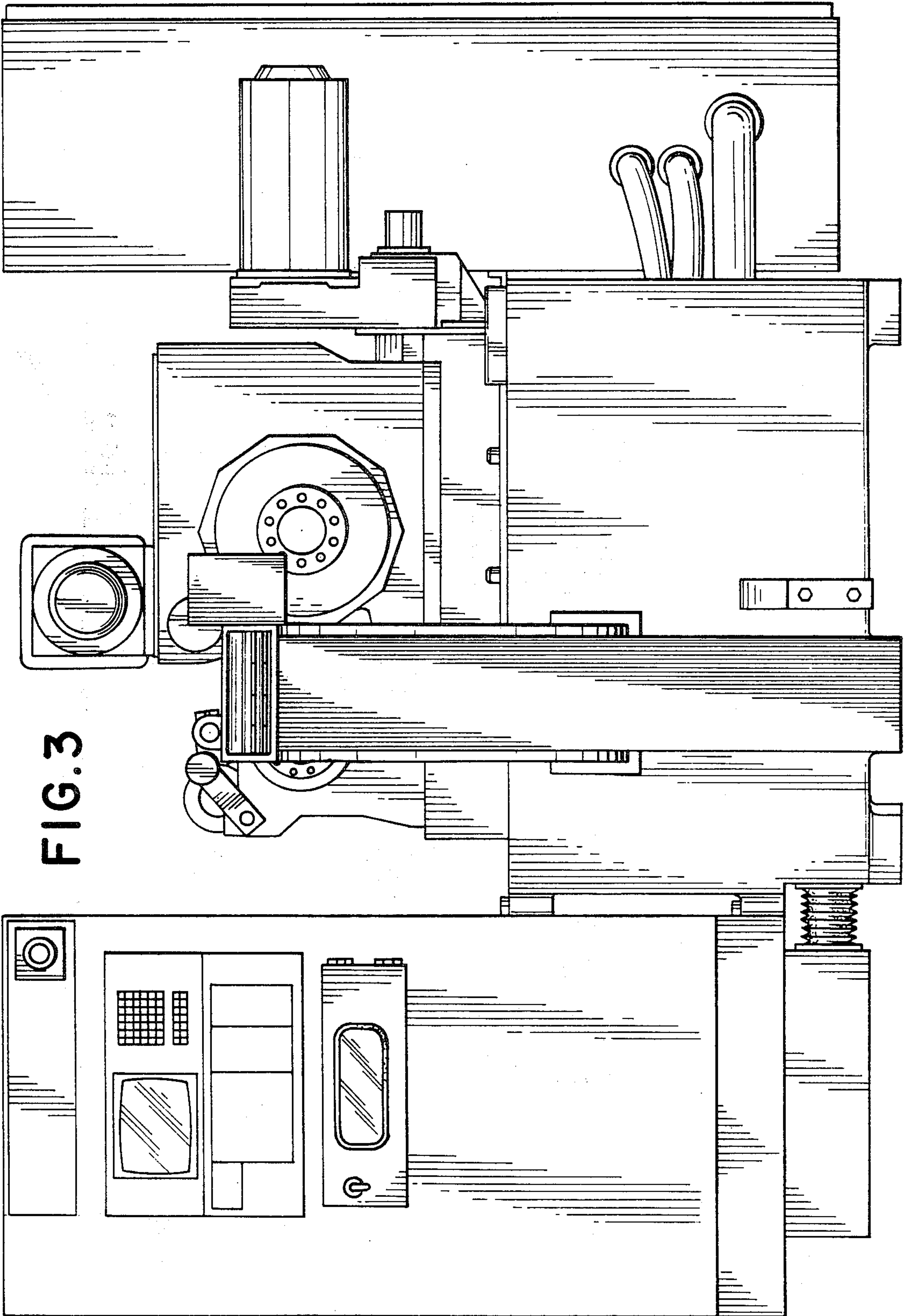
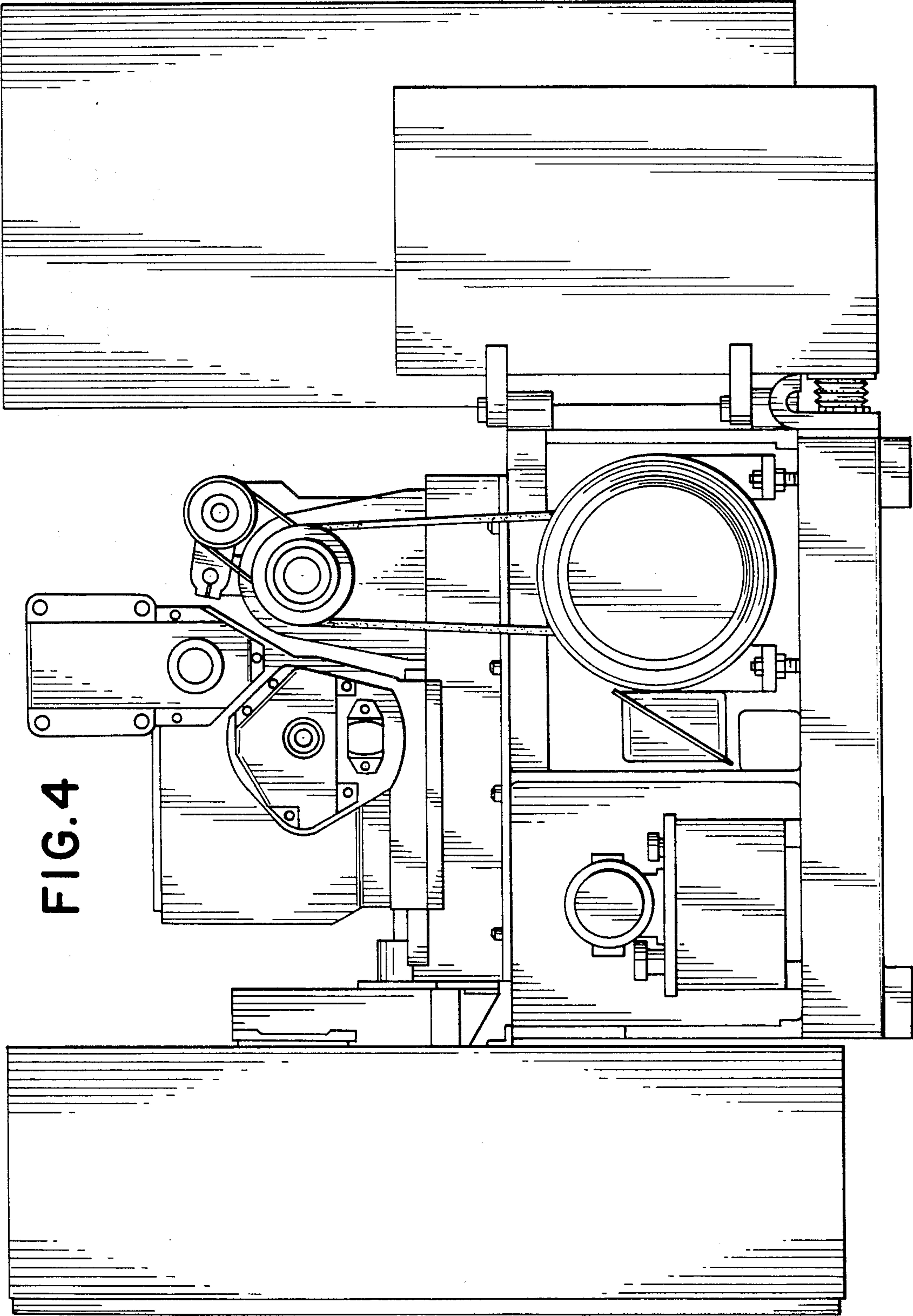

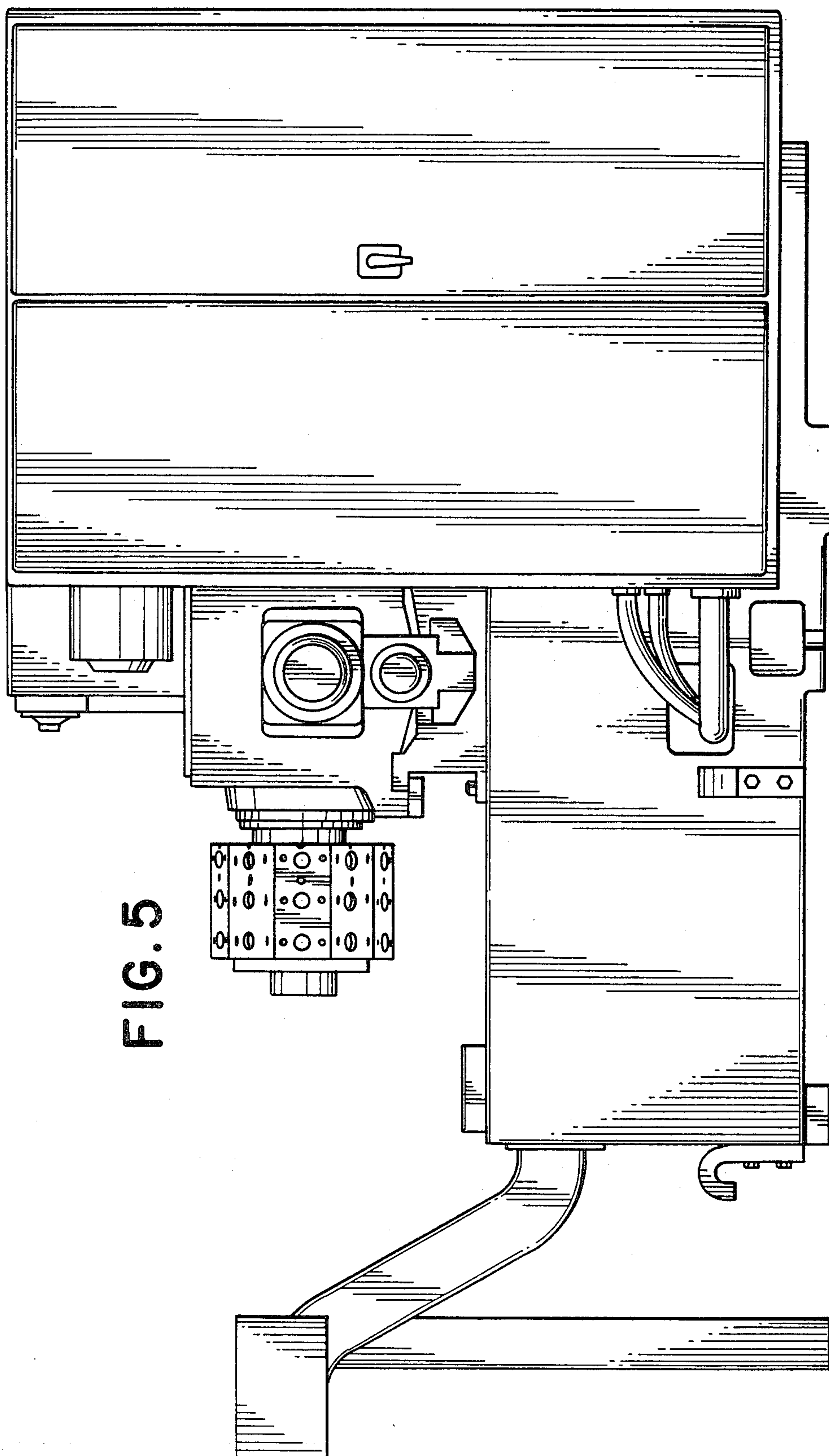

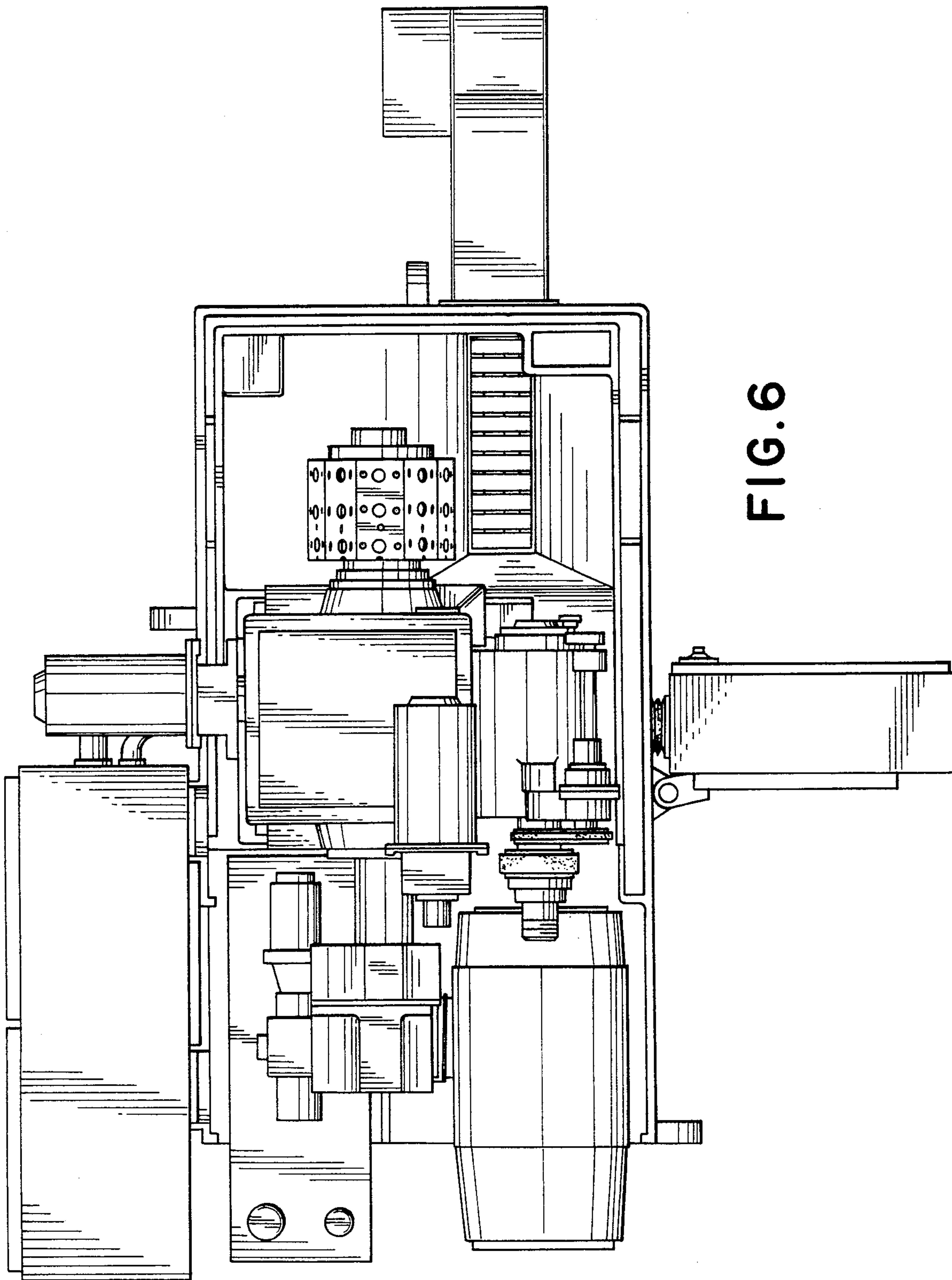
