[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a storage drawer for hair care implements, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a storage drawer for hair care implements showing my design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof of an enlarged scale;

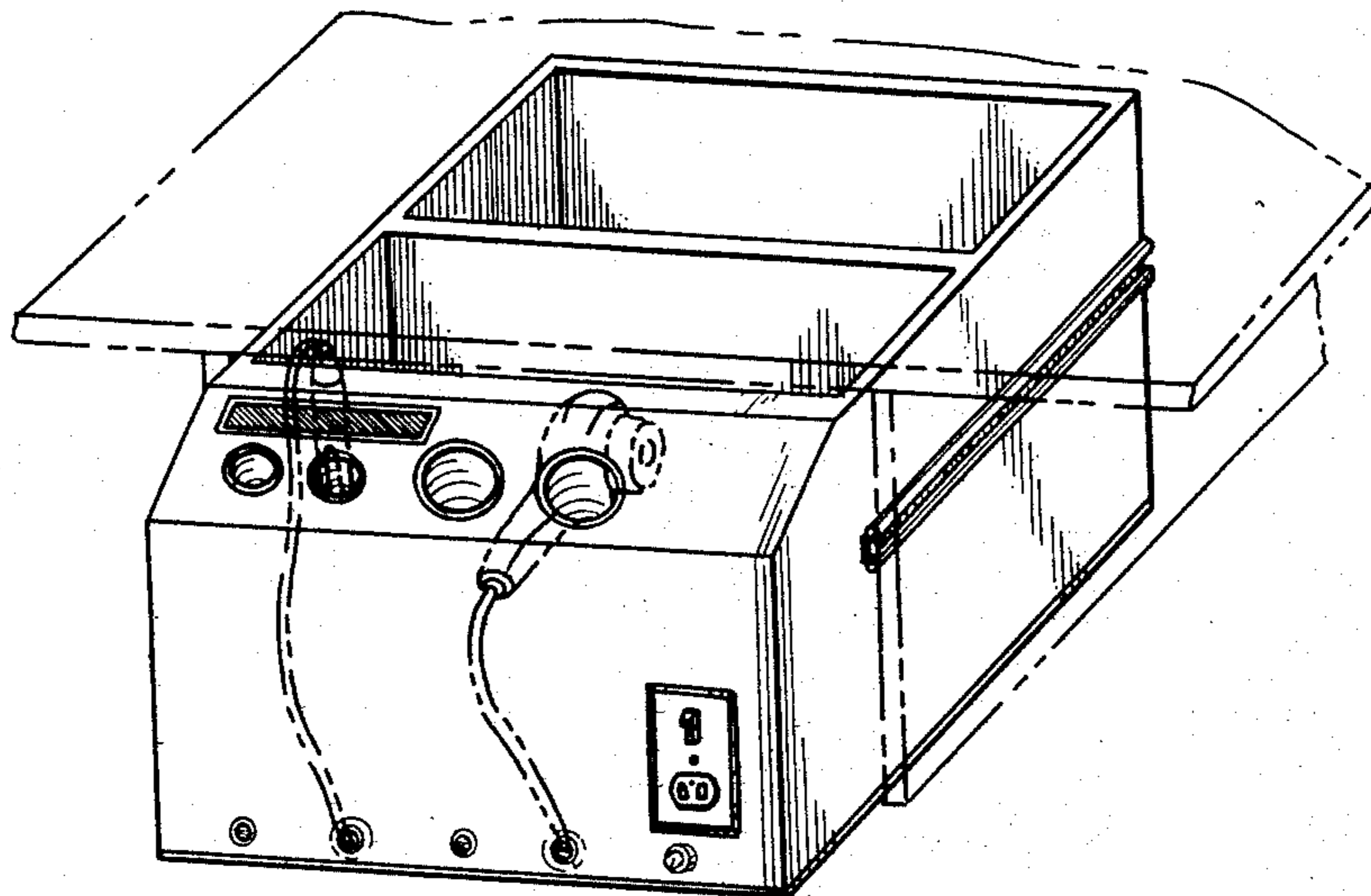
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the drawer of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the drawer of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the drawer of FIG. 2; and FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof.

The side of the storage drawer for hair care implements not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 1.

The broken lines showing a fragmentary shelf and hair care implements in FIG. 1 are for illustrative purposes only.



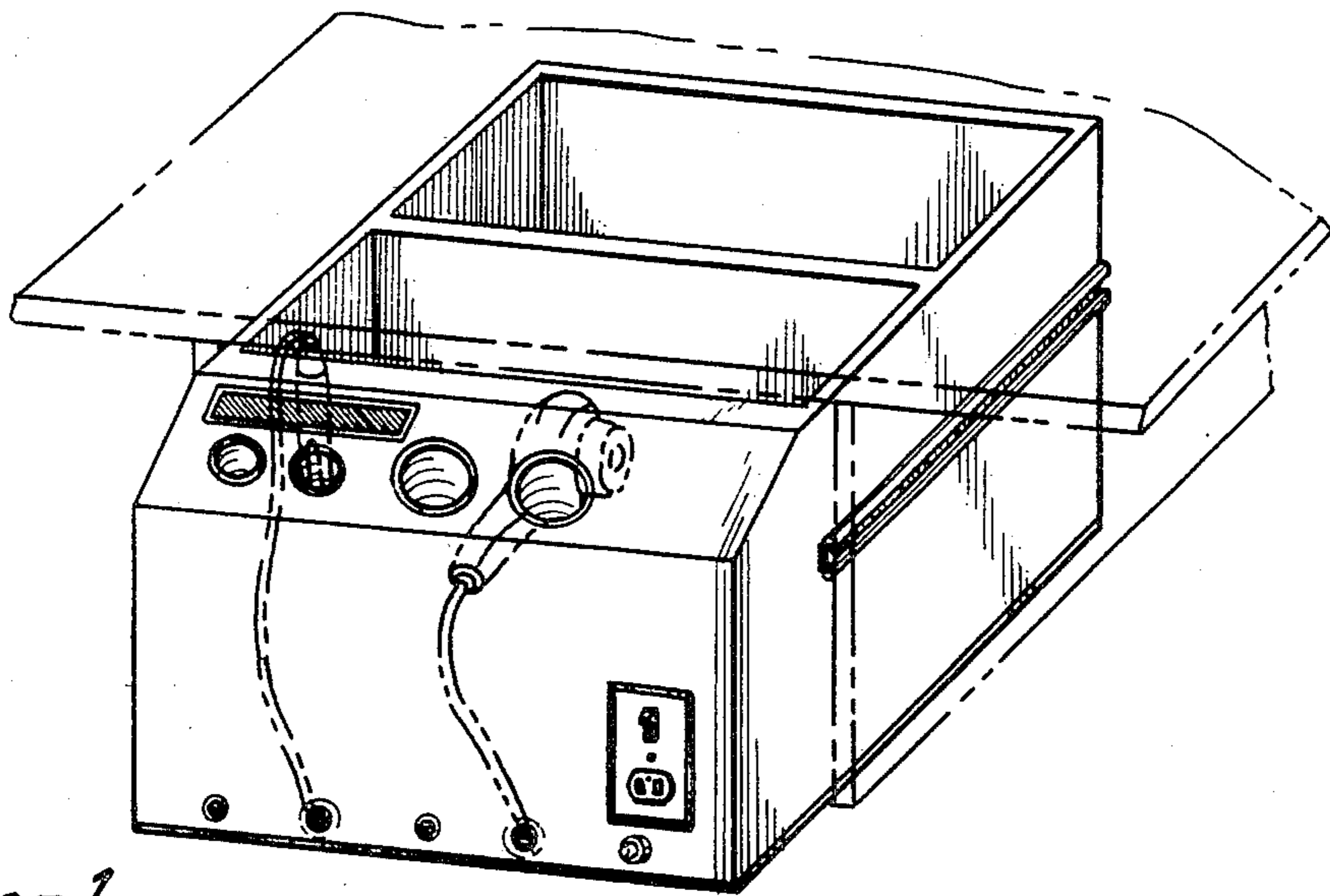

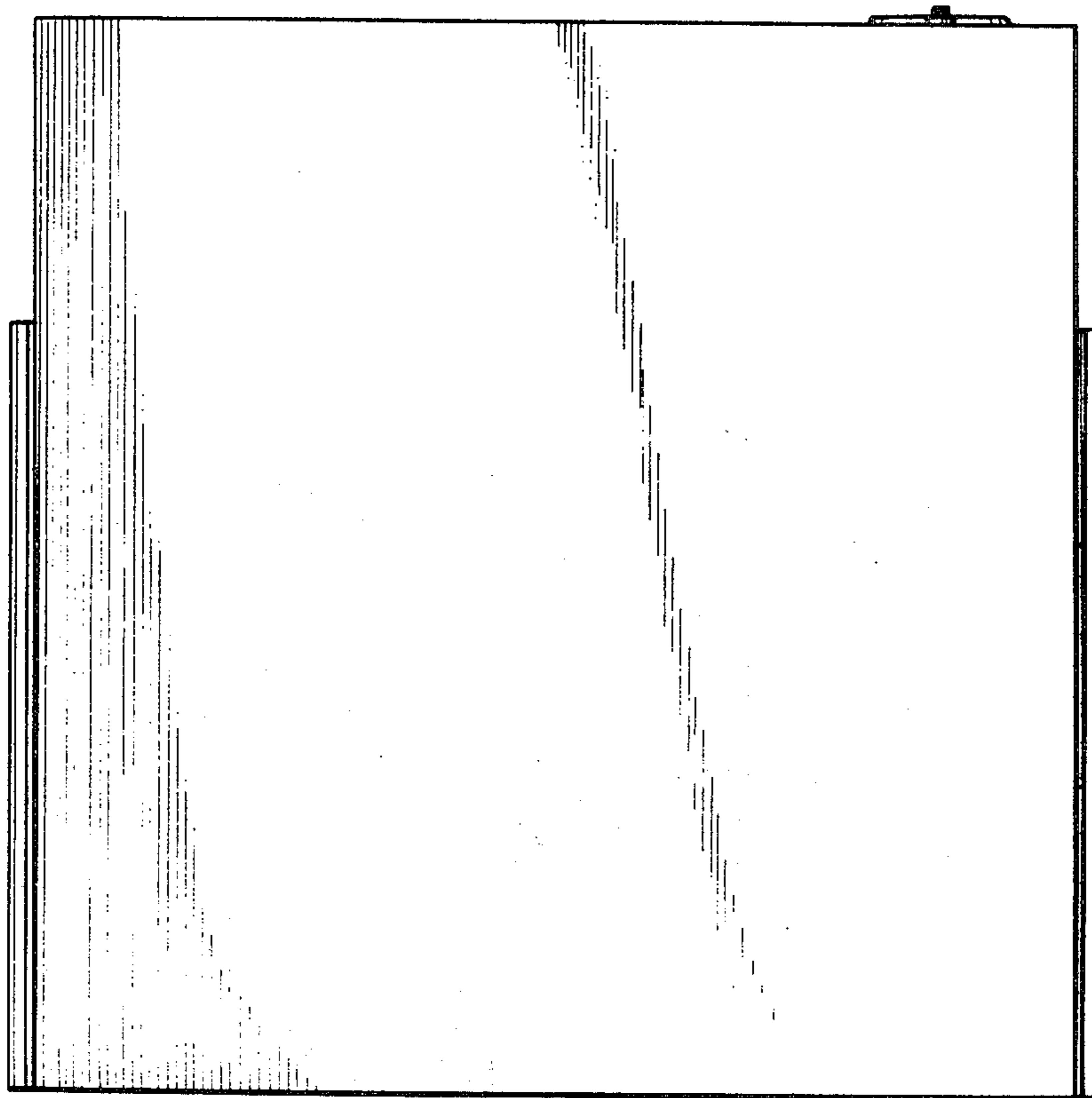

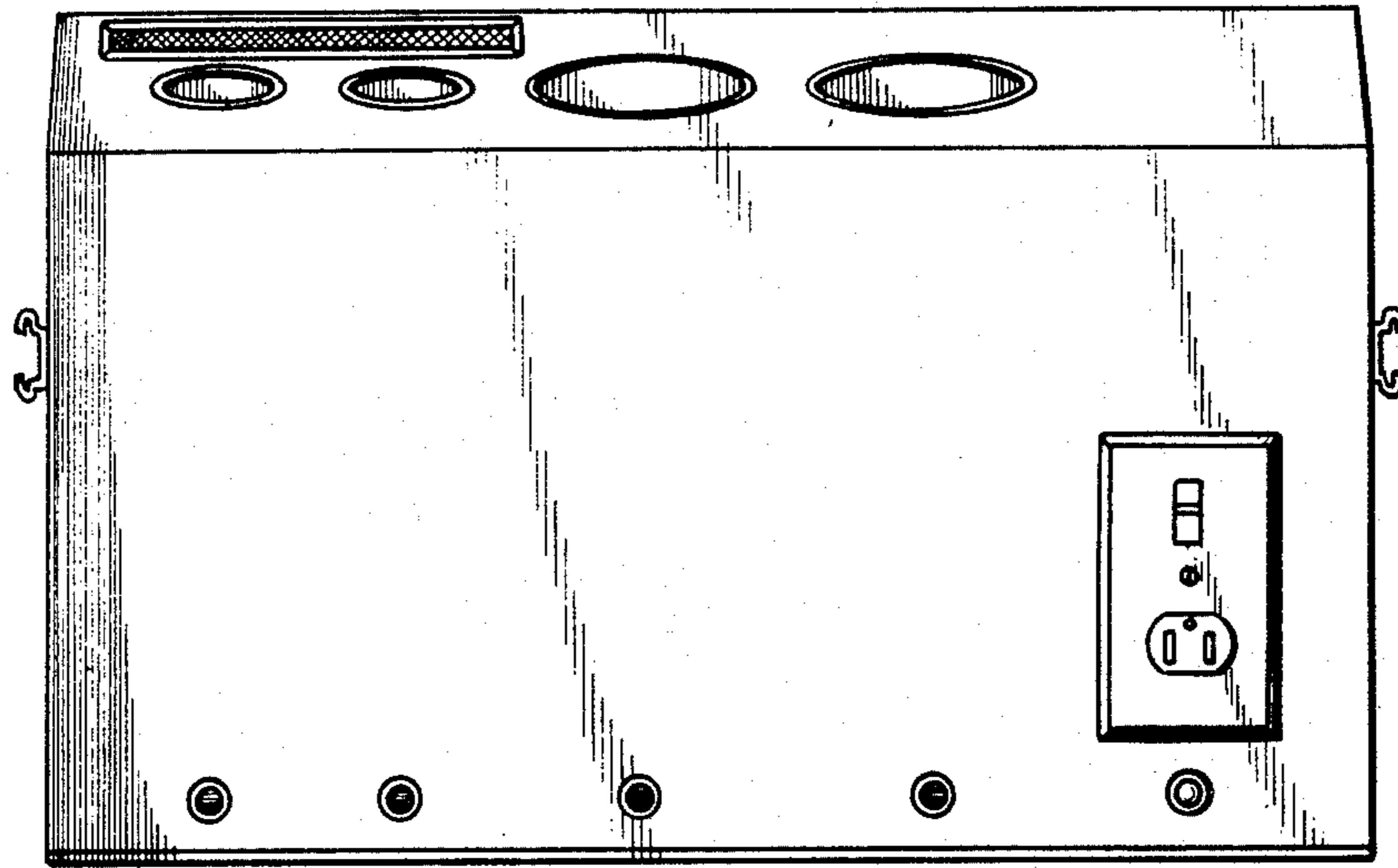

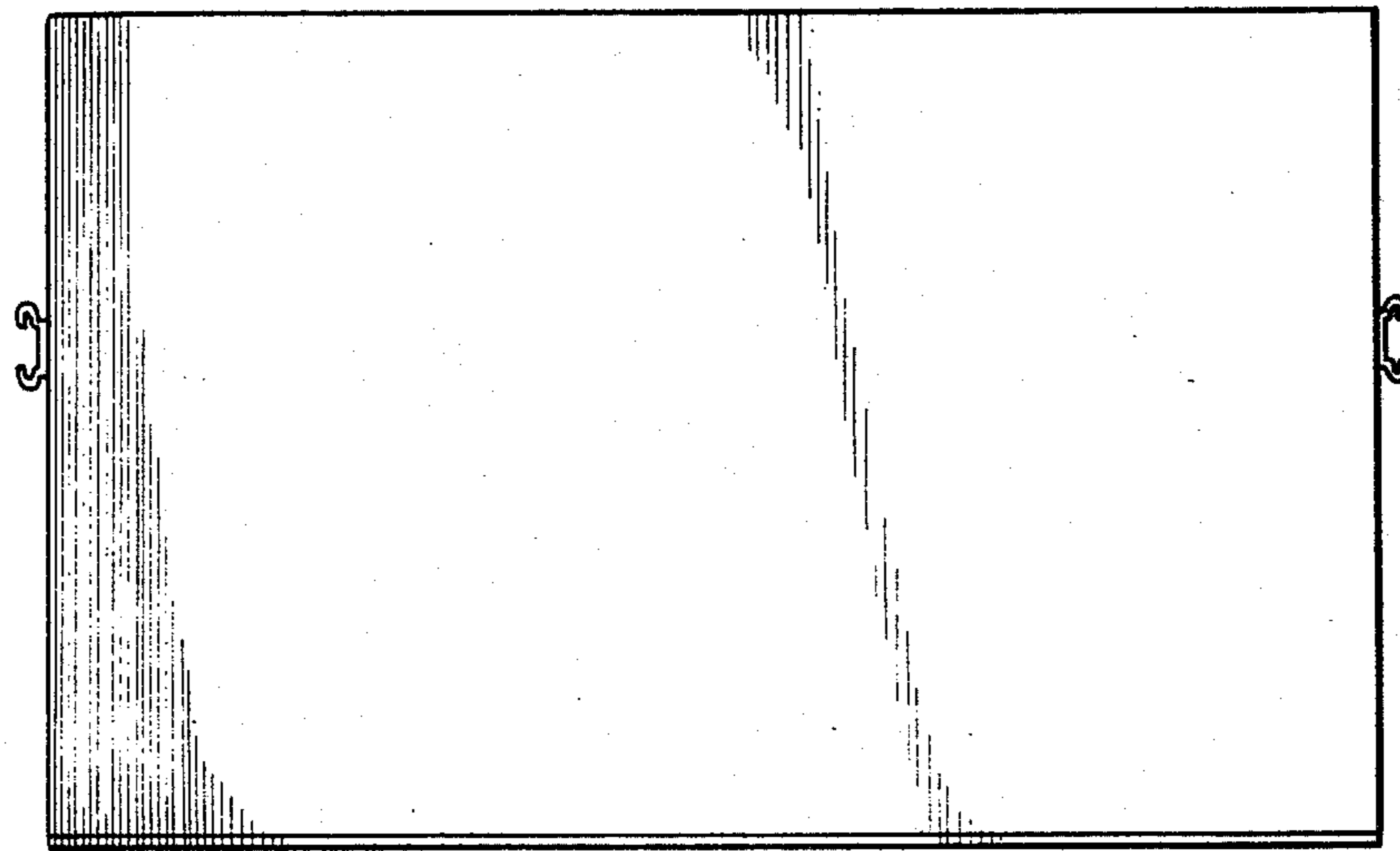

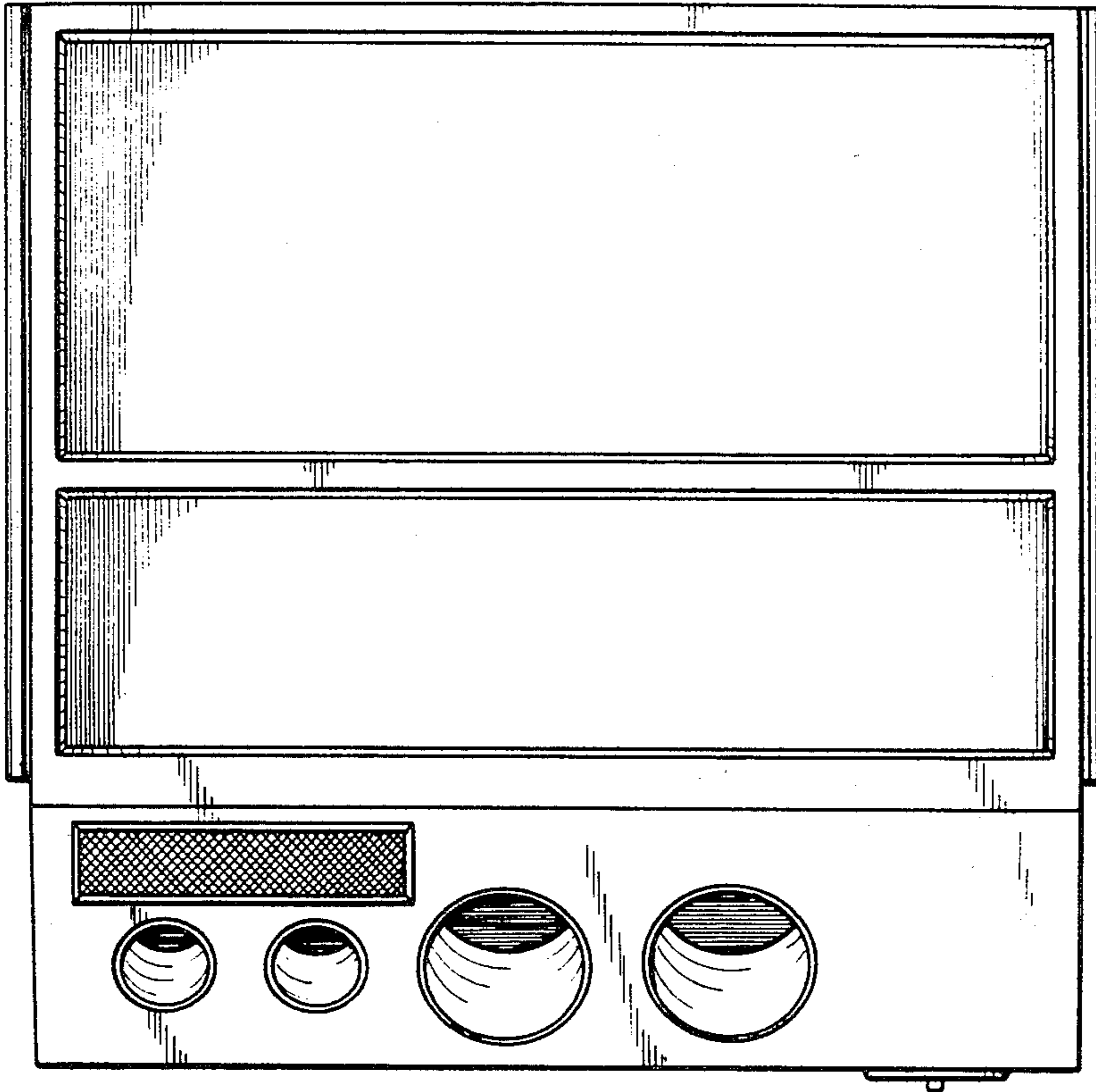

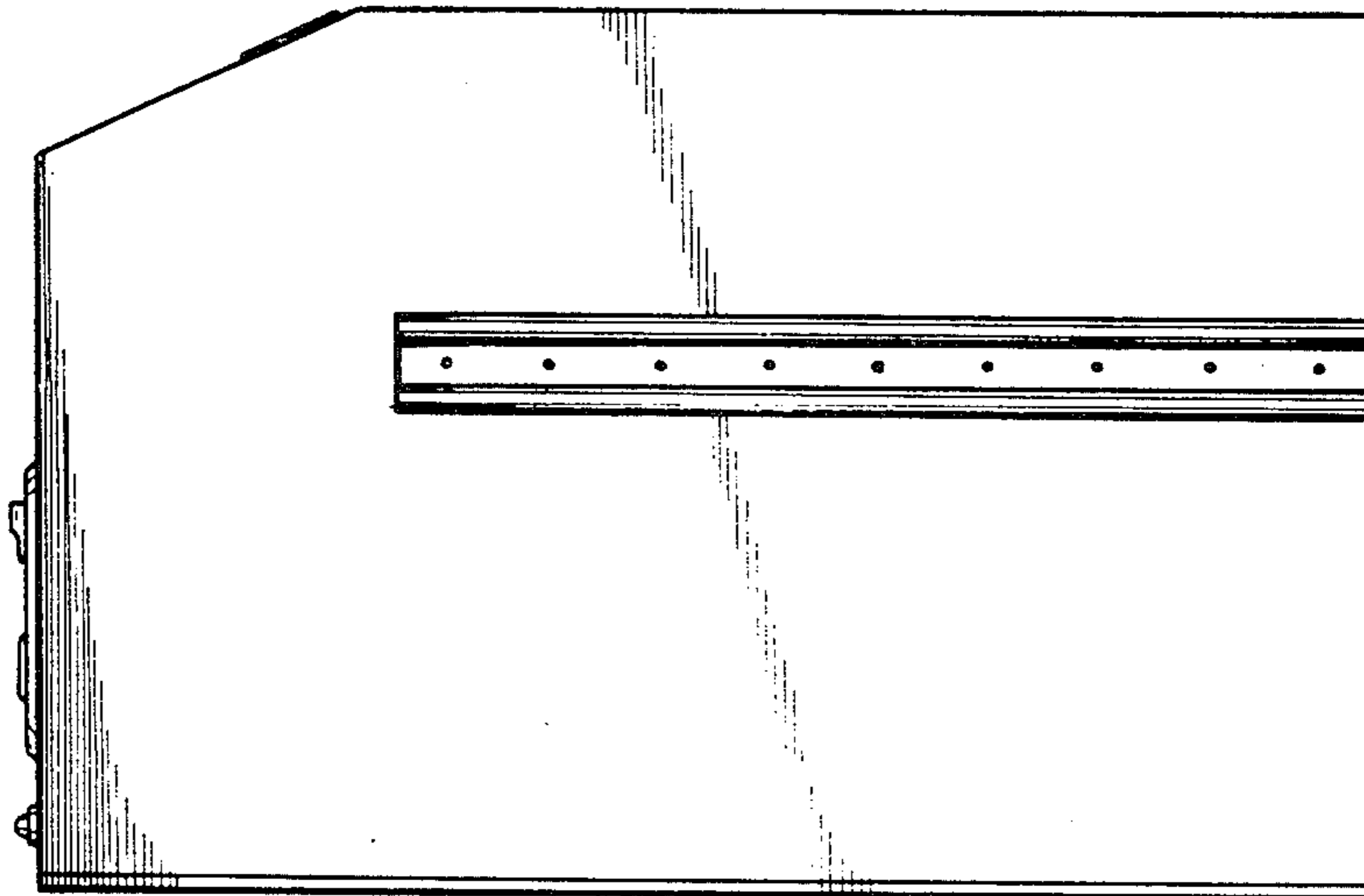
