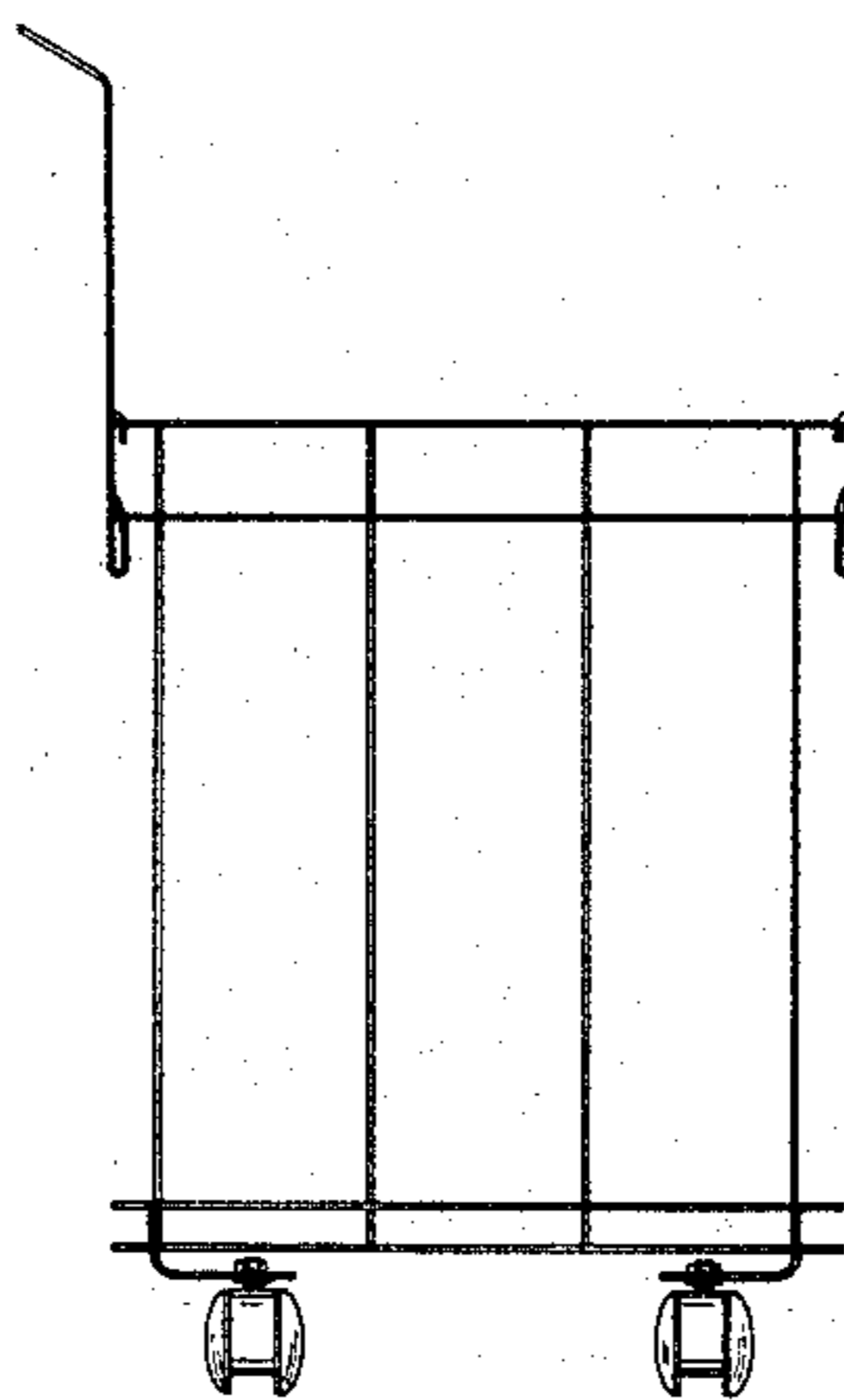

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cart for paper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a cart for paper showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof with side panels raised in a alternate position;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 3; and
FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary elevational view thereof showing the self locking mechanism in collapsed condition as in FIG. 1.



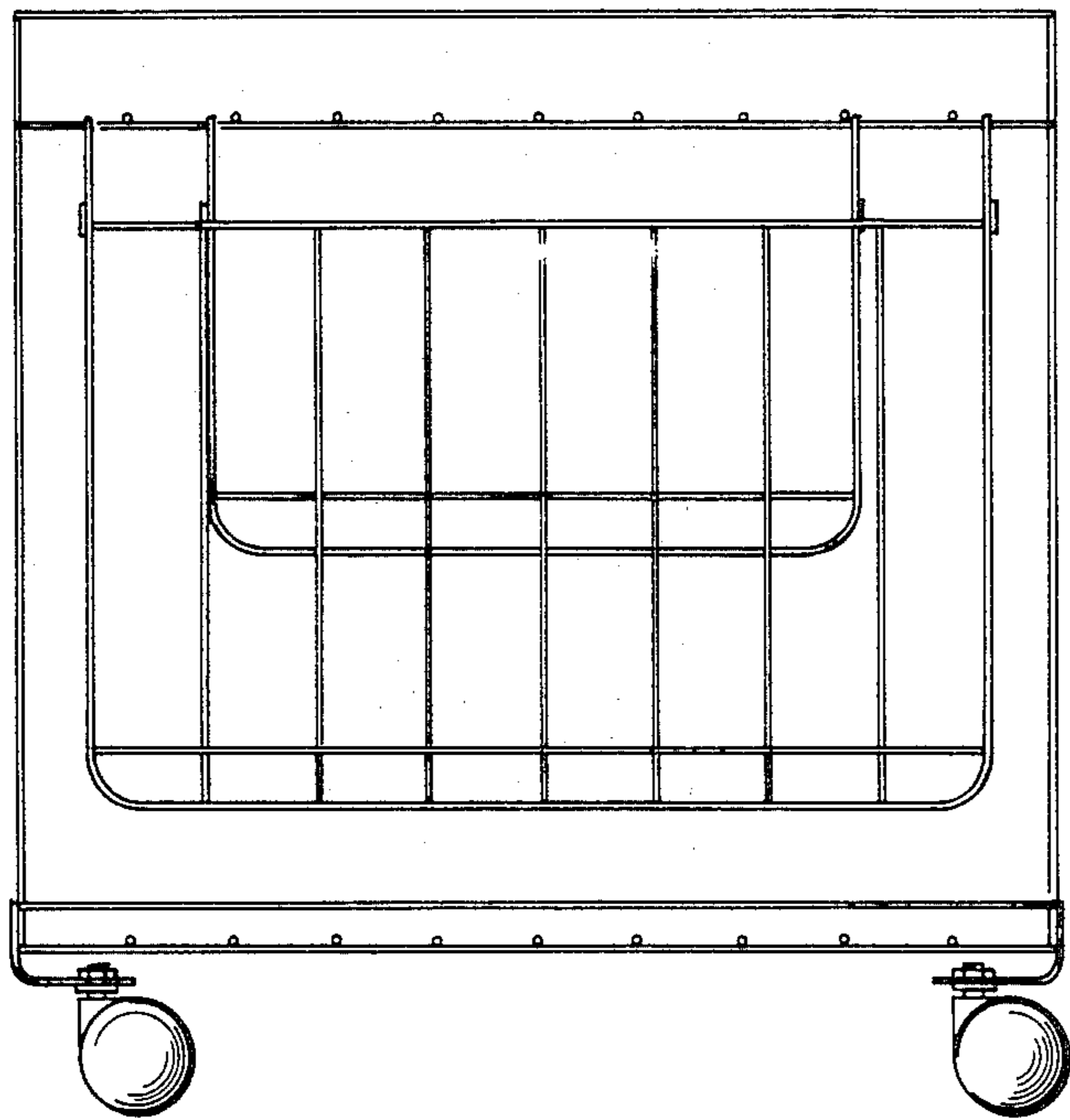

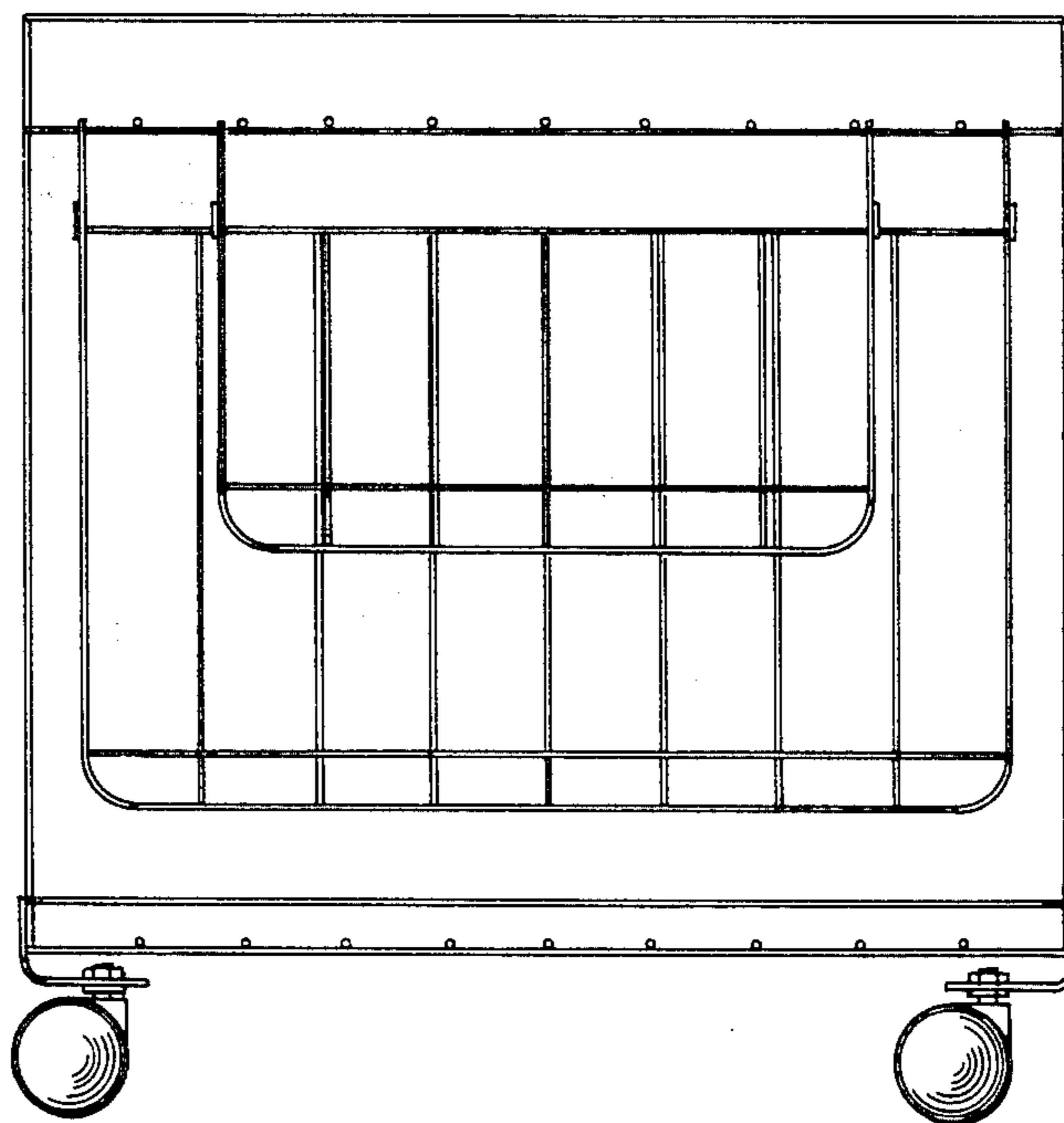

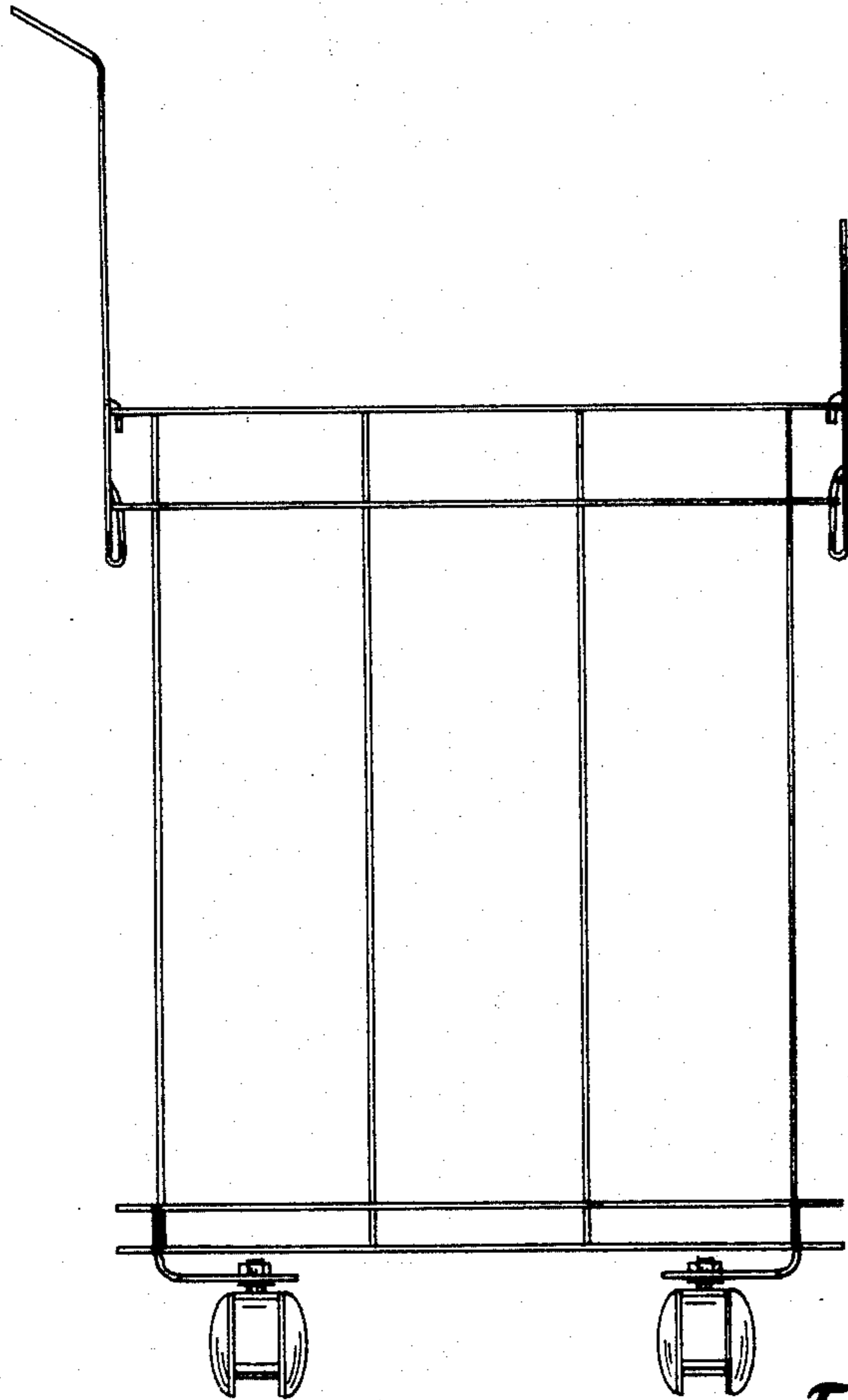

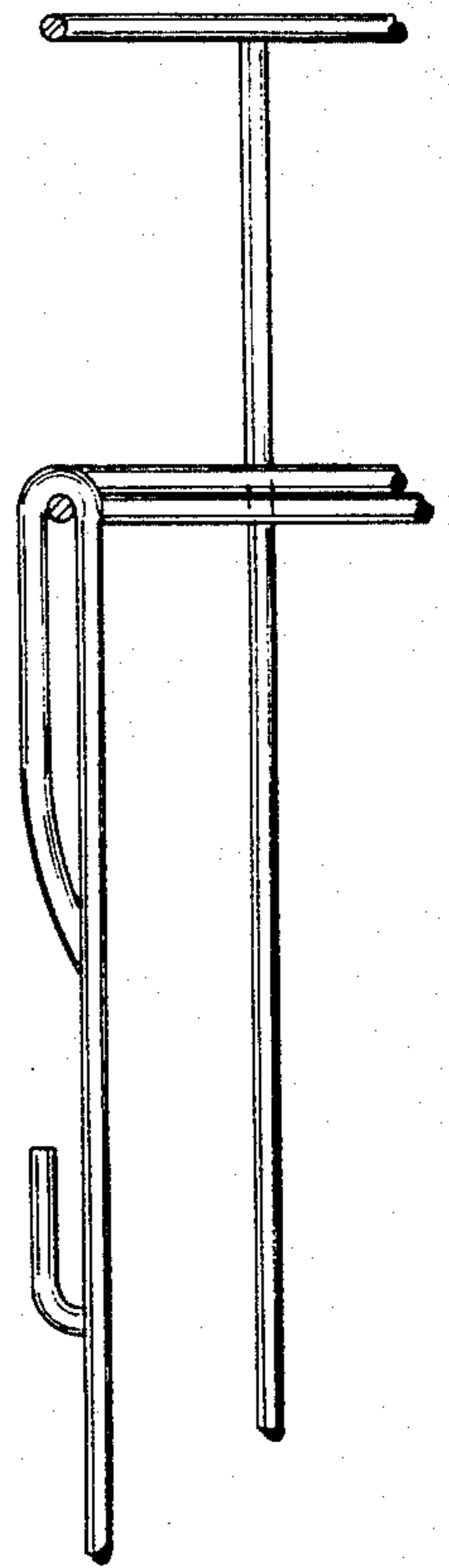

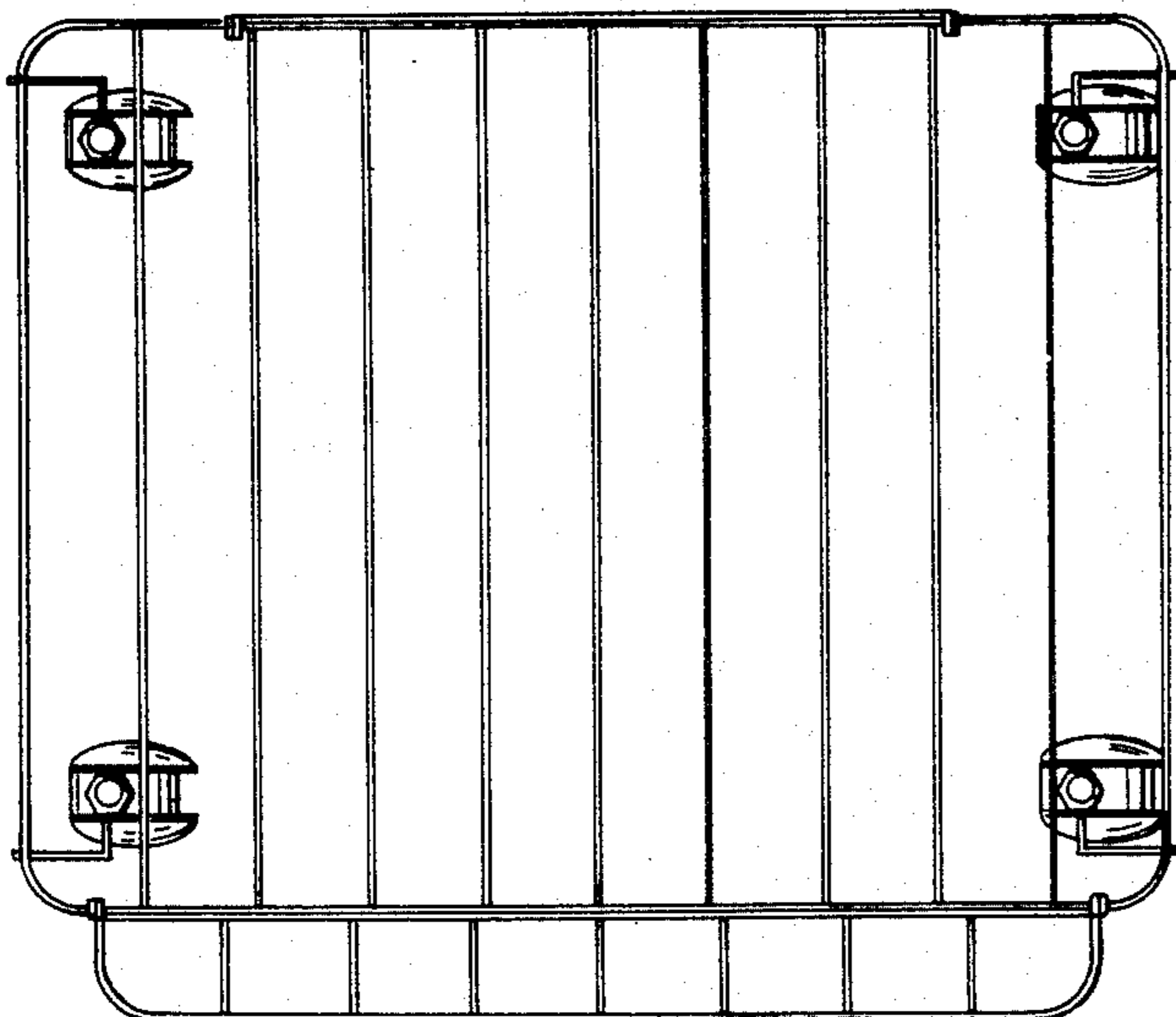
