The ornamental design for a combined stairs and enclosure for a hydrotherapy spa, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined stairs and enclosure for a hydrotherapy spa showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a second perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 4—4 of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 5—5 of FIG. 3.

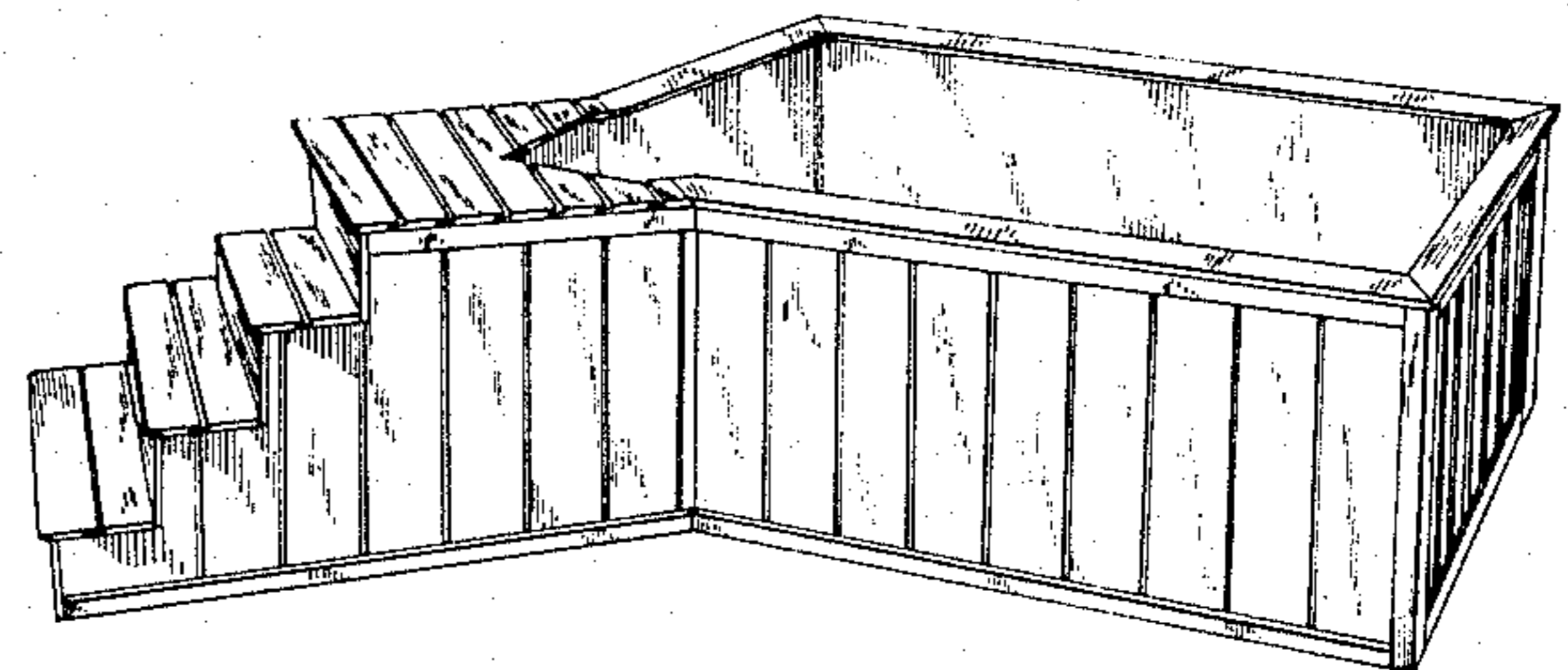
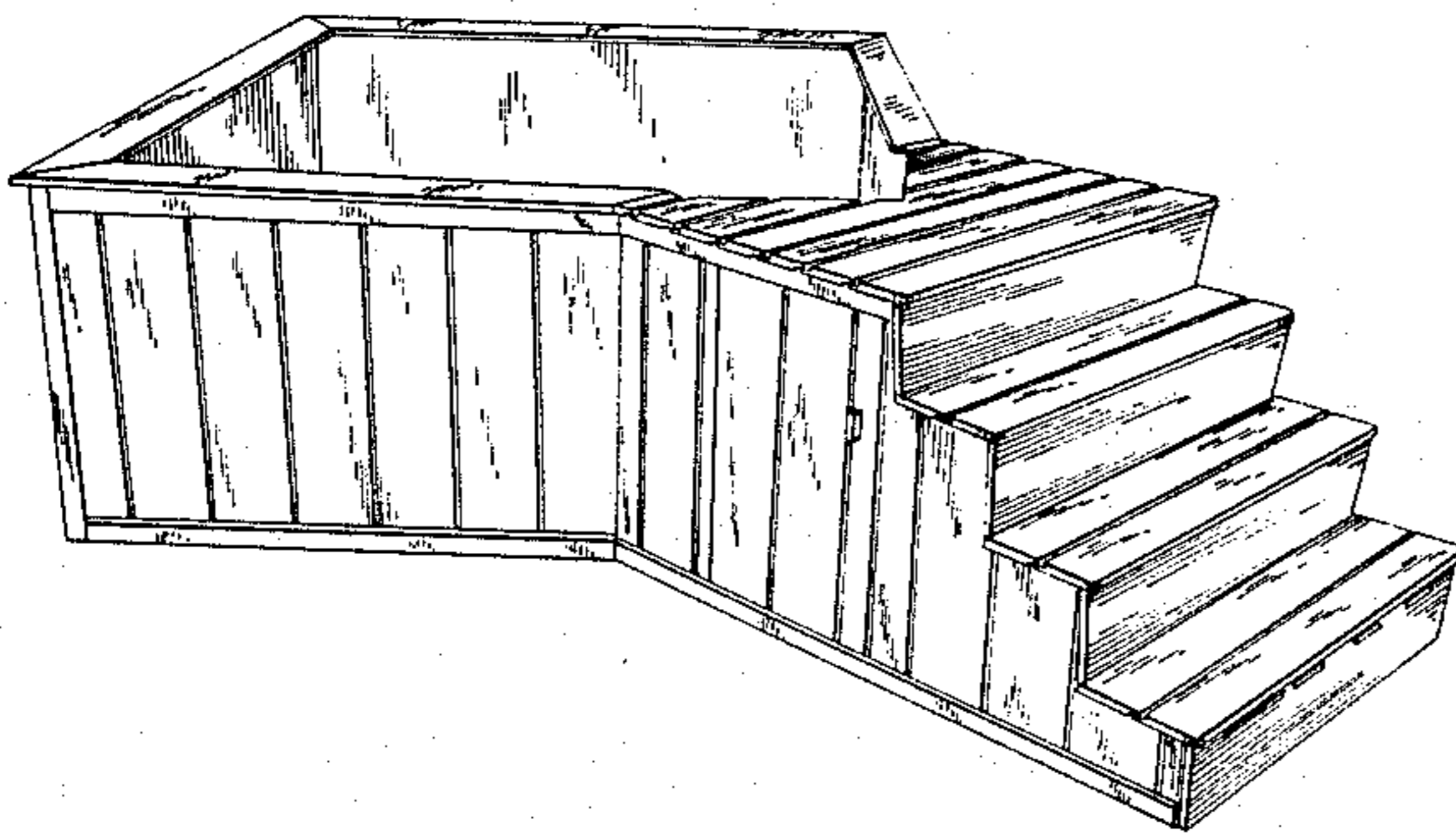

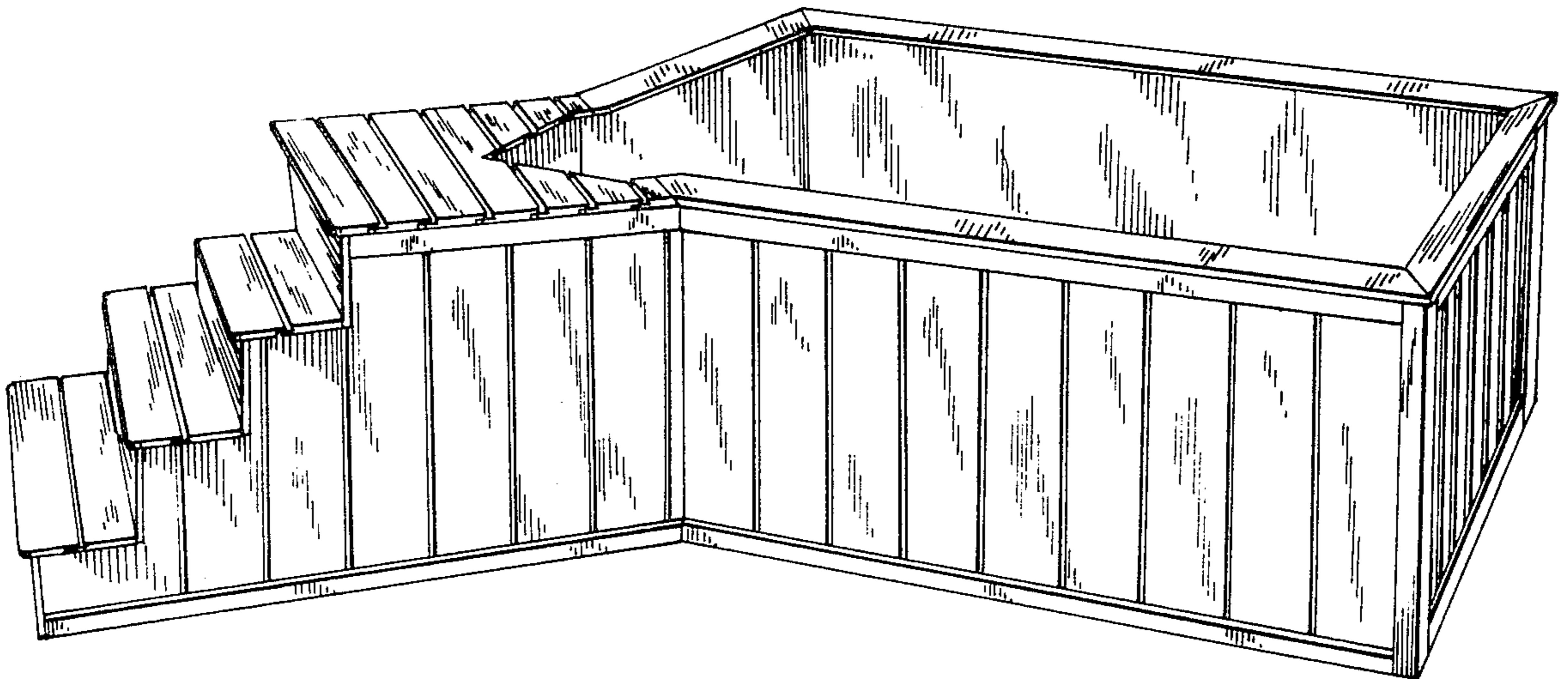
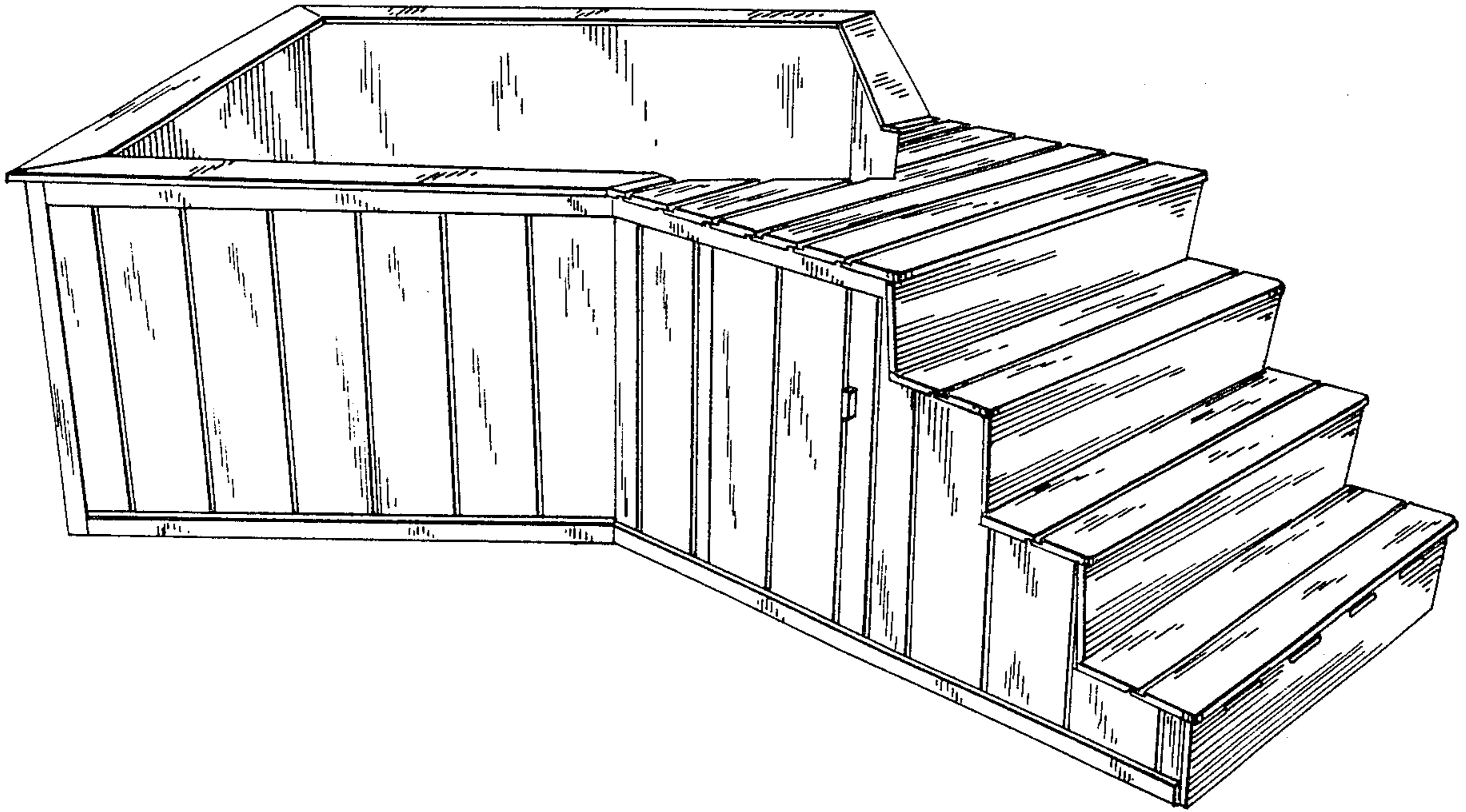

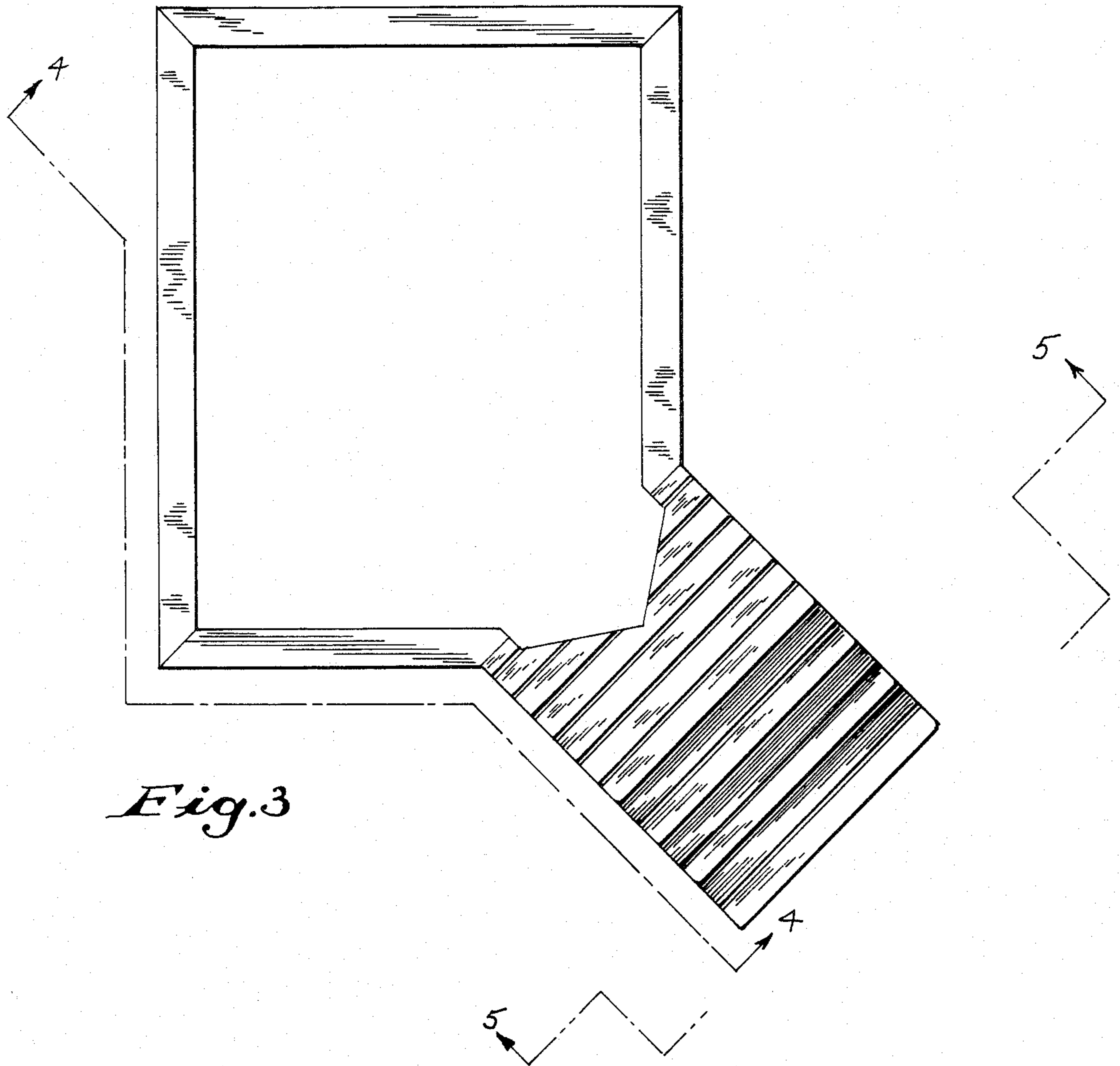

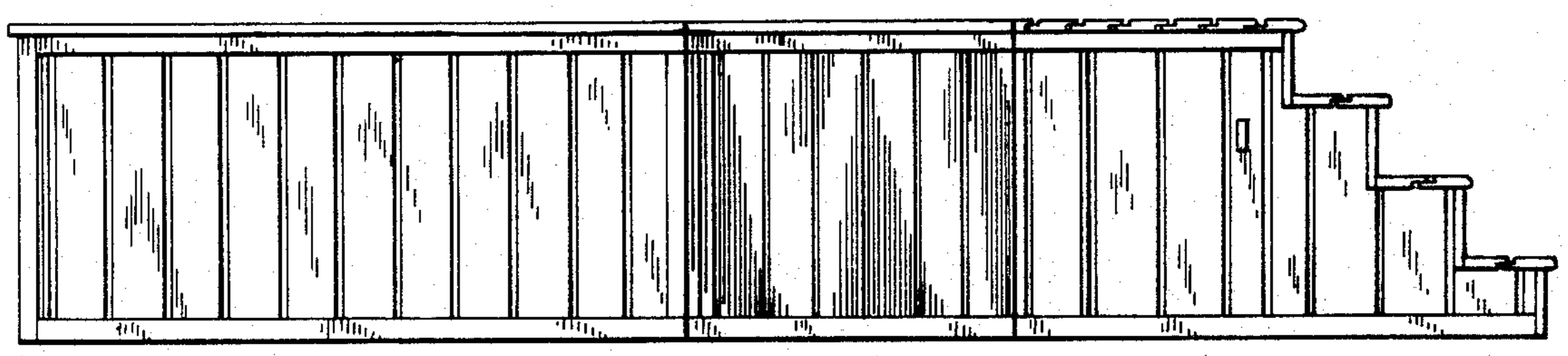

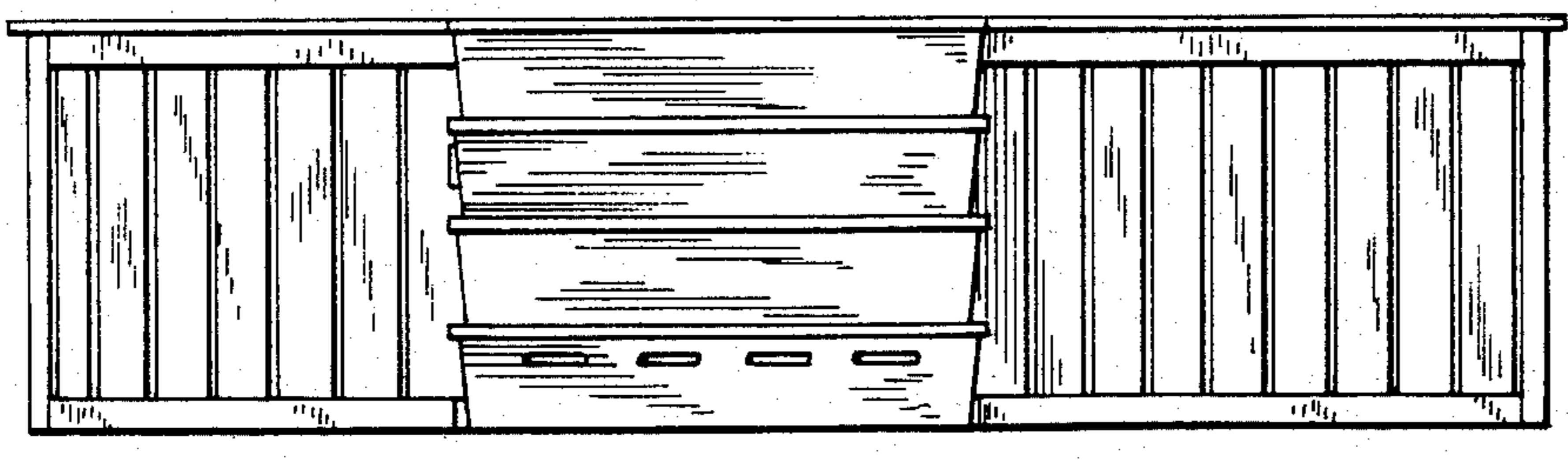
