DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a child's chair showing
our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left
side elevational view being a mirror image thereto;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

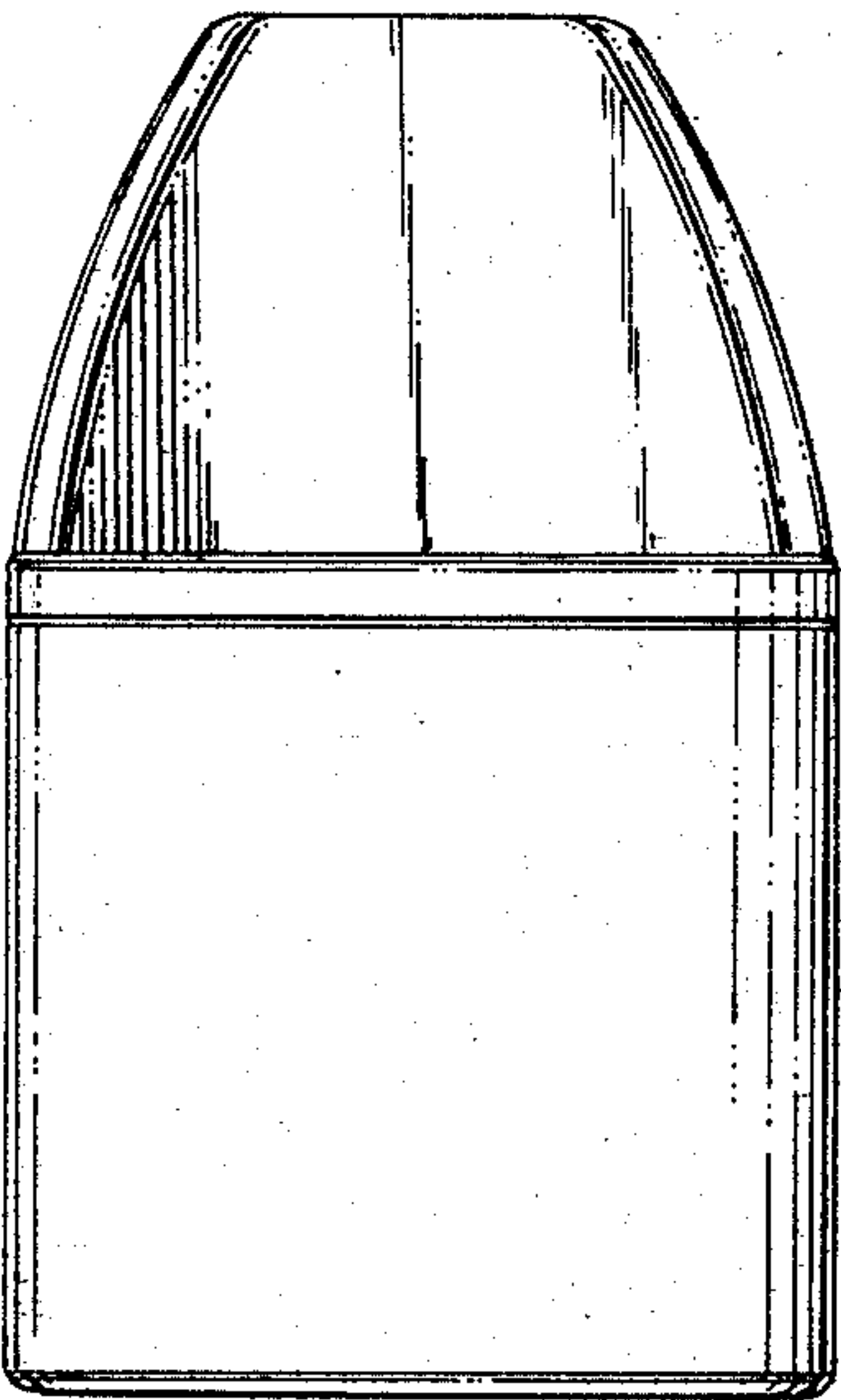

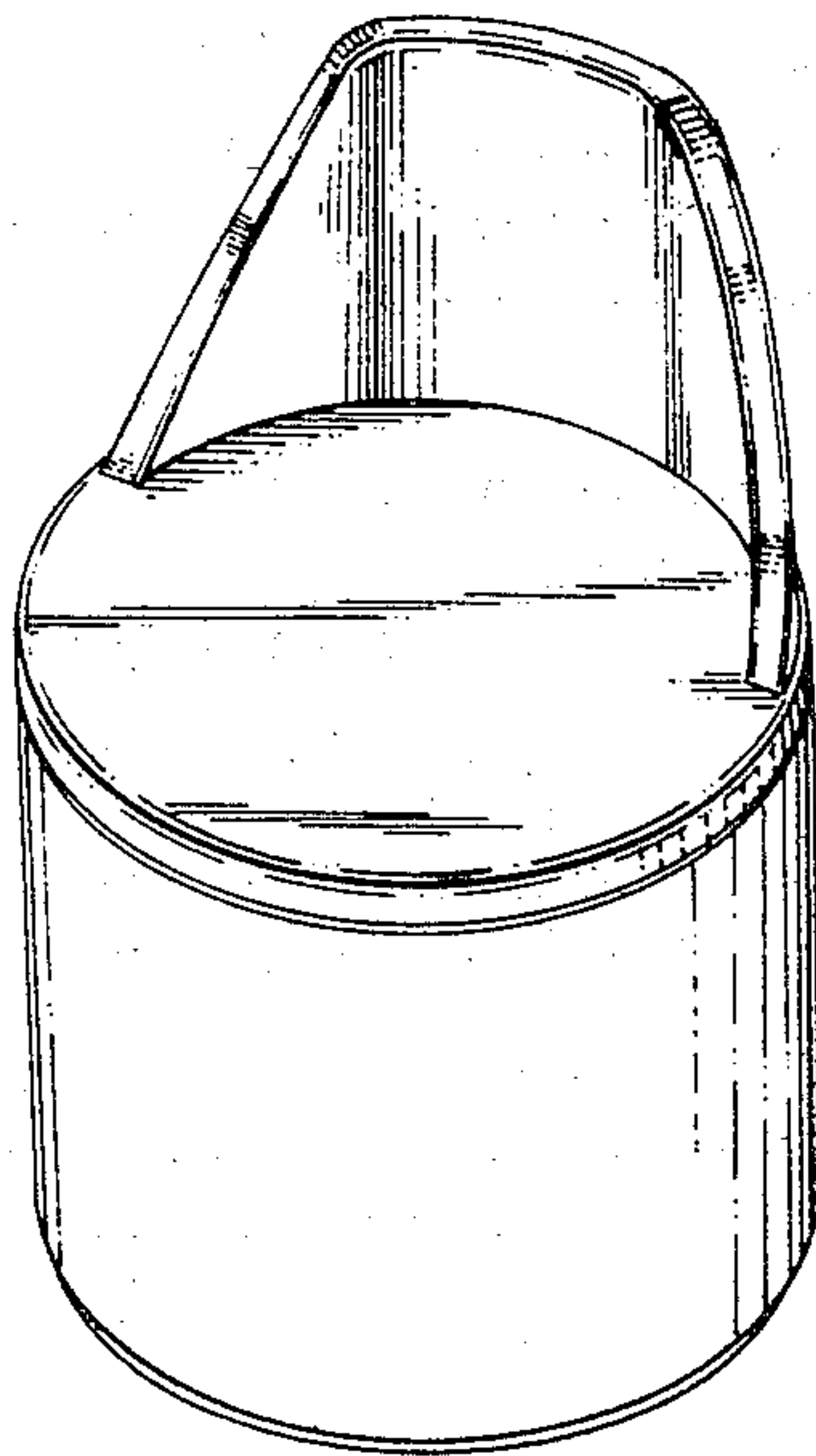

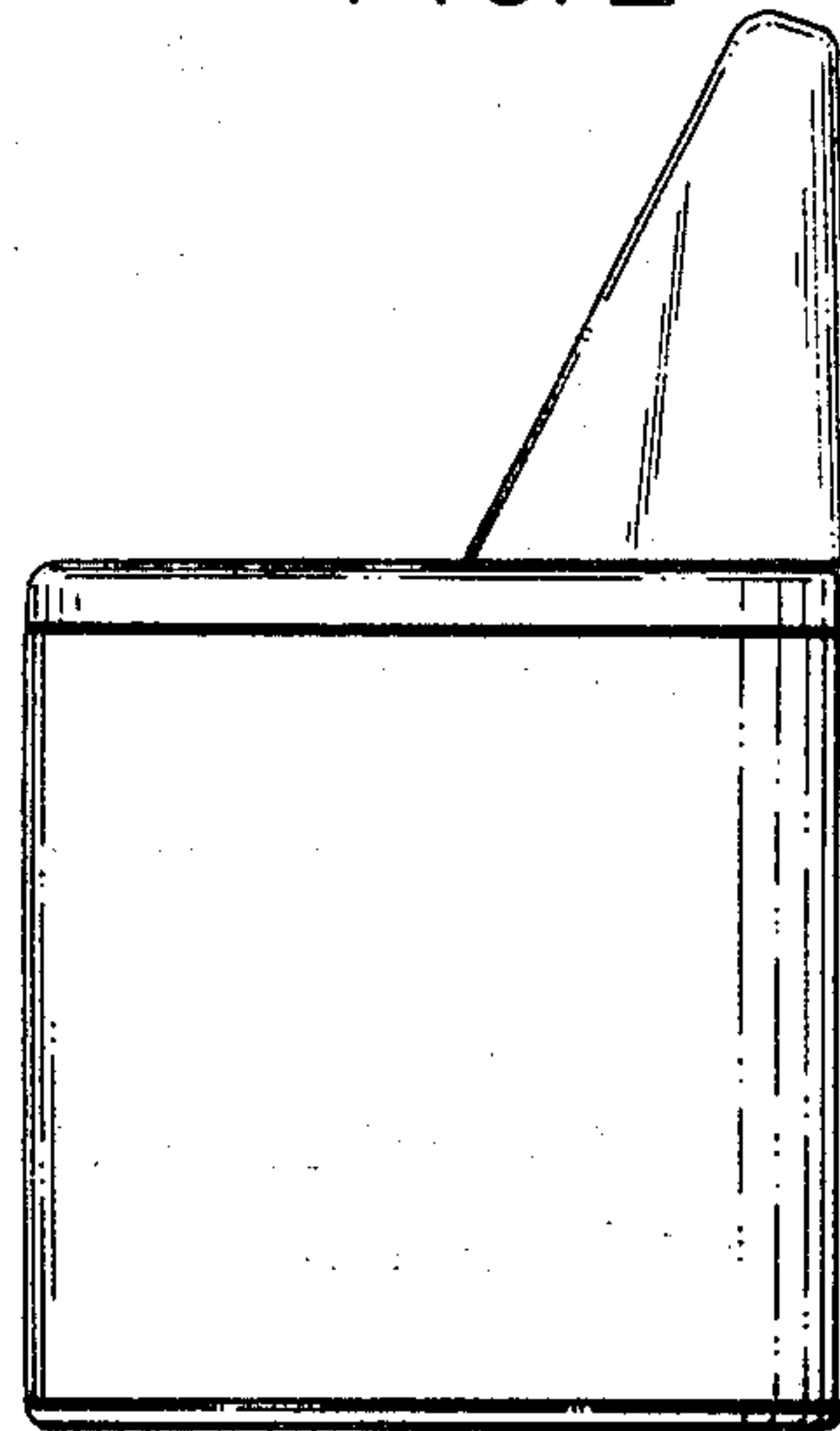

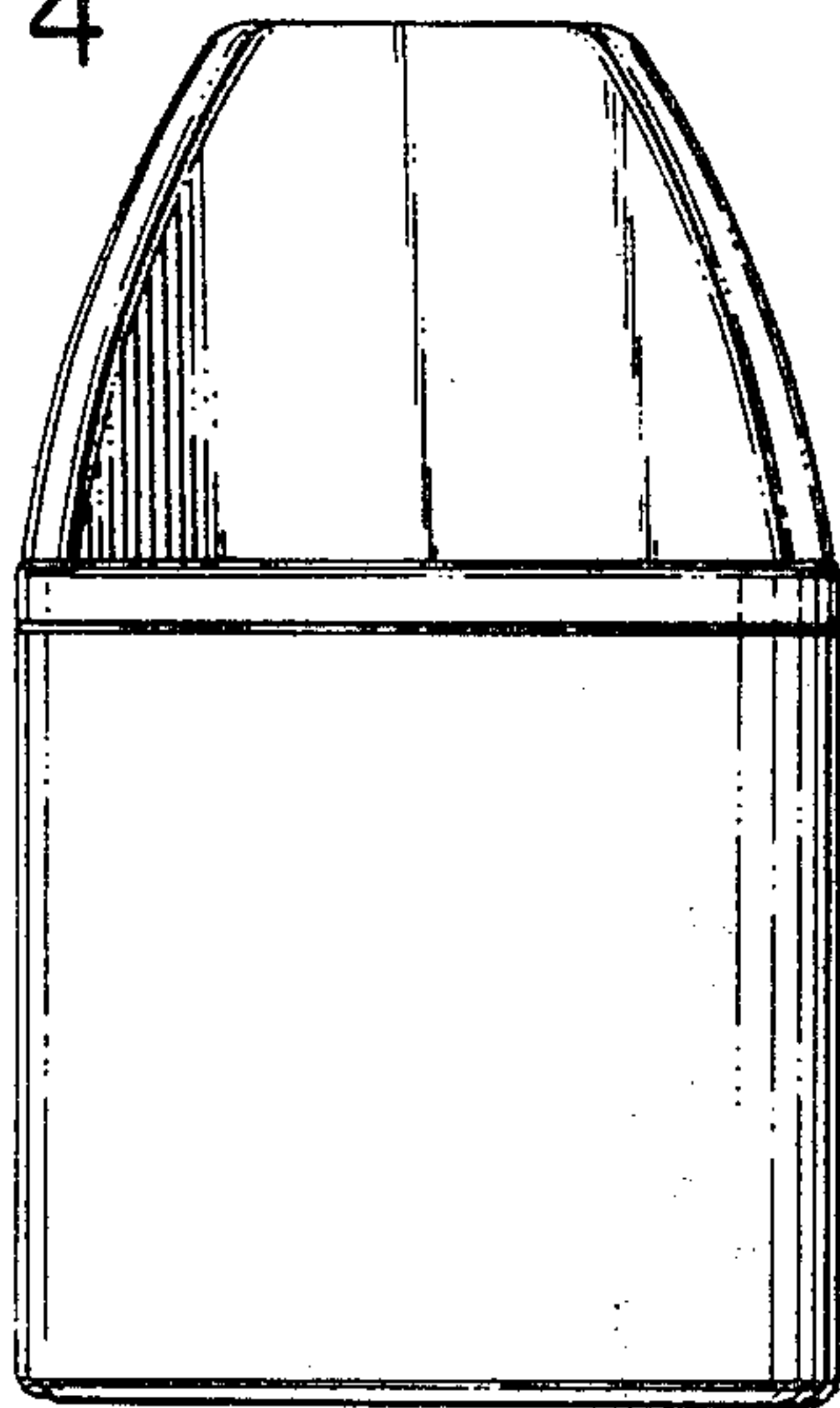

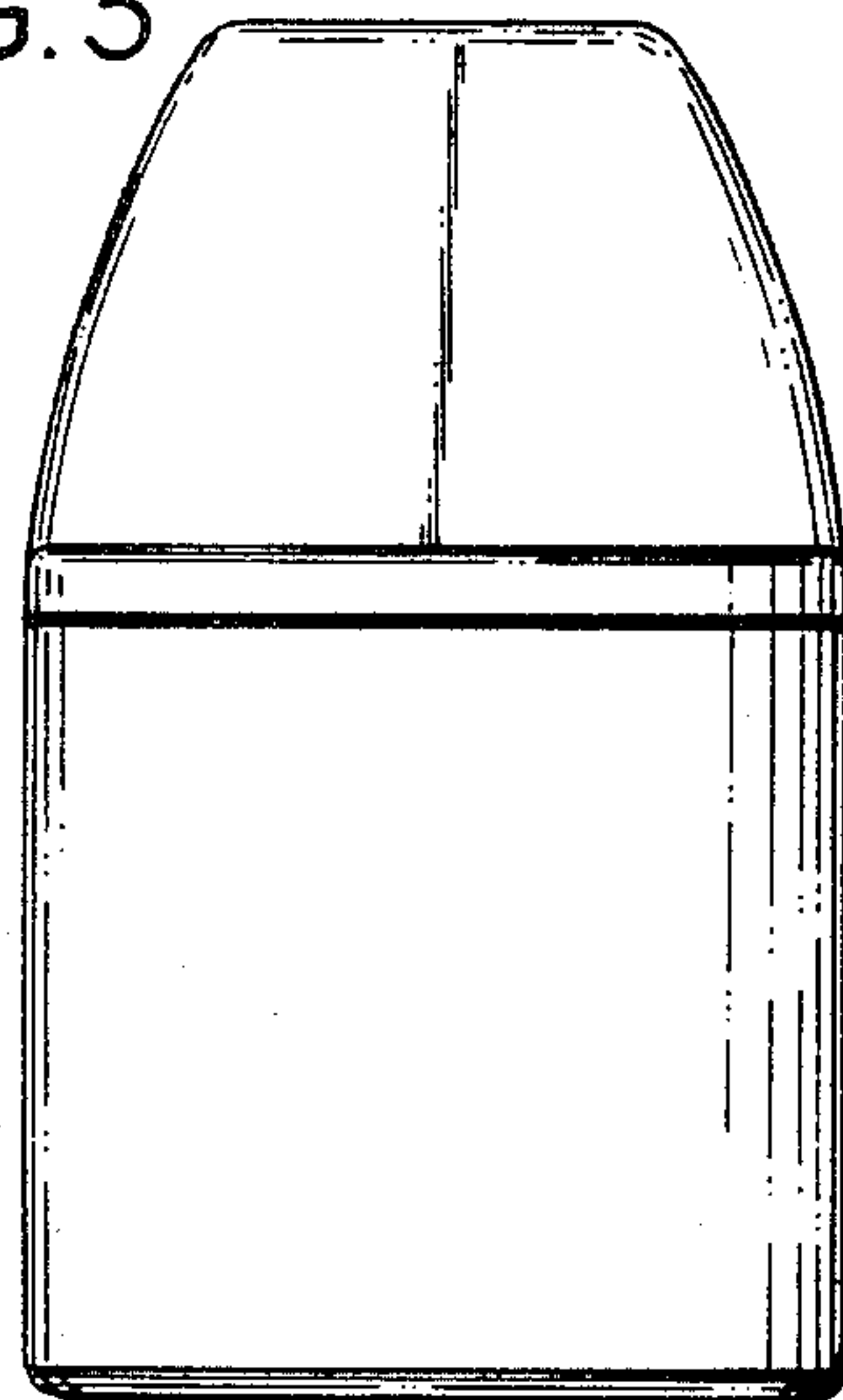

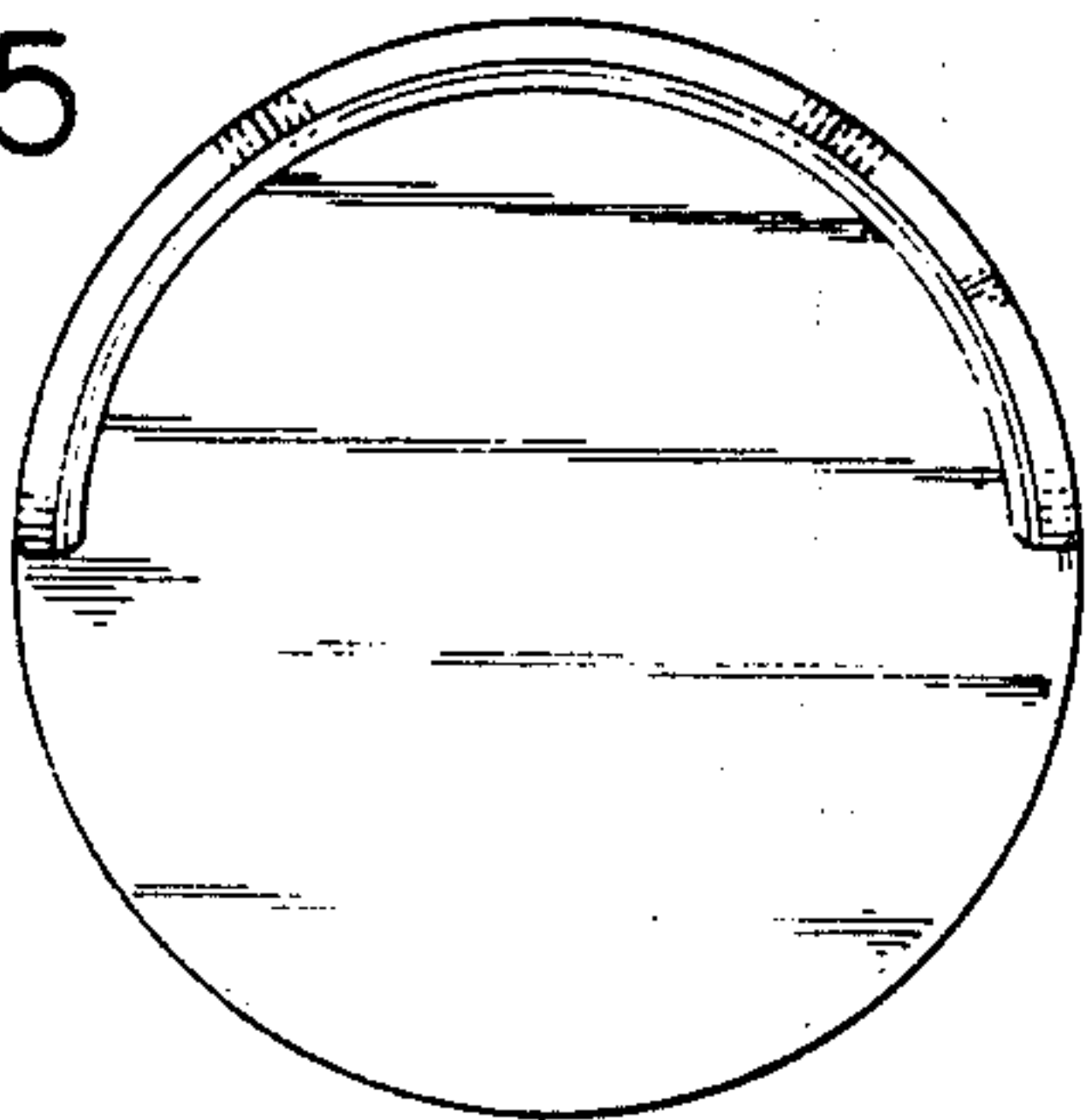
