DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of luggage showing  
our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is an enlarged scale side elevational view, the  
opposite side being substantially a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

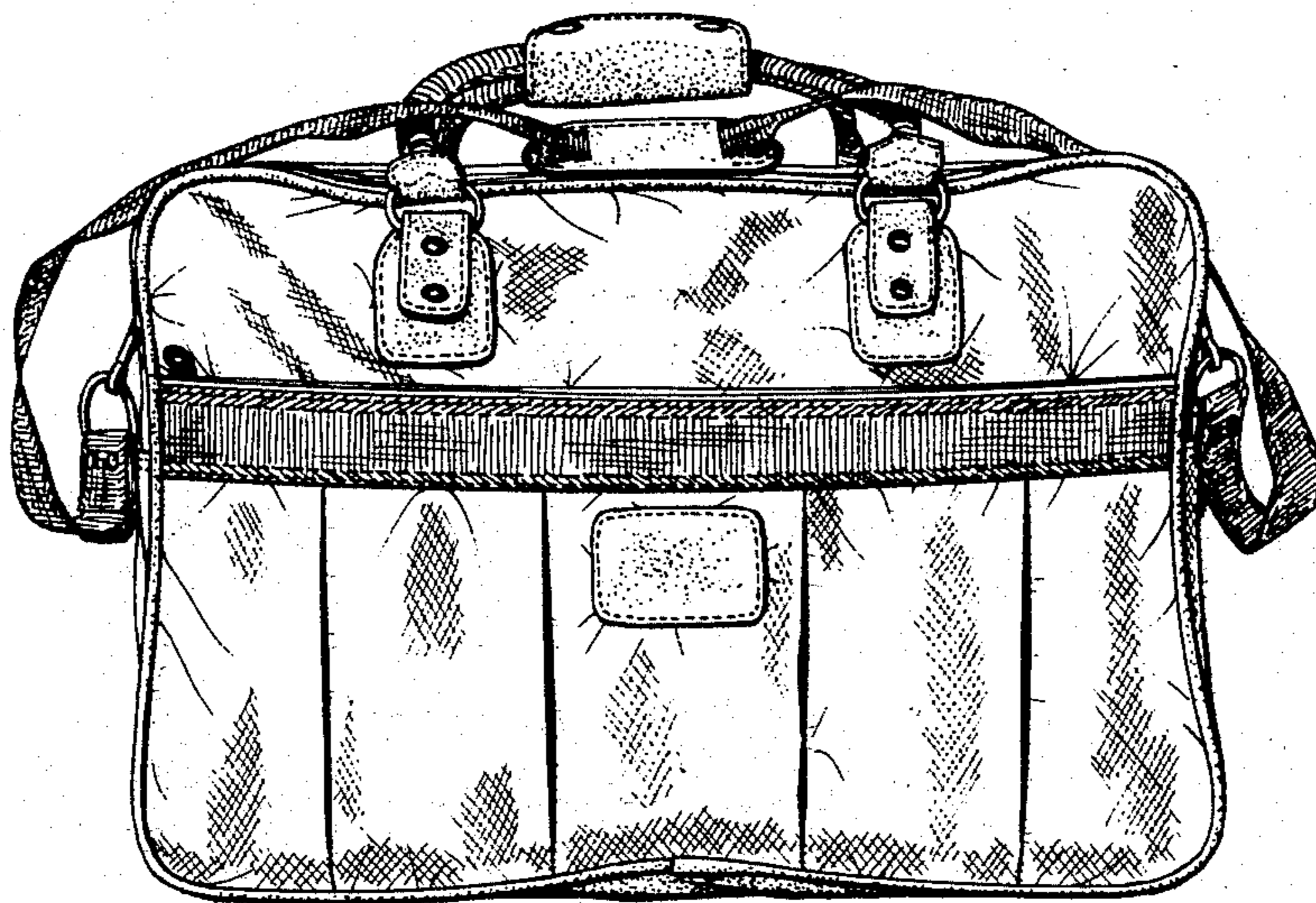

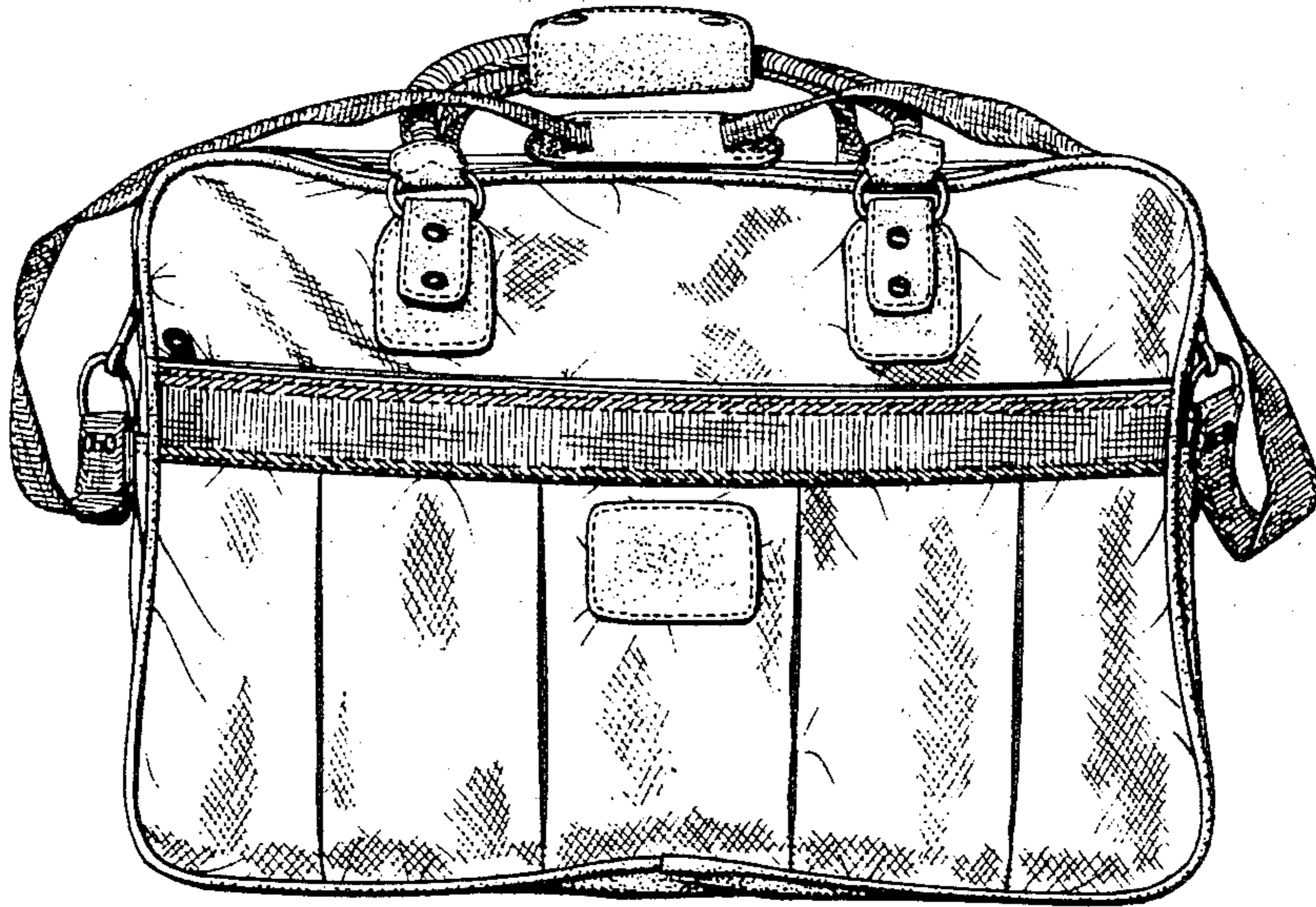

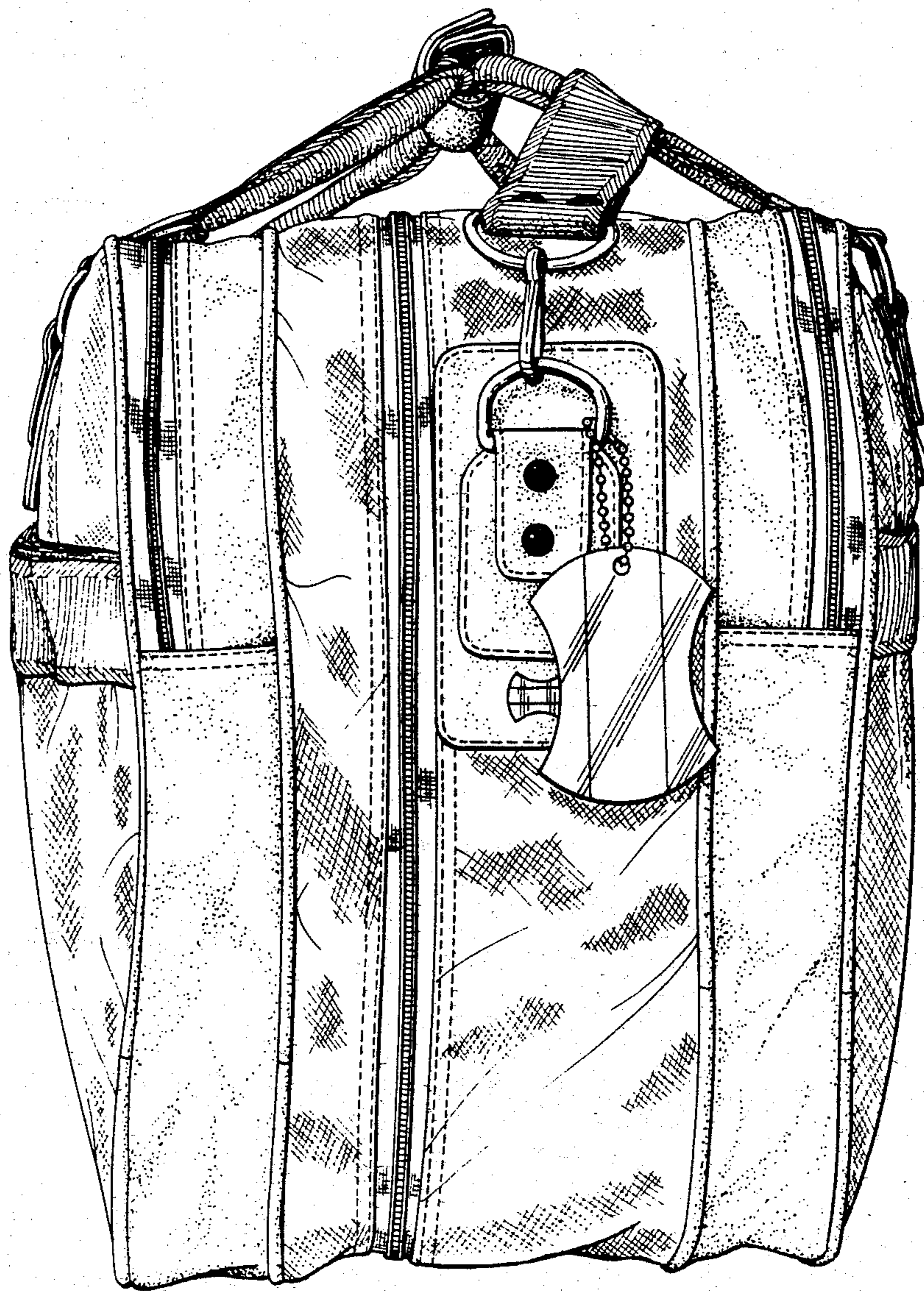

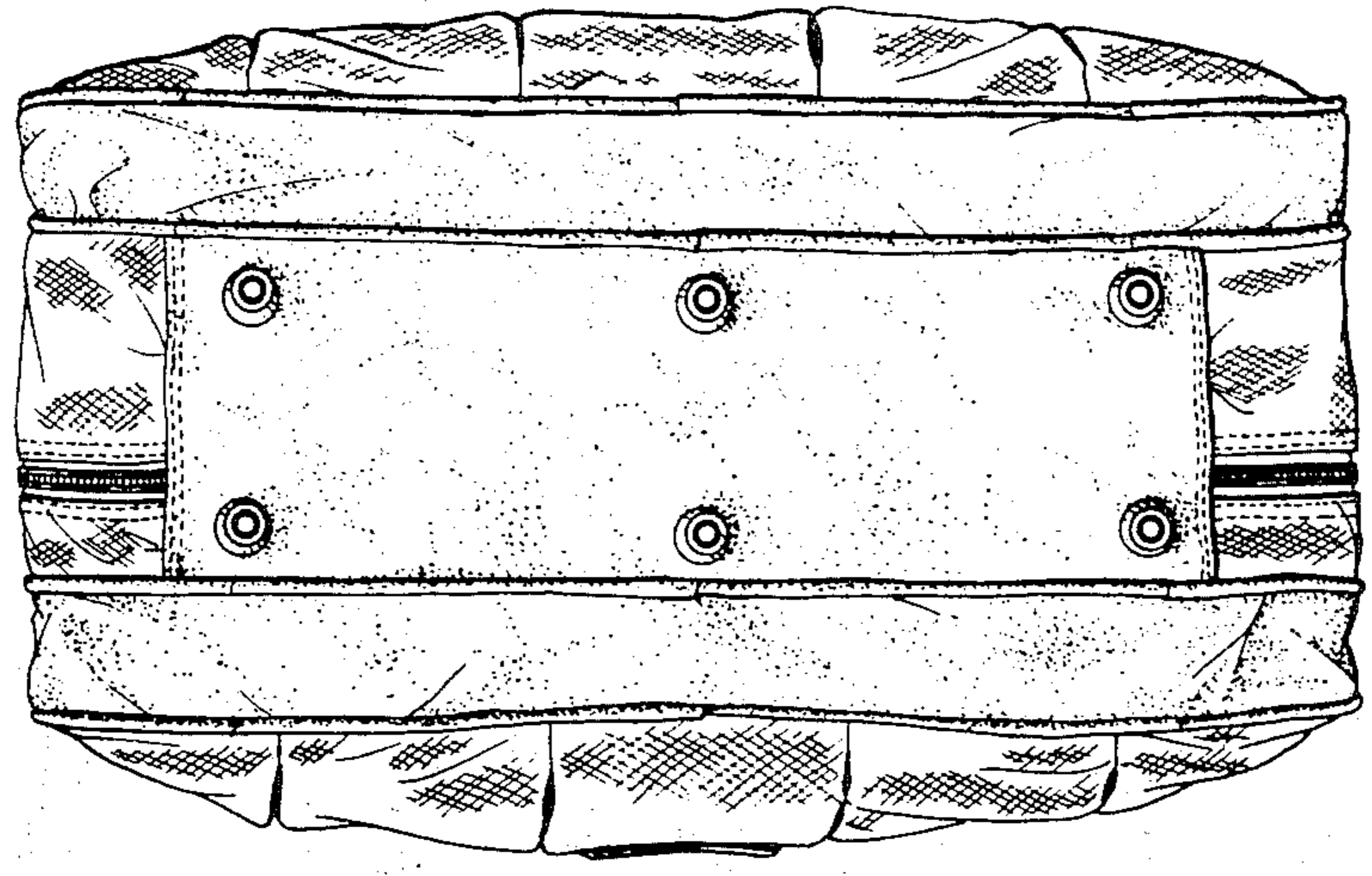
